43260 Moana's Island Fun

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Fantastic adventures await Disney's Moana fans aged 5 and up in this LEGO® I Disney Moana's Island Fun (43260) fantasy building toy kit. Featuring a double-sided model inspired by the Disney's Moana 2 movie, this buildable micro-world playset is a small set with a big world inside. The island has a waterfall slide with a hidden entrance and the house has rooms for the Moana and little sis Simea LEGO I Disney micro-doll figures, plus space for Pua. There's a small boat and engaging story starters and the island can be locked with the key, making it perfect for on-the-go portable play.

Disney buildable model for kids – Inspire girls and boys aged 5 and up with this Moana's Island Fun building kit toy that's ready for imaginative role play and makes a fun fantasy display afterward.

Building kit micro-world – The buildable toy features a double-sided island/house model with a key, Moana and little sis Simea LEGO® | Disney micro-doll figures and a Pua LEGO | Disney animal figure.

Fantasy building toy functions – Unlock the model with the key, move the waterfall slide up to access the entrance and push the small upper waterfall section aside to find the hidden surprise.

LEGO® building set for kids – Place the building kit on display with everything tucked inside, or play out favorite movie scenes or unlimited new stories with Disney's Moana, little sis Simea and Pua.

Measurements – This 175-piece LEGO® building set features an opening island/house model that measures over 4 in. (10 cm) high,3 in. (8 cm) wide and 4 in. (10 cm) deep.

The front of the box shows the island in the back! There is a green side with a waterfall and trees! And the other side has a house! In the front, there is a small boat, a turtle, and Pua the pig!

The back of the box shows the back of the build! Moana and her little sister are in the front playing with a drum and a clam shell!

The top of the box shows a real size image of Moana's little sister Simea!

The build is 175 pieces in total and is for ages 5+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Moana, Pua, and the house.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Simea, a little turtle, boat, and the island!

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.

- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43260) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 bags labeled 1 and 2, 2 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Bag 1 - Moana, Pua, and House

Group 1 - Page 5.

Group 2 - Steps 1-12 and 3 red 1x1 round flower plates from Step 13.

Group 3 - Rest of Step 13 and Steps 14-25.

Group 4 - Steps 26-38.

Group 5 - Steps 39-43.

Bag 2 - Simea, Turtle, Boat, and Island

Group 6 - Page 3-4.

Group 7 - Steps 1-5.

Group 8 - Steps 1-7 and 2 light orange 1x1 round flower plates from Step 8.

Group 9 - Rest of Step 8 and Steps 9-17.

Group 10 - Steps 18-34.

Group 11 - Steps 35-46.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Moana and Pua

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 brown body printed with a dark tan dress with red drapes, 1 brown head printed with light brown eyes and lips, 1 brown hair, and 1 white pig with light grey spots. Assemble your minifigure then put Pua the pig next to her! Now put them away while we make the house!

Group 2 - House

- 1. Vertically place a green 2x6 plate in front of you.
- 2. Horizontally place a light green 4x8 plate with a rounded side and a gap on top of the middle 2 rows so it is centered horizontally, the rounded side faces the front, and the back row aligns with the back row of the 2x6 plate.
- 3. Horizontally place 2 lime green 2x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so they are centered horizontally.
- 4. Horizontally place a lime green 2x4 plate on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 5. Place a green 2x2 round plate underneath the front left overhang so 1 column is exposed to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 6. Place a lime green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the back stud of the left ppp so the leaves face the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 7. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally.
- 8. Horizontally place a brown 1x6 tile on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.
- 9. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x8x5 curved panel with a window in front of you so the top-facing studs face the back and the side studs face up.
- 10. Vertically place a light orange 1x4 plate on the left column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 11. Vertically place a light orange 2x3 wedge plate on the front 3 rows of the left column so the angled side overhangs to the left and the short end faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

- 12. Place a light orange 1x2 curved tile behind the left ppp so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 13.1. Place a red 1x1 round flower plate on the front right stud. Then place another 1 on the back right stud. Now place 1 more on the middle stud of the left column.

Group 3 - House

- 13.2. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the middle stud of the right column. Then place 1 on the front stud and back stud of the left column.
- 14. Horizontally place your part upright on the main build behind the 1x6 tile so it is centered horizontally and the upright 1x1 round flower plates face the front.
- 15. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now vertically place a nougat 1x2 brick with a side stud on the front left corner so the side stud faces the right. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate upright on the right-facing side stud.
- 16. Vertically place a tan 1x2x2 brick on the front left corner.
- 17. Vertically place a tan 1x2 ridged brick on the front left corner so the horizontal ridges face the right.
- 18. Place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on the front 2 rows on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right.
- 19. Place a dark brown 2x2 inverted dome brick on top of the ppp. Then place a tan 2x2 round tile on top.
- 20. Place a nougat 1x1 brick with a clip on the front right corner so the clip faces the right. Now place a tan 1x1 brick behind it.
- 21. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a clip on the long side on the front right corner so the clip faces the left. Then attach a light blue brush to the clip so the bristles face the left.
- 22. Vertically place a tan 1x2 ridged brick on the front right corner so the horizontal ridges face the left.
- 23. Place a nougat 1x1 brick with a clip on the front right corner so the clip faces the right. Then place a tan 1x1 brick behind it.
- 24. Horizontally place a green 1x2 rounded plate on the 4th row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then place a red brown 1x3 curved plate to the left so the curve faces the back left and there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 25. Horizontally place a brown 1x8 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

Group 4 - House

26. Let's make a part! Vertically place a lime green 2x4 plate in front of you.

- 27. Horizontally place a nougat 4x8 plate with a rounded side and a gap on top so the round side faces the front and the back row is aligned with the back row of the 2x4 plate.
- 28. Horizontally place 2 light orange 1x8 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the back 2 rows so they are centered horizontally.
- 29. Horizontally place 2 brown 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally and slope to the front.
- 30. Place a yellow 2x2x2 slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 31. Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 brick with 4 side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now place the front row of a yellow 2x2 corner slope brick to the left so it slopes to the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 32. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 ridged brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the vertical ridges face the front. Now place the front row of a yellow 2x2 corner brick with a cutoff corner to the left so the cutoff corner faces the front left. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 33. Horizontally place a light orange 4x6 trapezoid plate on top so it is centered and the short side faces the front.
- 34. Place a yellow 2x2 brick on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 35. Place a light orange 2x2 inverted slope brick to the left and right of the ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right.
- 36. Horizontally place a yellow 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 37. Vertically place a yellow 1x2 slope tile to the left and right of the ppp so they slope inwards.
- 38. Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the 1x4 tile faces the front. Now horizontally place your part on top so it is centered!

Group 5 - House

- 39. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 2x6 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the back.
- 40. Place a brown 2x2 round tile with a stud on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front. Now place 2 lime green 1x1 round plates with 3 leaves, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally and the leaves face the back left and back right.
- 41. Place a lime green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front row on the 2nd column from the left so the leaves face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 42. Place a white flower on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the 1x1 round plates with 3 leaves.

43. Horizontally place your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and the round side of the 2x6 plate with a round side overhangs 1 row to the top. Now put your build away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 6 - Simea, Turtle, and Clam

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 light brown body printed with tan shorts and a red and orange shirt, 1 light brown head printed with light brown eyes and lips, and 1 brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you. Now place a transparent blue gem tile inside of a white clam shell, then close it and place it in front of you. Then place a light green turtle with a light brown and light green shell in front of you. Now put everything away while we make the boat!

Group 7 - Boat

- 1. Let's make a boat! Horizontally place a nougat 2x3 plate in front of you.
- 2. Vertically place a brown 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column. Then place a light orange 2x2 round tile with a stud to the right.
- 3. Vertically place a light nougat 1x4 plate with inverted slope sides underneath the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 4. Place a brown 1x1 round plate on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud.
- 5. Place a brown 4L bar on top of the ppp. Then attach a white flag to the bar so it faces the left and the angled side faces up. Now put your build away while we make the island!

Group 8 - Island

- 1. Vertically place a lime green 2x6 plate in front of you.
- 2. Horizontally place a light green 4x8 plate with a rounded side and a gap on top of the middle 2 rows so it is centered horizontally, the rounded side faces the front, and the back row aligns with the back row of the 2x6 plate.
- 3. Horizontally place a green 1x2 rounded plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a dark green 1x2 ingot tile on top.
- 4. Place a light blue 2x2 corner tile on the back 2 rows on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it looks like the braille letter f. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 5. Place a teal 2x2 plate on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 6. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light green 2x8x5 curved panel with a window in front of you so the top-facing studs face the back and the side studs face up.

- 7. Place a light orange 1x1 round flower plate on the back right corner.
- 8.1. Place a light orange 1x1 round flower plate on the right column on the 2nd stud from the front. Then place another 1 on the left column on the 2nd stud from the back.

Group 9 - Island

- 8.2. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the back left corner. Then place another 1 on the left column on the 2nd stud from the front. Then place 1 more on the right column on the 2nd stud from the back. Now place a light grey 1x1 round tile on the front left corner and front right corner.
- 9. Horizontally place your part on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front.
- 10. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the front left corner so the clip faces the left. Now place a green 1x1 brick behind it.
- 11. Vertically place 2 dark grey 1x2 log bricks, 1 on top of the other, on the front left corner so there is no overhang.
- 12. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the front left corner so the clip faces the left. Now place a green 1x1 brick behind it.
- 13.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 brick with a hole in front of you. Then insert a lime green 2L pin with an axle hole into the right-facing hole so the pin goes all the way through and faces the left.
- 13.2. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 log brick on top.
- 13.3. Place a dark grey 2x2 inverted slope brick on top so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2 log brick on the left column.
- 13.4. Vertically place your part on the front right corner so the pin faces the left.
- 14. Place a green 1x3 curved plate on the 3 leftmost columns on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th rows from the front so the curve faces the back left and there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 15. Vertically attach a dark tan 4L axle connector with 2 pinholes to the left-facing pin so the other pinhole is on top and in the front.
- 16. Horizontally place a green 1x8 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.
- 17. Insert a teal key into the right-facing axle hole. You can turn the key to move the 4L axle connector with 2 pinholes back and forth!
- 18. Rotate your build 180 degrees and take out the key and put it away. Now place a light grey 1x1 round tile on the back left corner. Then place a light orange 1x1 round flower plate in front. Make sure they are on the 2x2 inverted slope brick!

- 19.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x4 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a light blue 2x2 sloped curved tile on top so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the front.
- 19.2. Place a long brown curved bar on the leftmost column so the bar faces the front left. Then attach a lime green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves to the end of it so the leaves face the back left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 19.3. Horizontally place your part on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 20. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the long side on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the clips face the front. Now vertically attach the bar of a transparent light blue 2x6 curved windshield to the front-facing bar so it slopes down to the front! Make sure the wall side faces down! This is a waterfall!
- 21. Let's make a part! Vertically place a light grey 2x4 plate in front of you.
- 22. Horizontally place a light green 4x8 plate with a rounded side and a gap on top so the round side faces the front and the back row is aligned with the back row of the 2x4 plate.
- 23. Vertically place a green 1x2 rounded plate on the back right corner.
- 24. Horizontally place a lime green 2x6 plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 25. Vertically place a nougat 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the back left corner so the clip faces the left.
- 26. Horizontally place a dark green 1x2 slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right so it slopes to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 27. Vertically place a light blue 2x3 tile on the front 3 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 28. Place a teal 2x2 plate to the left of the back 2 rows of the ppp. Now place a teal 2x2 slope brick to the right of the back 2 rows of the 2x3 tile so it slopes to the right.
- 29. Vertically place a teal 1x2 slope tile on the left column of the previous 2x2 plate so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a green 1x2 rounded plate to the right.
- 30. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on top of the ppp so the clip faces the front.
- 31. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 arch brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 32. Place a dark grey 2x2 corner brick with a cutoff corner on the back 2 rows to the front left of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 33. Place a dark grey 1x1 round brick on the 2nd row from the front in front of the right column of the left ppp. Then place a light green 1x1 round brick with 3 leaves on the 2nd row from the front in front of the left column of the right 2x2 corner brick with a cutoff corner so the leaves face the front right.

- 34. Horizontally place a green 3x6 trapezoid plate on the back 3 rows so it is centered horizontally and the short side faces the front.
- 35. Place a green 2x2 brick on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 36. Place a green 2x2 corner slope brick on the back 2 rows to the left and right of the ppp so they slope to the front left and front right respectively. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x2 sloped curved brick on the 3rd row from the back so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front.
- 37. Place 2 green 2x2 corner slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so they are centered horizontally and slope to the front left and front right respectively.
- 38. Vertically attach the bar of a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side to the front-facing clip. Then vertically place a light blue 1x2 sloped curved brick on top so it slopes to the left.
- 39. Now rotate the ppp to the right so it slopes to the front!
- 40. Bring back your previous build so it is centered horizontally and the windshield slopes to the front. Now horizontally place your current build on top so it is centered!
- 41.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a gold 1x1 telescope bar in front of you. Then place a transparent orange candle flame on top.
- 41.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 on the leftmost column on the 3rd row from the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 42. Place 2 light green 1x2 rounded plates with leaves, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally, overhang 1 row to the front, and the leaves face the front left and front right.
- 43. Horizontally place a green 1x2 rounded plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 44. Place 2 lime green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves, 1 to the right of the other, on the ppp so the leaves face the front left and front right.
- 45. Attach the bar of a teal key to the left-facing clip so the handle is in the back!
- 46. Rotate your build so it is vertical and the waterfall faces the left. Now vertically attach the bar of a red brown 1x2 rounded brick with a gap to each of the front-facing clips. Now bring back your previous build and orient it so the upright 1x1 round flower plates face the left. Now attach the back-facing clips of it to the 2 ppp.
