

42649 Heartlake City Candy Store

Here's a sweet birthday gift for kids aged 6 and up who love pretend-play sets and shop toys. Girls, boys and young builders can explore the LEGO® Friends Heartlake City Candy Store (42649), which is packed with goodies and fun details. The set comes with 2 minidolls, a micro-doll, a cat figure and lots of accessories for creative play.

This set is a great toy for supporting kids' social development skills. Your young builder can act out customer interactions or create sibling stories with Leo and his younger sister, Alba. The set is packed with candy shop-themed features, like the pick 'n' mix selection, the giant lollipop, a gumball machine and a cash register. There's also a candy-making area with ingredients, scissors and a cooking pot. And who could resist saying hello to the store's two mascots – a chocolate bar and a wrapped candy?

Kids' pretend-play set packed with imagination – This Heartlake City Candy Store for girls and boys aged 6 and up comes with 2 mini-dolls, a micro-doll and a cat figure, plus accessories for role play.

Candy store role play – This toy set is designed to support kids' social development skills as they act out customer interactions or create sibling stories with Leo and his younger sister, Alba.

2 mini-dolls, a micro-doll and a cat figure – Kids can create lots of different stories with the characters and fun accessories included in this set.

Sweet shop fun – The set includes lots of candy shop features, like the pick 'n' mix selection, a giant lollipop, a gumball machine and a candy-making area with ingredients, scissors and a cooking pot.

Measurements – 376-piece set with a candy store model measuring over 4.5 in. (11 cm) high, 6.5 in. (16 cm) wide and 6.5 in. (16 cm) deep.

The front of the box shows the candy store in the back! There are a bunch of different candies in the window! So many to choose from! In the front, there is a gumball machine, a chocolate bar mascot and a wrapped candy mascot!

The back of the box shows the back of the candy store. Inside, there are a lot of candy bars, drinks, and more!

The top of the box shows a real size image of Gigi.

The build is 376 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Alba, the wrapped candy mascot, and the candy store.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the chocolate bar mascot and the candy store.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Pluto the cat and the candy store.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for Gigi and the candy store.

Bag 5 includes the pieces for Leo and the candy store.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set:

(<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42649>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 3 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 27 - 1 transparent red 1x1 cone brick and 1 red 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar from Step 26.

Group 28 - 1 transparent blue 1x1 cone brick and 1 light blue 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar from Step 27.

Group 29 - 1 transparent green 1x1 cone brick and 1 green 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar from Step 27 and Steps 28-29.

Group 31 - Steps 1-3.

Group 32 - Step 4 and 2 magenta 1x1 round bricks from Step 5.

Group 33 - 2 orange 1x1 round bricks from Step 5.

Group 34 - 2 lime green 1x1 round bricks from Step 5 and Steps 6-10.

Group 35 - Step 11-17 and 1 tan 1x4 plate from Step 18.

Group 36 - Rest of Step 18, Steps 19-20, and 2 transparent orange 1x1 dome tiles from Step 21.

Group 37 - Rest of Step 21 and 2 brown 1x2 tiles printed with chocolate from Step 22.

Group 38 - 2 pink 1x2 tiles printed with chocolate from Step 22.

Group 39 - 2 green 1x2 tiles printed with chocolate from Step 22.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Alba

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 small light brown body printed with light blue clothes and blue overalls, 1 light brown head printed with light brown eyes and lips, and 1 brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we build the mascot!

Group 2 - Wrapped Candy Mascot

1. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2x2 brick with side studs on 3 sides on top so the 2x2 side studs face the front.

2. Vertically place a light orange 1x2 jumper plate upright on the left-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Place a light orange 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar upright on the left-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

4.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's make the legs and feet! Vertically place a yellow 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a white 5L antenna on the back row. Then place a white 1x1 tile with a rounded side in front so the rounded side faces the front.

4.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 underneath the left column so the 1x1 tile with a rounded side faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

5. Place a light orange 4x4 dome brick with a 2x2 recess upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered.

6.1. Place a light orange 2x2 round tile with a sticker upright on the ppp.

6.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the light orange 2x2 round tile. This sticker has a smiley face on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

7. Place a light orange 1x1 dome brick upright on the left-facing bar so the anti-stud faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now put your mascot away while we make the candy store!

Group 3 - Candy Store

1. Place a tan 8x8 plate in front of you. Then place a light purple 2x2 round tile on the front left corner.

2. Place a lime green 2x2 tile with a stud on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and overhangs 1 column to the left. Now vertically place a tan 2x6 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so the round side faces the left and the front row aligns with the front row of the build. Then place a lime green 1x1 round tile on the back row of the ppp.

3. Place a lime green 2x2 tile with a stud on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front. Now horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so the round side faces the front and the leftmost column aligns with the leftmost column of the 8x8 plate. Now place a lime green 1x1 round tile on the rightmost column of the ppp.

4. Place a light purple 1x2 curved tile to the left of the front 2x2 tile with a stud so the curve faces the front right. Then place a lime green 1x1 round tile behind the ppp. Now place another light purple 1x2 curved tile in front of the leftmost 2x2 tile with a stud so the curve faces the back left. Then place a lime green 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp.

Group 4 - Candy Store

5.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a door! Horizontally place a pink 2x6x6 angled door frame in front of you so the flat side faces the front. Now attach a transparent door with a sticker to the front so the front-facing stud is on the right. Then place a white 1x1 round tile printed with a red swirl upright on the front-facing side stud.

5.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the transparent door. This sticker has a wrapped candy sign that says open! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

5.3. Orient the door frame so the door opens to the front left, then place the 2 rightmost columns of it behind the right 2x2 tile with a stud.

6. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the door opens to the back right. Now place a light blue 2x2 corner brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front and 1st and 2nd columns from the right, in front of the rightmost column of the door frame so it looks like the braille letter d. Then place the front row of another 1 on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, to the left of the back row of the door frame so it looks like the braille letter d.

7. Place the left column of a light blue 2x2 corner tile with a cutoff corner in front of the right column of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front left. Then place the front row of another 1 to the left of the back row of the right 2x2 corner brick so the cutoff corner faces the front left.

8.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a light blue 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on top so the clip faces the left. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate on top.

8.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 on the back left corner to the left of the back row of the 2x2 corner brick so it overhangs 1 column to the left and the clip faces the left. Now repeat symmetrically to the front right corner.

9. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a tan 2x6 plate with a round side underneath the front right overhang so the round side faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.

10. Vertically place a light purple 1x4 brick in front of the left column of the right 2x2 corner brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.

11. Vertically place the left column of a transparent 2x4x5 half cylinder panel in front of the rightmost column of the door frame so the round side faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.

12.1. Place a magenta 1x1 round brick on the front row, in front of the left column of the half cylinder panel. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.

Group 5 - Candy Store

12.2. Place an orange 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Group 6 - Candy Store

12.3. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Group 7 - Candy Store

12.4. Place a yellow 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Group 8 - Candy Store

12.5. Place a light purple 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

13. Vertically place the front row of a light blue 1x6 brick on top of the front right ppp. Then vertically place a yellow 1x2 rounded plate on top of the ppp so it is centered vertically on it. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back left.

14. Place a light blue 2x2 corner tile with a cutoff corner on the back right of the door frame so it is centered diagonally and the cutoff corner faces the back right.

15. Place 3 teal 1x1 round plates, 1 next to the other, to the front left of the ppp, so they sit on the door frame.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 9 - Chocolate Bar Mascot

16. Let's make a part! Let's make the chocolate bar mascot! Horizontally place a purple 2x3 plate in front of you.

17. Horizontally place a dark brown 2x3 plate with a 1 stud gap on top so the gap is in the front.
18. Vertically place a white 1x4 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 3 rows to the front.
19. Horizontally place a purple 2x3 plate underneath the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
20. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on the front left corner so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
21. Horizontally place a purple 2x3 plate on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a brown 1x3 plate behind it so it is centered horizontally.
22. Vertically place a brown 1x2 plate with a hole on the short side on the back left corner so the hole is in the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 23.1. Horizontally place a brown 2x3 tile with a sticker on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 23.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the brown 2x3 tile. This sticker has a smiley face with pink cheeks on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 10 - Chocolate Bar Mascot

24. Vertically place 3 purple 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 2 rows. Then horizontally place a purple 1x3 plate behind it so it is centered horizontally.
25. Place a purple 1x2 tile on the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp. Then place a purple 1x1 quarter tile to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the back left.
26. Attach the bar of a yellow 1x1 rounded plate with a bar to the front left clip so the stud is in the front and faces up. Then place a white 1x1 tile with a round side on it so the round side faces the front. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.
27. Lift up your mascot so it sits on the 1x1 rounded plate with bars. The 1x1 tiles with a round side should face the front! Then attach a yellow arm with a pin to the left-facing hole so the hand faces down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. This is the chocolate bar mascot! Now put him away so we can keep building the candy store!

Group 11 - Candy Store

- 28.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light pink 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place another 1 on top so the side studs face the front.
- 28.2. Place a light pink 2x2 round tile with a sticker upright on the top 2 rows of front-facing side studs.

28.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the light pink 2x2 round tile. This sticker has a smiley face on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

28.4. Horizontally place 2 pink 1x2 tiles printed with bubblegum, 1 above the other, upright on the front-facing side studs.

28.5. Vertically place your part in the gap of the right 2x4x5 half cylinder panel so the upright tiles face the right.

29. Vertically place a yellow 2x4 brick on the front 4 rows to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.

30.1. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 jumper plate on the front row on top of the ppp. Then place a light yellow 2x2 tile with a stud behind it. Now horizontally place another light yellow 1x2 jumper plate behind it.

30.2. Place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud in the gap of the 2x4x5 half cylinder panel that is in the back left. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 jumper plate in front of the ppp.

31.1. Place a tan 2L bar with a stop on the front row on top of the jumper plate. Then place 2 more behind it so they sit on the 2x2 tile with a stud and the 1x2 jumper plate. Now place a transparent red crystal on the back 2L bar with a stop.

Group 12 - Candy Store

31.2. Place a transparent green crystal in front of the ppp on top of the middle 2L bar with a stop.

Group 13 - Candy Store

31.3. Place a transparent blue crystal in front of the ppp on top of the 2L bar with a stop.

32.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a lollipop display! Place a red 2x2 inverted dome brick in front of you. Then place a red 2x2 dome brick on top. Now place a red 1x1 cupcake wrapper on top. Then insert a white 4L bar into the top.

32.2. Flip your part upside down so the bar faces down, then place it on the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is in the gap of the back left 2x4x5 half cylinder panel.

33. Place a dark brown 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns to the left of the 1x2 jumper plate so there is no overhang. Then place a brown 2x2 tile with a stud on top.

34. Place a dark brown 1x1 plate on top of the ppp. Then place a brown 1x1 tile on top. Now place a dark brown 1x1 plate to the right of the ppp so it sits on the 1x2 jumper plate. Then place a brown 1x1 tile on top.

35.1. Let's make a part! Place a yellow 2x2 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 jumper plate on the front row. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light orange basket on top so the handles face the left and right.

35.2. Place your part on the front left corner on top of the 8x8 plate.

36. Let's make a part! Let's make a gumball machine! Place a red 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a light grey 1x1 half cone brick on top.

37. Place a red 1x1 brick with a hole on top so the hole faces the left and right. Now insert a white 1L pin with a stud into the left-facing hole so the stud faces the left.

38.1. Place a green 1x1 round plate on top.

Group 14 - Candy Store

38.2. Place a light pink 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp.

Group 15 - Candy Store

38.3. Place a blue 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp.

39. Place a transparent ball on top of the ppp. Then place a light grey 1x1 round tile with a windup key on the left-facing side so the ends face the front and back.

40. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so the door opens to the front left. Now place your part on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the windup key faces the left.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 16 - Pluto the Cat

Sub-Build 2. Locate 1 black cat with ears printed with black and yellow eyes, then place it in front of you. Now put it away so we can continue the build!

Group 17 - Candy Store

41. Make sure the door of your build opens to the front left! Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 inverted slope brick on the front row of the 4th column from the right so it sits on the left stud of the 2x4x5 half cylinder panel and slopes and overhangs to the left. Now repeat symmetrically to the back left.

42. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate on the front row to the right of the ppp so it overhangs 1 column to the right. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on top so the clip faces the right. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate on top. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the back left.

43. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs hanging down on the front row on top of the ppp and 1x2 inverted slope brick so it is centered horizontally on them and the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.

44. Horizontally place a yellow 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner to the left and right of the previous 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs that is in the front right so the cutoff corners face the front left and front right respectively. Now repeat symmetrically to the back left.

45. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the rightmost column so the bar faces the right.

46. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate on the leftmost column. Then horizontally place 2 yellow 1x2 plates with a stud and a clip, 1 in front of the other, to the right so the clips are on the right.

47. Vertically place a teal 1x3 sloped curved brick on the front right corner so it slopes and overhangs 2 rows to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 18 - Candy Store

48. Place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns.

49. Now diagonally place the leftmost anti-stud of your part on the middle 1x1 round plate that is on the door frame so the bar faces the front left.

50. Place the middle stud of a light purple 1x6 curved plate on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud that was on your ppp so the curve faces the back right. It should also connect to the 2x2 plates with a cutoff corner.

51. Horizontally place 2 light pink 1x3 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column of the ppp so they slope to the right and there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.

52. Place a light pink 2x2 dome brick on the front 2 rows to the right of the 2 ppp. Then place a pink ball on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back left.

53.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate on top.

53.2. Place the plate part of a teal 2x2 corner sloped curved brick on the left column so it slopes to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile on top.

53.3. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 upright on the 2x4 front-facing side studs so the 1x2 tile is at the bottom and faces the front! Then repeat symmetrically to the back left.

Group 19 - Candy Store

54. Let's make a part! Let's make a display! Place a magenta 4x4 round plate in front of you.

55. Horizontally place 2 light green 1x2 plates with a bar on the short side, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns so they are centered vertically and the bars face the left.

56. Place a light purple 2x2 triangle tile on the left stud of the front row so the right angle faces the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a pink 3x3 heart shaped plate on the front 2 rows of the 2 rightmost columns so the tip faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

57. Horizontally place 2 yellow 1x2 plates with an upright vertical bar on the long side, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns so they are centered vertically and the bars face outwards to the front and back. Now vertically place a light pink 1x4 plate to the right so it is centered vertically.

58. Place 2 light pink 2x2 round tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns so they are centered vertically. Now place a light pink 1x1 round tile on the right stud of the front row. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

59. Horizontally place a red 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the 4 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

60. Place a light pink 1x1 round tile on the left stud of the ppp.

61.1. Place a white 3x3 round tile with a sticker on the right stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs so it is centered on it.

61.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the white 3x3 round tile. This sticker is a teal lollipop with 2 hearts and a peppermint candy on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

62.1. Let's make another part! Let's make a chocolate bar! Horizontally place a purple 2x4 plate upside down in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x4 rounded plate on the front row. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

62.2. Flip your part over so it is right side up and horizontal. Then place a purple 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns. Now horizontally place 2 brown 1x2 ingot tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns.

62.3. Vertically place a purple 1x2 tile on the leftmost column. Then place a purple 2x2 triangle tile on the back row to the right so the right angle faces the back left.

62.4. Now horizontally place the front left corner of your part on top of the back bar of your previous part so the 1x2 ingot tiles face the back right.

Group 20 - Candy Store

63.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a wrapped candy! Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on top so it is centered horizontally. Now place a gold 1x1 round plate to the left and right.

63.2. Place a light orange 2x2 round tile on top of the jumper plate so it is centered on it. Now place a light orange 1x1 tile with a round side to the left so the round side faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

63.3. Now horizontally place the leftmost column of your part on top of the front bar of your previous part so the right end faces the front right.

64. Now rotate your main build so the door opens to the front. Then horizontally attach the left-facing bars of your part to the top-facing clips that are behind the 1x3 sloped curved bricks in front of the door frame so the tile side faces the front! This is the store display! Now put your build away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 2):

Group 21 - Gigi

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 light brown pair of legs printed with tan shoes, pink socks, and light blue shorts, 1 light brown torso printed with a light orange and orange stripe shirt and a necklace, 1 light brown head printed with light purple eyes, lips, and makeup, and 1 pink and light yellow hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we build the candy store!

Group 22 - Candy Store

1. Horizontally place a tan 6x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on the back left corner so the bar faces the left.
2. Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 brick on the back row to the right of the ppp so it overhangs 1 row to the back.
3. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on the back right corner so the bar faces the right.
4. Horizontally place a blue 1x4 brick on the 4 leftmost columns in front of the 1x2 brick with a bar and 2x4 brick. Then place a yellow 1x1 brick to the right.
- 5.1. Place a magenta 1x1 round brick on the back left corner on top of the 1x2 brick with a bar. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 23 - Candy Store

- 5.2. Place an orange 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Group 24 - Candy Store

- 5.3. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.
6. Horizontally place a transparent 1x6x5 panel on the 2nd row from the back, between the ppp so the wall faces the back.
7. Horizontally place a light grey 2x3x2 cabinet on the 3 rightmost columns in front of the ppp so the opening faces the front. Now attach a transparent light blue cabinet door to the front so it opens to the left.
8. Place a light blue 1x1x3 brick on the leftmost column in front of the 1x1 round bricks. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick to the right.

9. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x2 panel on the 4th row from the front, to the left of the cabinet so the wall faces the back.

10. Vertically place a light blue 2x4 brick on the front 4 rows to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place another 1 on top.

11. Place a light grey 2x2 tile with a stud on the 4th and 5th rows from the front on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Then horizontally place 2 light grey 1x3 jumper plates, 1 in front of the other, to the left.

12. Place a transparent pink 1x1 round tile on top of each of the studs of the 2 previous 1x3 jumper plates. Then place a transparent pink 2x2 dish to the right, on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud.

13. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x2 panel on the 2 rightmost columns in front of the 1x1 round bricks so the wall faces the back. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 rounded plate in front. Now vertically place a red brown 2x4 plate on the front 3 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it overhangs 1 row to the front.

14. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on top of the back left corner of the ppp. Then vertically place a white 1x2 jumper plate on top. Now place a silver 1x1 round plate on top.

15. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope tile printed with a scale to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the right. Then place a light grey 1x1 tile printed with a keypad in front.

16. Place a yellow 1x1 brick on the 2nd column from the right on the 5th row from the front.

Group 25 - Candy Store

17.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a yellow 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a yellow 1x1 round plate on the back row. Then place a yellow 1x1 plate with a clip in front so the clip faces the front. Now vertically place a yellow 1x2 rounded plate on top.

17.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 on the back right corner so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

18. Place a magenta 1x1 round brick on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x8 plate in front so it is centered horizontally.

19. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the overhang faces the front. Now horizontally place a lime green 2x6 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front.

20. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 3rd column from the left of the 2nd row from the front so the leaves face the front left. Then place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

21. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side to the left and right so the bars face outwards to the left and right.

22. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs hanging down on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

23. Horizontally place 2 light pink 1x3 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right. Now place a yellow 1x1 round plate to the left and right.

24. Place a pink ball on top of each of the 2 ppp.

25.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate in front of you.

Group 26 - Candy Store

25.2. Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 plate on top.

25.3. Place the plate part of a teal 2x2 corner sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now vertically place 2 teal 1x1 sloped curved bricks with a 1x1 plate part, 1 to the right of the other, in between the 2 ppp so they slope and overhang to the back.

25.4. Horizontally place a teal 1x4 tile on top. Now horizontally place your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and the 1x4 tile is at the bottom and faces the front.

26.1. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the ppp faces the back. Now place a transparent pink 1x1 cone brick on the 3rd column from the left and 5th row from the front so it sits on top of the 1x8 plate. Then place a pink 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top.

Group 27 - Candy Store

26.2. Place a transparent red 1x1 cone brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a red 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top.

Group 28 - Candy Store

27.1. Place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a light blue 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top.

Group 29 - Candy Store

27.2. Place a transparent green 1x1 cone brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a green 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top.

28. Place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2nd column from the left, on top of the 1x1 round plate. Then place a dark brown 1x1 plate on top. Then place a brown 1x1 tile on top.

29.1. Attach a gold pair of scissors to the right front-facing clip so the blades face up. Then place a black pot on the rightmost column on the 4th row from the front so the handle faces the right. Now place a transparent pink 1x1 round tile inside it.

29.2. Bring back your main build and orient it so the door opens to the front right corner. Now rotate your current build so the 2x6 plate with a round side faces the front. Then attach the right-facing bars of your current build to the left-facing clips of the front row of your main build! Now put it away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 3):

Group 30 - Leo

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 light brown pair of legs printed with light blue shoes and yellow shorts, 1 light brown torso printed with a white shirt and a teal and orange jacket, 1 light brown head printed with light brown eyes and lips, 1 brown hair, and 1 silver 1x1 round tile printed with 5 on it. Now assemble your minifigure then attach the 1x1 round tile to his hand! This is a coin!

Group 31 - Candy Store

1. Horizontally place a tan 6x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on the back left corner so the bar faces the left.

2. Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 brick on the back row to the right of the ppp so it overhangs 1 row to the back.

3. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on the back right corner so the bar faces the right.

Group 32 - Candy Store

4. Horizontally place 2 yellow 2x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so they are centered horizontally.

5.1. Place a magenta 1x1 round brick on the back left corner on top of the 1x2 brick with a bar. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 33 - Candy Store

5.2. Place an orange 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Group 34 - Candy Store

5.3. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

6. Horizontally place a transparent 1x6x5 panel on the 2nd row from the back, between the ppp so the wall faces the back.

7. Vertically place a transparent 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the 2nd column from the left on the 4th and 5th rows from the front so the long wall faces the left. Now vertically place another 1 to the right so the wall faces the right. This is a container! Now repeat this process 2 more times to the right so you end up with 3 containers!

8. Place a light blue 1x1x3 brick on the leftmost column in front of the 1x1 round bricks. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

9.1 Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a yellow 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a yellow 1x1 round plate on the back row. Then place a yellow 1x1 plate with a clip in front so the clip faces the front. Now vertically place a yellow 1x2 rounded plate on top.

9.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 on the back right corner so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

10.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light yellow 1x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place 3 transparent 1x2 panels with 3 walls, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the long walls face the front.

10.2. Horizontally place your part on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the long walls of the panels face the front.

Group 35 - Candy Store

11. Horizontally place a yellow 1x8 tile on the 5th row from the front, on top of the 1x2 rounded plates, in front of the 1x6x5 panel so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light purple 1x1 round brick behind the leftmost and rightmost columns of the ppp.

12. Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 brick with 4 side studs behind the ppp, on top of the 1x6x5 panel so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side to the left and right so the bars face outwards to the left and right.

13. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the overhang faces the front. Now horizontally place a lime green 2x6 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front.

14. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 3rd column from the left of the 2nd row from the front so the leaves face the front left. Then place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

15. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs hanging down on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

16. Horizontally place 2 light pink 1x3 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right. Now place a yellow 1x1 round plate to the left and right.

17. Place a pink ball on top of each of the 2 ppp.

18.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate in front of you.

Group 36 - Candy Store

18.2. Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 plate on top.

18.3. Place the plate part of a teal 2x2 corner sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now vertically place 2 teal 1x1 sloped curved bricks with a 1x1 plate part, 1 to the right of the other, in between the 2 ppp so they slope and overhang to the back.

18.4. Horizontally place a teal 1x4 tile on top. Now horizontally place your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and the 1x4 tile is at the bottom and faces the front.

19.1. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the ppp faces the back. Now horizontally place a white 2x4 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and hangs 1 row down.

19.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the white 2x4 tile. This sticker has a pink and white stripe background and has a picture of a hand filling up a basket full of candy! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

20.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a red lightsaber handle in front of you so the thicker side faces up. Then place a red 1x1 corner panel on top so the corner of the walls face the back left.

20.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach 1 to the right front-facing clip so the panel faces down and the corner of the walls face the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

21.1. Place 2 transparent orange dome tiles in the back left container made up of 2 1x2 panels. They should not attach to any studs!

Group 37 - Candy Store

21.2. Place 2 transparent green dome tiles in the back right container made up of 2 1x2 panels. They should not attach to any studs! Then place 2 transparent pink 1x1 round tiles to the left, in the middle container!

22.1. Vertically place 2 brown 1x2 tiles printed with chocolate bars upright in the middle horizontal 1x2 panel so the tile sides face the front.

Group 38 - Candy Store

22.2. Vertically place 2 green 1x2 tiles printed with chocolate bars upright in the left horizontal 1x2 panel so the tile sides face the front.

Group 39 - Candy Store

22.3. Vertically place 2 pink 1x2 tiles printed with chocolate bars upright in the right horizontal 1x2 panel so the tile sides face the front.

22.4. Bring back your main build and orient it so it is vertical and the door opens to the front left corner. Now rotate your current build 180 degrees so the 2x6 plate with a round side faces the front. Then attach the left-facing bars of your current build to the right-facing clips of the front row of your main build.
