

## **43256 Anna's Sleigh Adventure**

Winter fun awaits Disney's Frozen fans aged 4 and up as they learn to build with this LEGO® | Disney Frozen Anna's Sleigh Adventure (43256) building playset, with a hot chocolate stand, stable, sleigh, small sled, sledding hill and other fantasy building toy items. It also has 4 characters: Anna and Kristoff LEGO | Disney mini-doll figures, an Olaf LEGO | Disney snowman figure and a Sven LEGO | Disney animal figure.

Fulfill a child's passion for Disney's Frozen with a buildable toy that makes a fun birthday gift, boosts confidence and lets adults share the joy. 2 Starter Brick elements help give kids a sturdy start, and each bag of bricks has a character so play starts fast – the full building model kit can be finished later!

Disney's Frozen building toy for kids – Thrill girls and boys aged 4 and up with this Anna's Sleigh Adventure buildable toy set that sparks imaginations as kids build and play out winter stories.

Building model kit – Sleigh, hot chocolate stand, stable, Anna and Kristoff LEGO® | Disney Frozen mini-doll figures, Olaf LEGO | Disney snowman figure and a Sven LEGO | Disney reindeer figure.

Fantasy building toy features – The stand has a counter and attached stable, the sleigh has a harness and small storage in the back, and the sledding hill has a mini sled and a ladder for easy access.

Story-starter buildable toys – This LEGO® building set lets Disney fans use their imaginations to have wintry fun like sledding or enjoying hot chocolate and snacks with Anna, Kristoff, Olaf and Sven.

Measurements – The 192-piece building set includes a hot chocolate stand and attached stable that, together, measure over 5 in. (12 cm) high, 3 in. (8 cm) wide and 3 in. (8 cm) deep.

The front of the box shows a stable and a stand that has hot chocolate! In the front, there is a slide for sledding! To the left, there is a reindeer hauling a carriage!

The back of the box shows all the accessories that the set comes with! It comes with 2 minifigures, Olaf the snowman, a reindeer, hot chocolate, sled, carrot, pitch fork, a lantern, candy cane, a bowl, slide, hot chocolate stand, carriage, and a stable!

The top of the box shows a real size image of Anna!

The build is 192 pieces in total and is for ages 4+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the reindeer and carriage!

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Olaf and the hot chocolate stand.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Kristoff and the stable.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for Anna and the slide!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building,

here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43256>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 4 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

The steps in this set correspond to page numbers.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

#### Group 1 - Reindeer

6-7. Horizontally place a dark grey reindeer with light grey hair and antlers in front of you so the antlers face the right. Now place a dark grey 2x2 tile with a stud on top.

8-9. Place a dark grey 2x2 half circle brick on top so it slopes to the front and back. Now place a gold lantern on top of a transparent yellow 1x1 round brick, then put it next to the reindeer! Now put them away while we make the carriage!

#### Group 2 - Carriage

10-11. Horizontally place a teal 6x8 plate with inverted sloped sides in front of you. Then place a short black 2x2 ridged brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

12-13. Vertically place a light grey 2x2 plate with a socket on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the socket faces the left. Now horizontally place a yellow 2x4 brick to the right so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on the front left corner so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

14-15. Horizontally place a light purple 1x6 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick behind it so it is centered horizontally. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

16-17. Vertically place a light purple 1x2 plate on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

18-21. Place a white 2x2x2 cabinet on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the opening faces the right. Now attach a transparent 2x2 cabinet door to the right-facing side of the cabinet.

22-23. Place a teal 2x2 brick on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place 3 tan 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 3rd column from the right so they slope to the left.

24-25. Place a teal 2x2 tile on the front 2 rows to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a magenta 1x2 jumper plate on the 5th column from the left so it is centered vertically.

26-27. Place a magenta 2x2 tile with a stud to the left of the ppp so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 panel with a long wall and a middle wall in front of the left column of the ppp so the long wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

28-29. Vertically place a teal 2x4 sloped curved tile printed with a light pink rectangle outline and a light blue diamond in the center on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Now horizontally place a teal 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick in front so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

30-31. Flip your build upside down so it is horizontal and the socket faces the left. Now vertically place a dark grey 2x4 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place dark grey 6x12 sled rails to the left so it is centered vertically and the long side faces the left. This piece is 2 1x12 plates connected with 2 arches!

### Group 3 - Carriage

32-33. Flip your build over so it is horizontal and the socket faces the left. Now vertically place a tan 2x4 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a gold 1x4 fence panel on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the wall faces the right. Now horizontally place a teal 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick in front so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

34-35. Place the lantern you made in group 1 on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so the handle is vertical. Now attach the bar of a white curved bar with a swirl to the front-facing clip so the swirl is on the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

36-37. Let's make a part! Let's make the connector for the reindeer and carriage! Horizontally place a light purple 2x2 plate connected to a 1x2 plate with long bars in front of you so the 1x2 plate is on the left. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball on the long side on the rightmost column so the ball faces the right. Now place a light purple 2x2 sloped curved tile on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the left.

38-39. Horizontally attach the ball of your part to the left-facing socket.

40-41. Bring back your reindeer and horizontally place it in front of you so the antlers face the right. Then take off the 2x2 half circle brick and 2x2 tile with a stud. Now rotate your carriage 180 degrees so the 1x2 plate overhang faces the right. Now attach the 1x2 plate overhang to the rightmost column of the reindeer.

42-43. Vertically place a light purple 1x2 plate on the left column of the reindeer.

44-47. Place a dark grey 2x2 half circle brick on top of the reindeer so it slopes to the front and back. Now put it away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 4 - Olaf

4-5. Place a white snowman body printed with buttons and brown arms in front of you so the hands face the front. Then place a white snowman head on top so the face faces the front. Place a brown stem with 3 tips on top. Then attach an orange unicorn horn to the front-facing hole. This is a carrot!

6-7. Place a white 1x1 swirl on top of a transparent 1x1 mug printed with hot chocolate, then attach it to Olaf's hand! Now put him away while we make the hot chocolate stand!

Group 5 - Hot Chocolate Stand

8-9. Place a light purple 10x10 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the front. Now vertically place a brown 1x4 brick with 3 holes on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

10-11. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick on the leftmost column in front of the 1x4 brick with 3 holes. Then place a transparent light blue 1x1 octagonal tile in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Then vertically place a teal 1x4 brick on the back 4 rows of the 2nd column from the left.

12-13. Horizontally place a tan 2x8x6 door frame on the 5th and 6th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally and the 1x8 studs are in the front. Now horizontally place a tan 1x8 brick on the front row of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

14-15. Place a nougat 2x2 round brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, in front of the 2x8x6 door frame. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a teal 2x8 plate on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally.

16-17. Horizontally place a brown 1x2x2 brick on the back right corner of the previous 2x8 plate. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 brick with a side stud in front so the side stud faces the front. Now horizontally place another 1 on top so the side stud faces the front.

18-19. Place a mint blue 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the 2 ppp. Then place 3 mint blue 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the ppp.

20-21. Place a brown 2x2 inverted cone brick on the rightmost 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a gold 1x1 faucet upright on the top front-facing side stud so the bar faces down.

#### Group 6 - Hot Chocolate Stand

22-23. Place a transparent 2x2 round brick on top of the previous 2x2 inverted cone brick. Then place a brown 2x2 round tile with a stud on top.

24-25. Let's make 2 identical parts! Insert a transparent 4x8 glass pane with a rounded side into a tan 1x6x6 door frame.

26-27. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 on the back left corner so the round side of the pillars face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

28-29. Horizontally place a magenta 1x4 plate on the 4 leftmost columns on top of the front row of the ppp and 1x8 brick. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x6 plate to the right.

30-31. Place a white 1x1 brick on the back left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x3 tile on the back left corner. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right, Then horizontally place a white 2x10 plate in front so it is centered horizontally.

32-33. Horizontally place a nougat 1x2 brick with 2 side studs in front of the previous 2x10 plate so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick with 4 side studs to the left and right so the side studs face the front.

#### Group 7 - Hot Chocolate Stand

34-35. Place a white 2x2 tile with a round side upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs so the round side hangs 1 row down. Then place 2 more upright on the front-facing side studs to the right so there are 2 free columns in between each of them. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a rounded side upright on the front-facing side studs in between the 3 ppp so the rounded side faces down. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 brick with 4 side studs on the 6th row from the back, on top of the bricks with upright tiles so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

36-37. Horizontally place a magenta 1x2 jumper plate on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 sloped curved brick to the left and right so they slope outwards to the left and right. Then place a transparent light blue snowflake on top of the 1x2 jumper plate.

38-39. Horizontally place a teal 2x4 rounded tile printed with hot chocolate and snow flakes upright on the 4 front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Now place a white and purple candy cane on the leftmost 2x2 tile with a stud so the curve faces the left. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 tile printed with a chocolate bar to the right so it is centered vertically on the 2x2 tile with a stud.

## Group 8 - Hot Chocolate Stand

40-41. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x6 plate on the 5th row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Make sure it is on the first floor! Then vertically place a mint blue 1x4 plate on top of the 1x4 brick that is on the front 4 rows of the 2nd column from the right.

42-43. Vertically place a teal 2x4 brick on the front 4 rows of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Then place 2 mint blue 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 in front of the other, on top of the ppp.

44-45. Place a magenta 1x1 round brick on the front 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a tan 1x1 round tile printed with sprinkles on top.

46-47. Place a brown 2x2 inverted cone brick on the 2x2 tile with a stud behind the ppp. Then place a light grey whisk inside.

48-51. Rotate your build 180 degrees, then place the hot chocolate you attached to Olaf's hand on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is to the right of the 1x2 tile printed with a chocolate bar! Now put your build away while we make more!

## Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

### Group 9 - Kristoff

4-5. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with dark blue shorts, dark grey socks, and black boots, 1 dark blue torso printed with light blue sleeves and a purple belt, 1 tan head printed with light brown eyes, nose, and lips, 1 tan hair, 1 brown pitchfork, and 1 yellow 1x2 ridged brick. Assemble your minifigure, then attach the pitchfork to his hand, and put the brick next to him. This brick is hay! Now put everything away while we make the stable!

### Group 10 - Stable

6-7. Horizontally place a nougat 6x10 plate in front of you. Then place a tan 2x2x3 brick on the back left corner.

8-9. Place a brown 2x2 barrel on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the ppp. Then horizontally place a nougat 1x4 brick on the back row to the right of the 2x2x3 brick. Now place a brown swirl on the 5th column from the right of the 3rd row from the front. This is a pile of poo!

10-11. Horizontally place a brown 1x4x2 fence on the back row on top of the 1x4 brick to the right of the 2x2x3 brick. Then place a tan 2x2x3 brick on the back 2 rows to the right. Now horizontally place 2 brown 1x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back left corner.

12-13. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the back of the 2 leftmost columns. Then place a tan 2x2 brick on the back left corner. Now horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the back on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Then place a tan 2x2 brick on top so there is no overhang.

14-15. Place a white 2x2 slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the front. Then place a transparent light blue crystal on the right stud of it. Now place another white 2x2 slope brick on the back 2 rows on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it slopes to the front. Then place a transparent light blue crystal on the left stud of it.

#### Group 11 - Stable

16-17. Place 2 yellow 2x2 bricks with a pin, 1 in front of the other, on the back right corner so the pins face the right. Then place a yellow 2x2 slope brick on the front right corner so it slopes to the front.

18-19. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 slope tile on the back right corner so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place a yellow 2x4 tile with 2 studs in front.

20-21. Attach a green stem to an orange carrot, then place it inside the barrel! Now place a brown pitch fork on the back stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs. Then place a yellow 1x2 ridged brick on the front stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs so it faces the front right and back left. Make sure the horizontal ridges face the front left.

22-23. Bring back your hot chocolate stand and place it in front of you so the round side of the 8x8 plate faces the front. Now horizontally attach the right-facing pins of your current build to the left-facing holes. Now put it away while we make the next part!

#### Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 4):

#### Group 12 - Anna

4-5. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with a blue dress, and black shoes, 1 torso printed with a black shirt and a mint blue long sleeve shirt, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes and pink lips, 1 red brown hair printed with a magenta and light purple hat. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you.

6-7. Place a white 1x1 swirl on top of a transparent 1x1 mug printed with hot chocolate, then attach it to Anna's hand! Now put her away while we make the sled and slide!

#### Group 13 - Sled

8-9. Let's make a sled! Horizontally place a light purple 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the long side on the back left corner so the clips face the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

10-11. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now place a nougat 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns.

12-13. Vertically place a nougat 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the right. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 panel with a long wall and a middle wall to the left so the middle wall faces the left.

14-15. Horizontally attach a white hockey stick to the front-facing clips so it is centered horizontally and the tip is on the right and faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now put your sled away while we make the slide!



#### Group 14 - Slide

16-17. Horizontally place a tan 4x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place 2 white 1x2 bricks with a pin on the long side, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so the pins face the left.

18-19. Vertically place a mint blue 2x4 brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it is centered vertically. Now vertically place a light grey 2x3 tile on the back 3 rows to the right.

20-21. Horizontally place 2 white 2x3 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 3 rightmost columns so they slope to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

22-23. Horizontally place a transparent light blue 1x2x2 panel on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the front. Now vertically place 2 mint blue 1x2 bricks, 1 in front of the other, to the right so they are centered vertically.

24-25. Vertically place 2 mint blue 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so they are centered vertically and slope to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

26-27. Place a white 4x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Now vertically place a teal 1x4 plate on the leftmost column of the 4x4 plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

28-29. Horizontally place a nougat 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the long side on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the clips face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a yellow 2x2 plate in between them so it is centered.

#### Group 15 - Slide

30-31. Vertically place a nougat 2x4 tile on top so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Then vertically place a white 1x4 panel to the left and right so the walls face outwards to the left and right.

32-33. Vertically attach a brown ladder to the back-facing clips so it slopes down.

#### Group 16 - Slide

34-35. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 4x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the bar faces the right.

36-37. Place a mint blue 2x2 sloped curved tile on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Now horizontally place 2 white 1x6 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the left so they are centered vertically.

38-39. Horizontally place 2 transparent light blue 1x4 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the walls face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

40-41. Vertically attach the bar of your part to the front-facing clips so it slopes to the front.

42-43. Bring back your main build and horizontally place it in front of you so the round side of the 8x8 plate faces the front. Now attach the left-facing pins of your current build to the right-facing holes.
