

77055 Able Sisters Clothing Shop

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Looking for a fun LEGO® set for little makers? The Able Sisters' Clothing Shop (77055) building kit comes with toy accessories galore to inspire hours of creative fashion role play for girls and boys aged 6 plus, as well as fans of the Animal Crossing™ video game series.

This pretend shop playset comes with Animal Crossing minifigures Mabel, a hedgehog, and Sasha, a rabbit. Kids can help Sasha pick some new clothes and pretend to alter the outfit with the scissors and sewing machine to make it fit perfectly or head to the stall outside to finish their outfit off with the perfect accessory, paying for it with Bells, just like in the video game.

Pretend shop playset for fun fashion role play – Girls, boys and fans of Animal Crossing™ can recreate scenes from the video game series with the Able Sisters Clothing Shop building kit.

Feature-filled creative toy – This brick-built store includes a workshop area, rack of clothing, Mabel the hedgehog minifigure, Sasha the rabbit minifigure, plus a garden with a peach tree and pond.

Packed with shop toy accessories for kids – This playset is packed with accessories, including a cap, sunglasses, 1 pair of trousers, 2 sweaters, a bag, scissors and a sewing machine mini build.

Dimensions – This 322-piece shop playset measures over 5.5 in. (14 cm) high, 10.5 in. (27 cm) wide and 5.5 in. (14 cm) deep.

The build is 322 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Mabel the hedgehog, an accessories booth, and a peach tree.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Sasha the rabbit, and the clothing store.

Bags 3 to 5 include the pieces for the clothing store.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back

- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/77055>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Mabel the Hedgehog

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 short blue pair of legs, 1 lime green skirt, 1 blue torso printed with white and green plaid overalls, 1 white and blue hedgehog head printed with orange cheeks, black eyes and nose, and yellow ears. Assemble your minifigure then put her aside while we make the clothing booth!

Group 2 - Clothing Booth

1. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 plate in front of you.

2. Place a green 6x6 rounded plate on top of the 3 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

3.1. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front stud of the rightmost column.

Group 3 - Clothing Booth

3.2. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

4. Let's make a part! Vertically place a tan 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a nougat 2x4 brick on the back 2 rows so it overhangs 2 columns to the right.

5. Vertically place a tan 2x3 plate underneath the overhang so 1 row is exposed to the front.

6. Horizontally place 2 nougat 1x2 log bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row.

7. Horizontally place 2 transparent 1x2x2 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so the walls face the back.

8. Place 2 gold 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 2 rows.

9. Place a gold 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top of each of the 2x2 tiles with a stud.

10. Place a small lime green hat on the right ppp. Then horizontally place a transparent purple pair of sunglasses on the left 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar.

You will have 2 extra lime green 1x2 sloped curved tiles. Save them for later!

Group 4 - Clothing Booth

11.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a nougat 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x4 plate on the back row. Now vertically place a lime green 1x2 sloped curved tile from group 3 on the leftmost column so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the 2nd column from the right so it slopes to the front.

11.2. Vertically place a light green 1x2 sloped curved tile on the rightmost column so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the 2nd column from the left so it slopes to the front.

11.3. Horizontally place your part on top of the 1x2x2 panels of your previous part so it slopes and overhangs 1 row to the front.

12. Bring back your previous part and place it in front of you so the flowers are on the right and the leftmost column of the 2x4 plate faces the left. Now horizontally place your part on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th rows from the back of the 6x6 rounded plate so it is centered horizontally on it. Now put away your build while we make a peach tree!

Group 5 - Peach Tree

13. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 plate in front of you.

14. Place a green 6x6 rounded plate on top of the 3 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

15.1. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the left.

Group 6 - Peach Tree

15.2. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

16. Place a brown 2x2 round brick with roots on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back of the 6x6 rounded plate so it is centered horizontally on it.

17. Stack 2 brown 2x2 round bricks on top of the ppp so there is no overhang.

18. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a green 2x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

19. Place a green 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick with a 1x2 plate part on the leftmost column so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

20. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

21. Vertically place a green 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

22. Horizontally place 2 green 1x2x1 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so the walls face the back. Then horizontally place 1 more on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the front.

23. Place a green 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

24.1. Place a light yellow flower in between the panels. It should not attach to any studs!

24.2. Now horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Then vertically place a green 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 brick with a side stud on the front row so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 brick on the back row.

25. Insert a brown claw with a bar into each of the front-facing side studs so the clip hands face left and right.

26. Attach a light yellow ball with a bar to each of the front-facing claws so the balls hang down. These are the peaches!

27. Bring back your previous build so the 1x1 round flower plate is in the front left corner and the 2x4 plate faces the right. Now horizontally place your part on top of the 2x2 round brick so it is centered horizontally and the peaches face the front.

28. Place a black and white butterfly on top of the 1x1 round flower plate so the tips face the back left and back right. Then horizontally place the left column of a light orange basket on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the right of the 6x6 rounded plate so the handles face the front and back.

29. Vertically place a brown 2x4 plate underneath the front 2 rows of the 6x6 rounded plate so it is centered horizontally to it.

30-31. Place a light blue 4x4 rounded plate on the front 2 rows of the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Now put your build away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 7 - Sasha the Rabbit

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 short mint blue pair of legs, 1 white torso printed with a blue jacket with a yellow K on it, 1 mint blue and white bunny head with big orange ears, black eyes, and a red and black mouth. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we build the clothing store.

Group 8 - Clothing Store

32. Horizontally place a nougat 8x16 plate with 1x4 gaps on the sides in front of you. Then horizontally place a nougat 1x4 plate on the back row in each of the 1x4 gaps.

33.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light green 4x8 plate with a round side and a gap in front of you so the round side faces the front. Now horizontally place a green 1x8 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally.

33.2. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the back. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 plate on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

33.3. Horizontally place the overhang of your part on the left 1x4 gap of the front row so the round side faces the front.

Group 9 - Clothing Store

34.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light green 4x8 plate with a round side and a gap in front of you so the round side faces the front. Now horizontally place a nougat 1x8 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally.

34.2. Horizontally place a nougat 2x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the back. Then horizontally place a nougat 1x2 plate on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

34.3. Horizontally place the overhang of your part on the right 1x4 gap of the front row so the round side faces the front.

35.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a green 3x4 plate with a raised round side in front of you so the round side faces the left. Now horizontally place 2 green 2x3 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns so they overhang 1 column to the right.

35.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place the overhang of 1 part on the 1x4 gap of the leftmost column so the round side overhangs 3 columns to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

36. Vertically place a light grey 1x4 masonry brick on the rightmost column of the back row so the brick grooves face the right.
37. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 masonry brick in front of the ppp so the brick grooves face the right. Now vertically place a light grey 1x4 masonry brick in front of the ppp so the brick grooves face the right.
38. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 masonry brick to the left of the front row of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front.
39. Horizontally place a light grey 1x4x6 door frame to the left of the ppp so the side with ridges faces the front.
40. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 masonry brick to the left of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front. Then vertically place the front row of a light grey 1x4 masonry brick to the left of the ppp so the brick grooves face the left.
41. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 masonry brick to the left of the back row of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x4 masonry brick to the left of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front.
42. Vertically place a light grey 1x4 masonry brick on the leftmost column of the back row so the brick grooves face the left. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 masonry brick in front of the ppp so the brick grooves face the left.
43. Place a red 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column of the back row so it slopes to the back.
44. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now place a red 1x1 brick behind the ppp that is on the front right corner. Then vertically place a red 1x4 brick behind the ppp.
45. Vertically place a red 1x4 brick on the 4th column from the right, on top of the 2 ppp. Then place a red 1x1 brick behind the ppp.
46. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a red 1x6 plate on the 2nd row from the front, behind the ppp so it sits on top of the masonry bricks.
47. Let's make a part! Let's make a window! Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a transparent 1x4x3 panel on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the back.
48. Place a white 1x1x3 brick on the back left and back right corners.

Group 10 - Clothing Store

49. Place a red 1x1x3 brick on the front left and front right corners.
50. Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

51. Place a white 1x1 slope tile on the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 half cylinder brick in between the 2 ppp.

52. Horizontally place your part on the previous 1x6 plate that is on top of the masonry bricks on the 7th row from the front so it overhangs 1 row to the back.

Group 11 - Clothing Store

53. Place a white 1x1 brick to the right of the 1x4x6 door frame that is in the back left so there are 2 free columns in between them. Now place a white 1x1x3 brick on top.

54. Vertically place a red 1x2x5 brick in front of the ppp.

Group 12 - Clothing Store

55. Place a red 1x1x3 brick in front of the ppp. Then place a red 1x1 brick on top.

56. Horizontally place a red 1x2x5 brick to the left and right of the 1x4x6 door frame.

Group 13 - Clothing Store

57. Place a white 1x1 brick on the leftmost column of the 3rd row from the back, to the left of the ppp. Then place a white 1x1x3 brick on top.

58. Vertically place a red 1x2x2 brick in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a red 1x4 brick in front of the ppp.

59. Vertically place a red 1x4 brick on top of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then vertically place a red 1x2x2 brick in front. Now place a red 1x1 slope tile in front so it slopes to the front.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

60. Place a red 1x1 brick on the rightmost column of the 2nd row from the front so it sits on top of the 1x4 brick. Then vertically place a red 1x4 brick behind the ppp.

61. Vertically place a red 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, on top of the 2 ppp so the side studs face the left. Then place 3 red 1x1 bricks, 1 behind the other, behind the ppp.

62. Vertically place a red 1x6 brick on top of all the ppp from the previous step so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a red 1x6 brick to the left of the back row of the ppp.

63. Vertically place 2 red 1x4 bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 4th column from the left so there is no overhang.

64. Vertically place a red 1x2x2 brick on the back 2 rows of the 2 ppp. Then vertically place a red 1x4 brick in front of the ppp.

65. Vertically place a red 1x4 brick on top of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then vertically place a red 1x2x2 brick in front of the ppp.

66. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now place a white 1x1 brick with a side stud on the rightmost column of the 3rd row from the front so the side stud faces the front. Then place another 1 on the 7th column from the left of the 3rd row from the front so the side stud faces the front.

67.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a door! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 curved door frame in front of you so the clips face the front. Now attach the bars of a curved door with a window to the front-facing clips. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud of the door.

67.2. Horizontally place your door on the 2nd row from the front, in front of the 1x4x6 door frame so it is centered horizontally to it.

68. Place a white 2x2 plate on top of the ppp and 1x4x6 door frame.

69. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

70. Place a white 2x2 brick on top so it is centered horizontally.

71. Place 2 white 2x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other on top so they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right.

72. Vertically place 2 white 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they slope outwards to the left and right. This is a roof!

73. Vertically place the left column of your part on the 4th column from the left and 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th rows from the back so it sits on top of the 1x6 brick and the back 5 rows of your part overhang 1 column to the right.

Group 15 - Clothing Store

74. Let's make a part! Let's make a part of the roof! Horizontally place a white 2x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 brick in the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

75. Place a white 2x2 slope brick on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it slopes to the right.

76. Place a white 2x2 brick on the 2 leftmost columns. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick to the right. Now place a white 2x2 slope brick to the right so it slopes to the right.

77. Place a dark grey 2x2 round brick on the 2 leftmost columns. Then place a dark grey 2x2 round tile with a stud on top.

78. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope tile to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place another 1 to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the right.

79.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 3x5 cloud shaped plate with 3 studs upside down in front of you. Now place a light grey 1x1 round plate with a bar on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the bar faces the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 inverted sloped curved tile on top of the ppp so it slopes to the left. This is smoke for the chimney!

79.2. Place the bar of your part on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the 2 leftmost columns so the studs of the cloud-shaped plate face the right.

80. Vertically place the back row of your part on the 2nd row from the back and 4th column from the right so it overhangs 1 column to the left and the cloud plate is in the back.

81. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in front of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate to the left of the back row of the 2x2 plate that is to the left of the ppp.

82. Vertically place the front row of a white 2x4 plate to the left of the ppp so the back 3 rows overhang 1 column to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 plate to the left of the back row of the ppp.

83. Horizontally place a white 1x6 tile on top of the 2 ppp so there is no overhang.

84. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile in front of the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp. Then place a white 2x2 tile with a stud in front. Now place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 rightmost columns of the 3rd and 4th rows from the front. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 tile behind it. It should sit in front of the 2x2 slope bricks!

85. Horizontally place a white 1x6 tile in between the front row of the previous 2x2 tiles with a stud so it is centered horizontally in front of the curved door frame.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 16 - Clothing Store

86. Let's make a part! Let's make a part of the roof! Horizontally place a tan 2x16 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a green 1x4 tile on the rightmost column so 2 rows overhang to the front.

87. Horizontally place a tan 2x16 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally.

88. Vertically place a brown 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right, so it sits to the left of the 1x4 tile.

89. Place 2 green 2x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top of the ppp.

90. Place 2 green 2x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the 2 ppp. Then vertically place a brown 2x4 plate to the left.

91. Place 2 green 2x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top of the ppp. Now place 2 green 2x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the 2 ppp.

92. Place a green 1x1 tile on the back row to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place 2 light grey 1x2 plates with a stud and a clip, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows, to the left of the ppp so the clips are in the back. Now place a green 1x1 tile on the back row to the left.

93. Horizontally place a green 1x4 sloped curved tile on top of the front row of the previous 1x2 plates with a clip and a stud so it is centered horizontally on them.

94. Place a brown 2x2 plate on the front 2 rows in front of the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp.
95. Place a green 2x2 tile on the front 2 rows on top of the ppp. Then place a green 2x2 tile to the left.
96. Vertically place a brown 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left.
97. Place 2 green 2x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top of the ppp. Then vertically place a green 1x4 tile on the leftmost column.
98. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a green 2x10 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a green 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
99. Horizontally place a green 1x8 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
100. Horizontally place a lime green 2x8 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.
101. Horizontally place a lime green 2x8 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally.
102. Horizontally place a green 2x3 slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a green 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally.
- 103.1. Vertically place a lime green 1x2 sloped curved tile on the leftmost column of the front 2 rows so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place 3 more to the right so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them and they slope to the front.

Group 17 - Clothing Store

- 103.2. Vertically place a light green 1x2 sloped curved tile to the right of each of the 4 ppp so they slope to the front.
104. Rotate your part 180 degrees. Now horizontally place 2 blue 1x2 plates with 2x2 side studs sticking up, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2nd row from the front so they are centered horizontally and the side studs face the back.
105. Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.
106. Place a green 1x1 brick on the front row in front of the leftmost column of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
107. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the bar faces the front. Now horizontally stack 2 tan 1x2 plates on top.
108. Horizontally place 2 green 2x3 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 2 rows so they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right.

109. Vertically place 2 green 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 2 ppp so they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right.

110. Bring back your previous part so it is horizontal and the clips are in the back left. Now horizontally attach the front-facing bar of your current part to the clips so the tile side faces up and to the front.

111. Bring back your main build and horizontally place it in front of you so the door is in the front. Now rotate your part 180 degrees. Then place the 2x3 slope brick part on the 2 rightmost columns of your part on top of the front right 2x2 tile with a stud so the side studs face the front, the 1x2 sloped curved tiles face the front, and the 4x16 tile part is in the back and diagonal.

112. Horizontally place a blue 2x6 tile printed with a shirt, shoe, hat, and buttons upright on the 2x4 front-facing side studs of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

113.1. Let's make a part! Place a transparent yellow 1x1 round brick in front of you. Now place a black lantern on top so the bar is horizontal. Then attach a black claw to it so the bar faces the back.

113.2. Attach the bar of your part upright on the front-facing side stud that is to the left of the front door so the anti-stud faces down.

114.1. Place a green 1x1 round plate on the 2nd row from the back of the leftmost column. Then place another 1 on the front row of the 2nd column from the left.

Group 18 - Clothing Store

114.2. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the 2 ppp.

115. Attach a black 4L bar upright on the front-facing side stud to the right of the door. Now attach the clips of a sand green flag with 2 clips to the bar so it hangs down.

Group 19 - Clothing Store

There are no steps in this group!

You will have 12 extra light yellow 1x1 round flower plates. Save them for later!

Group 20 - Clothing Store

116.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a green 1x1 round flower plate in front of you. Now place a green plant with 3 stems on top. Now stack 2 light yellow 1x1 round flower plates from group 19 on top of each of the stems.

116.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 on the 2nd row from the front of the 2nd column from the right. Then place another 1 on the 3rd column from the left of the 3rd row from the front.

117. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 2x4 plate in front of you.

118. Place a green 6x6 rounded plate on top of the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

119. Vertically place a white 1x4x2 fence on the 4th column from the left so it is centered vertically.

120. Rotate your part 90 degrees counterclockwise so the 2x4 plate faces the back. Now place the back 2 rows of your part underneath the front 2 rows of the left 2x8 rounded part so it is centered horizontally to it.

121. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 2x4 plate in front of you.

122. Place a green 6x6 rounded plate on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

123. Rotate your part 90 degrees counterclockwise so the 2x4 plate faces the back. Now place the back 2 rows of your part underneath the front 2 rows of the right 2x8 rounded part so it is centered horizontally to it.

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 1):

Group 21 - Clothing Store

124. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now place a white 2x2 tile printed with a picture of 3 cat minifigures in red, purple, and blue outfits, upright on the 2 left-facing side studs of the brick wall on the right side so it hangs 1 row down.

Group 22 - Clothing Store

125. Place a nougat 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows to the left of the right 1x1 slope tile that is on the front right corner. Then vertically place a nougat 1x2 tile behind the right column of the ppp. Then place a nougat 2x2 tile behind it.

126. Place a nougat 2x2 tile with a stud to the left of the 1x2 tile from the previous step. Then place a nougat 2x2 tile to the left of the ppp. Then place another nougat 2x2 tile with a stud to the left.

127. Place a nougat 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the 1x2x5 brick that is to the right of the 1x4x6 door frame in the back left of the building.

128. Place a nougat 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the 1x2x5 brick that is to the left of the 1x4x6 door frame in the back left of the building. Now horizontally place a nougat 1x2 tile in front of the ppp.

129. Place a nougat 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the ppp. Then place a nougat 2x2 tile in front of the ppp. Now place another nougat 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the ppp.

Group 23 - Clothing Store

130.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then vertically place 2 light brown 1x2 log bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top.

130.2. Place a white 2x2 slope brick with a keypad and card reader on top so it slopes to the right. Now place a gold 1x1 round tile printed with a star on the front row. This is a register! Now put it away while we make another part!

131. Horizontally place a brown 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top so it is centered horizontally.

132. Place a brown 2x2 round ridged brick underneath the 2 leftmost columns. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

133. Vertically place a light brown 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then place a brown 1x1 tile on the front right corner. Then place a brown 1x1 clip behind the ppp so the clip hands face the left and right.

134. Attach a silver pair of scissors to the clip so the blades face the front. This is a sewing table!

135. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a black 1x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns.

136. Place a black 1x1 plate on the rightmost column.

You will have an extra black 1x1 plate. Save it for later!

Group 24 - Clothing Store

137. Place a transparent 1x1 plate on the leftmost column. Then place a black 1x1 brick with 2 side studs on the rightmost column so the side studs face the front and right.

138. Horizontally place a black 1x1 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left and the plate part is on the right. Then place a black 1x1 plate from group 23 on the rightmost column.

139. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns.

140.1. Place a dark grey 1x1 round plate upright on the right-facing side stud.

Group 25 - Clothing Store

140.2. Place a light grey 1x1 round tile printed with a speedometer upright on the front-facing side stud.

141. Bring back your sewing table and orient it so it is horizontal and the scissors are on the right. Now horizontally place your part on top of the 2 studs of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs so it slopes to the left.

142. Stack 2 light blue 1x1 round bricks on top of the back left corner.

Group 26 - Clothing Store

143. Place a magenta 1x1 round brick on the rightmost stud on top of the 1x2 plate.

Group 27 - Clothing Store

144. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick on the front left corner.

145. Locate a magenta purse and put it in front of you. Now put your purse and your sewing table away while we make another part!

You will have an extra yellow torso. Save it for later!

Group 28 - Clothing Store

146.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 brick on the back right corner. Then horizontally place a green 1x4 tile to the left.

146.2. Horizontally place a green 1x2 brick on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a green 1x4 tile to the right.

146.3. Horizontally place a pink torso printed with a sweater on the front left 1x2 brick so the hands face the front. Then horizontally place a yellow torso from group 27 printed with blue circles, pink triangles, and red curved lines on the back right corner so the hands face the front. This is a clothing display!

147.1. Let's make another part! Place a light grey 2x2 tile with 2 studs in front of you so the studs are in the front.

147.2. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 hinge base with small clips on top of the ppp so the wall faces the back. Now attach a white 2x2 plate with a bar underneath to the ppp so the studs overhang to the back.

147.3. Vertically place a white 2x3 tile printed with a pink border and different clothing types on top so 1 row overhangs to the back. Now rotate it to the front so the tile faces the front. This is a sign! Put it away so we can make another part!

148.1. Place a green 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 brick on the back row.

148.2. Horizontally place a green 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then place a green 2x2 plate on top.

148.3. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate upright on the front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a short purple pair of legs on the front row so the toes face the front. We are finished with this part, now let's put everything inside the shop!

149.1. Place your cash register on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is in the back left corner of your shop so it slopes to the right. Then Vertically place your sewing table in front of your ppp so it sits on the 2 2x2 tiles with a stud and the scissors are in the back.

149.2. Place a brown 2x2 round plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, to the right of the previous sewing table.

Group 29 - Clothing Store

149.3. Place a bright pink 2x2 round plate on top of the ppp.

149.4. Place your sign on the front 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the front right corner so the 2x3 tile faces the front. Now horizontally place the clothing display with the 2 torsos on the 2 2x2 tiles with a stud that are behind the ppp so the hands face the front.

149.5. Horizontally place the magenta purple purse on the rightmost column of the window sill that is behind your ppp. It should sit in front of the panel! Now place the display with the pair of legs to the left of the ppp so it sits on the 2x2 tile with a stud and the feet face the front.
