

43223 Asha in the City of Rosas

Inspire kids and Disney fans aged 6 and up to wish upon a star with this LEGO® I Disney Asha in the City of Rosas (43223) buildable set from Walt Disney Animation Studios' upcoming film, *Wish*. The kit includes a marketplace with stairs and a balcony, a back room with a table, a cart, a LEGO I Disney mini-doll figure and 2 LEGO I Disney figures.

This building set has 3 characters – Asha, her goat Valentino and Star – to encourage role play as kids explore daily life in the City of Rosas. Fulfill a child's passion for magical stories and making wishes with a building kit that makes a fun birthday gift.

A wish for adventure – Give a Disney fan, or any kid aged 6 and up who's a fan of adventures, a gift to inspire the imagination with this LEGO® I Disney Asha in the City of Rosas (43223) set.

Everyday play – The construction set includes a marketplace with double doors, a staircase, a back room with a table, a balcony, a cart with a flag, plus lots of accessories for creative play.

Fun characters – Includes an Asha LEGO® I Disney mini-doll figure and Valentino and Star LEGO I Disney figures. This set, based on the upcoming film from Walt Disney Animation Studios, *Wish*, is made for adventures in the City of Rosas market.

Stories await – The marketplace measures over 4.5 in. (12 cm) high, 7 in. (17 cm) wide and 4 in. (11 cm) deep, ready to inspire hours of inventive storytelling and imaginative play.

The front of the box shows Asha's house in a much larger city! Behind her house, there is a hill with lots of houses built on top! Asha's house is small but it has a staircase to the roof and even a palm tree!

The back of the box shows the backside of her house! It has a place to sit at a table with food!

The top of the box shows Asha with her cart and a yellow star figure!

The build is 154 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Asha, her cat, and her house!

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the rest of her house!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.

- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- “Anti-stud” is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43223>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 bags labeled 1 and 2, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Asha

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 dark tan pair of legs with black shoes and a light purple dress, 1 dark tan torso printed with a light purple top with a magenta necklace, 1 dark tan head printed with light brown eyes and dark red lips, and 1 brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you!

Sub-build 2.1. Let's make a flag! Attach a dark tan flag with 2 clips and 2 stickers to a tan 4L bar, then attach it to Asha's hand! Now put a little tan dog with a yellow shirt next to her!

Sub-build 2.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place 2 of sticker 6, 1 on each side of the dark tan flag with 2 clips. These stickers have a tan and magenta side, and have a dark red rose in the middle! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Sub-build 3. Let's make a part! Place a transparent 2x2 dish in front of you. Then stack 2 transparent 1x1 round bricks on top. Now place a yellow ball with pointy parts and eyes on top! This is Wish! Now put everything away while we make a cart!

Group 2 - Cart

1. Horizontally place a black 2x4 plate with a hole underneath in front of you.

2. Insert a tan 2L axle pin into the front-facing hole so the axle faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

3. Vertically place a brown 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the rightmost column so the clip faces the right. Then horizontally place a light purple 2x3 plate to the left.

4. Vertically place a brown 1x2 slope tile on the rightmost column so it slopes to the right.

5. Vertically place a light purple 3x4 crate on the 3 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. It should overhang 1 row in the front and back.

6. Attach brown handlebars to the right-facing clip so the ends of the 2 handles face the right and are angled down.

7. Attach a gold wheel with spokes to the front-facing axle. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now put your cart away so we can make the house!

Group 3 - House

1. Horizontally place a dark tan 6x8 plate in front of you.
2. Let's make a door! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 door frame in front of you so the thinner sides face the front. Now attach 2 dark brown doors to the front. Now place 4 gold 1x1 round plates, 1 on each stud of each side of the doors. Now horizontally place your door on the back left corner of the 6x8 plate so the doors open to the back.
3. Vertically place a white 1x2 panel on the leftmost column in front of the doorframe so the wall faces the left.
- 4.1. Horizontally place a purple 2x4 tile with a sticker to the right of the previous 1x2 panel. This is a rug!
- 4.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the purple 2x4 tile. This sticker is a purple, teal, and pink stripe rug. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
5. Vertically place a tan 1x3 slope brick on the back 3 rows on the 2nd column from the right so it slopes to the front.
6. Rotate your build so it is vertical and the doors open to the right. Now vertically place the back row of a light brown 2x4 plate on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so it overhangs 3 rows to the front.
7. Place a dark tan 10x10 plate with a rounded side underneath the overhang so the rounded side faces the left and the rightmost column aligns with the rightmost column of the 6x8 plate.
8. Vertically place a tan 2x4 brick to the right of the previous 2x4 plate so 1 column overhangs to the right.
9. Horizontally place a tan 1x3 slope brick in front of the previous 2x4 plate and 2x4 brick so it slopes to the left and there is no overhang.
- 10.1. Vertically place a white 1x6x5 panel printed with a window, guitar, and plants on the rightmost column in front of the doorframe so the wall faces the left.
- 10.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the inside of the white 1x6x5 panel with prints. This sticker is 2 rugs hung up. There is a large red one and a smaller blue one! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
11. Rotate your build so it is horizontal and the doors are in the back left corner. Now place 2 light orange 2x2 crates, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the previous 1x6x5 panel so they are centered horizontally in between the slopes.
12. Let's make a part! Attach a green stem to the anti-stud of a purple 1x1 plate with balls. These are grapes! Now place it inside the left crate from the previous step. Then place a green apple in the right crate.

13. Place a white 1x1x3 brick on the leftmost column in front of the 1x2 panel. Then place another 1 in front of the rightmost 1x3 slope brick. Now horizontally place the right column of a white 1x2x3 brick in front of the 1x3 slope brick that is to the left.
14. Place a tan 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs above each of the 1x1x3 bricks so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs on top of the 1x2x3 brick from the previous step so the side studs face the front.
15. Place a gold 1x1 round plate on top of each of the 1x1x2 bricks with 2 side studs from the previous step. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 rounded plate on top of the 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs.
16. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x6 arch bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the plates from the previous step.
17. Vertically place a tan 1x4 brick in the back left corner on top of the door frame and arch brick.
18. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick to the right of the front and back rows of the 1x4 brick from the previous step.
19. Vertically place a tan 2x4 brick to the right of the horizontal 1x4 bricks from the previous step.
- 20-21. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick to the right of the front and back rows of the 2x4 brick from the previous step.

Group 4 - House

22. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the doors are in the front right corner now. Now horizontally place a tan 4x8 plate with a rounded side underneath the front 1x4 brick overhang so it is centered horizontally and the rounded side faces the front.
23. Place an orange 1x1 cone brick in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of the 1x4 brick overhang that is on top of the plate with a rounded side from the previous step. Now place a purple 2x2 round tile with a sticker on the front 2 rows of the 4x8 plate with a rounded side so it is centered horizontally.
24. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the purple 2x2 round tile. This sticker is a circular rug with a teal diamond surrounded by purple and teal dots. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
25. Horizontally place a light orange 2x4 tile with 2 studs behind the 2x2 round tile so it is centered horizontally on the 1x4 brick and 1x1 cone bricks.

You will have an extra pink 1x1 ice cream. Save it for later!

Group 5 - House

26. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 rounded plate on top of the right stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs so it is centered horizontally on it. Now place a brown 1x1 ice cream on the right stud. Then place a pink 1x1 ice cream from group 4 on the left stud. Now rotate the 1x2 rounded plate so the ends face the back left and front right.

27. Place a white tea cup on the left stud of the previous 2x4 tile with 2 studs.

28. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 slope brick on the front 2 rows of the 10x10 plate with a rounded side so it slopes to the right and the 2 leftmost columns are free.

29. Place a brown 1x1 brick with an axle hole to the left of the front row of the previous 2x4 slope brick so the axle hole faces the left. Now attach a dark brown 1x1 pin connector connected to a 1L axle to the axle hole so the pinhole faces up. This piece is a horizontal hole that has a vertical axle underneath it!

30. Vertically place a brown 2x4 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns behind the pin connector and 1x1 brick with an axle hole so it slopes to the back.

31. Place a green 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it sits on top of the 2x4 slope bricks and 1x1 brick with an axle hole.

32. Place a teal 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so the leaves face the front right. Then place another 1 on the leftmost column on top of the 2x4 slope brick so the leaves face the back left.

33. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the doors are in the back left. Now place a dark brown 2x2 barrel on the front 2 rows so the 5 leftmost columns are free. It should sit underneath 2x2 front-facing side studs!

34. Let's make a part! Insert a green stem into an orange carrot! Now place your carrot inside the barrel!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 6 - House

35. Place a green 2x2 tile with a stud to the right of the barrel from the previous step.

36.1. Vertically place the back row of a light blue 2x3 tile with a sticker to the right of the front row of the 2x2 tile with a stud from the previous step.

36.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the purple 2x3 tile. This sticker is a blue rug with 3 light blue diamonds running down the center. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

37. Place a dark red 2x2 brick to the right of the front 2 rows of the 2x3 tile from the previous step. Then place another 1 behind it.

38. Place a light brown 1x1 wine glass on the back right and front left corner of the back 2x2 brick from the previous step. Then place a light brown 1x1 bowl on the center of the front 2x2 brick from the previous step.

39. Horizontally place a white 1x4 fence to the right of the front row of the back 2x2 brick from step 37. Then place a white 1x1 flower plate in front of the rightmost column of the 1x4 fence.
40. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a white 2x4 brick in front of the 1x1 flower plate from the previous step.
41. Horizontally place the front row of a white 2x4 brick on top of the back row of the previous 2x4 brick so it overhangs 1 row to the back.
42. Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick on top of the 1x4 fence and 2x4 brick so there is no overhang.
43. Horizontally place a tan 1x3 slope brick on the back left corner on top of the 1x4 bricks so it slopes to the right. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right so it slopes to the left.
44. Vertically place a tan 1x3 slope brick on the leftmost column in front of the slope brick from the previous step so it slopes to the front. Now vertically place another 1 in front of the rightmost column of the right 1x3 slope brick from the previous step so it slopes to the front. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 tile in between the front rows of the 1x3 slope bricks.

Group 7 - House

45. Horizontally place the front row of a white spiral staircase on top of the back row of the upper 2x4 brick that is in the front right corner so the spiral staircase curves to the left and connects to 2 studs.
46. Horizontally place a white 4x6 plate on the back 4 rows so the rightmost column sits on top of the leftmost column of the spiral staircase.
47. Place a dark red 2x2 brick in the back left corner of the previous 4x6 plate. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick in front of the left column of the 2x2 brick.
48. Vertically place a tan 1x3 slope brick on top of the previous 1x2 brick and front left corner of the 2x2 brick so it slopes to the back.
49. Place 3 green 1x1 round flower plates on the rest of the studs of the 2x2 brick from step 47.

Group 8 - House

50. Place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the green 1x1 round flower plates from the previous step.
51. Place a gold 1x1 round plate on the front right corner of the previous 4x6 plate from step 46. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 fence to the left.
52. Place a tan 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top of the 1x1 round plate from the previous step so the side studs face the front.
53. Horizontally place the right column of a white 1x2 jumper plate on top of the previous 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 tile to the left.

54. Place a white 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on top of the previous 1x2 jumper plate. Then place a white 2x2 dish upside down on top.

55. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 jumper plate upright on the lower row of the 2x2 front-facing side studs.

56. Place the lower row of a white 1x3 curved tile upright on the upper front-facing side stud of the leftmost column so the curve faces the top left. Now place another 1 upright to the right so it creates an arch! Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right so you have 2 arches in total!

57. Place a white 1x1 tile printed with a light grey rose upright on the front-facing side stud underneath the 1x3 curved tile of the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place another 1 upright on the front-facing stud of the 1x2 jumper plate.

58. Vertically place a copper green 1x2 plate with a clip and a stud on the back left corner so the clip is in the back. Then vertically place another 1 to the right so it sits to the left of the flower plates.

Group 9 - House

59.1. Let's make a roof! Place a teal 6x6 plate in front of you. Now we are going to place 6 light blue 1x1 quarter tiles, all of which will point to the back and the curves will face the front! Place 1 on the 2nd column and 4th column from the left of the 2nd row from the back. Then place another 1 on the 3rd column from the left of the 3rd row from the back. Now place 1 on the 2nd and 4th column from the right of the 2nd row from the front. Now place another 1 on the 3rd column from the right of the front row.

59.2. Flip your part upside down so the curves of the quarter tiles face the front. Then vertically place a brown 2x3 plate with a bar underneath on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

59.3. Attach the bars of your part to the 2 clips in the back left corner so it slopes to the front.

60. Let's make some leaves! Horizontally place a green 1x4 leaf plate with 6 studs in front of you so the extended stud faces the left. Place a teal 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in the back left corner so the leaves face the left. Then place another 1 on the front right corner so the leaves face the left. Now place a white 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of them. Now place the rightmost column of your part upright on the upper rightmost front-facing side stud so it hangs down.

61. Let's make a palm tree! Horizontally place a brown 2L pin connector in front of you.

62. Insert a black 2L pin connector into the left and right sides of the pin connector.

63. Horizontally attach a brown 2L pin connector to the right-facing pin. Now insert a black 2L pin into the right-facing side.

64. Horizontally attach a brown 2L pin connector to the right-facing pin.

65. Attach a brown curved bar with a pin to the right-facing pin connector so it curves to the back.

66. Insert a green hotdog into the right-facing bar hole so it curves to the front. This is a leaf!

67.1. Attach a light green palm leaf plate to the hot dog so the leaves face the back and the studs face the right.

Group 10 - House

67.2. Attach a green palm leaf plate to the hot dog so the leaves face up and the studs face the right.

68. Attach a green palm leaf plate to the hot dog so the leaves face the front and the studs face the right.

69. Place your palm tree upright on the pin connector that is in the back right corner.

70. Place an orange pumpkin on the front left corner. Then place a stem with 3 leaves on top.

71.1. Horizontally place the front left corner of a red 2x3 tile with a sticker on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is to the right of the barrel. It should be slightly diagonal and the right end should face the front right.

71.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the red 2x3 tile. This sticker is a rug with red, blue, and yellow stripes. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

72.1. Place a transparent 1x1 bottle on the 2nd row from the front to the left of the 1x4 studs from the brick.

Group 11 - House

72.2. Place a transparent green bottle on the 3rd row from the front on top of the leftmost column of the 1x4 studs from the brick.

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
