Measurements – This 358-piece buildable playset includes a jewelry box that measures over 4.5 in. (11 cm) high, 6.5 in. (17 cm) wide and 4 in. (10 cm) deep.

The build is 358 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Evil Queen, a bracelet, and the jewelry box.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the jewelry box.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Snow White and the jewelry box.

Bags 4-5 include the pieces for the jewelry box.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building,

here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.

- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.

- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.

- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.

- Plate: piece with studs.

- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)

- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.

- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.

- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.

- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece

- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.

- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).

- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43276</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 17 - Steps 85-96. Bag 5 - Jewelry Box Group 18 - Steps 97-102. Group 19 - Steps 103-121. Group 20 - Steps 122-133. Let's get to building! Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Evil Queen and Bracelet

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with a long purple dress, 1 torso printed with a black and purple top, 1 tan head printed with a black mask, and 1 gold crown. Assemble your minifigure then put her aside while we build a bracelet!

Sub-build 2.1. Horizontally place a purple bracelet band in front of you so the studs face up and the holes are on the right.

Sub-build 2.2. Place a black 1x1 quarter tile on the leftmost stud so the curve faces the front left. Then place another 1 to the right so the curve faces the back right. Then place a light blue 1x1 round tile to the right. Now repeat this pattern to the right until there are no more free studs! Now put your bracelet away while we make the room that goes inside the jewelry box!

Group 2 - Jewelry Box Room

1. Place a tan 8x8 plate in front of you. Then place a red 2x2 corner plate in the back right corner so it looks like the braille letter d.

2. Horizontally place a red 1x6 plate on the back row to the left of the previous corner plate. Then vertically place a red 1x6 plate on the rightmost column in front of the previous corner plate.

3. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the leftmost column in front of the 1x6 plate.

4. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on top of the previous 1x2 brick. Then horizontally place a red 1x8 brick on the back row so there is no overhang.

Group 3 - Jewelry Box Room

5. Vertically place a tan 1x6 plate on the rightmost column in front of the 1x8 brick.

6. Vertically place a red 1x3 slope brick in the back left corner so it slopes to the front. Then place a red 1x1 brick on the back row to the right.

7. Vertically place 4 red 1x3 half-arches, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row to the right of the previous 1x1 brick so they arch and overhang to the back.

8. Horizontally place a red 1x2 brick on the back row to the right of the half-arches.

9. Horizontally place 2 light blue 1x4x3 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row, so the walls face the back.

Group 4 - Jewelry Box Room

10. Horizontally place a red 1x6 plate on the back row on top of the previous 1x4 panels so it is centered horizontally. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round plate to the left and right.

11.1. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the panels are on the left. Now horizontally place a white 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the back row to the right of the previous 1x1 round plate so the wall faces the front.

11.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the white 1x6x5 panel. This sticker is a large gold circle, and in the center is a purple circle with the evil queen on fire! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

12. Horizontally place a light brown 1x5 plate on the back row on top of the right side of the previous panel so there is no overhang. Then place a red 2x2 corner plate to the left so it looks like the braille letter f. Now vertically place a red 1x6 plate on the leftmost column in front of the corner plate.

13. Stack 2 dark grey 1x1 round plates together then place them on the back right corner.

14. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the rightmost column in front of the previous 1x1 round plates.

15. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the back right corner so the clip faces the right. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round plate in front.

16. Vertically place a red 1x3 slope brick in the back right corner so it slopes to the front.

17. Place a light blue 1x1x3 brick in the back right corner on top of the previous slope brick. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round plate on top.

18. Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 sloped curved tile in the back right corner so it slopes to the right. There should be no overhang.

19. Horizontally place a curved 2x6 doorframe on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back in front of the 1x6x5 panel so the short side faces the front.

20. Vertically place a dark blue 2x3 tile with an angled side on the back 3 rows to the left of the previous 1x2 sloped curved tile so the angled side faces the front. Then vertically place another 1 to the left.

21. Place a dark red $2x^2$ tile in the back left corner to the left of the previous $2x^3$ tiles with an angled side. Then vertically place a dark red $1x^6$ tile on the leftmost column in front of the $2x^2$ tile.

Group 5 - Jewelry Box Room

22. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a blue 1x4 archway in front of you.

23. Horizontally place 2 dark blue 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top.

24. Place a gold 1x1 cone brick underneath the leftmost and rightmost columns of the arch brick.

25. Place a dark grey 1x1 round plate on the left jumper plate. Then insert a candle flame into it so the flat side faces front and back. Now place a light grey telescope bar on the right jumper plate. Then place a transparent pink diamond on top.

26. Vertically place your part in front of the 2nd column from the left of the door frame so the diamond faces the back.

27. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the overhang of the half-arches faces the front! Now horizontally place a pink 1x4 half-cylinder brick on the front row so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a red 1x4 tile behind it. Put this away for now while we build more!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 6 - Jewelry Box

28. Horizontally place a red 1x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x6 tile on top so it is centered horizontally.

29. Place a light blue 2x2 tile on the 2 leftmost columns so it overhangs 1 row to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

30. Rotate your build so it is vertical and the overhang faces the right. Then horizontally place the leftmost column of a red 2x16 plate underneath the front overhang. Now repeat symmetrically to the back.

31. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate on the front row to the right of the 2x2 tile. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x8 plate to the right. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate to the right. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the back.

Group 7 - Jewelry Box

32. Horizontally place a tan 1x6 tile on the 2nd row from the front to the right of the 2x2 tile. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate to the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 tile to the right. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the back.

33. Place a light blue 2x2 tile on the front 2 rows of the rightmost column so it overhangs 1 column to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

34. Vertically place a red 1x10 plate underneath the rightmost overhang of both 2x2 tiles so it is centered vertically.

Group 8 - Jewelry Box

35. Vertically place a light blue 1x6 tile on the rightmost column in between the 2x2 tiles.

36. Horizontally place a red 1x8 brick on the front left corner so there is no overhang. The 2 leftmost studs should sit on the 2x2 tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

37. Horizontally place a red 1x8 brick on the front right corner so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a red 2x10 brick in between all of the previous 1x8 bricks so it is centered vertically.

38. Horizontally place 2 red 1x3 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row, so together they are centered horizontally.

39. Let's make a part! Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on top so the connector faces the left. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on top. Now vertically place your part on the right column of the 2x10 brick so it sits in front of the previous 1x3 bricks and the connector faces the left.

40. Horizontally place a tan $1x^2$ plate on the $2x^{10}$ brick in front of your previous part. Then horizontally place a light grey $1x^2$ plate with a hinge connector on the short side on top so the connector faces the right. Then horizontally place a tan $1x^2$ plate on top.

41. Vertically place a teal 2x4 brick on the 2x10 brick in front of your previous part. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick in front.

42. Place a red 2x2 brick on the back 2 rows so it sits on top of the 2 1x3 bricks and 1x2 plate. It should be centered horizontally and overhang in the front left corner. Then vertically place a dark red 2x3 brick in front. Then vertically place a teal 2x4 brick in front.

43. Horizontally place a red 1x4x2 panel on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the front.

44. Horizontally place a red 1x2x3 panel on the back row to the right of the 2x2 brick so the wall faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

45. Vertically place a red 2x10 brick on top of the previous bricks in between the previous 1x2x3 panels so there is no overhang.

46. Vertically place a red 2x3 slope brick on the back 3 rows in between the 1x2x3 panels so it slopes to the front.

47. Horizontally place 2 red 1x3 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row on top of the previous 1x2x3 panels and 2x3 slope brick so there is no overhang.

48. Place a short light grey 1x1 brick on the front row on top of the 1x4x2 panel so it sits to the right of the 2x10 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

49. Place a tan 1x1 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on top of each of the previous 1x1 short bricks so the side studs face the front.

Group 9 - Jewelry Box

50.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a red 1x4 plate on top.

50.2. Horizontally place a tan $1x^2$ plate on top so it is centered horizontally. Then place a tan $1x^1$ plate with 2 side studs hanging down to the left and right so the side studs face the front.

50.3. Horizontally place a red 1x4 plate on top. Now horizontally place your part on the front row on top of the previous 2x10 brick and 1x1 plates with side studs so the side studs face the front. There should be no overhang!

51.1. Horizontally place a red 1x6x5 panel printed with a light blue and teal curve design on the front row to the right of the previous part so the wall faces the front. There should be 1 free stud to the right! Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Group 10 - Jewelry Box

51.2. Now horizontally place a red 1x6x5 panel on the back right corner so the wall faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

52. Horizontally place a red 1x10 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a red 1x4 plate to the left and right.

53. Stack 5 red 1x1 round bricks together then place them on the front right corner to the right of the 1x6x5 panel. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

54. Horizontally place a red 1x10 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a red 1x4 plate to the left and right.

55. Place a dark red 1x1 round tile in the front left and front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

56. Horizontally place 4 dark red 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row in between the 1x1 round tiles. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

57. Flip your build upside down so it is horizontal. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x3 rounded plate upside down on the front left and front right corners. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

58. Flip your build over so it is upright and horizontal. The side studs should face the front! Now locate the building you made using the previous bag and orient it so the 1x4 half-cylinder tile on top of an overhanging arch faces the left. Now insert your previous build into the left side of the jewelry box so the back right-facing clip attaches to the hinge connector. Now put everything away while we make Snow White!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 11 - Snow White

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with a light yellow dress, 1 tan torso printed with a blue top, 1 tan head printed with pink lipstick, 1 black hair with a red bowtie, and 1 red apple. Assemble your minifigure then put the apple in her hand! Now put her away while we build another room!

Group 12 - Jewelry Box Room

59. Place a tan 8x8 plate in front of you. Then place a red 2x2 corner plate in the back left corner so it looks like the braille letter f.

60. Horizontally place a red 1x6 plate on the back row to the right of the corner plate. Then vertically place another 1 on the leftmost column in front of the corner plate.

61. Horizontally place a red 1x8 brick on the back row. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the rightmost column in front of the 1x8 brick.

62. Vertically place a light blue $1x^2$ plate on top of the previous $1x^2$ brick. Then horizontally place another 1 on the front row to the right of the $1x^6$ plate.

63. Vertically place 2 tan 1x3 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column in front of the 1x8 brick.

Group 13 - Jewelry Box Room

64. Horizontally place a red 1x2 brick in the back left corner.

65. Vertically place 4 red 1x3 half-arches, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row to the right of the previous 1x2 brick so they arch and overhang to the back.

66. Place a red 1x1 brick on the back row to the right of the arch bricks. Then vertically place a red 1x3 slope brick to the right so it slopes to the front.

67. Horizontally place 2 light blue 1x4x2 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row of the arch bricks so the walls face the back and there is no overhang.

68. Horizontally place a red 1x6 plate on top of the previous 1x4x2 panels so it is centered horizontally. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round plate to the left and right.

69. Vertically place a white 1x6x5 panel on the leftmost column in front of the previous 1x1 round plate so the wall faces the right. Now horizontally place a red 1x3 slope brick in the front left corner so it slopes to the right.

70. Place a red 2x2 corner plate in the back left corner so it looks like the braille letter f. Then horizontally place a red 1x6 plate to the right so it sits on the 1x6 plate and 1x1 round plate.

Group 14 - Jewelry Box Room

71.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a transparent orange 1x2 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

71.2. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 jumper plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

71.3. Vertically place a yellow 1x2x2 slope brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

71.4. Place a black pot on the jumper plate so the handle faces the front. Now vertically place your part in the back left corner of the tan 8x8 plate to the right of the 1x6x5 panel so it slopes to the right.

72.1. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 plate in front of you.

72.2. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2x2 slope brick in the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

72.3. Horizontally place a tan $1x^2$ masonry brick on the back row so the brick grooves face the front. Then place a red mug on the front row on the 2nd stud from the right so the handle faces the right.

72.4. Vertically place your part on top of your previous part so the mug is on the right.

73. Place a tan 2x2 tile on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the corner plate. Then vertically place a tan 1x3 plate on the leftmost column in front of the previous 2x2 tile.

74.1. Let's make a part! Place a light blue 2x2 round brick in front of you.

74.2. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the left column. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on the right column so the clip faces the front.

74.3. Place a brown 2x2 round tile with a stud on top.

74.4. Place your part in front of your previous parts to the right of the 1x6x5 panel so the clip faces the front.

75. Place a dark grey 1x1 round plate on top of the previous 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then insert a white candle stick in it. Then insert a transparent orange candle flame on top so the flat side faces the left and right.

Group 15 - Jewelry Box Room

76. Place a red 1x1 brick in the front left corner.

77. Place a light blue 1x1x3 brick in the front left corner on top of the previous 1x1 brick. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round plate on top.

78. Vertically place a dark red 1x2 sloped curved tile in the front left corner so it slopes to the front and there is no overhang.

79. Vertically place a dark red 1x6 tile on the leftmost column behind the previous 1x2 sloped curved tile. Then horizontally place a dark red 1x6 tile to the right of the back row of the previous 1x6 tile. Now place a dark red 1x1 round tile to the right.

80. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the overhang of the arches faces the front. Now horizontally place a pink 1x4 half-cylinder brick on the front row so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a red 1x4 tile behind it.

81. Locate your main jewelry box build and horizontally place it in front of you so the gap is on the right. Then rotate your room so the 1x4 half-cylinder brick faces the right. Now insert it into the right gap of the jewelry box so the clip attaches to the hinge connector.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 16 - Jewelry Box

82. Vertically place a light blue 1x4 sloped curved brick with a 1x4 plate part upright on the left frontfacing side studs so the plate part is on the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

83. Place a red $2x^2$ round tile with a stud upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a light blue $1x^2$ tile upright above and below the previous $2x^2$ round tile with a stud.

84.1. Let's make a part! Place a red 3x3 heart plate in front of you so the 90-degree angle faces the front right.

84.2. Place a light yellow 2x2 tile in the front right corner.

84.3. Place a light yellow 1x1 quarter tile in the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then place another 1 behind it so the curve faces the back left. Now place 1 on the back right corner so the curve faces the back right. Then place another 1 to the left so the curve faces the back left.

84.4. Place your part upright on the front-facing side stud of the 2x2 round tile so it is centered and the 90-degree angle faces down.

Group 17 - Jewelry Box

85. Let's make a part! Vertically place a red 6x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

86. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick in the back right corner so it overhangs 2 studs to the right. Now repeat symmetrically to the left.

87. Vertically place a red 6x10 plate underneath the right overhang so the front rows align. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

88. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on the back row to the right of the 1x4 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

89. Vertically place a pink 2x6 brick in the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

90.1. Let's make a part! Stack 2 pink 2x4 plates together so there is no overhang then vertically place them in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 2x4 plate with a hole on top so the hole faces the front. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.

90.2. Vertically place 1 part in the front left corner in front of the 2x6 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

91. Horizontally place 3 light blue 1x6 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so there is no overhang.

92. Vertically place 2 light blue 1x4 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column in front of the previous 1x6 plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

93. Horizontally place a red 1x8 tile in the back left corner. Then horizontally place a red 1x2 grill tile to the right. Now horizontally place a red 1x8 tile to the right.

94. Place a red 2x2 sloped curved tile on the 2 leftmost columns on top of the tiles and studs in front of the 1x8 tile so it slopes to the right. Then horizontally place a red 1x2 sloped curved tile in front so it slopes to the right. Now place a red 2x2 sloped curved tile in front so it slopes to the right. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

95. Vertically place a red 1x2 grill tile on the 2nd column from the left in front of the 2x2 sloped curved tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

96. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on the front row so it is horizontally centered. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick to the left and right.

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 1):

Group 18 - Jewelry Box

97. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the holes are in the back. Place a black 2L pin in the right-facing side of the back left hole. Then place another 1 into the right-facing side of the back right hole.

98. Vertically insert the hole of a red 2x4 plate in the back left pin so the plate is upright and faces the back. Then repeat to the back right pin.

99. Now flip them down to the front so the plate sides face up.

100. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on the back row to the right of the 1x4 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

101. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x 6 plate to the left and right.

102. Horizontally place a red 1x8 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a red 1x3 tile to the left and right.

Group 19 - Jewelry Box

103. Let's make another part! Vertically place a red 6x10 plate in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud in the back left corner.

104. Place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud in the front left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x6 plate on the 2nd column from the left in between the 2x2 tiles with a stud.

105. Place 3 pink 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns, on top of the 1x6 plate so they slope to the left.

106. Horizontally place a pink 1x6 plate on the 2nd row from the front so it overhangs 2 studs to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

107. Vertically place a red 6x10 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered vertically.

108. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the front to the right of the 1x6 plate. Then horizontally place a pink 1x6 plate to the right so it overhangs 4 studs to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

109. Vertically place a red 6x10 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered vertically.

110. Place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud in the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now vertically place a pink 1x6 plate on the 2nd column from the right in between the 2x2 tiles with a stud.

111. Place 3 pink 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns, on top of the 1x6 plate so they slope to the right.

112. Place a pink 1x1 round tile on top of each of the 2x2 tiles with a stud that is in each of the corners!

113. Place a pink 1x3 curved tile to the right of the back 2 sloped curved tiles on the left side so the curve faces the back left corner. It should touch the 1x6 plate in the back! Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

114. Place a pink 1x1 quarter tile on the 3rd row from the front to the right of the previous 1x3 curved tile so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

115. Place a pink 1x1 quarter tile on the 3rd row from the front behind the left stud of the 1x2 plate that is centered horizontally so the curve faces the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

116. Place a pink 1x3 curved tile on the 3rd row from the front to the left of the previous 1x1 quarter tile so the curve faces the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

117. Place a pink 1x1 quarter tile on the 5th row from the front to the left of the previous 1x3 curved tile so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

118. Place 7 pink 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 2 rows, so they slope to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

119. Place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on top so it is centered.

120. Horizontally place your part on top of your previous part so there is no overhang. It should only attach to the 2x4 plates with a hole that is in the back left and back right corners!

121. Bring back your main jewelry box build and horizontally place it in front of you so the heart faces the front! Now horizontally place your part on top so there is no overhang! When you lift the top, it should open to the back!

Group 20 - Jewelry Box Sword

122. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x8 plate in front of you.

123. Place the plate part of a light grey 2x2 brick with a hole and a plate side on the rightmost column so the brick overhangs to the right.

124. Vertically place a gold 1x2 plate to the left of the previous light grey 2x2 brick with a hole and a plate part.

125. Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 tile on the front row to the left of the 1x2 plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now horizontally place a yellow 2x3 tile with an angled side to the left so the angled side faces the left.

126. Place a yellow 2x2 tile on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right.

127. Vertically place a tan 1x6 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a yellow 1x4 tile on top so it is centered vertically. Now place a transparent blue 1x1 round plate in front and behind it.

128. Insert a blue 2L pin axle into the right-facing hole so the axle faces the right.

129. Insert a tan 2L ridged axle connector into the right-facing axle.

130. Insert a dark grey 2L bar with a stop into the right-facing axle connector.

131. Insert a transparent light blue 1x1 round plate connected to a chain into the right-facing bar so the stud faces the right.

132. Attach a light blue ball upright on the right-facing stud of the previous chain.

133. Insert the angled side of your sword through the top, in between the 2x4 sloped curved tiles with a plate part so the tile side faces the front! Now attach the other 1x1 round plate of the chain to the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is centered on top!
