

71810 Young Dragon Riyu

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Boys and girls aged 6+ can recreate aerial adventures from season 2 of the NINJAGO® Dragons Rising TV show with this Young Dragon Riyu (71810) playset. This kids 'dragon toy features a Young Riyu model with posable wings and legs, a posable tail, and a saddle so that minifigures can ride on his back.

This ninja toy comes with 3 minifigures: Arin armed with a climbing hook and katana sword accessory, Sora with a katana sword accessory, and a villainous Wolf Mask Warrior with a sword accessory. Kids have all they need to role-play being a ninja warrior and play out action-packed battles.

The LEGO® NINJAGO range of buildable ninja toys for kids includes mechs, vehicles and temples for exciting role-play adventures. Each battle set can be created with the LEGO Builder app, which guides you and your child on an easy and intuitive building adventure.

All-action dragon toy for kids – Boys and girls aged 6 years old and up can play out scenes from season 2 of the NINJAGO® Dragons Rising TV show with the Young Dragon Riyu playset.

Posable dragon model – Kids can position the wings, tail and legs of this dragon toy before placing one of the NINJAGO® character minifigures in its saddle and soaring into the sky.

3 minifigures – Ninja playset includes Arin armed with a climbing hook and katana sword accessory, Sora with a katana sword accessory and a Wolf Mask Warrior with a sword accessory.

Ninja gift – This ninja toy provides a fun build-and-play experience and can be given as an unexpected treat to boys and girls who love pretending to be their ninja heroes.

Measurements – This 132-piece NINJAGO® toy set includes a dragon model measuring over 2.5 in. (6 cm) high, 7.5 in. (19 cm) long and 7 in. (18 cm) wide.

The front of the box shows Sora fighting a wolf mask warrior on the edge of a cliff! Luckily, Arin on his dragon named Riyu are closing in to help!

The back of the box shows Arin and Sora on the dragon flying through the air!

The top of the box shows a real size image of Arin.

The build is 132 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Arin, Wolf Mask Warrior, and Dragon.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Sora and the rest of the Dragon!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.

- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/71810>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 bags labeled 1 and 2, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Arin

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 light orange pair of legs printed with a light green karate belt, 1 light orange torso printed with an orange dragon, 1 light orange mask with a sword holder, 1 yellow head printed with eye brows, eyes, and hair on the sides, 1 light orange helmet with 2 spikes, 1 gold sword, and 1 gold hook. Assemble your minifigure, then attach the sword to the sword holder, then attach the hook to his hand! Make sure the spikes on the helmet face the front. Now put it away while we make the wolf warrior!

Group 2 - Wolf Mask Warrior

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 dark blue pair of legs printed with purple and dark grey drapes, 1 dark blue torso printed with purple and dark grey drapes, with light blue blades, 1 dark blue head printed with a wolf mask, 1 dark blue wolf head, and 1 silver sword. Assemble your minifigure then attach the sword to his hand!

Group 3 - Dragon

1. Vertically place a dark blue 2x4 plate with inverted sloped sides in front of you.
2. Horizontally place the rightmost column of 2 dark blue 1x4 inverted sloped curved bricks with a plate part on top of the left column, so they are centered vertically and slope and overhang 3 columns to the left.
3. Repeat the previous step symmetrically to the right.
4. Place a lime green 2x2 round plate on top so it is centered.
5. Vertically place a dark grey 1x4 plate with inverted sloped sides to the left of the previous 2x2 round plate so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
6. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2 rounded plate on the rightmost column. Then vertically place 2 dark grey 1x2 plates with a ball on the short side, 1 in front of the other, to the left so they overhang to the front and back and the balls face outwards.

7. Vertically place a light grey 2x4 plate with 2 angled sides on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the short end faces the right.
8. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2 rounded plate on top of each of the 1x4 plates with inverted sloped sides so they are centered vertically. Then vertically place a dark blue 2x4 plate in between the 1x2 round plates so it is centered vertically.
9. Place the right column of a dark grey 2x2 corner plate on the front left corner of the 2x4 plate from the previous step so it looks like the braille letter d. It should sit on the 1x2 rounded plate that is to the left! Now repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back!
10. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with 2 side studs above the plate on the front row of the 2 rightmost columns so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
11. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the long side on the rightmost column so the socket faces the right. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x2 rounded plate on top.
12. Vertically place 2 light grey 1x2 plates with a clip on the short side, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 2 rows, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so the clips face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
13. Vertically place a light grey 2x4 plate with 2 angled sides on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the short side faces the left.
14. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball on the short side on the front stud of the 2nd column from the left so it overhangs to the front and the ball faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
15. Place a dark grey 2x2 plate with a hole underneath on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the hole faces the left. Now insert a black 1L pin with a ball into it so the ball faces the left.

Group 4 - Dragon

16. Horizontally place a sand blue 1x3 tile on the front row to the left of the 1x2 plate with a clip. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now horizontally place a light orange 2x4 plate in between them so the leftmost column is free.
17. Horizontally place 2 light orange 1x6 plates, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the 1x2 rounded plate that is on the rightmost column so they are centered vertically.
18. Vertically place a sand blue 1x2 angled sloped curved tile on the front stud of the 2nd column from the left so the angled side faces the left and it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
19. Vertically place a sand blue 1x2 tri-slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left.

20. Horizontally place 2 light brown 1x2 plates with a clip and a stud, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the 1x2 rounded plate that is on the rightmost column so they are centered vertically and the clips are on the left.

21. Place a sand blue 2x2 plate with a mudguard on the 2 rightmost columns so the mudguard faces the right. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 ingot tile to the left of the top-facing clips so it is centered vertically.

22. Place a short tan 2x2 ridged brick to the left of the 1x2 ingot tile so it is centered vertically.

23-24. Attach the bar of a sand blue 4x5x2 angled sloped cockpit to the top-facing clips so the cockpit is on the left. Make sure to push it down so it touches the angled sloped curved tiles!

Group 5 - Dragon

25. Place a sand blue 1x1 brick on the front row in front of the bar from the previous piece. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

26. Vertically place a sand blue 1x4 sloped curved tile on top of the 1x1 bricks from the previous step so it is centered vertically.

27. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the front row of the 2 rightmost columns so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

28. Vertically place a brown 1x2 plate with a bar on the short side upright on the front-facing 2nd column from the right so the bar faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

29. Place a brown 2x2 sloped curved tile upright on the front-facing 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

30. Let's make a part! Insert a black 1L pin with a ball into a sand blue dragon head with ridges on the top. Now attach the ball of your part to the right-facing socket so the head faces the right!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 6 - Sora

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 white pair of legs printed with dark blue pockets and pink chains, 1 white torso printed with a pink belt with a gold buckle and pink backpack straps, 1 dark blue mask with a sword holder, 1 yellow head printed with a mean female head with scars, 1 pink hair with dark blue cat ears. Assemble your minifigure, then attach the sword to her hand and the cat ears to her hair! Now put your minifigure away while we continue making the dragon!

Group 7 - Dragon

31. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a dark blue 2x2 plate in front of you.

32. Place a light orange 1x1 round plate in the back right corner. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the short side on the front row so the socket faces the right.

33. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball on the short side on the back left corner so it overhangs 1 column to the left and the ball faces the left.

34. Horizontally place a mint blue 2x3 angled plate on the back row so the angled side overhangs to the back and the short side faces the left.

35. Place a sand blue 2x2 sloped curved tile with a sticker on the front 2 rows so it slopes to the front.

36. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the sand blue 2x2 sloped curved tile. This sticker is dark blue with orange scales! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

37.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with 2 side studs above the plate in front of you so the side studs face the left. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with 2 teeth upright on the left-facing side studs so the larger tooth is in the front.

37.2. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the long side on top so the socket faces the right.

37.3. Vertically place a sand blue 1x2 tri-slope tile on top so it slopes to the left.

37.4. Attach the socket of your part to the left-facing ball so the teeth face the front and the anti-studs face the left.

38. Now you should have 2 identical parts! These are the dragon's legs!

39. Attach the right-facing socket of each of your parts to the front-facing balls so the teeth face the right.

Group 8 - Dragon

40. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a dark blue 2x2 plate in front of you.

41. Place a light orange 1x1 round plate in the back left corner. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the short side on the front row so the socket faces the left.

42. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball on the short side on the back right corner so it overhangs 1 column to the right and the ball faces the right

43. Horizontally place a mint blue 2x3 angled plate on the back row so the angled side overhangs to the back and the short side faces the right.

44. Place a sand blue 2x2 sloped curved tile with a sticker on the front 2 rows so it slopes to the front.

45. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the sand blue 2x2 sloped curved tile. This sticker is dark blue and orange scales! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

46.1. Let's make another part! Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with 2 side studs above the plate in front of you so the side studs face the right. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with 2 teeth upright on the right-facing side studs so the larger tooth is in the front.

46.2. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the long side on top so the socket faces the left.

46.3. Vertically place a sand blue 1x2 tri-slope tile on top so it slopes to the right.

46.4. Attach the socket of your part to the right-facing ball so the teeth face the front and the anti-studs face the right.

47. Now you should have 2 identical parts! These are the dragon's legs!

48. Attach the left-facing socket of each of your parts to the back-facing balls so the teeth face the right.

49. Bend his legs down so the anti-studs of his feet face down and the teeth face the right. These are his toes!

Group 9 - Dragon

50. Let's make a part! Vertically place a mint blue 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the long side on top so the socket faces the right.

51. Place 2 dark blue 1x1 plates with a double-sided stud, 1 in front of the other, on top so the double-sided studs face the left.

52. Vertically place a sand blue 1x2 tri-slope tile on top so it slopes to the right.

53. Attach the bar of a gold ridged blade to the front-facing stud so the blade faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

54.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball and a socket on the short sides on top so the ball faces the left. Now place 2 sand blue 1x1 slope tiles on top so they slope to the right.

54.2. Attach the ball of your part to the right-facing socket of your previous part.

55. Make sure the dragon's head is still facing the right, then attach the socket of your part to the left-facing ball of your dragon! This is his tail!

56. Vertically attach the back-facing bar of 1 sand blue wing to the front-facing clips so the angled ends face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

57. Attach a gold fang with a clip to the small right-facing bar of the front wing so the fang curves down. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
