42614 Vintage Fashion Store

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Inspire young builders to think about the planet while having fun with fashion with this social-emotional toy. The LEGO® Friends Vintage Fashion Store (42614) shopping toy for kids, girls, and boys aged 6+ includes 3 LEGO Friends characters, a cat figure, and accessories.

This kids' toy lets creative girls and boys tell the story of Olly, Liann, and Jordin, who love making new outfits from old clothes. Kids can help the characters wash and recycle donated clothes in the workshop. There's a fitting room where the friends can try on outfits, plus lots of clothing which the mini-dolls can wear, including hats, pants, a pair of shoes, and fanny packs. The accessories also include detergent, measuring tape, spray paint, and a cash register.

LEGO® Friends Vintage Fashion Store set – This social-emotional toy includes a buildable shop with a workshop, 3 mini-dolls, a cat toy figure, plus lots of fashion accessories for kids aged 6 plus.

Choose new outfits – This kids' toy set comes with lots of upcycled fashion items for the mini-dolls to wear, including hats, pants, a skirt, a pair of shoes, a handbag, and fanny packs.

A social-emotional toy with 3 mini-dolls – Set includes 3 LEGO® Friends characters plus a cat figure so the creative play starts right away.

Fitting room and workshop – The set has a fitting room, where the characters can change, plus a workshop with a washing machine and sewing machine role-play toy accessories.

The build is 409 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Liann and the store! Bag 2 includes the pieces for Shadow the cat and the store! Bag 3 includes the pieces for Olly and the store! Bag 4 includes the pieces for Jordin and the store!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.

- Behind/Back: away from you.

- Up: towards the ceiling.

- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.

- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back

- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.

- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.

- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.

- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.

- Plate: piece with studs.

- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)

- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.

- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.

- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.

- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece

- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.

- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).

- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42614</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Liann

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with light blue shorts and green shoes, 1 torso printed with a white and green shirt with a pink sweater over it, 1 tan head printed with dark red eyes, 1 black hair, 1 lime green round brick, and 1 white 1x1 faucet. Assemble your minifigure then place the faucet on top of the 1x1 round brick. Now attach the faucet to her hand!

Group 2 - Store

1. Horizontally place a light blue 4x8 plate in front of you.

2. Vertically place a yellow 1x8 brick with holes on the rightmost column so it overhangs 4 studs to the front.

3. Place 2 magenta 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 in front of the other, on top of the plate, to the left of the previous 1x8 brick. Then vertically place a lime green 2x4 plate to the left.

4. Horizontally place the back right corner of a light blue 8x16 plate underneath the overhang.

5. Vertically place a yellow 1x8 brick with holes in the back left corner of the 8x16 plate so it overhangs 4 studs to the back. Then horizontally place the leftmost column of a light blue 4x8 plate underneath it.

6. Horizontally place a lime green 1x3 tile in the back left corner to the right of the 1x8 brick. Vertically place a lime green 1x3 tile on the back 3 rows to the right of the previous 1x3 tile so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place another 1 on the 2nd column from the left of the build in front of the 1x3 tile. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right of the front row of the previous 1x3 tile. They should form a square! Now place a white 2x2 tile with a circle in the middle of the tiles.

7.1. Place a yellow 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally and the studs face the back. There should be 2 free columns to the left in between this and the tiles. Now horizontally place a black 2x4 tile with a sticker in front so there is a 1 row gap in between and it is centered horizontally.

7.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the black 2x4 tile. This sticker is a bunch of purple, light blue, orange, yellow, pink triangles that fill the entire tile! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

8. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick on the 2nd column from the left so it sits to the right of the front stud of the 1x8 brick with holes. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

9. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 brick on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the previous 1x1 round brick and 1x8 brick with holes. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a yellow 2x6 brick to the left of the previous 1x1 round brick and 1x2 brick that are on the right.

You will have 3 extra black 2x2 triangle tiles. Save them for later.

Group 3 - Store

10. Place a white 2x2 triangle tile to the left of the previous 2x6 brick so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a black 2x2 triangle tile from group 2 in front of the previous triangle tile so together they make a square. Now place a black 2x2 triangle tile in front of the previous triangle tile so together they make a square. Now place a white 2x2 triangle tile in front of the previous triangle tile so together they make a square. Now place a white 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a white 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a black 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a black 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a black 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a black 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a black 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a black 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Then place a black 2x2 triangle tile from group 2 in front of the previous triangle tile so together they make a square. Now you should have a 2x6 area of triangle tiles!

11. Place a yellow 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the 2 leftmost columns to the left of the triangle tiles so the studs face the back. Then place 4 yellow 2x2 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the triangle tiles so the studs face the back.

12. Place a light pink 1x1 round plate in the back left corner. Then place a light blue 1x1 plate with a clip in the back right corner so the clip faces the back. Now vertically place a yellow 1x6 plate in front of each of them.

13. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the previous clip faces the front. Now horizontally place a teal 1x2 log brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, to the right of the back stud of the previous 1x6 plate that is on the left. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 rounded plate to the right. Now horizontally place another teal 1x2 log brick to the right.

14. Horizontally place a pink $1x^2$ rounded plate on top of each of the $1x^2$ log bricks from the previous step. Then horizontally place a black $1x^2$ brick with 2 side studs in between the $1x^2$ rounded plates so the side studs face the front.

15. Place a light pink 1x1 round plate to the right of the rightmost 1x2 rounded plate from the previous step. Then place another 1 on the 2nd column from the right in front of the 2x2 tile with 2 studs. Now place a light pink 1x1 brick on top of each of them.

16. Stack 3 pink 2x2 bricks together so there is no overhang, then place them on the 2 rightmost columns so the front left corner sits on the previous 1x1 brick.

17. Stack 3 more pink 2x2 bricks together so there is no overhang, then place them on the previous stack of 3 bricks.

18.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x6x6 door frame in front of you. Then attach a light yellow glass pane with a sticker to the front so the sticker faces the front.

18.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the glass pane. This sticker has a pink-haired girl singing into a mic! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

18.2. Vertically place your part on the rightmost column in front of the previous stack of bricks so the sticker faces the right.

19. Vertically place a light pink 1x8 plate on the front right corner on top of the previous part. Then vertically place a light pink 1x2 plate to the left of the back 2 studs.

20. Vertically place a light pink $1x^2$ plate on top of the $1x^2$ plate from the previous step. Then place a black $1x^1$ round plate with a bar on the back stud of the previous $1x^8$ plate so the bar faces the back. Then vertically place a yellow $1x^6$ plate in front.

Group 4 - Store

21. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 rounded plate in front of the previous 1x6 plate so it overhangs 1 stud to the left. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 round plate underneath the overhang.

22. Vertically place the front row of a light pink 2x4 tile on top of the previous 1x2 rounded plate. Then vertically place a light pink 1x4 tile with 2 studs behind the right column.

23.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x6x6 door frame in front of you. Then vertically attach a transparent 3x6 door with a sticker to the front right side so it opens to the right. Now place a blue 1x1 skate upright on the front-facing stud so the wheels are on the left and right.

23.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 14 on the transparent 3x6 door. This sticker is a yellow and green sign that says open. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

23.3. Vertically attach a transparent 3x6 door with a sticker to the front left side so it opens to the left. Then place a blue skate upright on the front-facing stud of the door so the wheels are on the left and right.

23.4. Horizontally place your part in front of the 6 triangle tiles so the doors open to the back.

24.1. Let's make 3 identical parts! Horizontally place a yellow 1x2x2 window frame in front of you. Then attach a transparent glass pane to the front.

24.2. Now you should have 3 parts! Horizontally place them, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the previous door frame so the glass panes face the back.

25. Horizontally place a light pink 2x4 tile to the left of the back rows of the 1x4 tile with 2 studs that is on the rightmost column so it overhangs 1 row to the back.

26. Vertically place a light pink 1x2x5 brick on top of the 1x1 brick and 2x2 tile with 2 studs to the left of the previous door frame.

27. Place a light pink 1x1 brick on top of the back stud of the previous 1x2x5 brick. Then place a light pink 1x1 round plate on top.

You will have 3 extra white 1x1 slope curved bricks with a 1x1 plate part. Save them for later.

Group 5 - Store

28.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x6x6 door frame in front of you.

28.2. Attach a transparent 6x6 glass pane with a sticker to the front so the sticker faces the front.

28.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the transparent 6x6 glass pane. This sticker has a green background and says "VINTAGE" in red. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

28.4. Vertically place an orange 1x1 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part on top of the leftmost stud so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then vertically place 2 more to the right so there is a 1 stud gap in between them all and they slope and overhang to the front.

28.5. Vertically place 3 white 1x1 sloped curved bricks with a 1x1 plate part from group 4 on top of the 1x6x6 door frame so they slope and overhang to the front.

28.6. Horizontally place your part on the 2x2 tiles with 2 studs to the left of the 1x2x5 brick so it slopes to the back.

29. Horizontally place 2 white 1x3 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the previous part. Then vertically place a pink 1x8 plate on the front left corner.

30. Vertically place a pink 1x6x5 panel on the front left corner so the wall faces the left. Then vertically place a pink 1x2x5 brick behind it.

31. Vertically place 2 pink 1x4 bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top of the previous pieces on the front left corner.

32. Horizontally place a pink 1x8 plate on the back stud of the back 1x4 brick from the previous step so there is no overhang. Then place a tan 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs in front of the rightmost stud of the 1x8 plate so the side studs face the front.

33. Horizontally place a pink $1x^2$ rounded plate on the front left corner so it overhangs 1 stud to the right. Then place a transparent yellow $1x^1$ round plate underneath the overhang. Now vertically place a yellow $1x^6$ plate on the leftmost column behind the $1x^2$ rounded plate.

34. Vertically place a light pink 2x4 tile in the front left corner so it overhangs in the back right. Then vertically place a light pink 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column behind the 2x4 tile. Now horizontally place a pink 1x6 tile to the right of the back stud of the 1x4 tile with 2 studs. Then horizontally place the back row of a pink 2x4 tile to the right so it overhangs in the back right.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 6 - Shadow and Pants

Sub-build 2. Locate a black and white cat named Shadow and place him in front of you! Now put him away while we build!

35.1. Locate a lime green pair of pants and horizontally place them on the left 1x3 tile with 2 studs that is in front of the window so the shoes face the back.

Group 7 - Pants and Store

35.2. Locate a pair of legs printed with an orange skirt and dark purple shoes and horizontally place them on the right 1x3 tile with 2 studs so the shoes face the back.

36.1. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a sticker upright on the side studs that are in front of the previous pair of legs.

36.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 13 on the white 1x2 tile. This sticker is the price and it says 5! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

37.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile with a sticker upright on the side studs.

37.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the light blue 2x2 tile. This sticker has a white background and a pink hanger on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

37.3. Vertically place your part on the back right corner of the 2x4 plate that is on the front left side so the tile faces the right.

38. Place 2 white 1x1 telescope bars, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row on top of the 2x4 plate you placed your previous part on.

39.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a light orange 2x4 tile with 2 studs in front of you. Then place a light grey 1x1 round plate with an angled bar underneath on the back stud so the stud faces the front left. Then vertically place a black 1x2 tile printed with a blue phone screen on top of the 1x1 round plate so it is centered.

39.2. Vertically place the back right corner of your part on top of the 1x2x2 brick with an upright tile so the front row sits on the telescope bars!

You will have 2 extra lime green 1x1 round plates. Save them for later.

Group 8 - Store

40.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 tile with 2 studs in front of you. Then place a lime green 1x1 round plate from the previous group on top of each of the studs. Then place a light blue 1x1 round plate on top of each of the previous 1x1 round plates.

40.2. Place a light green cap on top of the left stud so the lip faces the left.

40.3. Place a pink baseball hat on top of the right stud so the lip faces the left. Now vertically place a yellow propeller on top of the baseball hat.

40.4. Vertically place your part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs to the left of the doors so it hangs 2 studs down. Make sure the hats face down!

41.1. Let's make a part! Place a black 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 round plate on top so it is centered. Now place an orange 1x2 curved tile on the front left corner of the 4x4 round plate.. Then place another 1 in the back left corner.

41.2. Vertically place a transparent 2x4x6 curved panel with a sticker on the right 2 columns so there is no overhang. Then place 2 orange 1x2 curved tiles on top of the panel so there is no overhang.

41.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the transparent 2x4x6 curved panel. This sticker has a quilt made up of blue, yellow, pink, purple fabric! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

41.4. Place your part on the front right corner on top of the circle of the 2x2 tile surrounded by 1x3 tiles so it is centered.

42.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black $1x^2$ brick with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a white $1x^2$ pair of flip flops with 2 studs on top so the lip faces the back. Then horizontally place a white $1x^2$ tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs.

42.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 11 on the white 1x2 tile. This sticker has a yellow background and has a price of 4 on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

42.3. Horizontally place your part on the front row on top of the 2x2 tile with 2 studs so the tile faces the front.

43. Horizontally attach a brown broom to the front-facing clip on the leftmost column so the broom faces down.

You will have 8 extra black 2x2 triangle tiles. Save them for later.

Group 9 - Store

44.1. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the front of the store faces the front. Place a black 2x2 triangle tile from group 8 on the rightmost column on the 2nd and 3rd row from the front so the right angle faces the back right.

44.2. Place a white 2x2 triangle tile on the 2nd and 3rd row from the front to the left of the previous triangle tile. They should form a 2x2 tile! Now place another white 2x2 triangle tile to the left so the right angle faces the back right. Now repeat this entire step to the left alternating black and white triangle tiles. The entire 2nd and 3rd row from the front should be filled with triangle tiles!

45. Horizontally place a white 1x3 tile with 2 studs in the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x6 tile on the front row to the left of the right 1x3 tile with 2 studs.

46. Vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved tile on the front row to the left of the previous 1x6 tile so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Now place a black 2x2 sloped curved tile to the left so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved tile to the left so it slopes and overhangs to the front.

47.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.

47.2. Horizontally place a purple 1x2 purse with a handle on top.

47.3. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a sticker on the front-facing side studs.

47.4. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 13 on the white 1x2 tile. This sticker has a light blue background and has a price of 5 on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

47.5. Horizontally place your part on the front left corner on top of the 2 studs of the 1x3 tile.

Group 10 - Store

48. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 rounded plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

49. Place a lime green 1x1 round plate underneath the leftmost and rightmost studs.

50. Horizontally place 3 black 1x2 bricks with 2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the side studs face the front.

51.1. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a sticker upright on the 2 leftmost and 2 rightmost frontfacing side studs.

51.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place 2 sticker 9's on the 2 white 1x2 tiles. These stickers have a green background and a price of 2. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

52.1. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs.

52.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 11 on the white 1x2 tile. This sticker has a yellow background and has a price of 4 on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

53. Horizontally place a purple 1x2 pair of flip flops on top so it is centered horizontally and the lip faces the back. Then place a white 1x1 faucet on the leftmost stud so the bar faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

54.1. Place a purple fanny pack on the left 1x1 faucet.

Group 11 - Store

54.2. Place a yellow fanny pack on the right 1x1 faucet.

55. Horizontally place the rightmost stud of your part on the rightmost stud of the front row so the tiles face the front.

56. Let's make a part! Place a light blue 4x4 plate in front of you.

57. Vertically place a tan 2x3 tile on the back 3 rows so it is centered horizontally.

58. Vertically place a yellow 1x4 brick with holes on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

59.1. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2x2 brick with a sticker on the front row in between the 1x4 bricks with holes so the sticker faces the front.

59.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the yellow 1x2x2 brick. This sticker has a picture of pants and shoes and a recycle sign. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

60. Place a yellow 1x1 brick in the back left and back right corners. Then vertically place a yellow 1x3 brick in front of each of them.

61. Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a yellow 1x3 plate on the leftmost and rightmost columns behind the 1x4 tile with 2 studs.

62. Vertically place a yellow 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

63. Vertically place the brick part of a yellow 1x4 sloped curved brick with a 1x4 plate part on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

64. Vertically place a yellow 2x4 tile on top so it is centered vertically.

65. Insert a black pin into the front and back left-facing holes.

66.1. Let's make another part! Vertically place a lime green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the back row so the long wall faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now place a light blue 2x2 tile in between them.

66.2. Insert your part into the back-facing 2x3 gap.

67. Attach the pins of your part to the 1st and 3rd right-facing holes from the front.

Group 12 - Store

68. Let's make a part! Vertically place a white 2x3 plate with a rounded side and a hole in front of you so the rounded side faces the back.

69. Place a white 2x2 round plate on the back row so the front row is free.

70. Place a white 1x4 curved plate on the front right stud so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

71. Horizontally place a yellow 1x6 plate underneath the front studs of the previous curved plates. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 plate on top of the 1x6 plate so it is centered horizontally.

72. Place 2 orange 1x1 quarter tiles on the back row so the curves align with the round plate. Then place an orange 1x1 tile in front of the right quarter tile. Now horizontally place an orange 1x2 tile in front so it is centered horizontally.

73. Place an orange 1x2 curved tile to the left and right of the previous 1x2 tile so there is no overhang. Then place an orange 1x1 tile in the front left and front right corners.

74.1. Place the back row of a white 4x4 tile with a sticker on the front row so it is centered horizontally in between the 1x1 tiles. It should overhang 3 rows to the front!

74.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the white 4x4 tile. This sticker has a large orange recycling sign with pictures of pants, shoes, and fanny packs. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

75. Flip your build upside down so the 4x4 tile faces the front. Now stack 2 pink 1x2 rounded plates together so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.

76. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so the front of the store faces the back. Then attach the left antistud of the 1x2 rounded plate of your part upright to the back-facing bar on the rightmost column of your build.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 13 - Olly

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with blue pants and black shoes, 1 tan torso printed with a black and white shirt, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes and purple glasses, 1 blond hair, and 1 white 1x4 tile printed with a measuring stick. Assemble your minifigure then attach the tile to his hand.

Group 14 - Store

77. Put away your main build while we build a room! Horizontally place a light pink 8x16 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick in the back left corner.

78. Vertically place a yellow 1x4 brick with 3 holes on the leftmost column in front of the 1x2 brick. Then place a lime green 1x1 round brick in front of the right stud of the 1x2 brick.

79. Horizontally place a blue 2x6 brick on the back 2 rows to the right of the 1x2 brick and 1x1 round brick.

80. Place a blue 1x1x6 pillar on the back left corner.

81. Vertically place a blue 1x2x5 brick on the leftmost column in front of the pillar. Then vertically place a blue 1x2 brick in front.

82.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Then horizontally attach a white cabinet door with a sticker to the front so it opens to the right.

82.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the white cabinet door. This sticker has a picture of water in an orange circle. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

82.3. Place a light grey 1x1 round tile on the front right corner. Then place an orange 1x1 round flower plate to the left.

82.4. Place a transparent orange 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then place a dark blue 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top. This is a washer!

82.5. Vertically place your part on the front left corner so it faces the right.

83. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick with a side stud on the front left corner so the side stud faces the front. Then vertically place a blue 1x4 brick behind it.

84.1. Vertically place a white 1x4x3 panel with a sticker on top of the previous 1x4 brick so the wall faces the right.

84.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the white 1x4x3 panel. This sticker has drawings of clothes, post-it notes, and markers! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

You will have 2 extra transparent orange 1x1 bricks. Save them for later.

Group 15 - Store

85. Place a transparent orange 1x1 brick from group 14 on the front left corner. Then place a transparent pink 1x1 brick on top. Now place another transparent orange 1x1 brick from group 14 on top.

86. Vertically place a blue 1x6 brick on the front left corner.

You will have 6 extra white 1x2 plates. Save them for later.

Group 16 - Store

87. Vertically place an orange 1x2 plate on the back 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left. Then vertically place 2 more to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them. Now vertically place 3 white 1x2 plates on the back 2 rows in the gaps of the previous 1x2 plates.

88. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the back 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left. Then vertically place 2 more to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them. Now vertically place 3 orange 1x2 plates on the back 2 rows in the gaps of the previous 1x2 plates.

89. Vertically place a blue 1x2 brick in front of the rightmost column of the previous 2x6 brick that you placed the 1x2 plates on. Then vertically place a black 1x2x2 panel to the left so the wall faces the right. Now vertically place a lime green 1x2 jumper plate to the left. Then vertically place a black 1x2x2 panel to the left so the wall faces the left. Now place a purple 2x2 tile with a stud to the left.

90.1. Let's make a part! Place a light orange 2x2 crate with a sticker in front of you so the sticker faces the front.

90.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 12 on the light orange 2x2 crate. This sticker has drawings of clothes, post-it notes, and markers! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

90.3. Place a light pink 1x1 round plate and a teal 1x1 round plate inside.

90.4. Place your part on top of the purple 2x2 tile with a stud that is to the left of the 1x2x2 panel so the sticker faces the front.

Group 17 - Store

91.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a lime green 2x3 plate in front of you.

91.2. Vertically place a black $1x^2$ plate with a clip on the rightmost column so the clip faces the front. Then place a light blue $2x^2$ tile with 2 studs to the left so the studs face the back.

91.3. Horizontally place a purple 1x3 plate on the back row.

91.4. Place a white 1x1 tile with a rounded side on the back left corner so the rounded side faces the left. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 inverted arch brick to the right so it slopes to the left.

91.5. Horizontally place your part on top of the 2 1x2x2 panels that are to the right of your previous part. Make sure it still slopes to the left!

You will have 1 extra lime green 1x1 round plate. Save it for later.

Group 18 - Store

92.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a purple 1x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate on the right 2 studs.

92.2. Place a white 1x1 plate with a side stud hanging down on the rightmost stud so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved tile to the left so it slopes to the left.

92.3. Place a lime green 1x1 round plate from group 17 on top of the 1x1 plate with a side stud. Then place a light grey 1x1 round tile upright on the front-facing side stud.

92.4. Place a light grey 1x1 round plate underneath the leftmost column.

92.5. Horizontally place the rightmost column on top of the 1x2 inverted arch brick from your previous part so it overhangs to the left.

93. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Horizontally place a black 1x6 plate on the 2nd row from the front on top of the 6 1x2 plates that are in the front right corner.

94. Place a light pink 1x1 tile on the front row in front of the leftmost and rightmost studs of the previous 1x6 plate. Then horizontally place a light pink 1x4 plate in between them.

95. Stack 2 blue 1x1x2 bricks with 2 side studs on top of each other so the side studs face the front, then place them on the rightmost stud of the previous 1x6 plate. Now place a short blue 1x1 brick on top.

96. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a yellow 1x2x2 window frame in front of you. Then insert a glass pane into the front. Now you should have 2 parts! Horizontally place them, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the previous stack of 1x1x2 bricks so the glass faces the front.

97. Repeat the previous step, then horizontally place them on top of the previous 1x2x2 window frames so the glass faces the front.

Group 19 - Store

98. Stack 2 blue 1x1x2 bricks with 2 side studs on top of each other so the side studs face the front, then place them to the left of the previous window frames. Now place a short blue 1x1 brick on top.

99. Stack 3 blue 1x1x2 bricks with 2 side studs together so the side studs face the left, then place them on the back stud of the bricks that are to the left of the bricks from the previous step.

100. Vertically place a blue 1x2x5 brick in front of your previous stack of 3 bricks.

101. Vertically place a blue 1x2 brick on top of the stack of 3 bricks and 1x2x5 brick. Then horizontally place 2 blue 1x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in front so there is no overhang.

102. Place a blue 1x1x6 pillar in front of the leftmost stud of the previous 1x4 bricks.

103.1. Let's make a part! Place a black angled 2x6 door frame in front of you so the smooth side faces the front. Then attach a transparent door to the front so it opens to the left. Now place a blue 1x1 skate on the front-facing stud of the door so the wheels face the left and right.

103.2. Place your door frame behind the previous stack of 3 bricks so the door opens to the left. It should sit on the back 4 rows. This door is at an angle to the building!

104. Horizontally place a black 1x1 telescope bar on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 fence with a curved design to the right.

105. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick on the leftmost stud of the previous 2x6 angled door frame. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x3 inverted slope brick to the right so it overhangs to the right. Now place a black 3x3 triangle brick in front so the right angle overhangs in the back right. It should be in the same column as the rightmost stud of the 1x3 inverted slope brick.

106. Vertically place a black 1x6 plate on the back right corner. Then vertically place another 1 on the rightmost stud of the previous 1x3 inverted slope brick so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a black 2x8 plate in front of both of the 1x6 plates.

107. Horizontally place 3 black 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row of the previous 2x8 plate so together they are centered horizontally and slope to the front. Then vertically place a black 1x3 slope brick to the left and right of the 1x2 slope tiles so they slope to the front. They should not overhang.

108. Horizontally place a green 1x2 rounded plate with leaves on top of the 1x1 round brick and 1x3 inverted slope brick on the 2x6 angled door frame so the leaves overhang to the left. Now horizontally place a lime green 1x2 sloped curved tile on the right stud so it slopes to the right.

109. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the open back faces the front. Now place a black 2x2 corner tile with a cutoff corner in front of the angled 2x6 door frame so the cutoff corner faces the front left.

110. Attach a silver pair of scissors to the front-facing clip that is to the left of the door so the sharp end faces down.

111. Insert a black 2L pin into the front and back left-facing holes.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 20 - Jordin

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with long mint blue pants and dark blue shoes, 1 tan and brown torso printed with a mint blue shirt, 1 tan and brown head printed with dark red eyes, 1 black hair, and 1 white 1x2 tile printed with a credit card. Assemble your minifigure then attach the 1x2 tile to her hand!

Group 21 - Store

112. Horizontally place 3 light grey 1x2 panels with small clips, 1 to the right of the other, on the back left corner in front of the 1x2 slope tiles so the wall sides face the back.

113. Attach a dark grey 1x2 plate with bars underneath to each of the previous 1x2 panels with clips.

114. Place a transparent orange 1x1 brick in the front left corner. Then vertically place a black 1x4 brick behind it. Now vertically place a black 1x4 brick in front of the 1x3 slope brick that is to the right of the plates from the previous step. Then place a transparent orange 1x1 brick in front.

115. Vertically place a black 1x2 log brick on the leftmost column. Then place a dark grey 1x1 brick with a side stud behind it so the side stud faces the right. Now vertically place a black 1x3 slope brick behind it so it slopes to the back. Now repeat all parts symmetrically on top of the 1x1 brick and 1x4 brick that are in front of the right 1x3 slope brick.

Group 22 - Store

116. Place a transparent pink 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then vertically place a black 1x3 slope brick behind it so it slopes to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right on top of the bricks from the previous step.

117.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x8 plate in front of you. Then place 4 black 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they slope and overhang to the front.

117.2. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the front of the store faces the front. Then horizontally place your part in the back right corner on top of the bricks from step 116 so they slope to the front.

118. Horizontally place 2 black 1x3 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the front right corner, on top of the 3 1x2 plates with bars underneath.

119. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light pink 1x6 plate in front of you.

120. Horizontally place a light orange 1x3x3 window frame on the 3 rightmost studs so the thinner side faces the front. Then insert a transparent 3x3 glass pane into the front.

You will have an extra transparent pink 1x1 brick. Save it for later.

Group 23 - Store

121. Place a transparent orange 1x1 brick to the left of the 1x3x3 frame. Then place a transparent pink 1x1 brick from group 22 on top. Now place another transparent orange 1x1 brick on top.

122. Horizontally place a pink 1x2x3 window frame on the 2 leftmost columns so the thinner side faces the front. Now insert a transparent 2x3 glass pane into the front. Then horizontally place a black 1x6 tile on top.

123. Horizontally place your part on top of the previous 2 black 1x3 plates.

124. Now push your part back so it is diagonal.

125. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on the front row on the right side in front of the windows so it is centered horizontally on the 4 studs. Now place a brown 1x1 quarter tile to the right so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

126. Place a light pink 1x1 tile on the lowest front-facing side stud to the right of the 4 windows. Now vertically place a light pink 1x2 tile upright above it. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

127. Place a light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the left stud in front of the 4 windows so the leaves face the front left. Then place a white 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

128. Place a light pink 1x3 curved tile upright on the front-facing side stud to the left of the windows so the curve faces the top left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 24 - Store

129.1. Place a transparent pink 1x1 round tile upright on the topmost left-facing side stud that is in front of the door. Then place another 1 upright on the 3rd stud from the bottom of the left-facing side studs.

Group 25 - Store

129.2. Place a transparent orange 1x1 round tile upright on the 2nd stud from the top of the left-facing side studs. Then place another 1 upright on the 2nd stud from the bottom of the left-facing side studs.

Group 26 - Store

129.3. Place a transparent light blue 1x1 round tile upright on the lowest left-facing side stud. Then place another 1 upright in between the 1x1 round tiles on the left-facing side studs.

130. Place a black 2x2 round table in the front left corner.

131. Place a black 1x1 telescope bar on the front row on the 3rd column and 8th column from the left. Then place another 1 on the leftmost column behind the 2x2 round table.

132. Vertically place a black 1x6 tile on the back left corner on top of the telescope bars. Then horizontally place another 1 on the front row on top of the 2 telescope bars.

133. Place a white 3x3 plate with a cutoff corner on the front left corner so the cutoff corner faces the back right. Then place a pink mug on the front row on the 2nd stud from the left so the handle faces the back.

Group 27 - Store

134. Place a transparent orange 1x1 round tile on the back row on top of the rightmost stud of the 1x4 fence with a curved design. Then place a white 1x1 brick with a side stud and a rounded side to the left so the side stud faces the front.

135. Place a lime green leaf plate with 6 studs on the back row to the left of the 1x1 brick with a side stud so the stud with a long branch faces the front left. Then place a lime green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the stud with the long branch so the leaves face the front left. Then place a white 1x1 round flower plate on the left stud of the back row of the leaf plate.

136. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 sloped curved tile on the 1x1 brick with a side stud and a rounded side so it slopes to the left onto the leaf plate.

137.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a lime green leaf plate with 6 studs in front of you so the stud with the long branch faces the right. Now place a lime green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the rightmost stud so the leaves face the right.

137.2. Place a white 1x1 round flower plate on the front right stud. Then place a light orange butterfly on the back right stud.

137.3. Vertically place the leftmost stud of your part upright on the side stud of the brick that has a rounded side so the 3 leaves face the top. Now insert a green stem with 3 leaves upright into the lowest stud so it connects with the 1x1 brick with a side stud and rounded side.

138. Place a lime green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the back row on top of the 1x2 rounded plate with leaves, to the left of the 1x2 sloped curved tile so the leaves face the left. Then place a red 1x1 round tile printed with a strawberry on top. Now place another in front of the right column of the previous 1x2 sloped curved tile so the leaves face the leaves face the front left. Then place a white 1x1 round flower plate on top. They should go on top of the door!

139. Bring back your main build and horizontally place it in front of you so the front of the store faces the front. Now horizontally place your build on top so it is centered horizontally.
