

71815 Kai's Source Dragon Battle

The LEGO® NINJAGO® Kai's Source Dragon Battle (71815) adventure playset helps kids aged 4+ learn how to build while they enjoy exciting ninja adventures in the NINJAGO universe. This action toy features a red dragon model that kids can pose by moving its jaw, head, tail, legs, and 4 wings. Kids can also place a fire element in its mouth to scare villains.

This LEGO building toy for kids comes with 4 minifigures: Climber Kai with a katana sword accessory, Wyldfyre with a katana sword accessory, a Wolf Mask Guard with a spear, and a Wolf Mask Warrior with a sword accessory. There is also a small forest build to trap characters, a powerful shooter vehicle that can fire a large arrow, and 3 small flame elements.

Posable dragon figure – Kids can recreate action from season 2 of the NINJAGO® Dragons Rising TV show by moving the dragon's jaw, head, tail, legs, and 4 wings into different positions.

4 LEGO® NINJAGO® minifigures – Ninja playset includes Climber Kai and Wyldfyre, each with a katana sword accessory, a Wolf Mask Guard with a spear, and a Wolf Mask Warrior with a sword accessory.

Forest trap and shooter – This red dragon toy set includes a small forest build used to trap characters, a powerful shooter vehicle that can fire a large arrow, plus 3 small flame elements.

Measurements – 120-piece LEGO® set with a red dragon model measuring over 3.5 in. (10 cm) high, 11.5 in. (29 cm) long and 7 in. (18 cm) wide.

The front of the box shows Kai trapped in a forest build with vines! But don't worry, Source, a big red dragon, is coming to save him! These wolf warriors stand no chance against a dragon! Oh no! In the background is a powerful vehicle that can shoot large arrows! Source has gotta be careful!

The back of the box shows all the accessories that the set comes with. It comes with 4 minifigures, 2 spears, 2 swords, a dragon, 2 flames, a vehicle, a large arrow, and a forest trap.

The top of the box shows all the minifigures holding their weapons and swinging them around!

The build is 120 pieces in total and is for ages 4+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for a minifigure and the dragon.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for 2 minifigures and a trap.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for a minifigure and a vehicle.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/71815>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1 through 3, 3 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

The steps in this set correspond to page numbers.

Bag 1 - Minifigure and Dragon

Group 1 - Pages 6-9.
Group 2 - Pages 10-19.
Group 3 - Pages 20-23.
Group 4 - Pages 24-39.
Group 5 - Pages 40-65.

Bag 2 - 2 Minifigures and Trap
Group 6 - Pages 4-5.
Group 7 - Pages 6-7.
Group 8 - Pages 8-26.

Bag 3 - Minifigure and Vehicle
Group 9 - Pages 4-7.
Group 10 - Pages 8-25.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Wyldfyre Minifigure

6-7. Locate 1 dark red pair of legs with an orange karate belt, and red robe bottoms, 1 dark red sleeveless torso printed with a dark red shirt and a red robe, 1 dark tan shoulder armor, 1 yellow head printed with red eyebrows, 1 red hair, and 1 gold sword. Assemble your minifigure then put the sword in her hand! Now put your minifigure away while we build a flame!

8-9. Place 1 transparent purple 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a transparent purple 1x1 cone brick on top. Now insert a transparent orange-purple flame into the cone brick so it is horizontal, its flat side should be facing you. Put this aside while we build a dragon!

Group 2 - Dragon

10-11. Horizontally place a dark red 4x10 vehicle base with angled sides in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 brick with a hole on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically.

12-13. Place a red 2x2 brick with 1x4 angled sides to the right of the previous brick so the angled sides face the front and back and angle inwards to the left. Now horizontally place a dark red 2x3 plate on the leftmost column on top of the 2 previous bricks so there is no overhang.

14-15. Vertically place a white 1x2x2 brick to the right of the previous 2x3 plate. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the socket faces the right.

16-17. Horizontally place a red 4x6 angled sloped curved brick to the right of the previous 1x2x2 brick so it slopes to the right and is centered vertically. Then vertically place a red 2x4 plate to the left of the previous 4x6 angled sloped curved brick so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a dark red 2x4 plate with angled sides to the left so it is centered vertically and the short end faces the left.

18-19. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the front row of the previous 4x6 angled sloped curved brick so the clips face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place 2 red 1x1 clips with a 1x1 plate next to each other, to the left so they sit on the front 2 rows of the 2x4 plate and the clips face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 3 - Dragon

20-21. Place a dark blue 2x2 plate on top of the previous 1x2 plates with 2 clips so there is no overhang. Vertically place a dark blue 1x2 tile with an overhead bar on the right column of the previous 2x2 plate so the bar is sloping to the left. Then horizontally place a black 2x3 plate to the left.

22-23. Vertically place a dark blue 1x2 slope tile on the leftmost column of the previous 2x3 plate so it slopes to the right.

Group 4 - Dragon

24-25. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark red 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 2x4 plate with 2x2 studs and angled sloped curved sides on the 2 leftmost columns so the short end faces the left. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge on the leftmost column so the hinge faces the left.

26-27. Horizontally place a red 1x2 brick with a hole connected to a 1x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so the brick is on the right. Then horizontally place a dark red 2x3 sloped curved brick on top so there is no overhang and it slopes to the left. Then insert a black 2L pin into the right-facing hole.

28-29. Attach the hinge connector of a dark red 1x12 tail plate with 6 studs and angled sloped sides to the left-facing hinge so it is slightly bent up from horizontal.

30-31. Now attach the pin of your part to the left-facing hole of your main dragon build. This is the tail we just attached!

32-33. Let's make the head now! Horizontally place a dark red 4x7 bottom half of a dragon head in front of you so the studs are on the left. Now insert the pin of a dark grey pin connected to a ball with a bar into the left-facing hole on the head. Now horizontally place a red 1x1 plate with a 1x1 clip on the front left corner so there is no overhang and the clip faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

34-35. Vertically place a red 1x4 plate on the leftmost column so there is no overhang. Then place a dark tan 2x2 sloped curved tile on the center of the previous plate so it slopes to the right and does not overhang.

36-37. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud to the right of the previous sloped curved tile so the side stud faces the right. Then insert the bar of a transparent purple-orange flame into the side stud so the flame faces the right and the flat side faces front and back.

38-39. Let's make another part! Place a gold top half of a dragon head printed with red eyes, and scales in front of you so the studs and bars are on the left. Then vertically place 2 dark tan 1x2 rounded plates, 1 behind the other, on the leftmost column so there is no overhang.

Group 5 - Dragon

40-41. Place a dark tan 2x2 sloped curved tile on the center of the 2 previous plates so it slopes to the right and there is no overhang. Then insert a black fang into the front stud of the 1x2 rounded plate so it slopes down to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

42-43. Now attach the left-facing bars of your top half of the dragon head to the clips on the lower half so the head sits to the right.

44-45. Now attach the left-facing ball of your dragon head to the right-facing socket of your main build.

46-47. Let's make a leg now! Horizontally place a red 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a black 1x2 plate with 3 toes on the leftmost column so the toes overhang to the left.

48-49. Vertically place a red 2x2 plate with 1x3 angled sides to the right of the previous plate so the angled parts surround the 1x2 plate with toes. Then place another black 1x2 plate with toes to the right so the toes overhang to the right.

50-51. Horizontally place a dark red leg on a 2x4 tile on top of the 2x4 studs so the side studs face the front and the outer curve of the leg faces the right. If there is no outer curve on the right, then find the other leg. Now attach 2 red 2x2 round tiles to the front-facing sets of side studs.

52-53. Now attach the back-facing pin of your leg to the left front-facing hole of your main build.

54-55. Let's make another leg! Horizontally place a red 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a black 1x2 plate with 3 toes on the rightmost column so the toes overhang to the right.

56-57. Vertically place a red 2x2 plate with 1x3 angled sides to the left of the previous plate so the angled parts surround the 1x2 plate with toes. Then place another black 1x2 plate with toes to the left so the toes overhang to the left.

58-59. Horizontally place a dark red leg on a 2x4 tile on top of the 2x4 studs so the side studs face the front. Now attach 2 red 2x2 round tiles to the front-facing sets of side studs.

60-61. Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Now attach the back-facing pin of your leg to the right front-facing hole.

62-63. Vertically attach the bar of a red and gold wing to the front 2 top-facing clips so the 3 wing tips face the right. Make sure that there is a diagonal bar to the left of the bar you just connected to the clips. Then attach another red and gold wing to the front-facing clips that are to the left so it is orient the same way. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

64-65. Orient your dragon so the head faces the left. Now place your minifigure on top so it sits to the right of the tile with an overhead bar so she can ride it! Put everything away now while we build 2 more minifigures and a trap!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 6 - Climber Kai Minifigure

4-5. Locate 1 red pair of legs with a gold karate belt, 1 red torso with a gold and dark red robe along with a gold rope around his shoulder, 1 dark red and gold shoulder armor, 1 yellow head printed with a red and black mask, 1 red helmet, and 1 gold katana. Assemble your minifigure then put the sword in his hand!

Group 7- Wolf Mask Guard

6-7. Locate 1 dark blue pair of legs printed with a dark grey belt, 1 dark blue torso printed with a purple and dark grey robe with light blue blades on his chest, 1 dark blue head printed with a wolf mask over eyes, 1 black hood, and 1 silver spear. Assemble your minifigure then put the spear in his hand!

Group 8 - Trap

8-9. Place a light brown 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the front. Then horizontally place 2 purple 2x3 slope bricks next to each other on the back row so together they are centered and slope outwards to the left and right.

10-11. Horizontally place a black 1x4 sloped curved tile in front of the previous bricks so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a transparent purple 4x4 angled slope brick with rock formations in front so it slopes to the front.

12-13. Horizontally place a dark blue 1x2 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side in front of the previous brick so the bar faces the left.

14-15. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on top of the previous brick with a bar so the bar faces the right.

16-17. Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side behind the previous brick so the clip faces the back. Then place a dark blue 2x2 slope brick on top so it slopes to the front and there is no overhang.

18-19. Now attach the end bar of a black curved branch to the back-facing clip so the branch faces the left. Then horizontally attach the end stud of a purple leaf with 6 studs to the branch so it overhangs to the left. Make sure the stud connected with a long bar faces the left.

20-21. Horizontally place the end stud of a purple leaf with 6 studs to the right stud of the 2x2 slope brick so it overhangs to the right. Make sure the stud connected with a long bar faces the right. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes to the left onto the left stud of the 2x2 slope brick.

22-23. Let's make a part! Insert the bar hole of a black clip to the bar of a black curved branch. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.

24-25. Now attach the clip of 1 part to the right-facing bar of the 1x2 brick so the branch is upright and faces the front. Then attach the clip of your other part to the left-facing bar so the branch faces the front.

26. Now you can put a minifigure in between the branches so he gets trapped!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 9 - Wolf Mask Guard and Flame

4-5. Locate 1 dark blue pair of legs printed with a dark grey belt, 1 dark blue torso printed with a purple and dark grey robe with light blue blades on his chest, 1 dark blue head printed with a wolf mask over eyes, 1 dark blue wolf mask, and 1 dark grey and red sword. Assemble your minifigure then put the sword in his hand!

6-7. Place 1 transparent purple 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a transparent purple 1x1 cone brick on top. Now insert a transparent orange-purple flame into the cone brick so the flat side faces front and back. Put everything aside while we build a vehicle!

Group 10 - Vehicle

8-9. Vertically place a light grey 2x2 plate with small pins in front of you so the pins face the front and back. Then horizontally place a dark blue 2x8 plate on top so it overhangs 6 columns to the left.

10-11. Vertically place a black 2x2 plate with pins underneath the 2 leftmost columns so the pins face the front and back. Then horizontally place a light grey and dark grey 2x6 arrow shooter brick on top of the 6 leftmost columns so the hole faces the left.

12-13. Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs on the leftmost columns so the side studs face the left. Then place a light blue 2x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes to the right.

14-15. Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 tile with 2 studs to the right of the previous 2x2 sloped curved tile so there is no overhang.

16-17. Let's make a part! Vertically place a black 2x2 plate with angled sloped curved sides in front of you so the short end faces the right. Then place 2 transparent purple 1x1 cone bricks next to each other on the left column. Then vertically place a magenta 1x2 slope tile on the right column so it slopes to the right.

18-19. Horizontally place your part upright onto the left-facing side studs so the slope faces up.

20-21. Insert 2 small black wheels into the 2 small pins that are on the right side of the build. Then insert 2 large black wheels into the 2 pins that are on the left side of the build.

22-23. Locate a large light arrow with a black tip and horizontally insert it into the left-facing hole underneath the cone bricks so the tip faces the left.

24-25. Now you can press on the button on the right-facing side to shoot the arrow out!
