

41728 Heartlake Downtown Diner

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Kids aged 6 and up can role-play lots of restaurant stories with this LEGO® Friends Heartlake Downtown Diner (41728) building toy set. With lots of accessories to inspire creative play, they can pretend to make sandwiches or imagine being a customer at the diner. Features include a drive-through, outdoor seating, plus an arcade game and a moving jukebox. Kids can use the salad ingredients in the fridge to customize sandwiches. Other accessories include 2 drinks, money, 3 slices of bread for sandwiches, a napkin holder, a trash can, and a skateboard. There's also a mischievous cat who loves to visit the diner!

Restaurant role play for kids aged 6+ – Inspire hours of creative play with this LEGO® Friends Heartlake Downtown Diner (41728) set.

Includes 3 mini-dolls – This Heartlake City set comes with LEGO® Friends characters Liann, Aliya, and Charli, plus lots of restaurant-inspired accessories.

Encourages imaginative role play – Kids can pretend to make sandwiches using the bread and the ingredients in the fridge or they can imagine being a customer at the diner.

A fun place to relax – Kids who love to play restaurants will enjoy features like the drive-through, outdoor seating, plus an arcade game and a moving jukebox.

Made for play – The diner measures over 4.5 in. (11 cm) high, 7.5 in. (19 cm) wide and 4 in. (11 cm) deep.

The build is 346 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the table, arcade game, jukebox, and 2 minifigures!

Bag 2 includes the pieces for part of the diner.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the rest of the diner!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.

- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/41728>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1-3, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Liann

Sub-build 1.1. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with pink shoes and light orange shorts, 1 white and green striped torso printed with a light blue jacket, 1 tan head printed with brown eyes, 1 light orange helmet with black hair, and 1 black hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you. You can interchange the hair and the helmet!

Sub-build 1.2. Horizontally place a lime green skateboard in front of you. Then vertically attach a teal pair of wheels underneath the leftmost and rightmost sides. Now put your minifigure on it! Then put everything away while we make Aliya!

Group 2 - Aliya

Sub-build 2.1. Locate 1 brown pair of legs printed with pink flip flops and a dark blue skirt, 1 brown torso printed with a white and dark blue shirt, 1 brown head printed with light brown eyes, and 1 dark brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you.

Sub-build 2.2. Attach a purple and mint blue pen and a black 1x2 panel with a bar and a sticker to her hand. Then place a black and white cat named Shadow next to her!

Sub-build 2.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the 1x2 panel with a bar. This sticker is a light blue notebook cover with a star and a horseshoe on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 3 - Outdoor Seating

1. Horizontally place a light purple 6x10 plate in front of you.
2. Place 2 dark grey 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns so they are centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
3. Vertically place a light grey 2x4 plate on the 2 middle columns so it is centered.
4. Place 2 dark grey 2x2 round tables, 1 in front of the other, on top of the previous 2x4 plate.
5. Vertically place a white 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the previous tables so it is centered vertically.
6. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a teal 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 1x4 plate on the rightmost column so it overhangs 2 studs to the front.
7. Horizontally place a teal 2x3 plate underneath the overhang so it aligns with the previous 2x3 plate.
8. Vertically place 2 pink 1x4 half-cylinder bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2 left columns.
9. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with 2x2 anti-side-studs on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
10. Vertically place a pink 1x2 brick on the front 2 studs. Then vertically place another 1 behind it.
11. Vertically place a pink 1x4 half-cylinder brick on top so it is centered vertically.
12. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Turn them so they sit on the 2x4 anti side-studs!
13. Place 1 part on the 2 leftmost 2x2 tiles with a stud so it is centered vertically and the 4x6 anti-studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 14.1. Let's make a part! Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a side stud and bottom lip in front of you so the side stud faces the front. Then place a light grey 1x1 tile on top. Now place a white 1x1 slope tile upright on the front-facing side stud so it slopes to the left.
- 14.2. Place your part on its side on the back stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs so it slopes to the back.

Group 4 - Sandwich and Trash

15.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate in front of you. Then place a red 1x1 round plate on the leftmost stud. Then place a light orange 1x1 plate to the right. Then place a red 1x1 round plate to the right. Now place a light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves to the right so the leaves face the right. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 half-cylinder brick on top.

15.2. Now horizontally place your sandwich on the front stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs so it is centered horizontally. Now turn it so it faces the back left and front right.

16. Place a green trash can with 2 handles next to the build. Then place a green 2x2 dish on top. Now put everything away while we make a jukebox!

Group 5 - Jukebox

1. Horizontally place a red 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate on the back row.

2. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 tile on the front row.

3. Place 2 light brown 1x1 round plates, 1 in front of the other, underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

4. Place a yellow 1x1 brick with a hole on the middle stud so the hole faces the front and back. Then place a red 1x1 brick to the left and right.

5. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate on top.

6. Place a black 1x1 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the leftmost column so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a red 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs hanging down to the right so the side studs face the front.

7. Place a light grey 1x1 tile with a rounded side upright on the lower middle front-facing stud so the rounded side faces down. Then place a red 1x1 half-cylinder brick upright to the left and right so it slopes to the left and right.

8. Place a light grey 1x1 tile upright on the middle front-facing side stud. Then place a red 1x1 half-cylinder brick upright to the left and right so it slopes to the left and right.

9. Horizontally place a light blue 2x3 plate on top so it overhangs 1 row to the front.

10. Stack 2 transparent 1x2 plates together so there is no overhang, then vertically place them on top so it is centered horizontally.

11. Vertically place a red 1x2 tile on top of the previous 1x2 plates. Then vertically place a red 1x2 sloped curved brick to the left and right so they slope outwards. Now put your build away while we make an arcade game!

Group 6 - Arcade Game

1. Place a light blue 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 brick on top.

2. Vertically place a light blue 2x3 plate on top so it overhangs 1 row to the front.

3.1. Place a black 2x2x2 slope brick with a sticker with a sticker on the back 2 rows so it slopes to the front.

3.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the black 2x2x2 slope brick. This sticker is a chicken game that has 2 out of 3 hearts at the top. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

4. Place a red 1x1 round tile on the front left corner. Then place a light orange 1x1 round tile with an upward bar to the right.

5. Place a black 2x2 inverted slope brick on top of the 2x2x2 slope brick so it slopes to the front. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile on top. Put your build away while we make another minifigure.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 7 - Charli

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with light blue shoes and a white pants, 1 tan torso printed with teal and white overalls, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes, and 1 mint blue hair. Assemble your minifigure, then put him away while we make the diner!

Group 8 - Diner

1. Place a light purple 10x10 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the left. Then place another 1 to the right so the rounded side faces the right.

2-3. Place a light grey 2x2 sloped curved tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the front. Then place another 1 to the left and right so they also slope and overhang to the front.

4.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light yellow 1x6 door frame in front of you. Then vertically attach a transparent 3x6 door with a sticker to the left front-facing side. Now place a teal 1x1 round tile upright on the front-facing side stud.

4.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the transparent 3x6 door. This sticker has a red sign that says open. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

5. Vertically attach a transparent 3x6 door with a sticker to the right front-facing side. Now place a teal 1x1 round tile upright on the front-facing side stud.

6. Horizontally place your part on the plate behind the 3 2x2 sloped curved tiles so it is centered horizontally. The door should open to the front!

7. Horizontally place a light brown 1x2 tile on the front row to the left of the 2x2 sloped curved tiles. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 brick behind it. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

8. Horizontally place a white 1x6 curved brick to the right of the previous 1x2 brick you placed on the right so the curved side faces the front right. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns behind the previous brick. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

9.1. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front row to the right of the right 1x2 tile. Then place 1 on the rightmost column in front of the 1x2 brick. Then place another 1 on the front right corner. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the left.

Group 9 - Diner

9.2. Place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the previous green 1x1 round flower plates.

10. Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the right of the 1x6 door frame so the side studs face the front. Then place a white 1x2x2 brick on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

11. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 brick on top of the left 1x2x2 brick you previously placed.

12.1. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 brick with a sticker on top of the 1x2x2 brick that is to the right of the door frame so the sticker faces the back.

12.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the white 1x2x2 slope brick. This sticker is a picture of Charli and he has a medal on the frame! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

13. Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row on top of the door frame so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 brick with 4 side studs to the left and right so the side studs face the front.

14.1. Horizontally place a transparent 1x6x6 curved panel with a sticker on top of the 1x6 curved brick to the right of the door frame so there is no overhang.

14.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the transparent 1x6x6 curved panel. This sticker is a picture of Shadow the cat and he is wanted! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

15. Place a teal 1x1 brick on the 2nd column from the right behind the previous 1x6x6 curved panel.

16.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a light grey 4x6 plate in front of you. Vertically place a light grey 2x4 tile on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

16.2. Place 2 light grey 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they slope and overhang to the front. Now repeat symmetrically to the back.

16.3. Place a light grey 4x4 tile with 4 studs on the 2 leftmost columns so it overhangs 2 columns to the left and the studs are on the left.

16.4. Vertically place the overhang of your part on the 2 rightmost columns behind the 1x2 brick.

Group 10 - Diner

17.1. Let's make a part! Stack 2 white 1x4 plates together so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 brick with 4 side studs on top so the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a teal 2x4 tile upright on the front-facing side studs so it hangs down.

17.2. Vertically place your part on the studs of the 4x4 tile from the previous step so the tile faces the right.

18. Place a pink 1x1 brick with a side stud on the rightmost column to the right of the 1x1 teal brick so the side stud faces the front. Then place a white 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.

19. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Place a light brown 2x2 corner plate on the 2nd column from the left so it surrounds the previous 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs and overhangs to the left. It should look like the braille letter j.

20. Place a light orange 1x1 plate on the back stud of the previous 2x2 corner plate. Then place a teal 1x1 brick on top.

21. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns on top of your previous 1x1 brick and 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs. Then vertically place a light brown 2x3 plate on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the 2x2 corner plate.

Group 11 - Diner

22. Place a white 1x1 brick on the leftmost column on top of the left stud of the previous 1x2 plate. Then horizontally place a white 1x3 half-arch to the right so it arches to the right.

23. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the 2 leftmost columns on top of the previous bricks.

24. Vertically place a light grey 1x4 window frame in front of the right stud of the previous 1x2 brick. Then stack 2 white 1x4 plates together so there is no overhang, then vertically place them on top of the window frame.

25. Place a white 1x1 brick on the front stud of the previous 1x4 plate. Then vertically place a red 1x2 brick with 2 sets of 1x2 side studs behind it so the side studs face the left and right. Then place a white 2x2 corner brick behind it so it looks like the braille letter f.

26.1. Place a white 2x2 tile in front of the 1x6x6 door frame so it is centered horizontally.

Group 12 - Diner

26.2. Place a dark blue 2x2 tile to the left and right of the previous 2x2 tile. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 grill tile to the left of the back row of the left 2x2 tile. Then place a light grey 2x2 tile with 2 studs to the right of the right 2x2 tile so the studs are in the front.

27.1. Place a dark grey 2x2 tile in front of the previous white 2x2 tile so it is centered horizontally.

Group 13 - Diner

27.2. Place a white 2x2 tile to the left and right of the 2x2 tile you placed in step 27.1.

28. Place a white 2x2 tile in front of the previous dark blue 2x2 tile so it is centered horizontally. Now place a dark blue 1x1 quarter tile to the right of the back row of the 2x2 tile so the curved side faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

29. Place a dark blue 1x2 curved tile in front of each of the previous 1x1 quarter tiles so the curves face the front.

30. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate in front of the right column of the previous 1x2 grill tile that you placed to the left of the 2x2 tiles. Then vertically place a white 1x2x2 brick to the left.

31. Vertically place a light grey 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs on top of the 1x2 plate from the previous step so the side studs face the right.

32. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 brick in front of the previous 1x2x2 brick with side studs. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate in front. Now place a white 2x2 tile in front.

33. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs on top of the 1x2 plate from the previous step so the side studs face the front. Then place a light grey 1x1 round tile on the front row in front of the left column of the 2x2 tile from the previous step. Now place a light grey 1x1 round tile to the right so there is 1 column free in between.

34. Vertically place a light brown 2x4 plate on top of the 2x4 set of studs from the the 1x2x2 bricks and 1x2x2 bricks with side studs.

35.1. Horizontally place a red 2x4 tile with a sticker upright on the right-facing side studs so it sits to the right of the previous 2x4 plate. There should be no overhang.

35.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the red 2x4 tile. This sticker is a menu and has pictures of bread, tomatoes, cheese, and lettuce. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 14 - Diner

36. Horizontally place a white 1x2 slope brick printed with a number pad and chip reader on the back row of the previous 2x4 plate so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 tile printed with money on top so it is centered horizontally on top of the stud.

37.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate in front of you. Then place 2 tan 1x1 half-cylinder bricks on top so they slope to the front and back.

37.2. Now you should have 2 parts! Horizontally place them, 1 in front of the other, in front of the previous 1x2 slope brick on the right column of the 2x4 plate so they overhang to the right.

38. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a red 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Now attach a transparent light blue cabinet door to the front so it opens to the left.

Group 15 - Diner

39. Vertically place a red 1x2 tile on the rightmost column. Then horizontally place a red 2x2 tile with an upright 1x2 plate on top so the studs face the front.

40.1. Flip your part on its side so it is horizontal and the studs face the front. Then place a yellow 1x1 round brick on the right stud.

Group 16 - Diner

40.2. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick on the left stud. Then place a light grey 1x1 round tile printed with a soda can top on top of each of the 1x1 round bricks.

41. Attach the back-facing anti-studs of your part to the front-facing side studs of the 1x2x2 brick so it overhangs 1 column to the right.

42. Locate the arcade game you previously made and vertically place it in front of the 1x2x2 bricks that are to the right of the 1x6x6 door frame so it slopes to the front.

43. Place a transparent 1x6x6 curved panel to the right of the arcade game on top of the 1x6 curved brick so there is no overhang.

44. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the 2nd column from the left in front of the 1x2 brick.

45.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a hole on the 2 left columns. Then place a teal 1x1 brick to the right. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate on top. Now horizontally place a white 1x3 slope brick on top so it slopes to the left.

45.2. Vertically place your part on top of the previous 1x2 brick so it slopes to the front and there is no overhang.

46. Place a pink 1x1 brick with a side stud on the rightmost column on top of the 1x2 brick so the side stud faces the back. Then place a white 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the back.

47. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns on top of the previous bricks so there is no overhang.

Group 17 - Diner

48. Place a white 1x1 brick on top of the right stud of the 1x2 plate from the previous step. Then horizontally place a white 1x3 half-arch brick to the left so it arches to the left.

49. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns on top of the previous 1x1 brick and 1x3 half arch.

50. Place a pink 1x1 brick with a side stud on the rightmost column on top of the previous 1x2 brick so the side stud faces the back. Then horizontally place a white 1x16 brick to the left so it connects to both half arch bricks.

51. Let's make a part! Insert the axle side of a dark grey 2L pin with a 1L axle into a black gear. Now insert the 2L pin side into the right-facing hole in the front right corner so it goes all the way in.

52. Locate your juke box you previously made and vertically insert the hole into the previous left-facing pin. Now you can twist the gear to make the juke box go back and forth!

53.1. Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 sloped curved brick with a sticker upright on the right-facing side studs above the 1x4x3 window frame that is on the left side so it is centered horizontally, slopes and hangs down.

53.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the dark blue 2x4 sloped curved brick. This sticker is a menu and has pictures of burgers and sodas. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

54. Place a pink 1x1 brick with a side stud on the leftmost stud column on top of the 1x2 brick and to the left of the 2x2 corner brick so the side stud faces the back.

55.1. Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 sloped curved brick with a sticker upright on the left-facing side studs above the 1x4x3 window frame that is on the left side so it is centered horizontally, slopes and hangs down.

55.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the dark blue 2x4 sloped curved brick. This sticker is a menu and has pictures of burgers and sodas. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

56. Place the front row of a light yellow 6x6 quarter plate on the leftmost 1x1 brick with a side stud and 1x16 brick so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. They should overhang in the front left and front right.

57. Vertically place a light yellow 2x4 plate in front of the 2 leftmost columns of the previous 6x6 quarter plate that is on the left.

58. Rotate your build 180 degrees so it is horizontal and the doors face the front. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 plate upright on the front-facing side studs above the door frame so it is centered horizontally.

59. Vertically place 4 light yellow 2x6 plates, 1 to the right of the other, in between the 6x6 quarter plates so they overhang 1 row to the front.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 18 - Diner

60. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 2x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on the leftmost column.

61. Place a light orange 1x1 plate on the back row to the right of the 1x2 plate.

62. Vertically place 5 white 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the 1x1 plate.

Group 19 - Diner

63. Horizontally place a pink 1x1 half-cylinder brick on the rightmost 1x2 jumper plate so it slopes to the front and back. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 half-cylinder brick to the left. Now vertically place a light brown 1x2 plate on the leftmost column.

64. Vertically place your part upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the door frame so the raised 1x2 plate part is on the bottom.

65.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a teal 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a teal 1x8 half-arch brick with a plate part on top so it arches to the left. This plate should face the left.

65.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 upright on the rightmost bottom front-facing side stud so the arch attaches to the right of the 1x1 plate from your previous part. Now repeat symmetrically to the top front-facing stud.

66.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 1x5 plate in front of you. Then place a pink 1x1 half-cylinder brick on the rightmost stud so it slopes to the front and back. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 half-cylinder brick to the left.

66.2. Now vertically place your part upright on the rightmost column in between the previous parts so the 1x1 half-cylinder brick is at the top.

Group 20 - Diner

67. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 2x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on the leftmost column.

68. Place a light orange 1x1 plate on the front row to the right of the 1x2 plate.

69. Vertically place 5 white 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the 1x1 plate.

Group 21 - Diner

70. Horizontally place a pink 1x1 half-cylinder brick on the rightmost 1x2 jumper plate so it slopes to the front and back. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 half-cylinder brick to the left. Now vertically place a light brown 1x2 plate on the leftmost column.

71. Vertically place your part upright on the front-facing side studs to the left of the door frame so the 1x2 plate part is on the bottom.

72. Horizontally place a white 1x8 plate upright on the front-facing side studs above the door frame so it is centered horizontally.

73.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a teal 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a teal 1x8 half-arch brick with a plate part on top so it arches to the right. The plate should face the right.

73.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 upright on the leftmost bottom front-facing side stud so the arch attaches to the left of the 1x1 plate from your previous part. Now repeat symmetrically to the top front-facing stud.

74.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 1x5 plate in front of you. Then place a pink 1x1 half-cylinder brick on the rightmost stud so it slopes to the front and back. Now horizontally place a pink 1x4 half-cylinder brick to the left.

74.2. Now vertically place your part upright on the leftmost column in between the previous parts so the 1x1 half-cylinder brick is at the top.

75. Horizontally place 4 teal 1x3 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the front-facing side studs above the door frame, so they are centered horizontally. Now horizontally place another 1 upright on the front-facing side studs below the 1x4 half-cylinder brick that is to the left of the door frame so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

76. Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing stud below the 1x3 tile so the leaves face the right. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

77. Vertically place 2 teal 1x3 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the back 3 rows of the 2x4 plate that is in the back right corner.

78. Place a light grey 2x2 brick in front of the 1x3 tiles from the previous step.

79. Place a light grey 2x2 tile with an upright 1x2 plate on top of the previous 2x2 brick so the side studs face the front.

Group 22 - Diner

80. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the back.

81.1. Place a dark blue 2x2 tile with a sticker on top so it is centered horizontally.

81.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the dark blue 2x2 tile. This sticker has a light blue skateboard with yellow wheels. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

82. Place a dark blue 1x1 quarter tile on the front row to the left of the 2x2 tile so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

83. Place a dark blue 1x2 curved tile in the back left corner so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

84. Place a light blue 2x2 plate underneath the front row on the 2 rightmost columns so 1 row is exposed to the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate on the front row.

85. Place a dark blue 2x2 triangle tile on the right stud so the right angle faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

86. Horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of your part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs of the 2x2 tile that is on the right side.

87. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 sloped curved plate with a smooth underside upright on the front-facing anti-studs of the 2nd column from the right of your previous part so it slopes up.

Group 23 - Diner

88. Place 2 red 1x1 round plates, 2 light orange 1x1 plates, 1 green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves, and 1 light green 1x1 round plate inside the cabinet that is behind the 1x1 round bricks that are on the front row. Make sure to close it after!

89. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Place a teal 1x8 curved plate on the front right corner on top of the 6x6 quarter plate so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a teal 1x3 tile on the front row to the left.

90. Horizontally place a red 1x3x2 sloped curved brick to the left of the back stud of the previous 1x8 curved plate so it slopes to the right.

Group 24 - Diner

91. Place a red 3x3x2 sloped curved corner brick in front of the brick from the previous step so it slopes to the front right. Then vertically place a white 1x3x2 sloped curved brick to the left so it slopes to the front.

You will have 2 extra white 1x3x2 sloped curved bricks. Save them for later.

Group 25 - Diner

92. Vertically place a red 1x3x2 sloped curved brick to the left of the brick from the previous step so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place a white 1x3x2 sloped curved brick from group 24 to the left so it slopes to the front. Now repeat both steps again to the left. Now vertically place a light grey 2x3 plate to the left.

93. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2 plates with 2x2 side studs sticking up, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row in front of the previous 2x3 plate so together they are centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

94. Horizontally place a teal 1x3 tile to the left of the previous 1x2 plates with 2x2 side studs. Then place a teal 1x8 curved plate to the left so the curve faces the front left.

95. Let's make a part! Vertically place a red 2x4 brick in front of you.

96. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate on the front and back rows.

97. Place a red 2x2 sloped curved tile on the back 2 rows so it slopes to the front.

98. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 panel with little clips in front of the previous tile so the wall faces the back.

99. Vertically place your part on top of the 2x3 plate and 1x2 plates with 2x2 front-facing side studs. Make sure it slopes to the front.

Group 26 - Diner

100.1. Vertically place a white 1x3x2 sloped curved brick to the left of your previous part behind the 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place 2 more to the left so they slope to the front and there is a 1 column gap in between each of them.

Group 27 - Diner

100.2. Vertically place a red 1x3x2 sloped curved brick in each of the 1 column gaps from the previous step so they slope to the front.

101. Place a red 3x3 sloped curved corner brick to the left of the leftmost 1x3x2 sloped curved brick so it slopes to the front left. Then horizontally place a red 1x3x2 sloped curved brick behind it so it slopes to the left.

102. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

103. Place a white 2x2 round plate on the rightmost column so it overhangs to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

104.1. Horizontally place a dark blue 2x6 tile with a sticker on top so it is centered horizontally.

104.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the dark blue 2x6 tile. This sticker says "diner" in all capital letters. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

105. Place a dark blue 1x1 quarter tile in the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

106. Horizontally place your part upright on the front-facing 2x4 side studs so it is centered horizontally.

107. Place a white 2x2 plate with a bar underneath on top of the 1x2 panel with small clips behind your previous part so the studs hang to the front. Make sure you push it all the way down so they are slightly up and face the front.

108. Place a red 2x2 turntable plate on top of the previous 2x2 plate with a bar. Then place a light grey 2x2 round turntable plate on top.

You will have an extra light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves. Save it for later.

Group 28 - Sandwich

109.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x4 plate in front of you.

109.2. Place a red 1x1 round plate in the front right corner. Then place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in the back right corner so the leaves face the back right. Now place a red 1x1 round plate in the back left corner. Then place a light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in the front left corner so the leaves face the front left.

109.3. Place a red 1x1 round plate on the front row on the 2nd column from the left. Then place a light orange 1x1 plate behind it. Now place a red 1x1 round plate on the back row on the 2nd column from the right. Then place a light orange 1x1 plate in front of it.

109.4. Horizontally place a tan 2x4 half-cylinder brick on top so there is no overhang.

109.5. Horizontally place your part on the previous 2x2 round turntable plate so it is centered horizontally.
