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Here's a fun birthday gift or anytime treat for kids who love animal-care pretend play! Girls, boys or any pet-lover aged 6 and up can enjoy hours of fun at the LEGO® Friends Pet Accessories Shop (42650). The set comes with 3 minidolls and cat, dog and bunny figures for imaginative play.

Join Nova, Leo and Matilde as they pick out new hats and accessories for their furry friends Churro, Pickle and Amos. Take the pets on the elevator to the grooming area, where a conveyor belt moves them through the soaping, washing and drying stations. Then check out the accessories on sale, including a chef's hat, baseball cap and yarn ball. There's also money and a cash register so kids can create their own customer moments. Watch out for the dog poop! Luckily there's a shovel for emergency cleanups! Discover more humorous details – like the building's pup design, complete with moving eyebrows and spinning bow.

Pretend-play building set for kids – This Pet Accessories Shop for girls and boys aged 6 and up comes with 3 minidolls, plus cat, dog and bunny figures, and lots of accessories for imaginative play.

Pet-grooming toy and pet accessories shop – The dog-shaped two-story building features a pet accessories shop and a grooming station so kids can enjoy hours of fun pampering the animals.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic[™] part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic[™].

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ells and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42650) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Nova and Pickle

Sub-build 1. Locate1 tan pair of legs printed with black shoes and teal shorts, 1 tan torso printed with a magenta shirt with a yellow dog, 1 tan head printed with olive green eyes and lips, 1 tan hair, 1 brown stick, and 1 nougat 1x1 round tile printed with a white paw. Assemble your minifigure then attach the stick and 1x1 round tile to her hands! This round tile is a treat!

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 light brown dog with a harness, and 1 teal set of wheels. Attach the wheels to the small clips underneath the dog, then put him in front of you. This is Pickle! Now put them away while we build the pet accessories store!

Group 2 - Pet Accessories Store

- 1. Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate with holes in front of you. Then place an orange 2x2 round tile with a hole on the 2 leftmost columns.
- 2. Place a lime green 2x2 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns.
- 3. Orient the build so it is vertical and the overhang faces the front. Now horizontally place the back right corner of a lime green 8x14 plate underneath the overhang.

Group 3 - Pet Accessories Store

4. Place an orange 2x2 plate on the back right corner, in front of the 2x2 round tile with a hole.

Group 4 - Pet Accessories Store

- 5. Place a light blue 2x2 plate on top of the ppp. Then vertically place a light blue 1x6 brick on the rightmost column in front of the ppp.
- 6. Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 tile on the back row to the left of the 2x2 plate. Then place the left column of a yellow 2x2 corner tile in front of the rightmost column of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter h.
- 7. Place a yellow 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the ppp. Then place 3 more, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the ppp.
- 8. Horizontally place a blue 2x4 brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, to the left of the 1x6 brick. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left of the ppp.
- 9. Vertically place a yellow 1x2 tile on the 4th and 5th rows from the front, to the left of the 2x2 tile with a stud.
- 10. Horizontally place a yellow 1x6 plate in front of the ppp. Then place a yellow 2x2 triangle tile behind the 2nd column from the right of the ppp so the right angle faces the front right.

You will have 2 extra red 1x2 plates. Save them for later!

Group 5 - Pet Accessories Store

- 11.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a red 1x2 plate from group 4 on top.
- 11.2.Place a tan 2x2 corner sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part on the left column so it slopes to the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate on top.
- 11.3. Horizontally place your part on the front row on the 6th, 7th, 8th, and 9th columns from the right so it slopes and overhangs to the front.

- 12. Horizontally place the 4 leftmost columns of a lime green 4x8 plate with a round side underneath the overhang of the ppp so the round side faces the front.
- 13.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a red 1x2 plate from group 4 on top.
- 13.2.Place a tan 2x2 corner sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part on the left column so it slopes to the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate on top.
- 13.3. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th, columns from the right, to the right of the previous part so it slopes to the front. These are the dog paws for the store!
- 14. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the rightmost stud of the 3rd row from the front.
- 15. Place a yellow 1x1x1 corner panel to the left of the ppp so the corner of the wall faces the back right. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2x1 panel to the left so the wall faces the back. Then place a yellow 1x1x1 corner panel to the left of the ppp so the corner of the wall faces the back left.
- 16. Place a yellow 1x1x1 corner panel on the 2nd row from the front, in front of the ppp so the corner of the wall faces the front left. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2x1 panel to the right so the wall faces the front. Now place a yellow 1x1x1 corner panel to the right so the corner of the wall faces the front right.
- 17. Place a light blue 1x1 brick on the front row of the 7th column from the left. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick behind it.
- 18.1. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front left corner. Then place another 1 on the front row of the 6th column from the left.

Group 6 - Pet Accessories Store

- 18.2. Place a light purple 1x1 round flower plate on each of the 2 ppp.
- 19. Place a pink 2x2 sloped curved tile on the front row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then place another 1 to the right so it slopes and overhangs to the front.
- 20. Place a light blue 2x2 brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front of the leftmost column so it overhangs 1 column to the left.
- 21. Place a lime green 8x8 plate with a round side underneath the overhang of the ppp so it is centered vertically to the 8x14 plate so the round side faces the left.
- 22. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 slope brick on the back row on the 8th and 9th columns from the left so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a light grey 2x4 plate with holes in front.
- 23. Place 2 pink 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows of the ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right.

- 24. Place 2 pink 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the 2 ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right.
- 25. Place a brown 1x1 swirl on the back row on the 7th column from the left so it sits to the left of the 1x2 slope brick. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 round tile on the 3rd row from the front on the 7th column from the left.
- 26. Place a light blue 1x1 brick on the front row of the 8th column from the left.
- 27. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a clip on the back row on the 9th column from the left so it sits on the 1x2 slope brick and the clip faces the back. Now vertically place a pink 1x2 brick on the front 2 rows of the 9th column from the left.

Group 7 - Pet Accessories Store

- 28.1. Let's make a part! Place a light grey 1x1 round plate with a bar in front of you so the bar faces the left. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 round brick on top. Now place a teal 1x1 round tile on top. This is a water dispenser!
- 28.2. Place your part on the 3rd row from the front of the 8th column from the left so the bar faces the left.
- 29. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick in front of your ppp.
- 30. Vertically place a light yellow 1x6x2 arch brick on the back 6 rows of the 9th column from the left, so it sits on top of the 1x1 brick with a clip and 1x2 brick.
- 31. Place a pink 1x1 brick in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick on the front 2 rows to the left of the ppp.

Group 8 - Pet Accessories Store

- 32. Place a light yellow 1x1 brick on the front row on top of the ppp. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick behind it so there is no overhang.
- 33.1. Let's make a part! Place a short white 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round brick on top. Now place a white 1x1 round tile on top.
- 33.2. Place your part on the 2nd row from the front of the 7th column from the left.
- 34. Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front row of the 5th column from the left. Then horizontally place a white 1x4x2 fence behind it so it sits to the left of the 1x1 round tile.
- 35. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 3rd and 4th column from the right, in front of the ppp.
- 36.1. Let's make a part! Place a short white 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round brick on top. Now place a white 1x1 round tile on top.
- 36.2. Place your part on the 2nd column from the right, to the right of the 1x4x2 fence.

- 37. Vertically place a white 1x4x2 fence in front of the ppp. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front stud of the rightmost column.
- 38.1. Let's make a part! Place a short white 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round brick on top. Now place a white 1x1 round tile on top.
- 38.2. Place your part on the 2nd column from the right so it sits in front of the 1x4x2 fence.
- 39.1. Vertically place a pink 1x2 brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back of the 9th column from the right.

Group 9 - Pet Accessories Store

- 39.2. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick on the back 2 rows to the right of the ppp.
- 40.1. Place a light yellow 1x1 brick on the front row of the 9th column from the right so it sits on top of the arch brick. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x2 slope brick behind it so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Then skip 1 row behind it and place another yellow 1x2 slope brick so it slopes and overhangs to the right.

Group 10 - Pet Accessories Store

- 40.2. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 slope brick behind each of the 1x2 slope bricks from the previous step so they slope and overhang to the right.
- 41. Vertically place a light yellow 1x4 brick on the front 4 rows of the 9th column from the right. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick behind it. Now place a pink 1x1 brick behind it.
- 42. Attach a silver shovel to the front-facing clip so the shovel head faces up.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 11 - Matilde and Amos

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with a red skirt and light brown slippers, 1 tan torso printed with a white shirt with cherries, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes and pink lips, 1 blonde hair, 1 white bunny. and 1 bright pink yarn ball. Assemble your minifigure then put the bunny and the yarn ball next to her! Now put them away while we continue the build!

Group 12 - Pet Accessories Store

- 43.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a door! Horizontally place a yellow 1x4x6 door frame in front of you so the grooves face the front. Now attach a transparent door with a sticker to the front so the front-facing stud is on the right.
- 43.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the transparent door. This sticker has a dog bone sign that says open. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

- 43.3. Place a yellow 1x1 clip upright on the front-facing stud so the clip hands face the left and right. Now vertically attach a white dog bone to the ppp. This is the door handle!
- 43.4. Bring back your main build and orient it so it is horizontal and the fences are on the left. Now horizontally place your part behind the 2x2 sloped curved tiles that are on the front row so the door opens to the front.
- 44. Horizontally place 2 pink 1x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the right.
- 45.1. Place a pink 1x1 brick to the right of the 1x4x6 door frame.

Group 13 - Pet Accessories Store

- 45.2. Place a light yellow 1x1 brick on the front stud of the column to the right of the ppp.
- 46. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick on top of the ppp so there is no overhang.

Group 14 - Pet Accessories Store

- 47. Horizontally place 2 pink 1x2 bricks, 1 on top of the other, on the back row of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then place a pink 1x1 brick on the left column of the ppp.
- 48. Horizontally place 2 transparent 1x4x3 panels, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the 1x2 bricks from the previous step so the walls face the front. Now horizontally place 2 pink 1x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 2 ppp so there is no overhang.

Group 15 - Pet Accessories Store

- 49. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick on the front 2 rows of the rightmost column. Then vertically place another 1 on top. Now stack 2 light yellow 1x1 bricks on top of the back row of the ppp.
- 50. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x4x3 half arch brick on the front row of the rightmost column so it arches to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the left so it sits 10th column from the left, and there is a 2 column gap in between them.
- 51. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 brick on the front 2 rows of the rightmost column. Then vertically place another 1 on the front 2 rows of the 10th column from the right so there is no overhang.
- 52. Horizontally place an orange 1x6 plate on top of the 2 light yellow 1x4x3 half arch bricks so it is centered horizontally on them.
- 53.1. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the fences face the back. Now horizontally place a light yellow 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the front row to the left of the 2x2 round tile with a hole so the wall faces the back.

- 53.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the light yellow 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a dog with a cat and a guinea pig on top of it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 54. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the fences face the right. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x8 tile to the right of the back row of the ppp.
- 55. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x3 arch brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with side studs on the 2 rightmost columns so the side studs face the front.
- 56. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a side stud on the leftmost column so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place an orange 1x3 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 57. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.
- 57.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the light blue 1x3 tile. This sticker has a picture of a pink party hat and white chef hat and a price of 4 for each! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 58. Place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 59. Place a gold cone hat with a ball on the leftmost ppp. Then place a small white chef hat on the rightmost column.
- 60. Horizontally place your part on the 2 leftmost 2x2 tiles with a stud in front of the previous 1x8 tile so the upright tile faces the front.
- 61. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x3 arch brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the 2 rightmost columns so the side studs face the front.
- 62. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a side stud on the leftmost column so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place an orange 1x3 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 63.1. Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.
- 63.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the light blue 1x3 tile. This sticker has a top hat and a green cap on it, with a price of 5 for each! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 64. Place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 65. Place a small black top hat on the leftmost column. Then place a small green cap on the rightmost column.

- 66. Horizontally place your part on top of the 2 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 to the right of the previous part so the upright tile faces the front.
- 67. Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 log brick on the back row.
- 68. Place 2 light blue 1x1 round plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row.
- 69. Place a silver 1x1 round tile printed with a can cap, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row.
- 70. Place a tan 2x2 plate on top so it overhangs 1 row to the front.
- 71.1. Horizontally place an orange 1x2x2 brick with a sticker on the back row so the sticker faces the front. Now place 2 orange 1x1 double slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp so they slope to the front and back.
- 71.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the orange 1x2x2 brick. This sticker has a picture of dog food in a pink bowl. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 72. Place your part to the right of the previous part so it sits to the right of the 1x8 tile.

Group 16 - Pet Accessories Store

- 73. Vertically place a light blue 1x2x5 brick on the 2nd column from the left, behind the 2x2 round tile with a hole.
- 74. Place a pink 2x2 brick on top of the ppp so there is no overhang. Now vertically place a pink 1x2 slope brick on the front 2 rows on the 9th column from the right, behind the shovel so it slopes to the front.
- 75. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then place a pink 1x1 brick in front of the ppp. Now place another 1 on the rightmost column in front of the 2x2 brick.
- 76. Horizontally place a tan 1x16 brick in front of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally in front of them. Now vertically place a pink 1x2 brick in front of the leftmost column and rightmost column of the ppp.
- 77. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick in front of the left ppp so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a pink 1x10 brick to the right. Now horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the right.
- 78. Horizontally place the front row of the 2 light blue 6x8 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 3 ppp so they are centered horizontally on them. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate behind the 2 rightmost columns of the 2 ppp.
- 79. Place a tan 1x1 round plate with a bar on the 2nd row from the front, to the left of the previous 6x8 plates so the bar faces the left. Now place a green 1x1 brick with a hole on top so the hole faces the left. Then place an orange 1x1 double slope tile on top so it slopes to the front and back. This is a bird house!
- 80.1. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2x2 window frame in front of you so the ridges face the back. Then place a yellow 1x1 round plate on the leftmost column. Now vertically place a green 1x2 tile printed with a

100 dollars on the right column so it is centered vertically. Place a light grey 1x1 round plate with a bent bar on top of the left column so the side stud faces the front. Now place a light grey 1x1 tile printed with a keypad and card reader on top of the ppp.

80.2. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the front, on the 11th and 12th columns from the right so the upright tile faces the front. It should sit to the left of the 2x2 sloped curved tiles.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 17 - Leo and Churro

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 light brown pair of legs printed with light blue shoes and yellow shorts, 1 light brown torso printed with a white shirt and a pink jacket, 1 light brown head printed with brown eyes and lips, and 1 brown hair, and 1 white cat printed with orange spots. Assemble your minifigure then put the cat next to her!

Group 18 - Pet Accessories Store

- 81. Let's make a part! Stack 2 light grey 2x6 plates so there is no overhang, then horizontally put them in front of you.
- 82. Vertically place 2 light grey 1x2 bricks with an axle hole, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns.
- 83. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the rightmost column. Then horizontally place a light blue 2x5 stair plate to the left so the higher side is on the left and there is no overhang.
- 84. Horizontally place a yellow 2x3 tile on the 3 leftmost columns.
- 85. Bring back your build so it is centered horizontally and the fences face the right. Now vertically place your part on the 2 leftmost columns, behind the 2x2 round tile with a hole so the 2x3 tile is in the front.
- 86. Let's make a part! Attach a white axle with an axle connector to the leftmost front-facing axle hole so the axle connector faces up and down. Now insert a yellow 11L axle into the top-facing axle connector so it is centered vertically.

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- 87. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a lime green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate on the rightmost column.
- 88. Horizontally place a light blue 2x5 stair plate on the 3 leftmost columns so the higher side overhangs 2 columns to the left.
- 89. Place a light grey 2x2 plate with a ball underneath the 2 leftmost columns so the ball faces the left.
- 90. Place an orange 2x2 round tile with a hole on the 2 leftmost columns.

- 91. Vertically place a white 3x4 tile with a row of studs on the 3 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.
- 92. Horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of your part on the front left corner so the ball faces the left. Now push the 11L axle all the way down. Make sure it goes into the 2x2 round tile with a hole! Now you can use your finger and lift the left-facing ball up and down. This is an elevator!
- 93. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th columns from the right so it sits in front of the 6x8 plates.
- 94. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light yellow 1x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the 2 rightmost columns so the side studs face the front.
- 95. Place a pink 1x1 brick on the 3rd column from the right.
- 96. Horizontally place 2 light yellow 1x3 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the 5 leftmost columns so 1 column overhangs to the left.
- 97. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x3x2 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part underneath the overhang so it slopes to the left.
- 98. Horizontally place the 4 rightmost columns of your part on top of the previous 1x4 plate that is in front of the 6x8 plates so it slopes to the left. Make sure the leftmost column sits on the bricks on the 8th column from the left.
- 99. Stack 2 light yellow 1x4 plates so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them on the front right corner so there is no overhang. The rightmost column of your part should be on the front row of the rightmost column.
- 100. Place a light yellow 1x1 tile on the front row of the rightmost column. Then place a pink 1x1 brick to the left. Now horizontally place a lime green 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the left so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs to the left so the side studs face the front.

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- 101. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x8 brick in front of you. Then place a light blue 1x1 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate on the leftmost column so it slopes and overhangs to the front.
- 102. Horizontally place a pink 2x8 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally.

You will have 2 extra light blue 1x1 sloped curved bricks with a 1x1 plate part. Save them for later!

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103. Vertically place a yellow 1x1 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part on the back right corner so it slopes to the front.

- 104.1. Vertically place a yellow 1x1 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part on the back 2 rows of the 2nd column from the left so it slopes to the front. Now vertically place another 1 on the back 2 rows of the 3rd column from the right so it slopes to the front.
- 104.2. Vertically place a light blue 1x1 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part from group 20 on the back 2 rows of the 3rd column from the left so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the back 2 rows on the 2nd column from the right so it slopes to the front. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 105. Place a white 1x1 round tile on the front row on the 3rd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 106. Place a pink 2x2 brick on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a pink 1x3 sloped curved brick on the front left corner so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 107. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile with a round side on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 jumper plate behind it so it is centered horizontally.
- 108.1. Place a yellow 1x1 tile with a round side on the back right corner so the round side faces the back. Now place 3 more to the left so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them and the round sides face the back.

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- 108.2. Place 4 light blue 1x1 tiles with a round side on the back row next to the ppp so the round side faces the back.
- 109. Horizontally place your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally on them and the 1x1 tiles with a round side hang 1 row down.
- 110.1. Place a gold 3x3 round tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side stud of the ppp so it is centered on it.
- 110.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the gold 3x3 round tile. This sticker says shop on it with 3 red paw prints. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 111.1. Let's make a part! Place a short white 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round brick on top. Then place a white 1x1 round tile on top.
- 111.2. Place your part on the 9th column from the left, on the front left corner of the 6x8 plate.
- 112. Vertically place a white 1x4x2 fence behind the ppp, then horizontally place another 1 on the front row of the 6x8 plate, to the right of the 1x1 round tile from the previous step.
- 113.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a short white 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round brick on top. Then place a white 1x1 round tile on top.

- 113.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 on the back left corner of the 6x8 plate, behind the 1x4 fence. Then place another 1 on the front row of the 6x8 plate, to the right of the 1x4 fence.
- 114. Let's make a part! Let's make a tree! Stack 3 brown candlesticks in front of you so the bar faces down.
- 115. Insert a brown 2L bar with a stop into the top-facing bar hole.
- 116.1. Vertically place the front row of a green 1x2 rounded plate with leaves on top of the ppp so the leaves face the back. Now horizontally place the right column of another 1 on the front row so the leaves face the left. Then place a lime green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the leftmost column so the leaves face the back left. Then place 1 more on the back right corner so the leaves face the back.
- 117. Place your part on the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the front left corner behind the fence so the leaves face the front left and front right.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

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- 118. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x10 brick on the 6th row from the back on the 10 rightmost columns so it sits to the right of the 1x1 round tile.
- 119. Place 2 brown 2x2 plates with 2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so they are centered horizontally to the ppp. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate to the left and right of the back row of the 2 ppp.
- 120. Horizontally place a red 1x4 plate on the back row of the 2x2 plates with 2 side studs so it is centered horizontally on them.
- 121. Place a tan 1x2 plate with a 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick to the left and right of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 122. Place a light yellow 1x1 brick on the 6th row from the back on the 10th column from the right so it sits to the right of the 1x1 round tile.
- 123. Horizontally place the back row of 2 light blue 2x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp so there is no overhang.
- 124. Vertically place a light yellow 1x4 brick on the rightmost column to the right of the ppp so there is no overhang.
- 125. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 sloped curved brick to the left of the front row of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Then horizontally place the back row of a light blue 2x4 plate to the left so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 sloped curved brick to the left of the back row of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

- 126. Now place a brown 1x1 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the 2nd column from the right, in front of the 1x2 sloped curved brick so the side studs face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left, so it sits in front of the left 1x2 sloped curved brick.
- 127. Place a white 1x1 round tile to the left of the right ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 128. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 bricks with a hole, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so they are centered in between the 1x2 inverted sloped curved bricks.
- 129. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole to the left and right of the 2 ppp so the holes face the front. Now insert a white 1L pin with a stud upright into each of the 2 ppp so the studs face the front.

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- 130. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate in between the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally to them.
- 131. Horizontally place a yellow 1x8 tile on the 7th row from the back, so it is centered horizontally in front of the 2 1x2 sloped curved bricks.
- 132. Stack 2 tan 1x8 plates on top of each other so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them in front of the ppp so it is centered horizontally to it.
- 133. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 plate on the 9th column from the left on the 4th and 5th rows from the front. Then horizontally place 2 orange 1x6 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the ppp.
- 134. Stack 2 orange 2x2 plates on top of each other so there is no overhang, then place the right column of them on the 1x2 plate from the previous step.

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- 135.1. Let's make a part! Place a light grey 2x2 plate with a ball in front of you so the ball faces the front. Then place a yellow 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top so the studs are in the back. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back row.
- 135.2. Place your part on top of the 2 previous 1x6 tiles so the ball faces the front. It should not sit on any studs!
- 136. Horizontally place a light grey 1x8 tile on the front row of your ppp so the 2 rightmost columns sit on the front row of the 2x2 plate that is to the right. The part with the ball should freely move left and right!
- 137. Vertically place the front row of an orange 1x2 sloped curved tile on the leftmost column of the ppp so it slopes to the back. Now place an orange 2x2 sloped curved tile on the 2 rightmost columns of the previous 1x8 tile so it slopes to the back.
- 138. Place a white 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top of the part that can freely move left and right so there is no overhang and the studs are in the front. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 jumper plate on top.

- 139. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2x2 slope brick to the right of the previous 2x2 sloped curved tile from step 137 so it slopes to the front.
- 140.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole in front of you. Then insert a dark tan 3L axle with a stud into the back-facing side so the axle faces the front and the stud faces the back. Now place a light grey gear with an axle hole upright on the front-facing axle so it goes all the way back.
- 140.2. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of the 8th row from the front of the 2nd floor so the axle faces the front.
- 141. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 bricks with a pin, 1 to the right of the other to the right of the ppp so the pins face the front. Now attach a red gear with a pin hole to each of the front-facing pins of the 2 ppp.

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- 142.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole in front of you. Then insert a dark tan 3L axle with a stud into the back-facing side so the axle faces the front and the stud faces the back. Now place a light grey gear with an axle hole upright on the front-facing axle so it goes all the way back. Then place a lime green 3L axle connector to the front-facing axle.
- 142.2. Horizontally place your part to the right of the ppp so the axle connector faces the front.

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- 143. Horizontally place a tan 1x8 plate on top of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally on it. Now horizontally place a tan 1x3 sloped curved tile on the leftmost column of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 144. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2x2 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the gears, in between the 1x2 sloped curved bricks so the side studs face the front.
- 145. Vertically place a light yellow 1x2x2 slope brick on the leftmost column so the back row is to the left of the 1x2 sloped curved brick and it slopes to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the 10th column from the left so it sits to the right of the 1x2 sloped curved brick and also slopes to the front.
- 146. Stack 2 light blue 1x6 plates so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them in front of you.
- 147. Horizontally place a light blue 1x1 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate on the leftmost column so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 148. Place a light blue 1x1 plate on the 2nd column from the left without counting the slope, so it sits to the right of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 149. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the 2 leftmost columns so there is no overhang and the clips face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 150. Vertically place a tan 2x3 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 2 rows to the back.

- 151. Horizontally place the front row of your part on top of the 1x2x2 bricks with 2x2 side studs that are in front of the gears so it is centered horizontally.
- 152. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope tile on the back row of the ppp so it is centered horizontally on it and slopes to the back.
- 153. Horizontally place a nougat 1x2 hinge plate with small clips in front of the ppp so the wall faces the front. Now place a brown 2x2 plate with a bar underneath on top of the ppp so the studs are in the back.
- 154.1. Horizontally place an orange 2x3 tile with a sticker upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs so 2 columns overhang to the left.
- 154.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the orange 2x3 tile. This sticker has 3 cat paws with different cleanliness. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 155.1. Horizontally place an orange 2x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs to the right of the ppp.
- 155.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the orange 2x3 tile. This sticker has a picture of a clean cat and dog. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 156.1. Place a light grey 2x2 plate with a hole underneath on the row behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally between the 1x2 plates with clips and the hole overhangs 1 row to the front. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 ingot tile on the front row of the ppp. Then insert a white 1L pin with a stud into the front-facing hole of the 2x2 plate with a hole so the stud faces the front.
- 157. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate behind the previous 1x2 ingot tile so it is centered horizontally to it. Now horizontally place a light yellow 1x3x2 sloped curved brick with a plate part to the left and right of the ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right.
- 158. Horizontally place 2 light yellow 1x3 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 2 ppp.
- 159. Insert a transparent blue flame into the front-facing side stud of the 1L pin with a side stud so it hangs down. This is a water stream!
- 160. Let's make a part! Place a white 1x1 round tile with bubbles on it on top of a light grey 1x1 rounded plate with a bar. Now attach the bar of your part to the left front-facing clip so the bubbles face down.
- 161. Let's make a part! Place a short light grey 1x1 half cone brick underneath a light grey 1x1 rounded plate with a bar. Now attach the bar of your part to the right front-facing clip so the anti-stud faces down.
- 162.1. Let's make a part! Place a nougat 2x2 barrel in front of you. Then place a silver pair of scissors and a light orange brush inside. Now place your part in front of the 1x1 round tile and leftmost 1x4x2 fence that are to the right of the ppp.

- 163.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a brown 1x6 sloped curved brick with a 1x2 plate part in front of you so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place a brown 1x2 tile on top.
- 163.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place the 2 rightmost columns of your part upright on the 2 right-facing side studs so it slopes up and to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 164.1. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 rounded tile with a sticker upright on the bottom 4 front-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the top and it is centered horizontally.
- 164.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the brown 2x4 rounded tile. This sticker has a dog mouth and nose on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 165. Place a white 2x2 round tile printed with a black eye upright on the left front-facing side stud so it is centered. Now place another 1 on the right front-facing side stud so it is centered on it!
- 166. Place a brown 2x2 round plate upright on the left front-facing side stud above the round tile so it is centered on it. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 167. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 rounded tile upright on the front-facing side studs of the left 2x2 round plate so it is centered horizontally and it faces the bottom left and top right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. These are the dog eyebrows!
- 168. Let's make a part! Let's make a bowtie! Place a teal 2x2 turntable plate in front of you. Then place a light grey 2x2 round turntable plate on top.
- 169. Place a light blue 1x1 round plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back right corner.
- 170. Place a light blue 3x3 quarter round plate on the back left corner so the curve faces and overhangs to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the front right.
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- 171. Place a light blue 2x2 round tile on top so it is centered.
- 172. Horizontally place your part on top of the front-facing 2x2 plate. It should be above the eyebrows!
- 173. Place a red bowtie, a gold crown, and a transparent purple pair of glasses inside the 2x4 box made up of panels on the front right corner.

You can make the eyebrows move by twisting the back-facing ridged axle connector behind the dog!

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
