## 43275 Cinderella's Castle & Horse Carriage

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Kick-start endless fantasy play and stories for kids aged 6 and up with this LEGO® I Disney Princess Cinderella's Castle & Horse Carriage (43275) building set toy. The set includes a buildable 2-level castle playset featuring a ballroom with spinning floor, a sewing room and 3 rooms upstairs. Attached to the castle, there's a stable with hay and a saddle for the LEGO I Disney horse figure. There's also a carriage with a harness and room for LEGO I Disney mini-doll figures Cinderella and Prince Charming, plus LEGO Disney animal figures Lucifer and Gus, and many play accessories.

Disney's Cinderella buildable castle playset for kids – Treat girls and boys aged 6 and up with a Cinderella's Castle & Horse Carriage building playset and spark fantasy stories as kids dive into play.

Model kit – Includes a buildable 2-level castle toy with a stable, multiple rooms, a spinning floor, a carriage with a harness and LEGO® I Disney horse figure, 4 LEGO I Disney characters and more.

Buildable fantasy toy functions – Place Disney Princess Cinderella and Prince Charming on the spinning floor so they can dance or change the horse's harness for a saddle or bag.

Disney castle playset – The fantasy building toy has 4 entrances, including a mouse door, window for Lucifer, Cinderella's gown, crown and wand, a carriage with a harness and gold accents, and more.

Measurements – This 596-piece buildable playset includes a 2-level castle that measures over 11.5 in. (29 cm) high, 11 in. (28 cm) wide and 3.5 in. (9 cm) deep.

The build is 596 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Cinderella and the sewing room.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Lucifer the cat and the cat room.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Prince Charming and the ballroom.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for the bedroom.

Bag 5 includes the pieces for the horse and stable.

Bag 6 includes the pieces for the piano room.

Bag 7 includes the pieces for the carriage.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.

- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<u>https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43275</u>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

## Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3 and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 7 bags labeled 1 to 7, 5 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 10 - Steps 1-7 and 2 white 2x2 tiles and 2 white 1x2 tiles from Steps 8-9. Group 11 - Rest of Steps 8-9 and Steps 10-16. Group 12 - Steps 17-22. Group 13 - Steps 23-37. Bag 4 - Bedroom Group 14 - Steps 1-16. Group 15 - Steps 17-30. Group 16 - Steps 31-44. Bag 5 - Horse and Stable Group 17 - Page 2. Group 18 - Steps 1-9. Group 19 - Steps 1-8. Group 20 - Steps 9-15. Group 21 - Steps 16-17. Group 22 - Steps 18-24. Bag 6 - Piano Room Group 23 - Steps 1-13 and 1 black 1x2 tile from Step 14. Group 24 - Rest of Step 14, Steps 15-19, and 1 light pink 1x2 plate from Step 20. Group 25 - Rest of Step 20 and Steps 21-31. Group 26 - Steps 32-38. Bag 7 - Carriage Group 27 - Steps 1-12. Group 28 - Steps 13-25. Group 29 - Steps 26-38.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Cinderella

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 light blue dress printed with blue drapes, 1 tan torso printed with a light blue dress, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes and pink lips, 1 light yellow hair with a light blue headband. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we build the sewing room!

Group 2 - Sewing Room

1. Vertically place a tan 6x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the back right corner.

2. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick on the front right corner.

3. Place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right. Then place another 1 in front of the ppp. Now place a light orange 1x1 slope tile on the 3rd row from the front, on the 3rd column from the left, so it slopes to the front left.

4. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick on the front left corner. Then place a light blue 1x1 brick on the 2nd row from the front on the rightmost column.

5. Place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on the leftmost column on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back so it overhangs 1 column to the left.

6. Vertically place a lime green 4x8 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so it is centered vertically to the build and the round side faces the left.

7. Place a brown  $2x^2$  tile on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, on the 4th and 5th columns from the left, so it sits in front of the  $2x^2$  tile with a stud.

8. Place a light blue 1x2 curved brick on the front 2 rows on the 7th and 8th columns from the right so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

9. Vertically place a brown 1x2x2 panel with a rounded window behind the left column of the front ppp so the wall faces the left. It should sit to the left of a 2x2 tile. Then vertically place a light blue 1x2 brick behind the ppp.

10.1. Horizontally place a white 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the back right corner so the wall faces the back.

10.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the white 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a bunch of pictures of a dress, a dog, and words hung up on the wall! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

11. Place a light blue 1x2 curved brick on the front 2 rows on top of the previous 1x2 curved brick so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a blue 2x2 inverted slope brick behind the 1x2x2 panel with a rounded window so it slopes and overhangs to the left.

12. Vertically place a light blue  $1x^2$  brick on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a light blue  $1x^2$  slope brick on the front row to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left so it slopes to the right. Then place a light blue  $1x^1$  brick to the left.

13.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a window! Horizontally place a white 2x8 curved panel with a window and side studs in front of you so the top studs face the back and the side studs face up. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 tile on the back row.

13.2. Vertically place a white 1x3 plate on the left column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

13.3. Vertically place a light pink 1x2 tile on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

13.4. Place a light pink 1x2 curved tile behind the left ppp so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

13.5. Vertically place your part on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the left.

14. Place an orange 1x1 round plate on the back stud of the 2nd column from the left. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on top.

15. Place an orange pumpkin on the back stud of the leftmost column. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on top.

Group 3 - Sewing Room

16. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front stud of the 2x2 inverted slope brick that is on the 2nd column from the left so the leaves face the left. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top.

17. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the rounded side of the build faces the back. Now place a light orange 2x2 box on the back 2x2 tile with a stud that is to the right of a 2x2 tile. Then place a silver pair of scissors inside!

18. Let's make a part! Let's make a sewing machine! Horizontally place a black 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 ridged brick on the leftmost column so the horizontal ridges face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

19. Horizontally place a black 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top so it is centered horizontally.

20. Place a black 1x1 cone brick on the left stud of the ppp. Then vertically place a light pink 1x2 tile to the right of the ppp so it overhangs to the front.

21.1. Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 cone brick in front of you. Then place a black 1x1 short rounded brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front. Now place a light grey 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar upright on the front-facing side stud.

21.2. Now place a black 1x1 brick with 2 side studs on the sides in front of you so the side studs face the left and right. Then place the cone brick of your current part upright on the right-facing side stud so the 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar faces down. Then place a light grey steering wheel upright on the left-facing side stud.

21.3. Horizontally place the 1x1 brick of your part on top of the cone brick of your previous part so the steering wheel faces the left.

22. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, to the left of the 1x6x5 panel.

23. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the front right corner. Then vertically place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap behind it. Now vertically place a white 1x2 brick behind the ppp.

24. Place a white 1x2 curved brick on the 2 rightmost columns behind the ppp so the curve faces the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 brick in between the back row of them.

25. Vertically place a white 1x2x3 slope brick on the front left corner so it slopes to the back. Then place a white 1x1x5 brick on the front row to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place a white 1x2x3 slope brick on the leftmost column, in front of the 1x2 curved brick so it slopes to the front.

26. Vertically place a white 1x3 inverted slope brick on the front left corner so it slopes to the back. Then vertically place another 1 behind it so it slopes to the front.

27. Vertically place a white 1x6 brick on the front left corner on top of the 2 ppp.

28. Horizontally place a light blue 4x8 plate on the front 4 rows so it is centered horizontally.

29. Horizontally place another behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 4 - Lucifer the Cat

Sub-build 2. Locate a black cat with tan toes, and pink ears, nose, and green eyes, and place him in front of you! Now put him away while we build the pet room!

Group 5 - Cat Room

30. Rotate your main build so it is horizontal and the rounded side faces the left. Then horizontally place a white 1x6 brick on the back right corner.

31. Horizontally place a white 1x3 brick in front of the 3 leftmost columns of the ppp.

32. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 tile on the back right corner.

33. Horizontally place a white 2x3 brick on the back 2 rows to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick to the left so it slopes to the back.

34. Place a tan 1x1x1 corner panel on the 3rd row from the back on the 4th column from the right so the corner faces the front right. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3x1 panel to the left so the wall faces the front.

35. Place a blue 2x2x3 corner slope brick on the back 2 rows to the left of the 1x2x2 slope brick so it slopes to the back left and overhangs 1 column to the left. Now horizontally place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick in front so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the left.

36. Vertically place a white 1x2x2 rounded window frame on the 3rd column from the left so the ridges face the left. Then attach a gold rounded lattice window pane to the left-facing side of it. Make sure to count the 2 leftmost columns at the ground level!

37. Horizontally place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the left.

38. Vertically place a blue 1x4 arch brick on top of the 2 slope bricks and rounded window frame that are on the 3rd column from the left.

39. Place a blue 2x2x3 corner slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front left and overhangs 1 column to the left. Now place 2 blue 2x2x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp so they slope to the front.

40. Rotate your build so it is vertical and the rounded side faces the back. Then place a white 1x1 brick on the 4th row from the front on the 3rd column from the left. Then place a white 1x1 double slope tile on top so it slopes to the left and right.

41. Place a light orange 2x2 plate on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the left.

42. Vertically place a blue 1x3 brick on the 2nd column from the left and 5th, 6th, and 7th rows from the front, on top of the 2x2x2 slope bricks, and in front of the 2x2x3 corner slope brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

43.1. Horizontally place a tan 2x3 tile with a sticker to the left of the right ppp so it sits on top of the 1x3 panel. The tile side should face the left and it should not attach to any studs!

43.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the tan 2x3 tile. This sticker has a bunch of pictures of a cat, cheese, mouse, and a trap for the mouse! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 6 - Cat Room

44. Horizontally place a blue 4x6 plate on top of the 1x3 bricks and 2x2x3 corner slope bricks so it is centered horizontally on them!

45. Place a white 1x1 brick with a hole in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of the ppp so the holes face the front.

46. Attach a gold 1x1 round plate with a dangling tassel to the hole of the right ppp.

47. Horizontally place a blue 1x6 plate in front of the 4x6 plate so it sits on the 2 1x1 bricks with a hole.

48. Horizontally place 3 gold 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row of the previous 4x6 plate so there is no overhang.

49. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the 3 ppp.

50. Place a white 2x2 corner brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it looks like the braille letter d. Then place another 1 to the left so it looks like the braille letter f.

Group 7 - Cat Room

51. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back left corner.

52. Horizontally place a light blue  $1x^2$  plate on the front left corner. Then vertically place a light blue  $1x^2$  plate with 2 side studs sticking up on the rightmost column so the side studs face the right.

53. Place a light pink 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns.

54. Vertically place a light pink 1x2 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a light pink 1x2 tile to the right. Now vertically place a light pink 1x2 jumper plate to the right.

55. Place a pink 1x1 quarter circle tile upright on the front right-facing side stud so the curve faces the top left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. This is a cat bed!

56. Vertically place the 1x2 slope tile of your part in between the previous 2x2 corner bricks so the quarter circle tiles face the front.

Group 8 - Cat Room

57. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on 2 sides on the long sides behind your ppp so it is centered horizontally to it. Now horizontally place a blue 1x2 slope tile upright on the back-facing side studs of the ppp so it slopes down.

58. Vertically place a white 1x2 masonry brick on the 2x2 corner brick to the left of the ppp so the brick grooves face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

59. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 plate on the back row of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light blue 1x1 plate in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of it.

60. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 rounded window frame on top of the previous 1x4 plate so it is centered horizontally on it and the ridged side faces the back. Then attach a gold rounded lattice window pane to the back-facing side of it.

61.1. Vertically place a light yellow 2x3 pentagonal tile upright on the front-facing side studs below your ppp so the angled side faces up.

61.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the light yellow 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker has a picture of a paw, curves and swirls! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

62. Vertically place 2 white 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 on top of the other, to the left of the 1x2x2 rounded window frame so there is no overhang and the brick grooves face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

63. Horizontally place a white 1x4 arch brick on the back row of the 4 ppp and 1x2x2 rounded window frame so it is centered horizontally.

64. Place a white 1x1 brick in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of the ppp.

65. Place the middle stud of the front row of a blue 3x3 quarter circle plate on the left 1x1 brick from the previous step so the curve faces the back left. It should overhang 1 column to the left and 1 row to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

66. Place a red 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally on it.

67. Place a blue 1x1 slope tile on the front left corner of the left 3x3 quarter circle plate so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a pink wand with a star on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered horizontally.

68. Horizontally place a transparent blue 2x4x4 half cone panel with a rounded window behind the 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered horizontally, there is no overhang, and it slopes to the back.

69. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Then place a gold ski pole on top.

70. Place a light blue fish on the 3x3 plate that is on the front left corner. Then place a pink yarn ball on the 2nd row from the front on the 3rd column from the right! Now put your build away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 2):

Group 9 - Prince Charming

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with dark red pants and black shoes, 1 tan torso printed with light yellow armor, 1 tan head printed with light brown eyes and lips, 1 black hair, and 1 silver sword. Assemble your minifigure then attach the sword to his hand!

Group 10 - Ballroom

1. Place a tan 6x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back right corner.

2. Place a white 1x1 tile on the back row to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 tile to the left.

3. Place a white 2x2 tile with a round ridge on the back left corner so it overhangs 1 column to the left.

4. Place a tan 6x6 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered vertically to the build.

5. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back left corner. Then place a white 1x1 tile to the right. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 tile to the right.

6. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

7. Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile on the 3rd row from the back so it is centered horizontally. Then place a white 2x2 tile with a round ridge in front.

8.1. Place a white 2x2 tile on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back and 4th and 5th columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

You will have 2 extra 1x2 tiles. Save them for later!

Group 11 - Ballroom

8.2. Place a black 2x2 tile in front of each of the 2 ppp.

9. Vertically place a black 1x2 tile on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 3rd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place a white 1x2 tile from group 10 in front of each of the 2 ppp.

10. Vertically place a red 1x2 jumper plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back and the 2nd column from the left. Then vertically place another 1 in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

11. Place a light blue 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 inverted half arch brick to the right so it slopes to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

12. Place 2 red 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally and slope and overhang to the front. Now vertically place a light blue 1x2 sloped curved tile to the left and right so they slope and overhang to the front.

13. Place a black 2x2 round plate with 6 arms on the front 2x2 tile with a round ridge. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

14. Vertically place a white 1x4x6 door frame on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the ridge faces the left.

15.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a present! Place a light pink 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 light blue 1x2 plates, 1 in front of the other, on top. Now place a light pink 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then place a light blue 1x1 round flower plate on top.

15.2. Place the back right corner of your part on the back 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the 1x4x6 door frame so the front left corner is slightly angled to the left.

16. Place a gold 1x1 cone brick on the back 1x2 jumper plate that is on the 2nd column from the left. Then place a transparent 1x1 dish on top. Then place a light blue cupcake wrapper on top. Now place a light pink 1x1 swirl on top.

Group 22 - Ballroom

17. Repeat the previous step symmetrically to the front but now using a light purple 1x1 swirl.

18. Vertically place a white 1x4x6 door frame on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the ridge faces the right.

19. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a white 1x2x2 brick on top. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with an axle hole on top. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

20.1. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then horizontally place a light blue  $1x^2$  brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a white  $1x^2x^2$  brick with a sticker on top so the sticker faces the front. Now horizontally place a white  $1x^2$  brick with an axle hole on top.

20.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the white 1x2x2 brick. This sticker is a gold portrait of Lucifer the cat in a pink bowtie. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

21.1. Horizontally place a light blue  $1x^2$  brick on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a white  $1x^2x^2$  brick with a sticker on top so the sticker faces the front. Now horizontally place a white  $1x^2$  brick with an axle hole on top.

21.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the white 1x2x2 brick. This sticker is a gold portrait of Gus the mouse! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

22. Place a white 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 13 - Ballroom

23. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

24.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a gold 1x1 round plate with a bar upside down in front of you so the bar faces the back. Now place a gold 1x1 telescope bar on top so the anti-stud faces up. Then insert a transparent orange candle flame into the top.

24.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach the bar of 1 part to the left front-facing axle hole so the flame faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

25. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the flames are in the back. Place a white 1x1 brick on the rightmost column on the 3rd row from the back. Now place another 1 on the front right corner. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

26. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the front left corner. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip behind it so the clip faces the left. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

27. Vertically place a gold 1x4 lattice panel on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the wall faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

28. Horizontally place a white 1x5x4 half arch brick on the front row on the 2nd column from the left so it arches to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

29. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

30. Horizontally place a white 1x4 tile on top of the front 1x5x4 half arch bricks so it is centered horizontally. Now repeat symmetrically to the back.

31. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the back row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

32. Vertically place a white 1x6 brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

33. Vertically place a gold 2x3 pentagonal tile upright on the left 2 front-facing side studs so the angled side hangs 2 rows down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

34.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's make lights! Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate in front of you. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 cone brick on top. Now place a gold 1x1 round plate with a bar on top so the bar faces the back.

34.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach the bar of 1 part to the left front-facing axle hole so the anti-stud faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

35. Vertically place a light blue 2x6 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

36. Bring back your main build and orient it so the rounded side faces the front. Now horizontally attach the right-facing clips of your current build to the left-facing bars of the 1x2 rounded bricks of the main build.

37. Place the 2 left columns of a white 1x3 curved brick on the front 3 rows of the previous 2x6 plate so the curve faces the front left and the rightmost column attaches to the main build. Then place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of each stud of the ppp. Now put your build away for now while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 3):

Group 14 - Bedroom

1. Horizontally place a light blue 2x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 2x4 tile on top so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 2 rows to the front.

2. Place a light blue 8x8 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front.

3. Vertically place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back 4 rows to the left and right of the 2x4 tile.

4. Horizontally place a light pink 1x2 tile on the back left corner. Then place a light pink 2x2 tile with a stud in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

5. Horizontally place a white 1x4 tile on the 5th row from the back so it is centered horizontally. Now place a white 1x1 brick on the leftmost column in front of the 2x2 tile with a stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

6. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick on the 5th row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Now place the front row of a light blue 1x2 curved brick to the left so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

7. Horizontally place a white  $1x^2$  tile on the 4th row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a white  $1x^2$  inverted half arch brick to the left and right so they slope inwards to the left and right.

8. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a round side on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front. Then place 2 light pink 1x2 curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, in front so they are centered horizontally and curve to the front left and front right.

9. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick on top of the 1x4 brick that is on the 5th row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light blue 1x2 curved brick to the left and right so there is no overhang.

10. Place a white 1x1 round brick on the 2nd column from the left on top of the 1x2 inverted half arch brick that is in front of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

11. Place the leftmost column of a white 1x4x2 curved fence with swirls in front of the left ppp so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

12. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a stud and a clip on top of the leftmost column of the ppp and 1x1 round brick so the clip faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

13. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the studs of the 2 ppp. Then place 2 more, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally.

14.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a clock! Horizontally place a white 2x8 curved panel with a window and side studs in front of you so the top studs face the back and the side studs face up. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 tile on the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

14.2. Horizontally place a white 2x4 plate in between the 2 ppp. Then place a white 4x4 dish printed with a light blue and gold clock on top so it is centered.

14.3. Horizontally place your part behind the 1x2 plates with a stud and a clip so it is centered horizontally and the 4x4 dish faces the front.

15. Attach a gold curved bar with a swirl to the left top-facing clip so it is upright and curves to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

16. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the round side of the build faces the back. Now place a white 1x1x5 brick on the leftmost column on the 4th row from the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. They should sit in front of the 2x8 curved panel with a window!

Group 15 - Bedroom

17. Place the front row of a light blue 1x3 curved plate on top of the left ppp so the curve faces the back left and there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate in between the back row of them.

18. Let's make a part! Let's make the bed! Horizontally place a white 4x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light pink 1x2 tile on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

19. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a side stud on the rightmost column on the 2nd row from the front so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

20. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

21. Vertically place a light pink 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left. Then horizontally place a white 2x4 brick to the right.

22. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically.

23.1. Horizontally place a light pink 2x4 tile with a sticker to the left of the ppp so it is centered vertically.

23.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the light pink 2x4 tile. This sticker has a pink blanket with a gold heart and a purple stripe at the end with gold etchings. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

24. Horizontally place 2 light pink 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they slope to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

25. Vertically place a light pink  $1x^2$  sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Then vertically place a white  $1x^2$  panel with a long wall and middle wall on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the long wall faces the left.

26. Attach a gold curved bar with a swirl to the front-facing side stud that is on the rightmost column so the swirl faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

27.1. Vertically place a light yellow 2x3 pentagonal tile with a sticker upright on the left-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and the angled side overhangs 2 rows to the top.

27.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the light yellow 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker has a slipper on it with gold etchings. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

28. Vertically place your part on the front 5 rows of the main build so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front. The 2x3 pentagonal tile should face the front!

29.1. Let's make a part! Place a light blue 1x1 brick with a side stud and a bottom lip in front of you so the side stud faces the front, Now place a pink 1x1 plate on top.

29.2. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top. Then place 1 upright on the front-facing side stud.

29.3. Place a white candle stick on top. Then place a transparent orange candle flame on top. Now place your part on the front left 2x2 tile with a stud so the side stud faces the front right.

30. Place a blue brush on the front right 2x2 tile with a stud so the bristles face the front left.

Group 16 - Bedroom

31. Place a white 2x2 inverted slope brick on the 1x2 plate that is behind the bed so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs 1 row to the back. It should go on top of the panel with the clock!

32. Place a transparent blue 1x1 round brick to the left of the front row of the ppp. Then place a white 1x2 curved brick to the left so the curve faces the back left. Now place a transparent blue 1x1 round brick in front of the left column of it. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

33. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 4x8 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the back. Then place a red 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

34. Horizontally place a transparent blue 4x8x8 half cone panel on the back row so it is centered horizontally and it slopes to the back.

35. Horizontally place a red 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top of the ppp.

36. Place a gold crown on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the tips face the front.

37. Horizontally place a transparent blue 2x4x4 half cone panel on top of the 4x8x8 half cone panel so it is centered horizontally and it slopes to the back.

38. Let's make a part! Let's make a flag! Place a gold 1x1 cone brick in front of you. Then place a pink flag on top so the flag faces the left.

39. Place a gold harpoon spike on top of the ppp then push it all the way down.

40. Now place your part on top of the 2x4x4 half-cone brick so the flag faces the left.

41. Horizontally place a light blue dress with drapes on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud.

42. Horizontally place your part on top of the 1x2 curved bricks and 1x1 round bricks so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the back. The front left and front right corners should sit on the 1x1 round bricks!

43. Bring your main build back so it is horizontal and the 2x4x4 half cone panel is in the back left and slopes to the back. Place the front right corner of your part on the front row on the 3rd column from the right so the rounded side faces the back.

44. Vertically place a light blue 2x6 plate on the 2 rightmost columns of your build so there is no overhang!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 4):

Group 17 - Horse

Sub-build 4. Place a white horse with mint blue hair and snowflakes in front of you so the head faces the left. Then place a white 2x2 plate on top. Now place a white 2x2 half cylinder brick on top so it slopes to the front and back.

Group 18 - Stable

1. Horizontally place a lime green 4x8 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the front. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on the back right corner.

2. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on the back right corner so the clip faces the right. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on top.

3. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 brick in front of the ppp so it overhangs 1 column to the right.

4. Place a brown 2x2 round brick on the back 2 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left.

5. Place a light blue 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the ppp. Then place a light blue 2x2 round plate on the 2 rightmost columns on top of the 1x2 plate and brick.

6. Horizontally place a transparent blue 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the back right corner so the wall faces the back. Then horizontally place another 1 in front so the wall faces the front.

7. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 ridged brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally so the vertical ridges face the front. Now horizontally place the left column of a yellow 1x2 ridged brick behind the right column of the ppp so the vertical ridges face the front.

8. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 2nd column from the left, in front of the 2x2 tile with a stud so the leaves face the front left. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top.

9. Place a teal 2x2 horse saddle on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so the stud is in the front. Now put your part away while we make the next thing!

## Group 19 - Stable

1. Vertically place a lime green 6x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on the back right corner so the bar faces the right.

2. Place a light blue 1x1 brick on the rightmost column in front of the ppp. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick on the back row to the left of the 1x2 brick with a bar. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick to the left so it overhangs 2 columns to the left.

3. Vertically place a lime green 4x8 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so it is centered vertically to the build and the round side faces the left.

4. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick to the left. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick to the left.

5. Vertically place a brown 1x1 plate with a 1x1 slope tile on the 3rd column from the left on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

6. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 brick on the back right corner. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 slope brick on the back row to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place another 1 to the left so it slopes to the right.

7. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick on the back row to the left of the ppp. Then place a light blue 1x1 brick to the left.

8. Horizontally place a white 1x2x3 slope brick on the back right corner so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place another 1 to the left so it slopes to the right. Make sure there are 2 columns in between them! Then horizontally place a white 1x2x2 brick to the left.

Group 20 - Stable

9. Place a brown 1x1 brick with a clip on the 3rd column from the left on top of the 2nd row from the back so the clip faces the left. Then place a red brown 1x1 brick on top. Now place another brown 1x1 brick with a clip on top so the clip faces the left.

10. Place a light grey 1x1 rounded brick with a side stud on top of the ppp so the side stud faces the left.

11. Place the front row of a white 2x2 corner brick on top of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter f.

12. Horizontally place a white 1x3 inverted slope brick on the back right corner so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left so it slopes to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 brick to the left.

13. Horizontally place a white 1x8 brick on the back row so there is no overhang.

14. Place a white 1x1x5 brick on the rightmost column in front of the ppp.

15. Horizontally place a white 1x6x5 panel on the front right corner so the wall faces the front.

16. Place a brown 1x1x2 brick on the 2nd row from the front on the 3rd column from the left.

17. Place a light grey 1x1 rounded brick with a side stud on top of the ppp so the side stud faces the left. Then horizontally place a white 1x2x2 brick on the front row to the left of the 1x6x5 panel.

18. Place a white  $2x^2$  corner brick on the front 2 rows to the left of the  $1x^6x^5$  panel so it looks like the braille letter h. Then horizontally place a white  $1x^2$  brick on the front row on top of the ppp.

19. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the front row to the left. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 brick to the left.

20. Vertically place a white 1x6x2 arch brick on the 3rd column from the left so it is centered vertically.

21. Vertically place a light blue 4x8 plate on the 4 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

22. Vertically place a light blue 4x8 plate to the left of the ppp so it is centered vertically.

23. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the rounded side faces the front. Now attach the bars of a brown 3x4 ridged gate door with side studs to the front-facing clips so the door is on the right and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place the 3 left columns of a light blue 1x4 tile upright on the front-facing side studs of it so 1 columns overhangs to the right.

24. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing side stud so the leaves face the top left. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate upright on it. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. This is the stable!

Building Instructions (Bag 6, Book 5):

Group 23 - Piano Room

1. Locate 1 tan mouse with ears and a nose printed with a yellow shirt! This is Gus! Now put him away while we continue building! Let's build the piano room on top of the stable! Orient the stable so the rounded side of the build faces the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x6 brick on the back left corner.

2. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 tile on the back left corner.

3. Horizontally place a white 1x3 brick on the 2nd row from the back, in front of the 3 rightmost columns of the 1x6 brick.

4. Horizontally place a white 2x3 brick on the back 2 rows on top of the ppp. Then vertically place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick to the right so it slopes to the back.

5. Horizontally place a blue 1x4 brick on top of the front row of the 2 ppp so there is no overhang.

6. Place a blue 2x2x3 corner slope brick on the back 2 rows to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the back right and overhangs 1 column to the right. Now horizontally place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick in front so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the right.

7. Vertically place a white 1x2x2 rounded window frame in front of the left column of the ppp so the ridged side faces the right. Now attach a gold lattice rounded window pane to the right-facing side of the ppp.

8. Horizontally place a blue 1x2x2 slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the right.

9. Vertically place a blue 1x4 arch brick on top of the 2 previous 1x2x2 slope bricks and rounded window frame so there is no overhang.

10. Place a blue 2x2x3 corner slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front right and overhangs 1 column to the right. Now place 2 blue 2x2x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 2 rows to the left of the ppp so they slope to the front.

11. Horizontally place a blue 1x4 brick on top of the 2 ppp.

12. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the rounded side faces the back. Now place a red 2x2 tile with a stud on the 4th and 5th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally.

13.1. Horizontally place a light yellow 2x4 tile with a sticker on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

13.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the light yellow 2x4 tile. This sticker has a light pink and pink oval rug with a light blue pearl necklace on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

You will have an extra black 1x2 tile. Save it for later!

Group 24 - Piano Room

14.1. Let's make a part! Let's make the piano! Place a black 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 brick on the back row. Now place 2 gold 1x1 round flower plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row.

14.2. Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile from group 23 on the back row. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile printed with piano keys on the front row.

14.3. Place your part on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so the higher side is in the back.

15. Horizontally place a blue 1x6 plate on the 4th row from the front so it is centered horizontally.

16. Horizontally place a blue 4x6 plate behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

17. Horizontally place 3 gold 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row of the ppp so there is no overhang.

18. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the studs of the 3 ppp.

19. Place a white 2x2 corner brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of the 4x6 plate, in front of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter f. Then place another 1 to the right so it looks like the braille letter d.

You will have an extra light pink 1x2 plate. Save it for later!

Group 25 - Piano Room

20.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back row. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate with 2 side studs sticking up on the front row so the side studs face the front.

20.2. Horizontally place a light pink 1x2 plate from group 24 on the front row. Then horizontally place a light pink 1x2 slope tile on the back row so it slopes to the back. Now horizontally place a light pink 1x2 jumper plate on the front row.

20.3. Place a pink 1x1 quarter circle tile upright on the left front-facing side stud so the curve faces the top left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

20.4. Place your part in between the 2 previous 2x2 corner bricks so it is centered horizontally and the 1x1 quarter circle tiles face the front.

Group 26 - Piano Room

21. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick with 1x2 side studs on both long sides on top of the 2x2 corner bricks behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front and back. Now horizontally place a blue 1x2 slope tile upright on the back-facing side studs so it slopes down.

22. Vertically place a white 1x2 masonry brick on top of the 2x2 corner brick to the left of the ppp so there is no overhang and the brick grooves face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

23. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 plate on the back row of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally. Now place a light blue 1x1 plate in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of the ppp.

24. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 rounded window frame on top of the previous 1x4 plate so it is centered horizontally and the ridged side faces the back. Now attach a gold rounded lattice window pane to the back-facing side of the ppp.

25.1. Vertically place a light yellow 2x3 pentagonal tile upright on the front-facing side studs below the rounded window frame so the angled sides face up.

25.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the light yellow 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker has a picture of cheese with swirls. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

26. Stack 2 white 1x2 masonry bricks so there is no overhang, then vertically place them to the left of the rounded window frame so there is no overhang and the brick grooves face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

27. Horizontally place a white 1x4 arch brick on the back row of the 4 ppp and rounded window frame so it is centered horizontally.

28. Place a white 1x1 brick in front of the leftmost and rightmost columns of the ppp.

29. Place the middle stud of the front row of a blue 3x3 quarter circle plate on the left ppp so the curve faces the back left. It should overhang 1 column to the left and 1 row to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

30. Place a red 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally on them.

31. Place a blue 1x1 slope tile on the front left corner of the left 3x3 quarter circle plate so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a transparent 1x1 round plate with a bent bar on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so the stud faces the front.

Group 27 - Piano Room

32. Horizontally place a transparent 1x2 tile printed with a light blue slipper upright on the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

33. Horizontally place a transparent light blue 2x4x4 half cone panel with a window behind the 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.

34. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Then place a gold ski pole on top.

35. Place a yellow 1x1 slope tile on the rightmost column on the 2nd row from the front so it slopes to the back left. Then place another 1 on the 2nd column from the right on the 4th row from the front so it slopes to the back right.

36. Bring back your previous small build that has the horse saddle and horizontally place it in front of you so the rounded side of the build faces the back. Now attach the left-facing clip of it to the rightmost front-facing bar.

37. Bring back your main build and horizontally place it in front of you so the 4x8x8 half cone panel slopes to the back. Now place a white 1x3 curved brick on the back 3 rows of the 2 rightmost columns so the curve faces the back left and it overhangs 1 column to the right. Now attach the right-facing clips of your main build to the left-facing bars of the 1x2 rounded bricks of your current build and make sure the overhang of the ppp attaches to your current build!

38. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the studs of the ppp. Now put your build away while we make the horse carriage!

Building Instructions (Bag 7, Book 5):

Group 28 - Carriage

1. Vertically place a black 2x2 plate with 2 pins and round parts in front of you.

2. Horizontally place a white 2x6 brick on top so it overhangs 4 columns to the left.

3. Place a blue 4x4 round plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and 2 columns are exposed to the left.

4. Horizontally place a white 2x6 brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and overhangs 4 columns to the left. Now vertically place a black 2x2 plate with 2 pins and round parts underneath the 2 leftmost columns.

5.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side in front of you so the bar faces the front. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 inverted sloped curved brick with a plate on the right column so it slopes and overhangs 3 columns to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

5.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the bar faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

6. Place a light blue 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

7. Vertically place a white 1x4 plate on the 3rd column from the right so it is centered vertically.

8. Place an orange 2x2 plate with 2 side studs on the front 2 rows to the left of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

9. Vertically place 2 tan 1x4 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the 2 ppp so they are centered vertically.

10. Place an orange 2x2 plate with 2 side studs on the front 2 rows to the left of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

11. Vertically place a white 1x4 plate on the 3rd column from the left so it is centered vertically.

12.1. Let's make a part! Stack 2 light blue 2x2 plates so there is no overhang, then place them in front of you.

12.2. Vertically place a black 1x2 plate on the left column. Then horizontally place the 1x2 plate part of the horse hitch on the right column so the 2x2 plate overhangs to the right. Now place a light blue 2x2 tile on the 2 leftmost columns.

12.3. Place the 2 rightmost columns of your part on top of the 2 leftmost columns of your previous part so it is centered vertically and overhangs to the left.

Group 29 - Carriage

13. Horizontally place a light pink 1x2 plate on the front row on the 6th and 7th columns from the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

14. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a light grey 2x6 plate on the 4th column from the right so it is centered vertically.

15. Place a light blue 2x2 tile on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the left, without counting the overhang.

16. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 jumper plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the left, without counting the overhang.

17. Place a light blue 1x1 plate on the front row in front of the right 2x2 tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

18. Vertically place a white 1x4 brick on the 3rd column from the right so it is centered vertically.

19. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick to the left of the ppp so it is centered vertically. Now place a green 1x1 brick with a side stud in front so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

20. Vertically place 2 light pink 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the ppp so they are centered vertically and slope to the left.

21. Vertically place a light pink 2x4 tile to the left of the ppp so it is centered vertically.

22. Vertically place 2 brown 1x2 panels with a long wall and middle wall, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the ppp so they are centered vertically and the middle walls face the right.

23. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick to the left of the ppp so it is centered vertically. Now place a green 1x1 brick with a side stud in front so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

24. Vertically place 2 white 1x2 bricks with 2 side studs, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the ppp so they are centered vertically and the side studs face the left.

25.1. Let's make 4 identical parts. Place a white 3x3 corner sloped curved brick in front of you so it slopes to the front left. Then place a light blue 1x1 plate underneath the back right corner.

25.2. Now you should have 4 identical parts! Place the middle column of the back row upright on the top left front-facing side stud so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Group 30 - Carriage

26.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a light blue 2x6 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the back.

26.2. Place a white 1x3 curved plate on the back left corner so it overhangs 1 row to the front and the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a light blue 1x1 plate underneath the leftmost overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

26.3. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

26.4. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

27.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a white 2x3 sloped curved brick in front of you so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side underneath the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

27.2. Vertically place a gold 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side underneath the rightmost column so the bar faces the right.

27.3. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically attach the clips of 1 part to the front-facing bar so the sloped curved brick faces the front and the bar faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

28. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs hanging down on the 3rd column from the right so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right.

29. Place a gold 1x1 heart tile in front of the ppp so the tip faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

30. Place a white 1x1 rounded brick with a side stud on the front stud of the 3rd column from the right so the side stud faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

31. Vertically place a white 1x2 jumper plate on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically. Then place a transparent 1x1 gem tile on top.

32.1. Place a white 2x3 pentagonal tile with a sticker upright on the right-facing side studs so the angled side overhangs 1 row to the top.

32.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the white 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker has a white pumpkin in a gold circle on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

33. Place 1 gold curved bar with a swirl upright on the front right facing side stud so the bar faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

34. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate upright on the front left-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place another 1 on the front stud of the 3rd column from the left, without counting the overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

35.1. Place a white 2x3 pentagonal tile with a sticker upright on the left-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and the angled side overhangs 2 rows to the top.

35.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the white 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker has a white pumpkin in a gold circle on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

36. Attach 2 gold wheels with swirls to the front-facing pins so they curve outwards. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

37. Bring back your horse and horizontally place it in front of you so the head faces the left. Then take off the 2x2 plate and 2x2 half cylinder brick.

38. Attach the 2 leftmost columns of overhang to the horse so it can pull the carriage!
