

42662 Hair Salon and Accessories Store

Adapted by John Le and tested by Jolene Nemeth.

This set tells the story of friends Nova and Aliya as they enjoy a day of fun trying out new styles with hair stylist Faraji. The 2-story building features a hair salon upstairs with styling chairs, hair dryers, brushes and wigs for the characters to try on. Downstairs, there is an accessories store with more wigs and fun accessories to complete the characters' new looks. Kids can put the characters in the photo booth and see the photos of Aliya and Nova pop out. The set also features a spinning window display, plus a skate ramp with in-line skates and a helmet accessory.

Pretend-play hair salon toy for kids – This Hair Salon and Accessories Store toy for girls and boys aged 7 and up comes with 3 mini-dolls and lots of hairstyling accessories for creative role play.

Hair salon toy – Give the mini-dolls a makeover at the hair salon, where there are styling chairs, toy hair dryers, brushes, wigs and more.

Choose accessories in the store – Check out the accessories store, where there are more wigs and accessories, a spinning window display and a cash register, then visit the photo booth.

Includes 3 LEGO® Friends characters – This set comes with Nova and Aliya mini-dolls, plus Faraji the hair stylist, giving kids lots of opportunities to create their own fun friendship stories.

Measurements – 347-piece set with a main model measuring over 6 in. (15 cm) high, 7.5 in. (19 cm) wide and 3 in. (8 cm) deep.

The build is 347 pieces in total and is for ages 7+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Nova, Aliya, the photo booth, accessories, and the skating ramp!

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the accessories store.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Faraji and the accessories store.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for the hair salon.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.

- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO

brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, els and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42662>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 3 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Bag 1 - Nova, Aliya, Photo Booth, Accessories, and Skating Ramp

Group 1 - Page 7 and 2 pink rollerblades, 1 pink helmet, and 1 white 1x3 tile printed with photos from Page 10.

Group 2 - Page 8 and 1 white 1x2 tile printed with a light blue phone with digital pay!

Group 3 - Steps 1-6.

Group 4 - Steps 7-8.

Group 5 - Steps 9-21.

Group 6 - 1 bright yellow 2x4 plate from Step 1.

Group 7 - Rest of Step 1 and Steps 2-6.

Group 8 - Step 1 and 2 black 1x2 inverted sloped curved bricks and 2 black 1x2 sloped curved tiles from Step 2.

Group 9 - Rest of Step 2-3 and Steps 4-6.

Bag 2 - Accessories Store

Group 10 - Steps 1-10.

Group 11 - Steps 11-23.

Group 12 - Steps 24-27, and 1 light yellow flower from Step 28.

Group 13 - 1 light blue flower from Step 28.

Group 14 - 1 orange flower from Step 28 and Step 29.

Group 15 - Step 30-44 and 1 light blue brush from Step 45.

Group 16 - Rest of Step 45.

Bag 3 - Faraji and Accessories Store

Group 17 - Page 48.

Group 18 - Steps 46-56 and 1 tan 2x2 plate, 1 transparent 1x1 round plate, and 1 light green 1x1 round tile from Step 57.

Group 19 - 1 purple 1x1 round plate and 1 light purple 1x1 round tile from Step 57.

Group 20 - Rest of Step 57 and Steps 58-59.

Bag 4 - Hair Salon

Group 21 - Step 1 and 6 white 1x3 sloped curved bricks from Step 2.

Group 22 - Rest of Step 2 and Steps 3-5.

Group 23 - Steps 6-11.

Group 24 - Steps 12-19.

Group 25 - Steps 20-29.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Nova

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 teal pair of legs printed with shoes and pants, 1 tan torso printed with a black shirt and purple sweater, 1 tan head printed with light green eyes and lips, 1 blonde hair, 1 pink helmet, 2 pink rollerblades, and 1 white 1x3 tile printed with photos. Assemble your minifigure then attach the rollerblades to her feet, and the 1x3 tile to her hand! You can switch out the hair and helmet if you like!

Group 2 - Aliya

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 light blue pair of legs printed with light brown and pink shoes, 1 brown torso printed with a pink top with white polka dots, 1 brown head printed with light brown eyes and lips, 1 brown hair, and 1 white 1x2 tile printed with a phone with digital pay. Assemble your minifigure then attach the 1x2 tile to her hand! Now put everything away while we make the photo booth!

Group 3 - Photo Booth

1. Horizontally place a bright yellow 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on the back row.
2. Vertically place a pink 1x2 brick on the front right corner so it overhangs 1 row to the front.
3. Horizontally place a bright yellow 1x4 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally.
4. Horizontally place a pink 2x4 brick on the front 2 rows so it overhangs 1 column to the left.
5. Place a light grey 2x2 plate underneath the overhang so 1 column is exposed to the left.
6. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 pins on the long side on the front left corner so the pins face the left.

Group 4 - Photo Booth

7. Horizontally place a dark orange 1x4 plate on the back right corner. Now horizontally place 2 dark orange 1x2 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the front right corner.
8. Horizontally place 2 dark orange 1x4 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the front left corner.
9. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the pins face the right. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x4 brick on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a bright yellow 1x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the ppp.

Group 5 - Photo Booth

10. Place a pink 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column on the 2nd row from the front so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a pink 1x3 sloped curved brick to the right so it slopes to the right.
11. Vertically place a transparent 1x2x1 panel on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the wall faces the right. Then vertically place a transparent 1x2 tile to the left.
12. Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 brick on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp.
- 13.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick with a hole in front of you. Then insert a dark grey 2L pin with a 1L axle into the front-facing hole so the axle faces the front and the pin faces the back.
- 13.2. Place a white 2x2 round ridged brick upright on the front-facing axle so the studs face the front. Then place a bright pink 2x2 round tile upright on the front-facing side studs.
- 13.3. Horizontally attach the corner pinhole of a dark orange 4L L-shaped lift arm to the back-facing pin so the axle hole is on the left and the short end is on the right and faces down.
- 13.4. Rotate your part 180 degrees so the 2x2 round tile faces the back. Now horizontally place the 1x2 brick part of your part on the back left corner.

14.1. Horizontally place a black 1x4x3 panel with a sticker on the front left corner so the wall faces the back.

14.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the black 1x4x3 panel. This sticker has a mirror with a camera icon in the bottom left corner. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

15. Vertically place the front row of a blue 1x3 brick on the rightmost column of the ppp. Then horizontally place a blue 1x3 brick to the left of the back row of the ppp.

16. Place a blue 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick with a hole to the right.

17. Horizontally place a black 3x4 tile with a row of studs on top of the 1x3 bricks so it covers all the studs.

18. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate with 2 side studs sticking up on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

19. Horizontally place a blue 1x4 sloped curved tile on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally on top of it.

20. Place a transparent green 2x2 dish upright on the front-facing hole so the anti-stud faces the front. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 round plate upright on it.

21.1. Place a white 2x2 tile with a round side with a sticker upright on the 2 front-facing side studs on top of the build so the round side overhangs 1 row to the top.

21.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the white 2x2 tile with a round side. This sticker has a light blue camera with a red flash around it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

21.3. Locate 1 white 1x3 tile with photos from group 1 and insert it into the left-facing side on top of the technic liftarm. Now twist the back-facing 2x2 round ridged brick to move the photos to the right to dispense them! Now put your photo booth away while we make the accessories!

Group 6 - Accessories

1.1. Horizontally place a bright yellow 2x4 plate in front of you.

Group 7 - Accessories

1.2. Horizontally place a bright pink 2x4 plate on top so it is centered.

2. Horizontally place a dark orange 1x4 plate on the back row.

3. Horizontally place 2 pink 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row. Then horizontally place another 1 on the front left corner.

4.1. Horizontally place a dark orange 1x2 slope tile with a sticker on the front right corner so it slopes to the front.

4.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the dark orange 1x2 slope tile. This sticker has a pink hat and a purple bowtie on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

5. Place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top of each of the 1x2 jumper plates.

6. Horizontally place a gold crown with 5 tips on the back right 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar so it faces the front. Then horizontally place black cat ears on the back left 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar so the ear grooves face the front. Now horizontally place a transparent purple pair of glasses on the front left 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar. Now put your accessories away while we make the skating ramp!

Group 8 - Skating Ramp

1. Place a dark grey 4x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 masonry brick on the back row so the brick grooves face the back.

2.1. Vertically place a black 1x2 inverted half arch brick on the rightmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the 2nd column from the left and 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it slopes to the front.

You will have 2 extra black 1x2 sloped curved tiles. Save them for later!

Group 9 - Skating Ramp

2.2. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick on the leftmost column on the 2nd row from the back. Then vertically place a white 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick on the 2nd column from the right on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it slopes to the front.

3. Vertically place a black 1x2 sloped curved tile from group 8 on the front right corner so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the front row on the 2nd column from the left so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Now vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved tile on the front row on the 2nd column from the right so it slopes and overhangs to the front.

4. Place 2 blue 2x2 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so they are centered horizontally and the studs are in the back.

5. Place a lime green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the leftmost column on the 2nd row from the front so the leaves face the front left. Then place a light blue 1x1 round flower plate on top.

6. Place a transparent blue 1x1 round brick on the back row on the 2nd column from the right. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 round plate on top. Now place a pink 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top. Now put your build away while we make the accessories store!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 10 - Accessories Store

1. Place a light grey 8x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 brick on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.
2. Vertically place a white 1x6 brick with holes on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically.
3. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6 brick on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place 2 pink 1x4 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the left so they are centered vertically.
4. Horizontally place a bright pink 2x4 plate on the front row to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile behind it.
5. Vertically place a bright pink 1x2 tile on the back 2 rows on the 3rd column from the left. Then place a bright pink 2x2 tile with a stud to the right. Now horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile in front of them. Then place a bright pink 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the 2 leftmost columns of the ppp. Then horizontally place 2 bright pink 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the right.
6. Horizontally place a bright pink 2x4 plate on the front left corner so it overhangs 3 columns to the left.
7. Vertically place a light grey 2x8 plate underneath the overhang on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it is centered vertically to the build.
8. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile on the 3rd row from the front so it overhangs 1 column to the left. Now place a bright pink 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, behind the ppp. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile behind it so it overhangs 1 column to the left. Now vertically place a bright pink 1x2 tile on the back 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left. Then place a bright pink 2x2 tile with a stud to the right.
9. Place a light grey 8x8 plate with a round side underneath the leftmost overhang so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the left.
10. Vertically place 2 pink 1x4 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the 7th column from the left so they are centered vertically. Now horizontally place 2 bright pink 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the ppp so they are centered vertically. Now place a bright pink 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows to the right of the 1x4 tile.

Group 11 - Accessories Store

11. Vertically place a bright yellow 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows on the 6th column from the left. Then horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 brick on the back row on the 5th and 6th columns from the left. Then vertically place a blue 1x1 plate with a 1x1 slope tile in front of the right column of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
12. Vertically place 2 dark orange 1x4 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so they are centered vertically.
13. Vertically place a dark orange 1x6 plate on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically. Then place a white 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs behind the ppp so the side studs face the back. Now place a dark orange 1x1 plate on the front row on the 2nd column from the right.

14. Place 2 black 1x1 plates with a clip, 1 in front of the other, on the 2nd column from the right, on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back so the clips face the left. Then vertically place a black 1x4 sloped curved tile on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically on them.

15.1. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the back right corner so the wall faces the right.

15.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the mint blue 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a bunch of hair products on a shelf, a hairbrush, and mirrors! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

16. Place a white 2x2 slope brick printed with a number pad and card reader on the front right corner so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x2x3 brick on top of the front right corner. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x2 brick on top.

17. Place a white 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the back row on the 2nd column from the right so the side studs face the back. Then horizontally place a white 1x3x2 half arch brick on top of the ppp so it overhangs to the left. Now place a mint blue 1x1 brick on the back row on the 2nd column from the right.

18. Stack 2 white 1x1x2 bricks with 2 side studs on top of the back row on the 6th column from the left so the side studs face the back. Then horizontally place a white 1x3x2 half arch brick on top of the ppp so it overhangs to the right.

19. Place a mint blue 1x1 plate on the front right corner. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x6 plate behind it. Now horizontally place a white 1x12 plate on the back right corner so the 2 leftmost columns sit on the 2 right columns of the left 1x3 half arch brick.

20. Place a white 1x1x5 brick on the 2nd row from the back on the 6th column from the left.

21. Vertically place a mint blue 1x2 brick on the front 2 rows on the 6th column from the left. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x2x3 brick on top. Then place a mint blue 1x1 brick on the front row on top of the ppp. Now vertically place a mint blue 1x2 inverted slope brick behind the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the back.

22. Vertically place a pink 1x8 plate on the 6th column from the left so it is centered vertically.

23. Place a white 1x1x5 brick on the back row on the 5th column from the left. Now vertically place a mint blue 1x6 plate to the right so there is no overhang.

24. Place a transparent 1x4x6 curved panel on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left and it aligns with the curve of the plate. Now place a blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the ppp so the studs are on the left.

25. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 grill tile to the right of the front row of the ppp. Then place a black 2x2 tile with a round ridge behind the ppp.

26. Let's make a part! Place a black 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a blue 2x2 dome brick on top so it is centered.

27. Place 2 transparent 1x1 round tiles with a top-facing bar, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally. Now place another 1 on the back stud of the leftmost column.

28.1. Place a light yellow flower on top of the leftmost 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar.

Group 13 - Accessories Store

28.2. Place a light blue flower on the front row on top of the left 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar.

Group 14 - Accessories Store

28.3. Place an orange flower on the front row on top of the right 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar.

29. Place a white 1x1 half cone brick on top of the 2x2 dome brick. Then place a white head on top.

Group 15 - Accessories Store

31.1. Place a blonde wig on top of the ppp so the hair slopes to the right. Now place a light pink flower upright on the small right-facing hole of the ppp.

31.2. Place your part on top of the 2x2 tile with a round ridge that is on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left of the main build so it is centered on it and can freely rotate.

32. Vertically place a white 1x2x3 panel on the leftmost column in front of the 1x4x6 curved panel so the wall faces the left. Now vertically place a bright yellow 1x2 plate on top. Then vertically place a white 1x2x2 panel with a window on top so the wall faces the left. Now vertically place a bright yellow 1x2 plate on top.

33. Place a white 6x6 quarter round plate on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left. The curve should align with the curve of the panel!

34. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope tile on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back on the 4th column from the left so it slopes to the back. Then vertically place 2 mint blue 1x6 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 6 rows to the right of the ppp.

35. Horizontally place 2 mint blue 1x2 inverted slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the front 2 rows in front of the 2 ppp so they slope and overhang to the left.

36. Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Now vertically place a mint blue 1x6 brick on the front left corner. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x2 brick behind it.

37. Horizontally place 3 pink 1x4 bricks with 4 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row to the right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

38. Place a mint blue 1x1 brick on the front row to the right of the ppp. Then place the right column of a mint blue 2x2 brick behind it. Now horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 brick behind the ppp. Now vertically place a mint blue 2x4 brick behind the ppp.

39. Vertically place 2 white 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so they are centered vertically. Now horizontally place a white 1x3 tile on the front row to the right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a white 1x8 tile on the front row to the right. Then vertically place 2 white 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the ppp so they are centered vertically. Now vertically place a white 1x8 tile to the right so it is centered vertically.

40.1. Horizontally place a mint blue 2x4 tile with a sticker upright on the top left 3 front-facing side studs so it overhangs 1 column to the left and 1 row down.

40.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the mint blue 2x4 tile. This sticker has strands of string in different orientations such as swirls, curves, and waves. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

41.1. Horizontally place a mint blue 2x6 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ppp so 1 row hangs down.

41.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the mint blue 2x6 tile. This sticker has strands of string in different orientations such as swirls, curves, and waves. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

42.1. Horizontally place a mint blue 2x4 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ppp so 1 row hangs down.

42.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the mint blue 2x4 tile. This sticker has strands of string in different orientations such as small curls, bends, and curves. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

43.1. Vertically place a mint blue 2x6 tile upright on the 4 leftmost front-facing side studs below the 2x4 tile so 1 column overhangs to the left and 2 rows overhang to the top.

43.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the mint blue 2x6 tile. This sticker has an outline of a hairdryer, bowtie, hairbrush, and hair product. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

44.1. Vertically place a mint blue 2x6 tile upright on the 4 rightmost front-facing side studs below the 2x4 tile so 1 column overhangs to the right and 2 rows overhang to the top.

44.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the mint blue 2x6 tile. This sticker has an outline of a star, hair product, hair brush, and a cat headband. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

45.1. Attach a light blue hairbrush to the front right-facing clip on the left side so the bristles face the right.

Group 16 - Accessories Store

45.2. Attach a light orange hairbrush to the back right-facing clip on the left side so the bristles face the right.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 2):

Group 17 - Faraji

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 light green pair of legs printed with white shoes, 1 brown torso printed with a blue, orange, and pink shirt, 1 brown head printed with brown eyes and lips, and 1 tan hair. Assemble your minifigure then put him away while we continue building!

Group 18 - Accessories Store

46. Place a white 1x1 slope tile on the rightmost column on the 4th row from the front so it slopes to the front. Then place the back row of a white 2x2 tile with a top-facing pin to the left.

47.1. Let's make a part! Place a white 4x4 rounded tile with a sticker upside down in front of you. Then place a light grey 2x2 plate with a hole underneath on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally and the hole faces the front.

47.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the 4x4 rounded tile. This sticker has a pink background and a hairbrush, a comb, and scissors on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

47.3. Attach the hole of your part to the top-facing pin on the right side so the tile faces the front right.

48. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a bright yellow 2x4 plate in front of you.

49. Horizontally place a light blue 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

50. Vertically place a bright yellow 1x2 plate underneath the leftmost overhang so 1 row is exposed to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

51. Horizontally place a mint blue 1x6 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x6 plate on top.

52. Horizontally place 3 mint blue 1x2x2 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

53. Place 3 bright pink 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they are centered horizontally.

54.1. Horizontally place a mint blue 2x6 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.

54.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the mint blue 2x6 tile. This sticker has 14 squares on it that are half red and half pink. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

55. Stack 2 white 1x1 half cone bricks on top of the leftmost 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a white head on top.

56. Stack 2 white 1x1 half cone bricks on top of the middle 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a transparent 1x1 round plate on top. Now place a white head on top.

57.1. Place a tan 2x2 plate on the rightmost 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered on it. Then place a transparent 1x1 round plate on the front right corner. Now place a light green 1x1 round tile on top.

Group 19 - Accessories Store

57.2. Place a purple 1x1 round plate on top of the front left corner of the 2x2 plate. Then place a light purple 1x1 round tile on top.

Group 20 - Accessories Store

57.3. Place a transparent pink 1x1 round brick on the back right corner. Then place an orange 1x1 round tile on top. Now place a transparent purple 1x1 cone brick to the left of the ppp. Then place a transparent green diamond on top.

58. Place a tan wig with a ponytail on the left head so the pony tail faces the back. Then place a magenta wig with braids on the right head so it slopes to the back.

59.1. Bring back your main build and orient it so it is horizontal and the curved side faces the back left. Now horizontally place your part on the middle row of 2x2 tiles with a stud so it is centered horizontally on them and the upright tile faces the back.

59.2. Rotate your main build 180 degrees, then bring back your photo booth and horizontally attach the pins of it to the front 2 left-facing holes. Now put away your build while we make the hair salon!

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 3):

Group 21 - Hair Salon

1. Horizontally place a tan 6x14 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x3 sloped curved brick on the back right corner so it slopes and overhangs 2 rows to the back.

2.1. Vertically place 6 white 1x3 sloped curved bricks, on the back row to the left of the ppp so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them, and they slope and overhang 2 rows to the back.

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2.2. Vertically place a black 1x3 sloped curved brick on the back row to the left of each of the previous 1x3 sloped curved bricks so they slope to the back.

3. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick on the 5th row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a blue 1x6 brick to the left and right of the ppp.

4. Vertically place 2 blue 2x3x2 cabinets, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns so the openings face the left and they overhang 2 rows to the front. Now insert a white shelf into the bottom row of each of them.

5. Horizontally place a tan 2x14 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally to the build.

6. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6 brick on the front left corner. Now place a black 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front on the 4th and 5th columns from the right.

7. Vertically place a pink 2x6 plate on the front right corner on top of the cabinets.

8.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a mirror! Horizontally place a white 1x4x3 panel with a sticker in front of you so the wall faces the back.

8.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the white 1x4x3 panel. This sticker has a mirror on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

8.3. Horizontally place a mint blue 1x6 plate underneath your part so it is centered horizontally.

8.4. Stack 3 mint blue 1x1 bricks with a side stud on the rightmost column so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

8.5. Horizontally place a mint blue 1x6 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

8.6. Place a transparent yellow 1x1 round plate upright on each of the front-facing side studs.

8.7. Vertically place your part on the front right corner so the upright 1x1 round plates face the left.

9. Horizontally stack 5 white 1x2 masonry bricks on the 2 rightmost columns behind the ppp so the brick grooves face the back.

10. Horizontally place a transparent 1x2x5 brick to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a transparent 1x6x5 panel to the left so the wall faces the back. Now horizontally place a transparent 1x2x5 brick to the left.

11. Horizontally stack 5 white 1x2 masonry bricks to the left of the ppp so the brick grooves face the back.

Group 24 - Hair Salon

12.1. Vertically place a mint blue 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the front left corner so the wall faces the left.

12.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the mint blue 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a picture of 4 different hairstyles on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

13. Place a pink 1x1 plate on the front left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x6 plate behind it. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

14. Horizontally place 2 pink 1x6 plates, 1 to the right of the other, in between the back row of the ppp.

15. Vertically place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x2 inverted half arch brick behind it so it slopes to the front. Now place a white 1x1 brick behind it. Then repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

16. Place a white 1x1 round plate on the 4th column from the left of the back row, without counting the 1x3 sloped curved tiles. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 inverted half arch brick to the left and right so they slope inwards to the left and right. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

17. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a side stud on the long side on the back row in between the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the back. Now place a white 1x1 heart tile upright on the back-facing side stud so the tip faces down.

18. Horizontally place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then place a white 2x2 corner tile on the back left corner on top of the bricks so it looks like the braille letter f. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

19. Let's make a part! Let's make a sink and soap! Horizontally place a pink 2x3 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a transparent light blue 1x2x1 panel with 3 walls on the back left corner so the long wall faces the front.

20. Place a transparent light blue 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then place a transparent purple 1x1 round brick on the front right corner. Now place 2 pink 1x1 half cylinder bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front left corner so they slope to the front and back.

21. Place a gold 1x1 faucet on the back right corner so the bar faces the left. Now place a light green 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on the front right corner.

22. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th columns from the left, on the 5th and 6th rows from the front so the wall of the panel faces the front!

23.1. Let's make a part! Place a pink 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 plate on top. Now horizontally place 2 dark orange 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top.

23.2. Now place your part on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front.

24. Horizontally place a black 1x2 slope tile on the 2nd row from the front, on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place a blue 1x2 grill tile on the 5th column from the left, on the 5th and 6th rows from the front.

25.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a bright pink 2x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 bright yellow 1x2 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row.

25.2. Place a black 1x1 plate with a clip on the front left corner so the clip faces the front. Then place another 1 on the front row on the 2nd column from the right so the clip faces the front. Now place a white 1x1 round plate to the right of each of the 2 ppp.

25.3. Place 2 bright pink 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they are centered horizontally.

25.4. Horizontally place your part on the 5th and 6th rows from the front, to the right of the 1x2 grill tile.

26. Stack 2 white 1x1 half cone bricks on top of the left 2x2 tile with a stud of the ppp. Then place a white 1x1 round plate on top. Now place a white head on top. Then place a pink wig with curly hair on top so the front of the hair faces the back.

27. Stack 2 white 1x1 half cone bricks on top of the right 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a short purple wig on top.

28. Let's make a part! Place a dark grey 1x1 round plate with a bar in front of you so the bar faces the right. Then place a dark silver 1x1 cone brick on top. This is a hair dryer! Attach the bar of it to the left front-facing clip so the cone brick faces the right. Now attach a gold pair of scissors to the right front-facing clip so the blades face up.

29.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a chair! Place a pink 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the long side on the leftmost column so the clips face the left.

29.2. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the right column.

29.3. Horizontally place 2 dark orange 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top.

29.4. Vertically attach the bar of a dark orange 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side to the left-facing clips so the studs face up. Now vertically place a dark orange 1x2 tile on top.

29.5. Place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, on the 4th and 5th columns from the right so the leftmost 1x2 tile is upright and faces the right.
