21261 The Wolf Stronghold

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Kids build the Wolf Tamer a base featuring a big wolf's head above the entrance, then have fun switching the wolf's face from friendly to angry. Inside is a crafting table, blast furnace, anvil, and, for the first time in a LEGO Minecraft set, a smithing table. A chest of supplies contains a Netherite ingot, which kids can craft into a sword, sweet berries, and bones that are used to tame the wild wolf. Outside is a forest section with a tree, boulder, mushroom, and sweet berry bush. 2 Minecraft skeleton toys wander the forest: one has an enchanted bow, and the other has a bow and arrow and diamond helmet.

Creative castle playset – The toy includes a crafting table, blast furnace, anvil, and a smithing table, plus a LEGO® Minecraft® Wolf Tamer figure, 2 skeletons, and 2 wolves.

Building toy and action playset – Kids tame a wild wolf, battle skeletons, and make use of a variety of crafting equipment in this forest explorer-hero toy.

Minecraft® wolf toy – The entrance to the Wolf Tamer's base features a large, buildable wolf's head with a face that kids can quickly switch from friendly to angry.

312-piece forest fortress – The Wolf Stronghold part of the assembled building toy measures over 4.5 in. (11 cm) high, 6 in. (16 cm) wide and 5 in. (12 cm) deep.

The front of the box shows the wolf stronghold in the background. It is a stone building with a huge face of a wolf. In the front, the wolf tamer is fighting off two skeletons that have bows and arrows! Luckily, he has his two wolves to help fight them off!

The back of the box shows the wolf tamer building new gear with ingots on the roof. Below the roof, the two wolves are enjoying their bones. But they got to be careful because 1 skeleton has their bow drawn and is about to shoot them through the window! Another skeleton is hiding behind a tree waiting for them to come out!

The top of the box shows all the characters this set comes with. It comes with the wolf tamer, 2 skeletons, and 2 wolves!

The build is 312 pieces in total and is for ages 8+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the minifigure, wolves, utilities, and a tree.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the wolf stronghold.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the skeletons and the wolf stronghold.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we may be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: going from front to behind.

- Horizontally: going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up from left to right.
- Column: studs lined up from top to bottom or front to back

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/21261) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1, 2, and 3, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Wolf Tamer Minifigure

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 dark green pair of legs, 1 dark green torso printed with a sleeveless shirt, a brown belt, and a brown sling over his shoulder, 1 head printed with brown hair, green bangs, light green eyes, and a big smile on his face, 1 dark grey sword, 1 transparent round 1x1 plate with a bar underneath and 1 light grey 2x3 tile printed with a light grey wolf with a white beard on a blue background. Put the 1x1 plate underneath the top hole of the 2x3 tile. Ask a sighted person to make sure it is put on correctly! Assemble the wolf tamer then put the sword and shield into his hands!

Group 2 - Wolf 1

- 1. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 plate and 1 light grey 1x2 plate with a clip. Place the 2x2 plate on the table then vertically place the 1x2 plate on the left so the clip faces the left.
- 2. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 plate. Place it to the right of the 1x2 plate so it overhangs to the right.
- 3. Locate 1 green 1x2 plate. Vertically place it underneath the overhang.
- 4. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 plate. Place it on top of the left 2 columns.

- 5. Locate 1 light grey 1x2 plate with a bar. Horizontally attach the bar to the clip on the left side. This is the wolf's tail!
- 6. Locate 2 light grey 1x2 bricks with a groove. Vertically place them underneath the left side and right side of the set of 2x3 studs so the grooves face outwards. These are the wolf's legs!
- 7. Locate 1 light grey wolf head printed with a black and tan nose and white and black eyes attached to a 1x2 tile. Vertically place the tile on the right side so the face overhangs to the right. Put this aside while we make another wolf!

Group 3 - Wolf 2

- 1. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 plate and 1 light grey 1x2 plate with a clip. Place the 2x2 plate on the table then vertically place the 1x2 plate on the left so the clip faces the left.
- 2. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 plate. Place it to the right of the 1x2 plate so it overhangs to the right.
- 3. Locate 1 dark grey 1x2 plate. Vertically place it underneath the overhang.
- 4. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 plate. Place it on top of the left column.
- 5. Locate 1 light grey 1x2 plate with a bar. Horizontally attach the bar to the clip on the left side. This is the wolf's tail!
- 6. Locate 2 light grey 1x2 bricks with a groove. Vertically place them underneath the left column and right column of the set of 2x3 studs so the grooves face outwards. These are the wolf's legs!
- 7. Locate 1 light grey wolf head printed with a black and tan nose and white and black eyes attached to a 1x2 tile. Vertically place the tile on the right side so the face overhangs to the right.

Group 4 - Crafting Table and Anvil

- 1.1. Locate 1 black 2x2 round plate, 2 nougat 1x2 bricks with 2 horizontal light brown lines and 1 vertical brown line down the center. Place the plate on the table. Then horizontally place the bricks on top of the round plate so the print faces outwards. Ask a sighted person to make sure it is oriented correctly!
- 1.2. Locate 1 nougat 2x2 tile with a print of a crafting table! It is a 3x3 grid with tan squares in the corners! Place it on top of the bricks. You made a crafting table!

Let's make an anvil now!

- 1.1. Locate 1 black 2x2 round plate and place it on the table.
- 1.2. Locate 1 black 2x2 tile with a stud and 1 short black 1x1 brick. Place the brick on top of the tile then place them on top of the round plate.
- 1.3. Locate 1 black 1x2 plate and 1 black 1x2 tile. Place the tile on top of the plate so there is no overhang then vertically place them on top of the short brick so it is centered.

Group 5 - Furnace

- 1.1. Locate 1 black 2x2 round plate and place it on the table.
- 1.2. Locate 2 dark grey 1x2 bricks with a furnace print on them. Horizontally place them on the plate so the print faces outwards. Ask a sighted person to check.
- 1.3. Locate 1 dark grey 2x2 tile with a stud and place it on top of the bricks. '

Group 6 - Smithing Table and Food Chest

- 1.1. Locate 1 black 2x2 round plate and place it on the table.
- 1.2. Locate 2 black 1x2 bricks printed with a dark red background and some tools on a wall. Horizontally place them on the front and back so the print faces outward. Ask a sighted person to check.
- 1.3. Locate 1 black 2x2 tile with a stud and 1 dark grey 1x2 ingot. Place the tile on top of the bricks. Then vertically place the ingot on top so it is centered.

Let's make a food chest now!

- 1.1. Locate 1 nougat 2x4 chest bottom and 1 nougat 2x4 chest top. Horizontally place the chest bottom on your table so the side with a lower edge is facing the back. Horizontally attach the chest top to the clips on the back edge of the chest.
- 1.2. Locate 2 white bones and 1 red pair of cherries. Place them inside the chest then close it!

You will have 2 extra transparent orange 1x1 plates. Save them for later.

Group 7 - Torches and Tree

Sub-build 2. Locate 2 brown telescope bars and 2 transparent yellow 1x1 plates. Place each plate on top of the studs of the bars. Then locate 2 transparent orange 1x1 plates from group 6. Place them on top of the previously placed plates to make torches!

Let's make a base for the tree to sit on!

- 1. Locate 1 dark green 4x10 plate and place it horizontally in front of you.
- 2. Locate 1 green 2x2 tile with a stud. Place it in the back right corner of the plate.
- 3. Locate 1 green plant with 3 stems. Insert it into the tile with a stud.
- 4. Locate 3 red 1x1 round plates and 3 green 1x1 round flower plates. Place each flower plate on top of the round plates. Then place them on each of the stems of the plant.
- 5. Locate 1 light grey 4x4 plate Horizontally place it on the front 2 rows so it is to the left of the 2x2 tile with a stud.

Group 8 - Tree

- 6. Locate 1 blue 4x10 plate. Horizontally place it underneath the overhang so the left and right sides are aligned.
- 7. Locate 1 light brown 2x4 plate. Vertically place it to the left of the 4x4 plate.
- 8. Locate 1 dark green 1x1 plate and 1 light grey 2x2 corner plate. Place the 1x1 plate in the back right corner of the 4x4 plate. Then place the corner plate on top of the 4x4 plate so it surrounds the 1x1 plate and looks like the braille letter h.
- 9. Locate 1 dark green 1x1 plate and 1 light grey 2x2 corner plate. Place the 1x1 plate in the front left corner of the previously placed corner plate. Then place the corner plate on top of the previously placed corner plate and 1x1 plate so it surrounds the 1x1 plate and looks like the braille letter d.
- 10. Locate 1 brown 2x2 brick and 1 light grey 2x2 tile with a stud. Place the tile on top of the previously placed plates. Then place the 2x2 brick to the left so there are 2 free columns in between.

Group 9 - Tree

- 11. Locate 1 white 1x1 round plate and 1 red 1x1 plate. Place the plate on top of the round plate. Then place them on the front left corner of the 2x4 plate. This is a mushroom!
- 12. Locate 4 brown 2x2 bricks. Stack them on top of the previously placed brown 2x2 brick.
- 13. Let's make a part! Locate 1 green 2x2 plate and 1 dark green 2x6 brick. Place the 2x2 plate on the table. Then horizontally place the 2 rightmost columns of the brick on top of the plate.
- 14. Locate 1 green 2x2 plate and 1 green 2x6 plate. Vertically place the 2x6 plate underneath the middle of the 2x6 brick so it is centered. Then place the 2x2 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns of the brick.

Group 10 - Tree

- 15. Locate 2 dark green 2x2 bricks. Place them in the front and back on top of the plate.
- 16. Locate 1 dark green 2x6 brick and 2 dark green 2x2 bricks. Vertically place the 2x6 brick in the middle so it does not overhang. Then place the 2x2 bricks to the left and right so there is no overhang.
- 17. Locate 4 green 2x2 tiles with a stud and 1 brown 2x2 plate. Place the 2x2 plate in the center. Then surround it with the tiles.
- 18. Locate 1 dark green 2x2 brick and 1 green 2x2 tile with a stud. Place the brick on top of the 2x2 plate in the center. Then place the tile on top.
- 19. Now place your tree top on top of the stack of 5 bricks so it is centered.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 11 - Wolf Stronghold

- 1. Locate 2 dark green 4x10 plates. Horizontally place 1 to the right of the other.
- 2. Locate 1 light brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs. Horizontally place it on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally and connects the 2 plates.
- 3. Locate 1 light grey 1x4 plate and 1 light grey 2x4 plate. Horizontally place the 1x4 plate in front of the previously placed tile. Then place the 2x4 plate in front so it overhangs in the front.
- 4. Locate 1 blue 6x8 plate. Horizontally place it underneath the overhang so it is centered.
- 5. Locate 2 light grey 2x4 plates and 2 light grey 1x4 plates. Horizontally place the 1x4 plates to the left and right of the previously placed 1x4 plate. Then horizontally place the 2x4 plates to the left and right of the previously placed 2x4 plate.
- 6. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 corner plates and 2 dark green 1x1 plates. There are three 2x4 plates next to each other. Place a 1x1 plate in the back left corner of the right 2x4 plate. Then place a 1x1 plate in the back row and 2nd column from the right of the left 2x4 plate. Then place a corner plate to the back right of each of the 1x1 plates so they surround it and look like the braille letter j.
- 7. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 corner plates and 2 dark green 1x1 plates. Place the 1x1 plates in the back right corner of the previously placed plates. Then surround it with the corner plates so there is no overhang and so they look like the braille letter h.
- 8. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 tiles with a stud. Place them on top of the previously placed plates so there is no overhang.
- 9. Locate 2 blue 6x8 plates. Vertically place them underneath the overhang on the front left and right.

You will have an extra light brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs. Save it for the next step.

Group 12 - Wolf Stronghold

- 10. Locate 1 dark green 2x4 tile with 2 studs. Vertically place it on the 2 leftmost columns of the build so there are 2 free rows behind it. Now locate 1 light brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs from group 11. Vertically place it on the 2 rightmost columns of the build so that 2 rows behind it are free.
- 11. Locate 2 light grey 2x4 plates. Vertically place them in the front left and right corners of the build so they overhang 2 studs to the front.
- 12. Locate 2 dark grey 4x8 plates. Horizontally place them underneath the overhang so the left and right sides align with the 6x8 plates.
- 13. Locate 2 light grey 3x3 plates and 1 light grey 1x10 plate. Place the 3x3 plates to the left and right of the front 3 rows of the light grey 2x4 plates. Then in between the front row of the 3x3 plates, horizontally place the 1x10 plate.

- 14. Locate 2 light grey 2x4 plates and 1 green 4x6 plate. Vertically place the 2x4 plates behind the 2 leftmost and 2 rightmost columns of the 1x10 plate. Then horizontally place the 4x6 plate between the 2x4 plates.
- 15. Locate 4 light grey 2x2 tiles with a stud. Horizontally place 1 in the front left corner and 1 in the front right corner of the build. Then place 2 more in between them on the 2 front rows so there is a 4-stud gap in between each tile.
- 16. Locate 2 dark grey 2x2 bricks. Place the bricks behind the front left and front right corner tiles.
- 17. Locate 2 light grey 2x4 plates and 4 light grey 1x2 masonry bricks with grooves. Place the plates horizontally in front of you. Then horizontally place the masonry bricks on the back row so the sides with a brick pattern face the back. You should have 2 of these parts! Horizontally place them to the left and right of the previously placed 2x2 bricks so the 1x2 masonry bricks are in the back.

You will have 2 extra dark grey 2x2 bricks. Save them for later.

Group 13 - Wolf Strong Hold

- 18. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 bricks. In the front row, there are 4 light grey 2x2 tiles with a stud. Behind each of the 2 middle 2x2 tiles with a stud, skip 2 rows then place the bricks. Now locate 2 dark grey 2x2 bricks. Place them on top of the previously placed bricks.
- 19. Locate 1 dark grey 1x1 slope tile. Place it to the right of the back row of the previously placed bricks you placed on the left so it slopes to the front.
- 20. Locate the crafting table and furnace you made previously. The furnace has a stud on top while the crafting table does not. Place the crafting table in front of the 2x2 bricks you previously placed on the left. Then place the furnace in front of the 2x2 bricks you placed on the right. The print on the crafting table should be facing the right and the print on the furnace should be facing the left. Make sure they are oriented correctly. Ask a sighted person to check!

You will have 3 extra light grey 2x2 bricks. Save them for later.

Group 14 - Wolf Stronghold

- 21.1. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 brick from group 13 and place it on the table.
- 21.2. Locate 1 dark green 1x1 plate and 1 light grey 2x2 corner plate. Place the 1x1 plate in the front left corner of the brick. Then place the corner plate on the brick so it surrounds the 1x1 plate and looks like the braille letter d.
- 21.3. Locate 1 dark green 1x1 plate and 1 light grey 2x2 corner plate. Place the 1x1 plate in the back right corner of the plates. Then place the corner plate on the plates so it surrounds the 1x1 plate and looks like the braille letter h.
- 21.4. Locate 1 dark green 1x1 plate and 1 light grey 2x2 corner plate. Place the 1x1 plate in the back left corner of the plates. Then place the corner plate on the plates so it surrounds the 1x1 plate and looks like the braille letter j.

- 21.5. Locate 1 dark grey 2x2 brick and place it on top.
- 21.6. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 brick from group 13 and place it on top. Now place your part behind the 2x2 that is in the front left corner of the build.
- 22. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 brick from group 13. Place it behind the crafting table so it sits on the dark grey 2x2 brick.

You will have 3 extra brown 1x4 plates. Save them for later.

Group 15 - Wolf Stronghold

- 23. Put your build away while we build a door! Locate 1 brown 1x4 plate from group 14 and place it horizontally on the table. Then locate 1 black 1x4 plate and horizontally place it on top.
- 24. Locate 2 brown 1x2 log bricks. Horizontally place them on top of the plate.
- 25. Locate 1 brown 1x2 rotator brick with a hole and 1 dark grey 1x2 rotator brick with a pin. Horizontally place the brick with a hole on the left 2 studs so the hole is on the left. Then insert the pin into the hole.
- 26. Locate 1 brown 1x1 brick and 1 brown 1x1 brick with a side stud. Place the 1x1 brick to the left of the 1x2 brick. Then place the brick with a side stud to the right so the side stud faces the front.
- 27. Locate 1 black 1x4 plate. Horizontally place it on top so there is no overhang.
- 28. Locate 1 brown 1x4 plate from group 14. Horizontally place it on top of the previously placed plate.
- 29. Locate 2 brown 1x2 log bricks. Horizontally place it on top of the previously placed plate.
- 30. Locate 1 brown 1x4 plate from group 14. Horizontally place it on top of the bricks.
- 31. Locate 1 black 1x4 plate and 1 brown 1x4 tile. Horizontally place the plate on top of the previously placed plate. Then horizontally place the tile on top.
- 32. Locate 1 light grey 1x1 round plate. Place it upright on the front-facing stud. This is the door handle!
- 33. Bring back your main build so it is oriented the same way. Now rotate your door 180 degrees. Then place the overhanging dark grey 1x2 rotator brick vertically on the left side of the brick that is behind the furnace so the door is on the left and sits in behind the 1x1 slope tile.

Group 16 - Wolf Stronghold

34. Locate 1 light grey 1x2 masonry brick with grooves. Vertically place it to the right of the previously placed 1x2 rotator brick so the side with horizontal and vertical grooves face the right.

- 35. Let's make a part! Locate 4 light grey 2x2 bricks, 2 light grey 1x2 bricks with grooves, and 2 dark grey 2x2 plates. Place a 2x2 brick on the table. Then horizontally place a 1x2 brick on the back row so the single groove faces you. Then place a 2x2 brick in front so it overhangs to the front. Then place a 2x2 plate on the back 2 rows. Repeat these steps so you end up with 2 parts! Now vertically place them on the bricks that are behind the crafting table and furnace. Make sure that the part is overhanging is facing the front.
- 36. Locate 1 light grey 1x8 brick. Horizontally place it on the back row of the previously placed parts.
- 37.1. Let's make a part! Locate 2 light grey 2x2 bricks and stack them together then place them on the table.
- 37.2. Locate 1 dark green 1x1 plate and 1 light grey 2x2 corner plate. Place the 1x1 plate in the back left corner. Then place the corner plate on the brick so it surrounds the 1x1 plate and looks like the braille letter j.
- 37.3. Locate 1 dark green 1x1 plate and 1 light grey 2x2 corner plate. Place the 1x1 plate in the back right corner. Then place the corner plate around it and looks like the braille letter h.
- 37.4. Locate 1 dark green 1x1 plate and 1 light grey 2x2 corner plate. Place the 1x1 plate in the front left corner. Then place the corner plate around it and looks like the braille letter d.
- 37.5. Locate 1 light grey 2x2 brick. Place it on top. Now place your part behind the 2x2 tile with a stud that is in the front right corner.
- 38. Locate 4 tall brown 1x1 bricks. Place them on top of each of the studs of the 2x2 tiles that are in the frontmost row.
- 39. Locate 2 dark brown 4x8 plates. Horizontally place 1 on the left 2 and 1 on the right 2 tall bricks so that the back corners of the plates are aligned on top of the 2x2 brick pillars and 1x2 overhang of the bricks.

Group 17 - Wolf Stronghold

- 40. Locate 2 dark brown 2x2 bricks and 2 brown 2x2 tiles with a stud. Place each tile on top of each of the bricks. Then place 1 on the back left corner of the left 4x8 plate. Then place 1 in the back right corner of the right 4x8 plate.
- 41. Locate 8 brown 1x2 tiles with a stud. Vertically place 4 to the left and 4 to the right of the previously placed 2x2 tiles with a stud.
- 42. Locate 2 light brown 1x4 masonry bricks with grooves. Horizontally place them on top of the previously placed 1x2 tiles with a stud so the sides with 1 groove face you.

43. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Locate 1 white 1x1 round plate, 1 red 1x1 plate, and 1 light brown dead bush. This has 5 sticks sticking out from it. Place the plate on top of the round plate to make a mushroom. Now place the mushroom on the front stud of the 2x4 tile that is on the 2 leftmost columns. Then place the dead bush on the back stud of the 2x4 tile that is on the 2 rightmost columns.

Group 18 - Wolf Stronghold

44. Locate 2 transparent blue 1x1 plates and 2 dark tan 1x2 plates. Horizontally place a 1x2 plate in front of the left 2 columns of the door so there are 1x2 studs free. Then leave 3 columns to the left of this plate free, then place a 1x1 plate. Then horizontally place a 1x2 plate in front of the right 2 columns of the door so there are 2x2 studs free. Then place a 1x1 plate on the 5th column from the left and the 8th row from the front.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 19 - Skeletons

Sub-build 3. Locate 2 white skeleton bodies, 4 white skeleton legs, 4 white skeleton arms, and 2 white skeleton heads printed with black eyes and a light grey nose. Assemble your skeletons by putting the legs on the body so the toes face the front. Then put the arms on so they angle towards the front. Then put the head on them! Now locate a light blue helmet and 2 bows. One bow is enchanted and one isn't! Put a bow in each of their hands! To do this attach the hand to the vertical bar underneath the intersection of the arrow and handle. Make sure the curved part faces the back! Then put the helmet on one of the skeletons so the middle tooth is in the front.

Group 20 - Wolf Stronghold

- 45. Locate 2 light grey 2x3 bricks. Vertically place them behind the 2 leftmost and 2 rightmost columns of the 1x8 brick that is behind the door so they sit on the brown 4x10 plates.
- 46. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 corner plates and 2 dark grey 2x2 corner tiles. Place a plate on the back right corner of the 2x3 brick you previously placed on the left so there is no overhang. Then place the tile on top of the plate so it looks like the braille letter d. Repeat symmetrically on top of the right 2x3 brick.
- 47. Locate 2 dark grey 1x1 bricks. Place them in the missing corner of the previously placed corner tiles.
- 48. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 corner bricks. Place them on top of the 2x3 bricks and 1x8 brick so they sit on the rest of the 2x3 brick and ends of the 1x8 brick. The left one should look like the braille letter f and the one on the right should look like the braille letter d.
- 49. Let's build a part! Locate 1 dark tan 2x6 plate and place it horizontally in front of you.

Group 21 - Wolf Stronghold

- 50. Locate 2 dark tan 1x1 bricks and 1 black 1x2 brick with an axle hole. Horizontally place the 1x2 brick in the middle of the front row of the 2x6 plate. Then place the 1x1 bricks to the left and right.
- 51. Locate 1 dark grey 2x4 brick. Horizontally place it behind the previously placed bricks so it overhangs 1 row to the back.

52. Locate 2 tan 1x3 bricks. Vertically place them to the left and right so they overhang 1 stud to the back.

You will have 1 extra red 1x2 tile with a stud. Save this for later.

Group 22 - Wolf Stronghold

- 53. Locate 2 dark tan 2x2 plates and 1 blue 1x2 tile with a stud. Place the 2x2 plates in the front left and front right corners so there is no overhang. Then vertically place the 1x2 tile on the right side in between the previously placed plates. Now locate 1 red 1x2 tile with a stud from group 21. Vertically place it to the left of the previously placed 1x2 tile with a stud.
- 54. Locate 2 tan 2x2 tiles. Place them in the front left and front right corners so there is no overhang.
- 55. Now horizontally place your overhang in the back of your part in between the 2 light grey 2x2 corner bricks that are to the left and right of the door.
- 56. Locate 1 light grey 1x4 brick and 2 light grey 2x3 bricks. Horizontally place the 1x4 brick behind the part we just made so it is centered. Then vertically place the 2x3 bricks to the left and right of the 1x4 brick.
- 57. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Locate 2 torches, an anvil, a chest, and a smithing table you previously made. Place the 2 torches on the stud of the 2x2 tiles on the leftmost and rightmost columns of the build. Horizontally place the chest in front of the 1x4 brick you previously placed so the handles keep it in place. Then place the anvil to the right so it sits on the front left corner of the 4x8 plate. Make sure the tile on top is vertical. Then place the smithing table to the left so it sits on the front right corner of the 4x8 plate. Make sure the ingot is vertical.
- 58. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 bricks and 1 light grey 1x4 brick. Place the 2x2 bricks in the front 2 rows of the previously placed 2x3 bricks that are behind the tan 2x2 tiles. Then horizontally place the 1x4 between the 2 bricks in the front row.
- 59. Locate 1 light grey 1x6 brick. Horizontally place it on top of the previously placed bricks so it is centered.
- 60. Locate 2 light grey 1x2 bricks and 2 black 1x2 tiles. Place the tiles on each of the 1x2 bricks. Then horizontally place the bricks on the 2 leftmost and 2 rightmost studs of the previously placed 1x6 brick.
- 61. Let's make a part! Locate 1 black 2x3 plate and horizontally place it in front of you.
- 62. Locate 1 tan 1x3 brick. Horizontally place it on the back row of the 2x3 plate.
- 63. Locate 1 red 1x1 brick with an axle hole and 1 red 1x2 axle. Place the brick in the middle of the front row so the axle hole faces the front. Then insert the axle into the front axle hole.
- 64. Locate 2 dark tan 1x1 bricks. Place them to the left and right of the previously placed axle brick.

You will have 1 extra black 1x2 plate. Save this for later.

Group 23 - Wolf Stronghold

65. Locate 2 tan 1x2 plates. Vertically place them on the left and right sides. Then locate 1 black 1x2 plate from group 22. Vertically place it in between the previously placed plates.

You will have an extra black 1x1 tile. Save it for later.

Group 24 - Wolf Stronghold

66. Locate 2 tan 1x2 tiles and 1 dark tan 1x1 tile. Vertically place the 1x2 tiles on the left and right sides. Then place the 1x1 tile in the front between the 2 tiles. Now locate 1 black 1x1 tile from group 23. Place it behind the 1x1 tile.

67. Bring back your main build so it is oriented the same way. Now horizontally insert the axle into the axle hole that is overhanging above the door. This is the wolf's nose!

68. Let's make the wolf's face now! Locate 1 light grey 1x6 brick and 1 light grey 2x2 plate with a smooth underside. Place the plate horizontally on the table. Then place the back row of the plate underneath the 2 leftmost study of the brick.

69. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 plates with a smooth underside. Place the back row of them underneath the brick.

Group 25 - Wolf Stronghold

70. Locate 2 light grey 1x1 plates and 1 light green 1x2 plate. Horizontally place the 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered. Then place the 1x1 plates in the front left and front right corners.

71. Locate 2 blue 1x1 bricks with a bar. Place them to the left and right of the previously placed 1x2 plate so the bars are in the front.

Group 26 - Wolf Stronghold

72. Locate 4 light grey 1x2 plates. Vertically place 2 stacked together in the front left corner and 2 stacked together in the front right corner so they overhang to the front.

73. Locate 2 white 1x2 plates attached to a vertically upright 1x2 tile. Vertically place them on the 1x2 plate in the front middle so it overhangs and the back of the tiles face you.

Group 27 - Wolf Stronghold

74. Locate 1 light green 1x2 plate. Horizontally place it on the back row of the previously placed plates.

75. Locate 1 black 1x4 rounded plate. Horizontally place it in front of the previously placed plate so it is centered.

You will have 2 extra light grey 2x2 corner tiles. Save them for later.

Group 28 - Wolf Stronghold

76. Locate 2 black 2x2 corner tiles. Place 1 in the back left corner so the missing corner is in the back right. Then place 1 in the back right corner so the missing corner is in the back left. Locate 2 light grey 2x2 corner tiles from group 27. Place them in between the 2 previously placed corner tiles. The corner tile on the left should look like the braille letter h and the one on the right should look like the braille letter j. Make sure the front row is free.

You will have 2 extra red 1x1 tiles. Save them for later.

Group 29 - Wolf Stronghold

77. Locate 2 dark red 1x1 tiles and 1 dark tan 1x2 tile. Horizontally place the 1x2 tile in the middle of the front row. Then place the 1x1 tiles in the front left and front right corners. Then locate 2 red 1x1 tiles from group 28. Place them to the left and right of the previously placed 1x2 tile.

Group 30 - Wolf Stronghold

78. Locate 2 light grey 1x3 plates with a smooth underside and a hole in the middle. Flip your sub-build upside down so the 2x2 tiles are in the back. Then horizontally place the 1x3 plates in the front row so the hole fits into the bars.

You will have 2 extra white 1x1 tiles. Save them for later.

Group 31 - Wolf Stronghold

- 79. Make sure the sub-build is still upside down. Locate 1 dark tan 1x2 tile and 2 black 1x1 tiles. Horizontally place the 1x2 tile in the middle of the front row. Then place the 1x1 tiles to the left and right. Now locate 2 white 1x1 tiles. Place them in the front left and front right corners.
- 80. Bring back your main build so it is oriented the same way. Now using the 2 front-facing tile bottoms, horizontally place it on top of the build behind the nose so it is centered. You can take this sub-build off and turn it 180 degrees so the wolf is mad!
- 81. Locate 1 transparent blue 2x4 plate. Horizontally place it behind the 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column so it overhangs 2 columns to the left.
- 82. Now bring back your tree build. Orient it so the flower plant is in the front left corner. Now attach the overhang to the back right corner of the tree build!
