

21248 The Pumpkin Farm

Adapted by John Le and tested by Jolene Nemeth.

Set in the game's infamous swamp biome, this highly reconfigurable toy features leading character Steve at a pumpkin farm built around a pumpkin-shaped house. The house has a furnished interior, including a bed, crafting table, furnace, and a frog light. Outside is a pumpkin patch that Steve cultivates with his hoe. Play opportunities shift to battle action when a witch throws potions at Steve and he fends her off using his bow. The set also includes a frog, boat, and a chest containing an egg and sugar, giving kids the opportunity to make pumpkin pie!

Minecraft® pumpkins and potions – LEGO® Minecraft The Pumpkin Farm (21248) features an action-packed pumpkin patch located in the game's swamp biome.

Authentic action – The set features familiar Minecraft® character Steve, plus a witch, a frog with frogspawn and lots of accessories, including a boat, treasure chest and a carved pumpkin.

Many ways to play – Kids can build a pumpkin-shaped house, tend a pumpkin patch, battle a potion-flinging witch, sail a boat and combine ingredients to make pumpkin pie.

Endlessly reconfigurable – The playset measures over 4 in. (11 cm) high, 10.5 in. (27 cm) wide and 5.5 in. (14 cm) deep and combines with other sets (sold separately) in the LEGO® Minecraft® range.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Steve, accessories, and the pumpkin farm!

Bag 2 includes the pieces for a witch and the swamp.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the pumpkin farm!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.

- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/PPP: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/21248>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1, 2, and 3, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 16 - Steps 25-28 and 1 light grey 2x4 tile from Step 29.

Group 18 - Steps 32-36 and 3 dark grey 1x4 plates from Step 37.

Group 19 - Rest of Step 37 and Steps 38-44.

Group 20 - Steps 45-50.

Group 21 - Steps 51-52.

Group 22 - Steps 53-57.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Steve

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 purple pair of legs, 1 light blue torso, 1 square head printed with a light tan face, brown hair, and white and black eyes, 1 silver garden hoe, and 1 light purple bow and arrow. Assemble your minifigure then you can choose which item to put in his hands! Put this away while we make accessories!

You will have an extra light brown 2x2 tile with a stud and a transparent 2x2 brick. Save them for later.

Group 2 - Lamp and Bed

Sub-build 2.1. Place a light brown 2x2 brick in front of you. Then place a light brown 2x2 tile with a stud from group 1 on top.

Sub-build 2.2. Place a transparent purple 2x2 tile with a stud on top so there is no overhang. Then place a transparent 2x2 brick from group 1 on top, then another transparent purple 2x2 tile with a stud. Put this aside while we make a bed!

Sub-build 3.1. Horizontally place a brown 2x6 plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 round plate underneath the 2 leftmost and 2 rightmost columns.

Sub-build 3.2. Stack 2 teal 2x4 plates together so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them on the 4 left columns.

Sub-build 3.3. Place a white 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns. Then place a white 2x2 tile on top. Put this away while we make more!

Group 3 - Crafting Table

Sub-build 4.1. Place a black 2x2 round plate in front of you. Horizontally place 2 light brown 1x2 bricks printed with 2 horizontal light brown lines and 1 vertical brown line, 1 in front of the other, on top so the print sides face outwards.

Sub-build 4.2. Place a light brown 2x2 tile printed with a brown grid on top. This is a crafting table! Put this away so we can make a furnace!

Group 4 - Furnace

Sub-build 5.1. Place a black 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick with a furnace fire print on the back row so the print faces the back.

Sub-build 5.2. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick with a furnace on the front row so the print faces the front.

Sub-build 5.3. Place a dark grey 2x2 tile with a stud on top.

Sub-build 5.4. Place a dark grey 2x2 round plate on top so it is centered. Then place a dark grey 2x2 round tile printed with lava on top. Put this away while we make a boat!

Group 5 - Boat

Sub-build 6.1. Vertically place a dark red 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place another 1 on the left column so it overhangs to the left.

Sub-build 6.2. Vertically place a dark red 2x4 plate underneath the overhang so 1 column is exposed to the left.

Sub-build 6.3. Vertically place 2 dark red 1x2 plates with 2 side studs above the plate, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so the side studs face the left. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

Sub-build 6.4. Horizontally place a dark red 1x4 plate on the front row. Then horizontally place a dark red 1x4 tile with 2 studs on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Sub-build 6.5. Horizontally place a dark red 1x4 tile upright on the left-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

Sub-build 6.6. Flip your boat upside down so the upright tiles face left and right. Now place a transparent blue 2x2 round plate with a smooth underside on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

Sub-build 6.7. Flip your boat so it is upright and the upright tiles face the front and back. Then place 2 dark red paddles in the boat! Now put this away while we make a chest with an egg!

Group 6 - Chest

Sub-build 7.1. Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 chest bottom in front of you so the lower lip faces the back. Then attach a light brown 2x4 chest top to the back of the chest.

Sub-build 7.2. Place a white egg and a white 1x1 round plate inside, then close it.

Group 7 - Pumpkin Farm

1. Horizontally place a blue 6x10 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a dark grey 2x4 brick in the back right corner.

2. Vertically place 3 white 2x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the previous 2x4 brick.

3.1. Place a transparent blue 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows of the rightmost 2x4 plate. Then place another 1 on the back 2 rows of the middle 2x4 plate.

Group 8 - Pumpkin Farm

3.2. Place 4 brown 2x2 tiles with a stud on top of the previous 2x4 plates so there are no more free studs from the 2x4 plates

4. Horizontally place a dark grey 2x4 brick on the front right corner. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left. Now vertically place a dark grey 2x4 brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place another 1 behind it so it overhangs 2 columns to the left.

Group 9 - Pumpkin Farm

5. Place a dark grey 2x2 tile with a stud on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now place another 1 on the front left corner. Then place another 1 on the right 2 columns of the 2x4 brick that is on the back left corner.

6. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front left 2x2 tile with a stud of the 2x3 grid of 2x2 tiles with a stud. Then place another on the back row on the 2nd 2x2 tile with a stud from the right. Now insert a green stem into each of them.

7. Place an orange square-shaped head behind the leftmost stem. Then place another 1 to the right. They should sit on the 2x2 tile with a stud!

You will have 2 extra transparent orange 1x1 plates. Save them for later!

Group 10 - Pumpkin Farm

8. Place a dark brown 1x1 telescope bar on the back left and back right 2x2 tiles with a stud. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 plate on top of each of the telescope bars. Now place a transparent orange 1x1 plate from group 9 on top of each of them. Put this build away for now while we make a witch!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 11 - Witch

Sub-build 8. Locate 1 short brown pair of legs, 1 long purple torso with a vertical teal stripe, 1 dark tan square-shaped head printed with eyes and a red nose, 1 witch hat, and 1 light grey frog. Assemble your minifigure then put the frog by her side! Now put this away while we make a swamp!

Group 12 - Swamp

9. Horizontally place a blue 6x10 plate in front of you. Then place a brown 2x2 brick in the back right corner.

10. Vertically place a brown 2x4 brick on the front right corner so it overhangs 2 rows to the front. Now place a brown 2x2 brick to the left so it sits on the front 2 rows of the 6x10 plate.

11.1. Place a dark green 2x2 tile with a stud in the back left corner. Then vertically place a brown 2x4 brick to the right.

11.2. Place a green 1x1 tile with a rounded side in the front left corner so the rounded side faces the front. Then place another 1 to the right so the rounded side faces the front. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate with a rounded side behind them so the rounded side faces the back.

12. Place a brown 2x2 brick in the back right corner. Then place another 1 on the back 2 rows of the 2x4 brick that is on the front right corner.

13.1. Place a dark green 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows to the left of the 2x2 brick that is on the 2x4 brick in the front right corner.

You will have an extra dark green 2x2 tile with a stud. Save it for later.

Group 13 - Swamp

13.2. Place a green 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows of the 2x4 brick that is on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left.

14. Vertically place a brown 2x6 plate on the 2 rightmost columns on top of the 2 2x2 bricks so the only overhang is in the middle.

15. Vertically place a brown 2x4 brick in the back right corner. Then place a dark green 2x2 tile with a stud from group 12 in front. Now place a green 2x2 tile with a stud in front on the overhang of the 2x4 brick.

16. Stack 2 brown 2x2 bricks together so there is no overhang then place them on the back 2 rows on top of the 2x4 brick that is on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Now place a brown 2x2 plate on top.

17. Horizontally place a brown 2x8 plate on the back right corner on top of the 2x4 brick and 2x2 plate so there is only overhang in between. Now place a green 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 rightmost columns in front of the 2x8 plate.

Group 14 - Swamp

18. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 brick in the back right corner on top of the 2x8 plate. Then place a brown 2x2 brick to the left. Now place a dark green 2x2 tile with a stud to the left.

19. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate on the back row on top of the 2x2 brick from the previous step. Then place a green 1x2 plate with 2 clips in front so the clips face the front.

20.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side in front of you so the bar faces the back.

20.2. Place a green 2x2 corner plate on top so it overhangs to the front and looks like the braille letter d.

20.3. Place a dark green 1x1 tile on the back right corner. Now attach the bar of your part to the 2 front-facing clips so your part hangs down and the 1x1 tile faces the front.

21.1. Let's make a part! Place a green 6x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a dark green 2x6 brick on the 2 rightmost columns.

21.2. Vertically place 2 more dark green 2x6 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the 6x6 plate so there are no more exposed studs of the 6x6 plate.

21.3. Vertically place 2 dark green 2x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the part so they are centered. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the clips face the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the clips face the left.

21.4. Flip your build upside down so the clips face the front and left. Then stack 2 brown 2x2 bricks together so there is no overhang, then place it on the center of the 6x6 plate.

21.5. Stack 2 more brown 2x2 bricks on top of the previous 2x2 bricks so there is no overhang.

21.6. Flip your part so it is upright then place your part on the back right corner on top of the 2x4 brick. This is a tree!

22.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side in front of you so the bar faces the right.

22.2. Place a green 2x2 corner plate on top so it overhangs to the left and looks like the braille letter d. Now place a dark green 1x1 tile on the leftmost stud.

22.3. Attach the bar of your part to the left-facing clips that are on top of the tree!

Group 15 - Swamp

23.1. Place a green plant with 3 stems on the front right 2x2 tile with a stud that is on top of the 2x4 brick that overhangs. Now place a mint blue 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the stems.

23.2. Place an orange square head printed with a brown jack o'lantern face on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the back row and the 2nd one from the left so the print faces the front.

23.3. Place a transparent purple head on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is in front of the square head from the previous step. Now place a transparent 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top.

24.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side in front of you so the bar faces the right. Then place a green 2x2 corner plate on top so it overhangs to the left and looks like the braille letter d.

24.2. Place a green 2x2 corner plate underneath the overhang so it looks like the braille letter f and 2 studs are exposed to the left.

24.3. Place a green 2x2 corner plate on top so it overhangs to the left and looks like the braille letter j.

24.4. Place a green 2x2 corner plate underneath the overhang so it looks like the braille letter h and 2 studs are exposed to the left.

24.5. Place a green 2x2 corner plate on top so it overhangs to the left and looks like the braille letter d.

24.6. Place a dark green 1x1 tile on the front row on top of the middle stud of the 1x3 set of studs. Then do the same for the back row.

24.7. Vertically attach the bar of your part to the front-facing clips that are on top of the tree so it hangs down.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 16 - Pumpkin House

25. Vertically place a blue 4x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 light green 2x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so they are centered horizontally. They should overhang to the left and right!

26. Vertically place the back right corner of a blue 6x10 plate underneath the left overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

27. Place a light green 2x2 plate on the back 2 rows to the left and right of the 2x4 plates. Then horizontally place 2 light green 2x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the previous 2x4 plates so they are centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a light green 2x4 plate in front so it is centered horizontally.

28. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Then place an orange 2x2 brick in front. Now place another 1 on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left in front of the 2x2 plate. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

29.1. Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 tile on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally.

Group 17 - Pumpkin House

29.2. Horizontally place a green 2x4 tile on the front 2 rows so there are 4 free columns to the left. Then place a brown 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so there are 4 free rows in front. Then place a dark green 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the 2x2 brick that is on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left.

30. Place a green 1x1 tile with a rounded side on the front row on the 3rd and 4th studs from the right so the rounded sides face the front. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate with a rounded side behind them so the rounded side faces the back. Now place a transparent 1x1 round tile with black dots on the front row on the 6th column from the right. Then place another 1 on the 2nd row from the front on the 5th column from the right.

31. Place an orange 2x2 brick in the back left corner. Then horizontally place an orange 2x4 brick in front so it overhangs 2 studs in the front left corner. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Group 18 - Pumpkin House

32. Place an orange 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 right columns of the left 2x4 brick from the previous step. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

33. Stack 2 orange 2x2 bricks together so there is no overhang, then place them to the left of the 2x4 plate that is on the 5th and 6th rows from the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

34. Place 2 orange 1x1 bricks with a side stud and a bottom lip, 1 in front of the other, on the right column of the previous left stack of 2x2 bricks so the side studs face the right. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 tile upright on the right-facing side studs.

35. Place a brown 1x1 round plate on the back 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Then place a light brown 1x1 brick on top. Now place another brown 1x1 round plate on top. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

36. Vertically place an orange 1x2 brick on top of the left column of the stack of 2x2 bricks that are to the left of the 2x4 plate on the 5th and 6th rows from the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

You will have 3 extra dark grey 1x4 plates. Save them for later!

Group 19 - Pumpkin House

37.1. Let's make a door! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 plate from group 18 in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x4 log brick on top.

37.2. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 plate from group 18 on top.

37.3. Place a brown 1x1 brick with a side stud on the leftmost stud so the side stud faces the front. Then place a light grey 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud. Then place a brown 1x1 brick to the right. Now horizontally place a brown 1x2 brick with a downward facing pin to the right so the pin is in the back right corner. Then attach a dark grey 1x2 brick with a pinhole to the pin. This brick should overhang!

37.4. Stack 2 brown 1x4 plates together so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them on top. Now horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 plate from group 18 on top.

37.5. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 log brick on top. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 tile on top.

37.6. Vertically place the 1x2 brick overhang of your part on top of the left column of the right 2x2 stack of bricks that are on the 5th and 6th rows from the front. Your door should be on the left and open to the front!

38. Place an orange 2x2 brick on top of the previous 1x2 brick overhang of your door and 1x2 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

39. Stack 2 orange 2x4 bricks together so there is no overhang, then vertically place them in the back left corner. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

40. Place an orange 2x2 brick in the back left corner. Then horizontally place an orange 2x4 brick in front so it sits on the 2x2 brick and 1x1 round plate. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

41. Vertically place 2 orange 1x3 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2x2 brick that is to the left of the door so they overhang 1 row to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

42. Horizontally place 2 orange 1x3 bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the back left corner so they overhang 1 column to the right. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 plate on the rightmost column of these bricks. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

43. Horizontally place an orange 2x4 plate on the 2x4 brick that is on the leftmost column in front of the pieces from the previous step so there is no overhang. Then vertically place another 1 on the 2 1x3 bricks that are to the right so it overhangs 1 row to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

44. Horizontally place an orange 2x4 brick on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back on top of the previous 2x4 plates so there are 2 free columns to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 20 - Pumpkin House

45. Vertically place an orange 1x2 plate to the left of the previous 2x4 brick that is on the left. Then vertically place an orange 1x2 tile on top. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

46. Vertically place an orange 1x4 tile on the back 4 rows and 3rd column from the left. Then place an orange 2x2 tile with a stud to the right of the front 2 rows of the 1x4 tile. Then vertically place an orange 1x2 tile to the right. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

47. Vertically place an orange 1x2 brick on the back 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

48. Horizontally place an orange 2x6 brick behind the door so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place an orange 2x4 brick on top so it is also centered horizontally.

49. Let's make a part! Horizontally place an orange 2x12 plate in front of you. Then vertically place an orange 1x3 brick on the 2nd column from the left so it overhangs 1 row to the back. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

50. Horizontally place an orange 2x12 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally.

Group 21 - Pumpkin House

51. Vertically place an orange 1x3 brick to the right of the left 1x3 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a brown 2x2 brick on the front 2 rows on the 5th and 6th columns from the left. Then vertically place a brown 2x4 brick to the right so there is no overhang.

52. Place a brown 2x2 brick on the front 2 rows of the 2x4 brick.

Group 22 - Pumpkin House

53.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a green 2x4 brick on the 4 left columns.

53.2. Place a green 2x2 brick on the 2 leftmost columns. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 plate on the 2nd column from the right.

53.3. Vertically place a brown 1x2 brick on the rightmost column.

53.4. Horizontally place your part on the front 2 rows on top of the upper 2x2 brick so it is centered horizontally on it.

54. Bring back your main build and orient it so it is horizontal and the door faces the back. Now horizontally place your part on top of the 2x2 tiles with a stud so the leftmost and rightmost columns of your part rest on the 1x4 tiles. The previous part you placed in the last step should face the front!

55. Locate your previous crafting table and place it inside the pumpkin house on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so it sits to the right of the 1x1 brick that is on top of a 2x2 tile with a stud. Now repeat symmetrically to the right with the furnace you previously made. Make sure the prints of both parts face the front!

56. Horizontally place the 2x6 bed you previously made on the front 2 rows to the right of the bricks that are on the leftmost column so the tile faces the left. Then place the lamp you previously made to the right so it sits against the bricks that are on the rightmost column.

57. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so the pumpkin faces the front and bring back your swamp build! Orient your swamp build so it is vertical and the tree is in the back left corner. Now attach the right-facing overhang of your swamp to the front left corner of the pumpkin house build. Now locate your pumpkin farm and orient it so it is horizontal and the overhang faces the left. Now attach the overhang of your part to the right side of the pumpkin house build on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front.
