The build is 365 pieces in total and is for ages 5+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the room with the fireplace and dress-making room.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the cat room and

Bag 3 includes the pieces for food and the ballroom.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for the tower and bed.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.

- Behind/Back: away from you.

- Up: towards the ceiling.

- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.

- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back

- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.

- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.

- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.

- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.

- Plate: piece with studs.

- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)

- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.

- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.

- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.

- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece

- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.

- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).

- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43206</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 4 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Cinderella

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 pair of legs with a light blue dress with a blue ribbon, 1 tan torso printed with a light blue top, 1 tan head with light blue eyes and pink lips, and 1 blonde hair with a blue ribbon. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we build the castle!

Group 2 - Fireplace Room

1. Horizontally place a teal 2x8 plate in front of you.

2. Vertically place a white 1x4 brick on the rightmost column so it overhangs 2 studs to the back.

3. Place a light green 8x8 plate with a rounded side underneath the overhang so it aligns with the 2x8 plate and the rounded side faces the back.

4. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap behind the 1x4 brick so there is no overhang.

5. Place a white 1x1x3 brick on the front stud of the 1x4 brick. Then vertically place a 1x4x5 panel with a small window behind it so the wall faces the right.

6. Horizontally place a light blue 3x4x6 panel with a window and angled sides behind the previous 1x4x5 panel so the angled side faces the back and there is no overhang.

7. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a sand blue 2x4 plate in front of you.

8. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 grill tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 jumper plate in front of it.

9. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x4 archways, 1 in front of the other, on top of the leftmost and rightmost columns.

10. Horizontally place a sand blue 2x4 plate on top so there is no overhang.

11. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side in the back right corner so there is no overhang and the clip faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

12. Horizontally place 2 sand blue 1x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they slope outwards.

13. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x2 brick on the back row on top of the previous slope bricks.

14. Place a transparent hourglass with sand inside on the front row on the 2nd stud from the right. Then place a black pan underneath the arches so it sits on the 1x2 jumper plate and the handle faces the front.

15. Vertically place your part on the front row to the left of the 1x1x3 brick and 1x4x5 panel so the handle of the pan faces the left. There should be no overhang.

16. Place a white 1x6x6 curved panel printed with blue and gold flags and a blue window to the left of the front row of the 3x4 panel so the curved side faces the back left.

17. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side in front of the 1x6x6 curved panel in the front left corner so the bar faces the front.

18. Place a light brown 1x1 round tile printed with a cookie on top on the front row to the right of the previous 1x2 brick with a bar. Then place a brown 2x2 round tile with a stud behind it so it sits to the right of the 1x2 brick with a bar.

19. Place a brown 2x2 barrel on top of the previous 2x2 round tile with a stud so there is no overhang. Then place a light blue fish inside the barrel.

Group 3 - Fireplace and Dress Room

20. Place a white 1x1x5 brick on the back stud of the previous 1x2 brick with a bar. Then place a white 1x1x3 brick in front of it.

21. Horizontally place a white 1x8 archway on the front row so it sits on top of the 1x1x3 bricks.

22. Vertically place a light blue 2x6 plate on the front right corner on top of the previous archway so there is no overhang in the front.

23. Place a light blue 6x6 plate with a curved side to the left of the previous 2x6 plate so the curved side faces the back left.

24. Attach a brown broom to the front-facing clip so the broom faces down.

25. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally on the 3x4 panel.

26. Horizontally place the 1x2 gap of a 3x6 plate with a rounded side around the previous 1x2 plate so the rounded side faces the back.

27. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the back right corner of the vertical 2x6 plate so it attaches to the 3x6 plate with a curved side behind it.

28. Let's make a part! Insert a gold lattice window with a round top into a white 1x2 window frame with a round top, then horizontally place it to the left of the back stud of the previous 1x2 brick so the window faces the back.

29. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick to the left so the back stud aligns with the window frame.

30. Horizontally place a white 1x4 archway on top of the window frame so it is centered horizontally to it.

31. Place a curved gold 1x4 fence to the left of the front stud of the left 1x2 brick so the curved side faces the back left.

32. Horizontally place 2 white 1x3x3 half arch bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column in front of the fence so they arch and overhang to the left. They should connect to the curved fence too!

33. Vertically place a blue 1x3 jumper plate on the rightmost studs of the previous arch bricks so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate on top of the 1x4 archway that is in the back right so it is centered horizontally.

34. Place a blue 1x1 plate with a clip in front of the right vertical 1x2 brick so the clip faces the right. Then horizontally place a pink 1x3 archway to the left.

35. Vertically place a blue 1x1 tile with a 1x1 slope tile on top of the previous 1x1 plate with a clip and 1x2 brick so it slopes to the front.

Group 4 - Dress Room

36.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front.

36.2. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 jumper plate on the back row so there is no overhang.

36.3. Insert a pink 2x3 drawer into the bottom row of the cabinet. Then place a light blue hairbrush and light grey scissors inside, then close the drawer!

36.4. Horizontally place your part on top of the 1x3 archway so there is no overhang in the front and it opens to the front.

Let's make a part: 37.1. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick in front of you.

37.2. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.

37.3. Place a gold 2x2 round tile printed with a mirror upright on the front-facing side studs so there is no overhang.

37.4. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on top so there is no overhang. Then place a pink 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top. Then horizontally insert a tiara into the bar, so it faces the front.

38. Horizontally place your part on top of the 1x3 jumper plate that is on top of your previous cabinet so the mirror faces the front.

39-40. Place a gold 1x2 curved tile on the front 2 rows to the right of the leftmost 1x3 jumper plate so the curved side faces the front left. Then place another 1 behind it so the curved side faces the back left. Now repeat both steps symmetrically to the right so they create a 2x2 round gap. Now place a white 2x2 half-cone brick inside the 2x2 gap.

41. Place a white and blue dress on top of the previous half-cone brick so it is centered.

42. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the round side of the 3x6 plate faces the front. Then stack 2 white 1x1 round bricks, then place them in front of the leftmost column of the 1x4 archway. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

43. Place a white 1x1 brick with a scroll on top of the left 1x1 round brick so the scroll faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 5 - Dress Room

44.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 3x6 plate with a round side and a 1x2 gap so the round side faces the back.

44.2. Then horizontally place 2 blue 1x3 sloped curved bricks on top so there is no overhang.

44.3. Place 2 gold 1x2 curved bricks in front of the previous sloped curved bricks so there is no overhang.

44.4. Horizontally place your part on top of the previous scroll bricks so the 1x2 gap fits around the 1x2 plate.

45. Horizontally place a transparent blue 2x4 sloped curved half-cone panel on top of the previous part so there is no overhang. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick on top.

46.1. Let's make a part! Place a pink 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 panel with a window on the back row so the wall faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

46.2. Place a blue 2x2 pyramid brick on top so there is no overhang.

46.3. Place a white bar with a stop on top. Then insert a gold flag so it faces the left.

46.4. Place your part on the back right corner on the 2x2 set of studs from the 1x3 arch bricks so the flag faces the front left.

47. Place a yellow butterfly on the front right stud of the previous 3x6 plate with a curved side that you placed the 1x1 round bricks on. Make sure it is on the front right corner of the 2x2 set of studs. Then place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves behind the front left stud of the build so the leaves face the front. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now place a green tree on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so there is no overhang.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 6 - Lady Tremaine and Lucifer the Cat

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 pair of legs with a long purple dress, 1 torso printed with a purple long sleeve, 1 tan head printed with light green eyes and purple lips, 1 dark grey hair, and 1 black cat. Assemble your minifigure then put the cat by her side!

Group 7 - Treasure Chest

Sub-build 3. Horizontally place a gold 2x4 chest bottom in front of you so the lower lip faces the back. Then place a gold 1x1 round tile printed with a coin, a dark grey sword, a transparent green diamond, and a transparent light grey diamond inside. Now horizontally place a gold 2x4 chest top on top so it attaches to the back. Make sure it can open and close! Now place it aside while we build a staircase.

Group 8 - Stair Case

1. Horizontally place a teal 2x8 plate in front of you.

2. Place a white 1x1 brick with a clip in the front left corner so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

3. Vertically place a pink 1x2 plate to the right of the previous 1x1 bricks. Then place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud to the right.

4. Horizontally place a white 1x2 curved brick with a 1x1 plate on the front left corner so it slopes to the right and there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

5. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 tile on the rightmost column. Then place a yellow 1x1 slope tile printed with cheese on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud so it slopes to the front.

6. Vertically place a white 1x2x2 brick on the leftmost column. Then vertically place another 1 on top of it.

7. Horizontally place a light blue 4x7 staircase to the left of the rightmost 1x2 tile so it connects to the leftmost column. It should go down to the right.

8. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 tile on the leftmost column so there is no overhang. Then attach a transparent pink wand with a star to the front-facing clip so the star is on top.

Group 9 - Cat Room

1. Place a light green 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the back.

2. Place a white 1x6x6 curved panel printed with blue and gold flags and a light blue lattice window on the front right corner so the curved side faces the back right.

3. Horizontally place a light blue 3x4x6 panel with angled sides to the left so the angled sides face the back and the front row aligns with the curved panel.

4. Vertically place a light blue 1x3 brick in the front left corner so it overhangs 1 stud to the front. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap behind it.

5. Horizontally place a teal 2x8 plate underneath the overhang so the sides align with the 8x8 plate with a rounded side.

6. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the front right corner so the bar faces the front.

7. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 brick on the front row to the left of the previous brick. Then horizontally place a gold 2x4 rounded tile behind it so it sits to the left of the 1x2 brick with a bar.

8. Place a white 1x1x5 brick on the back stud of the 1x2 brick with a bar.

9. Horizontally place a white 1x4x5 panel with a window on the front row in front of the previous brick so the wall faces the front and there is no overhang. Then vertically place another 1 on the front left corner so the wall faces the left and there is no overhang.

10.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x4 door frame in front of you. Then attach a door with a cat door hole to the front so it opens to the left.

10.2. Attach a transparent light blue cat door to the cat door hole.

10.3. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate upright to the front-facing stud.

10.4. Horizontally place your part on the front row to the left of the previous panel so the door opens to the front.

11. Vertically place a light blue 2x6 plate on the front left corner on top of your previous part so there is no overhang in the front.

12. Place a light blue 6x6 plate with a curved side to the right of the previous plate so the curved side faces the back right.

13. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the back on top of the 3x4 panel with angled sides so it is centered horizontally on it.

14. Horizontally place the 1x2 gap of a light blue 3x6 plate with a rounded side around the previous 1x2 plate so the rounded side faces the back.

15. Place a blue 1x1 plate with a clip on the leftmost column on the 5th row from the front so the clip faces the left. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick behind it.

16. Let's make a part! Insert a gold lattice window with a round top into a white 1x2 window frame with a round top, then horizontally place it to the right of the back stud of the previous 1x2 brick so the window faces the back.

17. Place 2 gold 1x1 round flower plates next to each other in front of the previous 1x2 window frame.

18. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick to the right of the previous window frame and a 1x1 round flower plate.

19. Horizontally place a white 1x4 archway on top of the previous window frame so it is centered horizontally on it.

20. Place a gold 1x4 curved fence to the right of the right 1x2 brick so the curved side faces the back right.

21. Horizontally place 2 white 1x3x3 half arch bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column in front of the fence so they arch and overhang to the right.

22. Vertically place a blue 1x3 jumper plate on the leftmost studs of the previous arch bricks so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate on top of the 1x4 archway that is on top of the window so it is centered horizontally. It should connect to the curved fence too!

Group 10 - Upper Floor

23. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x2x3 brick with a sticker in front of you.

24. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the brown 1x2x3 brick. This sticker has 3 gold bars and a swinging pendant. It is the interior for a grandfather clock! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

25. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs above the plate on top so the side studs face the front.

26. Place a brown rounded 1x4 brick with 2 studs on top so it is centered horizontally.

27. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on top. Then place a brown 2x2 round tile printed with a clock upright on the front-facing side studs.

28. Place a brown 1x1 pyramid tile on top.

29. Horizontally place your part in between the front studs of the vertical 1x2 bricks so it sits in front of the window.

30. Vertically place a blue 1x1 slope tile with a 1x1 tile on the leftmost column on top of the front stud of the 1x2 brick so it slopes to the front.

31-32. Place a gold 1x2 curved tile on the front 2 rows to the left of the 1x3 jumper plate that is on the rightmost side so the curved side faces the front right. Then place another 1 behind it so the curved side faces the back right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left so it makes a 2x2 round gap. Now place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud in the 2x2 round gap.

Group 11 - Upper Floor

33. Let's make a part! Place a gold 2x2 round ridged brick in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 round tile with a stud on top so there is no overhang. Then place a transparent head printed with a goldfish on top. Then place a transparent sphere on top of the head. Place your part on the front left corner of your build so there is no overhang.

34. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the round side of the 3x6 plate faces the front. Stack 2 white 1x1 round bricks together then place them on the 2nd row from the front in front of the leftmost column of the 1x4 archway. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

35. Place a white 1x1 brick with a scroll on top of the left previous 1x1 round brick so the scroll faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

36.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 3x6 plate with a round side and a 1x2 gap so the round side faces the back.

36.2. Then horizontally place 2 blue 1x3 sloped curved bricks on top so there is no overhang.

36.3. Place 2 gold 1x2 curved bricks in front of the previous sloped curved bricks so there is no overhang.

36.4. Horizontally place your part on top of the previous scroll bricks so the 1x2 gap fits around the 1x2 plate.

37. Horizontally place a transparent blue 2x4 sloped curved half-cone panel on top of the previous part so there is no overhang. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick on top.

38.1. Let's make a part! Place a pink 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 panel with a window on the back row so the wall faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

38.2. Place a blue 2x2 pyramid brick on top so there is no overhang.

38.3. Place a white bar with a stop on top. Then insert a gold flag so it faces the left.

38.4. Place your part on the 2 leftmost columns on top of the 1x3 arch bricks so there is no overhang and the flag faces the front left.

39. Place a green leaf plate with 6 studs on the 3rd stud from the front on the 2nd column from the left so it faces the front right. The other end should sit to the left of the front 2 studs of the build.

40. Place an orange pumpkin on the back left stud of the leaf plate. Then insert a green stem into the pumpkin. Now place another pumpkin on the right stud of the front row. Then insert a green stem into it.

41. Rotate your build so the door faces the right. Now bring back your stair case and orient it so it goes down to the back. Then attach the left-facing clip to the right-facing bar of your main build. Now you can rotate your stair case so it goes down to the right!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 12 - Food

1. Horizontally place a teal 2x8 plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 brick with a clip on the back right corner so the clip faces the back.

2. Horizontally place a white 1x6 archway on the back row to the left of your previous brick. Then place a white 1x1 brick with a clip to the left so the clip faces the back.

3. Place a white 1x1 brick with a scroll on the front left corner so the scroll faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 13 - Food

4. Horizontally place a pink 2x8 plate on top so it is centered.

5. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

6. Place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud to the left and right of the previous jumper plate so there is no overhang.

7. Horizontally place a gold candelabra on the jumper plate. Then place a white 1x1 round brick on the middle stud. Then place a transparent orange candle fire on top of the 1x1 round brick.

8. Place a silver wive glass on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

9. Place a light brown croissant on the right 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then place a light yellow and tan pie on the left 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then place a light brown 1x1 round tile printed with a pie on it in the front left corner. Then place a yellow 1x1 slope tile printed with cheese in front of you. Then place a

light brown mouse printed with a yellow shirt (Gus Gus) next to it. Now put everything away while we build the ballroom.

Group 14 - Ballroom

1. Place a light blue 10x10 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the front.

2. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 sloped curved brick in the back left corner so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Horizontally place the 1x4 plate part of a white 4x8 sloped curved tile printed with blue and gold stairs on the back row between the previous sloped curved bricks so it slopes to the back.

4. Place a white 1x1 brick with a clip on the leftmost column in front of the sloped curved brick so the clip faces the left. Then place a pink 1x1 brick to the right. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

5. Horizontally place a white 2x6 tile in between the previous pink 1x1 bricks so it is centered horizontally.

6. Place a white 4x4 tile with a ridged circle in front of the 2x6 tile so it is centered horizontally. Then place a gold 2x2 round tile in front so it is also centered horizontally.

7. Vertically place a teal 1x4 tile in front of the left pink 1x1 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

8. Place a teal 1x6 curved tile in front of the left 1x4 tile so the curved side faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

9. Place a blue 8x8 round plate on top of the ridged circle of the 4x4 tile so it can freely spin.

10. Place a white 1x1x3 brick on top of the left 1x3 sloped curved brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

11. Horizontally place a pink 1x2x5 brick in front of the left previous brick so it sits on top of the 2 1x1 bricks. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

12. Horizontally place a pink 1x8 archway on top of the 2 previous 1x2x5 bricks so it is centered horizontally.

13. Vertically place a white 1x6x6 door frame on the leftmost column in front of the 1x2x5 brick so the rounded side of the pillars faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

14. Vertically place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the back stud of the left door frame so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

15. Horizontally place a white 1x3 half-arch brick on top of the front stud of the left door frame so it arches to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

16. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Horizontally place a white 1x5 half-arch brick on the front left corner in front of the 1x2 rounded brick with a gap so it arches to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

17. Vertically place a blue 1x8 brick on the leftmost column on top of the previous arch brick so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

18. Horizontally place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick on the front stud of the left 1x8 brick so there is no overhang and it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 15 - Ballroom

19. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate in between the 2 previous slope bricks so it is centered horizontally. Then place a gold 1x1 plate with a clip to the left and right so the clips face the front.

20.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a blue 2x6 windshield with a sticker in front of you.

20.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the blue 2x6 windshield. This sticker is 2 horses pulling a pumpkin carriage with Cinderella guiding the horses. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

21. Vertically place your windshield on the 2 leftmost columns behind the 1x2x2 slope brick so it slopes to the left.

22. Horizontally place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick behind the windshield so it slopes to the left.

23. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Horizontally place a white 1x6 arch brick on the front row to the left of the 1x2x2 slope brick. Then horizontally place a pink 1x6 brick on top of the pink 1x8 arch brick so it sits to the left of the back row of the windshield.

24. Vertically place a blue 1x8 brick to the left of the windshield and 2 slope bricks.

25. Place a white 1x1 brick with a scroll to the left of the front stud of the previous 1x8 brick so the scroll faces the front. Then place a blue 2x2 inverted slope brick to the left so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then place a white 1x1 brick with a scroll to the left so the scroll faces the front.

26. Horizontally place a blue 2x4 brick on the back 2 rows to the left of the previous 1x8 brick.

27. Vertically place a blue 1x8 brick to the left of the previous 2x4 brick so there is no overhang in the front or back.

28.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a blue 2x6 windshield with stickers in front of you so it slopes to the front.

28.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 and sticker 4 on the blue 2x6 windshield. These stickers have sketches of dresses. Make sure the stickers are placed on correctly and are oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

28.3. Vertically place your windshield in front of the 1x2x2 slope brick that is in the back left corner so it slopes to the left.

29. Horizontally place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick in front of the windshield so it slopes to the left.

30. Horizontally place a white 1x8 tile on the front row on top of the previous slope brick so there is no overhang.

31. Horizontally place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs in front of the previous 1x8 tile so it is centered horizontally on the scroll bricks and inverted slope brick. Then vertically place a white 2x3 tile behind the 2 leftmost columns of the previous 1x8 tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

32. Horizontally place 2 white 3x4 tiles with 4 studs, 1 to the right of the other, behind the previous 2x3 tiles so together they are centered horizontally.

33. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a side stud on the front row in front of the 2 previous 3x4 tiles with 4 studs so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the front.

34. Place a blue 1x1 brick to the left and right of the previous brick.

35. Horizontally place a blue 1x4 brick on top of the previous 1x1 bricks and 1x2 brick with a side stud.

36. Horizontally place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick to the right of the previous 1x4 brick so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

37. Horizontally place 2 blue 1x3 slope bricks on the front row on top of the previous bricks so they slope outwards and there is no overhang.

38. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on top of the previous 1x3 slope bricks so there is no overhang.

39. Place a gold crown on top of the previous jumper plate. Then place a transparent pink heart on top.

40. Place a white 4x4 dish printed with a light blue and gold clock upright on the front-facing side stud.

41. Attach the bar of a gold curved bar with swirls to the front-facing clip to the right of the previous dish so it curves to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 4):

Group 16 - Prince Charming

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with dark red pants and black shoes, 1 gold and yellow torso printed with white gloves, 1 tan head printed with brown eyes and a smile, 1 black hair, and 1 transparent 1x2 tile printed with light blue slippers. Assemble your minifigure then put the tile in his hand.

Group 17 - Tower and Bed

1. Place a light blue 8x8 plate in front of you. Then place a gold 1x4 fence on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

2. Vertically place a blue 1x2 slope tile in the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Horizontally place a 2x6 door frame with curved sides in front of the 1x4 fence so it surrounds it. The shorter side should be on the back row.

4. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on the front row on the 2nd stud from the left and 2nd stud from the right. Repeat this step for the row in front of the slope tiles and door frame.

5.1. Vertically place a white 1x2x2 brick with a sticker in front of the right 1x2 slope tile so the sticker faces the right.

5.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the white 1x2x2 brick. This sticker is a drawing of Prince Charming and Cinderella. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

6. Horizontally place 2 white 1x3x3 half-arch bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column in front of the 1x2 slope brick so they arch and overhang to the left.

7. Horizontally place 2 white 1x3 arch bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column on top of the 1x2x2 brick so they arch and overhang to the right.

8. Vertically place a white 1x2x2 brick on the right studs of the left arch bricks so there is no overhang.

9. Horizontally place a white 1x8 archway on top of the back stud of the previous 1x2x2 brick so it sits on the left stud of the right 1x3 arch brick. Then horizontally place another 1 in front so it aligns with it.

10. Place a white 2x2 brick to the right of the previous 1x8 archways so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

11. Let's make a part! Place a white 6x6 plate in front of you.

12. Vertically place a pink 1x6 plate on the leftmost and rightmost columns.

13. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

14. Vertically place a white 1x4 panel in front of the leftmost stud of the 1x4 brick so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

15. Horizontally place 2 white $1x^2$ rotator panels on the front row so together they are centered and the tall side faces the back.

16. Attach 2 white 1x2 plates with bars underneath to the 2 previous rotator panels.

17. Vertically place 3 pink 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so they slope to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

18.1. Place a pink 4x4 tile with 4 studs and a sticker on top of the 2 1x2 plates with bars underneath so there is no overhang in the front and the 4 studs are in the front.

18.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the pink 4x4 tile with 4 studs. This sticker is a diagonal grid with a brown horizontal line at the top. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

19. Horizontally place a white 1x4 sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and it slopes to the front. This is a bed! You can lift the 4x4 tile with 4 studs upright and there is storage under!

20. Vertically place your bed on top of the 4 1x1 round flower plates so the 1x4 sloped curved brick is in the back.

21. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a white 4x4 tile with a ridged circle in front so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

22. Place a light blue $2x^2$ tile with a stud to the right of the previous $4x^4$ tile with a ridged circle so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

23. Place a pink 1x1 heart tile to the left and right of the back row of the 4x4 tile with a ridged circle.

Group 19 - Tower

24.1. Let's make a part! Place a pink $2x^2$ plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white $1x^2x^2$ panel with a window on the back row so the wall faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now place a blue $2x^2$ pyramid brick on top so there is no overhang. Now repeat the steps again so you have 2 parts in total.

24.2. Place your parts to the left and right of the previous 2x2 tiles with a stud. Make sure the windows face the front and back.

25. Let's make a part! Place a light blue 8x8 round plate in front of you.

26. Place 2 blue 1x6 curved bricks on the back row so they are centered horizontally and there is no overhang.

27. Place 2 teal 1x6 curved tiles on the front row so they are centered horizontally and there is no overhang.

28. Vertically place a light blue 2x3 tile with an angled side behind the front 1x6 curved tiles so it is centered horizontally and the angled side faces the front. Then vertically place another 1 behind it so the angled side faces the back.

29. Vertically place 2 gold 1x2 jumper plates, 1 in front of the other, to the left of your previous tiles. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

30. Place your part on top of the ridged circle of the 4x4 tile so it can spin freely. Make sure to keep it as is right now while we continue building on it!

31. Place a transparent blue 4x8 sloped curved half-cone panel on the back 2 curved 1x6 bricks so there is no overhang and it slopes to the back.

32. Insert a white bar with a stop into each of the blue 2x2 pyramid bricks that are on the left and right. Then insert a gold flag into the bars so they face the back right.

33. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 2x4 plate in front of you.

34. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate underneath the leftmost and rightmost columns so there is no overhang.

35. Place a 2x2 inverted sloped curved plate with a smooth underside underneath the back row so it overhangs 1 row to the back. The studs in the back should be at the same height as the studs on the 2x4 plate.

36. Rotate your part 180 degrees. Then vertically place a light blue 2x3 tile with 2 clips on top so there is no overhang and the clips face the back.

37. Place a gold 1x1 plate with a tooth on the front left corner so the tooth faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

38. Attach a transparent light blue angled sloped windshield with a bar to the back-facing clips so the sloped side faces the back when it is upright.

39. Vertically place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick on the left column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

40. Place your part on the 4 jumper plates that is on your previous part so the upright windshield faces the back. This is a throne!

41. Place a transparent blue 2x4 sloped half-cone panel on top of the 4x8 slope half-cone panel so there is no overhang and it slopes to the back.

42. Place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick on top of your previous panel. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate in the 1x2 gap created by the previous panel.
