

10785 Bakey with Cakey Fun

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Kids join Gabby and Cakey in an activity-packed kitchen. There's a mixing machine and ingredients such as whipped cream, fruit, and chocolate, plus a chef-cat oven. The big, tiered cake has a revolving top section that kids can decorate with tasty treats, including swirls of frosting, fruit, chocolate, and 2 gold stars. With a cake case Starter Brick, kids soon experience the joy of creative construction. When the day's play is over, all the accessories stow away inside the big cake until next time. There's a colorful picture-story guide in the box, while the LEGO Builder app features intuitive zoom and rotate tools.

Portable play – The large cupcake measures over 2.5 in. (6 cm) high, 2.5 in. (6.5 cm) wide, and 2.5 in. (6.5 cm) deep and opens up so all the set's accessories can be stowed away inside.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Gabby, her friend, and the cake-baking set!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.

- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- “Anti-stud” is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/10785>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 1 bag labeled 1, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

The steps in this set correspond to page numbers.

Bag 1 - Gabby, Cat, and Cake Baking Set

Group 1 - Pages 6-9.

Group 2 - Pages 10-31.

Group 3 - Pages 32-61.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Gabby and Cat

6-7. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with blue jeans and pink and white shoes, 1 torso printed with a white and grey shirt and a pink jacket over it, 1 tan head printed with white and black eyes and red lips, 1 dark brown hair, and 1 pink and white cat ears. Assemble your minifigure then put the cat ears on top of her hair!

8-9. Locate a white cat on top of a pink cupcake wrapper and put it beside Gabby! Now place a white 1x1 ice cream swirl on top of a mint blue cupcake wrapper then put it in front of you! Now put everything away while we build the cake-baking set!

Group 2 - Cake Baking Set

10-11. Place a mint blue 8x8 round plate in front of you. Then place a red 2x2 tile with an upward pin on top so it is centered.

12-13. Place a tan 2x2 round tile with a hole printed with a pink donut on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a pink 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

14-15. Let's make a part! Place a light yellow 4x4 round brick in front of you. Then place 4 mint blue 1x2 curved tiles on top so there is no overhang. They should form a circle!

16-17. Place a light yellow 2x2 round brick in the center in between all the previous tiles. Then place a pink 2x2 plate with drips on the side on top.

18-19. Place your part on top of the upward pin of your main build so it is centered and can freely spin!

20-21. Let's make a part! Place a light yellow 8x8 cupcake wrapper in front of you.

22-23. Locate 2 pink 1x1 ice creams, 2 gold 1x1 stars, 1 banana, and 2 purple 1x1 stacks of grapes, then place them inside the cupcake wrapper! They should not connect to any studs!

24-25. Insert a light green pair of cherries into the top of an orange carrot. Then put it inside the cupcake wrapper!

26-27. Now locate your previous build and place it on top of the cupcake wrapper so it is centered!

28-29. Let's make a part! Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with 2 clips in front of you so the clips face the left. Then place a light blue 2x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes to the right. Then horizontally attach a light brown ladder to the clips so it faces the left.

30-31. Now rotate the ladder so it faces up. Now place it beside your build. Gabby can use this ladder to reach up higher to decorate!

Group 3 - Cake Baking Set

32-33. Place a light blue 6x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 2x6 brick on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

34-35. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place 2 light grey 1x2 grill tiles, 1 to the right of the other to the right so there is no overhang.

36-37. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope brick to the right of the previous 1x2 grill tiles so it slopes to the front. Then horizontally place a light pink 1x2 jumper plate on the back row to the right of the previous slope tile.

38-39. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with an overhead bar in front of the previous jumper plate so the bar faces the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 grill tile in front.

40-41. Place a large light grey mixing bowl on a 2x2 tile in front of the previous 1x2 grill tile. It should sit on the 2 rightmost columns.

42-43. Attach a silver clip with a bar holder to the 1x2 tile with an overhead bar so the hole of the bar holder faces the front. Then insert a silver whisk into the hole.

44-45. Horizontally place a white 1x4 archway on top of the previous 1x2 slope bricks. Then angle the whisk down into the bowl!

46-47. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on top of the previous archway so there is no overhang.

48-49. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs on top of the previous 1x4 brick so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

50-51. Place a pink 2x2 round tile with a sleeping cat face on the front-facing 2x2 side studs.

52-53. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 jumper plate on top of the previous 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs. Then place a pink 1x1 slope tile to the left and right so they slope inwards.

54-55. Place a red 1x1 round plate on top of the previous 1x2 jumper plate that is on top of the arch. Then place a white chef hat on top!

56-59. Let's make a part! Place a light grey 2x2 tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a mint blue cupcake wrapper on top. Now place a white 1x1 ice cream swirl on top.

60-61. Place your part underneath the arch so it sits on the 2 grill tiles!
