Watch as kids make friends with characters Luna and Paisley. Adventurous Luna and shy Paisley always bring out the best in each another while having lots of fun. The toy Pancake Shop comes with a stove, toppings for the pancakes, and a mixer that spins so kids can pretend to make the tasty treats. There's also a small cash register plus a table and a menu card for acting out customer stories. Kids will love spotting the bunny hiding under the bush.

Pancake pretend play for kids aged 6+ – Kids can enjoy hours of fun making pancakes, serving customers, and enjoying tasty treats as they build and play with this LEGO® Friends Pancake Shop (41753)

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.

- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/41753) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 1 bag labeled 1, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 8 - Steps 17-20 and 1 white 1x1 round tile and 1 brown 1x1 round brick from Step 21.

Group 9 - Rest of Step 21.

Group 10 - Step 22-30.

Group 11 - Steps 31-32 and 4 pink 1x3 sloped curved bricks from Step 33.

Group 12 - Rest of Step 33 and Steps 34-38.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Paisley and Bunny

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 light grey bunny with ears and light brown eyes, 1 orange carrot, and 1 green stem. Insert the stem into the carrot then place it next to your bunny!

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 light tan pair of legs printed with white and blue shoes, and a dark blue skirt, 1 light tan torso printed with a white shirt covered in pin diamonds, 1 light tan head printed with dark red eyebrows and light blue eyes, 1 dark red hair, and 1 silver fork. Assemble your minifigure and then put the fork in her hand! Now put everything away while we make another minifigure!

Group 2 - Luna and Sign

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with pink shoes, and light orange shorts, 1 tan torso printed with a pink and blue diamond shirt, 1 tan head printed with light brown eyes, 1 brown hair, and 1 silver fork. Assemble your minifigure then put the fork in her hand!

Sub-build 4. Vertically place a purple wheelchair base in front of you so the back of the chair faces the back. Now attach 2 black wheels to the left-facing and right-facing pins. Then attach 2 black wheels with a bar underneath the front so it connects to the 2 clips. Now sit your minifigure on top of the wheelchair.

Sub-build 5.1. Vertically place a light purple 2x3 tile with 2 clips and a sticker in front of you so the clips face the front. Then attach a white 1x2 plate with a bar upside down to the front-facing clips so the antistuds face up.

Sub-build 5.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the light purple 2x3 tile. It is a sticker of a menu showing a tomato, strawberry, and grapes. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Sub-build 5.3. Horizontally place the 1x2 plate with a bar in front of you so the bar is in the front and the tile is upright and the sticker faces the front. This is a sign with a menu on it! Put everything away now while we build a table and chair!

Group 3 - Table and Chair

1. Place a light blue 4x4 round plate in front of you.

- 2. Place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud in the front left corner so it connects to 3 studs. Then repeat symmetrically on the back right corner.
- 3. Place a transparent 1x1 round tile with an upward bar to the right of the back row of the front 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then place a transparent purple cone brick upside down on top of the bar. Now repeat both parts to the back right.
- 4. Place a tan 2x2 round tile printed with syrup, strawberries, and butter on the front left 2x2 round tile with a stud so there is no overhang.
- 5. Place a white 2x2 round table on top of a light green 2x2 plate, then place it in front of you. Now place the 4x4 round plate on top so it is centered.
- 6.1. Place a white 2x2 brick in front of you. Then place a teal 2x2 tile with a sticker on top so there is no overhang.
- 6.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the teal 2x2 tile. It is a sticker of a round white and red cushion. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 7. Place the table next to your chair! Now put everything away while we build a tree!

Group 4 - Tree

- 1. Horizontally place a light green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x3x3 arch brick in the back left corner so it arches to the right.
- 2. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 sloped curved brick in the front left corner so it slopes to the right and there is no overhang. Then place a light brown 1x1 plate on top.
- 3. Vertically place a brown 1x1 slope tile connected to a 1x1 tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the front.
- 4. Place a transparent brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the previous tile so it sits on the arch brick.
- 5.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green leaf plate in front of you so the stems with 3 studs are on the left and the 1 with 5 is on the right. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the rightmost stud. Then place another 1 on the front left stud. Then place another 1 on the back stud that is in the middle. It is the stem with 1 stud.
- 5.2. Now horizontally place your part to the right of the previous 1x1 round plate.
- 6. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 rounded plate on top of the 1x1 round plate and middle stud of the leaf plate. Now put your build away while we build a mixer!

Group 5 - Mixer

- 1. Horizontally place a light green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a light brown 1x1 round brick in the back right corner.
- 2. Place a light brown 1x1 brick with a clip on the front right corner so the clip faces the front. Then vertically place a light brown 1x2 log brick to the left so there is no overhang.
- 3. Stack 2 light grey 2x3 plates with a rounded side and a hole so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them on the 2 right columns so the hole overhangs to the right.
- 4. Insert a red 1L pin into the top-facing hole so the stud faces up.
- 5. Vertically place a red 1x2 tile to the left of the previous pin so there is no overhang. Then vertically place a red 1x2 jumper plate to the left.
- 6. Insert a dark grey clip on a bar into the 1x1 stud of the pin so the clip hands are on the left and right.
- 7. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a red 1x2 plate with a bar on the short side in front of you so the bar faces the left. Then horizontally place a red 1x2 sloped curved brick on top so it slopes to the left.
- 8.1. Let's make another part! Place a red 1x1 brick with a hole in front of you so the hole faces left and right. Then insert the pin of a tan 2L pin axle into the right-facing hole so the axle faces the right.
- 8.2. Attach a black 1L axle connector to the right-facing axle.
- 8.3. Insert a light grey mixing tool into the left-facing hole. Now place your part on top of the previous part so the mixer faces the left.
- 9. Place a red 1x1 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes to the left and right.
- 10. Attach the bar of your part to the right clip so the mixer faces down onto the 1x2 jumper plate and 1x2 tile.
- 11. Lift up the mixer top and then place a blue bowl on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud. Now put this build away while we make the shop!

Group 6 - Pancake Shop

- 1. Place a light green 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the back. Then place a red 1x1 round tile printed with a strawberry in the front right corner.
- 2. Place a light grey 1x1 plate to the left of the previous tile. Then vertically place a light blue 1x3 brick behind it.
- 3. Vertically place a tan 1x4 brick to the left of the previous 1x1 plate and 1x3 brick.
- 4. Place a light brown 1x1 round brick on the front row to the left of the previous 1x4 brick. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 log brick behind it. Now place a light brown 1x1 round brick behind that.

- 5. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 grill tile to the left of the back 1x1 round brick. Then place a light brown 1x1 round brick to the left.
- 6. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the rounded side of the plate faces the front. Place a light blue 1x2 curved brick in front of the 1x3 brick that is in the 2nd column from the left so the curve faces the front left.
- 7. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick in front of the left 1x1 round brick and grill tile. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with a bar to the right so the bar faces the right.
- 8. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 brick to the right of the previous curved 1x2 brick. Then place a light grey 1x1 plate to the right.
- 9. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with 2 side studs on top of the previous 1x1 plate so the side studs face the front and right. Then place another 1 on the 1x1 plate that is in the back left so the side studs face the back and left.
- 10. Vertically place a tan 1x4 brick to the right of the previous 1x1 brick with 2 side studs that is in the back so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place another 1x4 brick behind the front 1x1 brick with 2 side studs so there is no overhang.

Group 7 - Pancake Shop

- 11. Stack 2 light blue 1x1 plates together then place them on top of the front 1x1 brick with 2 side studs. Then repeat again for the back 1x1 brick with 2 side studs.
- 12. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 brick to the left of the front stack of 1x1 plates you previously placed. Then place a light blue 1x2 curved brick to the left so there is no overhang. Then vertically place another light blue 1x3 brick behind it so it sits in front of the stack of 1x1 plates.
- 13. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate on top of the right stud of the previous horizontal 1x3 brick and stack of 1x1 plates. Then vertically place another teal 1x2 plate on top of the back stud of the previous vertical 1x3 brick and stack of 1x1 plates.
- 14. Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves upright onto the left-facing side stud so the leaves face the front. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the leftmost column so there is 1 stud free in between it and the 1x1 round tile in the back left corner.
- 15. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves, then place them upright onto the front-facing side stud so the leaves face the left.
- 16. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the rounded side of the plate faces the back. Now place a light brown 1x1 round brick on top of each of the previous 1x1 round bricks. There should be 3!

Group 8 - Pancake Shop

17.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round plate upright onto the right front-facing stud. Then place a light grey 1x1 tile printed with a meter upright on the left front-facing side stud.

- 17.2. Now vertically place your part in between the 2 previous 1x1 round bricks so it sits on top of the 1x2 log brick and the side studs face the left.
- 18.1. Place a teal 1x1 plate behind the 1x2 plate that is on the front 2 rows on the 2nd column from the right. Then vertically place a teal 2x3 plate to the left on the front 3 rows so there is no overhang.
- 18.2. Place a teal 1x1 plate to the right of the back left 1x2 plate. Then horizontally place a teal 2x3 plate in front of them both.
- 19. Place a teal 3x3 plate with a rounded side behind the front 2x3 plate and 1x1 plate so there is no overhang.
- 20. Vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick on top of the front 2 rows on the 2nd column from the right so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left so it slopes to the right.
- 21.1. Place a white 1x1 round tile on top of a brown 1x1 round brick. Then place it to the right of the 1x2 sloped curved brick you placed in the back so there is a 1 stud gap in between.

Group 9 - Pancake Shop

21.2. Place a yellow 1x1 round tile on top of a transparent yellow 1x1 round brick. Then place it to the left of the previous 1x1 round tile on top of a round brick.

Group 10 - Pancake Shop

- 22. Vertically place a 1x2 slope tile printed with a keypad in front of the stud of the 1x2 sloped curved brick that is in the back so it slopes to the front. Then place a silver 1x1 round tile printed with the number 5 on it to the right of the front row of the previous 1x2 slope brick.
- 23. Place a white 1x1 brick with a clip on the front row to the left of the previous 1x2 sloped curved tile so the clip faces the front.
- 24. Place a black 2x2 tile with a stud behind the previous 1x1 brick with a clip so it sits to the left of the 1x2 sloped curved brick. Then place another 1 behind it.
- 25. Horizontally place a white 1x2 masonry brick on the front row on top of the previous 1x1 brick with clip and 1x2 sloped curved brick so the brick grooves face the back. Then vertically place another 1 on the back 1x2 sloped curved brick and 1x2 slope brick so the brick grooves face the right.
- 26. Place a light grey faucet on top of a red 1x1 round brick. Then attach the vertical bar to the front-facing clip so the 1x1 round brick is on the bottom and the faucet faces the front. This is a fire extinguisher.
- 27. Place a tan 2x2 round tile printed with strawberries, butter, and syrup on the front 2x2 tile with a stud. This is a pancake! Then place a transparent brown 1x1 round plate behind it on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a transparent orange candle fire on top.

- 28. Vertically place a white 1x3 arch brick on the front row on the right stud of the 1x2 masonry brick so it arches to the back. Then horizontally place another 1 on the back stud of the 1x2 masonry brick that is in the back so it arches to the right.
- 29. Place a white 1x1 brick on the front stud of the masonry brick that is in the back. Then place another 1 on the front row on top of the left stud of the masonry brick.
- 30. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row on top of the 1x1 brick and 1x3 arch brick so the side studs face the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the back 1x3 arch brick and 1x1 brick so the side studs face the left.

Group 11 - Pancake Shop

- 31. Let's make a part! Place a white 6x6 plate with a cutoff corner so the cutoff corner faces the back right.
- 32. Horizontally place a light grey 1x1 plate on the 2nd column from the left and 2nd row from the front. Then vertically place a pink 1x4 plate behind it. Then horizontally place another pink 1x4 plate to the right of the 1x1 plate.

You will have 4 extra pink 1x3 sloped curved bricks. Save them for later.

Group 12 - Pancake Shop

- 33. Vertically place a pink 1x3 sloped curved brick from group 11 on the front right corner so it slopes and overhangs 1 row to the front. Then vertically place a purple 1x3 sloped curved brick to the left so the slopes align. Then vertically place a pink 1x3 sloped curved brick from group 11 to the left so the slopes align. Then place another purple 1x3 sloped curved brick to the left so the slopes align. Now repeat symmetrically to the back left.
- 34. Place a pink 3x3 sloped curved brick on the front left 2x2 set of studs so it slopes and overhangs to the front left.
- 35. Place your part on top of the arch bricks and 1x2 bricks with side studs so the 3x3 sloped curved brick faces the back right.
- 36. Vertically place a white 1x8 tile upright onto the right front-facing stud of the 1x2 brick so it attaches to the side stud below. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.
- 37. Place a white 1x1 round tile upright onto the front-facing side stud to the left of the previous 1x8 tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.
- 38.1. Let's make a part! Place a light grey 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place a transparent brown 1x1 round plate on top.
- 38.2. Place a light grey bar into the 1x1 round plate.
- 38.3. Place a white 3x3 dish upside down into the top-facing bar so it goes all the way down.

- 38.4. Insert 4 yellow 2x2 round tiles with a stud into the top-facing bar.
- 38.5. Place a brown 2x2 round plate dripping on the sides on top of the top-facing bar.
- 38.6. Place a red 1x1 round flower plate on the front right stud. Then place another 1 on the back left stud. Now place a black 1x1 jello tile on the front left stud.
- 38.7. Place your part on top of the roof on the back right stud so the jello tile is still in the front left corner.
