40715 Alien Pack

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Launch imaginations with the LEGO® Alien Pack (40715), an out-of-this-world space toy for budding astronauts aged 7 and up. Packed with galaxies of play potential, the set includes 6 alien characters, 1 LEGO minifigure and an awesome space vehicle. Space-lovers can make friends with the extraterrestrials, who are decorated with new face and eye elements, before discovering the cool accessories. With a walkie-talkie, oxygen tank and more, the intergalactic adventure never has to end.

Send imaginations into space – Kids aged 7 and up make friends with aliens in the LEGO® Alien Pack space toy set.

Extraterrestrial friends – Get acquainted with 6 alien characters, who are decorated with new face and eye elements.

LEGO® astronaut – Includes a LEGO minifigure, who's dressed in a spacesuit and comes with a space vehicle, which they can sit inside.

Dimensions – The set includes 181 pieces and the landscape measures over 3 in. (7 cm) high, 2 in. (6 cm) wide, and 2.5 in. (7 cm) deep.

The build is 181 pieces in total and is for ages 7+.

Bags 1 and 2 include the pieces for the astronaut, vehicle, 1 alien, and the rock mound.

Bags 3 and 4 include the pieces for the rest of the aliens!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/40715) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later!

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bags 1-2, Book 1):

Group 1 - Astronaut

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 white pair of legs, 1 white torso printed with a gold planet with a red arrow around it, 1 black oxygen tank, 1 yellow head printed with red glasses and red lips, 1 white helmet, and 1 black walkie talkie. Assemble your minifigure then attach the walkie talkie to her hand! Make sure the oxygen tank is on her back!

Group 2 - Vehicle

- 1. Vertically place a light grey 2x2 plate with 2 small pins in front of you so the pins face the front and back. Then vertically place a blue 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the left column so the clip faces the left.
- 2. Horizontally place a blue 2x3 plate on the right column so it overhangs 2 columns to the right.
- 3. Vertically place a light grey 2x2 plate with 2 small pins underneath the 2 rightmost columns.
- 4. Horizontally place a blue 2x3 plate on top of the 3 leftmost columns.
- 5. Place 2 yellow 1x1 plates with a clip, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so the clips face the right.
- 6. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with 2 bars on the leftmost column so the bars face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. The bars should face inwards towards each other!
- 7. Place 2 transparent yellow 1x1 slope tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so they slope to the left.
- 8. Place a blue 1x1 plate with a double-sided stud on the front right corner so the double-sided stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 9. Place a transparent red 1x1 round plate upright on each of the right-facing side studs of the double-sided studs.
- 10. Attach a dark grey claw to the front right-facing clip so the clip faces up and the clip hands are in the front and back. Then attach a light grey bar with an anti-stud to the back right-facing clip so the anti-stud faces down.
- 11. Attach a blue bar with a barhole to the left-facing clip so the barhole faces the left. Now attach a dark grey claw to it so the claw hands face up and down. Then attach light grey handlebars to it so the handlebars curve up. Now lift the handlebars up so they are upright!

12. Attach a black wheel to each of the front-facing small pins. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place your minifigure on it so she can drive! Now put it away so we can make an alien!

Group 3 - Alien

- 1. Place a tan 2x2 plate with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front.
- 2. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the back row so the bar faces the back.
- 3. Place a lime green 2x2 plate on top.
- 4. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs on the left column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 5. Flip your build upside down so the bar faces the back. Now vertically place a green 1x1 plate with a 1x1 sloped curved brick on the back left corner so it overhangs and slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.
- 6. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 log brick on the front row.
- 7. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with teeth on the front row so the teeth face the front. Then repeat on the back row. These are the toes!
- 8. Flip your build over so the teeth face the front. Now attach a light green 1x1 round plate with a leaf to the back bar so the leaf faces the back.
- 9. Place a green 2x2 round tile with a stud on top.
- 10. Place a pink 1x1 plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing side stud so the leaves face the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place 1 upright on the back left-facing side stud so the leaves face the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 11. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 jumper plate upright on the front-facing side studs. Then place a lime green 1x1 round tile printed with an eye upright on it.
- 12. Place a yellow fang on top so it curves to the front. Then place 1 upright on the front left-facing side stud so it curves down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 4 - Rock Formation

- 1. Place a dark tan 6x6 plate with a cutoff corner in front of you so the cutoff corner faces the front left. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile with a stud on the back right corner.
- 2. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate in front of the 2x2 tile with a stud. Then vertically place another 1 to the left of the 2x2 tile with a stud.

- 3. Place a light purple crystal on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place an orange 1x1 round plate on the left stud of the horizontal 1x2 plate. Then place 1 on the front stud of the vertical 1x2 plate.
- 4. Horizontally place a lime green 1x1 rounded plate on the back left corner. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x2 slope brick to the right so it slopes to the back. Then horizontally place another 1x2 slope brick on the 2 rightmost columns in front of the 1x2 plate so it slopes to the right.
- 5. Place a light green fang on the back left corner so it curves to the right. Then place another 1 to the right so it also curves to the right.
- 6. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the rightmost column on the 2nd row from the front so the clip faces the right. Then place a dark tan 2x2 corner brick in front of the vertical 1x2 slope brick and to the left of the horizontal slope brick so it looks like the braille letter d.
- 7. Place a dark tan 2x2 corner slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the fangs so it slopes to the front left. Then place another 1 on the front 2 rows to the left of the 1x1 brick with a clip so it slopes to the front left.

Group 5 - Rock Formation

- 8. Horizontally place a red brown 1x2 plate on top of the left 2x2 corner slope brick and 1x2 slope brick to the right. Then place a mint blue 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front right corner so the leaves face the front right. Now place another 1 in front of the left column of the 2x2 corner plate so the leaves face the front left.
- 9. Place a red brown 2x2 corner brick on the 2 rightmost columns on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it looks like the braille letter h. Then place the front row of another 1 to the right of the back row of the previous 2x2 corner brick so it looks like the braille letter d.
- 10. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the rightmost column on the 2nd row from the front.
- 11. Vertically place a brown 1x2 inverted slope brick on top of the 1x1 brick from the previous step so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x2x2 slope brick to the left so it slopes to the front and there is no overhang.
- 12. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2x2 slope brick to the left of the 1x2x2 slope brick from the previous step so it slopes to the back and there is no overhang.
- 13. Place a brown 3x3 plate with a cutoff corner on top of the previous slope bricks and inverted slope brick so the cutoff corner faces the front left.
- 14. Vertically place a dark 1x2 slope brick on the back right corner of the previous 3x3 plate with a cutoff corner so it slopes to the front. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left of the back row of the 1x2 slope brick so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a red brown 1x2 plate on top of them.
- 15. Vertically place a light pink 1x1 round plate with a leaf on the right stud of the 1x2 plate from the previous step so the leaf faces the front. Now place another 1 on the 2nd column from the left on the 2nd row from the back so the leaf faces the back. Now place a magenta 1x1 plate with a stack of balls on top of each of them.

- 16. Let's make a tree branch! Stack 2 black candle sticks with a bar on top of each other so the bar hole faces up. Then attach a curved bar with a stud on top so it overhangs to the right. Now attach the bottom-facing bar of your part to the clip of the right-facing side of the build so it overhangs to the right.
- 17. Place a purple plant with 5 stems on top of the stud of the previous curved bar. Then place 3 mint blue 1x1 round flower plates upside down on the upper stems. Now put your build away so we can make some aliens!

Building Instructions (Bags 3-4, Book 1):

Group 6 - Alien

- 1. Place a white 2x2 plate with 8 bars around it in front of you. Now place a lime green 2x2 round plate on top.
- 2. Vertically place a lime green 1x2 rounded plate on the right column. Then place a green 1x1 plate with a clip on the front left corner so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 3. Attach a green 1x1 plate with a clip to the left-facing bar. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes and overhangs to the left.

Group 7 - Alien

- 4. Flip your part upside down so the 1x2 sloped curved tile is on the left. Now horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 rounded plate on the front row of the 2x2 plate with 8 bars. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 5. Flip your part back over so the 1x2 sloped curved tile faces the back. Now place a lime green 2x2 dome brick printed with an alien face with 3 eyes and a mouth on top of the front 2 rows so the print faces the front.
- 6. Place a pink 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on top of the 2x2 dome brick so the leaves face the left. Then place a yellow fang on top so it curves to the left. Now put it aside so we can make another alien!

Group 8 - Alien

- 1. Place a white 2x2 plate with 8 bars around it in front of you.
- 2. Place a lime green 2x2 round plate on top.
- 3. Place a light blue 2x2 round flower plate on top so it is centered.
- 4. Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2 side studs sticking up on the left column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 5. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

- 6. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 tile with 2 studs upright on the front-facing side studs. Then place a lime green 1x1 round tile printed with a black and white eye upright on it.
- 7. Place a green 2x2 round tile with a stud on top so it is centered. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with a clip on the left-facing side so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 8. Place 2 pink 1x1 plates with 3 leaves, 1 to the right of the other, on the back-facing studs so the leaves face the bottom left and bottom right.
- 9. Place a light green 1x1 cone brick on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then place a gold crown on top! Now put it aside so we can make another alien!

Group 9 - Alien

- 1. Place a lime green 2x2 plate in front of you.
- 2. Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2 side studs sticking up on the left column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 3. Place a tan 2x2 plate with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.
- 4. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with a clip on the left-facing side stud so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 5. Place a dark tan 2x2 plate with 3 teeth on the back row so the teeth overhang to the back.
- 6. Place a lime green 2x2 plate on top so there is no overhang.
- 7. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the left column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 8. Place a lime green 2x2 sloped curved tile upright on the left-facing side studs so it slopes up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 9. Place a lime green 2x2 plate on top.
- 10. Place a green 2x2 round tile with a stud upright on the front-facing side studs so it sticks up. Then place a lime green 1x1 round tile printed with a black and white eye upright on it.
- 11. Place a white 2x2 plate with 8 bars around it on top.
- 12. Vertically place 2 tan 1x2 plates with a bar on the short side, 1 to the right of the other, underneath the 2x2 plate so the bars face the front.
- 13. Attach a green 1x1 plate with a clip to the left-facing bar of the plate with 8 bars so it is diagonal and faces the top left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach another 1 to the back-facing bar so the stud faces up.

14. Place a green 2x2 round tile with a stud on top of the 2x2 plate with 8 bars. Now place a pink 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on top of it so the leaves face the back. Now put it aside so we can make another alien!

Group 10 - Aliens

- 1. Place a lime green 2x2 plate in front of you.
- 2. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 rounded plate on the back row. Then place a light green 1x1 plate with a rounded side and a bar on the front left corner so the bar faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 3. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 rounded plate on the front row. Then vertically place 2 green 1x1 plates with a 1x1 sloped curved brick, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they slope and overhang to the back.
- 4. Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the left column so the bar faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 5. Place a lime green 2x2 dome brick printed with an alien face with 3 eyes and a mouth on top so the print faces the front.
- 6.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a lime green 1x1 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a green 1x1 plate with a clip on the left column so the clip faces the left. Now horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes to the right.
- 6.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! These are the alien's arms! Attach the clip of 1 part to the front left facing bar! Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 7. Place a green candle holder with a curved stem with a stud on top of the left bar so the stud faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 8. Place a pink 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on top of the 2x2 dome brick so the leaves face the back. Now place a yellow fang on top so it curves to the back.
- 9. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick on top of the left stud of the curved stem. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now put it aside so we can make 1 more alien!

Group 11 - Alien

- 1. Place a green 2x2 flower plate in front of you.
- 2. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the back row so the bar faces the back. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with 2 side studs sticking up on the front row so the side studs face the front.
- 3. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 sloped curved brick on the back row so it slopes to the back.

- 4. Place a lime green 1x1 brick with a side stud on the front left corner so the side stud faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 5. Place a lime green 1x1 round plate with a leaf on top of the bar in the back so the leaf faces the back.
- 6. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the front row so the side studs face the front.
- 7. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 jumper plate on top of the front row.
- 8. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 tile with 2 studs upright on the front-facing side studs. Then place a lime green 1x1 round tile printed with a black and white eye upright on it.
- 9. Place a pink 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the left-facing side stud so the leaves face the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 10. Attach a green 1x1 round plate with a bent bar underneath to the left-facing stud so the stud faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 11. Place a yellow 1x1 clip upright on the front left facing side stud so the clip hands are on the left and right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
