Kids can act out the story as the characters use the mirror to check out their new look, then pay using their smartphones at the self-serve checkout. This playset makes a fun gift for 6-year-old and up, girls, boys, and kids. The set comes with LEGO Friends Paisley and Candi mini-dolls so play can start right away. Fun accessories include 2 fanny packs for the characters to wear. Discover a range of role-play toys for kids in the LEGO Friends universe, where young builders can enjoy creative play and act out real-life adventures. This small LEGO set comes with the LEGO Builder app for an easy and intuitive building adventure. Here kids can zoom in and rotate models in 3D, save sets, and track progress.

The front of the box shows the tiny accessories store in the back. They have mirrors, a pay system that takes card and wireless pay, and they have a bunch of accessories for sale! They have a few cabinets with bowties, flowers, lipsticks, handbags, and more! In the front, Candi is offering some red lipstick to her friend Paisley!

The back of the box shows how the tiny accessories store can fold into a compact store, or open up to be a larger store! There are 3 smaller pictures show Candi showing Paisley all the products they have. Candi decides on a yellow fanny pack, so she goes and pays for it at the pay system using her phone!

The top of the box shows a real-sized image of Paisley!

The build is 129 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the 2 minifigures and the tiny accessories store!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.

- Behind/Back: away from you.

- Up: towards the ceiling.

- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.

- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back

- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.

- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.

- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.

- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.

- Plate: piece with studs.

- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)

- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.

- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.

- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.

- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece

- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space in none of and beining piece.

- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).

- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42608</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 1 bag labeled 1, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

The steps in this set correspond to page numbers.

Bag 1 - Minifigures and Tiny Accessories Store Group 1 - Page 5 Group 2 - Page 6-7 Group 3 - Pages 8-15. Group 4 - Pages 16-28. Group 5 - Pages 29-49. Group 6 - Pages 50-54 and 1 light orange 1x6 plate from Page 55. Group 7 - Rest of Page 55 and Pages 56-71.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Candi

5. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with light blue jean shorts, and white and lime green shoes, 1 tan torso printed with a purple shirt and yellow belt, 1 tan head printed with eyelashes, dark red lips and eyebrows, and 1 light brown hair. Assemble your minifigure and put her aside!

Group 2 - Paisley

6-7. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with blue jeans and purple shoes, 1 torso printed with a white jacket over a white shirt, 1 fanny pack, 1 head printed with eyelashes, light blue eyes, dark red lips and eyebrows, 1 dark red hair, and 1 white 1x2 tile printed with a phone that has a credit card pulled up. Now assemble your minifigure and put the fanny pack over her shoulder so it is on her chest, then put the phone in her hand so she can pay for stuff! Put her aside so we can build the item display and drawers!

Group 3 - Drawers and Display

8. Horizontally place a light blue 2x6 plate in front of you.

9.1. Horizontally place 2 white 2x3x2 cabinets next to each other on top of the previous plate so there is no overhang and the openings face the front.

9.2. Now attach 1 transparent light blue cabinet door to the left side of the left cabinet so it opens to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

10. Now insert 3 flowers into the right cabinet then close it! The flowers are orange, yellow, and pink!

11. Insert an orange bowtie and red lipstick into the left cabinet then close it!

12. Place a dark purple 2x2 tile on top of the build so it is centered horizontally. Then place a dark purple 2x2 tile with a stud to the left and right so there is no overhang.

13. Place a white 1x1 cone brick on top of each of the previous studs of the 2x2 tiles.

14. Place a yellow fanny pack over the left cone brick so it faces the front. It should not attach to any studs.

15. Now put this aside so we can build the store!

Group 4 - Tiny Accessories Store

16. Horizontally place a light blue 4x8 plate in front of you.

17. Horizontally place a light orange 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light orange 2x2 corner plate to the left and right so the left one looks like the braille letter f, and the right one looks like the braille letter d.

18. Place a dark purple 1x1 round tile in the missing corners of each of the previous corner plates. Then vertically place a dark purple 1x2 jumper plate in front of each of the previous round tiles.

19. Vertically place a light orange 1x2 hinge plate on the front left corner of the build so the little rounded part faces the front when the plate looks like a 2x2 plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. There should be a 1x2 overhang with each of these plates.

20. Now orient each of the 1x2 overhangs so they are horizontal. Put the back row of a dark blue 4x4 plate under the overhang, so that the left two studs on the 4x4 plate's back row are free. The overhang will attach to the rightmost, and second-from-right studs on the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

21. Place a light orange 2x2 corner plate in the back left corner of the left 4x4 plate so it looks like the braille letter f. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

22. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a mint blue 1x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place another on top so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a transparent 1x4x3 panel on top so there is no overhang so the wall faces the back.

23. Now horizontally place your part on the back row of the build so it is centered horizontally.

24. Place a mint blue 2x2x5 curved corner panel to the left and right of your previous part. The left one should look like the braille letter f and the right one should look like the braille letter d.

25. Vertically place 2 mint blue 1x2 bricks on top of each other in front of the left curved corner panel. They should sit to the left of the 1x2 jumper plate and there should not be any overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

26. Vertically place a transparent 1x2x3 panel on top of each of the previous stack of bricks so the walls face outwards.

27. Horizontally place a dark purple 1x2 jumper plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a dark purple 3x3 plate with a curved corner to the left so the curved side faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. They should align with the curved corner panels below.

28. Horizontally place a dark purple 1x8 plate in front of the 2 previous 3x3 plates with a curved corner so it is centered horizontally.

Group 5 - Tiny Accessories Store

29. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate in front of you. Then place a mint blue 1x2 brick on top so there is no overhang.

30. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on top so there is no overhang.

31.1. Place 2 mint blue 1x1x2 bricks with 2 side studs next to each other on top of the 1x2 plate so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on top so there is no overhang.

31.2. Horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 brick on top of the previous plate. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on top so there is no overhang.

32.1. Vertically place an orange 2x6 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs so there is no overhang.

32.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the orange 2x6 tile. This sticker has a mirror on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

33. Make sure the left 1x2 hinge plate part on the 4x4 plate is horizontal. Then horizontally place your part on the back right corner of the left 4x4 plate so it sits on top of the hinge plate and the mirror faces the front.

34. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate in front of you. Then place a mint blue 1x2 brick on top so there is no overhang.

35.1. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on top so there is no overhang.

35.2. Place 2 mint blue 1x1x2 bricks with 2 side studs next to each other on top of the 1x2 plate so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on top so there is no overhang.

36. Horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 brick on top of the previous plate. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on top so there is no overhang.

37. Vertically place an orange 2x6 plate upright on the front-facing side studs so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 sloped curved brick upright on the bottom row of the front-facing side studs so the curved side faces the table.

38. Horizontally place a white 1x2 panel upright on the row above the previous brick so the long wall faces the bottom.

39.1. Vertically place a black 2x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs above the previous panel.

39.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the black 2x3 tile. This sticker has a keypad with a screen of what you bought, a place to tap your credit card, or do wireless pay on your phone! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

40. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 tile upright above the previous 2x3 tile with a sticker.

41. Make sure the 1x2 hinge plate on the right 4x4 plate is horizontal. Now horizontally place your part on top of this 1x2 hinge plate so the sticker faces the front.

42.1. Place a mint blue 2x2x5 curved panel with a sticker in front of you so the curved side faces the front left.

42.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the curved side of the 2x2x5 curved panel. This sticker has a picture of all the accessories! It has flowers, fanny packs, and bowties all in orange and purple! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

43. Now place your curved panel to the right of the previous part so the curved side faces the back right.

44.1. Place a mint blue 2x2x5 curved panel with a sticker in front of you so the curved side faces the front left.

44.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the curved side of the 2x2x5 curved panel. This sticker has a picture of all the accessories! It has flowers, fanny packs, and bowties all in orange and purple! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

45. Now place your curved panel to the left of the mirror that you placed on the left side. The curved panel should sit on top of the 2x2 corner plate and the curved side should face the back left.

46.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a transparent 1x2x2 panel in front of you so the wall faces the back. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on top so the bar faces the back.

46.2. Then horizontally place a transparent 1x2x3 panel on top so the wall faces the back and there is no overhang.

47. Vertically place your part on the rightmost column in front of the curved panel so the wall faces the right.

48.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a transparent 1x2x2 panel in front of you so the wall faces the front. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on top so the bar faces the front.

48.2. Horizontally place a transparent 1x2x3 panel with a sticker on top so the wall faces the front and there is no overhang.

48.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the wall side of the transparent 1x2x3 panel. This sticker has a rainbow sign that says open in all capitals. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

49. Now vertically place your part on the leftmost column in front of the curved panel so the wall side faces the left.

Group 6 - Tiny Accessories Store

50. Place a dark purple 3x3 plate with a curved side on the back left corner on top of the curved panel of the left 4x4 plate so the curve aligns with the curved panel. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now rotate your 4x4 plates that are on the left and right sides to the back. They should be aligned with the middle 4x8 plate. It should look like a 4x16 area now!

51. Place a dark purple 1x1 plate on the back left corner and back right corner of the build. Then place another one on the front row to the left and right of the center 1x8 plate.

52. Horizontally place a light orange 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally on the build. Then place a light orange 1x2 curved tile to the left and right so they align with the curve of the 3x3 plate below.

53. Vertically place a light orange 1x2 hinge plate in front of the left previous 1x2 curved tile so when it looks like a 2x2 plate, the little round part faces the front. Make sure the hinge plate connects the 4x4 part to the 4x8 part. When you rotate the left 4x4 part, the hinge plate should move with it. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

54. Horizontally place a light orange 1x2 plate on the back left corner of the build. Then place a light orange 1x2 curved tile to the right so the curve aligns with the curve of the 3x3 plate. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

You will have an extra light orange 1x6 plate. Save it for later.

Group 7 - Tiny Accessories Store

55. Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 plate from group 6 on the front row so it is centered horizontally and sits in between the 2 hinge plates. Then horizontally place a black 1x6 plate behind the previous plate so it is centered horizontally.

56. Horizontally place a yellow 2x4 plate on the front 2 rows on top of the previous plates so it is centered horizontally.

57. Vertically place 2 yellow 1x3 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row of the previous 2x4 plate so they are centered horizontally and slope to the back. They should align with the back row of the build!

58. Place a yellow 3x3 corner sloped curved bricks to the left of the previous sloped curved bricks so it slopes to the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

59. Horizontally place a yellow 1x3 sloped curved brick in front of the left previous 3x3 sloped curved brick so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

60. Place 2 light orange 1x1 clips on the front row in between the 2 previous slope bricks so the clip sides face the front and back.

61. Let's make a part! Place a light orange 3x3 plate with a curved side in front of you so the curved side faces the back left corner. Then place a yellow 2x2 plate in the front right corner so there is no overhang.

62. Place 1 part on the front left corner of the build so it sits on the 2x2 stud area and overhangs in the front left. The curved side should face the back right. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

63. Place a yellow 3x3 sloped curved brick on the back right stud of the previous left 2x2 plate so it slopes to the back right. The curve should align with the curve in the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

64. Horizontally place a yellow 1x3 sloped curved brick in front of the previous left 3x3 sloped curved brick so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

65. Vertically place a yellow 1x3 sloped curved brick in the back left corner of the build so it slopes to the back. It should not overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

66. Place a light orange 1x1 round plate in the front left corner and front right corner of the build. Then place a yellow 1x1 quarter tile in the front left corner on top of the previous plate so the curved side faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

67. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side so the bar faces the front. Then place an inverted yellow 2x2 sloped curved plate underneath the previous plate so it slopes to the back. The 1x2 plate with a bar should sit on the front row of the sloped plate.

68.1. Horizontally place a white rounded 2x4 tile with a sticker on top so it is centered horizontally.

68.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the white rounded 2x4 tile. This sticker has a picture of a light blue fanny pack surrounded by orange and pink flowers, on a blue, orange, purple, and pink polka dot background!! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

69. Now horizontally attach the bar of your part to the clips on the center of the front row so the tile side is upright and faces the front.

70. Now insert the cabinet and display part you made in the front 2 rows of your build so it sits on the 1x2 jumper plates! Make sure the cabinets open to the front!

71. You can also rotate the left and right sides inwards so it becomes an enclosed store!
