

## **42615 Pet Adoption Day**

Kids who love pet toys can enjoy hours of animal care role play with the LEGO® Friends Pet Adoption Day (42615) toy playset for girls, boys, and kids aged 6+. The animal toy set includes 4 mini-dolls, 2 micro-dolls, a baby figure, 5 pet figures and lots of accessories.

This social-emotional toy inspires kids to care for pets as they help Paisley match the animals to their new owners. There's a pig, a cat, a hamster, a hedgehog, and a dog figure, each with its own shelter. There's a picnic area where the pets and their new owners can relax, and a shop selling pet food. When it's time to go to their forever home, Paisley pops the pets into the trailer. Accessories include a brush, apple, pen, pet food bowl, mushroom, mugs, adoption papers, and pet food.

Buildable pet adoption toy for animal lovers – The LEGO® Friends Pet Adoption Day playset for kids, girls, and boys aged 6 plus comes with 7 characters, 5 animal figures, and lots of accessories.

Buildable trailer and animal shelters – Kids can role-play their own animal care stories with this playset as they match the pets to new owners and give them a ride on the trailer.

7 LEGO® Friends characters – This social-emotional toy comes with 7 characters, plus a pig, a cat, a hamster, a hedgehog toy, and a dog figure, so the creative play starts right away.

Lots of accessories for pretend play – The set comes with accessories, including a brush, apple, pet food bowl, pet food, mugs, adoption papers, a pen, and a mushroom.

Measurements – This 400-piece set measures over 2 in. (5 cm) high, 10.5 in. (26 cm) wide, and 4.5 in. (11 cm) deep when the pet shelters are connected in a curve.

The build is 400 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Paisley, Iris, the arch, and a booth.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Anthony, Ella, booths, and a carrier!

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Alba and another booth!

Bag 4 includes the pieces for Ida, a carrier, a booth, and a grooming area!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42615>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Paisley

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with sand blue jeans and purple shoes, 1 tan torso printed with a yellow shirt, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes, and 1 dark red hair. Assemble your minifigure and put her aside while we make Iris!

Group 2 - Iris

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 brown pair of legs printed with light blue pants and dark blue shoes, 1 brown torso printed with a light blue shirt, 1 brown head printed with pink eyes, and 1 light grey hair. Assemble your minifigure and put her away while we make the arch!

Group 3 - Arch

1. Horizontally place a green 2x16 plate in front of you.
2. Place a yellow 1x1 round flower plate in the front left and back right corners.
3. Horizontally place 2 light purple 1x2x3 slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so they slope to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 4 - Arch

4. Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in the back left corner so the leaves face the back left. Then place another 1 in the front right corner so the leaves face the front right. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on each of them.
5. Horizontally place a green 2x3 tile to the right of the left 1x2x3 slope bricks. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
6. Place 2 green 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row in between the 2x3 tiles so they slope and overhang to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 7.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 brick on top. Now horizontally place another pink 1x2 plate on top. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on top so the bar faces the back.
- 7.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 on the left 1x2x3 slope bricks so the bar faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 8.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x4 plate in front of you.

8.2. Horizontally place the plate part of 2 light yellow 1x6 half-arches with a 1x2 plate part , 1 in front of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns so the arches overhang to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

8.3. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

8.4. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

8.5. Place 2 light purple 2x2 sloped curved tiles on top so they slope outwards to the left and right. Now horizontally place your part on top of the previous 1x2 plates with a bar so the side studs face the front.

9.1. Place a light yellow 4x4 rounded tile with a sticker upright on the 2x2 side studs so it is centered.

9.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the light yellow 4x4 rounded tile. This sticker says adopt and has a bunch of dogs on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

10.1. Let's make 2 identical balloons! Place a light blue 2x2 inverted dome brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round plate with a hole on top. Now place a tan 1x1 round plate on top.

10.2. Place a light blue 2x2 dome brick on top.

10.3. Insert a transparent light blue bar into the bottom anti-stud.

10.4. Attach a white barhole with a clip to the bar so the clip faces down and the clip hands face the front and back.

10.5. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach the bar of 1 part to the front of the left-facing bar of the 1x2 plate so the balloon faces the top left. Then attach the bar of the other balloon to the back of the right-facing bar so the balloon faces up.

#### Group 6 - Arch

11.1. Let's make 2 identical balloons! Place a light green 2x2 inverted dome brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round plate with a hole on top. Now place a tan 1x1 round plate on top.

11.2. Place a light green 2x2 dome brick on top.

11.3. Insert a transparent light green bar into the bottom anti-stud.

11.4. Attach a white barhole with a clip to the bar so the clip faces down and the clip hands face the front and back.

11.5. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach the bar of 1 part to the back of the left-facing bar of the 1x2 plate so the balloon faces up. Then attach the bar of the other balloon to the front of the right-facing bar so the balloon faces the top right

#### Group 7 - Booth.

1. Horizontally place a green 4x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

#### Group 8 - Booth

2. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate in front of the previous 1x4 plate so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x4 window frame on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

4. Horizontally place 2 pink 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 1x4 plate so they slope to the front.

5. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate on the leftmost column in front of the 1x2 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

6. Vertically place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on the front 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left. Then vertically place 3 pink 1x2 plates, 1 to the right of the other, to the right.

#### Group 9 - Booth

7. Vertically place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost 1x2 plate from the previous step so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place 2 teal 1x2 jumper plates, 1 in front of the other, to the left.

8. Place a gold 1x1 clip on the 1x2 jumper plate that is on the front row and 2nd column from the left so the clip hands face left and right.

9. Attach a white bone to the clip from the previous step!

10. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate in the back left and back right corners. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part in front, so they slope to the front.

11. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on top. Now vertically place another light yellow 1x2 brick on top. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

12. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

13. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Now vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the back right corner so the clip faces the right.

14. Horizontally place a light yellow 2x6 plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

15. Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

16.1. Vertically place the plate part of a white 1x2 sloped curved brick with a plate part in front of the leftmost stud of the previous 1x6 plate so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Now vertically place 2 more to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them.

#### Group 11 - Booth

16.2. Vertically place the plate part of 3 pink 1x2 sloped curved bricks with a plate part in front of the previous 1x6 plate so they sit in the gaps of the previous bricks and slope and overhang to the front.

17. Horizontally place 2 pink 1x6 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the back 2 rows so they are centered horizontally.

18. Horizontally attach the bar of a white 1x1 plate with a bar on each side to the lower right-facing clip so the stud faces the front. Now place a heart upright on the side stud so the tip of the heart faces down.

19.1. Vertically attach the bar of a white flag with a sticker to the upper right-facing clip so the sticker faces the front.

19.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the white flag with a bar. This sticker has a picture of a brown dog and her description on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

20. Vertically place a brown dog with a purple collar on the front 2 1x2 jumper plates so the head faces the front. Now put this away while we make Anthony and Ella!

#### Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

#### Group 12 - Anthony

Sub-build 3. Locate a pair of legs printed with sand blue jeans and black boots, 1 brown torso printed with a black top, 1 brown head printed with light brown eyes, and 1 green hair. Assemble your minifigure then put him aside while we make Ella!

#### Group 13 - Ella

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 tan body printed with pink shoes and a pink top with a strawberry on it, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes, and 1 light orange hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we make a carrier

#### Group 14 - Carrier

1. Let's make a carrier! Horizontally place a light yellow 2x4 plate in front of you.

2. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the leftmost column so the clip faces the left. Then horizontally place a white 2x3 plate to the right.

3. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 brick on the rightmost column.

4. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the leftmost column so the long wall faces the left. Then horizontally place 2 light blue 1x2 panels on the middle 2 columns so the walls face outwards.
5. Flip your build so it is upside down and the clip faces the left. Now place 2 light grey 2x2 round plates with clips underneath, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the clip hands face front and back.
6. Vertically attach a black pair of wheels to each of the previous clips.
7. Flip your build over so it is horizontal and the clip faces the left. Now horizontally place 2 pink 1x2 sloped curved bricks with a plate part, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so the 1x1 plate parts overhang to the left.
8. Vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on top of the previous plate parts of the previous bricks.
9. Attach the short bar of black handle bars to the left-facing clip so the handles face the right.
10. Place a tan baby inside of a light purple cocoon inside the carrier!
11. Now bring back Roy and Ella and have Roy push the carrier!

#### Group 15 - Booth

1. Horizontally place a green 4x6 plate in front of you. Then
2. Horizontally place 2 yellow 1x2 ridged bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in front of a light yellow 1x4 plate so they are centered horizontally and the vertical ridges face the front. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side in the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
3. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate in front of each of the previous 1x2 bricks with clips.
4. Place a dark brown 1x1 round tile in the front left corner. Then place a brown 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows to the right. Now place another dark brown 1x1 round tile on the 2nd row from the front to the right of the 2x2 tile with a stud. Now horizontally place a light green 1x2 jumper plate on the front right corner.
5. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate on the back left and back right corners. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part in front so they slope to the front.
6. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x3 window frame on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
7. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 ridged brick in front of the previous window frame so it is centered horizontally and the vertical ridges face the front. Now insert a red apple into the front right 1x2 jumper plate so the apple faces the left.

#### Group 16 - Booth



8. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on top. Now vertically place another light yellow 1x2 brick on top. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

9. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

10. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side on the back right corner so the clip faces the right.

11. Horizontally place a light yellow 2x6 plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

#### Group 17 - Booth

12. Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

13. Horizontally place a yellow 1x6 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

14.1. Vertically place the plate part of a white 1x2 sloped curved brick with a plate part in front of the leftmost column of the previous 1x6 tile so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Now vertically place 2 more to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them.

#### Group 18 - Booth

14.2. Vertically place the plate part of 3 yellow 1x2 sloped curved bricks with a plate part in front of the previous 1x6 tile so they sit in the gaps of the previous bricks and slope and overhang to the front.

15. Horizontally place a yellow 1x6 tile in front of the previous 1x6 tile so it is centered horizontally.

16. Horizontally attach the bar of a white 1x1 plate with a bar on each side to the lower right-facing clip so the stud faces the front. Now place a heart upright on the side stud so the tip of the heart faces down.

17.1. Vertically attach the bar of a white flag with a sticker to the upper right-facing clip so the sticker faces the front.

17.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the white flag with a bar. This sticker has a picture of a pink pig and her description on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

18. Place a pink pig named Hamlet on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the front row so the head faces the front.

19. Bring back your previous booth build and place it in front of you so the 1x1 plate with a bar on each side faces the right. Now attach the left-facing clip of your current build to the right-facing bar of the previous booth build. Now put these away while we make another booth!

#### Group 19 - Booth

1. Horizontally place a green 4x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

2. Horizontally place a light brown 1x4 log brick in front of the previous 1x4 plate so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side in the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate in front of each of the previous 1x2 bricks with a clip. Then place a light brown 1x1 round plate in the front left corner. Now place a light green 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows to the left of the 1x1 plate that is on the right.

4. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate on the back left and back right corners. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part in front so they slope to the front.

5. Place a light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in front of the leftmost column of the 1x4 log brick so the leaves face the front right. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top.

6. Place a white 1x1 cone brick on the front left corner. Then place a red 1x1 dome on top. This is a mushroom!

#### Group 20 - Booth

7. Place a green 1x1 round plate on the leftmost and rightmost studs of the 1x4 log brick.

8. Horizontally place a light brown 1x2 brick with a side stud in between the 1x1 round plates from the previous step so the side stud faces the front.

9. Horizontally place the plate part of a light brown 1x2 sloped curved brick on top of the right stud of the previous 1x2 brick with a side stud so it slopes to the right onto the 1x1 round plate. Now repeat symmetrically to the left.

10. Horizontally place a light brown 1x2 tile on top of the previous 1x2 sloped curved bricks with a plate part.

#### Group 21 - Booth

11. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x3 window frame on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

12. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on top. Now vertically place another light yellow 1x2 brick on top. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

13. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

14. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side on the back right corner so the clip faces the right.

15. Horizontally place a light yellow 2x6 plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

16. Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

17.1. Vertically place the plate part of a white 1x2 sloped curved brick with a plate part in front of the leftmost column of the previous 1x6 plate so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Now vertically place 2 more to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them.

#### Group 22 - Booth

17.2. Vertically place the plate part of 3 teal 1x2 sloped curved bricks with a plate part in front of the previous 1x6 tile so they sit in the gaps of the previous bricks and slope and overhang to the front.

18. Place 3 teal 2x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so they are centered horizontally.

You will have an extra orange 1x1 round flower plate. Save it for later!

#### Group 23 - Booth

19.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green leaf plate with 6 studs in front of you so the end stud with the long stem faces the right.

19.2. Place a light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front right stud so the leaves face the back. Then place another 1 on the back left stud so the leaves face the back.

19.3. Place an orange 1x1 round flower plate from group 22 on the back left 1x1 plate with 3 leaves. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the front right plate with 3 leaves.

19.4. Place the leftmost stud of your part on the front-facing side stud so the stud with the long stem faces the top right.

20. Insert a green stem with 3 tips into the front-facing side stud so it connects to the side stud of the 1x2 brick.

21. Horizontally attach the bar of a white 1x1 plate with a bar on each side to the lower right-facing clip so the stud faces the front. Now place a heart upright on the side stud so the tip of the heart faces down.

22.1. Vertically attach the bar of a white flag with a sticker to the upper right-facing clip so the sticker faces the front.

22.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the white flag with a bar. This sticker has a picture of a hedge and its description on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

23. Place a brown 1x1 spikey hedgehog named Marshmallow on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the front row so the face faces the front.

24. Bring back your previous booth builds and horizontally place them in front of you so the plate with 2 bars faces the right. Then attach the left-facing clip of your current booth to the right-facing bar.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

#### Group 24 - Alba

Sub-build 5. Locate 1 brown body printed with light blue shoes and light blue overalls, 1 brown head printed with pink eyes, and 1 dark brown hair. Assemble your minifigure and put her away!

#### Group 25 - Table

1. Place a green 4x4 plate in front of you.
2. Stack 2 tan 2x2 round ridged bricks so there is no overhang, then place them on the plate so they are centered.
3. Place a light blue 4x4 round plate on top of the bricks so it is centered. Then place a yellow mug on the right stud of the front row so the handle faces the right. Then place another 1 on the back stud of the leftmost column so the handle faces the front.
4. Place an orange 1x1 round brick on the 2nd row from the back on the 2nd stud from the right. Then place a white 1x1 round plate with a bar on top so the bar faces the right. Then place a white 1x1 round tile on top.
- 5.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Stack 2 tan 2x2 round plates together so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place 2 light brown 1x2 tiles on top so there is no overhang.
- 5.2. Now you should have 2 parts! These are chairs! Place them next to the table, they should not connect to any studs!

#### Group 26 - Booth

1. Horizontally place a green 4x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

#### Group 27 - Booth

2. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in front of the previous 1x4 plate so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side in the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
3. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate in front of each of the previous 1x2 bricks with a clip.

#### Group 28 - Booth

4. Place a pink 1x1 round tile with a red strawberry on the front right corner. Then place a yellow 1x1 round flower plate to the right of the leftmost 1x1 plate. Then place an orange 1x1 plate to the right. Now place another yellow 1x1 round flower plate to the right.
5. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x3 window frame on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
6. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick in front of the 2 rightmost studs of the 1x4x3 window frame. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 slope brick to the left so it slopes to the left.

7. Place a light blue 1x1 brick on top of the right stud of the 1x2 brick from the previous step. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 jumper plate to the left.

#### Group 29 - Booth

8. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate in the back left and back right corners. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part in front so they slope to the front.

9.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 slope tile on top so it slopes to the front.

9.2. Flip your part on its side so the anti-studs face the front. Now attach a transparent light blue 1x1 round brick on the right front-facing anti-stud. Now attach a white 1x1 plate with a bent bar to the round brick so the bar faces the right.

9.3. Now vertically place your part on top of the 1x1 brick from step 7 so the bar of the 1x1 round plate faces the front. This is a water spout!

#### Group 30 - Booth

10. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on top. Now vertically place another light yellow 1x2 brick on top. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

11. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

12. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick on the back left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side on the back right corner so the clip faces the right.

13. Horizontally place a light yellow 2x6 plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

14. Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

15.1. Vertically place the plate part of a white 1x2 sloped curved brick with a plate part in front of the leftmost column of the previous 1x6 tile so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Now vertically place 2 more to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them.

#### Group 31 - Booth

15.2. Vertically place the plate part of 3 light blue 1x2 sloped curved bricks with a plate part in front of the previous 1x6 tile so they sit in the gaps of the previous bricks and slope and overhang to the front.

16. Horizontally place 2 light blue 1x6 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the back 2 rows.

17. Horizontally attach the bar of a white 1x1 plate with a bar on each side to the lower right-facing clip so the stud faces the front. Now place a heart upright on the side stud so the tip of the heart faces down.

18.1. Vertically attach the bar of a white flag with a sticker to the upper right-facing clip so the sticker faces the front.

18.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the white flag with a bar. This sticker has a picture of a tan hamster with pink ears. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

19. Place a tan hamster with pink ears named Jellybean on the 1x1 plate on the 2nd row from the front that is in between the 1x1 round flower plates so the head faces the front.

20. Bring back your previous booth builds and horizontally place them in front of you so the plate with 2 bars faces the right. Then attach the left-facing clip of your current booth to the right-facing bar.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 32 - Ida

Sub-build 6. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with a light orange skirt, black boots, and light blue leggings, 1 torso printed with an orange and light orange top, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes, and 1 white hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we make a carrier!

Group 33 - Carrier

1. Horizontally place a yellow 2x4 plate in front of you.
2. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the leftmost column so the clip faces the left. Then horizontally place a white 2x3 plate to the right.
3. Place 2 yellow 2x2 inverted sloped curved bricks with a plate part, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they slope and overhang to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
4. Vertically place a yellow 1x2 panel on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud in between them so it is centered vertically.
5. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate on the back row. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x4 tile on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.
6. Flip your build upside down so the clip faces the left. Now place 2 light grey 2x2 round plates with clips underneath, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the clip hands face front and back.
7. Vertically attach a black pair of wheels to each of the previous clips.
8. Flip your part over so the clip faces the left. Now let's make a part! Insert a white bar into the barhole of a white bar with a barhole. Now attach the bar of the barhole to the left-facing clip.
9. Bring back Ida and attach the bar to her hand so she can pull the carrier!

Group 34 - Grooming Area

1. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
2. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick on the leftmost column. Then place a light yellow 1x1 brick on the front right corner. Then place a white 1x1 brick with a clip behind it so the clip faces the right.
3. Vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on top of the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Group 35 - Grooming Area

4. Horizontally place a light purple 2x6 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.
5. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 arch brick on the back left corner. Then place a yellow 2x2 tile to the right.
6. Horizontally place a light purple 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back left corner on top of the previous 1x4 arch brick.
7. Place a transparent 1x1 round brick in the front left corner. Then place a pink 1x1 round tile on top.

#### Group 36 - Grooming Area

8. Place 2 teal 1x1 round plates, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the previous 1x1 round tile. Then place a silver 1x1 round tile printed with a can tab on top of each of them.
9. Place a transparent 1x1 round brick to the right of the 1x1 round tiles from the previous step. Then insert a silver pen into it.

#### Group 37 - Grooming Area

10. Place a transparent 1x1 round brick on the back row on top of the right stud of the 1x4 tile with 2 studs. Then place a lime green 1x1 round tile on top.
11. Attach a blue brush to the right-facing clip so the bristles face the front.
- 12.1. Horizontally place an orange 1x2x2 brick with a sticker in the back left corner so there is no overhang.
- 12.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the orange 1x2x2 brick. This sticker has a picture of dog food in a bowl. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 12.3. Place 2 double-sloped 1x1 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they slope to the front and back.

#### Group 38 - Booth

1. Horizontally place a green 4x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

2. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side in the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate in front of each of the previous 1x2 bricks with a clip.

4.1. Let's make 3 identical parts! Stack 2 light brown 1x1 round plates together and place them in front of you!

4.2. Now you should have 3 identical parts! Place 1 to the left of the right 1x1 plate. Then place another 1 behind it. Then place 1 on the 2nd row from the back to the left.

5. Place a purple 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on top of the previous stack of 1x1 round plates so the cutoff corner faces the front left.

You will have an extra transparent light blue 1x1 round tile. Save it for later!

#### Group 39 - Booth

6. Horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate in the front right corner. Then place a light brown 1x1 round tile with a white paw on top of the left stud of the 1x2 rounded plate. Now place a transparent light blue 1x1 round tile to the right.

7. Place a light brown 1x1 round plate on the leftmost stud of the previous 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner.

8. Stack 4 light brown 1x1 plates together, then place them to the left of the 1x1 round plate from the previous step.

9. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 jumper plate with a rounded side on top of the 1x1 round plates from the previous 2 steps so the rounded side faces the front. Then place a light purple 2x2 round tile with a stud on the front 2 rows to the right of the 1x1 plate that is on the leftmost column.

10. Place a light yellow 1x1 plate on the back left and back right corners. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part in front so they slope to the front.

#### Group 40 - Booth

11. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x3 window frame on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

12. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in the back left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on top. Now vertically place another light yellow 1x2 brick on top. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

13. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

14. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick on the back left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a clip on the back right corner so the clip faces the right.

15. Horizontally place a light yellow 2x6 plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.



16. Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

17.1. Vertically place the plate part of a white 1x2 sloped curved brick with a plate part in front of the leftmost column of the previous 1x6 tile so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Now vertically place 2 more to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them.

#### Group 41 - Booth

17.2. Vertically place the plate part of 3 purple 1x2 sloped curved bricks with a plate part in front of the previous 1x6 plate so they sit in the gaps of the previous bricks and slope and overhang to the front.

18. Place 3 purple 2x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so they are centered horizontally.

19.1. Vertically attach the bar of a white flag with a sticker to the upper right-facing clip so the sticker faces the front.

19.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the white flag with a bar. This sticker has a picture of a white cat and her description on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

20. Place a white cat named Bella on the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the front row so the head faces the front!

21. Bring back your previous booth builds and place it in front of you so the 1x1 plate with a bar on each side faces the right. Now attach the left-facing clip of your current build to the right-facing bar of the previous booth builds.
