

42625 Beach Smoothie Stand

Kids can create lots of different smoothie flavors by combining ingredients and then mixing them in the blender. They can act out the story as Nova and Niko relax with a drink on the swing before exploring in the beach buggy. This LEGO building set comes with lots of accessories to fuel imaginative play, including a menu board, surfboard, life jacket, dashboard camera, and signpost.

Kids' play food set – Girls and boys aged 6+ can enjoy smoothie-making fun at the beach with this LEGO® Friends Beach Smoothie Stand role-play toy, which includes 2 mini-dolls and a turtle figure.

Mix up smoothie combinations – Imaginative play is lots of fun with this LEGO® set as kids choose ingredients and place them in the blender ready to mix up tasty drink combos.

Create the beach scene – As well as a buildable smoothie stand, this set comes with a buildable beach buggy, a swing, a cooler, and a signpost so kids can enjoy making up their own beach-inspired stories.

2 mini-dolls and a turtle figure – This set comes with a turtle figure, a Niko mini-doll, and a Nova mini-doll with an extra face to show her reaction when she gets sand in her eyes.

Lots of accessories for storytelling – Includes strawberry, banana, blueberry, orange, yogurt, and peanut butter smoothie ingredients, plus glasses, a surfboard, a life jacket, and a dashboard camera.

Measurements – 213-piece set with a smoothie stand measuring over 5 in. (13 cm) high, 5 in. (12 cm) wide and 1.5 in. (4 cm) deep.

The build is 213 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the sign, vehicle, minifigures, cooler, and drinks!

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the beach smoothie stand!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42625>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 bags labeled 1 and 2, 2 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Bag 1 - Minifigures, Sign, Vehicle, Cooler, and Drinks

Group 2 - Left Minifigure on Page 5 and Page 6.

Group 3 - Page 7.

Group 9 - Steps 19-25.

Bag 2 - Beach Smoothie Stand

Group 10 - Steps 1-21.
Group 11 - Step 22.
Group 12 - Step 23.
Group 13 - Steps 24-37.
Group 14 - Steps 38-44.
Group 15 - Steps 45-49 and 4 light brown 1x2 plates with claws from Steps 50-51.
Group 16 - Rest of Steps 50-51 and Steps 52-65.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Niko

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with light blue shorts and light green shoes, 1 torso printed with an orange and blue shirt, 1 tan head printed with dark brown eyes and a smile, and 1 black hair! Assemble your minifigure then put him aside while we make another minifigure!

Group 2 - Nova

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with light green shorts and yellow flip-flops, 1 torso printed with a light blue top, 1 tan head printed with dark tan eyes and red lips, and 1 tan hair. Assemble your minifigure and put her aside while we make a cooler!

Group 3 - Cooler

1. Horizontally place a light purple 2x4 chest bottom in front of you so the lower lip faces the back. Then place a white 2x4 chest top on top so it attaches to the back.

2. Place a dark blue 1x1 round tile, a light yellow 1x1 round tile, 1 orange 1x1 round tile printed with an orange, and 1 pink 1x1 round tile printed with a strawberry inside the chest! Then close it!

Group 4 - Drinks

3. Place a white 1x1 round brick and a light brown head in front of you. Place a green 1x1 round tile on top of each of them. These are drinks! Now put everything away so we can make a palm tree with signs!

Group 5 - Palm Tree with Signs

1. Place a tan 3x3 quarter plate in front of you so the curved side faces the front left corner.

2. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 slope brick in the back right corner so it slopes to the front.
3. Place a light brown 1x1 round brick on the back row to the left of the previous 1x2 slope brick.
4. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 plate on top of the slope brick and 1x1 round brick.
5. Place a brown 1x1 brick with a side stud and a bottom lip on the left stud of the 1x2 plate so the side stud faces the left.
6. Place a brown 1x1 brick with a side stud and a bottom lip on top of the previous 1x1 brick with a side stud so the side stud faces the front.
7. Place a brown 1x1 brick with a side stud and a bottom lip on top of the previous 1x1 brick with a side stud so the side stud faces the left.
8. Place a light brown 1x1 round brick on top of the previous brick. Then place a dark green 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top.
- 9.1. Horizontally place an orange 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the bottom left-facing side stud so it is centered horizontally.
- 9.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the orange 1x3 tile. This sticker has an arrow pointing to the left and it says "HL VALLEY". Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 6 - Palm Tree with Signs

- 10.1. Horizontally place a lime green 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the middle front-facing side stud so it is centered horizontally.
- 10.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the lime green 1x3 tile. This sticker has an arrow pointing to the right and says "GREEN-TECH". Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 7 - Palm Tree with Signs

- 11.1. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the top left-facing side stud so it is centered horizontally.
- 11.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the lime green 1x3 tile. This sticker has an arrow pointing to the right and says "HL RIDGES". Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
12. Attach the clip of a lime green 1x2 rounded plate with a lot of leaves to the top-facing bar so the leaves face the front.
13. Place a light green sea turtle next to the tree! Now put everything away while we make a car!

Group 8 - Car

1. Horizontally place a light grey 2x8 plate in front of you.
2. Place a black 2x2 plate with a pin on the front left corner so it overhangs to the front and the pin faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
3. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate to the right of the previous 2x2 plates with pins. Then vertically place a lime green 2x6 plate to the right so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a white 1x2 plate to the right.
4. Place a black 2x2 plate with a pin on the front right corner so it overhangs to the front and the pin faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
5. Place a black 1x1 plate with a clip on the front left corner so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a rail on the leftmost column in between the 1x1 plates so the rail faces the left.
6. Horizontally place 2 lime green 2x6 plates, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the previous plates.
7. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate on the front middle overhang of the 2x6 plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
8. Place a transparent red 1x1 round plate in the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
9. Vertically place a light blue 2x4 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.
10. Vertically place a light blue 2x4 sloped curved tile on top of the previous 2x4 plate so it slopes to the left.
11. Place a light blue 1x1 brick on the front row to the right of the previous sloped curved tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate in between them.
12. Vertically place a white 1x2 steering wheel on the leftmost column of the previous 2x4 plate so the wheel faces the right.
13. Place a white 2x2 plate with 2 side studs on the front 2 rows to the right of the 1x1 brick so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
14. Vertically place 2 light orange 1x2 panels with a middle wall, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the 1x1 bricks and steering wheel so the middle walls face the right.
15. Vertically place a light orange 2x4 tile to the right of the previous 1x2 panels with a middle wall.
16. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 log brick on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
17. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 log brick on the rightmost column in between the previous log bricks. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a bar on top so the bar faces the right.

18. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front row on top of the 2x2 plate with 2 side studs so it is centered horizontally. It should overhang to the left and right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 9 - Car

19. Vertically place a light blue 2x6 plate with a rounded side on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the right.

20. Place a lime green 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the studs are on the right. Then place an orange life vest on the right-facing bar so it faces the right.

21. Vertically place a lime green surfboard on top of the 2x2 tile with 2 studs so it is centered vertically and the tip faces the front.

22. Place a white 1x1 plate with a side stud on the leftmost column and 2nd row from the front so it sits in front of the steering wheel and the side stud faces the left. Then place a white 1x1 tile with a rounded side on top so the rounded side faces the right. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile upright on the left-facing side stud.

23. Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 rounded plate with a bar in front of you. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile on top. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total! Then attach the bar of 1 part to the front left-facing clip so the round tile is on top and faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

24. Horizontally place a lime green 2x4 angled plate upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally, the long side is on top and it hangs down. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

25. Insert 4 light grey wheels into 4 black tires. Now attach them to the front-facing and back-facing pins so the ridged side faces outward.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 10 - Beach Smoothie Stand

1. Place a tan 6x6 quarter plate in front of you so the rounded side faces the front left corner. Then place a white 1x1 round tile in the back left corner.

2. Vertically place 2 teal 1x2 log bricks, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the previous 1x1 round tile.

3. Vertically place 2 teal 1x2 log bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top of the previous 1x2 log bricks.

4. Vertically place a white 1x2x2 panel with an arch window on the back 2 rows to the right of the log bricks so the wall faces the left.

5. Horizontally place a white 2x4 plate on the back 2 rows to the right of the previous panel so it overhangs 1 column to the right.

6. Horizontally place a tan 6x10 plate underneath the overhang so the front row is aligned with the front row of the 6x6 quarter plate!

7. Vertically place a white 1x2 panel with a window on the back 2 rows to the right of the previous 2x4 plate so the wall faces the right.
8. Horizontally place a white 1x6 tile in front of the previous 1x2 panels and 2x4 plate.
9. Place a teal 1x1 plate in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of the previous 1x6 tile.
10. Stack 2 teal 1x2 log bricks together then vertically place them to the right of the previous 1x2 panel with a window. Now stack 2 more teal 1x2 log bricks together then vertically place them in front.
11. Place a tan 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on each of the previous 1x1 plates so the side studs face the front.
12. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 1x2x2 window frame in front of you so the thinner side faces the front. Then attach a purple lattice window to the front. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total. Now horizontally place them, 1 to the right of the other, in between the 1x1x2 bricks with side studs so the windows face the front.
13. Place a white 2x2 plate on top of the right 1x2 panel and 1x2 log brick.
14. Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate in front of the previous 2x2 plate so there is no overhang in the front and right.
15. Horizontally place a white 1x2 jumper plate in the front left corner of the previous 2x6 plate. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right.
16. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 grill tile behind the 1x2 jumper plates so it is centered horizontally to them.
17. Place the front 2 rows of a white 3x3 quarter plate to the left of the previous 2x6 plate so the curved side faces the front left.
18. Horizontally place a white 1x3 plate behind the previous 3x3 quarter plate so it overhangs 1 stud to the left.
19. Place a teal 1x1 round brick on the right stud of the previous 1x3 plate. Then place another 1 to the left of the 1x2 jumper plate.
20. Place another teal 1x1 round brick on top of each of the previous 1x1 round bricks.
21. Vertically place a teal 1x4 archway on top of the previous 1x1 round bricks.

Group 11 - Beach Smoothie Stand

- 22.1. Let's make a part! Place a red 1x1 round plate in front of you. Then place a transparent 1x1 round brick on top.
- 22.2. Insert the upward bar of a transparent 1x1 round tile into the top of the round brick.

22.3. Place a red 1x1 round plate upside down on top. Then place a green stem with 3 leaves on top.

22.4. Now place it on the left 1x2 jumper plate.

Group 12 - Beach Smoothie Stand

23. Repeat step 22 but now use lime green 1x1 round plates. Now place it on the right 1x2 jumper plate.

Group 13 - Beach Smoothie Stand

24. Stack 2 teal 1x2 log bricks, then horizontally place them to the right of the previous 1x2 jumper plates. Then stack 2 more teal 1x2 log bricks together, and horizontally place them behind the previous log bricks so they sit on the back row.

25. Vertically place 2 teal 1x4 archways, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the log bricks from the previous step.

26.1. Vertically place a light orange 2x4 rounded tile with a sticker upright on the left 1x2 front-facing side studs so it attaches to the bottom right corner.

26.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the light orange 2x4 rounded tile. This sticker is a menu and has a banana, strawberries, and some drinks! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

27.1. Vertically place a light orange 2x4 rounded tile with a sticker upright on the right 1x2 front-facing side studs so it attaches to the bottom left corner.

27.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the light orange 2x4 rounded tile. This sticker is a menu and has oranges, blueberries, and drinks! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

28. Vertically place 2 teal 1x2 log bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the back right corner. Then vertically place another one on top of each of them.

29. Place a white 1x1 brick printed with an orange sun in front of the previous 1x2 log bricks. Then place a white 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top.

30. Vertically place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back right corner on top of the 1x2 log bricks.

31. Place a teal 1x1 round brick on each of the studs of the previous 1x4 tile.

32. Place another teal 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 1x1 round bricks from the previous step.

33. Vertically place a teal 1x4 archway on top of the previous 1x1 round bricks.

34. Horizontally place a light brown 1x8 archway on the back right corner on top of the 1x4 archways. Then horizontally place a light brown 1x6 archway to the left.

35. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 1x2x2 window frame in front of you so the thinner side faces the front. Then attach a purple lattice window to the front. Now vertically place it on the leftmost column in front of the 1x8 archway so the window faces the left.

36. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a pin on the rightmost column in front of the 1x8 archway so the pin faces the left. Then vertically place another 1 in front of the leftmost column of the right 1x8 archway so the pin faces the right.

37. Vertically place a teal 1x2 log brick on top of each of the previous 1x2 bricks with a pin.

Group 14 - Beach Smoothie Stand

38.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a light blue 2x3 plate in front of you.

38.2. Horizontally place a light orange 1x2 panel with a middle wall on the back row so the middle wall faces the front.

38.3. Place a light orange 2x2 tile in front of the previous panel.

38.4. Horizontally place a white swing underneath the front 2 rows so the 2x3 plate overhangs 1 row to the back.

38.5. Horizontally place your part on top of the pins from the previous 1x2 bricks so the overhang faces the front.

39. Horizontally place a light brown 2x16 plate on the back 2 rows.

40. Horizontally place a light brown 1x8 archway in front of the previous 1x2 bricks with a pin. Then horizontally place a light brown 1x6 archway to the left.

41. Horizontally place a tan 2x4 tile in front of the 4 rightmost columns of the previous 2x16 plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

42. Place a teal 2x2 turntable plate on the back left corner on top of the 1x3 plate and 3x3 quarter plate. Then place a light grey 2x2 round turntable plate on top. Now place a light orange 2x2 round tile with a stud on top.

43.1. Let's make a part! Place a light orange 2x2 round tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top.

43.2. Place a tall transparent dome upside down on top of the upward bar. Then place a transparent 2x2 round plate with a smooth underside upside down on top.

43.3. Place your part on top of the back left corner on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud.

44. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 panel with clip hands in the back right corner so the long wall faces the back. Then horizontally place another tan 1x2 panel with clip hands in the back left corner of the 2x16 plate so the long wall faces the back.

Group 15 - Beach Smoothie Stand

45. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light brown 2x16 plate in front of you.
46. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate in the back left and back right corners.
47. Place 2 tan 1x1 clips, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so together they are centered horizontally and the clip hands face front and back.
48. Horizontally place a light brown 2x6 tile in front of the 1x1 clips so it is centered horizontally and overhangs to the front.
49. Horizontally place a light brown 2x16 plate underneath the overhang so the leftmost and rightmost columns are aligned.

You will have 4 extra light brown 1x2 plates with claws. Save them for later!

Group 16 - Beach Smoothie Stand

50. Place a dark orange 1x2 plate with claws on the back left corner so the claws face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a light brown 1x2 plate with claws from group 15 to the right of the leftmost 1x2 plate with claws so the claws face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
51. Place 2 dark orange 1x2 plates with claws, 1 to the right of the other, on the front left corner so the claws overhang to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a light brown 1x2 plate with claws from group 15 in front of the 2 leftmost columns of the 2x6 tile so the claws overhang to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a dark orange 1x2 plate with claws in between them so the claws overhang to the front.
52. Flip your part upside down so it is horizontal and the claws face the front. Then place a brown 2x2 plate with a bar underneath in the back left corner so the bar faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
53. Now attach the bars of your previous part to the 1x2 rotator panels that are in the back left and back right corners of your main build so the claws face the front! Make sure it is bent down to the front!
54. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 4x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the back.
55. Place a purple 2x2 round tile in the front left corner.
56. Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves behind the previous tile so the leaves face the back left.
57. Place a purple 2x2 round tile on the back 2 rows to the right of the previous 1x1 plate with 3 leaves. Then place a light green 1x1 round plate to the right of the front row of the previous 2x2 round tile.
58. Horizontally place a light blue 2x3 plate on the front 2 rows to the right of the 2x2 round tile that is in the front left corner.

59. Place the front two rows of a red 4x4 quarter plate to the right of the previous 2x3 plate so the rounded side faces the back right and it overhangs to the right.

60. Place a lime green 1x4 curved tile on the curved side of the previous 4x4 quarter plate. There should be no overhang.

61. Flip your build upside down so it is horizontal and the rounded side faces the back. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate with a bar on the front row of the 4x8 plate with a rounded side so it is centered horizontally to it and the bar faces the front.

62. Horizontally place 2 lime green 1x2 sloped curved plates with a smooth underside on top of the previous 1x2 plate with a bar so they slope outwards to the left and right.

63. Flip your part so it is upright and the rounded side faces the back. Now place a light orange 2x2 round tile with a stud on the back right corner of the 2x3 plate so it sits on the 1x1 round plate. It should not touch the 4x4 quarter plate.

64. Place a light orange 4x4 dish on top of the previous round tile with a stud. Then place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on top so the leaves face the back right.

65. Attach the front-facing bar of your part to the top-facing clips so it is upright and the dish faces the front!
