10787 Kitty Fairy's Garden Party

Adapted by John Le and tested by Jolene Nemeth.

Gabby, Pandy Paws and Kitty Fairy from the popular TV series drink tea in the tree house, where Kitty Fairy has a bed and strawberry snacks. There are flowers for young gardeners to grow, plus a slide, swing, and merry-go-round for the friends to play on. Accessories, including apples, a watering can, teapot, cups, and butterflies, inspire kids to explore imaginative role play.

Magical garden playset – LEGO® Kitty Fairy's Garden Party (10787) takes kids aged 4+ into a magical place filled with popular characters from DreamWorks Animation's Gabby's Dollhouse.

Iconic characters – Includes a Gabby mini-doll figure and Pandy Paws and Kitty Fairy figures, plus a buildable tree house with a bed and snacks and a garden with a slide, swing, and merry-go-round.

Activities and adventures – Kids join the friends as they water the flowers and make them grow, play on the swing, merry-go-round, and slide, and drink tea in the tree house.

Hands-on fun in the garden – The tree house and slide measures over 5 in. (13 cm) high, 7 in. (17 cm) wide and 4 in. (11 cm) deep.

The build is 130 pieces in total and is for ages 4+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Gabby, the seesaw, and swings.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the flowers, tree house, and slide.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the tree house's roof.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.

- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/10787) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1, 2, and 3, 3 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

The steps in this set correspond to page numbers.

Bag 1 - Gabby, Seesaw, and Swings

Group 1 - Pages 6-7.

Group 2 - Pages 8-9 and 2 orange 1x2x2 bricks from Page 10.

Group 3 - Rest of Page 10.

Bag 2 - Tree house, Slide, and Flowers

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Gabby

6-7. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with white and pink shoes, blue pants, red underskirt, and orange skirt, 1 torso printed with a yellow, green, blue, and purple stripe, 1 tan head printed with brown eyes and red lips, 1 dark brown hair, and white and pink cat ears. Assemble your minifigure and put the cat ears on top of her hair! Now put your minifigure away while we build the swing set!

Group 2 - Swings

8-9. Place a light green 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the left. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 grill tile in the front right and back right corners so there is no overhang.

10-11.1. Horizontally place an orange 1x2x2 brick to the left of each of the previous 1x2 grill tiles.

Group 3 - Swings

10-11.2. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2x2 brick on top of each of the previous 1x2x2 bricks.

Group 4 - Swings

12-13. Horizontally place a light green 1x2x2 brick on top of each of the previous 1x2x2 bricks. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick with a pin on top of each of the previous bricks so the pins face inwards.

14-15. Let's make a part! Vertically place a red 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place an orange 2x2 tile with a stud on top so it is centered vertically. Horizontally place a red 1x2 sloped curved brick on the back row so it slopes to the back. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 panel with a middle wall on the front row so the long wall faces the front. Now horizontally place a white swing with tall sides underneath it so it is centered.

- 16-17. Rotate your build so the rounded side of the plate faces the front. Horizontally place your part in between the 1x2x2 bricks so the swing attaches to the pins and the slope brick face the back.
- 18-19. Horizontally place a purple 1x8 archway on top of the back stud of each of the 1x2 bricks with pins. Then horizontally place another 1 in front. Now horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on the back archway so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate in front.

Group 5 - Swings

- 20-21. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick with a sleeping cat face on the previous 1x2 plate so it slopes to the front. Then place a pink 2x2 sloped curved corner brick to the left and right so the studs sit next to the 1x2 brick. There should be a set of 1x4 studs in the back now!
- 22-23. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate on top of the previous corner bricks and 1x2 brick. Then horizontally place 2 pink 1x2 tri-sloped tiles next to each other on top of the previous 1x4 plate so they slope to the front.
- 24-25. Vertically place a light green leaf plate with 6 studs in front of you. The stud with the longer branch should face the front. Now insert a red apple underneath the front stud. Repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.
- 26-27. Place the back stud of 1 part on the leftmost stud of the front 1x8 archway so the apple faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 28-29. Vertically place a pink 1x2 sloped curved tile on top of the left leaf plate and archway so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 30-31. Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front stud of the 2nd column from the left so the leaves face the front left. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top.

Group 6 - Seesaw

- 32-33. Place a light green 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the left. Then vertically place a green 1x4 tile on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically.
- 34-35. Horizontally place a green 1x2 tile to the left of the front and back rows of the 1x4 tile. Then place a white 2x2 tile with a pin in between the previous 1x2 tiles. Then vertically place a green 1x4 tile to the left of the previous pieces so it is centered vertically.
- 36-37. Place a red 4x4 round brick on top of the 2x2 tile with a pin.
- 38-39. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 2x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place 2 white 1x2 panels with a middle wall, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they are centered horizontally and the middle walls face outwards.
- 40-41. Place an orange 2x2 tile with a stud to the left and right of the previous panels so there is no overhang. Then place a purple 1x1 round flower plate on the front right corner and back left corner. Now

place a purple 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front left corner and back right corner so the leaves face the front left and back right.

- 42-43. Vertically place an orange 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 44-45. Vertically place your part on top of the 4x4 round brick so it is centered on it.

Group 7 - Seesaw

46-47. Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the leftmost stud of the 2nd row from the back so the leaves face the back left. Then place a yellow 1x1 round flower plate on top.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 8 - Fairy and Bed

4-5. Horizontally place a pink 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the right. Then place a purple 2x2 tile to the right. Now place a pink fairy with transparent green wings, a green dress, and a green tiara on top of the 2x2 tile. Put it away now while we build the tree house and slide.

Group 9 - Tree house and Slide

- 6-7. Place a light green 8x8 plate with 3 1x4 gaps and a 1x4 overhang in front of you so the 1x4 overhang faces the left.
- 8-9. Place a tan 1x4 plate in each of the 1x4 gaps of your 8x8 plate so there is no overhang.
- 10-11. Place a light green 8x8 plate with a rounded side underneath the left overhang so it is centered horizontally and the rounded side faces the left.
- 12-13. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the back right corner so the long wall faces the back.
- 14-15. Vertically place 2 tan 1x4 window frames, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the previous 1x2 panel with 3 walls.
- 16-17. Vertically place a light brown 2x4 brick on top of the 2 previous window frames. Then place an orange 1x1 round flower plate on the rightmost column in front of the window frame.
- 18-19. Place a light brown 3x3 curved tree stump with 2 branches to the left of the previous 1x1 round flower plate so the branches face the front and right.
- 20-21. Place another light brown 3x3 curved tree stump with 2 branches to the left of the previous tree stump so the branches face the front and left. It should be on the front 3 rows.
- 22-23. Vertically place a light brown 1x4 panel with a small window behind the leftmost column of the left 3x3 curved tree stump so the wall faces the left.

- 24-25. Horizontally place a blue 1x6 tile on the back stud of the previous panel so it attaches to the back left corner of the 2x4 brick that is to the right.
- 26-27. Vertically place a blue 1x4 tile with 2 studs in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of the previous 1x6 tile.
- 28-29. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 curved tile in front of the left 1x4 tile with 2 studs so the curved side faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a blue 1x2 tile in between the previous curved tiles.
- 30-31. Place a red 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the left stud of the right-facing branch so the leaves face the front right. Then place a yellow butterfly on the front left corner of the front-facing branches.
- 32-33. Place a light brown 1x1 round brick on top of the previous 1x1 plate with 3 leaves.
- 34-35. Place a light brown 1x1 round brick on top of the previous 1x1 round brick. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 plate behind it.
- 36-37. Vertically place the 1x4 plate part of a yellow slide on the previous 1x1 round brick and 1x4 plate so it goes down to the right.
- 38-39. Vertically place a yellow 1x3 tile on the front 3 studs of the previous 1x4 plate part of the slide. Then vertically place a yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile behind it so it slopes to the back.

Group 10 - Flowers

- 40-41. Place an orange 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the left stud of the left-facing branch so the leaves face the front left. Then place a light green watering can on the front row of the 8x8 plate with a rounded side so there are 3 free studs to the left. Make sure the handle is on the left and the spout faces the right.
- 42-43. Let's make a part! Stack 3 green 1x1 round bricks together then place them in front of you.
- 44-45. Place a purple x-shaped 4x4 flower tile with rounded sides on top of the previous 1x1 round brick so it is centered. Then place a yellow 2x2 round tile printed with a happy face on top so it is centered.
- 46-47. Place your part on the 2nd row from the back on the 4th stud from the left.
- 48-49. Place a green 1x1 round brick on the 3rd row from the front and 3rd stud from the left. Then place a yellow flower brick on top.
- 50-51. Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front stud on the 2nd column from the left so the leaves face the front left. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top.
- 52-55. Let's make a part! Stack 2 green 1x1 round bricks together then place them in front of you. Place a purple x-shaped 4x4 flower tile with rounded sides on top of the previous 1x1 round brick so it is centered. Then place a yellow 2x2 round tile printed with a happy face on top so it is centered. Now place

it on the 3rd stud from the front on the 2nd column from the left. There should be a 2-stud gap between this and the 1x1 round flower plate!

56-57. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the slide faces the left. Now place a pink 1x1 round tile printed with a strawberry on top of a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves. Now place your part in the 1x2 panel that is in the front left corner.

58-59. Vertically place the bed that you previously made in group 8 on the 2nd row from the front underneath the 1x6 tile that is on the front left side so the 1x2 slope tile faces the back and the front row is free.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 11 - Cat Minifigure

4-5. Locate a white cat head printed with whiskers, black eyes, and pink ears, and 1 white and black torso printed with a pink bag over his body. Now assemble your minifigure and put him away while we build the roof!

Group 12 - Tree house Roof

- 6-7. Place a light brown 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the right.
- 8-9. Place a green 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then place another 1 to the right.
- 10-11. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on the back left corner so there is no overhang.
- 12-13. Horizontally place a light green leaf plate on top of the 1x4 brick so the stud with the long branch faces the left. There should only be an overhang in the front and back.
- 14-15. Place a pink 1x6 curved brick to the right of the previous 1x4 brick so the curve faces the back right. Then place a purple 1x1 round flower plate on the left 2x2 round tile with a stud.
- 16-17. Place a white teacup in the back left corner on the leaf plate, so the handle faces the back. Then horizontally place a light green 1x2 sloped curved tile on the right stud of the leaf plate so it slopes to the right onto the curved brick. Then place a yellow butterfly to the right so it sits on the curved brick.
- 18-19. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a red 1x2 plate on the leftmost column.
- 20-21. Vertically place an orange 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place 2 red 1x2 panels to the right so the walls face outwards.
- 22-23. Place your part on top of the right 2x2 round tile with a stud so it is centered. Rotate it so the 1x2 sloped curved brick faces the front left corner.

- 24-25. Place a yellow 2x2 round brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right and on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front.
- 26-27. Horizontally place a light green 1x2x2 brick with a rounded extended part on the front row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so the rounded parts face the front.
- 28-29. Place a green 2x2 round plate with leaves on top of the previous 2x2 round brick.
- 30-31. Place a white teapot on the front left corner of the previous 2x2 round plate with leaves so the handle faces the left. Then place a white tea cup on the back right corner of the previous 2x2 round plate with leaves so the handle faces the back.
- 32-33. Rotate your part 180 degrees so the 1x2x2 brick with an extended rounded part faces the back. Now place a tree with cat ears shaped film printed with green, blue, yellow, pink, and purple leaves, and lights on the extended rounded part of the previous 1x2x2 brick so the print faces the front.
- 34. Now horizontally place your part on top of the previous tree house so the film is in the back and the back row is aligned with the back row of the slide!
