76311 Spider-Verse: Miles Morales vs. The Spot

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Spider-Verse: Miles Morales vs. The Spot (76311) is a high-quality buildable toy for fans of Marvel Studios' Spider-Man: Across the Spider-Verse movie aged 9 and up. This build-and-play adventure LEGO® set makes an ideal gift for young Super Heroes, especially Marvel fans and kids who enjoy buildable, hands-on adventure toys.

The Spider-Man playset comes with 4 minifigures: Miles Morales, The Spot, Gwen Stacy and Officer Jefferson. The convenience store has an exploding-wall feature that allows the ATM to be removed. Accessories include a long, flexible web rope and a flexible web that is large enough to encase a minifigure. The police car opens to allow 2 minifigures to be placed inside.

Buildable Spider-Verse set – Spider-Verse: Miles Morales vs. The Spot is a build-and-play kids' toy for boys and girls aged 9 and up based on Marvel Studios' Spider-Man: Across the Spider-Verse.

LEGO® Spider-Man minifigures – The buildable Spider-Man playset comes with Miles Morales, The Spot, Gwen Stacy and Officer Jefferson minifigures, plus web-slinging accessories.

Build-and-play Super Hero playset – The convenience store's exploding-wall feature allows the ATM to be stolen by The Spot and inspires endless imaginative adventures.

Buildable police car - Officer Jefferson's police vehicle opens to allow 2 minifigures to be placed inside.

375-piece, buildable playset – The convenience store measures over 4.5 in. (11 cm) high, 6 in. (15 cm) wide and 3.5 in. (9 cm) deep.

The build is 375 pieces in total and is for ages 9+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for officer Jefferson and the police car.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Miles Morales, The Spot, and the convenience store.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Gwen Stacy and the convenience store.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.

- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/76311) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1, 2, and 3, 2 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Officer Jefferson

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 dark blue pair of legs, 1 light blue torso printed with a black vest and badge, 1 brown head printed with eyes and gold glasses, and 1 dark blue hat. Assemble your minifigure, then put him away while we build the police car!

Group 2 - Police Car

- 1. Vertically place a black 2x4 plate with taller sides and small pins in front of you so the pins face the front and back. Then horizontally place a black 2x3 plate on top so it is centered vertically and overhangs 1 column to the right.
- 2. Horizontally place a white 6x12 car base on top so it is centered vertically and overhangs 9 columns to the left.

- 3. Horizontally place a black 2x3 plate underneath the 3 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.
- 4.1. Let's make a part! Place a dark grey 2x2 tile with 2 studs in front of you so the studs are on the right. Then place a black 2x2 plate with 2 side studs on top so it overhangs 1 column to the right and the side studs face the left.
- 4.2. Vertically place a black 2x4 plate with taller sides and 2 small pins underneath the overhang so it is centered vertically and the pins face the front and back.
- 4.3. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically.
- 4.4. Vertically place your part underneath the leftmost column of the build so 3 columns are exposed to the left.
- 5. Vertically place a yellow 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right.
- 6. Place a yellow 2x2 round brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate to the left so it is centered vertically.
- 7. Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick with a mudguard on the front row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so it overhangs to the left, right, and the front. Make sure the mudguard faces the front! Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 8. Vertically place a light grey 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place 2 light grey 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, to the left so they are centered vertically and slope to the left.

Group 3 - Police Car

- 9. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a light blue 1x6 plate on the front row on the 5th column from the right so it overhangs 2 columns to the left. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate underneath the overhang. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.
- 10. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 steering wheel on the 6th column from the left, without counting the tile as a column, so the steering wheel faces the right.
- 11. Place a light grey 2x2 corner brick to the left of the front row of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter h and overhangs 1 row to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 12. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left. Then horizontally place a dark grey 2x3 brick to the right so it is centered vertically.
- 13. Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick with a mudguard on the front row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it overhangs to the left, right, and the front. Make sure the mudguard faces the front! Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

- 14. Horizontally place 2 blue 2x3 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the 3 leftmost columns so they are centered vertically.
- 15. Place a light blue 1x1 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 16.1. Horizontally place a white 1x6 brick with a sticker on the front row in between the 2x4 bricks with mudguards so it is centered horizontally and the sticker faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 16.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the white 1x6 bricks. These stickers say "PDNY" on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 17. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 plate on the front row on the 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th columns from the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 18. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 tile on the front row to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 19. Vertically place a light blue 2x6 plate on the 4th and 5th columns from the left so it is centered vertically. Then place a light grey 1x1 plate on the 2nd row from the front, to the right of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 4 - Police Car

- 20. Let's make a part! Let's make the front end of the car! Horizontally place a transparent orange 1x2 plate in front of you.
- 21. Place a light grey 2x2 corner plate on the right column so it overhangs to the back and the right and looks like the braille letter h. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 22. Horizontally place a transparent orange 1x2 plate underneath the left overhang so 1 column is exposed to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 23. Place a light grey 1x1 plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 24. Place a white 1x1 plate with 2 side studs sticking up underneath the left column of the back row so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 25. Place a black 2x2 sloped curved brick with 2 studs on top so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front.
- 26. Place 2 transparent 1x1 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns so they slope to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 27. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the long side on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the clips face the front. Now attach a white 4L bar to the clips so it is centered horizontally.

- 28. Horizontally place your part upright on the left-facing side studs of the car so it is centered horizontally and the 1x1 slope tiles face up.
- 29.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick in front of you. Then place a light grey 1x1 plate on the rightmost column. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes to the left.
- 29.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 upright on the leftmost front-facing side studs so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 30. Rotate your car 90 degrees counterclockwise so the front end of the car faces the front. Then vertically attach the clip of a black 1x2 plate with a stud and a clip to the right end of the front-facing bar so it hangs down and the anti-studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 31. Rotate your car 180 degrees so the back end of the car faces the front. Now place a black 2x2 plate with 2 side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally, overhangs 1 row to the front, and the side studs face the front.
- 32. Stack 2 white 2x2 corner plates so there is no overhang, then place them on the front row on the 2nd column from the left so they overhang 1 row to the front and look like the braille letter j. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 5 - Police Car

- 33.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a transparent 1x2 plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 plate with 2 side studs sticking up on the left column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 33.2. Horizontally place your part upright on the bottom front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.
- 34. Horizontally place a mint blue 2x6 plate on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 35. Let's make a part! Horizontally place 2 white 1x2 plates with 2 side studs sticking up, 1 to the right of the other, in front of you so the side studs face the back.
- 36. Place a yellow 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top so it is centered horizontally and the studs overhang to the front.

Group 6 - Police Car

37. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally.

Group 7 - Police Car

38. Horizontally place a transparent orange 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so 1 column overhangs to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

- 39. Place a white 1x1 plate with a side stud sticking up underneath the leftmost column so the side stud faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 40. Horizontally place a transparent red 1x2 tile on the 2 leftmost columns. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 41. Now horizontally place your part upright on the 2x2 front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face up.

Group 8 - Police Car

- 42. Horizontally place a transparent 1x2 plate upright on the front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile upright on it.
- 43.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a white 1x1 plate with 2 side studs sticking up in front of you so the side studs face the left. Then place a white 1x1 brick on top.
- 43.2. Horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the right. Then place a white 1x1 brick underneath the overhang. Now vertically place a white 1x2 tile upright on the left-facing side studs.
- 43.3. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Rotate your car so it is horizontal and the upright anti-studs face the left. Now horizontally place 1 part upright on the rightmost front-facing side studs so the 1x2 tile faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 44. Horizontally place a white 1x4 tile on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a white 4x4 tile with 4 studs in between them so the studs are on the left.
- 45. Horizontally place a white 1x6 tile on the front row to the left of the 1x4 tile. Then place a light grey 1x1 plate behind the rightmost column of the 1x6 tile. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.
- 46. Horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved tile on the front left corner so it slopes and overhangs to the left. It should only attach to 1 stud! Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place 2 white 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so they slope and overhang to the left.
- 47. Place a white 4x4 tile with 4 studs to the right of the ppp so it is centered vertically and the studs are on the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 tile in front and behind it.

Group 9 - Police Car

- 48. Place a white 1x1 plate with a side stud sticking up in front of the 1x2 steering wheel so the side stud faces the front. Then place a black 1x1 plate upright on the front-facing side stud. Now place a black 1x1 slope tile upright on it so it slopes to the left. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the back.
- 49. Vertically place the leftmost column of a transparent black 3x4 windshield with studs in the corners on the left 4x4 tile with 4 studs so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Now vertically place a black 3x4 windshield with walls on the right 4x4 tile with 4 studs so it is centered vertically and slopes to the right.

- 50. Let's make a part! Let's make the roof! Horizontally place a white 4x6 sloped curved tile with 2x2 studs in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the left column so the clip faces the left.
- 51. Place a black 1x1 round part with an antenna on the front left corner so the antenna faces up. Then attach a black 4L bar to the left-facing clip so it is centered vertically.
- 52. Attach a black 1x1 round plate with a clip underneath to the back end of the 4L bar so the stud faces up. Then attach another 1 to the 4L bar in front of the clip of the 1x2 plate so the stud faces up. Now place a red 1x1 round tile on top of each of them.

Group 10 - Police Car

- 53. Attach a black 1x1 round plate with a clip underneath in front of each of the 2 ppp so the studs face up. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 round tile on top of each of them.
- 54. Horizontally place your part on top of the 2 windshields so it is centered vertically and there is no overhang. The tiles should be on the left!
- 55. Insert 4 black wheels into 4 black tires, now attach them to the front-facing and back-facing pins so the hollow sides face outwards.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 11 - Miles Morales

Sub-build 2.1. Locate 1 black pair of legs, 1 black torso printed with dark blue armor, and a red circle with a spider on it, 1 black head printed with white eyes with a red outline, 1 transparent 1x1 round plate with a bar underneath, and 1 white 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar. Assemble your minifigure then attach the 1x1 round plate with a bar underneath to his hand so the stud faces the front. Then place the white 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar upright on it. This is a web shooter!

Sub-build 2.2. This minifigure also comes with a brown head printed with eyes and a smile, and 1 black hair. You can switch this out for the other head!

Group 12 - The Spot

Sub-build 3.1. Locate 1 white pair of legs printed with 2 black spots, 1 white torso printed with 7 black spots, 1 black head printed with 1 large black spot. Assemble your minifigure then put him away while we make the convenience store!

Group 13 - Convenience Store

- 1. Horizontally place a dark grey 8x16 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 2x4 brick on the back right corner.
- 2. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 brick with 2 holes on the rightmost column in front of the 2x4 brick. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick to the left of the front row of the ppp.

You will have an extra white 1x1 brick printed with a sun. Save it for later!

Group 14 - Convenience Store

- 3.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a shelf of groceries! Horizontally place a dark tan 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4x2 panel on the back row so the wall faces the back. Then place the white 1x1 brick printed with a sun on the front right corner so the print faces the front. Then place a lime green 1x1 round plate on top.
- 3.2. Place a light purple 1x1 round brick on the front row of the 2nd column from the left. Then place a pink 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top.
- 3.3. Place a white 1x1 brick printed with popcorn and vertical red lines on the front left corner so the print faces the front. Then place a red 1x1 double-slope tile on top so it slopes to the front and back.
- 3.4 Vertically place your part on the back right corner so the wall faces the right.
- 4. Let's make a part! Let's make another shelf of groceries! Horizontally place a dark tan 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4x2 panel on the back row so the wall faces the back.
- 5. Horizontally place 2 dark tan 1x2 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally.
- 6.1. Place a short mint blue 1x1 brick on the front row of the 2nd column from the right.

You will have an extra mint green 1x1 round tile. Save it for later!

Group 15 - Convenience Store

- 6.2. Place a teal 1x1 half cylinder tile on top of the ppp so it slopes to the left and right.
- 6.3. Place a light blue 1x1 round brick on the front row on the 2nd column from the left. Then place a mint green 1x1 round tile from group 14 on top.
- 7. Place a short red brown 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then place a light orange 1x1 round tile on top.
- 8. Vertically place your part on the back right corner so it overhangs 1 column to the left and the panel wall faces the right.
- 9. Stack 4 dark red 2x2 corner bricks so there is no overhang, then place them on the 2 rightmost columns on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so they look like the braille letter j.
- 10. Let's make a part! Let's make a refrigerator! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick with 2 holes in front of you.
- 11. Insert a dark tan 3L axle with a stud into the right front-facing hole so the axle faces the back. Now horizontally attach the right axle hole of a red 2L thin lift arm with 2 axle holes to the back-facing axle so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat again.

- 12. Insert a dark tan 3L axle with a stud into the left front-facing hole so the axle attaches to the 2 thin lift arms in the back.
- 13. Horizontally place a silver 1x2 grill tile upright on the front-facing side studs.
- 14. Horizontally place a light grey 3x4 tile with 4 studs underneath your part so it is centered horizontally and vertically.
- 15. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 16. Vertically place 2 light grey 2x3 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they are centered.
- 17. Horizontally place a white 1x3 brick on the back left corner.
- 18. Horizontally place a transparent light blue 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally. Then place a transparent light blue 1x1 slope tile on the right column of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 19. Place a white 1x1 brick on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the right so the side studs face the back.
- 20. Horizontally place a white 1x3 brick on the back left corner.
- 21. Vertically place a white 1x2x3 brick on the front left corner. Then vertically place another 1 on the back right corner.
- 22.1. Horizontally place a white 1x3x3 curved door with a sticker on the front right corner so the stud is on the right and it opens to the front.
- 22.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the white 1x3x3 curved door. This sticker has a spiderweb, a sticker of Miles Morales, and ICE in red. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 23. Vertically place 2 light grey 2x3 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they are centered.
- 24. Place a white 2x2 corner tile on the front left corner so it looks like the braille letter h. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 25. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2x1 panel with a long wall and 2 side walls on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally and the long wall faces the back.
- 26. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so the shelves of groceries are in the front left. Now rotate your part 180 degrees, then horizontally place it on the back 3 rows on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the left.

- 27. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a bar on the leftmost column on the 5th row from the front so the bar faces the right. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick behind it. Now horizontally place a dark red 1x3 brick to the right.
- 28. Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 masonry brick on the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp so the brick grooves face the back. Now vertically place 2 dark red 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the front left corner so the brick grooves face the left. Then place a dark red 2x2 corner brick behind them so it looks like the braille letter f.
- 29. Vertically place a dark red 1x6 brick on the front left corner. Then place a dark red 1x1 brick with a side stud to the right of the back row of the ppp so the side stud faces the back.
- 30. Place 2 dark red 1x1 bricks with a side stud, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.
- 31. Attach the clip of a black 2x2 tile with a sticker and a clip underneath it to the right-facing bar so the sticker faces the front right. This is a TV!
- 32. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 13 on the black 2x2 tile with a clip underneath it. This sticker has 4 camera screens on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 33. Place a sand green 2x2 tile on the 4th and 5th rows from the front, on the 4th and 5th columns from the left. It should sit in front of a 2L thin lift arm with 2 axle holes! Now horizontally place a black 1x4x2 panel on the 3rd row from the back, on the 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th columns from the left so the wall faces the front. Then place the back row of a light grey 4x4 quarter circle plate to the right so the curve faces the back right.
- 34. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp so it is in front of the 1x4x2 panel. Then place a dark tan 2x2 corner plate in front so it looks like the braille letter h. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate to the right of the front row of the ppp.
- 35. Place a black 2x2 curved corner plate on top of the 2x2 corner plate from the previous step so the curved corner faces the front left.
- 36. Let's make 2 identical parts! Attach a transparent glass pane to a black 1x2x3 window frame. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place them, 1 to the right of the other, on the 3rd row from the back, on top of the 1x4x2 panel so glass panes face the back.
- 37. Let's make 3 identical parts! Attach a transparent glass pane to a black 1x2x2 window frame. Now you should have 3 identical parts! Horizontally place 2 parts, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 2 ppp so the glass panes face the back. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left so the glass pane faces the back.

Group 17 - Convenience Store

38. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the 3rd row from the back, on the 5th and 6th columns from the left. Then place a black 1x1 round plate with a bar hanging down to the right so the bar faces the back.

- 39.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 2x4x6 diagonal door frame in front of you so the flat side faces the front. Then attach a transparent door to it so the stud is on the right. Now place a dark grey 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing stud. Then place a black 1x4 diagonal brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the flat side faces the front.
- 39.2. Now place your part to the back right of the 2x2 curved corner plate that is on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so the door opens to the back right.
- 40. Place 2 black 1x1 bricks with a hole, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so the holes face the front. Then place a black 1x1x3 brick behind the right 1x1 brick with a hole.
- 41. Place a black 1x1x3 brick on top of the ppp.
- 42. Horizontally place a black 1x2x5 brick on the front row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Then place a black 1x1 plate on the left stud of the ppp.
- 43. Vertically place a black 1x2 brick on the right column of the previous 1x2x5 brick so there is no overhang. Then place the front row of a black 1x4 diagonal brick to the left of the front row of the ppp so the flat side faces the front left.
- 44. Vertically place a black 1x6 plate on the front 2 rows of the 3rd column from the right so it overhangs 4 rows to the back. Then horizontally place a black 1x6 plate to the left of the back row of the ppp so it sits on 3 studs. Now place the rightmost column of a light grey 4x4 quarter circle brick on the back 4 rows of the vertical 1x6 plate so the curve faces the front left.

Group 18 - Convenience Store

- 45. Place a light grey 2x2 corner brick in front of the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter d. Then place another 1 to the left of the back 2 rows of the 4x4 quarter brick so it looks like the braille letter d. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x4 brick to the left of the back row of the ppp.
- 46. Place the front 2 rows of a light grey diagonal 1x4 brick to the left of the 2x2 corner brick that is on the front 2 rows so the flat side faces the front left.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 19 - Gwen Stacy

Sub-build 4.1. Locate 1 black pair of legs, 1 white torso printed with a black bodysuit, 1 white head printed with white eyes with a purple outline, 1 white hood, 1 transparent 1x1 round plate with a bar underneath, and 1 white 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar. Assemble your minifigure then attach the 1x1 round plate with a bar underneath to her hand so the stud faces the front. Then place the white 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar upright on it. This is a web shooter!

Sub-build 4.2. This minifigure also comes with a tan head printed with eyes and lips, and blonde hair. You can switch this out for the other head and hood if you like!

Sub-build 4.3. Attach 1 end of a white rope to the bar of a white 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar. Then attach it to your minifigure's hand! Now put her away while we continue building the convenience store!

Group 20 - Convenience Store

- 47. Let's make a part! Let's make an ATM! Horizontally place a blue 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a blue 2x4 plate on top so it overhangs 1 column to the right.
- 48. Horizontally place a blue 2x4 plate on top so there is no overhang.
- 49. Place a blue 2x2 plate with 2 side studs underneath the overhang so 1 column is exposed to the right and the side studs face the right.
- 50. Place a blue 2x2 tile on the 2 leftmost columns. Then vertically place a blue 1x2 tile to the right.
- 51.1. Place a light grey 2x2 sloped curved tile with a sticker on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the right.
- 51.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the light grey 2x2 sloped curved tile. This sticker says insert card in light blue on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 21 - Convenience Store

- 52. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with 2 side studs sticking up on the right-facing side studs so the side studs face up. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 slope tile upright on the right-facing side studs so it slopes down.
- 53.1. Vertically place a white 1x2 tile with a sticker on top so it is centered vertically.
- 53.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the white 1x2 tile. This sticker says ATM in green on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 54. Vertically attach your part to the 2 front-facing side studs so it sits on the 2x2 tile and the 1x2 slope tile is on top and slopes to the back.

Group 22 - Convenience Store

There are no instructions in this group. You will have an extra green 1x2 tile printed with 100 dollars. Save it for later!

Group 23 - Convenience Store

- 55.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a cash register! Horizontally place a sand blue 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Then insert a white 2x3 drawer into the top front-facing row.
- 55.2. Place a white 2x2 slope brick printed with a keypad and card swiper on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 rounded plate on the rightmost column.

- 55.3. Attach the bar of a dark grey 1x1 round plate with a bar on the front row of the 1x2 rounded plate so the stud faces the back right. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile with a sticker upright on the stud of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and faces the back right.
- 55.4. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the light grey 1x2 tile. This sticker says game over on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 55.5. Place a green 1x2 tile printed with 100 dollars from group 22 on the right stud of the 2x2 slope brick so the ends face the front left and back right.
- 55.6. Vertically place your part to the right of the atm so there are 2 free columns in between them and the 2x2 slope brick slopes to the left.
- 56. Vertically place a dark red 1x2 masonry brick on the front left corner so the brick grooves face the left. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs behind it so the side studs face the right. Now place a dark red 2x2 corner brick behind it so it looks like the braille letter f and there is no overhang. Now horizontally place a dark red 1x2 plate to the right of the back row of the ppp. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x3 plate on top of the ppp.
- 57.1. Let's make a part! Let's make an air conditioner! Place a white 2x2 turntable plate in front of you. Then place a light grey 2x2 round turntable plate on top.
- 57.2. Horizontally place a white 2x3 plate on top so it overhangs 1 column to the left.
- 57.3. Place 2 dark grey 1x1 round plates, 1 in front of the other, underneath the overhang.
- 57.4. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 tile on the leftmost column. Then place a light grey 2x2 tile with an upright 1x2 plate to the right so the studs face the back.
- 58. Horizontally place the 1x2 anti-studs of the 2x2 tile with 2 side studs of your part on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left, on the 6th row from the front so the anti-studs of the 2x2 turntable plate face the back.
- 59. Vertically place a dark red 1x6 brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a dark red 1x3 brick to the right of the back row of it.

Group 24 - Convenience Store

- 60. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the 6th row from the front, on the 8th and 9th columns from the left. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate with 1x4 side studs hanging down, to the left and right so the side studs face the back.
- 61. Place a black 1x1 plate to the right of the 3 ppp. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down to the right so the side studs face the back.

- 62. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with 1x4 side studs hanging down in front of the right column of the ppp so the side studs face the right. Then place a black 1x1 plate in front. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down in front so the side studs face the right.
- 63. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate with 2 studs on the 5th row from the front, to the left of the back stud of the vertical 1x2 plate with 1x4 side studs from the previous step. Then place a tan 4x4 plate with a cutoff corner in front so the cutoff corner faces the front left.
- 64. Vertically place a yellow 1x2 slope brick on the 6th row from the front on the 5th column from the left so it slopes and overhangs to the back. Then place a light orange 2x2 slope brick to the right so it slopes and overhangs to the back. Now repeat the process twice to the right. In total you should have placed 3 1x2 slope bricks and 3 2x2 slope bricks!
- 65. Place a light orange 2x2 slope brick on the front 2 rows of the 3rd column from the right so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 slope brick behind it so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Now place a light orange 2x2 slope brick behind so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Then place a yellow 2x2 corner slope brick behind so it slopes and overhangs to the back right.
- 66. Vertically place a dark red 1x2 masonry brick on the leftmost column on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so the brick grooves face the left. Then place a dark red 2x2 corner brick behind it so it looks like the braille letter f. Then horizontally place a dark red 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the back row of the ppp so the brick grooves face the back.
- 67. Horizontally place a tan 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs to the right of the ppp so the side studs face the back. Now skip 2 columns to the right, then horizontally place 2 tan 1x2x2 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, so the side studs face the back.
- 68. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs in between the previous 1x2x2 bricks with 2x2 side studs so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally stack 2 dark tan 1x2 plates on top.
- 69. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows of the 3rd column from the right, so it sits on top of the 2x2 slope brick. Then skip 2 rows behind it, and place a dark tan 2x2 corner plate so it looks like the braille letter d and there is no overhang.
- 70. Place a tan 2x2 corner brick on top of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter d. Then vertically place a tan 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs in front of the right column of it so the side studs face the right.
- 71. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick on top so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Then vertically place another dark tan 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows of the 3rd column from the right. Then place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick on top so it slopes and overhangs to the left.
- 72. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the leftmost column on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front. Then place a dark tan 2x2 corner plate behind it so it looks like the braille letter f. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate to the right of the back row of the ppp. Then place a dark tan 2x2 corner plate on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back so it looks like the braille letter d

- 73. Vertically place a dark grey 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th rows from the front. Then place a dark grey 1x1 tile behind it. Now horizontally place 2 dark grey 1x6 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, to the right. Then place a dark grey 1x1 tile to the right. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x4 tile with 2 studs in front of the ppp.
- 74. Place a dark grey 2x2 corner tile on the front left corner so it looks like the braille letter j. Then place another 1 on the front 2 rows of the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it looks like the braille letter h.
- 75.1. Vertically place the bottom row of a light grey 2x4 tile with a sticker upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs.
- 75.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 14 on the light grey 2x4 tile. This sticker has a picture of a special offer of a donut with light blue frosting that is 2 dollars! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 76.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a black 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 round tile with a stud on top so it is centered. Now place a transparent 1x1 round plate with a bent bar underneath it on top so the stud faces the back.
- 76.2. Now place the 2 rightmost columns of the 2nd row from the top of 1 part upright on the 2 right-facing side studs that are on the leftmost column so the bent stud faces up.
- 76.3. Place the 2nd row from the top of 1 part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally on the side studs so the bent stud faces up.

You will have 4 extra green 1x2 plates with a rail. Save them for later!

Group 26 - Convenience Store

- 77. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with a rail from group 25 upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs that are underneath the slope bricks so the rail faces down. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate with a rail upright to the right so the rail faces down. Then horizontally place another green 1x2 plate with a rail to the right so the rail faces down. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate with a rail upright to the right so the rail faces down. Now horizontally place another green 1x2 plate with a rail to the right so the rail faces down.
- 78. Place a light orange 1x1 plate with a side stud hanging down upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so the side stud faces the left. Then place a yellow 1x1 plate upright on the left-facing side stud of the ppp.
- 79. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so it is vertical and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 rounded plate upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs that are underneath the slope bricks. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with a rail from group 25 upright to the right so the rail faces down. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate with a rail upright to the right so the rail faces down.

- 80.1. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so it is horizontal and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th front-facing side studs from the left that are underneath the slope bricks.
- 80.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the yellow 1x3 tile. This sticker says frozen food on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 80.3. Horizontally place a yellow 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ppp.
- 80.4. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 11 on the yellow 1x3 tile. This sticker says fresh meat on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 80.5. Horizontally place a yellow 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ppp.
- 80.6. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 12 on the yellow 1x3 tile. This sticker says soda and juice on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 81.1. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so it is vertical and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th front-facing side studs from the left that are underneath the slope bricks.
- 81.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 15 on the yellow 1x3 tile. This sticker says coffee and tea on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 81.3. Horizontally place a yellow 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ppp.
- 81.4. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 16 on the yellow 1x3 tile. This sticker says sandwiches on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 82. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so it is horizontal and the side studs face the front. Now attach the clip of a white 2x2 tile with a clip and a sticker behind it to the front-facing bar that is to the left of the refrigerator.
- 83. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the white 2x2 tile with a clip behind it. This sticker says ATM in red. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 84.1. Horizontally place a yellow 2x6 tile with a sticker upright on the left-facing 2x2 side studs so it is centered horizontally on the side studs.

- 84.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the yellow 2x6 tile. This sticker says groceries in green on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 85.1. Horizontally place the 2 rightmost columns of a yellow 2x4 tile with a sticker upright on the leftmost 2x2 side studs.
- 85.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the yellow 2x4 tile. This sticker says DELI, meat, fruit, veg, and is open 24 hours on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 85.3. Horizontally place a yellow 2x6 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ppp.
- 85.4. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the yellow 2x6 tile. This sticker says groceries, sandwiches, tea, coffee, and soda on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 86. Let's make a part! Place a white 3x3 round tile with a sticker upside down in front of you. Then place 2 black 1x1 round plates with a clip underneath, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2 back anti-studs so the clip hands face the front and back. Now horizontally attach the left end of a light grey 4L bar to the 2 clips. Now insert the bar into the left-facing side stud on the back row so the sticker faces the front.
- 87. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 17 on the yellow white 4x4 round tile. This sticker says DELI twice on a red sign, and has a green arrow pointing towards the right. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 88. Insert a white 2L bar with a stop into the front-facing side stud underneath the 2 anti-studs of the 2 1x1 round plates that are on the right front-facing side. Now attach a large white web to it so the inside faces the front!
