The build is 204 pieces in total and is for ages 8+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Professor Flitwick and the classroom.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Ron Weasley and the classroom.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Hermione Granger and the classroom.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.

- Behind/Back: away from you.

- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.

- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.

- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.

- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/76442</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

## Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1, 2, and 3, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Professor Flitwick

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 short dark brown pair of legs, 1 olive green torso printed with a dark red and brown vest covered in gold stars, 1 white beard, 1 tan head printed with eyes and a white beard, and 1 set of brown wands. Assemble your minifigure, then break off 1 wand and attach it to his hand! Now put him away while we make the classroom!

Group 2 - Classroom

1. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x6 plate in front of you.

2. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 brick with 2 holes on the 2 leftmost columns. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 hinge plate on the 2 leftmost columns so 2 columns overhang to the left and the round hinge part faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

4. Horizontally place a brown 1x2x2 panel on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so the wall faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

5. Horizontally place a brown 1x6 brick on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally.

6. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x4x3 window frame on top so it is centered horizontally and the side with the ridges faces the back. Now attach 2 dark grey lattice window panes to the back-facing side of the frame.

7. Stack 2 dark tan 1x1 bricks and place them to the left of the window frame. Then place a dark nougat 1x1 round brick on top.

8-9. Place a dark nougat 1x1 round brick to the right of the window frame. Then stack 2 dark tan 1x1 bricks on top.

10. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark tan 4x6 plate in front of you.

11. Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate on the back right corner. Now place a light grey 2x2 corner plate to the left so it looks like the braille letter j.

12. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the front left corner.

13. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a rail on the back right corner so the rail faces the back. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x3 plate to the left.

14. Horizontally place a light grey 1x6 tile on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally.

You will have an extra light grey 1x1 plate. Save it for later!

Group 3 - Classroom

15.1. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a dark tan 1x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x4 brick on top so it overhangs 1 column to the right. Now place a light grey 1x1 plate from group 2 on the rightmost column. Then place a brown 1x1 plate to the left.

15.2. Horizontally place the overhang of your part on the back left corner of the previous part.

16. Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the round hinge parts face the front. Now horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of your part underneath the 2 rightmost columns of overhang.

17. Place a brown 1x1x3 brick on the back row on the 9th column from the right.

18.1. Horizontally place a brown 1x2x3 panel with a sticker to the right of the ppp so the wall faces the front.

18.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the brown 1x2x3 panel. This sticker has dark brown writing on it and says things such as worm, tail, cave, and more! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

19. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a side stud to the right of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Then place a light grey 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.

20.1. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4x3 panel with a sticker on the back row to the right of the ppp so the wall faces the back.

20.1. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the dark grey 1x4x3 panel. This sticker has a burning fireplace on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

21. Place a light grey 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the right of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Then place another 1 on top so the side studs face the front.

22. Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 plate to the left of the ppp so it sits on top of the 1x4x3 panel.

23. Horizontally place a brown 1x6 plate on the back right corner so there is no overhang.

24. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 ingot tile upright on the bottom 2 right front-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. The one on the left should only attach to 1 stud!

25.1. Horizontally place a light grey 2x6 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs above the 2 ppp.

25.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the light grey 2x6 tile. This sticker has a carving on it and it is of a book surrounded by leaves. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

26. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the back row on the 9th column from the right. Then place a dark nougat 1x1 round brick on top.

27. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x3x3 half arch brick to the right of the ppp so it arches to the right.

28. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x6 tile to the right and below the arch of the ppp.

29. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x3x3 half arch brick on the back right corner so it arches to the left.

30. Place a dark nougat 1x1 round brick on the back right corner. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 brick on top of the back row on the 8th and 9th columns from the right so it sits on the arch brick and 1x1 round brick.

31. Horizontally place a brown 1x6 plate on the back right corner so the only overhang is between the half arch bricks. Then place a brown 1x1 plate to the left. Now horizontally place a brown 1x4 hinge plate to the left so the round hinge part faces the front.

Group 4 - Classroom

32. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp.

33. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 tile on the back right corner. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down to the left so there is a 1 column gap in between them. Now horizontally place a dark brown 1x3 tile to the left so there is a 1 column gap in between them.

34. Horizontally place 2 dark brown 1x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the previous 1x2 plate with 2 side studs so they are centered horizontally on it and slope outwards to the left and right.

35.1. Place a dark nougat 2x2 tile with a rounded side and a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs so the rounded side hangs 1 row down.

35.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the dark nougat 2x2 tile with a rounded side. This sticker has a picture of snakes, dragons, and dogs. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 5 - Ron Weasley

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 short black pair of legs, 1 torso printed with a dark grey shirt, with a black and red suit over it, 1 tan head printed with eyes and lips, 1 red brown hair, 1 set of brown wands, and 1 white feather. Assemble your minifigure, then break off a wand and attach it to his hand, and then attach the feather to his other hand! Now put him away while we continue building the classroom!

Group 6 - Classroom

36. Let's make a part! Let's make another part of the classroom! Horizontally place a dark tan 4x6 plate in front of you.

37. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a brown 1x4 tile behind it so it is centered horizontally.

38. Vertically place a brown 2x3 tile to the right of the 2 ppp so it overhangs 1 column to the right. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x4 plate underneath the overhang so 1 stud is exposed to the back.

39. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 hinge plate on the back left corner so 2 columns overhang to the left and the round hinge part faces the front.

40. Place a dark tan 1x1 plate underneath the overhang on the 2nd column from the left.

Group 7 - Classroom

41. Horizontally place a brown 1x6 brick on the back row so it overhangs 2 columns to the right. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate underneath the overhang.

42. Place a brown 1x1 brick to the left of the previous 1x6 brick. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with a rail to the left so the rail faces the back.

43. Place 2 brown 1x1 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the previous 1x2 plate with a rail.

44. Place a brown 1x1 plate on the back row on the 3rd column from the right. Then horizontally place a brown 1x6 plate to the left.

45-46. Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the overhang faces the left. Now place a dark brown 1x1x3 brick on top of the 2nd column from the left of the main build. Then horizontally place the back right corner of your part underneath the overhang.

47.1. Horizontally place a brown 1x4x3 panel with a sticker on the back row to the left of the previous 1x1x3 brick so the wall faces the front.

47.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the brown 1x4x3 panel. This sticker has a bunch of words on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

48.1. Horizontally place a brown 1x4x3 panel with a sticker on the back row to the left of the ppp so the wall faces the front.

48.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the brown 1x4x3 panel. This sticker has a bunch of words on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 8 - Classroom

49. Place a dark nougat 1x1 round brick on the back row on the 11th column from the left. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick on top. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x3x3 half arch brick to the left so it arches to the left.

50. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x6 tile to the left and underneath the arch of the ppp. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x3x3 half arch brick to the left so it arches to the right.

51. Place a dark nougat 1x1 round brick on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 brick on the back row on the 10th and 11th columns from the left so it sits to the left of the 1x1 round brick.

52. Horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of a brown 1x4 hinge plate on top of the previous 1x2 brick so the round hinge part faces the front.

53. Place a brown 1x1 plate to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate to the left.

54.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

54.2. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 sloped curved tile on the leftmost column so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

54.3. Place 2 dark brown 1x1 slope tiles on top, 1 to the right of the other, so they slope outwards to the left and right.

54.4. Horizontally place your part above the 1x4x3 window frame with lattice window panes so it is centered horizontally on it. It should sit to the left of the 1x3 tile. It should sit on the back row on the 10th to 16th columns from the right.

55. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the back row on the 6th and 7th columns from the left so the side studs face the front. Make sure not to forget to count the 2 leftmost columns since they are much lower than the rest of the build!

56. Horizontally place 2 dark brown 1x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp so they are centered horizontally on it and slope outwards to the left and right. Then horizontally place a dark brown 1x3 tile to the right.

57.1. Place a dark nougat 2x2 tile with a rounded side and a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs so the rounded side hangs 1 row down.

57.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the dark nougat 2x2 tile with a rounded side. This sticker has a picture of snakes, dragons, and dogs. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

## Group 9 - Classroom

58. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate on the front left corner.

59. Place a brown 1x1 plate on the back left corner. Then place another 1 to the right of the 1x4 plate.

60. Horizontally place the front right corner of your part underneath the leftmost overhang.

61. Place a dark grey 1x1x3 brick on top of the front row of the 7th column from the left. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick on top.

62. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on the front left corner so the brick grooves face the left. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick on the front row to the right. Now horizontally place a brown 1x4 tile to the right.

63. Place a light grey 1x1x3 brick with 2 clips on the back left corner so the clips face the right.

64. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2x2 brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on top so the brick grooves face the front.

65. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x6x2 arch brick on top of the right column of the ppp so it also sits on the 1x1 brick that is to the right.

66. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 slope brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the back. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick on top.

67. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on the front row of the 2 leftmost columns so the brick grooves face the front. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick to the right. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the right so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick to the right so the brick grooves face the front.

68. Place a brown 1x1 plate on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with a rail to the right so the rail faces the front. Now horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 plate to the right. Then horizontally place a brown 1x4 hinge plate to the right so the round hinge part faces the front.

69. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 tile on the 8th and 9th columns from the left so it sits to the left of the 1x2 sloped curved tile.

70.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

70.2. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 sloped curved tile on the leftmost column so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

70.3. Place 2 dark brown 1x1 slope tiles on top, 1 to the right of the other, so they slope outwards to the left and right.

70.4. Horizontally place your part to the left of the previous 1x2 tile from step 69.

71. Place a dark brown 1x1 tile to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place a gold 2x3 pentagonal tile printed with a mystery wizard with a question mark, upright on the front-facing side studs so the angled side of the pentagonal tile hangs 2 rows above the side studs.

72. Rotate your build 180 degrees so it is horizontal. Now horizontally attach the bars of a dark brown rounded door to the left-facing clips on the rightmost column. Then attach a black lattice window pane with a rounded side to the hole of the door.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 10 - Hermione Granger

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 short black pair of legs printed with black shoes and dark grey socks, 1 black skirt, 1 black torso printed with a suit and tie, 1 tan head printed with eyes and lips, 1 brown hair, 1 white feather, and 1 dark tan set of wands. Assemble your minifigure then attach the feather to 1 hand, and break off a wand and attach it to her other hand! Now put her away while we continue the classroom!

Group 11 - Classroom

73. Rotate your build 180 degrees so it is horizontal and the door is on the left. Now place a black 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on the rightmost column on the 2nd row from the front. Place a black bar with a stud on each side on top. Then place a black 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top so the antistud faces up. Now place a transparent orange candle flame on top.

74. Let's make a part! Let's make a chalkboard! Horizontally place a brown 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x1 plate with a 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

75. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 arch brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

76.1. Horizontally place a brown 1x4x3 window frame on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side with the grooves faces the front. Now attach a black panel with a sticker to the front of the window frame by clipping it to the top left and top right corners!

76.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the black panel. This sticker has words and teachings on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

77. Horizontally place 2 dark tan 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp.

78. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 tile on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered on them.

79. Horizontally place your part on the front 2 rows on the 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th columns from the right.

80. Let's make a part! Let's make a table full of books! Horizontally place a dark tan 2x6 plate in front of you.

81.1. Horizontally place a brown 1x2x2 panel with a sticker on the front left corner so the wall faces the front.

81.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the brown 1x2x2 panel. This sticker has 3 books on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

82. Place a brown 1x1 plate on the front row to the right of the ppp.

83. Place a brown 1x1 slope tile on the front row to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the back. Then place a red brown 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the back row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it overhangs 1 row to the back and the studs are on the left.

84. Vertically place a bright yellow 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows of the 3rd column from the left. Then vertically place a nougat 1x2 brick with a hole on top so the hole faces left and right. Now vertically place a bright yellow 1x2 plate on top. Then insert a tan 2L pin axle into the right-facing side of the hole so the axle faces the right.

Group 12 - Classroom

85.1. Let's make a part! Place a transparent 1x1 round plate in front of you. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top so the bar faces up. Now place a white feather on top so the tips face the back.

85.2. Place a transparent 4L bar underneath your part. Now lay it on its side so it is horizontal and the bar faces the left.

85.3. Attach a brown bar holder with an axle hole to the left-facing bar so the axle hole faces front and back. Now attach the bar of a black faucet to the left-facing bar hole so the anti-stud faces up.

85.4. Attach the axle hole of your part to the right-facing axle so the feather is in the front and the tips of it face up.

86.1. Horizontally place a brown 1x2x2 panel with a sticker on the front right corner so the wall faces the front.

86.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the brown 1x2x2 panel. This sticker has 2 books and a feather on top of them. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

87. Horizontally place a dark brown 2x6 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

88. Vertically place a dark red 1x2 tile on the leftmost column. Then place a red brown 2x2 tile with 2 studs to the right so the studs are on the right. Now place an olive green 2x2 plate to the right.

Group 13 - Classroom

89. Vertically place a dark blue 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs sticking up on the 4th column from the right so the side studs face the left. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs upright on the left-facing side studs so the studs are in the back. Then vertically place an aqua 1x2 tile upright on the left-facing side studs.

90.1. Vertically place a teal 1x2 plate on the 2nd column from the right.

Group 14 - Classroom

90.2. Vertically place a dark blue 1x2 plate on the 3rd column from the right.

91. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 bricks with grooves, 1 in front of the other, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so the horizontal grooves face outwards to the front and back.

92. Place a dark blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top of the 2 ppp so the studs are in the front.

93. Vertically place a purple 1x2 tile on the 2nd column from the right.

94. Place a black 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on the front right corner. Then place a transparent orange candle flame on top.

95. Horizontally place the 1x2 overhang in the back of your part underneath the window with grated windows. It should sit on the gap below the window! It should sit on the 10th to 16th columns from the right.

Group 15 - Classroom

96. Let's make a part! Let's make a table where the students can sit! Horizontally place a brown 1x6 plate in front of you. Then place a brown 2x2 tile on top so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

97. Horizontally place a dark brown 2x6 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally.

98. Place a brown 2x2 tile with a stud on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

99. Horizontally place 3 dark brown 1x2 log bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row.

100. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x6 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

101. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile printed with words and a wand on the front left corner. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between.

102. Horizontally place your part to the left of the stack of books so it sits on the 2x4 tile with 2 studs and tiles. There should be no overhang!
