77054 Leif's Caravan & Garden Shop

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Here's a pretend play building kit for girls, boys and fans of the Animal Crossing[™] video game series who love creative storytelling. LEGO® Animal Crossing Leif's Caravan & Garden Shop (77054) gift for 7-plusyear-olds comes with 2 minifigures, a car and caravan toy and a garden shop for hours of imaginative play.

It will also appeal to kids who love vehicle playsets as they drive the movable car toy and caravan into town and set up the plant store. The set comes with 2 minifigures – Leif the sloth and Poppy the squirrel – and lots of creative accessories. Kids can pretend to plant the seeds and water them using the can and pump, or they can role-play Poppy buying plants in exchange for Bells.

Car and caravan toy – Leif's Caravan & Garden Shop building kit toy for girls, boys and Animal Crossing[™] fans sparks hours of creative storytelling and imaginative play.

2 LEGO® minifigures from Animal Crossing[™] – This garden shop playset includes Leif, a sloth minifigure, and Poppy, a squirrel minifigure, from the video game series.

Many ways to play – Kids imagine driving the attachable car and caravan toy, setting up the plant store, planting seeds and watering them with the can and pump and buying plants and seeds with Bells.

Playset with a versatile vehicle – The travel trailer toy's sides open out allowing the play to continue inside, so kids can settle Leif in after cooking a meal of fresh veggies on the camp stove.

Dimensions – This 263-piece vehicle playset includes car and travel trailer toys that measure over 3 in. (8 cm) high, 7.5 in. (19 cm) long and 2.5 in. (6 cm) wide when attached to each other.

The build is 263 pieces in total and is for ages 7+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Leif the sloth, the garden stand, and car.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Poppy the squirrel and part of the caravan.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the rest of the caravan.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.

- Behind/Back: away from you.

- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.

- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.

- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.

- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/77054</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1, 2, and 3, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 1 - Pages 4-5. Group 2 - Steps 1-3. Group 3 - Step 4. Group 4 - Steps 5-6. Group 5 - Steps 7-17 and 1 brown 1x1 round plate and 1 green 1x1 round flower plate from Step 18. Group 6 - Rest of Step 18 and Steps 19-20. Group 7 - Steps 1-3. Group 8 - Steps 4-5. Group 9 - Steps 6-12. Group 10 - Steps 13-22. Bag 2 - Poppy and Caravan Group 11 - Page 28-29. Group 12 - Steps 1-5 and 1 light yellow 2x2 tile from Step 6. Group 13 - Rest of Step 6 and Steps 7-12. Group 14 - Steps 13-22. Bag 3 - Caravan Group 15 - Steps 23-29. Group 16 - Steps 30-32 and 1 brown 1x4 plate from Step 33. Group 17 - Rest of Step 33 and Steps 34-40 and 1 magenta 1x1 round flower plate from Step 41. Group 18 - Rest of Step 41 and Steps 42-50. Group 19 - Step 51 and 1 transparent 2x2 round plate with a smooth underside from Step 52. Group 20 - Rest of Step 52.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Leif the Sloth

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 short olive green pair of legs, 1 olive green torso printed with yellow overalls, 1 oval olive green head printed with a white face, dark green eyes, and red lips and nose, a light green hat, and a light green watering can. Assemble your minifigure then place the hat on top of his head and the watering can in his hand! Now put him away while we make the garden stand!

Group 2 - Garden Stand

1. Place a green 4x4 rounded plate with 4 feet in front of you. Then horizontally place a lime green 2x4 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

2. Place a dark tan 2x2 tile with a stud on the back right corner.

3. Vertically place a tan 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the ppp. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 round tile to the left of the ppp on the 2nd row from the back.

Group 3 - Garden Stand

4. Place a tan 2x2 dish on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a green 1x1 cone brick on top.

Group 4 - Garden Stand

5.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a water dispenser! Place a green 1x1 brick with a side stud and a bottom lip in front of you so the side stud faces the right. Now place a green 1x1 round plate with a bent bar underneath upright on the left-facing anti-stud so the bar faces the bottom left.

5.2. Place a green 1x1 clip upright on the right-facing side stud so the clip hands face up and down. Now attach a green bar with a bar holder to the right-facing clip so the bar holder faces the bottom right. This is the spout where the water comes out!

5.3. Place a green 1x1 round plate on top. Then place a green 1x1 round tile on top.

5.4. Horizontally place the anti-stud of your part on top of the 1x1 cone brick so the bar holder faces the bottom right! Now put your build away while we make another part!

6. Place a green 4x4 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a lime green 2x4 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

Group 5 - Garden Stand

7. Vertically place a brown 2x4 plate on the 2 rightmost columns.

8. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the rightmost column on the 2nd row from the back. Then place another 1 on the 2nd column from the right on the 2nd row from the front.

9. Place a brown 1x1 round brick on the back row on the 3rd column from the right.

10. Place a brown 1x1 brick with a side stud on top of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Now place a white 2x2 tile printed with a tomato, carrot, and a watermelon upright on the front-facing side stud so it is centered on it.

11. Bring back your previous build so the water dispenser is in the back right corner. Now horizontally place your part on top of the 2 leftmost columns of the main build so it is centered vertically. Then put away your build while we make another part!

12. Place a green 4x4 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a brown 1x1 round plate on the back left corner.

13. Place a brown 1x1 round plate on the leftmost column on the 2nd row from the front. Then place another 1 on the back row on the 2nd column from the right.

14. Let's make a part! Place a red brown 3x3 plate in front of you. Then place a brown 1x1 round plate underneath the front right corner. Now place your part on top of the 3 1x1 round plates! The 1x1 round plates should sit underneath the corners of the 3x3 plate!

15. Place a tan 1x1 plate with a clip on the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then place another 1 on the back row on the 2nd column from the right so the clip faces the right.

16. Place a brown 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

17. Horizontally place a red brown 1x3 plate on top of the 2 ppp. You will have an extra 1 brown 1x1 round plate and 1 green 1x1 round flower plate. Save them for later!

Group 6 - Garden Stand

18.1. Place a tan 1x1 round plate on the leftmost column on the 2nd row from the front. Then place a brown 1x1 round plate from group 4 on top. Now place a green stem on top.

18.2. Place a tan 2x2 bowl on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the right. Then place a brown 1x1 round brick on top. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate from group 4 on top. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top.

19. Attach a dark grey shovel to the left-facing clip so the shovel head faces up. Now place a white 1x1 brick printed with a green background and yellow flowers on the back row on the 2nd column from the right so the print faces the front. Then place a white 1x1 tile on top.

20. Bring your main build back so it is horizontal and the 2 leftmost columns of the 2x4 plate face the left. Now place your part on top of the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Now put your garden stand away while we make a car!

Group 7 - Car

1. Horizontally place a black 4x7 plate with 4 small pins in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 2x3 plate on the middle 3 columns so it is centered vertically.

2. Horizontally place a white 2x3 plate on the 3 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a black 2x4 plate to the right.

3. Horizontally place a teal 1x3 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate on the 3rd column from the left so it is centered vertically.

Group 8 - Car

4. Vertically place a teal 1x4 plate on the 3rd column from the left so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate on the front row to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

5. Vertically place a teal 2x4 plate with taller ends and mudguards on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

Group 9 - Car

6. Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs hanging down on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate to the right so it is centered vertically.

7. Horizontally place a teal 1x4 plate upright on the top left-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place 2 dark grey 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the bottom left-facing side studs so they slope down.

8. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile printed with green trees upright on the left-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then place a transparent 1x1 plate upright on the left-facing side studs in front and behind the ppp.

9. Place a white 1x2 steering wheel on the 5th column from the right so it is centered vertically and the wheel faces the right. Then place a teal 2x2 plate to the left.

10. Vertically place a teal 2x4 plate with taller ends and mudguards on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

11. Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs hanging down on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right.

12. Horizontally place a teal 1x4 plate upright on the top right-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place 2 dark grey 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the bottom right-facing side studs so they slope down.

Group 10 - Car

13. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile upright on the right-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then place a transparent red 1x1 plate upright on the left-facing side studs in front and behind the ppp.

14. Place a teal 2x2 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and 1 column overhangs to the right over the ppp.

15. Horizontally place a teal 1x8 plate on the front row so the 2 rightmost columns align with the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

16. Vertically place a black 1x4 plate with a ball on the long side on the rightmost column so the ball faces the right.

17. Vertically place a teal 1x2 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 sloped curved tile in front so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

18. Vertically place a teal 2x4 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then place a light grey 1x1 plate with a doubled sided stud on the front row to the right so the double-sided stud is in the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

19.1. Let's make a part! Let's make the front of the car! Vertically place a teal 1x4 plate in front of you. Then place 2 teal 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top so they slope to the left and overhang to the right.

19.2. Vertically place your part on the leftmost column so 1 column overhangs to the left onto the upright parts!

20. Vertically place a teal 1x2 plate on the leftmost column to the left of the steering wheel so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate in front and behind it.

21. Vertically place a transparent 2x4x2 windshield on the 2 leftmost columns on top of the 3 ppp so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Then vertically place a teal 1x4 tile on top.

22. Insert 4 white wheels into 4 black tires. Then attach them to the front and back facing pins! Make sure the hollow sides face outwards! Now put away your car while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 11 - Poppy the Squirrel

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 short dark red pair of legs, 1 dark red tail, 1 white torso printed with a dark blue, green, and white dress with white and pink flowers, 1 dark red and white head with ears printed with eyes and a mouth, 1 light orange basket, and 1 yellow 1x1 round tile printed with a star. Assemble your minifigure, and make sure the tail is behind her and faces up, then attach the round tile and basket to her hands! This round tile is a coin! Now put her away while we make the caravan!

Group 12 - Caravan

1. Horizontally place an orange 6x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x3 tile on the back left corner. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right.

2. Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 plate on the front left corner. Then vertically place a light orange 2x4 plate on the 2 leftmost columns behind it.

3. Vertically place a light orange 1x4 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 plate on the 2nd column from the left on the 4th and 5th rows from the front.

4.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place an orange 1x4 plate on the 4 rightmost columns.

4.2. Place a light orange 1x4 hinge plate on the 2 leftmost column so 2 columns overhang to the left and the rounded hinge faces the front! This piece is 2 1x2 plates connected with a hinge!

4.3. Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 plate on the 6 rightmost columns.

4.4. Rotate your part 180 degrees, then horizontally place the 2 rightmost columns on the 2 leftmost columns of the 2nd row from the back. Now rotate the 1x6 plate of your part to the back so it sits in the back left corner.

5. Vertically place a light orange 1x3 plate on the leftmost column on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th rows from the front. Then place a light orange 1x1 plate to the right of the back row of the ppp.

6.1. Place a light yellow 2x2 tile on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right and 2nd and 3rd rows from the front.

Group 13 - Caravan

6.2. Place an orange $2x^2$ tile to the left of the ppp. Then place a light grey $2x^2$ tile with a stud behind the ppp. Now place an orange $2x^2$ tile to the right.

7. Place a white 1x1 corner panel on the 2nd column from the left and 2nd row from the front so the wall faces the front right. Then place a white 1x1 brick behind it. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 plate behind it.

8. Place a yellow 2x2 dome brick on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered on it. Then place a black 1x1 plate with a double-sided stud on top so the doubled sided stud is in the front. Now attach a silver fork to the right-facing side stud of the double-sided stud. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of the 1x1 plate with a double-sided stud. Now place a silver pan on top so the handle faces the left. This is a stove!

9. Place a light grey 1x1 faucet on top of the 2nd column from the left and 3rd row from the front so the bar faces the front. This is the sink! Then place a light orange 1x1 plate on the 2nd row from the front of the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

10. Place a black 2x2 plate with a socket on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and it overhangs 1 column to the left and the socket faces the left. Then vertically place a light orange 1x2 slope tile on the left column of it so it slopes to the left.

11. Vertically place a light orange 1x4 brick to the right of the ppp so it is centered vertically.

12. Vertically place 2 transparent 1x2x2 panels, 1 in front of the other, on top of the ppp so the walls face the left.

Group 14 - Caravan

13.1. Place a light orange 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then place a light orange 1x1x3 brick on top.

13.2. Place a light orange 1x1 brick with a side stud on top of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Then attach the bar of a light grey 1x1 round plate with a bar to the front-facing side stud so the stud faces up.

13.3. Place a lime green 1x1 round tile on top of the ppp. Then attach a transparent yellow 1x1 round brick underneath the 1x1 round plate with a bar.

14. Place 2 light orange 2x2 inverted slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top of the 2 1x2x2 panels so they are centered vertically and slope and overhang to the right.

15. Horizontally place an orange 1x4x5 door on the front row to the right of the front left corner so the door opens to the front. The stud of the door should be on the left! Then attach a transparent window to the back-facing hole of the door!

16. Vertically place a light orange 2x4 plate on the front left corner.

17.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a window! Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 transparent 1x2x2 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they are centered horizontally and the walls face the front.

17.2. Stack 2 light orange 1x1 bricks, then place them on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

17.3. Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 brick on top so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x4 plate on the 4 leftmost columns.

17.4. Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Then horizontally place your part on the front right corner so the 1x4 plate is on the left. Make sure your window is on the part that can rotate! There should be no overhang!

18. Locate 1 light orange 1x4 hinge plate. This plate is made up with 2 1x2 plates connected together with a rounded hinge part. Orient it so it looks like a 2x2 plate and the round part faces the right. Now place it on the front right corner of your build. Then rotate the previous part to the front to make sure it works, then put it back after!

19. Vertically place a light orange 1x4 arch brick on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically.

20. Horizontally place 4 light orange 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns so they are centered vertically and slope to the right.

21. Horizontally place a light orange 1x1 brick on the front row on the 3rd column from the left. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x4 brick to the right.

22. Horizontally place a light orange 1x2 sloped curved brick on the front right corner so it slopes to the right. Then place a light orange 1x1 plate to the left. Now horizontally place a light orange 1x3 tile to the left.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 15 - Caravan

23. Vertically place a light orange 1x6 brick on the 2nd column from the left so it is centered vertically. Then place a light orange 1x1 brick on the back row to the right.

24. Horizontally place a light orange 1x4 arch brick on the front left corner so it overhangs 3 columns to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

25. Vertically place an orange 2x6 plate underneath the leftmost column of overhang so 1 column is exposed to the left. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick with 4 side studs on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left. Then place a light orange 1x1 brick in front and behind it.

26. Place a light orange 6x6 plate on top of the 6 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

27. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile printed with green trees upright on the left-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then place a transparent red 1x1 plate upright on the left-facing side studs in front and behind the ppp.

28. Place a light orange 1x1x3 brick on the back left corner. Then place a light orange 1x1 brick on top. Now horizontally place a light orange 1x6 brick to the right.

29. Horizontally place a light orange 1x3 tile on the front left corner. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right. Now vertically place a light orange 2x4 plate on the 2 leftmost columns behind the 1x3 tile.

Group 16 - Caravan

30.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally stack 3 light orange 1x2 bricks with a side stud on top of each other so there is no overhang and the side studs face the front. Then place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the top front-facing side stud so the leaves face down. Then place a gold 1x1 round tile printed with a clock upright on the ppp.

30.2. Horizontally place your part on the back row to the left of the door so the side studs face the front.

31. Horizontally place 2 orange 1x2x2 window frames, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row, to the left of the ppp so the thinner sides face the back. Now insert a transparent window pane into the back side of each of them! Then horizontally place a light orange 1x2 brick with a side stud on top of each of them so the side studs face the back.

32. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the back, to the right of the leftmost 2x4 plate. Then horizontally place a brown 2x4 plate in front.

33.1. Vertically place a brown 1x4 plate on the 2nd column from the left, in front of the 1x3 tile.

Group 17 - Caravan

33.2. Vertically place a light orange 1x4 plate on the leftmost column, behind the 1x3 tile.

34. Horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved tile on the 2nd row from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it slopes to the right. Then place a white 2x2 sloped curved tile in front so it slopes to the right. Now vertically place a lime 1x3 tile to the right. Then vertically place a green 2x3 tile to the right.

35. Vertically place a light orange 1x3 plate on the leftmost column to the left of the sloped curved tiles.

36.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x4 plate on the 4 rightmost columns.

36.2. Horizontally place a light orange 1x4 hinge plate on the 2 leftmost columns so the round hinge part faces the back.

36.3. Horizontally place a transparent 1x2x2 panel on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so the wall faces the front. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left.

36.4. Stack 2 light orange 1x1 bricks on the rightmost column. Then stack 2 more on the 3rd column from the left.

36.5. Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 brick on top of the 6 rightmost columns.

36.6. Horizontally place a light orange 1x4 plate on the 4 rightmost columns.

36.7. Rotate your part 180 degrees so the round hinge part faces the front. Then horizontally place the rightmost 1x2 plate of your part on the 2 leftmost columns of the 2nd row from the front. Then rotate the overhang to the front so it sits in the front left corner.

37. Vertically place 2 transparent 1x2x2 panels, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so they are centered vertically and the walls face the left.

38. Place 2 light orange 2x2 inverted slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top of the 2 ppp so they are centered vertically and slope and overhang to the right.

39. Vertically place a light orange 2x4 plate on the back left corner.

40. Locate a light orange 1x4 hinge plate and orient it so it looks like a 2x2 plate and the round hinge part faces the left. Then place it on the front left corner so there is no overhang.

You will have an extra magenta 1x1 round flower plate. Save it for later !

Group 18 - Caravan

41. Open the car by rotating the front left corner to the left. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the 2nd column from the left and 2nd row from the front. Then place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate from group 17 on top. Make sure it is to the right of the panel and not on top of the 2x4 plate. Then close it back up after.

42. Place a light orange 1x1 brick on the front row to the left of the 1x3 tile. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x4 brick to the left.

43. Horizontally place a light orange 1x3 tile on the front row to the left of the 1x3 tile. Then place a light orange 1x1 plate to the left. Now horizontally place a light orange 1x2 sloped curved brick to the left so it slopes to the left.

44. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the door faces the front. Now place a light orange 1x1 plate on the front row on the 3rd column from the right. Then place another 1 to the left. Now horizontally place a light orange 1x6 plate to the left.

45. Vertically place a light orange 1x4 arch brick on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically.

46. Horizontally place 4 light orange 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns, on top of the ppp so they slope to the right.

47. Horizontally place a light orange 1x4 brick on the front row on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the right. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x6 brick to the left.

48. Horizontally place a light orange $1x^2$ sloped curved brick on the front left corner so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a light orange $1x^4$ tile to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

49. Horizontally place a light orange 6x8 plate on top so it is centered.

50. Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 sloped curved brick upright on the front-facing side studs, above the windows so it slopes to the front.

Group 19 - Caravan

51.1. Let's make a part! Let's make the wheels! Horizontally place an orange 2x6 plate in front of you. Then place a light grey 2x2 plate with a small pin on the back right corner so it overhangs 1 row to the back and the pin faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

51.2. Vertically place a tan 2x4 brick on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

51.3. Insert a white wheel into a black tire, then attach it to the front-facing pin so the hollow side faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

51.4. Bring back your main build and flip it upside down so it is horizontal and the socket faces the left. Now vertically place the 2 rightmost columns of your part on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it is centered vertically. The wheels should sit in the arch bricks!

52.1. Place a transparent 2x2 round plate with a smooth underside on top of the 2 leftmost columns of the 2x6 plate of the ppp.

Group 20 - Caravan

52.2. Place a brown 2x2 round plate on the front left corner. Then place a brown 2x2 round plate with a smooth underside on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Now flip it over so it is right side up! Now you can attach the ball of your car to the socket of the caravan to ride it around!
