Kids can also enjoy an easy and intuitive building adventure with the LEGO Builder app, which lets them zoom in and rotate models in 3D, save sets, and track their progress.

Buildable memories – Based on the Disney and Pixar movie Up, this set will appeal to movie fans and older kids with its many details and challenging build. Designed for play and display, it inspires imaginative adventures and can take pride of place on a shelf once play is done.

Unlimited play – With the house measuring over 10.5 in. (27 cm) high, 6 in. (15 cm) wide, and 4 in. (11 cm) deep, this set is made for endless play sessions or display in kids' (or adults') rooms.

He is also wearing a large yellow-orange backpack that holds his tools and equipment! He has black binoculars, a golden megaphone, a red mug, a grey fork, and even a frying pan! Next to him is Carl Fredrickson, he has on a white buttoned shirt, brown jacket, brown bowtie, tan pants, purple and white

badge pinned to his jacket, and is holding a grey walking cane. Carl has glasses on, whitish grey hair, and a grumpy expression on his face while Russel has black hair, short legs, and a happy expression on his face!

The back of the box reveals the inside of the house. There are 4 rooms in this house. The first room through the front door features a plant inside a red pot atop a brown table. Hung on the wall is a cuckoo clock and a painting of a pink and yellow bird on a red background. The next room is a living room area. Carl Fredrickson is sitting on his red comfy couch listening to music from his record player. On the wall, there are many pictures, a wedding photo, a house atop a mountain, and some other photos of people. The top 2 rooms feature an old-fashion brown television with an antenna above it and a purple and blue bed. At the top of the house, there are a lot of balloons attached to the chimney! There are also some smaller pictures that show Carl filling up a yellow balloon while his dog sits and watches, Russell opening the front door and greeting Carl, and the inside of the living room filled with pictures and decorations.

The build is 598 pieces in total, 228 steps, and is for ages 9+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Russell and half of the first floor. Bag 2 includes the pieces for Carl Fredrickson and the rest of the first floor along with part of the second floor. Bag 3 includes the pieces for Dug and the rest of the second floor. Bag 4 contains the pieces for the balloons and the helium filling station.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we may be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43217>). As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1, 2, 3, and 4, and 1 set of instructions. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 — Russell Minifigure

Sub-Build 1. Assemble Russell using his brown shorts printed legs, yellowish tan torso, clear backpack holder, light nougat head, and yellow cap with black hair. Make sure the 2 studs of the clear backpack holder are on Russell's back! We will use this later to hold his huge backpack! Russell is dressed like a boy scout with his orangish-brown neckerchief and brown sash with tons of merit badges thrown over his shoulder!

Group 2 — Russell's Backpack

1. Locate 1 yellow 1x2 plate with 2 side studs. Place it horizontally so the 2 side studs are in front. Then locate 1 light orange 1x2 tile with a singular stud. Horizontally place this on the 2 side studs.
2. Locate 2 1x2 plates with a single stud and a pin hole. Vertically place them on top of the 1x2 plate with 2 side studs so the holes overhang in the back.
3. Locate 2 yellow 1x1 plates with a clip. Place them on the 2 top-facing studs so the clips point left and right.
4. Locate 1 more light orange 1x2 plate with a singular stud. Horizontally place this on top of the 2 1x1 plates with clips.
5. Locate 2 red pins with 1 short side and 1 long side. Insert the long side of these pins into the holes on the left and right so that the short side is sticking out.
6. Locate 1 red mug and 1 light grey fork. Insert the handle of the mug into the left pin and orient it so the mug faces the back and slightly up. Then place the handle of the fork into the left clip so the fork faces up.
7. Locate 1 light grey frying pan. Place the bottom of the frying pan onto the singular stud facing up and orient the handle so it is facing back and a little to the right.
8. Locate 1 black binoculars Place this on the right pin so the bigger circles of the binocular are facing back.
9. Locate 1 gold 1x1 circular brick and 1 gold handlebar with a stud hole on the bottom. Place this gold handlebar onto the stud of the circular brick to make the megaphone! Then with the bottom of the circular brick facing up and the handlebar facing you, attach it to the right clip. Congratulations you finished Russell's backpack! Now let's put it on him.
10. Orient the entire backpack so that the red mug is in the top right. Then attach the 2 studs that are on the back of Russell onto the top 2 stud holes of the backpack. The 2 studs should sit beneath the 2 holes of the 1x2 plates.

Group 3 — First Floor

1. Locate 1 nougat 6x10 plate. Place it horizontally in front of you. Now locate 1 tan 1x4 plate. Vertically place it in the back right corner so there is no overhang.
2. Locate 1 light brown 2x2 tile with a singular stud and 1 light grey 2x2 circular tile with a singular stud. Place the square 2x2 tile to the left of the 1x4 tan plate so it is aligned with the backside. Then place your circular tile right in front of this tile.
3. Locate 1 pink 1x2 brick with 2 side studs. Vertically place this in the back right corner on top of the tan 1x4 plate so the studs are facing left.

4. Locate 1 pink 1x2 brick with 2 side studs and 1 white 1x2 grill tile. Horizontally place the grill tile on the 2 side studs so they are facing left. Then vertically place this brick in front of the previously placed 1x2 pink brick.

5. Locate 1 pink 1x4 brick. Vertically place this in the back right on top of the 2 pink bricks with side studs.

6. Locate 1 tall bright pink 1x2 window frame and 1 tall clear 1x2 glass. Orient the window frame so it is horizontal, then feel the inner left and right sides. Make sure the thinner side is facing you, then insert your glass and snap it into place. Now vertically place this window on top of the pink 1x4 brick so that there is a free stud of the pink brick in front and behind it. Make sure the window side is facing right.

7. Locate 6 pink 1x1 bricks. Place them on each other until you have 2 sets of 3 brick high pillars. Then place them behind and in front of the window so they sit on the pink 1x4 brick.

8.1. Locate 1 pink 1x4 brick and set it down horizontally in front of you. Then locate 1 pink 1x1 brick and place it on the leftmost side of this brick.

8.2. Locate 1 pink 1x2 brick with 2 side studs. Horizontally place this to the right of the 1x1 brick so the 2 side studs are facing you. Then locate 1 more pink 1x1 brick and place it to the right of this brick.

8.3. Locate 1 brown 2x2 circular tile with a sticker and place it on the 2 side studs so there is no overhang at the top.

8.4. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 11 on the brown 2x2 circular tile. This sticker has light blue and dark blue pine trees on a white background. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

8.5. Then place this build vertically in the back right corner so it sits on top of the pink bricks and pink window. The sticker should be facing left.

Group 4 — First Floor

9.1. Time to make the record player! Locate 1 brown 1x2 plate with 4 side studs. Orient it so the side studs are facing back. Then locate 1 light brown 1x1 brick and place it on the left top-facing stud.

9.2. Locate 1 black 1x1 brick with 1 side stud. Place this to the right of the 1x1 brick from step 9.1 so that the side stud faces right. Then locate 1 brown 1x2 tile that is shaped like a gold bar and horizontally place it on the 2 top-facing studs.

9.3. Now lay it towards you so the bottom of the brown 1x2 plate with 4 side studs is facing back and so the 4 side studs are now facing up. Now locate 1 black 2x2 circular tile with a hole in the center. Place this on top of the 4 studs.

9.4. Locate 1 nougat 1x1 circular stud with a bar attached. Place this on the stud that is on the right-facing side and orient the bar so it is facing up. Now locate 1 miner hat with a stud in the front. Insert the stud part into the top of the bar and orient the hat so the inside faces left. Congratulations, you finished the record player, now let's place it!

9.5. Orient it so the bottom of the 1x2 plate with 4 side studs faces right now. Then place the bottom into the 2 side studs of the pink 1x2 brick that is below the pink window.

10. Let's make a lamp now! Locate 1 long gold stick, 1 white 2x2 ridged circular brick, and 1 white 2x2 circular tile. Place the circular tile on top of the circular brick so it aligns perfectly. Then orient your gold stick so the short end is facing up. Place the middle of the bottom of the circular brick into the top of the stick. Then place the bottom of the stick into the stud of the 2x2 circular tile located in front of the record player.

11. Locate 1 green 2x4 tile. Horizontally place this to the immediate left of the 2x2 circular tile that holds the lamp. Then locate 1 dark grey 1x4 tile and 1 tan 2x4 plate. Vertically place the 1x4 tile to the left of the green tile so that the back of it aligns with the backside of the 6x12 plate. Then vertically place the 2x4 plate to the left of this tile so it also aligns with the backside.

12. Locate 1 pink 1x4 brick. Vertically place this on the left side on top of the tan 2x4 plate so there is no overhang.

13. Locate 2 white 1x1 bricks with holes. Place these on top of the tan 2x4 plate to the right of the pink 1x4 brick so the holes face front and back and they create a vertical 1x2 gap between them. Then locate 1 black 1x2 plate with a bar attached. Vertically place this in the gap so that the bar part is facing right. Then locate 1 black 1x2 pin. Insert it into the hole of the 1x1 white brick located in the back. Make sure you insert the pin from the back so the pin is pointing away from you.

Group 5 — First Floor

14. Locate 1 pink 2x4 plate. Vertically place this on top of the pink 1x4 brick and 2 white 1x1 bricks with holes.

15. Locate 2 white 1x1 plates with a singular side stud and 1 white 1x2 plate with a side groove. Place the 1x1 plates on top of the vertically placed 2x4 plate in the back right and front right corners so that the side studs are facing right. Then vertically place the 1x2 plate in between these plates so that the groove is facing right.

16. Locate 1 pink 1x4 brick. Vertically place this to the left of the previously placed plates so it sits on top of the pink 2x4 plate. Then locate 1 gold 1x1 circular tile with a compass printed on it. Place this on the front stud of the 1x2 plate with a side groove.

17. Locate 2 pink 1x4 bricks and 2 tall pink 1x2 bricks with 4 side studs. Vertically place 1 of the 1x4 bricks on top of the previously placed 1x4 brick in step 16. Then vertically place 1 tall pink 1x2 brick on top of this brick on the back 2 studs so that the side studs are facing left. Then vertically place the other tall brick in front of this tall brick so that the side studs face right. Then vertically place the remaining 1x4 brick on top of these 2 bricks so there is no overhang.

Group 6 — First Floor

18. Locate 1 tan 2x4 plate and 1 green 2x6 curved plate. Vertically place the 2x4 plate in front of the green 2x4 tile that was placed in step 11 so it sits in the middle of the 2x4 tile and that there are 4 studs overhanging. Then horizontally place the middle of the green 2x6 curved plate under the overhang so that the curve is facing you.

19. Locate 2 dark tan 2x2 tiles. Place these to the left and right of the tan 2x4 plate so that it sits behind the green 2x6 curved plate.

20. Locate 1 red 1x1 bird. Place this in front of the compass that was placed in step 16. Orient it so that the tail is facing you and the beak is facing back. Then locate 2 long tan curved tiles. Place these to the left and right of the front stud of the tan 2x4 plate so that the back end of each curve is touching each of the pink walls.

21.1. Let's build the cuckoo clock now! Locate 1 brown 1x2 plate with 2 side studs. Orient it so that it is horizontal and the side studs are facing back. Then locate 1 brown 2x2 circular tile with a sticker on it and place it on the 2 top-facing studs so that it overhangs in the front.

21.2. Locate 2 gold 1x1 circular plates with a bar attached. Place them underneath the overhang so that the bars are facing you.

21.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the brown 2x2 circular tile. This sticker is a clock that has a small hand and a large hand. Instead of numbers, this clock uses Roman numerals! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

21.4. Locate 2 brown 1x1 slope tiles. Orient your clock so the 2 back-facing studs are now facing up. Then place 1 slope tile on the left stud so that it goes down from right to left. Then place the other slope tile on the right stud so it goes down from left to right.

21.5. Now orient your main build so the green 2x6 curved plate is on the right. Then with the 2x2 circular tile with the clock sticker facing you, place the back onto the 4 side studs located on the pink wall.

22. Keep your build oriented like this so the green 2x6 curved plate is still on the right. Then locate 1 tan 1x4 plate and 1 light brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top. Vertically place the 1x4 plate on the front so it is against the pink wall and there is an exposed 2x2 stud area to the left of this plate. Then vertically place your 2x4 tile to the right of this plate so there is an exposed 1x2 stud area to the right. Both of these pieces should overhang.

23. Locate 1 nougat 6x6 plate. Place this in the front and under the overhang of the 2 previously placed pieces so that the sides align with the sides of the 6x10 plate.

24. Locate 1 tan 1x4 plate. Vertically place this in front of the tan 1x4 plate from step 22. Then locate 1 tan 1x2 plate. Horizontally place this on the front 2 studs to the left of the tan 1x4 plate.

25.1. Locate 1 tan 4x6 frame, 1 brown 4x6 door with a sticker on both sides, and 1 gold 1x1 circular plate. Orient the door so it is horizontal and upright. Place the gold circular plate on this stud. This will be the front of the door!

25.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the front of the door. This sticker has a rectangular etched golden design and 3 golden locks! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

25.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the back of the door. This sticker has a rectangular etched golden design and a bunch of golden locks on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

25.4. Now orient your door frame horizontally so the inner side of the wall is thinner towards you. Then make sure your door is oriented so the front is facing you and is upright. Then insert the right side of the door into the frame and snap it into place.

25.5. Now vertically place your door on the back tan 1x4 plate so it is against the pink wall and that the door opens to the right.

26. Locate 1 brown 2x2 circular brick and 1 light brown 2x2 tile with a singular stud. Place the 2x2 tile on top of the circular brick. Then place it directly behind the tan 1x2 plate that is located in the front left corner.

27. Locate 1 yellow 1x2 brick and 1 orange 1x3 brick. Vertically place the 1x3 brick in front of the door so that there is a free stud on the 1x4 plate in front. Then to the left of this stud, horizontally place the 1x2 brick so it sits in front of the circular brick you placed in the last step.

28. Locate 1 green plant that has 3 leaves and a stem, and 1 red 1x1 brick that is 2 plates high. Place the red 1x1 brick on top of the singular stud of the 2x2 tile that is located in the front left. Then place the stem of your plant into this brick.

Group 7 — First Floor

29. Locate 1 yellow 1x2 brick and 1 orange 1x3 brick. Vertically place the 1x3 brick on top of the orange 1x3 brick with no overhang. Then horizontally place the 1x2 brick on top of the 1x2 brick that is in front of the plant.

Group 7 — First Floor

30.1. Locate 1 tan 1x2 plate. Horizontally place this on top of the yellow 1x2 brick from the last step so there is no overhang.

30.2. Locate 1 tall yellow 1x2 brick with 4 side studs and locate 1 brown 2x2 circular tile with a sticker. Place this circular tile on the 4 side studs.

30.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 12 on the brown circular tile. This sticker is of a pink and yellow bird on a red background! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

30.4. Now horizontally place this on top of the tan 1x2 plate in the front left corner so the picture faces back.

31. Turn your build so it is horizontal and the door opens towards you! Now locate 1 orange 1x1 brick with a side stud and 1 bluish-grey 1x1 circular tile. Place this tile on the side stud of the orange brick. Now locate 2 orange 1x1 bricks. Place them both on top of the orange brick with a side stud. Then take your build and place it to the immediate left of the door frame so that the circular tile is facing you. This is the doorbell for the door!

32. Locate 1 tall pink 1x2 window frame and 1 tall clear 1x2 glass. Orient the window frame so it is horizontal, then feel the inner left and right sides. Make sure the thinner side is facing you, then insert your glass and snap it into place. Then place your window directly to the left of the doorbell we just placed so that it sits on the 2 studs of the 1x3 brick. Make sure the glass is towards you!

33. Locate 1 tall tan 1x1 brick. Place this directly to the left of the window.

34. Locate 1 yellow 1x1 brick and 1 yellow 1x3 half arch. On the back left corner stud, horizontally place your half arch so that it goes up to the right. Then in front of that back left corner stud, place your 1x1 brick.

35. Locate 1 orange 1x3 brick and 1 yellow 1x1 brick. Place the 1x1 brick on top of the yellow 1x1 brick you placed in the last step. Then horizontally place your 1x3 brick so it sits directly to the left of the door on top of the window and doorbell.

36. Locate 1 pink 1x2 brick with 2 side studs and 1 white 1x2 grill tile. Horizontally place the grill tile on the 2 side studs. To the immediate right of the door, there is a vertical pink wall with 4 exposed studs on top. Vertically place the 1x2 brick on the back 2 studs so that the grill tile faces the left.

Group 8 — First Floor

37. Locate 2 orange 1x4 bricks, 1 yellow 1x2 brick, and 1 pink 1x1 brick. Horizontally place 1 orange 1x4 brick in front of the pink 1x2 brick you placed in the last step so that it doesn't overhang on the right. Then in front of the last stud of this 1x4 brick, place your pink 1x1 brick. To the left of the 1x4 brick, horizontally place your other 1x4 brick. Then vertically place your yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner so there is no overhang.

38.1. Locate 1 white 3x3 tile with a sticker.

38.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the white 3x3 tile. This sticker is of a house on top of a large mountain surrounded by a blue background. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly.

38.3. Then rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the door opens to the left now. Now there should be a tall 1x4 wall in front of you and another 1x4 wall behind this one. Then place your picture on the 4 front facing studs on the second wall. Make sure the picture doesn't overhang on the left and right. Also, make sure it is at the highest point it can be without overhanging at the top. Make sure it is oriented correctly!

39. Locate 4 tall tan 1x1 circular bars with a stud on top. This piece should feel like 3 different-sized cylinders with a stud on top. Rotate your build back to how it was so the door opens in the front. Place 2 behind the front left corner stud. Make sure they are behind one another and not on top of each other. Then place 2 to the right of the front left corner stud so that they are in the second and third columns.

40. Locate 2 tan 1x2 tiles that are shaped like gold bars. Vertically place 1 on top of the 2 circular bars you placed behind the front left corner. Then horizontally place the other on top of the 2 circular bars to the right of the front left corner.

41. Locate 2 tall tan 1x1 bricks. Place 1 in the front left corner stud and 1 directly to the right of the horizontally placed 1x2 tile from the previous step.

42. Locate 3 tall tan 1x1 bricks and 3 tan 1x1 circular bricks. Place each tall brick on top of each circular brick so you end up with 3 of these pillars. Then place 2 pillars on top of the 2 tall bricks you placed in the previous step. Then behind the vertically placed 1x2 tile shaped like a gold bar in the front left, place your last pillar.

43. Locate 1 tan 1x8 plate with a groove. Horizontally place this with the groove in the front, on the front 2 tall tan bricks that were placed in the previous step so the left side aligns with the tall tan brick in the front left corner. Now locate 1 nougat 6x6 plate. Place this on top of the plate you just placed so that the front left corner of the 6x6 plate is aligned with the front left corner of the build.

Building Instructions (Bag 2):

Group 9 - Carl Minifigure

Sub-Build 2. Assemble Carl Fredrickson using his tan legs, brown jacket over a white shirt-printed torso, light nougat head, and grey-white hair. Assemble his cane using a light grey L-shaped bar and a light grey 1x1 stud plate with 4 wheels. Make sure that when the handle of the cane is facing back, the 4 wheels should be facing front and back. Then put it in Carl's hand so he can stand!

Group 10 - First Floor

44. Put your main build aside for now. Let's make the windows! Locate 1 brown 2x2 plate with 2 raised top studs and 2 side studs. Place it in front of you so the 2 side studs are facing you. Then locate 1 dark tan 1x2 brick with a bar. Horizontally place the 1x2 brick on the lower back 2 studs so the bar is facing left.

45. Locate 1 brown 1x2 plate. Horizontally place the plate on top of the 1x2 brick so there is no overhang.

46. Locate 2 white 1x1 bricks with 2 side studs on different sides. Place 1 on the front left stud so the side studs are facing left and front. Then place it in the front right stud so the side studs are facing front and right.

47. Locate 1 tan 2x2 plate. Place this on top of the 4 top-facing studs. Then locate 1 mint-colored 1x2 tile with a singular stud. Horizontally place this on the back 2 studs of the tan 2x2 plate you just placed.

48. Locate 1 tall pink 1x2 window frame and 1 tall clear 1x2 glass. Orient the window frame so it is horizontal and upright, then insert your glass and snap it into place. Then horizontally place it in front of the 1x2 tile with a singular stud so the glass is towards you.

49. Locate 1 tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs. Horizontally place this on top of the window frame so the side studs are facing front. Then locate 1 bright green 1x2 plate with 4 side studs. Horizontally place this on top of the plate you just placed so the 4 side studs are facing back.

50. Locate 2 white 1x1 bricks with 2 side studs on different sides. Place 1 on the left stud of the plate you just placed so the side studs are facing left and front. Then place the other 1 to the right of this so the side studs face front and right.

51. Locate 1 tan 1x8 plate and 4 light green 1x2 slope tiles. Horizontally place the slope tiles onto the plate so they cover all the studs. Make sure the slopes are all facing the same direction. Now vertically attach to the left side of the build using the top and lower side studs. Make sure the slope is going down towards the back.

Group 11 - First Floor

52. Locate 1 tan 1x8 plate, 2 light green 1x4 plates, and 4 pink 1x2 slope tiles. Horizontally attach the 1x4 plates to the 1x8 plate so all the 1x8 studs are covered. Then use the 1x2 slope tiles to cover the studs of the 1x4 plates. Make sure the slopes are all going down in the same direction. Now vertically attach this to the right side of the build using the top and lower side studs. Make sure the slopes of the tiles are all going down towards the back.

53. Locate 1 tan 1x4 tile with a sidewall and 1 light green 1x4 tile with 1 stud on each side. On the front side, there are 4 side studs on the lower area below the window. Horizontally place the light green 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the bottom 2 studs so it is centered. Now above that, horizontally place the 1x4 tile with a sidewall in the center so the side wall is on top. It should act like a windowsill.

54. Locate 1 light green 1x4 tile with 1 stud on each side and 1 tan 1x2 plate with 1 bar on each side. On the front side, above the window, there are 4 front-facing studs. On the upper 2 studs, horizontally place your green 1x4 tile with 2 side studs so it is centered. On the lower 2 studs, horizontally place the 1x2 plate with 2 bars so it is centered and the bars are going down.

55. Locate 1 tan 1x4 tile. On the top, horizontally place this so it is centered.

56. Rotate the window build 180 degrees so the back is now facing you. Locate 1 clear head-shaped piece that says Paradise Falls, 1 clear 1x1 circular plate, and 1 light blue 1x1 circular tile. Place the 1x1 plate on top of the head-shaped piece then place the 1x1 tile on top of the plate. You just made the jar! Now in front of the window there is a 1x2 tile with 1 stud. Place this onto that stud so the side with Paradise Falls is facing you. Ask a helper to make sure it is oriented correctly!

57. Locate 1 brown 2x2 circular tile. Above the window, there is a 2x2 side stud area. Attach this to the 2x2 area.

58. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the brown 2x2 circular tile. This sticker has a picture of a pilot in a red shirt and brown pilot helmet. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

59. Put your window build away for now, we will now make another window. Locate 1 brown 2x2 plate with a raised side and 2 side studs and 1 light brown 1x1 brick with a hook. Place the 2x2 plate in front of you so the side studs are facing you. In the back left stud, place your 1x1 brick so the hook is facing left.

60. Locate 1 light brown 1x1 brick with a hook. Place this in the back right stud so the hook faces right.

61. Now locate 1 brown 1x2 plate. Horizontally place it on top of the 2 bricks with hooks.

62. Locate 2 white 1x1 bricks with 2 side studs. Place these on top of the 2x2 plate in the front left and front right so the side studs face left, front, and right.

63. Locate 1 tan 2x2 plate and 1 light green 1x3 tile with 2 studs. Place the 2x2 plate on top so it covers the 2x2 area. Then on the back 2 studs, horizontally place your green 1x3 tile so it is centered.
64. Locate 1 pink 2x4 window frame and 1 clear 2x4 glass pane. Insert the glass into the window frame then horizontally place the window frame in front of the light green 1x3 tile with 2 studs you previously placed. And make sure the glass is on the front side.
65. Locate 2 tan 1x2 plates with 2 side studs. Horizontally place 1 on top of the window frame so the side studs face you then horizontally place another on top so the side studs face back.
66. Locate 2 white 1x1 bricks with 2 side studs. Place 1 on the left top-facing stud so the side studs face left and front. Then symmetrically do the same for the right side.
67. Locate 2 tan 1x8 plates and 8 light green 1x2 slope tiles. Horizontally attach 4 of the 1x2 slope tiles to the 1x8 plate so it covers all the studs and the slopes are in the same direction. Then repeat to get 2 identical builds. Vertically place 1 on the left-facing side studs so the slopes go towards the back. Then symmetrically repeat for the right side.
68. Locate 1 tan 1x4 tile with a sidewall and 1 light green 1x4 tile with 2 studs. Below the window, there are 4 side studs. Horizontally place the green 1x4 tile on the bottom 2 studs so it is centered. Above this, horizontally place the tan 1x4 tile so it is centered and the sidewall sits on top.
69. Locate 1 light green 1x4 tile with 2 studs and 1 tan 1x2 plate with 1 bar on each side. On the front side, above the window, there are 4 side studs. On the upper 2 side studs, horizontally place your green 1x4 tile with 2 side studs so it is centered. On the lower 2 side studs, horizontally place the 1x2 plate with 2 bars so it is centered and the bars are going down.
70. Rotate your window build 180 degrees so now the back is facing the front. Locate 1 brown 2x3 tile.
- 70.1. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the brown 2x3 tile. This sticker is a wedding photo of the bride and groom. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!
- 70.2. Above the window there are 2 front-facing studs, horizontally place this 2x3 tile there so it is centered. Make sure the sticker is facing the right way!
71. Locate 1 tan 2x4 plate that has a trapezoidal shape and 4 studs. Horizontally place it on the 2 top-facing studs so it is centered. The angled side should be facing you.
72. Now bring back your previous window build and set it down to the left of your current build. Make sure the jar that says Paradise Falls is facing you. Now, using the left clip of your current build, attach it to the previous build. The clips are both located below the window sill. Now when you have done this, put your build aside while we make the last window.

Group 12 - First Floor

73. Locate 1 brown 2x2 plate with a raised side and 2 side studs and 1 dark tan 1x2 brick with a bar. Place the 2x2 plate down in front of you so the 2 side studs are facing you. Now horizontally place the 1x2 brick on the back 2 studs so the bar is facing right.

74. Locate 1 brown 1x2 plate. Horizontally place it on the 1x2 brick with a bar.
75. Now locate 2 white 1x1 bricks with 2 side studs. Place 1 in the front left stud so the side studs face left and front. Then symmetrically repeat for the right side.
76. Locate 1 tan 2x2 plate and 1 light green 1x2 tile with 1 stud. Place the 2x2 plate on top so it covers all the studs from the previous pieces. Now horizontally place the 1x2 tile on the back 2 studs.
77. Locate 1 pink 2x4 window frame and 1 clear 2x4 glass pane. Insert the glass into the window frame then horizontally place the window frame in front of the light green 1x2 tile you previously placed. And make sure the glass is on the front side.
78. Locate 1 tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs and 1 light green 1x2 plate with 4 side studs. Horizontally place the tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs on top of the window frame so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place the 1x2 plate with 4 side studs on the top so the side studs face back.
79. Locate 2 white 1x1 bricks with 2 side studs. Place 1 on the left top-facing stud so the studs face left and front. Then symmetrically repeat for the right top-facing stud.
80. Locate 1 tan 1x8 plate and 4 light green 1x2 slope tiles. Horizontally place the 1x2 slope tiles on the 1x8 plate to cover all the studs so that the slopes all face the same direction. Now vertically place it on the right-facing side studs so the slopes all face the back.

Group 13 - First Floor

81. Locate 1 tan 1x8 plate, 2 light green 1x4 plates, and 4 pink 1x2 slope tiles. Horizontally attach the 1x4 plates to the 1x8 plate so all the 1x8 studs are covered. Then use the 1x2 slope tiles to cover the studs of the 1x4 plates. Make sure the slopes are all going down in the same direction. Now vertically attach this to the left side of the build using the top and lower side studs. Make sure the slopes of the tiles are all going down towards the back.
82. Locate 1 tan 1x4 tile with a sidewall and 1 light green 1x4 tile with 2 studs. Below the window, there are 4 side studs. Horizontally place the green 1x4 tile on the bottom 2 studs so it is centered. Above this, horizontally place the tan 1x4 tile so it is centered and the sidewall sits on top.
83. Locate 1 light green 1x4 tile with 2 studs and 1 tan 1x2 plate with 1 bar on each side. On the front side, above the window, there are 4 side studs. On the upper 2 side studs, horizontally place your green 1x4 tile with 2 side studs so it is centered. On the lower 2 side studs, horizontally place the 1x2 plate with 2 bars so it is centered and the bars are going down.
84. Locate 1 tan 1x4 tile. Horizontally place it on the top-facing studs so it is centered.
85. Rotate the window build 180 degrees so the back is now facing the front. Locate 1 brown 2x2 circular tile and 1 white 1x2 tile that has a picture of mail. Attach the 2x2 circular tile to the 4 front-facing studs above the window. Then horizontally place the mail in front of the window on top of the 1x2 tile with 1 stud.

86. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the brown 2x2 circular tile that is above the window. This sticker is a picture of a grandma standing in a yellow background. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

87. Now bring back your previous window build and set it to the left of your current one. Make sure the Paradise Falls jar is on the side facing you. Use the clip that is on the right, below the window sill, and attach the current window. After you are done, the windows should be a half-circle shape.

88. Bring back your main build and orient it so the curved floor side is on the front right. Now with the window side facing you, attach it above the curved floor side so it sits against the side walls. Put aside your main build while we build the floor for the second floor.

Group 14 - Second Floor

89. Locate 1 dark tan 6x12 plate and 1 yellow 1x2 slope tile. Place the 6x12 plate horizontally in front of you. Then vertically place the slope tile in the back right so the slope goes down towards the right.

90. Locate 2 more yellow 1x2 slope tiles. Vertically place them on the right column so the slope tiles face the right. The entire right column should be covered in slope tiles now.

91. Locate 1 brown 2x2 corner brick. Place it in the front right corner so the missing corner of the corner brick is in the back left.

92. Locate 1 tan 2x4 tile with 2 studs and 2 tan 1x1 circular tiles. Horizontally place the 2x4 tile to the left of the brown 2x2 corner brick. Then behind the back left and back right corner of the 2x4 tile, place 2 tan 1x1 circular tiles.

93. Now locate 1 brown 2x2 corner brick and 1 yellow 1x2 slope tile. Place the corner brick to the left of the 2x4 tile so the missing corner is in the back right. Then to the left of this brick, vertically place your slope tile so the slope is going down towards the left.

94. Bring back your main build so the front side is facing you. Now to the right of the 6x6 plate, horizontally place this so it is in line with it. Make sure the 3 slope tiles are still in the far right column and there is no overhang. Put your build aside for now.

95.1. Locate 1 orange 2x8 plate and 1 yellow 2x2 slope brick. Horizontally place down your 2x8 plate. Now place the 2x2 slope brick in the middle of the plate so the slope is facing you.

95.2. Locate 2 more yellow 2x2 slope bricks. Place to the left and right of the previously placed slope brick so they all go in the same direction.

95.3. Locate 2 yellow 2x2 corner slope bricks. Place on the left and right side of the 2x8 plate so the slopes are in line with the previously placed slopes and so they overhang.

95.4. Locate 2 yellow 1x2 plates with a smooth and curved underside. Horizontally place them underneath the build in the front left and front right. Make sure the slope on the left is going up towards the left, and the one on the right is going up towards the right.

95.5. Now bring back your main build so the windows are facing you. Above the windows, there is a 2x2 studded area. Horizontally place this on the 2x2 area so it is centered and the slopes are going down towards you.

96. Now locate 2 tan 1x2 plates with a groove and 2 yellow 2x2 corner tiles. Horizontally place both of the 1x2 plates with grooves on top of the build you just placed so it sits in the center and so the grooves are facing you. Now to the left, place your corner tile so the missing corner is in the back left. Now to the right, place your other corner tile so the missing corner is in the back right.

97. Locate 1 pink 2x4 window frame and 1 clear 2x4 glass pane. Insert the glass into the window frame. Now horizontally place on the middle of the 2 tan 1x2 plates with grooves so the window is facing you.

98. Now locate 4 tall yellow 1x1 bricks with 2 side studs. Place 1 on top of another so 2 are stacked. Repeat to create another stack. Make sure the side studs are in the same direction. Place 1 of the stacked bricks to the left of the window so the side studs face left. Then use the other stack of bricks and place it to the right of the window so the side studs face right.

99. Locate 1 tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs and 1 tan 1x2 plate with bars. Horizontally place the 1x2 plate with 2 side studs on top of the window frame so they face you. Then horizontally place the 1x2 plate with bars on the 2 side studs of the previously placed piece so the bars are facing down.

100. Locate 1 yellow 1x4 plate. Horizontally place on top of the 4 top-facing studs above the window frame.

101. Locate 2 yellow 1x4 plates and 2 yellow 1x4 slope bricks. Attach each slope brick to each plate so there is no overhang. Now vertically attach 1 slope brick to the left-facing side studs of the bricks to the left of the window. Then repeat for the right-facing side studs. Make sure the slopes are pointing upwards.

102. Locate 2 tall yellow 1x2 slope bricks. Horizontally place on the top-facing studs so that together they make a point.

103. Locate 1 yellow 1x2 tile with 1 stud and 1 long white bar that has a circular bottom. Horizontally place the 1x2 tile on the top of the 2 slope bricks you just placed. Then using the circular bottom part of the bar, attach it to the singular stud of the tile.

104. Locate 1 teal 2x2 circular plate and 1 light grey 2x2 steering wheel that has a circular bottom. Attach the steering wheel to the middle of the circular plate. Then attach the middle of the 2x2 circular plate to the left stud under the middle window.

105. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the inside of the house is facing you. Put this aside for now while we make an armchair.

105.1. Locate 2 dark red 1x2 plates with 4 side studs. Vertically push them together so that the 4 side studs are facing left and the other 4 are facing right.

105.2. Locate 1 dark red 2x2 chair. Place it in between the 2 plates so that the back of the chair is in the back.

105.3. Now locate 2 dark red 2x2 tiles. Put 1 on each of the sets of 4 side studs.

105.4. Now while keeping the chair in the same orientation, attach it to the front 2 studs of the 2x2 studded area located in front of the middle window.

Building Instructions (Bag 3):

Group 15 - Dug + Second Floor

106.1. Locate the dog Dug! Put him aside for now with your other minifigures!

106.2. Locate 1 brown 1x4 brick. Vertically place it in the second column so it sits to the right of the slope tiles.

107. Locate 8 tan 1x1 circular bars with a stud on top. In the back right corner, place 1 of your bars. Then continue placing bars, from right to left until you run out. The last one should be to the right of a slope tile.

108. Locate 2 dark grey 1x3 tiles. Horizontally place them 1 in the back right corner on top of the bars. Then place 1 on the left 3 bars so that there are 2 open bars in between these tiles.

Group 16 - Second Floor

109.1. Locate 2 light blue 1x4 bricks. Horizontally place them side by side in front of the 8 bars.

Group 17 - Second Floor

109.2. Locate 1 light yellow 1x4 brick. Vertically place it on the right side in front of the light blue brick.

Group 18 - Second floor

110. Locate 3 tan 1x2 bricks that have 2 circular carved-out sides and a pointy piece in the middle. These pieces attach to another piece and lets them rotate. On top of the brown bricks on the left, vertically place 2 so that there is a 1x2 gap in between them. Make sure the wall side is facing right. Now to the left of the blue bricks placed in the previous step, there is a slope tile, then to the left of this there is a 1x2 brick. Vertically place the remaining brick on top of this brick so the wall side is facing left.

111.1. Locate 1 light blue 1x4 brick and 2 light blue 1x2 bricks. On top of the light blue bricks that are in front of the 8 bars, from left to right, horizontally place a 1x2 brick, then a 1x4 brick, then another 1x2 brick.

Group 19 - Second Floor

111.2. Locate 1 light yellow 1x4 brick. Vertically place in the last column on top of the previous 1x4 brick.

Group 20 - Second Floor

112. Locate 1 brown 3x4 crate and 1 black 2x2 circular tile with a stud. Horizontally place the crate in front of the window on the second floor so it sits against it. Then in front of the crate, skip a row, then place the 2x2 circular tile so that it sits in the first 2 columns of the crate. There should be 1 stud column in between the circular tile and the bricks on the left.

113. Locate 1 brown 2x3 back book cover that has 2 studs on it, 1 brown 2x3 front book cover that is smooth on both sides and 1 white 1x2 tile that says once upon a time. Connect the circular part of the book to the spine of the book cover. It should open from right to left. Now vertically place the 1x2 tile on the 2 studs in the book. Ask a helper to make sure the words on the tile are oriented correctly!

113.1. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the front cover of the book. This sticker has a picture of the words "my adventure book" in different colors. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

113.2. Now place the book into the crate you previously placed.

114. Put your build aside for now while we make a television. Locate 1 grey 1x1 brick with 4 side studs and 1 black 1x1 brick with 1 side stud and an extended part on the bottom. Now using the back of the 1x1 black brick, place it on the top-facing stud so the studs face front and up. Make sure the extended part is behind the stud facing back.

115. Locate 4 black 1x2 plates and 2 brown gold bar-shaped tiles. Place 1 plate onto another plate so there is no overhang, then attach the gold bar tile to the top of that so there is no overhang. Repeat so you have 2 of these. Now attach 1 to the left-facing side studs. Then attach the other for the right-facing side studs.

116. Locate 1 light grey round ball-shaped 1x1 tile with a black antenna attached. Attach it to the top-facing stud and turn the antenna so it is slightly angled to the right.

117.1. Locate 1 brown 2x3 tile.

117.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the brown 2x3 tile. This sticker has a picture of a television screen showing a camera in front of Earth and some clouds. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

117.3. Now attach it to the front-facing side studs of the build so it is centered.

118. Bring back your main build so the inside is facing you. Place this build with the television screen side facing you on top of the stud of the 2x2 circular tile that is in front of the crate.

Group 21 - Second Floor and Bed

119. Locate 2 black 1x1 circular bars with a stud on top. Locate the light blue bricks that are in front of the 8 bars. In front of the left stud of the 1x8 set of studs, place 1 bar. Then in front of this, skip 2 rows, then place 1 more bar.

120. Put your build aside while we make the bed. Locate 1 black 2x4 brick and 1 white 1x2 curved brick. This curved brick has no studs. Set down the black 2x4 brick horizontally in front of you. Then vertically place the curved brick on the left so it goes down towards the right.

121.1. Locate 2 purple 1x2 curved plates. This plate is a 1x1 plate connected to a curved brick. Place 1 in the front left so the curve overhangs and faces you. Place the other to the right of this and in the back so the curve is overhanging in the back.

Group 22 - Bed

121.2. Locate 2 light blue 1x2 curved plates. This plate is a 1x1 plate connected to a curved brick. Place 1 in the back left so the curve is overhanging. Then place 1 in the front to the right of the purple curved plate so the curve is overhanging.

122.1. Locate 1 purple 2x2 corner plate. This is a 1x1 plate connected to a corner curved brick. Place the 1x1 plate part of this in the front right so the curved part is overhanging.

Group 23 - Bed

122.2. Locate 1 teal 2x2 corner plate. This is a 1x1 plate connected to a corner curved brick. Place the 1x1 plate part of this in the back right so the curved part is overhanging.

123.1. Locate 2 light blue 1x1 tiles. There is a 2x3 stud area on the top. Place 1 in the back left stud. Then place the other in the front right stud.

Group 24 - Bed

123.2. Locate 2 light purple 1x1 tiles. Place 1 in the front left stud. Then place the other in the back middle stud.

Group 25 - Bed

123.3. Locate 2 pink 1x1 tiles. Place 1 in the front middle stud. Then place the other in the back right stud.

124. Bring your build back so the inside is facing you. Keeping this bed in the same orientation, place the white 1x2 curved brick with no studs part in between the 2 bars that were previously placed.

Group 26 - Roof

125. Put your build aside while we build the roof. Locate 1 dark grey 4x8 plate and 1 light blue 1x2 plate. Vertically place the 4x8 plate in front of you so it is upside down. Then attach the 1x2 plate in the back middle.

126. Locate 1 light blue 1x2 plate that has a curved underside. Horizontally place it upside down in the back right corner so the slope is going down towards the right. There should be no overhang.

127. Locate 1 light blue 1x8 plate. Horizontally place it upside down on the back left corner of the 4x8 plate so it overhangs by 7 studs.

128. Locate 2 dark grey 4x8 plates. Vertically place them upside down underneath the overhang so they line up with the 4x8 plate on the right.

129. Locate 1 light blue 1x8 plate and 1 light blue 1x2 plate that has a curved underside. Horizontally attach the 1x2 plate with a curved underside, upside down in the back left corner so the curve goes down to the left with no overhang. Then in between the 2 curved underside plates, horizontally attach the 1x8 plate so there isn't a gap between them anymore.

130. Locate 3 brown 2x6 plates. Make sure they are upside down. Horizontally attach 1 on the front two rows so there is 1 free column to the right. Now directly above this plate, skip 2 rows, then horizontally attach another. Now to the left of both of these plates, vertically attach 1 plate so it creates a C shape and is even with the front.

131. Locate 2 black 2x2 plates that have a smooth underside and an extended cylinder part that connects to the 1x2 connector bricks. Place both upside down on the horizontally placed brown 2x6 plates so they both sit on the right, and the extended round part is on the right.

132. Flip over your build now and orient it so it is horizontal and the curved underside plates are in the back. Now locate 6 light blue quarter circle plates. Columns go from left to right and rows go from front to back.

Place 1 in the 2nd column, 5th row so the right angle corner faces right.
Place 1 in the 2nd column, 7th row so the right angle corner faces right.
Place 1 in the 3rd column, 6th row so the right angle corner faces left.
Place 1 in the 10th column, 2nd row so the right angle corner faces right.
Place 1 in the 10th column, 4th row so the right angle corner faces right.
Place 1 in the 11th column, 3rd row so the right angle corner faces left.

133. Now bring back your main build and orient it so the inside is facing right. Orient your roof build so it is standing upright and the 2x2 connector plates are facing away from you at the bottom, then use those to attach the roof to the 1x2 connector bricks that are behind the slopes in the front of the main build. They should snap on and the roof piece should slope up, in line with the second story wall with the window.

Group 27 - Roof

134. Put away your build for now while we continue building the roof. Locate 1 dark grey 4x8 plate and set it vertically upside down in front of you.

135. Locate 1 light blue 1x2 plate that has a curved underside and 1 light blue 1x8 plate. Horizontally place the 1x8 plate in the back row so it is upside down and overhangs 5 studs on the left. Then horizontally place the 1x2 plate upside down in the back right corner so the slope is going down towards the right with no overhang.

136. Locate 1 dark grey 6x6 plate. Place it upside down underneath the overhang so the overhang sits on the back row of the plate. The leftmost column of the 6x6 plate should be free.

137. Locate 1 light blue 1x2 plate. Horizontally place it upside down in the back left corner so it overhangs 1 stud on the left.

138. Locate 1 dark grey 2x2 plate. Place it upside down underneath the overhang, so the overhang is on the top right corner of the 2x2 plate.

139. Locate 1 light blue 1x8 plate and 1 light blue 1x2 plate that has a curved underside. Horizontally place the 1x2 curved underside plate upside down in the back left so the curve goes down towards the left with no overhang. Then to the right of this, horizontally place your 1x8 plate upside down so it fills the gap between the curves.

140. Locate 3 white 1x2 plates with a groove. Vertically place 1 upside down in the front right corner so the groove faces right. Then behind this plate, vertically place the other 2, 1 behind the other, so the grooves face the same way.

141. Locate 1 brown 2x10 plate and 1 black 2x2 plate that has a smooth underside and an extended cylinder part. Horizontally place the 2x10 plate upside down to the left of the back white 1x2 plate with a groove. It should overhang by 1 column on the left. In the left 2 columns of this plate, place your 2x2 plate upside down so the cylinder part is on the left.

142. Locate 1 dark grey 3x3 triangular plate and 1 dark grey 2x2 triangular tile. Orient your 3x3 triangle plate so the right angle of the 2 long sides is pointing back. Next, orient your 2x2 triangle tile so the right angle is pointing back, then insert it in the front middle stud of the 3x3 plate. Now take your 3x3 plate and orient it upside down with the right angle corner in the back right. Place it on the frontmost row of the 6x6 plate and the leftmost column of the 4x8 plate, so the 2x2 tile sits in the corner gap made by those two pieces.

143. Now turn your build right side up so it is horizontal and so the grooves of the 1x2 plates are facing left. Locate 1 dark grey 2x2 triangular tile. Place it on the right side, in front of the 2x2 plate so the right corner of this tile is in the back left corner.

144. Locate 3 light blue 1x1 quarter circle tiles. Columns go from left to right and rows go from front to back.

Place 1 in the 2nd column, 6th row so the right corner faces right.

Place 1 in the 3rd column, 5th row so the right corner faces left.

Place 1 in the 3rd column, 7th row so the right corner faces left.

145. Bring back your main build and orient it so the inside is facing left. Now orient your roof build standing upright so the black 2x2 connector plate is facing away from you at the bottom. Then insert the connector part to the 1x2 connector brick on the build located directly to the left of the right window wall. This should sit diagonal resting on this wall. Together with the other roof, it should make an upside-down V shape.

Group 28 - Roof

146. Orient your build so the inside is facing you. Locate 1 tall light yellow 1x2 slope brick. Vertically place it in the last column so that there are 2 free studs in front of it. Make sure the slope is going towards the back.

147.1. Locate 1 tan 1x2 plate, 1 tall light yellow 1x2 brick with 4 side studs, and 1 brown 2x2 circular tile. Attach the circular tile to the 4 side studs of the 1x2 brick. Then place the brick onto the 1x2 plate so there is no overhang.

147.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the brown 2x2 circular tile. This sticker is of a girl at the beach with a blue, white, and tan background. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a helper to check!

147.3. Now vertically place your build in the 2 studs in front of the slope brick you previously placed. Make sure the picture is facing the left.

148. Locate 1 tall light yellow 1x2 slope brick and 1 light yellow 1x1 brick. Vertically place the slope brick in the last column on top of the previously placed pieces so that there is a free stud in front, and make sure the slope is going back. Then place your 1x1 brick in front of this brick.

149. Locate 1 very tall brown 1x2 brick. Horizontally place it in the front to the direct left of the black 1x1 circular bar that is to the left of the bed.

150.1. Set aside your main build. Locate 2 dark tan 1x10 plates, 1 tan 1x4 plate, 1 tan 1x2 plate, and 2 light grey 1x2 plates with clips. Set down 1 dark tan 1x10 plate horizontally. Horizontally place the tan 1x2 plate on the right 2 studs. To the left, horizontally attach both 1x2 plates with clips next to each other so they are facing back. Then to the left, horizontally attach the 1x4 plate. On top of all these plates, horizontally attach your last 1x10 plate so all studs are covered.

150.2. Bring back your main build and orient it so the inside is facing you. Now horizontally attach your sub-build in the front left so it sits on top of the very tall brown 1x2 brick and the last column. Make sure the clips of the sub-build are facing back.

151. Locate 1 brown 1x2 plate with a side hole instead of a stud, 1 light yellow 1x2 plate with a slope tile instead of a stud, and 1 black 1x2 pin. On top of the sub-build you just placed, horizontally attach the plate with a hole so the hole is on the left. Next, insert the pin into the hole from the front. Then vertically attach the 1x2 plate with a slope tile in the front right so the slope is facing back.

Group 29 - Chimney

152. Put your build aside while we build the chimney. Locate 2 dark red 1x2 plates with 2 side studs above it. Horizontally place 1 down so the studs face back. Then horizontally place the other in front of this so the studs face front. They should be 1 in front of the other and not connected. Now push them together so they are touching.

153. Locate 1 black 1x2 brick with a plus-shaped hole. Vertically place it in the right 2 studs in between the 2 plates.

154. Locate 1 brown 2x3 brick. Horizontally place it to the left of the brick you just placed so it overhangs 2 columns on the left.

155. Locate 2 black 1x2 plates with 2 side studs below it. Horizontally place 1 in the front right so the side studs are facing front. Then behind this, horizontally place the other one so the side studs face back.

156. Locate 2 dark red 2x2 tiles. Place 1 in the front 4 side studs then place 1 in the back 4 side studs.

157. Locate 1 dark red 1x2 plate and 1 dark red 2x2 tile. Horizontally place the 1x2 plate in the back left corner. Then to the right of this, place your 2x2 tile so there is no overhang.

158. Locate 1 dark red 1x2 plate. Underneath this build in the back left corner, horizontally place the other 1x2 plate.

159. Locate 1 dark red 1x8 plate. Horizontally place it underneath the front left part of the build so that this plate overhangs 6 studs on the left.

160. Locate 1 brown 1x2 brick with 2 holes and 1 dark red 1x1 brick. Horizontally place the 1x2 brick on the right side of the overhang. Then to the left of this brick, place the 1x1 brick.

161. Locate 1 dark red 1x6 brick. Horizontally place it to the left of the 1x1 brick so it overhangs 3 studs to the left.

162. Locate 1 dark red 1x12 plate. Horizontally place it underneath the 3-stud overhang of the 1x6 brick.

163. Locate 1 dark red 1x6 brick, 1 brown 1x2 brick with 2 holes, and 1 dark red 1x1 brick. To the left of the 1x6 brick, horizontally place your 1x6 brick. To the left of this, horizontally place your 1x2 brick with holes. Then to the left, place your 1x1 brick.

164. Locate 2 dark red 1x8 tiles and 1 dark red 1x4 tile. Horizontally place 1 dark red 1x4 tile on the left side. Then to the right, horizontally place both 1x8 tiles next to each other.

165. Now flip your build upside down so it is horizontal and the thicker side is on the left. Locate 1 dark red 2x2 plate. Attach this upside down to the left 2 columns so there is no overhang.

166. Bring back your main build so the inside is facing you. On the front side of your build, you will find 2 pins in the middle, 1 low and 1 high. Orient your chimney build so it is vertical. Make sure the larger part is on the top and the smooth tile side is facing left. Now insert your chimney into the holes of the main build.

Group 30 - Roof

167. Put away your main build while we build more of the roof. Locate 1 dark grey 4x8 plate and 1 dark grey 1x10 plate. Vertically set down your 4x8 plate. Now horizontally attach your 1x10 plate to the top of the 4x8 plate in the back so it overhangs 6 studs to the right.

168. Locate 1 dark grey 2x3 plate. Vertically attach it underneath the overhang on the left side so there are 4 studs of the 2x3 plate exposed in the front.

169. Locate 1 dark grey 2x8 plate. Vertically attach it to the right of the 2x3 plate underneath the overhang so the studs are exposed in the front. There should be no overhang in the back.

170. Locate 1 dark grey 3x8 triangular plate and 1 dark grey 2x2 angle plate. Vertically attach the 3x8 triangular plate to the right of the 2x8 plate underneath the overhang so the angled side is in the front right. Make sure the front is lined up with the front of the 2x8 plate. Now to the right of the 1x10 plate, there are 2 studs from the triangular plate. Attach the 2x2 angle plate to this so the 2 studs of the angle plate are on the left and the angle is on the right.

171. Locate 6 light blue 1x1 quarter circle tiles. Columns go from left to right and rows go from front to back. There is a gap in the build, but they still count as rows/columns.

Place 1 in the 2nd column, 6th row so the right corner points back.
Place 1 in the 4th column, 6th row so the right corner points back.
Place 1 in the 3rd column, 7th row so the right corner points front.
Place 1 in the 8th column, 4th row so the right corner points back.
Place 1 in the 10th column, 4th row so the right corner points back.
Place 1 in the 9th column, 5th row so the right corner points 'front.

172. Turn your build upside down so it is vertical and the angled plate is in front. Locate 1 light blue 1x4 plate and light blue 1x2 plate. Horizontally place them upside down in the back so that together they sit in the middle of the back row. Make sure the 1x2 plate is to the left of the 1x4 plate.

173. Locate 1 light blue 1x4 plate and 2 light blue 1x2 plates with a curved underside. In the back row horizontally place 1 of the curved plates upside down on each side so there is no overhang. Now there should be a 1x4 gap in between them. Horizontally place your 1x4 plate upside down in this gap.

174. Locate 1 brown 1x6 plate and 1 brown 2x6 plate. Vertically place the 1x6 plate upside down in the left column so it sits in front of the curve. Then in front of this, horizontally place the 2x6 plate upside down so the left column of this plate is in line with the previously placed piece.

175. Locate 2 light grey 2x3 plates with a bar underneath and 1 dark grey 1x2 plate with a groove. Vertically put the 2x3 plates next to each other, 1 to the right of the other, then horizontally attach the 1x2 plate in the front middle so the groove is facing you. Now flip them upside down then vertically place it in the front left corner made by the two brown plates you placed in the last step so the groove plate fits in the gap on the right.

176. Bring back your main build now so the front of the house is facing you. Now on the left side of the building, above the bed, there are 4 hooks which we will use to attach the roof. Horizontally insert the roof using the bars to attach to the hooks so that the gap of the roof is down and towards you.

Building Instructions (Bag 4):

Group 31 - Roof

177. Put aside your build for now while we build the window to put into the gap of the roof. Locate 1 yellow 2x2 plate and 1 dark grey 1x2 plate. Horizontally attach the 1x2 plate on the back 2 studs of the 2x2 plate.

178. Locate 1 tan 1x2 plate with a groove. Horizontally attach it on the front 2 studs of the 2x2 plate.

179. Locate 1 yellow 1x2 window frame. Horizontally place it on the back 2 studs.

180. Locate 1 yellow 1x2 window frame and 1 clear 2x2 glass pane. Put the glass into the window then horizontally attach the frame onto the front 2 studs so the window is in the front.

Group 32 - Roof

181. Locate 2 dark grey 1x2 plates with grooves. Vertically place 1 on the left 2 studs of the window frames so the groove faces left. Then vertically place the other one on the right 2 studs so the groove faces right.

182. Locate 1 dark grey 1x2 triangular slope tile and 1 dark grey 2x2 angled slope tile. Horizontally place the 1x2 slope on the front 2 studs. Then horizontally place the 2x2 angled slope on the back 2 studs so the angled part faces back.

183. Locate 1 dark grey 1x2 plate. Horizontally attach it underneath the build in the front 2 studs.

184. Now bring back your main build so the front of the building is facing you. On the left roof piece, there is a gap in it. Place your window build on it so the front 1x2 plate on the bottom sits on the circular bars with a stud on top. Make sure the angled slope part at the top of the window is facing into the roof.

185. Locate 1 dark grey cylinder piece with 4 bars sticking out of it. There is a white 1x1 long bar sticking out of the roof on the right part of the house. Attach this cylinder piece into the bar.

186. Locate 1 dark grey 1x1 circular stud and 1 teal chicken. Attach the chicken to the stud then push the plate into the white bar on the top of the roof. Push it all the way down and move the cylinder piece with 4 bars up so there is no gap between this and the 1x1 cylinder plate.

Group 33 - Balloons

187. Put your build away for now while we build the balloons. Locate 1 white octagonal shaped 2x2 plate with 8 bars around it and 1 light blue 2x2 circular tile with 1 stud. Attach the circular tile to the 4 studs of the 2x2 plate.

188. Now locate 1 red 1x6 axle. Attach it to the middle of the bottom of the octagonal shaped plate.

189. Now locate 1 light green 2x2 circular brick. Insert it through the rod so the studs of the brick attach to the bottom of the octagonal shaped plate.

190. Locate 1 white octagonal shaped 2x2 plate with 8 bars. Insert it through the rod and attach the studs to the brick above it.

Group 34 - Balloons

191.1. Locate 1 red 2x2 circular brick. Insert it through rod and attach the studs to the plate above.

Group 35 - Balloons

191.2. Locate 1 yellow 2x2 circular brick. Insert it through rod and attach the studs to the brick above.

192. Now locate 1 more white octagonal shaped 2x2 plate. Insert it through the rod and attach the studs.

193. Locate 1 white 1x2 axle connector and 1 red 1x2 axle. Connect the axle connector to the bottom of the 1x6 axle. Then insert the 1x2 axle to the bottom of the connector.

194. Now bring back your build and orient it so the front of the house is facing you. Now insert your build you just made into the top of the chimney. This will hold the balloons that come next!

Group 36 - Balloons

195. Locate 1 clear pole that has a stud connector at the bottom, 1 light green 2x2 cone shaped brick with 1 stud on top and 1 light green 2x2 bowl shaped brick that has no studs. Connect the cone shaped brick to the bowl shaped brick to make a balloon. Now insert the bottom of the bowl part to the clear pole. Now connect the pole to the light blue 2x2 circular tile that is at the top of the build you previously made.

Since there are a lot of different color balloons, I have split the balloon colors and pieces into their own groups to make this easier! Here are the groups :

Group 37 - White hook that connects to bar

Group 38 - White bar

Group 39 - Shorter grey bar

Group 40 - Light blue

Group 41 - Purple

Group 42 - Light green

Group 43 - Yellow

Group 44 - Red

196.1. Locate 1 purple 2x2 inverted cone shaped brick with 4 studs and 1 purple 2x2 cone shaped brick with 1 stud from group 41. Connect the cone brick to the 4 studs. Now locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook from group 37 that connects to a bar. Insert the bar into the bottom of the inverted cone then insert the hole of the hook piece to the bottom of the bar.

196.2. Make sure the build is oriented so the front of the house is facing you. There are 8 bars of each of the octagonal shaped plate that are above the chimney. Attach the hook of this balloon to the front right bar of the top octagonal shaped plate.

196.3. Locate 1 light blue bowl shaped brick and 1 light blue cone shaped brick from group 40. Connect the two to make a balloon. Then locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook piece. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick, then insert the hole of the hook to the bar. Attach the hook of this balloon into the back left bar of the top octagonal shaped plate.

197.1. Locate 1 yellow 2x2 inverted cone with 4 studs and 1 yellow 2x2 cone shaped brick with a stud. Attach the cone to the 4 studs of the inverted cone. Now locate 1 white bar and 1 hook piece from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the inverted cone then connect the hole of the hook to the bar. Now attach the hook to the front left bar of the top octagonal shaped plate.

197.2. Locate 1 red 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 red 2x2 cone brick from group 44. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the back right bar of the top octagonal shaped plate.

198. Now flip all the balloons upward so they surround the middle balloon.

199. Locate 2 light green 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 2 light green 2x2 cone brick from group 42. Connect them to make 2 balloons then locate 2 shorter grey bars from group 39 and 2 white hooks from group 37. Insert the bars into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the holes of the hooks into the bars. Connect the hooks in the front and back bar of the top octagonal shaped brick.

200.1. Locate 1 red 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 red 2x2 cone brick from group 44. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 shorter grey bar from group 39 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the left bar of the top octagonal shaped plate.

200.2. Locate 1 light blue 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 light blue 2x2 cone brick from group 40. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 shorter grey bar from group 39 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the right bar of the top octagonal shaped plate.

201. Now flip these balloons upward all the way.

202.1. Locate 1 yellow 2x2 inverted cone with 4 studs and 1 yellow 2x2 cone shaped brick with a stud from group 43.. Attach the cone to the 4 studs of the inverted cone. Now locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook piece from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the inverted cone then connect the hole of the hook to the bar. Now attach the hook to the back left bar of the middle octagonal shaped plate.

202.2. Locate 1 red 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 red 2x2 cone brick from group 44. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the front right bar of the middle octagonal shaped plate.

203.1. Locate 1 purple 2x2 inverted cone with 4 studs and 1 purple 2x2 cone shaped brick with a stud from group 41. Attach the cone to the 4 studs of the inverted cone. Now locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook piece from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the inverted cone then connect the hole of the hook to the bar. Now attach the hook to the front left bar of the middle octagonal shaped plate.

203.2. Locate 1 light blue 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 light blue 2x2 cone brick from group 40. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the back right bar of the middle octagonal shaped plate.

204. Now flip up all the balloons that are on the middle octagonal shaped plate.

205. Locate 2 light green 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 2 light green 2x2 cone brick from group 42. Connect them to make 2 balloons then locate 2 shorter grey bars from group 39 and 2 white hooks from group 37. Insert the bars into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the holes of the hooks into the bars. Connect the hooks in the left and right bar of the middle octagonal shaped plate.

206.1. Locate 1 red 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 red 2x2 cone brick from group 44. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 shorter grey bar from group 39 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the back bar of the middle octagonal shaped plate.

206.2. Locate 1 light blue 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 light blue 2x2 cone brick from group 40. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 shorter grey bar from group 39 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the front bar of the middle octagonal shaped plate.

207. Now flip all the balloons upwards.

208.1. Locate 1 purple 2x2 inverted cone with 4 studs and 1 purple 2x2 cone shaped brick with a stud from 41. Attach the cone to the 4 studs of the inverted cone. Now locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook piece from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the inverted cone then connect the hole of the hook to the bar. Now attach the hook to the back left bar of the bottom octagonal shaped plate.

208.2. Locate 1 light blue 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 light blue 2x2 cone brick from group 40. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the front right bar of the bottom octagonal shaped plate.

209.1. Locate 1 yellow 2x2 inverted cone with 4 studs and 1 yellow 2x2 cone shaped brick with a stud from group 43. Attach the cone to the 4 studs of the inverted cone. Now locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook piece from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the inverted cone then connect the hole of the hook to the bar. Now attach the hook to the back right bar of the bottom octagonal shaped plate.

209.2. Locate 1 red 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 red 2x2 cone brick from group 44. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 white bar from group 38 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the front left bar of the bottom octagonal shaped plate.

210. Now flip all the balloons upward.

211. Locate 2 light green 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 2 light green 2x2 cone brick from group 42. Connect them to make 2 balloons then locate 2 shorter grey bars from group 39 and 2 white hooks from group 37. Insert the bars into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the holes of the hooks into the bars. Connect the hooks in the front and back bar of the bottom octagonal shaped plate.

212.1. Locate 1 red 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 red 2x2 cone brick from group 44. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 shorter grey bar from 39 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the right bar of the bottom octagonal shaped plate.

212.2. Locate 1 light blue 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 light blue 2x2 cone brick from group 40. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 shorter grey bar from group 39 and 1 hook from group 37. Insert the bar into the bottom of the bowl shaped brick then insert the hole of the hook into the bar. Now connect the hook to the left bar of the bottom octagonal shaped plate.

213. Now flip all the balloons upward. You finished the balloons, now put aside your build while we build the yard part.

Group 45 - Front Yard

1. Locate 1 green curved 6x6 plate and 1 white 1x1 clip brick. Place the plate down in front of you so the curved part is in the front left corner. Now place your clip brick in the back right corner of the plate so the hook faces back.
2. Locate 1 white 1x1 clip brick. Place it on top of the previously placed clip brick so the clip faces to the right.
3. Now locate 2 white 1x4 fences. Horizontally place 1 to the left of the clip bricks then vertically place 1 in front of the hook bricks.
4. Locate 2 more white 1x1 clip bricks. Place 1 in the back left corner so the clip faces left. Then place 1 above this so the clip faces back.
5. Locate 2 white 1x1 pyramid shaped tiles and 1 tan circular bar with a stud on top. Place the circular bar in the front right of the plate, then above the 2 hook bricks, place your pyramid shaped tiles.
6. Locate 2 teal 2x2 cylinder bricks. Place 1 on top of the other then place it in the back right corner in front and to the left of the fences.
7. Locate 1 tan 2x2 brick and 4 tan 1x1 slope tiles. Place your 2x2 brick down. Place 1 slope in the front left of the brick so the slope goes down towards you. Then place 1 in the front right so it goes down to the right. Then place 1 in the back right so it goes down towards the back. Then place 1 in the back left so it goes down to the left. This is a cardboard box you just made! Place this in front of the teal cylinder bricks you previously placed.
8. Locate 1 white 1x2 plate and 2 white 1x1 half circle shaped tiles. Place your white 1x2 plate horizontally on top of the circular bar in the front right so it sits in the middle. Then place your half circle shaped tiles on top of it so the flat sides are on the left and right. This is a mailbox that you just made!
9. Locate 1 light green 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 light green 2x2 cone brick. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 long white staff that has a long side and short side. Insert the bottom of the balloon to the short end of the staff. Then connect the bar to the back right hook brick that has the hook facing back.

Group 46 - Front Yard

10. Locate 1 light blue 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 light blue 2x2 cone brick. Connect the two to make a balloon then locate 1 white bar and insert it into the bottom of the balloon. Then connect the bar to the back right hook brick that has the hook facing right.

Group 47 - Front Yard

11. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 cone brick, 1 light grey 1x1 circular plate with a bar attached, and 1 light grey 2x2 steering wheel. Attach the steering wheel to the stud of the plate with a bar. Then attach this to top of the cone brick so the bar faces left. Now place the cone brick on top of the 2 teal 2x2 circular bricks so the bar faces left. This is the helium they use to make the balloons stay in the air!

Group 48 - Front Yard

12. Locate 1 red 2x2 bowl shaped brick and 1 red 2x2 cone brick. Connect the two to make a balloon. Then insert the bottom of the balloon into the bar that is under the wheel.

Group 49 - Front Yard

13. Locate 1 purple 2x2 inverted cone with 4 studs and 1 purple 2x2 cone shaped brick with a stud. Attach the cone to the 4 studs of the inverted cone then locate 1 white bar. Insert the bar into the bottom of the inverted cone brick. Now attach the bar to the hook in the back left that is facing back.

Group 50 - Front Yard

14. Locate 1 yellow 2x2 inverted cone with 4 studs and 1 yellow 2x2 cone shaped brick with a stud. Attach the cone to the 4 studs of the inverted cone then locate 1 white staff that has a short side and a long side. Insert the short side into the bottom of the inverted cone brick. Now attach the bottom of the staff to the hook in the back left that is facing left.

15. Locate 1 brown squirrel. Place it in the stud that is in the 3rd row from the front and 2nd column from the left so it is facing left.
