Ready for everyday play – The hot-air balloon measures over 7 in. (18 cm) high, 3.5 in (9 cm) long and 3 in. (8 cm) wide, and all 3 builds are made for endless play sessions

The build is 320 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the magic carpet and lounge area!

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the hot air balloon!

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the horse and carriage.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building,

- here are some terms we'll be using:
- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two

studs on top.

- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.

- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.

- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece

- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43216</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1 -3, 3 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 13 - Rest of Step 12, Steps 13-20, and 1 tan 2x2 round plate from Step 21. Group 14 - Rest of Steps 21 and Steps 22-25. Group 15 - Steps 26-27.

Bag 3 - Horse and Carriage Group 16 - Page 2-4. Group 17 - Steps 1-19. Group 18 - Steps 20-24. Group 19 - Steps 25-39.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Jasmine and Elephant

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with light blue pants and gold shoes, 1 brown torso printed with a light blue top, 1 brown head printed with dark red eyes and red lips, and 1 black hair with light blue hair ties. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you!

Sub-build 2. Horizontally place a light blue elephant in front of you so the nose faces the left. Now insert a light blue flame into the top of the nose so it faces the right. Now put these away while we make the lounge!

Group 2 - Lounge

1. Vertically place a white 2x8 brick in front of you.

2. Horizontally place a yellow 2x6 plate underneath the front 2 rows so 4 columns are exposed to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

3. Vertically place a white 2x8 brick to the left of the previous 2x8 brick so it is centered vertically.

4. Vertically place a light grey 1x8 plate to the left of the previous 2x8 brick so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a white 1x6 tile on top so it is also centered vertically.

5. Vertically place a white 2x6 tile on the leftmost column so it overhangs to the left and is centered vertically.

6-7. Place 2 yellow 4x4 quarter plates, 1 in front of the other, underneath the leftmost overhang so together they are centered vertically, and they form a half-circle that faces the left. The curves should face the back left and front left!

8. Place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

9. Horizontally place a white 1x3 inverted sloped curved brick on the front row to the left of the 2x6 bricks so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

10. Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in front of the right column of the previous 2x2 round tile with a stud so the leaves face the front. Then place a purple 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Group 3 - Lounge

11. Vertically place a tan 1x6 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place a light grey 1x1 plate with a bar and a rounded side on the front right corner so the bar faces the right. Then place another 1 on the back right corner so the bar faces the back.

12. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front row to the left of the 1x1 plate with a bar and a rounded side. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a tan 2x2 tile with a stud to the left of the 1x6 plate that is on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically.

13.1. Horizontally place a red 2x3 tile with a sticker in front of the 2x2 tile with a stud from the previous step. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

13.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on each of the 2 red 2x3 tiles. These stickers have a red pillow with purple stitching. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

14. Vertically place a white 1x4 half-cylinder brick on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place a white 2x2 half-cylinder corner brick on the front right corner so it looks like the braille letter j. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

15. Place a gold bowl on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right.

16. Place a gold 1x1 cone brick on the front row on the left stud of the 1x4 tile with 2 studs. Then place a transparent orange candle flame on top so it is horizontal. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

17.1. Let's make a part! Place a transparent light blue 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a white 3x3 dish on top. Then insert the bar of a white 1x1 round tile with an upward bar into the stud.

17.2. Place your part upside down on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the 2 leftmost columns.

18. Insert a transparent light blue 4L bar into the dish from the previous step. Then place a transparent light blue 2x2 dish on top so the stud faces up. Then place a light grey ball on top.

19.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown candlestick with a bar in front of you so the bar faces the right. Insert the hole of a brown bar holder with a clip into the right-facing bar so the clip faces the right and the clip hands face the front and back.

19.2. Insert the bar of a thick brown bar into the left-facing hole.

19.3. Now place your part on the clip side so the hole faces up. Make sure the clip hands face the front and back. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 rounded plate with long leaves on top so it overhangs 1

stud to the right and the leaves face the left. Now insert a light green 1x1 stem with 3 leaves on top of the left stud.

19.4. Attach the clip of your part to the bar in the back right corner so the leaves face the left.

20.1. Let's make a part! Place a light green stem with 3 leaves into the anti-stud of a purple 1x1 round plate with a stack of balls.

20.2. Place your part on top of the gold bowl that is on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right. Now put your part away while we make the magic carpet!

Group 4 - Magic Carpet

1. Place a white 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs above the plate on the back row so the side studs face the back.

2. Horizontally place a white 2x4 plate on the front row so it overhangs 1 row to the front and 2 columns to the right.

3. Place a white 2x2 round plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns of front overhang so 1 row of studs are exposed to the front.

4. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs on the front row so the side studs face the front.

5. Rotate your part 90 degrees clockwise so the 2x4 plate overhangs to the front. Now horizontally place a light purple 1x4 plate on the back row. Then horizontally place 2 purple 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, in front.

6. Horizontally place 2 purple 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they slope to the front.

7. Vertically place a tan 4x6 plate underneath the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

8. Rotate your part 90 degrees counterclockwise so the side studs are on the left and face front and back. Now horizontally place a pink $1x^2$ plate with $2x^2$ side studs above the plate on the front row to the right of the $1x^2$ plate with $2x^2$ side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

9. Place 2 purple 2x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, in between the side studs and to the right of the 1x2 tiles.

10. Place a lime green $2x^2$ round plate to the right of the $2x^2$ tiles from the previous step so it is centered vertically. Then place a purple $1x^1$ round flower plate in front of the left column. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 5 - Magic Carpet

11. Vertically place 2 light purple panels with a middle wall, 1 in front of the other, on top of the round plate and flower plates, so the long walls face the right.

12. Horizontally place a purple 2x4 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and overhangs 2 columns to the right.

Group 6 - Magic Carpet

13. Place 2 white 2x2 round plates, 1 in front of the other, underneath the 2 rightmost columns of overhang so they are centered vertically.

14. Horizontally place a pink $1x^2$ plate with $2x^2$ side studs above the plate on the front row to the right of the $1x^2$ panel with a middle wall so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

15. Vertically place a light purple 1x4 plate to the right of the 1x2 panels with a middle wall so it sits in between the side studs. Then vertically place 2 purple 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the right.

16. Vertically place 2 purple 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top of the 1x4 plate from the previous step so they slope to the right.

17. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs above the plate on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a light purple 1x1 round flower plate on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

18. Place 2 purple 2x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right.

19. Vertically place 2 light purple 1x2 panels with a middle wall, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so the long walls face the right.

20. Horizontally place a light purple 1x4 plate upright on the lower row of the left 2x4 front-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

21. Horizontally place a white 1x3 plate upright on the left 3 columns of the lower row of the right 2x4 set of front-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

You will have an extra 2x4 plate. Save it for later!

Group 7 - Magic Carpet

22.1. Let's make a part! Place a white 4x4 plate with inverted sloped sides in front of you so it slopes to the front and back. Then vertically place a gold 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the bar faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

22.2. Horizontally place a white 2x4 plate from group 6 on the middle 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

22.3. Place 2 purple 2x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the middle 2 columns so they are centered vertically.

22.4. Vertically place a purple 2x4 plate on the leftmost column so it overhangs 1 column to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

22.5. Flip your magic carpet build upside down so the 1x2 panels with a middle wall on the end face the right. Now horizontally place your part upside down on top in between the 2x2 round plates that are on the leftmost and rightmost side so it is centered vertically.

23. Make sure your build is still upside down. Now place a white 1x1 plate with a clip upright on the frontfacing side stud to the left of the 1x3 plate so the clip faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

24.1. Flip your build over so it is upright, horizontal, and the 1x2 panels with the middle walls on the end face the left. Place a light pink 2x2 sloped curved tile with a sticker upright on the 2 rightmost columns of front-facing side studs so it slopes it. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a light pink 2x2 sloped curved tile with a sticker upright on the 3rd and 4th columns of the front-facing side studs so it slopes up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Make sure all the sloped curved tiles slope up!

24.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place stickers 3 on the 4 light pink 2x2 sloped curved tiles. These stickers have a light pink flower inside of a gold area. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 8 - Magic Carpet

25.1. Place a light purple 2x2 sloped curved tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs to the left of each of the 2x2 sloped curved tiles from the previous step. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

25.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place stickers 4 on the 4 light purple 2x2 sloped curved tiles. These stickers have a light pink flower inside of a gold area. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

26. Flip your build so it is upside down and horizontal and the clips are on the left. Now horizontally attach the bar of a white cloud piece to each of the leftmost clips so the clouds face the right.

27.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a purple 4x4 sloped curved panel with 4 studs, a bar side , and a sticker in front of you so the studs are in the back. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2 clips on top so it is centered horizontally and the clips face the back.

27.2. Horizontally place a white 1x4 sloped curved tile on top so it is centered horizontally.

27.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the purple 4x4 sloped curved panel with 4 studs and a bar. This sticker has 2 gold swords with a large red flame below them! . Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

27.4. Attach a gold 1x1 clip to the leftmost bar so the anti stud faces the front. Then attach a gold 1x1 round plate with a gem dangling to it so it hangs down. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Make sure when the part is upright, the anti-studs of the 1x1 clips face the front!

27.5. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Make sure your main build is still upside down and horizontal. Then attach the clips of 1 part to the top-facing bar that is on the left side so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

28. Flip your magic carpet over! Now put it away while we make the Rapunzel and the hot air balloon!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 9 - Rapunzel

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with a light purple dress and tan shoes, 1 tan torso printed with a purple top, 1 tan head printed with light green eyes and pink lips, 1 blonde hair, and 2 pink flowers. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you! Now attach the pink flowers to the back of her hair!

Sub-build 4. Let's make a lantern! Place a transparent yellow 1x1 round brick in front of you. Then place a gold lantern cover on top. Now attach the lantern to her hand!

Group 10 - Hot Air Balloon

1. Place a tan 8x8 round plate in front of you. Then place a brown 2x2 round brick on top so it is centered.

2. Place 4 purple 1x6 curved bricks next to each other on top of the edge of the 8x8 round brick! They should follow the curve and make a circle!

Group 11 - Hot Air Balloon

3. Repeat the previous step on top of the previous bricks using 4 light purple 1x6 curved bricks.

4. Vertically place the short side of a light brown stair plate on top of the 2x2 round brick that is in the center so it faces the back. The back row of the plate should sit on the back row of the curved bricks.

5. Horizontally place a gold $1x^2$ plate with a bar on the long side on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the bar faces the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the bar faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

6. Place a tan 1x1 plate with a side stud hanging down on the front left corner on top of the curved bricks so the side stud faces the front left. Now repeat symmetrically to the other 3 corners!

7. Place 4 magenta 1x6 curved tiles next to each other, on the edge of the build so they form a circle!

8. Place a gold 1x1 plate with 3 leaves upright on the side stud that faces the front left corner so the leaves face down. Then place a transparent 1x1 gem tile upright on it. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the other 3 corners!

9.1. Attach the clips of a white flag with a sticker to the front-facing bar so the flag hangs down and the sticker faces the front. Then repeat again symmetrically to the left-facing and right-facing bars.

9.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place stickers 2 on the 3 white flags with 2 clips. These stickers have a gold star in the center of a purple pink area. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 12 - Hot Air Balloon

10. Attach a gold 1x1 clip to the left-facing bar so the anti-stud faces up. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate upside down on top of the anti-stud. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

11. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 11L axle in front of you. Then attach a red 2L axle connector to the right side.

You will have an extra light blue 2x2 round plate. Save it for later!

Group 13 - Hot Air Balloon

12. Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a light blue 2x2 round plate from group 12 on top. Now insert your part into the left-facing side so it goes all the way in and the studs face the right. Make sure it touches the previous 2L axle connector.

13. Insert a white 2x2 plate with 8 bars around into the left-facing side so it attaches to the anti-studs of the 2x2 round plate.

14. Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a brown 2x2 round tile with a hole on top. Now insert your part into the left-facing side so the tile side faces the right. Make sure it touches the 2x2 plate with 8 bars!

Group 14 - Hot Air Balloon

15. Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 round plate. Then place a nougat 2x2 plate with 8 bars around it on top. Now insert your part into the left-facing axle so the studs attach to the anti studs.

16. Insert 2 brown 2L pin connectors into the left-facing axle so they go all the way in. Now insert a light grey 1L axle connector into the left-facing axle so it goes all the way in.

17. Bring back your hot air balloon build. Now take your part and insert the left-facing axle upright into the top-facing middle hole of the 2x2 round tile.

18.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a gold mechanical arm in front of you so the clip is on the right and faces down. Now insert a gold bar into the left-facing hole.

18.2 Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach the clip of 1 part to the left-facing bar of the lower 2x2 plate with 8 bars so the bar faces diagonal into the upside down 1x1 round plate that is on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

19.1. Let's make a part! Place a gold 1x1 cone brick in front of you. Then place a gold 1x1 telescope bar on top. Now attach a tan double-sided clip to the bar so it faces the back.

19.2. Attach the back clip of your part to the front-facing bar that has a flag attached so the anti-stud of the cone brick faces the front.

20. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 3L axle in front of you. Then insert a red 2L axle connector into the left-facing side.

You will have an extra tan 2x2 round plate. Save it for later!

Group 15 - Hot Air Balloon

21. Insert a light blue 2x2 round plate into the right-facing axle so it touches the connector and the studs face the right. Now insert a tan 2x2 round plate into the right-facing axle so it attaches to the previous plate.

22. Insert a white 2x2 plate with 8 bars around it into the right-facing axle so it attaches to the previous plate.

23. Insert a black 8L axle into the left-facing axle connector.

24. Bring back your hot air balloon build. Then insert the left-facing axle upright into the top-facing axle connector.

25. Vertically attach the clip of a purple sloped curved hot air balloon cover to the top front-facing bar so it hangs down. The stud of it should face the front and be at the bottom. Now repeat symmetrically to the left, right, and back facing bars.

Group 16 - Hot Air Balloon

26.1. Let's make 4 identical parts! Vertically place a gold sloped curved hot air balloon cover in front of you so the stud is in the front and faces up. Then place a transparent 1x1 gem tile on top.

26.2. Now you should have 4 identical parts! Vertically attach the clip of a gold sloped curved hot air balloon cover to the top front right facing bar so it hangs down. Then repeat symmetrically to the front left, back left, and back right. Make sure the gem tiles are at the bottom and face outwards!

27. Place a gold 4x4 dish on top so it is centered. Now put your hot air balloon away while we make Cinderella!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 17 - Cinderella and Horse

Sub-build 5. Locate a pair of legs printed with a light blue and blue dress, 1 tan torso printed with a light blue top, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes and pink lips, and 1 blonde hair with a light blue headband. Assemble your minifigure then put her aside while we make a pumpkin and carrot!

Sub-build 6. Place an orange pumpkin in front of you. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now put this away!

Sub-build 7. Insert a green stem into an orange carrot, then put it away so we can make a horse!

Sub-build 8. Horizontally place a white horse with light blue hair in front of you so the head faces the left. Then insert a transparent pink flame into the left-facing hole of the head so it faces up. Now place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then place a white 2x2 half-cylinder brick on top so it slopes to the front and back. There should not be any overhang! Now put your horse away while we make the carriage!

Group 18 - Carriage

1. Horizontally place a white 2x12 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 2x2 plate with 2 circles and 2 pins underneath the 2 leftmost columns so the pins face front and back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

2. Horizontally place a light blue 2x3 plate on top of the 3 leftmost columns. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Vertically place a tan 2x4 plate underneath the 2x12 plate so it is centered horizontally and there is 1 row exposed to the front and back.

4. Place a light grey 2x2 plate with a socket on the 2 rightmost columns so the socket faces the right.

5. Horizontally place a white 2x3 tile with an angled side on the 3 leftmost columns so the angled side faces the right. Now vertically place a white 1x2 jumper plate on the rightmost column. Then place a white 2x2 sloped curved tile to the left so it slopes to the left.

6. Place 2 white 1x1 plates with an upright double-sided stud, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row of the middle 2x4 plate so the double-sided studs are in the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

7. Horizontally place 2 white 2x6 inverted sloped curved bricks with 3 holes on top of the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. They should sit on the 2x12 plate and 1x1 plates with a double sided stud from the previous step!

8.1. Vertically place a tan 2x4 plate on top of the 2x6 inverted sloped curved bricks from the previous step so it is centered horizontally.

8.2. Place a red 2x2 plate with 2 side studs to the right of the front 2 rows of the previous 2x4 plate so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

9. Horizontally place a yellow 2x6 plate on top of the plates from the previous 2 steps so it is centered vertically.

10.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a tan 2x3 stair plate in front of you so it overhangs to the back. Now horizontally place a gold 1x2 ingot tile on the front row. Then horizontally place another 1 behind it.

10.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place the overhang of 1 part on the front row of the 2x4 plate that is in between the side studs so it overhangs 2 rows to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

11. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the leftmost column of the 2x6 inverted sloped curved bricks so the side studs face the left and it is centered vertically. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate in front and behind it.

12. Vertically place a white 1x4 plate on top of the plates from the previous step so it is centered vertically.

13. Vertically place a pink 1x2 brick to the right of the 1x4 plate from the previous step so it is centered vertically. Then place a pink 1x1 brick with a side stud in front and behind it so the side studs face outwards to the front and back.

14. Vertically place 2 pink 1x2 tri-slope tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the bricks from the previous step so they slope to the right. Then vertically place a pink 2x4 tile to the right so it is centered vertically.

15. Vertically place 2 brown 1x2 panels with a middle wall, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the previous 2x4 tile so the long walls face the right. Make sure they don't overhang!

16. Vertically place a pink $1x^2$ brick to the right of the $1x^2$ panels with a middle wall from the previou step so it is centered vertically. Then place a pink $1x^1$ brick with a side stud in front and behind it so the side studs face outwards to the front and back.

17. Place a gold 1x1 round plate on the front row to the right of the bricks from the previous step. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

18. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs on top in between the 1x1 round plates from the previous step so the side studs face the right.

19. Vertically place a white 1x4 plate on top of the plates from the previous 2 steps so it is centered vertically.

Group 19 - Carriage

20.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a light blue 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place the right angle corner of a white 3x3 quarter sloped curved brick on top so it curves to the back right.

20.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 part upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ingot tiles so it curves to the bottom right. The 1x1 plate part should be in front of the 1x2 panel with a middle wall. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

21. Attach the bar of a gold curve with a swirl to the right-facing side stud underneath the right part you place so it faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

22.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a light blue 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place the right angle corner of a white 3x3 quarter sloped curved brick on top so it curves to the back right.

22.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Rotate your build 180 degrees. Place 1 part upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ingot tiles so it curves to the bottom right. The 1x1 plate part should be in front of the 1x2 tri-slope tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

23. Attach the bar of a gold curve with a swirl to the right-facing side stud underneath the right part you place so it faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

24.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a light blue 2x6 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the right.

24.2. Place a white 3x3 curved plate on the back right corner so the curve faces the back right. It should overhang 1 stud to the left. Now repeat symmetrically to the front.

24.3. Place a light blue 1x1 plate underneath the front overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

24.4. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 part in between the upright parts you placed on the right so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Group 20 - Carriage

25. Place a gold 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front left stud of the previous part you placed on the right so the leaves face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

26. Vertically place a white 1x2 jumper plate on the rightmost column of your previous part you placed on the right so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

27.1. Vertically place a white 2x3 tile with an angled side and a sticker upright on the 2x2 left-facing studs so the angled side hangs down.

27.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the white 2x3 tile with an angled side. This sticker has a light blue background and a crystal shoe in the middle. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

28. Place a gold 1x1 round plate on the jumper plate to the right of the upright 2x3 tile with an angled side you placed in the previous step. Then place a gold 1x1 clip on the rightmost 1x2 jumper plate so the clip hands face left and right.

29.1. Vertically place a transparent pink heart with a bar on top of the 1x1 round plate from the previous step.

29.2. Let's make a lantern! Place a gold 1x1 round plate in front of you. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 round brick on top. Now place a gold lantern on top.

29.3. Attach the bar of the lantern to the previous 1x1 clip that is on the right so the anti-stud faces up.

30.1. Let's make a chest! Horizontally place a brown 2x4 chest bottom in front of you so the lower lip faces the back. Then place a transparent 1x2 tile printed with 2 light blue slippers inside. Now attach a brown 2x4 chest top to the back, then close it!

30.2. Vertically place your part upright on the right-facing side studs so it is centered vertically and it opens from top to bottom.

31. Attach a large gold wheel with curves to each of the front-facing pins so the wheel faces outwards. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

32. Put away your carriage while we adapt the horse to pull it! Horizontally place your horse in front of you so the head faces the left. Then detach the 2x2 tile with a stud and 2x2 half-cylinder brick and put them away.

33. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue $2x^2$ plate attached to a $1x^2$ plate with 2 long bars in front of you so the $1x^2$ plate is on the left. Then place a light grey $2x^2$ plate with a ball on the 2 rightmost columns so the ball faces the right.

34. Place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the 2x2 plate with a ball.

35. Place the 1x2 plate of your part on the right column of your horse so the 2x2 plate part overhangs to the right.

36. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the left column of your horse.

37. Locate the white $2x^2$ half-cylinder brick and the $2x^2$ tile with a stud that you took off your horse. Separate them and put the $2x^2$ tile with a stud away.

38. Place the white 2x2 half-cylinder brick in the 2x2 gap of your horse so it slopes to the front and back.

39. Now bring back your carrier and horizontally place it in front of you so the socket faces the left. Now attach the right-facing ball of your horse to the socket!
