

## **10788 Gabby's Dollhouse**

Gabby's Dollhouse features 8 colorful rooms connected by a sliding elevator. Each room is filled with activities. For example, kids can bake in the kitchen, use a slide in the playroom, get creative in the art room, play piano in the music room, pamper themselves in the bathroom, take a nap in the bedroom or head to the rooftop for a party on the rotatable dance floor. Kids share their adventures with 4 popular characters from the show: Gabby, Pandy Paws, Cakey, and MerCat.

8-room playhouse – Fans of the DreamWorks Animation TV show aged 4+ can explore a home of their own with LEGO® Gabby's Dollhouse (10788), featuring popular characters and authentic accessories.

4 iconic characters – Kids join in the fun with a Gabby mini-doll figure, plus Pandy Paws, MerCat, and Cakey figures.

Authentic accessories – Includes a banana, berry, cupcake, cup, bowl, bottle, scissors, paintbrush, palette, hairbrush, shampoo bottle, book, flower, microphone, guitar, saxophone, and lots more.

Loads to discover – Kids can bake in the kitchen, slide in the playroom, get arty in the art room, play instruments in the music room, relax in the bathroom, nap in the bedroom, or party on the roof.

Packed to the rooftop with fun – The dollhouse measures over 13.5 in. (34 cm) high, 12.5 in. (31 cm) wide and 3.5 in. (9 cm) deep.

The front of the box shows the dollhouse has 8 rooms! It has a slide, a seesaw, a bedroom, an art room, a kitchen, a music room, and a rooftop!

The back of the box shows all the rooms separated and all the accessories! It has 8 different rooms, an elevator, 3 minifigures, a bunch of art supplies, fruits, and musical instruments!

The top of the box shows a real-sized image of Gabby!

The build is 498 pieces in total and is for ages 4+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the kitchen.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the bathroom.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the slide and seesaw room.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for the musical room.

Bag 5 includes the pieces for the bedroom.

Bag 6 includes the pieces for the art room.

Bag 7 includes the pieces for the left rooftop.

Bag 8 includes the pieces for the right rooftop.

Bag 9 includes the pieces for the elevator.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.

- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/10788>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 9 bags labeled 1 through 9, 9 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Cupcake Figure and Cabinet

6-7. Locate a white and pink cupcake cat figure and put her in front of you!

8-9. Place a white 2x2x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Then attach a white cabinet door to the front. Then place a gold 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Now place a white 1x1 bowl on top. Put everything away while we make the kitchen!

Group 2 - Kitchen

10-11. Horizontally place a mint blue 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you.

12-13. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in each of the 2 1x4 gaps on the back row. Then vertically place a white 1x4 plate in the gap on the leftmost and rightmost columns.

14-15. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole in front. Now vertically place a white 1x3 brick in front. Then repeat all parts to the right.

16-17. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a light yellow glass pane printed with a window and hooks with tools hanging into the frame.

18-19. Horizontally place your part on the back right corner to the left of the 1x3 brick so the glass pane faces the front.

20-21. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 brick on the back row to the left of the window frame.

22-23. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2x5 brick on top of the previous 1x2 brick.

Group 3 - Kitchen

24-25. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a light yellow glass pane into the frame.

26-27. Horizontally place your part on the back row to the left of the previous 1x2x5 brick so the pane faces the front.

28-29. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2x5 brick in the back left corner so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

30-31. Horizontally place 2 white 1x8 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so there is no overhang.

32-33. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6x5 panel on the front left corner so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

34-35. Place a white 1x1 brick in the front left corner. Then vertically place 2 white 1x3 bricks, 1 behind the other, behind the previous 1x1 brick. Then repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

36-37. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 2x4 brick in front of you. Horizontally place a transparent light blue 1x2 panel in the front left corner so the wall faces the front. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 faucet in the back left corner so the faucet faces the front. Now place a pink 1x1 mug in the front right corner so the handle faces the front.

38-39. Vertically place your part on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so there is 1 free row in front. The mug should be in the front left corner!

#### Group 4 - Kitchen

40-41. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Then attach a transparent blue 2x3 cabinet door the front so it opens to the left. Then horizontally place another 2x3x2 cabinet on top so the opening faces the front. Then attach a transparent blue 2x3 cabinet door the front so it opens to the left. Now place a yellow banana in the bottom cabinet and a purple pair of grapes in the top one.

42-43. Horizontally place a teal 1x3 brick with a cat face on the front row so the face faces the front. Then place a teal 1x1 slope tile in the front left corner so it slopes to the right. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

44-45. Horizontally place your part in the back left corner of the 8x16 plate so it sits in front of the window.

46-47. Place a white 2x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back to the right of your previous part. Then place a light grey 2x2 tile with a pin on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it is centered horizontally.

48-49. Insert a white 4x4 round brick into the previous pin so it can spin freely.

50-51. Place a mint blue 1x1 cupcake wrapper on the 2nd row on the 2nd stud from the left of the previous 4x4 round brick. Then place a pink 1x1 ice cream on top.

52-53. Place a white 2x2 corner tile in the back left corner on top of the bricks so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 3 tan 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row in between the previous tiles.

54-55. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column in front of the 2x2 corner tile. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

56-57. Place your previous cabinet that has a bowl on top on top of the 2x2 plate that is to the right of the 2 cabinets stacked on top of each other.

58. Place this build aside while we build more!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 5 - Cat Mermaid

4-5. Locate 1 mint blue cat head printed with black eyes and pink, purple, and light blue scales and 1 mint blue torso printed with a purple mermaid tail. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you.

6-7. Place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick in front of you. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a web on it on top. Now place it beside while we make the bathroom!

Group 6 - Bathroom

8-9. Horizontally place a mint blue 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you.

10-11. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in each of the 2 1x4 gaps on the back row. Then vertically place a white 1x4 plate in the gap on the leftmost and rightmost columns.

12-13. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole in front. Now vertically place a white 1x3 brick in front. Then repeat all parts to the right.

14-15. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a purple glass pane in the frame.

16-17. Horizontally place your part on the back right corner to the left of the 1x3 brick so the window faces the front.

18-19. Let's make a part! Place a dark purple 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 brick on top. Now place a white 2x2 plate with a clam shell on top so the clam shell faces the front.

20-21. Place it on the back row to the left of your previous part so the clam faces the front.

22-23. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 brick on the back row on top of the 2x2 plate with the clam shell.

24-25. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud on the back row on top of the previous 1x2x2 brick so the side stud faces the front.

26-27. Horizontally place a dark purple 1x2 plate on the back row on top of the previous 1x2 brick with a side stud.

28-29. Horizontally place a purple 1x2 brick on the back row on top of the previous 1x2 plate.

Group 7 - Bathroom

30-31. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a purple glass pane printed with a hanging towel and utensils on the wall in the frame.

32-33. Horizontally place your part on the back row to the left of the previous 1x2 brick so the glass pane faces the front!

34-35. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2x5 brick in the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

36-37. Horizontally place 2 white 1x8 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so there is no overhang.

38-39. Stack 2 pink 1x2 bricks together so there is no overhang then horizontally place them in front of you. Then horizontally place a light pink 1x2 sloped curved brick with a sleeping cat face on top so it slopes to the front.

40-41. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the back on the 4th and 5th columns from the right so it slopes to the front.

42-43. Place a white 2x2 tile with a stud in front of your previous part.

44-45. Place a white 2x2 inverted dome brick on top of the previous 2x2 tile with a stud. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 faucet on top of the front row of the 2x2 plate with a clamshell so the faucet faces the front.

46-47. Place a white 2x2 tile printed with a round window and a gold cat head over it upright on the front-facing side stud above the faucet so it is centered.

48-49. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 white 1x2 tri-slope tiles on top, 1 to the right of the other, so they slope to the front.

50-51. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the back to the right of the 1x2x5 brick that is in the back left corner so it slopes to the front.

#### Group 8 - Bathroom

52-53. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of the previous 1x4 part. Then place a white 1x2 curved brick in front of the left 1x3 brick so the curve faces the front left. Then place another 1 to the right so the curve faces the front right.

54-55. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6x5 panel on the leftmost column in front of the previous 1x2x5 brick so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

56-57. Place a white 1x1 brick in the front left corner. Then vertically place 2 white 1x3 bricks, 1 behind the other, behind it. Then repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

58-59. Place a white 2x2 corner tile in the back left corner on top of the bricks so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 3 tan 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row in between the previous tiles.

60-61. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column in front of the 2x2 corner tile. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

62. Horizontally place your build on top of the kitchen build you previously made then put everything away while we build another room!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 9 - Slide and Seesaw Room

4-5. Horizontally place a mint blue 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you.

6-7. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in each of the 2 1x4 gaps on the back row. Then vertically place a white 1x4 plate in the gap on the leftmost and rightmost columns.

8-9. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole in front. Now vertically place a white 1x3 brick in front. Then repeat all parts to the right.

10-11. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a dark blue glass pane in the frame.

12-13. Horizontally place your part on the back left corner to the right of the 1x3 brick so the window faces the front.

14-17. Stack 6 dark blue 1x2 bricks together so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them on the back row to the right of the previous window frame.

Group 10 - Slide and Seesaw Room

18-19. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a dark blue glass pane printed with clouds, cat drawings, and a rainbow in the frame.

20-21. Horizontally place it on the back row to the right of the previous stack of 1x2 bricks so the glass pane faces the front.

22-23. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2x5 brick in the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

24-25. Horizontally place 2 white 1x8 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so there is no overhang.

26-27. Vertically place a mint blue 1x4 brick on the leftmost column in front of the 1x2x5 brick.

28-29. Vertically place a mint blue 1x4 brick on the leftmost column on top of your previous 1x4 brick.

30-31. Horizontally place the upper side of a yellow slide on top of the previous 1x4 brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the right.



32-33. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2x5 brick in the front left corner in front of the slide.

34-35. Place a white 1x1 brick in the front left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x6 archway behind it.

36-37. Vertically place a pink 2x4 tile to the right of the slide so there are 2 free rows in front. Then vertically place a pink 1x4 tile to the right.

38-39. Place a white 2x2 brick with a pin to the right of the front 2 rows of the previous 1x4 tile so the pin faces the front.

#### Group 11 - Slide and Seesaw Room

40-41. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate in front of you. Place a teal 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns. Then vertically place a purple 1x2 panel with a middle wall to the right so the long wall faces the right.

42-43. Place a teal 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 rightmost columns. Then vertically place a purple 1x2 panel with a middle wall to the right so the long wall faces the left. Now horizontally place a light grey 2x4 tile with a hole below it underneath your part so it is horizontally centered.

44-45. Insert the back-facing hole of your part into the front-facing pin.

46-47. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6x5 panel on the rightmost column in front of the 1x2x5 brick so the wall faces the right.

48-49. Place a white 1x1 brick in the front right corner. Then vertically place 2 white 1x3 bricks, 1 behind the other, behind the 1x1 brick.

50-51. Place a white 2x2 corner tile in the back left corner on top of the bricks so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 3 tan 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row in between the previous tiles.

52-53. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column in front of the 2x2 corner tile. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

54-55. Place an orange 2x2 crate with a cat face on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left and the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Then place a red 1x1 skate and a blue 1x1 skate in it.

56. Horizontally place your build on top of the previous 2 builds that you made, then put everything away while we build the musical room!

#### Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 4):

#### Group 12 - Piano

4-5. Horizontally place a teal 2x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a teal 1x4 brick on the back row. Then horizontally place 2 white 1x2 tiles printed with piano keys next to each other on the front row. Now place a teal 1x1 slope tile on the back left and back right corners so they slope inwards to the left and right. Now put this away while we make the musical room!

### Group 13 - Musical Room

6-7. Horizontally place a mint blue 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you.

8-9. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in each of the 2 1x4 gaps on the back row. Then vertically place a white 1x4 plate in the gap on the leftmost and rightmost columns.

10-11. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole in front. Now vertically place a white 1x3 brick in front. Then repeat all parts to the right.

12-13. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a yellowish-green glass pane into the frame.

14-15. Horizontally place your part in the back left corner to the right of the 1x3 brick so the pane faces the front.

16-17. Horizontally place a yellowish-green 1x2 brick on the back row to the right of the previous part.

18-19. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud on the back row on top of the previous 1x2 brick so the side stud faces the front.

20-21. Horizontally place a white 1x2x3 brick on the back row on top of the previous 1x2 brick.

22-23. Horizontally place a yellowish-green 1x2 brick on the back row on top of the previous 1x2x3 brick.

### Group 14 - Musical Room

24-25. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a yellowish-green glass pane printed with a disco and music notes into the frame.

26-27. Horizontally place it on the back row to the right of the previous bricks so the wall faces the front.

28-29. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2x5 brick in the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

30-31. Horizontally place 2 white 1x8 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so there is no overhang.

32-33. Let's make a part! Stack 3 brown 2x2 round ridged bricks together so there is no overhang.

34-35. Place your part in front of the glass pane on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left.

36-37. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 2x3 plate in front of you. Then place a brown 2x2 round ridged brick on the left 2 columns. Then place a light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in the front right corner so the leaves face the right. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top.

38-39. Horizontally place your part on top of the previous stack of 2x2 round ridged bricks so it overhangs to the right.

40-41. Vertically place a yellow 2x3 brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right in front of the glass pane. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick on the back row of it so it slopes to the front.

#### Group 15 - Musical Room

42-43. Vertically place an orange 2x3 brick in front of the glass pane to the left of the previous 2x3 brick. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 sloped curved brick on the back row of it so it slopes to the front.

#### Group 16 - Musical Room

44-45. Vertically place a red 2x3 brick in front of the glass pane to the left of the previous 2x3 brick. Then horizontally place a red 1x2 sloped curved brick on the back row of it so it slopes to the front.

46-47. Vertically place a pink guitar upright on the front-facing side stud to the left of the previous 2x3 brick so the guitar base is bottom.

48-49. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6x5 panel on the front left corner so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

50-51. Place a white 1x1 brick in the front left corner. Then vertically place 2 white 1x3 bricks, 1 behind the other, behind the 1x1 brick. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

52-53. Place a white 2x2 corner tile in the back left corner on top of the bricks so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 3 tan 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row in between the previous tiles.

54-55. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column in front of the 2x2 corner tile. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

56-57. Place a black 1x1 mic stand on the 2nd row from the front and the 7th column from the left. It should be in front of the leftmost stud of the raised 1x4 front row of studs. Make sure that the ridged part of the bottom faces the front. Now attach a purple mic to the clip so it faces the right.

58-59. Vertically place your previous piano part on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left in front of the 2x2 round ridged bricks so the 1x2 tiles are on the right.

60-61. Horizontally place a gold saxophone on the 2x3 bricks that are in the back right corner. It should not connect to any studs!

62. Horizontally put your build away so the opening faces the front. Do not stack it on the previous 3 builds!

#### Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 5):

#### Group 17 - Cat and Book

4-5. Horizontally place a white and black cat's body in front of you. Then place a black and white cat head with ears on top.

6-7. Vertically place a brown bottom book cover in front of you so the bar is on the right. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile printed with a cat on it. Then attach a brown book cover to the clips on the left side. Then close the book!

8-9. Put your cat and book away now while we make the bedroom!

Group 18 - Bedroom

10-11. Horizontally place a mint blue 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you.

12-13. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in each of the 2 1x4 gaps on the back row. Then vertically place a white 1x4 plate in the gap on the leftmost and rightmost columns.

14-15. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole in front. Now vertically place a white 1x3 brick in front. Then repeat all parts to the right.

16-17. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a light blue glass pane into the frame.

18-19. Horizontally place your part on the back right corner to the left of the 1x3 brick so the glass pane faces the front.

20-21. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick on the back row to the left of the previous window frame. Then vertically place a pink 2x4 brick in front.

22-23. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x2x3 brick printed with a rainbow in front of you so the rainbow faces the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick on top.

24-25. Horizontally place your part on the back row to the left of the previous window frame so the side studs face the front.

26-27. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a light blue glass pane into the frame.

28-29. Horizontally place your part on the back row to the left of the previous part so the pane faces the front.

30-31. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2x5 brick in the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

32-33. Horizontally place 2 white 1x8 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so there is no overhang.

34-35. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with 2 teeth on the 2nd row from the back on top of the 2x4 brick so the taller tooth is on the right.

36-37. Vertically place a pink 1x4 sloped curved brick to the right of the previous 1x2 tile with teeth so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

38-39. Place a purple 2x2 corner brick with a 1x1 plate part in front of the previous right 1x4 sloped curved brick and 2x4 brick so the 1x1 plate part faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

40-41. Vertically place a pink 2x4 tile in front of the 1x2 tile with teeth.

#### Group 19 - Bedroom

42-43. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Then horizontally insert a pink drawer into the bottom row. Now place a transparent yellow 1x1 cone brick in the front left corner. Then place a transparent pink 2x2 dome brick on top of the 1x1 cone brick so it is centered.

44-45. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back to the left of the 1x2x5 brick that is in the back right corner.

46-47. Stack 2 brown 2x2 round ridged bricks together so there is no overhang, then place them in front of the glass pane on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left.

48-49. Let's make a part! Place a green 3x3 quarter plate in front of you so the curve faces the front right corner. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 panel on the back left corner so the wall faces the front. Then place a light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in front of the right column of the previous 1x2 panel so the leaves face the front. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top.

50-51. Place your part on top of the previous stack of 2x2 round ridged bricks so the curved side overhangs in the front right corner.

52-53. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6x5 panel on the front left corner so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

54-55. Place a white 1x1 brick in the front left corner. Then vertically place 2 white 1x3 bricks, 1 behind the other, behind the previous 1x1 brick. Then repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

56-57. Place a white 2x2 corner tile in the back left corner on top of the bricks so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 3 tan 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row in between the previous tiles.

58-59. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column in front of the 2x2 corner tile. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

60-61. Horizontally place a white cloud plate with 3 studs upright on the front-facing side studs above the tile with 2 teeth so it is centered. Then locate the brown book you previously made and place it in the back left corner behind the 1x2 panel.

62-63. Place a light orange brush in the back right corner on top of the cabinet. It should not connect to any studs!

64. Horizontally place your build on top of the previous build then put everything away while we make another build!

Building Instructions (Bag 6, Book 6):

Group 20 - Gabby

4-5. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with blue pants and white and pink shoes, 1 torso printed with a dark grey and white shirt with a pink jacket over it, 1 tan head printed with eyes and a nose, 1 brown hair, and 1 pink and white cat ears. Assemble your minifigure then put the cat ears on top of her hair!

6-7. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 tile with an overhead bar in front of you so the bar is in the back. Then vertically attach the clips of a white 2x3 tile printed with a drawing of a cat to the bar so the tile is upright and faces the front. Now put everything away while we make the art room!

Group 21 - Art Room

8-9. Horizontally place a mint blue 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you.

10-11. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in each of the 2 1x4 gaps on the back row. Then vertically place a white 1x4 plate in the gap on the leftmost and rightmost columns.

12-13. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole in front. Now vertically place a white 1x3 brick in front. Then repeat all parts to the right.

14-15. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a white glass pane printed with purple, green, and blue containers of paint, paint splatters, ribbon running across the top, and different wrapping paper into the frame.

16-17. Horizontally place your part in the back right corner to the left of the 1x3 brick so the pane faces the front.

18-19. Horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 brick on the back row to the left of the previous window frame.

20-21. Horizontally place a white 1x2x5 brick on the back row on top of the previous 1x2 brick.

Group 22 - Art Room

22-23. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 frame in front of you. Then insert a white glass pane into the frame.

24-25. Horizontally place your part on the back row to the left of the previous brick so the pane faces the front.

26-27. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2x5 brick in the back left corner so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

28-29. Horizontally place 2 white 1x8 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so there is no overhang.

30-31. Horizontally place a purple 1x6 brick on the 2nd row from the back to the left of the 1x2x5 brick that is in the back right corner.

You will have 1 extra transparent lime green 1x1 cone brick and 1 transparent lime green 1x1 round tile with a bar. Save them for later.

#### Group 23 - Art Room

32-33. Place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick on the 3rd stud from the left of the previous 1x6 brick. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top. Then place a transparent green 1x1 cone brick to the right. Now place a transparent lime green 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top.

34-35. Let's make a part! Horizontally stack 2 white 2x3x2 cabinets on top of each other so there is no overhang then place it in front of you so the openings face the front. Now insert a pink drawer into the bottom row of each of the cabinets! Then place a brown paint brush with a green tip inside the bottom drawer!

36-37. Place a light orange 2x2 crate with a cat face on top of the left 2 columns. Then place a light grey pair of scissors in the top drawer!

38-39. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back to the right of the 1x2x5 brick that is in the back left corner.

40-41. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6x5 panel on the front left corner so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

42-43. Place a white 1x1 brick in the front left corner. Then vertically place 2 white 1x3 bricks, 1 behind the other, behind the previous 1x1 brick. Then repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

44-45. Place a white 2x2 corner tile in the back left corner on top of the bricks so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 3 tan 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row in between the previous tiles.

46-47. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column in front of the 2x2 corner tile. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

48-49. Place a teal 2x2 round brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front behind the right 1x4 gap on the front row so it is centered horizontally behind it. Then place a gold 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so there are 4 free columns in between this and the previous round brick.

50-51. Place a brown painting palette on top of the previous 2x2 round brick so it is centered and slants towards the back right.

52-53. Horizontally place the previous upright 2x3 tile attached to a 1x2 tile with an overhead bar on top of the previous 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered horizontally and the tile side faces the front.

54. Horizontally place your build on top of the previous build then put everything away while we make a rooftop!

Building Instructions (Bag 7, Book 7):

Group 24 - Flower

There are no steps in this group! You will have an extra pink 1x1 round flower plate. Save it for later!

Group 25 - Flower

4-5. Place a teal 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then place a blue 1x1 cone brick on top. Now place a light green 1x1 round flower plate on top. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate from group 24 on top! Now put it aside while we make the rooftop!

Group 26 - Rooftop

6-7. Horizontally place a magenta 8x16 plate in front of you.

8-9. Horizontally place a pink 1x2x5 brick on the front right corner. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left.

10-11. Horizontally place a pink 1x6x5 panel printed with a blue circle with a smaller white circle in the middle on the front row to the left of the previous 1x2x5 bricks so the print faces the front.

12-13. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on the front row to the left of the previous 1x6x5 brick. Then place a pink 1x2 plate to the left.

14-15. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on top of the previous 1x4 brick. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2x2 brick with 4 side studs to the left so the side studs face the front.

16-17. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the right.

18-19. Horizontally place a pink 1x4x3 sloped curved brick in the front left corner so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2x2 brick with a rounded extended part to the right so the rounded part faces the back.

20-21. Place a pink 1x1 brick in the front right corner. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the left.

22-23. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on the front row to the left of the previous 1x2 brick. Then horizontally place a pink 1x6 sloped curved brick to the left so it slopes to the left.

24-25. Place a pink 1x1 round tile on each of the front-facing studs on the right column.

26-27. Horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded tile on the lower front-facing side stud so it overhangs to the left and slightly angled down. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded tile on the upper front-facing side stud so it overhangs to the left and slightly angled up.



#### Group 27 - Bed

28-29. Let's make a bed! Horizontally place a white 2x6 brick in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 tile to the left. Now horizontally place a purple 2x4 tile to the left.

30-31. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so all the pieces are on the back row. Now vertically place your part in front of the bricks on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the 1x2 sloped curved brick is in the back.

#### Group 28 - Bed

32-33. Let's make a bed! Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 tile to the left. Now place a light blue 2x2 tile to the left.

34-35. Vertically place your bed to the right of the previous bed in front of the panel so there is 1 free column in between this and the previous bed. Make sure the 1x2 sloped curved brick is in the back!

#### Group 29 - Bed

36-37. Let's make a bed! Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 tile to the left. Now place a pink 2x2 tile to the left.

38-39. Vertically place your bed to the right of the previous bed in front of the panel so there is 1 free column in between this and the previous bed. Make sure the 1x2 sloped curved brick is in the back!

#### Group 30 - Bed

40-41. Let's make a bed! Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a dark pink 1x2 tile to the left. Now place a light blue 2x2 tile to the left.

42-43. Horizontally place your bed on the 2nd and 3rd row from the front on the rightmost column so the 1x2 sloped curved brick is on the right.

44-45. Place a light blue baby bottle on the 4th row from the front and 6th column from the right so the handle faces the right.

46-47. Place the flower part you previously made and place it on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back and the 5th and 6th columns from the right.

48-49. Locate a cat ear shaped film printed with a purple ear with white dots and insert it into the front-facing extended rounded part of the 1x2x2 brick so the print faces the back. Make sure the curved side faces up.

50. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the open side faces the back and horizontally place it on top of the first stack of 3 buildings you made! It should be the rooms you made from bags 1-3!

## Building Instructions (Bag 8, Book 8):

### Group 31 - Balloon

4-5. Place a red 2x2 inverted dome brick in front of you. Then place a red 2x2 dome brick on top. Now insert the bar part of a white bar with an anti stud into the bottom of the inverted dome brick. Now put this aside while we make the right rooftop!

### Group 32 - Right Rooftop

6-7. Horizontally place a purple 8x16 plate in front of you.

8-9. Horizontally place a pink 1x2x5 brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right.

10-11. Horizontally place a pink 1x6x5 panel printed with a blue circle with a smaller white circle in the middle on the front row to the right of the previous 1x2x5 bricks so the print faces the front.

12-13. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on the front row to the right of the previous 1x6x5 brick. Then place a pink 1x2 plate to the right.

14-15. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on top of the previous 1x4 brick. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2x2 brick with 4 side studs to the right so the side studs face the front.

16-17. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the left.

18-19. Horizontally place a pink 1x4x3 sloped curved brick in the front right corner so it slopes to the right. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2x2 brick with a rounded extended part to the left so the rounded part faces the back.

20-21. Place a pink 1x1 brick in the front left corner. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the right.

22-23. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on the front row to the right of the previous 1x2 brick. Then horizontally place a pink 1x6 sloped curved brick to the right so it slopes to the right.

24-25. Place a pink 1x1 round tile on each of the front-facing studs on the left column.

26-27. Horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded tile on the lower front-facing side stud so it overhangs to the right and slightly angled down. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded tile on the upper front-facing side stud so it overhangs to the right and slightly angled up.

### Group 33 - Right Rooftop

28-29. Rotate your build 180 degrees so it is horizontal and the bricks are on the back row. Now horizontally place a purple 1x2 tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light grey 2x2 tile with a pin behind it.

30-31. Place a light yellow 4x4 round brick on top of the pin so it is centered on it.

You will have 2 extra pink 1x2 plates. Save them for later.

#### Group 34 - Right Rooftop

32-33. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate from group 33 in front of you. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate on top. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front.

34-35. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate on top. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front.

You will have 2 extra transparent blue 1x1 cone bricks. Save them for later.

#### Group 35 - Right Rooftop

36-37. Place a dark grey 1x1 round tile upright on the upper front-facing side stud. Then place a dark grey 2x2 round tile with a hole on the lower front-facing side stud so it is centered. Now place a transparent yellow 1x1 cone brick on the left stud. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick from group 34 on the right stud.

38-39. Now you should have 2 of these parts in total! Horizontally place 1 on the 2nd row from the back on the 2 leftmost columns so the upright tiles face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

40-41. Let's make a balloon! Place a lime green 2x2 inverted dome brick in front of you. Then place a lime green 2x2 dome brick on top. Now insert the bar part of a white bar with an anti stud into the bottom of the inverted dome brick.

42-43. Place your lime green balloon on the 3rd row from the back on the 4th column from the left.

44-45. Now locate your red balloon that you previously made and place it on the 3rd row from the back and 4th column from the right.

46-47. Locate 1 cat-ear shaped film printed with a purple window and black top and vertically place it on the front-facing extended rounded part behind the left balloon so the film faces the back. Make sure the rounded top faces up.

48. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the open side faces the back, then horizontally place it on the second stack of 3 buildings that you made! This is the right side of the building! Now lets make the elevator to put in between the 2 sets of buildings!

#### Building Instructions (Bag 9, Book 9):

#### Group 36 - Elevator

4-5. Vertically place a light purple 6x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 2x6 tile on the back row. Now horizontally place a white 2x6 plate in front.

6-7. Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick on top of the 2x6 plate so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole to the left and right. Now insert a yellow 2L pin into the right-facing and left-facing hole.

8-9. Horizontally place a tan 2x6 brick on top of the bricks from the previous step so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place 2 pink 2x3 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top so there is no overhang.

10-11. Horizontally place a tan 2x6 brick on top of the previous bricks so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light blue 2x2x13 support with 5 pin holes on top of the 2 leftmost columns of the previous 2x6 brick so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

12-13. Now horizontally place a light blue 2x2x13 support with 5 pinholes in between the previous supports so the wall faces the back.

14-15. Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate on top of the previous supports.

16-17. Insert a yellow 2L pin into the top right-facing pinhole. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

18-19. Horizontally place 2 pink 2x3 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the previous 2x6 plate so there is no overhang.

20-21. Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate on top of the previous bricks so it is centered horizontally.

22-23. Horizontally place 2 pink 2x3 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the previous 2x6 plate so there is no overhang.

24-25. Horizontally place a tan 2x6 brick on top of the previous bricks so it is centered horizontally.

#### Group 37 - Elevator

26-27. Place a light grey 2x2x3 brick on the 2 leftmost columns of the previous 2x6 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

28-29. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 3x6x6 door frame in front of you so the door frame faces the front. Now insert a purple glass panel into the front-facing door frame. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.

30-31. Horizontally place 1 part in front of the previous bricks on the 6x10 plate so the glass pane faces the back. Then horizontally place another 1 on top so the glass pane faces the back.

32-33. Horizontally place a pink 3x4 plate with a 2x4x5 brick with a cat face in between the previous 3x6x6 door frame so the plate part faces the front. Make sure the rounded parts on the left and right sides of the 2x4x5 brick part sits in the gaps of the frame. Make sure it can slide up and down!

34-35. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 3x6x6 door frame in front of you so the door frame faces the front. Now insert a purple glass panel into the front-facing door frame. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.

36-37. Horizontally place 1 part in front of the previous supports on top of the 3x6x6 door frame so the glass pane faces the back. Then horizontally place another 1 on top so the glass pane faces the back.

38-39. Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate on top of the back row of the previous door frame so it attaches to the 2x2x3 bricks.

40-41. Place a light grey 2x2 sloped curved tile on the back left corner of the previous 2x6 plate so it slopes to the back onto the 2x2x3 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

42-43. Horizontally place a pink 1x6 plate on top of the 3x6x6 door frame in front of the previous 2x6 plate.

44-45. Horizontally place a pink 1x6x5 panel printed with a blue and red heart on top of the door frame in front of the 1x6 plate so the wall faces the front.

46-47. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on top of the left 4 columns of the previous 1x6x5 panel. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the right.

48-49. Vertically place your part in between each set of buildings so the 3x4 plate part of the elevator faces the front. Now attach the pins to the left and right sets of buildings!
