77052 K.K.'s Concert at the Plaza

Kids set up for K.K.'s concert by fetching his toy microphone from the roof of the camper vehicle, pretend to play the toy guitar or join Isabelle for group stretching. They catch up on all the news at the café with Audie, before going about her business inside the town hall, where they can get a DIY recipe card, redeem rewards at the ATM, and check the recycle box for new items. Just like in the video game, the tree conceals a surprise and Resident Service's flag is customizable. Kids can also rearrange baseplates to change the look of their LEGO Animal Crossing set.

With 3 recognizable Animal Crossing[™] characters – This brick-built playset includes K.K., Isabelle, and Audie minifigures, a model of Resident Services with a café, and a drivable camper vehicle toy.

Lots to explore – Kids imagine performing a concert, go about their business inside Resident Services, hang out at the café or open up the camper to help K.K. settle in for the night.

Customizable toy – With lots of accessories, spare tiles for the flag, and modular baseplates, kids have the creative freedom to experiment and endlessly change up the look of their playset.

Measurements – This 550-piece set includes a Resident Services building measuring over 6 in. (16 cm) high, 9 in. (24 cm) wide, and 6 in. (16 cm) deep when arranged in standard configuration.

The build is 550 pieces in total and is for ages 7+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Audie and the cafe.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for K.K., the stage, and part of the car.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the rest of the car.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for Isabelle and part of the town hall.

Bag 5 includes the pieces for the rest of the town hall.

Bag 6 includes the pieces for the bulletin board, flags, and interior.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/77052) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 6 bags labeled 1 to 6, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Audie

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 short dark orange pair of legs, 1 dark orange tail, 1 dark orange torso printed with a teal shirt with pineapples, 1 dark orange head with ears and a rounded nose printed with light blue eyes, and 1 transparent purple pair of glasses. Assemble your minifigure then attach the sunglasses to her forehead! Put her away now while we build the cafe!

Group 2 - Cafe

- 1. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.
- 2. Place a light green 6x6 rounded plate on top of the 2 right columns so it is centered vertically.
- 3. Vertically place the front 2 rows of a green 2x4 plate underneath the back 2 rows of the rounded plate so it is centered horizontally.
- 4. Place a light brown 8x8 rounded plate on the 2 leftmost columns on top of the 2x4 plate so it is centered vertically.
- 5. Let's make a part! Place a tan 4x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x4 brick on the rightmost column. Then vertically place another light yellow 1x4 brick on the 2nd column from the left.

Group 3 - Cafe

- 6. Vertically place a light green 1x4 brick on the leftmost column and 2nd column from the right.
- 7. Place a tan 4x4 plate on top.
- 8. Place a tan 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 9. Place a transparent red head on top of the previous 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a pink 1x1 round tile on top.
- 10. Vertically place a tan 1x2x2 window to the left and right of the previous 2x2 tile with a stud.
- 11. Place a pink 2x2 round tile with a stud in the front right corner so there is no overhang. Then place a white teapot on top so the spout faces the right.

Group 4 - Cafe

There are no instructions in this step!

You will have an extra 1 tan 1x1 round tile printed with white frosting and sprinkles and 1 white 1x1 ice cream top. Save them for later.

Group 5 - Cafe

- 12.1. Let's make a part! Place a pink 2x2 round plate in front of you.
- 12.2. Place a tan 1x1 round tile printed with a pie on the front left corner. Then place a brown 1x1 ice cream top behind it.
- 12.3. Place a white 1x1 ice cream top from group 4 on the front right corner. Then place a tan 1x1 round tile printed with white frosting and sprinkles from group 4 behind it. Now place your part on the front left corner of your build so there is no overhang.
- 13. Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 plate with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x4 plate on the back row so it overhangs 2 studs to the left. Now place the back row of a tan 2x2 plate with 2 side studs underneath the overhang so the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place your part on top of the 1x2x2 window frames on the back 2 rows so the side studs face the front.
- 14. Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 plate on the back row.
- 15. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile in the back right corner so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place another 1 to the left on the 2nd column from the left so it slopes to the front.

Group 6 - Cafe

- 16. Vertically place a lime green 1x2 sloped curved tile in the back left corner so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place another 1 to the right on the 2nd column from the right so it slopes to the front.
- 17.1. Place a lime green 1x1 tile with a rounded side upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so the rounded side faces down. Then place another 1 upright on the front-facing 2nd stud from the right so the rounded side faces down.

Group 7 - Cafe

- 17.2. Place a light yellow 1x1 tile with a rounded side upright on the rightmost front-facing side stud so the rounded side faces down. Then place another 1 upright on the front-facing 2nd stud from the left so the rounded side faces down.
- 18. Place your part on top of the rightmost side of the 8x8 rounded plate so the back row of the 8x8 rounded plate is free. This should not sit on the 6x6 rounded plate.

- 19. Let's make a part! Place a white 2x2 round plate on top of a light yellow 2x2 round brick so there is no overhang. Then repeat again so you have 2 parts in total. Place 1 on the back 2 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.
- 20. Place a white 2x2 round table on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.
- 21. Let's make a part! Place a tan 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 round tile with a stud on top so it is centered.
- 22. Place a brown 1x1 round plate on the back stud of the rightmost column. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now place red cherries on top so the cherries face the front.
- 23. Place a brown 1x1 ice cream top on the front stud of the leftmost column. Then place a white 1x1 teacup on the right stud of the front row so the handle faces the right. Then place 1 on the right stud of the back row so the handle faces the back. This is a tabletop!
- 24. Place your table top on the previous 2x2 round table so it is centered.
- 25. Place a white bar with an anti-stud on top of the previous 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then attach a transparent pink umbrella top to the top of the bar.
- 26.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 rotator panel in front of you the wall faces the back. Then attach the underneath bar of a white 2x2 plate to the panel so the studs face the front. Now vertically place a white 2x3 tile printed with a cafe sign with coffee and cake upright on the front-facing side studs so it overhangs to the top.
- 26.2. Horizontally place your part on the leftmost column of the 6x6 rounded plate on the 3rd row from the front so the tile faces the front.
- 27. Place a brown 2x2 round treestump brick on the back right corner of the 6x6 rounded plate so it only connects to 3 studs. Then place a dark orange 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front right corner of the 6x6 rounded plate so the leaves face the front left.

Group 8 - Cafe

- 28. Stack 2 brown 2x2 round bricks together so there is no overhang then place them on top of the tree stump brick.
- 29. Let's make a part! Horizontally place an orange 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place an orange 2x2 inverted sloped curved brick with a plate side on top of the rightmost column so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 30. Place an orange 2x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 31. Horizontally place an orange 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 32. Vertically place an orange 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

- 33. Horizontally place 2 orange 1x2 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so the walls face the back.
- 34. Place an orange 1x1 brick with a side stud on the leftmost and rightmost studs so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 panel in between so the wall faces the front.
- 35.1. Horizontally place an orange 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and covers the interior gap. Then vertically place an orange 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 35.2. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 brick on the back row. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 brick with a side stud in front so the side stud faces the front.
- 36. Place a dark orange 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the upper front-facing side stud so the leaves face the bottom right. Then repeat the same for the right front-facing stud. Now place another 1 upright on the left front-facing side stud so the leaves face down.
- 37. Horizontally place your part on top of the previous 2x2 round bricks so it is centered horizontally and the leaves face the front. Now put your build away while we build K.K.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 9 - K.K.

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 short white pair of legs, 1 white torso, 1 white dog head with ears printed with a black nose and black eyes, and 1 light brown guitar. Assemble your minifigure then attach the guitar to his hands!

Group 10 - Stage

- 38. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.
- 39. Place a light brown 8x8 rounded plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.
- 40. Repeat the previous step symmetrically to the left.
- 41.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a green 1x2 rounded plate underneath the leftmost and rightmost columns. Then vertically place a green 1x2 plate underneath the leftmost and rightmost columns. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.
- 41.2. Horizontally place 1 part on the front 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left so the leftmost column is free. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 42. Stack 2 brown 2x2 round plates together so there is no overhang, then place them on the back 2 rows on the 5th and 6th columns from the right.

- 43.1. Let's make a part! Place a light grey 1x1 round flower plate in front of you. Then insert a black bar into the stud.
- 43.2. Attach the bar hole of a black clip to the bar so the clip hands face the front left and back right.
- 43.3. Attach a black microphone to the clip so the ball faces the back left. Now place your part on the 2nd column from the right on the 4th row from the back.
- 44. Place a black 1x1 round plate on the 2nd row from the back on the 5th column from the left.
- 45.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with a hole on top.
- 45.2. Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile on top.
- 45.3. Attach the stud of a dark grey 2x2 dish to the front-facing hole. Now place your part on top of the previous 1x1 round plate so it is centered and the dish faces the front right.
- 46. Place a white 2x2 tile printed with K.K. holding a guitar on the 2 right columns of the 2x4 plate that is in the front right corner.

Group 11 - Car

- 1. Horizontally place a black 2x12 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a transparent red 1x2 plate on the leftmost column.
- 2. Vertically place a light grey 2x4 plate with 2 pins to the right of the previous 1x2 plate so it is centered vertically and the pins face the front and back. Then horizontally place a light grey 2x6 plate to the right.

Group 12 - Car

- 3. Vertically place a light grey 2x4 plate with 2 pins to the right of the previous 2x6 plate so it is centered vertically and the pins face the front and back. Then vertically place a yellow 1x2 plate on the rightmost column.
- 4. Horizontally place a black 2x12 plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 5. Horizontally place a black 2x12 plate in front of the previous 2x12 plate so it is centered horizontally.
- 6. Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick with an arch in the front left corner so it overhangs 1 row to the front and the arch faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 7. Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 plate on the front row to the right of the 2x4 brick with an arch. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 8. Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick with an arch in the front right corner so it overhangs 1 row to the front and the arch faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

9. Vertically place a yellow 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right.

Group 13 - Car

- 10. Place a light grey 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns in between the 2x4 bricks with arches. Place a light grey 2x2 plate with a ball on top so the ball faces the left. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically.
- 11. Horizontally place 2 white 1x2 plates with 2x2 side studs below the plate, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row in between the bricks with arches so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 12. Horizontally place a white 2x4 sloped curved tile on the front-facing side studs so it slopes down. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 13. Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the front row of the front 2x4 bricks with arches so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 14 - Car

- 14. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs on the front left corner so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 15. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 16. Vertically place a white 1x4 tile on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a white 1x6 tile on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 17. Vertically place a red 2x4 plate to the right of the previous 1x4 tile.
- 18. Vertically place a blue 2x4 sloped curved brick on top of the previous 2x4 plate so it slopes to the right.

Group 15 - Car

19.1. Vertically place a light orange 1x4 tile to the right of the previous 2x4 sloped curved brick.

Group 16 - Car

- 19.2. Vertically place a blue 1x4 tile to the right of the previous 1x4 tile.
- 20. Place a light orange 2x2 brick to the right of the previous 1x4 tile so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 tile in front and behind it.
- 21. Vertically place a blue 1x4 tile to the right of the pieces from the previous step so it is centered vertically.

- 22.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a light grey antenna in the back left corner. Then place a light grey 1x1 tile with a speedometer in the back right corner. Now horizontally place a light grey steering wheel on the back row so the wheel faces the back.
- 22.2. Vertically place your part to the right of the previous 1x4 tile so the steering wheel faces the left.
- 23. Stack 2 white 1x4 plates together then horizontally place them on the front row to the right of the 1x6 tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 24. Vertically place a white 2x6 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically. You will have 2 extra transparent yellow 1x1 round tiles and 1 white 1x2 tile printed with music notes. Save them for later.

Group 17 - Car

- 25.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 grill tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 jumper plate with a rounded side to the left and right so the rounded sides face the back.
- 25.2. Place a transparent yellow 1x1 round tile from group 16 on top of each of the jumper plates with a rounded side.
- 25.3. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile on the front left and front right corners. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile printed with music notes from group 16 in between them.
- 25.4. Horizontally place your part upright on the right-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and hangs down. The 1x1 round tiles should be on top.
- 26. Let's make a part! Place a black 2x2 tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a transparent red 1x1 round tile on top. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total! Place 1 part upright on the front 4 left-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 18 - Car

- 27.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x6 brick on the back row. Now horizontally place 3 white 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they slope to the front.
- 27.2. Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and slopes to the right.
- 28. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the front row to the left of the previous part so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 29. Vertically place a transparent 3x6 windshield on the rightmost column so it slopes to the right, centered vertically, and there is no overhang.

- 30. Vertically place a black 1x6 plate on top of the previous windshield.
- 31. Let's make a part! Place a white 3x3 L-shaped plate in front of you so the corner faces the back right.
- 32. Horizontally place a white 1x3 brick on the back row.
- 33. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick on the front 2 studs so it overhangs 1 stud to the front.
- 34. Vertically place a white 1x3 plate underneath the overhang.
- 35. Place a white 1x2 brick with a pin on the front 2 studs of the previous 1x3 plate so the pin faces the front. Then attach a 1x2 brick with a hole to the previous pin. This part can rotate to the right! Make sure it is vertical while we build.
- 36. Vertically place a black 1x2x2 slope brick on the back right corner so it slopes to the back. Then place a black 2x2x2 slope brick to the left so it slopes to the back and overhangs to the front.
- 37. Vertically place a black 1x4x2 panel with 3 music notes in front of the previous 1x2x2 slope brick so the wall faces the right.

Group 19 - Car

- 38. Place a black 3x3 L-shaped plate on the back right corner so the corner faces the back right. There should be no overhang.
- 39. Vertically place a transparent 1x2x2 panel on the front 2 studs of the 1x2 brick that can rotate so the wall faces the right.
- 40. Vertically place 2 black 1x2 plates connected with a hinge on the front 4 studs so the rounded part faces the right. Make sure the front part can still swing back and forth!
- 41. Horizontally place a black 1x3 tile on the back row. Then vertically place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs in front of the rightmost column.
- 42. Rotate your part 90 degrees counterclockwise so the part that can rotate faces the right. Now attach the part that can rotate on the back row to the left of the windshield.

Group 20 - Car

- 43. Let's make a part! Place a white 3x3 L-shaped plate in front of you so the corner faces the back left.
- 44. Horizontally place a white 1x3 brick on the back row. Now rotate your part so the 1x3 brick is on the left and vertical.
- 45.1. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a white 1x3 plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 plate on the leftmost stud. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2 clips to the right so the clips face the back. Then horizontally place a white 1x3 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

- 45.2. Horizontally place your part on the front row to the right of 1x3 brick so the clips face the back and it overhangs 1 column to the right.
- 46. Horizontally place a white 1x3 plate underneath the overhang.
- 47. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a hole on the 2 rightmost columns so the hole faces the right. Then insert the pin of a white 1x2 brick into the hole. This part can rotate to the front but make sure it is horizontal and faces the right for now.
- 48. Horizontally place a black 1x2x2 slope brick on the front left corner so it slopes to the left. Then place a black 2x2x2 slope brick behind it so it slopes to the left and overhangs to the right.
- 49. Horizontally place a black 1x4x2 panel with 3 music notes on the front row to the right of the 1x2x2 slope brick so the wall faces the front.

Group 21 - Car

- 50. Place a black 3x3 L-shaped plate in the front left corner so the corner faces the front left and there is no overhang.
- 51. Horizontally place a transparent 1x2x2 panel on the 2 rightmost columns on the 1x2 brick that can rotate so the wall faces the front.
- 52. Horizontally place 2 black 1x2 plates connected with a hinge on the 4 rightmost columns so the rounded part faces the front. Make sure the 2 rightmost columns can still rotate!
- 53. Vertically place a black 1x3 tile on the leftmost column. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front row to the right.
- 54. Horizontally place your part on the front row of the car so the 1x2 part that can rotate attaches to the 1x2 set of study to the left of the windshield.

Group 22 - Car

- 55. Horizontally place a black 1x3 tile on the back row to the right of the 1x4 tile with 2 studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.
- 56. Vertically place 2 black 1x2 grill tiles, 1 in front of the other, in front of the rightmost column of the 1x3 tiles in between the previous tiles.
- 57. Attach a light grey popsicle to the front-facing clip so it is vertical and the popsicle faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 58.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side in front of you so the bar faces the back. Then place a red mug on the left stud so the handle faces the front. Now place a tan 1x1 quarter tile printed with pizza to the right so the curved side faces the front left.

- 58.2. Rotate your car so it is vertical and the windshield faces the back. Now push open the right side of the car so the 2 clips on it face the front. Now attach the back-facing bar of your part to the clips.
- 59. Rotate your build so it is horizontal and the windshield faces the right. Then insert 4 white wheels into 4 black tires. Now attach them to the pins underneath the front and back arches so the grooves face outwards.

Group 23 - Car

- 60. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light orange 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x6 plate on the back row.
- 61. Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 brick on the back row.
- 62. Horizontally place 3 light orange 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they slope to the back.
- 63. Horizontally place a light orange 2x6 plate on the front row so it overhangs to the front.
- 64. Rotate your part so the 1x2 slope tiles face the left. Place a light orange 6x6 plate underneath the overhang so 5 columns are exposed to the right.
- 65. Horizontally place a light orange 2x4 plate on the front 2 rows to the right of the previous 2x6 plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 66. Horizontally place a light orange 1x4 brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light orange 1x4 brick in between the leftmost studs of the previous 1x4 bricks.
- 67. Vertically place a light orange 1x6 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically.
- 68. Vertically place a light orange 2x6 plate to the right of the 2x4 plates so it overhangs 1 column to the right. Place 3 light orange 2x2 inverted sloped curved plates with a smooth underside, 1 in front of the other, underneath the overhang so they slope to the right.
- 69. Horizontally place a light orange 1x4 brick on the front row to the right of the previous 1x4 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light orange 1x4 brick in between the rightmost studs of the previous 1x4 bricks.
- 70. Vertically place a light orange 1x6 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically.
- 71. Horizontally place a light orange 1x2 sloped curved brick with a plate side on the front right corner so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light orange 2x4 sloped curved brick with a plate side on the 2 rightmost columns in between the previous pieces so it slopes to the right.
- 72. Vertically place a light orange 1x6 tile on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

- 73. Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 tile on the front row. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row to the right of the 1x6 tile. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x2 tile to the right.
- 74. Place a light orange 6x6 plate in between the previous vertical 1x6 tiles so there is no overhang in the front or back.
- 75. Now horizontally place your part on top so it is centered vertically and overhangs 2 columns to the right.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 24 - Isabelle

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 short dark brown pair of legs printed with light yellow shoes, 1 pink and red torso printed with a sweater with leaves, 1 light orange and light yellow head printed with hair, eyes, and a mouth, and 1 light orange bow tie. Assemble your minifigure then attach the bowtie to the right side of her hair when she is facing the front.

Group 25 - Town Hall

- 1. Horizontally place a nougat 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you. Then horizontally place a nougat 1x4 tile in each of the 1x4 gaps on the back row.
- 2.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a nougat 4x8 plate with a rounded side and 2 lower 2x3 sets of studs in front of you so the rounded side faces the right. Then vertically place a nougat 1x8 plate on the 2nd column from the left so it is centered vertically.
- 2.2. Vertically place a nougat 1x2 plate in the back left corner so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now vertically place a nougat 2x4 plate in between them so it overhangs 1 column to the left.
- 2.3. Vertically place the overhang of the 2x4 plate in the 1x4 gap on the rightmost column so the rounded side of the 4x8 plate faces the right.
- 3. Repeat step 2 3 more times so you have 4 parts in total. Now vertically attach the overhang of the 2x4 plate to the 1x4 gap on the leftmost column so the rounded side faces the left. Then horizontally attach the overhang of the 2x4 plates to the gaps on the front row so the rounded side faces the front.
- 4. Place a light brown 1x1 slope tile on the back row on the 2nd stud from the right so it sits on the 1x8 plate and slopes to the back.
- 5. Vertically place 3 light brown 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 in front of the other, in front of the 1x1 slope tile so the brick grooves face the right.
- 6. Horizontally place 2 light brown 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the front stud of the front masonry brick so the brick grooves face the front.

- 7. Vertically place the front stud of a white 1x2 brick to the left of the leftmost 1x2 masonry brick.
- 8. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick in front of the previous 1x2 brick.
- 9. Horizontally place a light grey 1x8 plate to the left of the back stud of the previous white 1x2 brick.
- 10. Horizontally place a light grey 2x8 brick in front of the previous 1x8 plate. Then horizontally place a light grey 2x8 plate in front of the previous 2x8 brick.
- 11. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick to the left of the previous 2x8 plate and the front row of the 2x8 brick. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick behind it.
- 12. Repeat steps 4-6 symmetrically to the right. The left and right sides should be completely symmetrical now.
- 13. Vertically place a white 1x5 plate in front of the 1x1 slope tile in the back left. Then horizontally place 1 in front so there is no overhang. Then vertically place 1 more to the right on top of the 1x2 and 1x3 bricks so there is no overhang. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.
- 14. Place a white 1x1 round plate on the back stud of the left 1x5 plate that is on the 1x2 and 1x3 bricks. Then place a white 1x1x5 brick on top. Then place a white 1x1 round plate then a white 1x1 round tile on top. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.
- 15. Horizontally place an orange 1x6 brick in front of the left 1x1x5 brick so it sits on the 1x5 plates and there is no overhang. Then place an orange 1x1 brick behind the leftmost column of the 1x6 brick. Then vertically place an orange 1x4 behind it. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.
- 16. Stack 3 orange 1x6 bricks together so there is no overhang, then vertically place it on top of the previous bricks on the left side so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 17.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x4x3 window frame in front of you so the thinner sides face the front. Then attach 2 white window shutters with gaps to the front of the frame. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 rounded window top with spokes on top so the spokes face the back. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.
- 17.2. Horizontally place 1 part to the right of the front stud of the previous left stack of 1x6 bricks so the shutters open to the front. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 18. Stack 3 orange 1x1 bricks together then place it to the right of the left window frame. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 19. Place an orange 1x1 brick on the back stud of the left stack of 1x6 bricks. Then vertically place an orange 1x4 brick in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 20. Vertically place an orange 1x4 brick on the back 4 studs of the previous left bricks. Then place an orange 1x1 brick in front. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

- 21. Horizontally place an orange 1x6 arch brick on top of the left 1x4 rounded window with spokes so it is centered horizontally on top. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 22. Horizontally place a white 1x4x6 door frame to the left of the previous right 1x6 arch brick so the thinner sides face the front. Then attach a brown door to the front so it opens from left to the right. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate with a bar on the front-facing stud of the door so the bar faces down.
- 23. Repeat the previous step symmetrically to the left.
- 24. Horizontally place an orange 1x8 plate on top of the previous door frames. The studs of this plate should align with the arch bricks!
- 25. Place a white 1x1 tile on the front and back studs of the 1x3 plate that is in front and to the left of the doors. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 26. Place a white 1x1x6 pillar in between the previous 1x1 tiles on the left. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 26 - Town Hall

- 27. Vertically place a white 2x6 plate on top of the left 2 studs of the left 1x6 arch brick so there is no overhang in the front. It should overhang 4 studs in the back right. Now place a white 1x1 round plate with a L-shaped bar on top of the arch brick to the right so the bar faces the front. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate to the right. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.
- 28. Horizontally place a white 4x10 plate in between the previous 1x2 plates so the front left and front right corners sit on the 1x1x6 round bricks.
- 29. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a clip and a stud on the front left corner of the left 2x6 plate so the clip faces the back. Then horizontally place a white 2x6 tile to the right so it overhangs in the back right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 30. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a clip and stud to the right of the previous left 2x6 tile so the clip faces the back. Then repeat to the right. Now horizontally place a white 2x4 plate between them.

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 1):

- 31. Place a purple 2x2 slope brick on the leftmost 2x6 plate behind the 1x2 plate with a clip and stud and 2x6 tile so it slopes to the front. Then place another 1 behind it so it slopes to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 32. Horizontally place a purple 1x2 slope tile on the back left 2x2 slope brick so it slopes to the back. Then horizontally place another 1 in front of it so it slopes to the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 33. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 purple 1x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row.

- 34. Place a purple 2x2 tile on the front right corner so it overhangs 1 row to the front.
- 35. Horizontally place a white 1x8 plate with a rail underneath the overhang so the rail faces the front and 6 studs are exposed to the left.
- 36. Place 3 purple 2x2 tiles on the front 2 rows to the left of the previous 2x2 tile.
- 37. Horizontally place 4 purple 2x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so there is no overhang.
- 38. Flip your part upside down so it is horizontal and the rail faces the front. Then vertically place a white 2x3 plate with a bar underneath on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 39. Now repeat steps 33-38 so you have 2 parts in total. Horizontally attach the bars of 1 part to the 2 leftmost top-facing clips of the 1x2 plates so the tiles face the front. Make sure the rail plate faces the front! The tiles should be at an angled and slope to the front! Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 28 - Town Hall

- 40. Let's make a part! Stack 2 white 2x4 bricks together so there is no overhang then horizontally place them in front of you.
- 41. Horizontally stack 2 more white 2x4 bricks on top so there is no overhang.
- 42. Stack 2 white 1x2 plates together so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them on the back row so they are centered horizontally.
- 43. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the leftmost and rightmost columns. Then vertically place a white 1x2 plate on top of each of the previous 1x2 bricks.
- 44. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row in between the 1x2 bricks so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile on top.
- 45. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a white 2x2 plate with an arch in between them so the arch faces the front.
- 46. Attach a white 3x3 round tile printed with a Roman numeral clock on the front-facing side studs so it is centered.
- 47. Place a purple 2x2 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 48. Vertically place a purple 1x2 slope tile on the left column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 49. Horizontally place your part on the 2x4 plate in between the previous parts so the 3x3 round clock faces the front.

Group 29 - Town Hall

- 50. Horizontally place a white 1x8 rail plate in front of you so the rail faces the front. Horizontally place a white 1x4 brick on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 51. Horizontally place a white 1x3 slope brick to the left of the previous 1x4 brick so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 52. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a clip and a stud underneath the left overhang so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 53. Horizontally place a white 1x3 slope brick on the 3 leftmost studs so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 54. Place a white 1x1 slope tile on the left stud so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 55.1. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a bar in front of you so the bar faces the left. Then horizontally place a purple 1x6 tile on top so it overhangs 4 columns to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x3 plate underneath the overhang to the right of the previous 1x2 plate with a bar. There should still be a 1 column overhang to the right. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.
- 55.2. Horizontally attach the bar of 1 part to the left clip so the tile faces the left. Make sure it is slanted on the slope bricks! Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 56. Horizontally place your part on the front row of the 4x10 plate in front of your previous clock so the rail plate faces the front and it is centered horizontally.

Building Instructions (Bag 6, Book 1):

Group 30 - Bulletin Board

- 57. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.
- 58. Place a nougat 6x6 rounded plate on the 2 left columns so it is centered vertically.
- 59. Place a green 1x1 brick on the back stud of the leftmost column of the 6x6 rounded plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a green 1x6 plate on top of the 2 previous 1x1 bricks.
- 60. Stack 3 green 1x1 bricks together then place them on the rightmost stud of the previous 1x6 plate.
- 61. Horizontally place a white 1x4x3 panel printed with a light yellow wall with papers hung up to the left of the previous stack of bricks so the wall faces the front.
- 62. Stack 3 green 1x1 bricks together then place them to the left of the previous 1x4x3 panel.

- 63. Horizontally place a green 1x6 plate on top of the previous 1x1 bricks and 1x4 panel so it is centered horizontally. Then place a yellow 1x1 bird on the leftmost stud so it faces the front left.
- 64. Attach the 2 rightmost columns of the 2x4 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns of the 8x8 rounded plate of your main build so it is centered vertically.

Group 31 - Plant and Stereo

- 65. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front stud of the leftmost column of the 8x8 rounded plate that you connected the bulletin board to. Then place a green stem with 3 leaves on it. Then place a light yellow flower on top.
- 66. Horizontally place a yellow 3x4 crate on the front right corner in front of the 1x4 window frame and to the right of the 1x3 brick.
- 67. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a blue 1x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the left 2 studs so the side studs face the front.
- 68. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a hole to the right of the previous 1x2 brick with side studs so the hole faces front and back.
- 69. Horizontally place a blue 1x3 plate on top.
- 70. Insert a light grey 1L pin with a stud into the front-facing hole so the stud faces the front. Then attach a light grey 1x1 round tile printed with a meter upright on the front-facing stud of the 1L pin.
- 71. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile printed with a tape recorder on the 2 front-facing side studs.
- 72. Place a black 1x1 clip on the leftmost and rightmost studs so the clip hands face front and back.
- 73. Horizontally attach a black bar to the top-facing clips.
- 74. Horizontally place your part on the back row inside of the previous 3x4 crate so the upright tiles face the front.

Group 32 - Speakers and Flag

- 75.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on top so the clip faces the right. Then place a light grey 1x1 slope tile on the right stud so it slopes to the right. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.
- 75.2. Attach the clip of 1 part to the front-facing bar above the left window so the anti-studs of the 1x2 brick face the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 76.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white pole on a 2x2 tile in front of you. Then place the antistud of a white bar on top. Now attach a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side to the middle of the previous bar so the studs are on the right and face the front. Then place a white 2x2 sloped curved plate

with a smooth underside underneath it so it slopes to the right. There should be a front-facing 2x2 set of study now!

- 76.2. Place your part on the 2 rightmost columns on the 2x2 set of studs so it is centered vertically on the 8x8 rounded plate.
- 77.1 . Let's make a flag to attach to the pole! Place a white 4x4 plate in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 round tile printed with a green acorn in the center of the plate.
- 77.2. Then place a green 1x2 curved tile in the back left and front right corners so they surround the 2x2 round tile.
- 77.3. Place a green 1x1 quarter tile in the back right stud so the curve face the front left. Then place 1 in front in so the curve faces the back left. Then place 1 on the back row to the left of the previous quarter tile so the curve faces the front right.
- 77.4. Repeat the previous step on the front left corner of the 4x4 plate. Put this flag away now while we make another flag!

Group 33 - Flag

There are no steps in this group!

You will have 2 extra orange 1x1 quarter tiles. Save them for later.

Group 34 - Flag

There are no steps in this group!

You will have 4 extra light yellow 1x1 quarter tiles. Save them for later.

Group 35 - Flag and Interior

- 78.1. Let's make a flag! Place a white 4x4 plate in front of you. Then place a light yellow 1x1 quarter tile from group 34 in the back left corner so the curve faces the front right. Then place another 1 on the 2nd column from the left and the 2nd row from the back so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front right.
- 78.2. Place an orange 1x1 quarter tile from group 33 on the 2nd column from the left and 2nd row from the front so the curve faces the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back right corner.
- 78.3. Place a purple 1x2 curved tile in the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then place a purple 1x1 quarter tile on the front row to the right so the curve faces the back right. Then place another 1 on the leftmost column behind the 1x2 curved tile so the curve faces the back right. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the back right corner.
- 79. Attach the 2 leftmost columns of your flags to the 2x2 front-facing side stude attached to the bar so it is centered vertically. You can switch out which flag you want to hang!

- 80. Vertically place a white 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 2x4 plate on the back 2 rows so it overhangs 2 columns to the left.
- 81. Vertically place a white 2x3 plate underneath the overhang so 1 row is exposed to the front.
- 82. Horizontally place a white 1x4 brick on the front row.
- 83. Horizontally place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the previous 1x4 brick.
- 84. Place a white 2x2 corner panel on the back left corner so the corner faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 36 - Interior

- 85.1. Vertically place a yellow 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it overhangs 2 studs to the right. Then vertically place a yellow 2x3 plate underneath the overhang so 2 rows are exposed to the front. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x4 tile on the back row. Now horizontally place a 2x4 sloped curved tile printed with a question mark and different items on the front 2 rows so it slopes to the front.
- 85.2. Rotate your previous part 180 degrees so the corner panels face the front. Now horizontally place your part on top so it is centered and slopes to the front.
- 86. Rotate your Town Hall 180 degrees so it is horizontal the bulletin board is on the right. Now vertically place your part in front of the right 1x4 window so there is a 1-row gap and to the left of the wall so it slopes to the left.

Group 37 - Interior

- 87. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 brick underneath the leftmost and rightmost columns.
- 88.1. Place a green 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns.

Group 38 - Interior

- 88.2. Place a light brown 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 rightmost columns.
- 89. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile printed with an acorn on top of the left 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered horizontally on it.
- 90. Place a tan 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on the right 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a tan cone brick upside down on top of the bar. Then insert a green stem with 3 leaves. Now place a yellow flower on top.
- 91. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front in between the 1x4 tiles on the front row.

- 92. Let's make a part! Place a light grey 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a green 2x2 plate with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.
- 93. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate on the back row.
- 94. Place a green 2x2 brick on top.
- 95. Place a white 2x2 round tile printed with a green outline and a green acorn on the front-facing side studs so it hangs up. There should be no overhang.
- 96. Place a white 2x2 slope brick printed with a cash register on top so it slopes to the right.
- 97. Vertically place a white 1x2 ridged brick on top.
- 98. Place a white 2x2 tile on top so it overhangs 1 column to the right.
- 99. Place your part in front of the left 1x4 window on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it sits to the right of the wall and slopes to the right.
- 100. Rotate your Town Hall 180 degrees so it is horizontal and faces the front. Now locate your stage and horizontally place it in front of you so the 2x4 plates are in the front. You can vertically place a green 2x4 plate underneath the right 8x8 rounded plate so it is centered horizontally. Then you can attach the back 2 rows of the 2x4 plate to the front right 8x8 rounded plate of the town hall!
