## 76441 Hogwarts Castle: Dueling Club

It features a buildable battle platform for 2 minifigures – push the steps at either end to topple the minifigure opposite – plus 1 of 14 collectible Hogwarts portraits to display above the buildable fireplace. The set includes 4 popular characters: Harry Potter and Draco Malfoy<sup>™</sup> LEGO minifigures, each with a wand and magical spell elements, plus Gilderoy Lockhart<sup>™</sup> and Severus Snape<sup>™</sup> minifigures for creative role play.

A fun everyday Harry Potter gift idea for kids, this small set is a cool treat toy to introduce boys, girls and any budding wizards or witches to the LEGO brick-built Wizarding World.

The build is 158 pieces in total and is for ages 8+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Harry Potter, Draco Malfoy, and the dueling table.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Severus Snape and the dueling table.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Gilderoy Lockhart and the dueling table.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building,

here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).
- For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/76441</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

## Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1-3, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 6 - Steps 18-19. Group 7 - Steps 20-22. Group 8 - Steps 23-25. Group 9 - Steps 26-33. Group 10 - Step 34. Group 11 - Step 35. Group 12 - Steps 36-37. Group 13 - Steps 38-42. Bag 3 - Gilderoy Lockhart and Dueling Table Group 14 - Page 37. Group 15 - Steps 1-6. Group 16 - Steps 43-46. Group 17 - Steps 47-49. Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Harry Potter

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 short black pair of legs, 1 torso printed with a dark grey shirt, black and red jacket, 1 light tan head printed with eyes, lips, and glasses, 1 black hair, 1 dark brown wand with a stud, 1 transparent 2x2 dish, and 1 transparent diamond. Assemble your minifigure then attach the wand to his hand and orient it so the stud faces the front. Now place the dish upright on the front-facing stud. Then place the diamond upright on it. This is a wand casting a spell!

Group 2 - Draco Malfoy

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 short black pair of legs, 1 torso printed with a black jacket, 1 light tan head printed with eyes and lips, 1 blonde hair, 1 black wand with a stud, 1 transparent yellow 2x2 dish, and 1 transparent yellow diamond. Assemble your minifigure then attach the wand to his hand and orient it so the stud faces the front. Now place the dish upright on the front-facing stud. Then place the diamond upright on it. This is a wand casting a spell!

Group 3 - Dueling Table

1-2. Let's make the dueling table! Horizontally place a black 6x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x3 plate on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

3. Horizontally place a brown 1x10 plate on the back row to the left of the 1x3 plate so it overhangs 5 columns to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

4. Horizontally place a black 6x8 plate underneath the 5 leftmost columns of overhang so 3 columns are exposed to the left.

5. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 plate on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

6. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile on the 2 leftmost columns on the 2nd row from the back. Then horizontally place another one on the 2 rightmost columns on the 2nd row from the front. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x6 tile on the 6 leftmost columns on the 2nd row from the front. Then horizontally place another one on the 6 rightmost columns on the 2nd row from the back.

7. Place a white 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x3 tile to the right of the back row of the left 2x2 plate. Now horizontally place a tan 1x3 tile to the left of the front row of the right 2x2 plate.

8. Place a dark grey 2x2 tile on top of each of the 2x2 plates.

9. Horizontally place a white 1x3 brick in front of the left 1x3 tile. Then horizontally place another one behind the right 1x3 tile.

10. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 brick with a horizontal gap on the back left corner so the gap faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place 4 brown 1x2 log bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row, in between the 1x4 bricks with a gap. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 4 - Severus Snape

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 black pair of legs with pockets, 1 black torso printed with a suit, 1 light tan head printed with eyes, wrinkles, and lips, 1 black hair, and 1 black wand. Wands come in a set of 2, make sure to break 1 off! Assemble your minifigure then attach the wand to his hand!

Group 5 - Dueling Table

11. Let's make a part! Let's make the inside of the table! Horizontally place a black 2x3 plate in front of you.

12. Vertically place a brown 1x4 tile on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate to the left.

13. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a black 1x4 plate underneath the front overhang. Then horizontally place the rightmost column of a black 1x6 plate underneath the back overhang.

14. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a rail on the back row to the left of the 1x4 tile so the rail faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

15. Place a dark grey 2x2 corner plate on the back 2 rows to the left of the plate with a rail and 1x2 plate so it looks like the braille letter h. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

16. Horizontally place a brown 2x3 tile on the front 2 rows. Then place a brown 2x2 corner tile behind the 2 rightmost columns of the 2x3 tile so it looks like the braille letter j.

17. Horizontally place a black 1x6 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so it overhangs 4 columns to the left.

Group 6 - Dueling Table

18. Horizontally place a white 1x5 plate underneath the overhang so 1 column is exposed to the left.

19. Place the back row of a yellow 2x2 corner plate on the leftmost column so it looks like the braille letter f.

Group 7 - Dueling Table

20. Place a blue 2x2 corner plate underneath the leftmost column so it looks like the braille letter j.

21. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so 1 column overhangs to the left.

22. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 plate on the 3 leftmost columns. Then horizontally place a green 1x6 tile behind it so there is no overhang. Now horizontally place a brown 1x4 tile to the right.

Group 8 - Dueling Table

23. Place a red 1x4 tile on the 2 leftmost columns so 2 columns overhang to the left. Then place a white 1x1 round tile to the right.

24. Bring back your main build so it is horizontal. Then horizontally place your part on top so it is centered vertically and overhangs 4 columns to the right. The 1x2 plates with rails should be on the right.

25. Push the right side of the part you just placed to the left so the rail fits in the gaps of the 1x4 bricks with gaps. 1 column should still overhang to the right.

Group 9 - Dueling Table

26. Let's make a part! Let's make the inside of the table! Horizontally place a black 2x3 plate in front of you.

27. Vertically place a brown 1x4 tile on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate to the left.

28. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a black 1x4 plate underneath the front overhang. Then horizontally place the rightmost column of a black 1x6 plate underneath the back overhang.

29. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a rail on the back row to the left of the 1x4 tile so the rail faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

30. Place a dark grey 2x2 corner plate on the back 2 rows to the left of the plate with a rail and 1x2 plate so it looks like the braille letter h. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

31. Horizontally place a brown 2x3 tile on the front 2 rows. Then place a brown 2x2 corner tile behind the 2 rightmost columns of the 2x3 tile so it looks like the braille letter j.

32. Horizontally place a black 1x6 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so it overhangs 4 columns to the left.

33. Horizontally place a white 1x5 plate underneath the overhang so 1 column is exposed to the left.

Group 10 - Dueling Table

34. Place the back row of a green 2x2 corner plate on the leftmost column so it looks like the braille letter f.

Group 11 - Dueling Table

35. Place a blue 2x2 corner plate underneath the leftmost column so it looks like the braille letter j.

Group 12- Dueling Table

36. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so 1 column overhangs to the left.

37. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 plate on the 3 leftmost columns. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x6 tile behind it so there is no overhang. Now horizontally place a brown 1x4 tile to the right.

Group 13 - Dueling Table

38. Place a red 1x4 tile on the 2 leftmost columns so 2 columns overhang to the left. Then place a white 1x1 round tile to the right.

39. Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the overhang faces the right. Now horizontally place your part on top so it is centered vertically and the side with the rails overhangs 4 columns to the left.

40. Push the left side of your part to the right so the rail sits in the gap of the bricks. 1 column should still overhang to the left.

41. Horizontally place a dark brown 2x6 plate on the back left corner so there is no overhang. It should sit on 1 row of studs and 1 row of tiles. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

42. Horizontally place a dark brown 2x4 plate on the back 2 rows in between the 2x6 plates. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 14 - Gilderoy Lockheart

Sub-build 4. Locate a dark grey pair of legs, 1 light grey torso printed with a light grey and dark grey plaid shirt, and white sleeves, 1 copper green cape, 1 light tan head with a smile, eyes, and eye lashes, 1 light brown hair, and 1 dark tan wand. Wands come in a set of 2, make sure to break 1 off! Assemble your minifigure then attach the wand to his hand!

Group 15 - Fireplace

1. Let's make a fireplace! Horizontally place a dark tan 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light tan 1x2x2 panel on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the back.

2. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 jumper plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a brown 1x1 round plate on top. Now place a transparent orange candle flame on top!

3. Vertically place a tan 1x2 log brick on the leftmost column. Then place a nougat 1x1 round tile on the front left corner. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

4. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a scroll on the back left corner so the scroll faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

5. Horizontally place a dark tan 2x4 plate on top so it is centered. Then horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other on the back row so they slope outwards to the left and right. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the back row on top of the slope bricks so the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile on top.

6. Vertically place a gold 2x3 tile with an angled side printed with an outline of a wizard with a question mark in the middle, upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered vertically and the angled side faces up.

Group 16 - Dueling Table

43.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a part for the dueling table! Horizontally place a red 1x6 plate in front of you.

43.2. Place a green 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so 1 row overhangs to the front. Then horizontally place the 2 rightmost columns of a red 1x6 plate underneath the overhang.

43.3. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with a clip on the short end on the 2 leftmost columns so the clip faces the left. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

43.4. Place a white 2x2 round brick underneath your part so it is centered.

43.5. Bring back your main build so it is centered. Now horizontally place your part on top so it is centered.

44. Horizontally place 2 brown 1x8 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

45. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 plate on the 3 leftmost columns on the 2nd row from the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

46. Place a black 4x4 plate to the right of the left 1x3 plates from the previous step so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place a black 2x4 plate in between them.

Group 17 - Dueling Table

47.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with a bar on the short side in front of you so the bar faces the left. Then place a dark brown 2x2 plate on top so it overhangs 1 row to the front.

47.2. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate underneath the front overhang. Now horizontally place 2 jumper plates, 1 in front of the other, on top.

47.3. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Pull the left overhang to the left so the clip underneath the 4x4 plate is exposed. Then attach the bar of 1 part to the clip so the studs face up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

48. Horizontally place 2 purple 2x6 tiles printed with gold moons, 1 to the right of the other in between the jumper plates so they are centered vertically.

49. Horizontally place 2 brown 1x8 tiles printed with a purple background and stars on the 2nd row from the back so they are centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now put your minifigures on the jumper plates so they can blast each other off with their wands! Pull on 1 side of overhang to knock the minifigure on the other side off the table!
