

## **77046 Julian's Birthday Party**

Adapted by John Le and tested by Natalie Charbonneau.

Creative kids aged 6+ enjoy hours of open-ended role-play scenes from their favorite video game series with the LEGO® Animal Crossing™ Julian's Birthday Party (77046) toy. This customizable toy is packed with cute accessories kids will recognize from the video game series to spark limitless fun storytelling.

Kids throw a party for Julian, a horse, girls and boys will recognize from the video game series. They give him a gift that includes a microphone and Bell coin element, and share cupcakes while Julian blows out the candle on his birthday cake. Once the festivities are over, kids remake the buildable scene, moving around the baseplates and rearranging the toy balloons, decorations and accessories.

Creative building toy for kids – Girls and boys aged 6+ role-play scenes from the video game series with LEGO® Animal Crossing™ Julian's Birthday Party, then customize the set to create new stories.

Customizable kids' toy – Comes with a Julian horse minifigure and lots of accessories kids will recognize from the Animal Crossing™ video game series.

Creative toy – Kids invent limitless role-play stories as they celebrate with Julian by playing music on the stereo, hanging balloons and decorations, and helping him blow out the candle on his cake.

Dimensions – This 170-piece set measures over 3.5 in. (9 cm) high, 6.5 in. (17 cm) wide and 4 in. (10 cm) deep when arranged in standard configuration.

The build is 170 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Julian the horse, presents, and a skateboard.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for a table with sweets.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for a pink tree, and a radio.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for a street lamp, balloons, and a banner.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- “Anti-stud” is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/77046>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Bag 1 - Julian, Presents, and Skateboard

Group 1 - Page 5.

Group 2 - Steps 1-3.

Group 3 - Steps 4-5 and 4 light orange 1x1 bricks from Step 6.

Group 4 - Rest of Step 6, Step 7, and 3 light orange 1x1 tiles from Step 8.  
Group 5 - Rest of Step 8 and Steps 9-11.  
Group 6 - Steps 12-15.  
Group 7 - Step 16.

Bag 2 - Table with Sweets

Group 8 - Steps 17-19.  
Group 9 - 2 white 2x2 round plates from Step 20.  
Group 10 - Rest of Step 20, Steps 21-24, and 2 pink flowers from Step 25.  
Group 11 - Rest of Step 25 and Steps 26-29.

Bag 3 - Pink Tree and Radio

Group 12 - Steps 30-34.  
Group 13 - Steps 35-49.  
Group 14 - Steps 50-55.

Bag 4 - Street Lamp, Balloons, and Banner

Group 15 - Steps 56-59.  
Group 16 - Steps 60-70, 3 pink 1x1 quarter circle tiles from Step 71.  
Group 17 - 3 light blue 1x1 quarter circle tiles from Step 71.  
Group 18 - 3 light yellow 1x1 quarter circle tiles from Step 71 and Step 72.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Julian the Horse

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 light blue pair of legs, 1 purple torso printed with a sweater with light blue and purple planets, and light blue stars, 1 light blue and white head with a horn printed with nostrils and eyes, and 1 gold party hat. Assemble your minifigure then attach the hat to his head!

Group 2 - Presents

1. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.
2. Place a lime green 6x6 rounded plate on top of the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.
- 3.1. Let's make a part! Place a white 2x2 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 white 1x2 jumper plates, 1 in front of the other, on top. Now place 2 red 1x1 slope tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top so they slope towards each other. This is a present!
- 3.2. Place your part on the back 2 rows on the 4th and 5th columns from the right.

Group 3 - Presents

4.1. Let's make a part! Let's make another present! Place a light blue 2x2 brick in front of you. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Now place a gold 1x1 star on top.

4.2. Place your part on the 2 rightmost columns on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back.

5. Let's make a part! Let's make a present! Place a light orange 3x3 plate in front of you. Then place a light orange 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front. Then place another 1 so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

#### Group 4 - Presents

6. Place 4 pink 1x1 bricks on top of the 3x3 plate so they sit next to the 5 ppp.

7. Place a light orange 1x1 tile on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

#### Group 5 - Presents and Skateboard

8. Place a pink 1x1 tile on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a pink 1x1 plate on the back row. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate in front of the ppp.

9. Place a pink 1x1 heart-shaped tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the point faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

10. Place your part on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the right, and 2nd, 3rd, and 4th rows from the front.

11. Let's make a part! Let's make a skateboard! Horizontally place a purple skateboard in front of you so the studs face up. Now vertically attach a teal set of wheels to the clips underneath the left side of the skateboard. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a gold 1x1 star on the left column. Then horizontally place a light orange bowtie on top so the ridges face the front. Now put your part away while we make another present!

#### Group 6 - Presents

12. Place a light orange 3x3 plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 brick on the back right corner.

13. Place a white 2x2 corner panel on the back left corner so the corner wall faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the front right corner.

14. Place a white 1x1 tile so it is centered vertically and horizontally. Then place a white 1x1 corner panel on the front left corner so the corner wall faces the front left.

15. Place a gold 1x1 star on top of the back left corner of the panel. Place a yellow 1x1 round tile printed with a star in front of the ppp on top of the panel. Then vertically place a black microphone to the right. They should not attach to any studs!

#### Group 7 - Presents

16.1. Place a light orange 3x3 plate on top so it is centered. Then place a purple 1x1 plate on top so it is centered.

16.2. Place a purple 1x1 tile on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a purple 1x1 half cylinder brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front and back. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now put away your present while we make a table full of sweets!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 8 - Table of Sweets

17. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.

18. Place a lime green 8x8 rounded plate on top of the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

19. Place a nougat 2x2 round plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then place another 1 on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically. Now place a nougat 2x2 round plate on the front 2 rows so it is centered on the 6x6 rounded plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 9 - Table of Sweets

20.1. Place a white 2x2 round plate on the front 2 rows on top of the 2x2 round plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 10 - Table of Sweets

20.2. Place a light blue 2x2 round plate on the 2 rightmost columns on top of the 2x2 round plate. Then place another 1 on the 2x2 round plate, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically.

21. Vertically place a nougat 1x4x2 arch brick on the 3rd column from the right of the 6x6 rounded plate. so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

22. Place a white 6x6 round plate on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and vertically on them.

23. Let's make a part! Let's make a cake! Place a light yellow 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then place a brown 2x2 round plate with drips on top so the little holes face the front, back, left, and right.

24. Place a light purple 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Now place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate on top.

25.1. Place a pink flower upright on the left-facing hole of the 2x2 round plate with drips. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 11 - Table of Sweets

25.2. Place a light yellow flower upright on the front-facing hole of the 2x2 round plate with drips. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

26. Place a white candle stick on top so it is centered. Then place a transparent orange candle flame on top so it is vertical.

27. Place your part on top of the 6x6 round plate so it is centered on it.

28. Place a transparent 1x1 bottle on the back stud of the rightmost column of the 6x6 round plate. Then place a pink mug on the rightmost column of the 2nd row from the front of the 6x6 round plate so the handle faces the right. Now place another 1 on the back row of the 2nd column from the left of the 6x6 round plate so the handle faces the left.

29. Place a light blue 1x1 cupcake wrapper on the left column of the front row of the 6x6 round plate. Then place a brown 1x1 swirl on top of the ppp. Now place another light blue 1x1 cupcake wrapper on the front row of the leftmost column of the 6x6 round plate. Then place a pink 1x1 round plate on top. Then place a red pair of cherries on top so the cherries face the front. Now put your table of sweets away while we make the pink tree!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 12 - Pink Tree

30. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.

31. Place a lime green 6x6 rounded plate on top of the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

32. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the front row of the rightmost column. Then place another 1 on the right column of the front row. Now place 1 more on the front row of the 4th column from the left.

33. Place a brown 2x2 round brick with roots on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back and 2nd and 3rd columns from the right.

34. Stack 2 brown 2x2 round bricks on top of the ppp so there is no overhang.

Group 13 - Pink Tree

35. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

36. Place a pink 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick with a 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

37. Horizontally place a pink 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

38. Vertically place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

39. Horizontally place 2 pink 1x2x1 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally and the walls face the back.

40. Horizontally place a pink 1x2x1 panel on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the front. Then place a pink 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

41. Place a brown stem on top of the panels. This is a stick!

42. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 2x4 plate in front of you. Vertically place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the right.

43. Place a white 1x1 plate on the back row on the 2nd column from the left. Then place a white 1x1 plate with a clip to the right of the ppp so the clip faces the back.

44. Horizontally stack 2 pink 1x2 plates on the back row so they are centered horizontally.

45. Vertically place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left.

46. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick with a side stud on the front row so the side stud faces the front.

47. Horizontally place your part on top of your previous part so it is centered on it and the side stud faces the front.

48. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate upright on each of the 3 front-facing side studs.

49. Horizontally place your part on the 2x2 round bricks that are on the 2nd row from the back and 2nd column from the right so it is centered horizontally on it and the side studs face the front.

#### Group 14 - Radio

50. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate in front of you. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with a pin hole on the rightmost column so the hole faces the front and back.

51. Insert a light grey 1L pin with a stud into the front-facing hole so the stud faces the front. Now place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate upright on the front-facing side stud.

52. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the 2 leftmost columns so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 grill tile upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs.

53. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate on top.

54. Place a light grey 1x1 round part with an antenna on the rightmost column so the antenna faces the top left.

55. Horizontally place your part on the 3rd row from the front and 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the left so the grill tile faces the front. Now put your part away while we make the street lamp and balloons!

#### Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

#### Group 15 - Street Lamp and Balloons

56. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.

57. Place a lime green 6x6 rounded plate on top of the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

58. Place a white 1x1 round flower plate on the left column of the back row. Then place another 1 on the 2nd row from the back and 4th column from the right. Now place a green 1x1 round plate on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the left.

59.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a balloon! Place a red 2x2 inverted dome brick in front of you. Then insert a white 5L bar with a stop into the top-facing stud so the bar goes all the way down and the stop is on top. Now place a red 2x2 dome brick on top.

59.2. Place the bar of your part on the 1x1 round flower plate that is on the back row.

#### Group 16 - Street Lamp, Balloons, and Banner

60.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a balloon! Place a light blue 2x2 inverted dome brick in front of you. Then place a light blue 2x2 dome brick on top. Now insert a white 4L bar into the bottom-facing anti-stud. Make sure it goes all the way in.

60.2. Place the bar of your part on the 1x1 round flower plate that is to the right of your previous balloon!

61. Let's make a part! Let's make a street lamp! Place a white 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a transparent yellow 2x2 round brick on top.

62. Place a white 1x1 plate on the back left corner. Then place a white 1x1 plate with a clip on the back right corner so the clip faces the back. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 plate on the front row.

63. Vertically place a white 1x2 tri-slope tile on the left column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

64. Place a white 2x2 rounded tile with a post underneath your part so it is centered.

65. Place your part on the 2 leftmost columns and 2nd and 3rd rows from the back so the clip faces the back.

66. Place a green plant with 3 stems on the 1x1 round plate that is on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the left. Now stack 2 magenta 1x1 round flower plates on top of each stem of the ppp.

67. Let's put together all 4 of our builds! Place your table of sweets in front of you so the 2x4 plate faces the back. Now place the 2x4 plate of your current build underneath the 2 leftmost columns of the table of sweets so it is centered vertically. Now attach the 2x4 plate of your build with the tree underneath the 2 rightmost columns of the table of sweets so it is centered vertically.

68. Rotate the build with presents so the 2x4 plate faces the back. Now vertically attach the 2x4 plate underneath the leftmost 6x6 rounded plate so it is centered horizontally underneath it.

69. Let's make a part! Let's make a banner! Horizontally place a white rope in front of you.



70. Vertically attach 9 plates with a clip to the middle 9 bars of the rope so the 1x1 plates are in the front and the studs face up.

71.1. Place a pink 1x1 quarter circle tile on the leftmost 1x1 plate with a clip so the right angle faces the front. Now place 2 more tiles to the right so there is a 2 column gap in between each of them.

Group 17 - Banner

71.2. Place a light blue 1x1 quarter circle tile to the right of each of the 3 ppp so the right angles face the front.

Group 18 - Banner

71.3. Place a light yellow 1x1 quarter circle tile to the right of each of the 3 ppp so the right angles face the front.

72. Attach the leftmost bar of your banner to the back-facing clip of the street lamp. Then attach the rightmost bar of the banner to the back-facing clip of the tree. Make sure the quarter circle tiles face the front!
