42651 Horse and Pet Vet Clinic

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Inspire creative pretend play for girls, boys and animal-lovers aged 7 and up. The LEGO® Friends Horse and Pet Vet Clinic (42651) comes with 3 LEGO Friends mini dolls, a horse, 3 dogs and a cat figure.

Young builders can create endless stories as they care for the animals. The set has a working space for vet Eniko, with an examination table, pet food, veterinary equipment and a scale to weigh the animals. The stable has hay, a pitchfork, brush, saddle and a clipboard with the horse's X-ray. Kids can role-play pet-owner stories as Olly brings his cat to see the vet and Autumn visits with her horse. The vet has her own pets – a dog and its two puppies. After giving the animals a checkup, it's time for Eniko to head upstairs, where there's a bedroom and bathroom.

Pretend play for animal-lovers – This Horse and Pet Vet Clinic toy for girls, boys and animal fans aged 7 years old and up comes with 3 LEGO® Friends mini dolls, a horse, 3 dogs and a cat figure

Horse and stable – Tell fun stories with Thunder the horse who is staying in the stable and comes with accessories, including a rider's helmet, saddle, pitchfork, brush, hay and X-ray results.

3 minidolls and 5 animal figures – There is lots of opportunity for creativity with this social-skills toy as kids tell the story of how Olly and Autumn visit the vet clinic with their pets.

Vet accessories – This animal toy set comes with lots of fun accessories for role play, including a cash register, sunflowers, pet food, a vet's hat, pet poop elements, shampoo and soap.

Measurements – 428-piece set with a main model measuring over 6 in. (15 cm) high, 8 in. (20 cm) wide and 3.5 in. (9 cm) deep.

The build is 428 pieces in total and is for ages 7+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for 3 dogs, Autumn, a doggy bed, and the pet vet clinic!

Bag 2 includes the pieces for Eniko and the pet vet clinic!

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Olly, a cat, a horse, and the pet vet clinic.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for the pet vet clinic.

Bag 5 includes the pieces for the pet vet clinic and sunflower.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42651) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!
Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):
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Group 1 - Dogs and Autumn

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 big brown hairy dog printed with a pink collar named Guba, 1 little brown dog printed with black and white eyes named Alma, and 1 little tan dog printed with hair named Pali. Put them away for now while we make a minifigure!

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with sand green pants and brown shoes, 1 tan torso printed with a light purple short printed with pockets and white flowers, 1 tan head printed with freckles and light green eyes, 1 light brown hair with a light blue helmet. Now put your minifigure away while we make a doggy bed!

Group 2 - Doggy Bed

- 1. Place a light orange 6x6 round plate in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 round tile on top so it is centered.
- 2. Place 4 pink 1x2 curved tiles around the ppp so they make a circle!
- 3. Place a yellow 1x3 sloped curved macaroni brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place another 1 on the front left corner so it slopes to the front left. Now put all your dogs in the middle of the doggy bed!

Group 3 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 1. Place a tan 8x8 plate in front of you. Then place a nougat 1x1 brick on the front right corner.
- 2. Horizontally place 2 nougat 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row to the left of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front.
- 3. Vertically place a nougat 1x2 masonry brick on the front row on the 3rd column from the left so it overhangs 1 row to the front and the brick grooves face the right.
- 4.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light purple 1x4x6 door frame in front of you so the ridges face the front. Now attach a white door with a window and doggy door to the front so the front-facing side stud is on the right.
- 4.2. Attach a transparent light blue doggy door to the front. Now place a light blue 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate on top of the door frame.
- 4.2. Horizontally place your part on the front left corner so it overhangs 2 columns to the left and the door opens to the front.
- 5. Horizontally place the front row of a tan 8x16 plate underneath the left overhang so it is aligned with the main build.
- 6. Horizontally place a green 4x8 plate with a round side underneath the front overhang so the round side faces the front and so the overhang sits on the back row of the 2nd column from the right of it.
- 7.1. Horizontally place a yellow 2x4 tile with a sticker in front of the 1x4x6 door frame so it is centered horizontally to it.

- 7.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the yellow 2x4 tile. This sticker has orange horse hoof prints, doggy prints, chicken feet prints, and cat paw prints! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 8. Vertically place a back row of a nougat 1x2 masonry brick to the left of the 1x4x6 door frame so the brick grooves face the left.
- 9. Horizontally place 2 nougat 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the back row of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front. Now place a nougat 1x1 brick to the left.
- 10. Horizontally place the back row of an orange 2x6 plate with a round side to the left of the 1x4x6 door frame so the round side overhangs to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 11. Place a tan 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the left and right of the 1x4x6 door frame so the side studs face the front.
- 12. Horizontally place 2 white 1x2x2 window frames, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the right 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs so the ridged sides face the front. Now attach a transparent light blue window pane to the front of each of the 2 ppp. Now repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 13. Place a nougat 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row of the rightmost column so the side studs face the front. Then place a short blue 1x1 brick on top of the ppp. Now repeat symmetrically to the front row of the 9th column from the left.
- 14. Place a tan 1x1x3 brick to the left and right of the 1x4x6 door frame.
- 15. Horizontally place 2 white 1x2x2 window frames, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the right ppp so the ridged sides face the front. Now attach a transparent light blue window pane to the front of each of the 2 ppp. Now repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 16. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick with 4 side studs on the 2nd row from the front of the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the left, so it sits on the ppp and the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Make sure they also sit on the window frames!

Group 4 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 17. Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a mint blue 2x4 tile in front of the 1x4x6 door frame on the 6th and 7th rows from the front and 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th columns from the left.
- 18. Place a nougat 1x1 brick on the back left corner so it sits on the short 1x1 brick.
- 19. Place a tan 1x1x3 brick on the leftmost column on the 2nd row from the back. Then place a tan 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the left.
- 20. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick on the back left corner so there is no overhang. Then place a tan 1x1 plate on the back row of the ppp.

- 21.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a nougat 1x5 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x4x3 brick on the back 4 rows. Now place a tan 1x1x3 brick on the front row. Then vertically place a nougat 1x5 plate on top.
- 21.2. Vertically place your part on the 9th column from the right so it sits in front of the 1x1 short brick.
- 22. Vertically place 2 tan 1x2 bricks, 1 on top of the other, on top of the back 2 rows of the 9th column from the right.
- 23. Let's make a part! Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate in front of you. Now place 2 tan 1x2x2 bricks with 2 side studs, 1 in front of the other, on top so the side studs face the left. Now vertically place your part on the 9th column from the right, in front of the 1x2 bricks so the side studs face the left.
- 24. Place a white 1x1 brick with a clip on the 9th column from the right and 4th row from the front so the clip faces the right. Now place a nougat 1x1 brick on top of the ppp.

Group 5 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 25. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x4x1 grated panel on the leftmost column on the 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th rows from the front so the wall faces the left. Now vertically place a pink 2x4 tile to the right on the 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th rows from the front.
- 26. Place a pink 1x1 brick on the 2nd column from the left and 3rd row from the front. Then place a nougat 1x1 round tile printed with brown dots on top.
- 27. Place a white 1x1x3 brick to the right of the ppp.
- 28. Vertically place the front row of a brown 4x7x7 staircase on the front left corner so the top of the staircase faces the back. Make sure the 1x2 brick part sits on the 1x2 plate.
- 29. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now place a tan 2x2 corner plate on the front right corner so it sits on top of the stair plate and it looks like the braille letter d.
- 30. Vertically place 4 light purple 1x3 tiles, 1 upright on each set of front-facing side studs of the 1x2x2 brick with 2 side studs so 1 row overhangs to the top.
- 31. Place a light purple 1x3 curved tile upright on the front-facing side studs so the rightmost column sits above the rightmost upright 1x3 tile and the curve faces the top right. Now place another 1 upright to the left so the curve faces the top left. The 2 ppp should touch the 1x3 tiles and they should form a rounded window frame! Now repeat everything symmetrically to the left.
- 32. Place a white 1x1x6 pillar on the 3rd row from the front to the left and right of the 2x4 tile that is in front of the door frame.
- 33. Vertically place the front row of a white 1x3 rounded plate on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 6 - Eniko

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 pair of legs printed with blue pants and white shoes, 1 tan torso printed with a light blue shirt and white gloves, 1 tan head printed with light brown eyes, lips, and purple splatter on her face, 1 brown hair, 1 mint blue medic hat, and 1 mint blue stethoscope. Assemble your minifigure then put the stethoscope around her neck and the hat on her hair! Now put her away while we continue the build!

Group 7 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 34. Place a tan 2x2 brick on the front right corner so there is no overhang.
- 35. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Now attach a transparent light blue cabinet door to the front so it opens to the right.
- 36. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on the front left corner so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 37. Place a light grey 2x2 tile with a stud on the rightmost column so 1 column overhangs to the right.
- 38. Vertically place a white 1x2x2 brick underneath the overhang.
- 39. Place a mint blue baby bottle, spoon, thermometer, and ice pack inside the cabinet then close it.
- 40. Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate on top so it is centered. Now place a white 1x1 round plate on the back right corner.
- 41.1. Place a light grey 2L bar with a stop on the back right 1x1 round plate. Then attach a white 2x2 tile with a sticker and a clip behind it to the ppp so the sticker faces the front left.
- 41.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the light grey 2x2 tile with a clip behind it. This sticker has a computer screen of an orange dog. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 42. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope brick printed with a number pad and a card reader on the leftmost column so it slopes to the front.
- 43. Attach a mint blue needle to the front left-facing clip so the tip faces down. Now attach a mint blue ear tool to the back left-facing clip.
- 44. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so it is horizontal and the stairs are on the left. Now vertically place your part on the 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th rows from the front on the 5th and 6th columns from the left so the 1x2 slope brick slopes to the right. Make sure to count from the leftmost column of the stairs! There should be 1 free column to the right between the ppp and the 2x4 tile.
- 45. Place a white 2x2 round plate on the front 2 rows of the 5th and 6th columns from the left.
- 46. Place a yellow 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the ppp. Then vertically place a white 1x2 slope tile printed with a scale to the right so it slopes to the right. This is a scale!

You will have an extra transparent blue 1x1 round tile. Save it for later!

Group 8 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 47. Horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate on the front row on the 9th and 10th columns from the left. Now place a nougat 1x1 round tile printed with a white paw print on the left column of the ppp. Then place a transparent blue 1x1 round tile from group 7 to the right.
- 48. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 grill tile on the 6th and 7th rows from the front and 10th column from the right.
- 49.1. Vertically place a yellow 2x4 tile with a sticker upright on the left-facing side studs that are above the ppp so it hangs 2 rows down.
- 49.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the yellow 2x4 tile. This sticker is a bulletin board with papers with different animal pictures clipped on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 50. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 brick in front of you. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on the rightmost column so the clip faces the front.
- 51. Horizontally place a white 2x3 plate on the 3 leftmost columns.
- 52. Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate on top. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 grill tile on the rightmost column.
- 53. Place a light grey 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile with a top-facing bar to the right so the bar is on the right.
- 54. Place a mint blue pen to the front-facing clip.
- 55.1. Let's make a part! Place a transparent 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round plate with a bar on top so the bar faces the right. Now attach a claw to the bar so the bar faces the right. Then attach a white bar holder with a clip to the right-facing bar so the clip faces the right and the clip hands face up and down.
- 55.2. Attach the clip of your part to the bar of the 1x2 tile with a top-facing bar so the anti-stud of the 2x2 dish faces down and to the left. This is an examination table!
- 56. Horizontally place your part on the 6th and 7th rows from the front, to the left of the 1x2 grill tile so the 2x2 tile with a stud is on the left.
- 57. Let's make a part! Horizontally place an orange 2x3 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place an orange 1x3 brick on the back row.
- 58. Horizontally place a nougat 1x3 jumper plate on the front row. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 59. Place 2 teal 1x1 round plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row.

- 60. Place 2 silver 1x1 round tiles printed with a can cap, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row on top of the ppp.
- 61.1. Horizontally place a dark blue 1x2 brick with a sticker on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the sticker faces the front.
- 61.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the dark blue 1x2 brick. This sticker has a yellow background and dog food in a light blue bowl on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 62. Place 2 light blue 1x1 double slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they slope to the front and back.
- 63. Vertically place your part on the front 3 rows of the 10th and 11th columns from the right so the 1x1 round tiles are on the left.
- 64. Place a white 1x1 round plate on the 3rd row from the front on the 4th column from the left so it sits on the rightmost column of the stairs. Then horizontally place a white 1x4x3 half arch brick on top so it arches to the right. Now stack 2 white 1x1 round plates on the leftmost column of the ppp.
- 65. Horizontally place a white 1x4x3 half arch brick on the 3rd row from the front on the 9th column from the right so it arches to the left.
- 66. Vertically place a tan 1x6 brick on the back 6 rows of the 9th column from the right. Now horizontally place 2 tan 1x6 plates, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the back row of the ppp. Now vertically place the back row of a tan 1x6 plate to the left of the ppp.

Group 10 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 67.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x10 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 67.2. Horizontally place your part on the 3rd row from the front, on top of the 2 half arch bricks so it is centered horizontally on them.
- 68.1. Horizontally place a mint blue clipboard with a bar and a sticker to the right-facing clip so the clipboard is in the back and the ridged side faces up.
- 68.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the mint blue clipboard with a bar. This sticker has an x-ray of a broken dog leg! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 69. Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the 4th row from the front so it sits on the back row of the 1x2 rounded plates and is centered horizontally to the door frame.
- 70.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a transparent yellow 1x1 round brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round plate on top. Now attach the bar of a white 1x1 round plate with a bar to the ppp so the 1x1 round plate is in the back. This is a lamp!

70.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach the 1x1 round plate of 1 part to the front row of the right 1x2 rounded plate that is on the 3rd row from the front so the 1x1 round brick is in the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

71. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front row of the 4th column from the right so the leaves face the front left. It should sit on the window sill! Then place another 1 on the front row of the 11th column from the left so the leaves face the front left. It should be on the window sill as well! Now place a yellow 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Group 11 - Pet Vet Clinic

72. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front row to the right of each of the 2 ppp so the leaves face the front right. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Group 12 - Pet Vet Clinic

73.1. Let's make a part! Place a nougat 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 plate with 2 side studs sticking up on the left column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

73.2. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 grill tile on the back row. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front right corner. Now place a transparent 1x1 round tile printed with a light blue beetle on the front left corner.

73.3. Place 2 orange 1x1 double slope tiles, 1 in front of the other, upright on the left-facing side studs so they slope up and down. This is a bird feeder!

73.4. Now rotate your main build 90 degrees clockwise so the door opens to the left. Now place your part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so it overhangs 1 column to the left and the slope tiles are on top.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 13 - Olly, Cat, and Horse

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with light green and white shoes and dark blue shorts, 1 tan torso printed with a white shirt and a red shirt wrapped around his shoulder, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes and lips, and blonde hair. Assemble your minifigure, then put him in front of you.

Sub-build 5. Locate a light grey and dark grey cat named Gertrude with a tail, ears printed with a light blue collar, and place her in front of you. Now put them both away while we make a horse!

Sub-build 6.1. Horizontally place a light grey horse named Thunder with black hair in front of you so the head faces the left. Now place a light grey 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then place a light grey 2x2 half cylinder brick on top so it slopes to the front and back.

Sub-build 6.2. Locate a teal horse saddle. You can take off the 2 ppp and place this there so the stud is on the right if you like! Now put everything away while we continue the build!

Group 14 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 74. Bring your build back so it is horizontal and the door opens to the front. Now place a white 1x1 brick on the front row on the 8th column from the left.
- 75.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 4x8 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the front. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x2 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 75.2. Place a nougat 2x2 plate on the back row to the left and right of the ppp so they overhang 1 row to the back.
- 75.3. Attach the overhang of your part to the front left corner so the leftmost column of your part aligns with the leftmost column of the build.
- 76. Place a nougat 1x1 brick with a clip on the 4th row from the front and 2nd column from the left so it sits on the front left corner of the 2x2 plate and the clip faces the front. Then place another 1 behind it so the clip faces the back. Then vertically place a nougat 1x2 masonry brick on the 4th and 5th rows from the front and 7th column from the left so the brick grooves face the right. It should sit on the right column of the 2x2 plate.
- 77. Vertically place a nougat 1x2x2 brick on top of the ppp. Then place a nougat 1x1x5 brick to the right of the back row of the ppp.
- 78.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a nougat 1x2 masonry brick in front of you so the brick grooves face the left. Now place 2 nougat 1x1 bricks with a clip, 1 in front of the other, on top so the clips face the front and back.
- 78.2. Vertically place your part on top of the 2nd column from the left, on top of the 1x1 bricks with a clip.
- 79. Vertically place a nougat 1x2 masonry brick on top of the ppp so the brick grooves face the left. Now vertically place another 1 on the 7th column from the left, on top of the 1x2x2 brick so the brick grooves face the right.
- 80. Horizontally place 2 nougat 1x6x2 arch bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top of the 2 ppp.
- 81. Place 2 white 1x1 round bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the back left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x4x2 fence in front. Now place a white 1x1 round brick in front. Then place a white 1x1 brick in front.
- 82. Place a white 1x1 round brick in front and behind the 1x4x2 fence.
- 83. Vertically place an orange 1x6 tile on the leftmost column on top of the fence and 1x1 round bricks so it is centered vertically on the fence. Now place a nougat 1x1x5 brick in front of the ppp.
- 84. Place a white 1x1x6 pillar on the leftmost column in front of the ppp. Then place another on the front row of the front on the 8th column from the left.
- 85. Vertically place the front row of a white 1x2 rounded plate on top of each of the 2 ppp.
- 86. Vertically place an orange 2x3 plate on the 4th and 5th columns from the left, on top of the arch bricks so it overhangs 1 row to the front.

87. Place an orange 3x3 quarter circle plate to the left and right of the ppp so the curves face the front left and front right respectively and they overhang 1 row to the front.

Group 15 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 88. Horizontally place a tan 1x6 tile to the left of the front row of the 2x2 brick that is on the front right corner. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left. Now vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs behind the rightmost column of the 2 ppp. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 behind the ppp so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate to the left. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 tile to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs in front of the leftmost column of the ppp.
- 89. Horizontally place 2 light blue 1x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 8 leftmost columns of the 4th row from the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x10 plate behind it so there is no overhang.
- 90. Place a light blue 2x2 corner slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns on top of the 2 ppp so it slopes to the front left. Then place 2 light blue 2x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, to the right so they slope to the front. Now place a light blue 2x2 corner slope brick to the right so it slopes to the front right.
- 91. Horizontally attach the bars of a light purple 4x5 gate with 3 studs to the 2 leftmost front-facing clips so the door is on the right and the studs face the front. Now place a transparent 1x1 round tile printed with a red ladybug on the rightmost front-facing side stud of the ppp.
- 92. Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x2 ridged brick on the 7th and 8th columns from the right and 7th row from the front so the vertical ridges face the front. Then horizontally place another 1 on top so the vertical ridges face the front.
- 93. Insert a pink brush into the 1x1 round brick that is on the front right corner so the bristles face the front. Then place a brown 1x1 swirl on the front row on the 3rd column from the right. This is a poop!
- 94. Attach a brown pitchfork to the 2 rightmost front-facing clips so the 3 tips face up. Then place a nougat 2x2 brick on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front and 7th and 8th columns from the right. Now place a tan 2x2 tile with a stud on top.
- 95. Place a teal 2x2 saddle on top of the ppp so the stud is on the right.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 16 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 96. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 6x14 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a nougat 1x2 plate with a stud and a clip on the back right corner so the clip is on the right.
- 97. Horizontally place a light nougat 1x2 plate with a stud and a clip on the 2 rightmost columns in front of the ppp so the clip is on the right.
- 98. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the back 2 rows of the 2nd column from the right. Then vertically place another 1 on top.

- 99. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the back left corner so the side studs face the back. Then horizontally place another 1 on the back row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so the side studs face the back.
- 100. Place a tan 1x1 brick on the back row on the 3rd column from the left. Then horizontally place 3 tan 1x2x3 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp. Now place a tan 1x1 brick to the right.
- 101. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 panel with a window on the back row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the wall faces the back. Now horizontally place another 1 on the back row on the 4th and 5th columns from the right so the wall faces the back. Then attach a transparent light blue window pane to the front of each of them.
- 102.1. Place a light blue 1x1 tile on the rightmost column in front of the clips. Then place another 1 on the rightmost column on the 2nd row from the front. Now place 1 more on the 2nd column from the right on the 3rd row from the front.

You will have 4 extra light blue 1x1 tiles. Save them for later!

- 102.2. Place a pink 1x1 tile on the front right corner. Then place another 1 on the rightmost column on the 3rd row from the front. Now place 1 more on the 2nd column from the right on the 4th row from the front. Then vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows of the 2nd column from the right.
- 103. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 brick on the 2nd row from the back of the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Then horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 jumper plate on top of the ppp.
- 104. Vertically place a white 2x4 brick on the front 4 rows of the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Then vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows to the left of the ppp. Then place a pink 1x1 tile behind the ppp. Now place a light blue 1x1 tile from group 16 behind the ppp. Now place a pink 1x1 tile behind the ppp.
- 105.1. Place a light blue 1x1 tile from group 16 on the front row on the 6th column from the right. Now place a pink 1x1 tile behind the ppp. Then place a light blue 1x1 tile from group 16 behind the ppp.
- 105.2. Place a pink 1x1 tile on the front row on the 7th column from the right. Now place a light blue 1x1 tile behind the ppp. Then place a pink 1x1 tile behind the ppp. Now place a black 2x2 plate behind the ppp on the 6th and 7th columns from the right.
- 106.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a mint blue 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a transparent light blue 1x2 panel on the back right corner so the wall faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a transparent light blue 1x2 panel with 3 walls in front so the wall faces the front.
- 106.2. Vertically place your part on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right, in front of the 1x2 jumper plate.

You will have an extra white 1x1 round tile. Save it for later!

Group 18 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 107. Place a light blue 1x1 round plate on the front row on the 4th column from the right. Then place a white 1x1 round tile from group 17 on top. Now place a transparent purple 1x1 round brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a light purple 1x1 round tile on top.
- 108.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a white 2x3 plate with a round side and a hole in front of you so the hole faces the front. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the back row. Then horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 jumper plate on top. Now place a white 2x2 tile with a round side on the front 2 rows so the round side faces the front. This is a toilet!
- 108.2. Vertically place your part on top of the 2x2 plate that is on the 6th and 7th columns from the right so the round side faces the front.
- 109. Place a tan 1x1x3 brick on the 2nd row from the back and 7th column from the left. Now vertically place a tan 1x2x3 slope brick in front so it slopes to the front.
- 110. Place 2 nougat 1x1 round plates, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back. Then place 2 more, 1 in front of the other, on the 6th column from the left, on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back.
- 111. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a nougat 2x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the rightmost column.
- 112. Place a white 2x2 sloped curved tile on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the left.
- 113.1. Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 tile with a sticker on the 4 leftmost columns.
- 113.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the dark blue 2x4 tile. This sticker is a blanket and has lots of cat faces on it and a green book about ants! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 114. Horizontally place your part on the 6 leftmost columns on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back so it sits on the 1x1 round plates and the 2x4 tile is on the left.
- 115.1. Horizontally place a yellow 2x4 rounded tile with a sticker on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front and 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the left.
- 115.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the yellow 2x4 rounded tile. This sticker is a dark orange rug with 2 dog faces! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 116. Place a tan 1x1 plate on the back row on the 4th column from the right. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 plate to the left of the ppp. Now vertically place a tan 1x3 plate to the left of the ppp so there is no overhang.
- 117. Place a tan 1x1 plate on the back row on the 2nd column from the left. Then horizontally place a tan 2x4 plate to the right of the ppp so it overhangs 1 row to the front.

- 118. Place a gold 1x1 faucet on top of the rightmost jumper plate that is on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right and 2nd row from the back so the bar faces the front. This is a bathtub!
- 119. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope brick on the back row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick to the right. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope brick to the right so it slopes to the right.
- 120. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope brick on the back row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on 2 sides to the right so the side studs face the front and back. Now horizontally place an orange 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the right so the side studs face the back. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope brick to the right so it slopes to the right.
- 121.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate on top. Now place an orange 2x2 round tile upright on the front-facing side studs.
- 121.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the orange 2x2 round tile. This sticker is a plant and lotion on a shelf on it! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 121.3. Vertically place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 7th column from the left so the 2x2 round tile faces the right.
- 122. Place a tan 1x1 brick on the front row of the ppp. Then place the right column of a tan 2x2 corner brick behind it so it looks like the braille letter d. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope brick to the left and right of the back row of the ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right.
- 123.1. Vertically place a pink 2x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side studs so it hangs 2 rows down.
- 123.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the pink 2x3 tile. This sticker is of a light purple flamingo and a blue bird! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 124.1. Let's make a part! Place a transparent 1x1 round brick in front of you. Then place a green bar with 3 tips on top. Now place a yellow 1x1 round flower plate on the front-facing tip.
- 124.2. Place your part on the 2nd row from the back on the 4th column from the left.
- 125. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row on top of the 1x2 slope bricks so they slope outwards to the left and right.
- 126. Place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back, in front of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the left.
- 127. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 double slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top of the ppp so they slope to the left and right. Now horizontally place 1 more behind it so it slopes to the left and right.

- 128. Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so it is horizontal and the stairs are on the left. Now horizontally place the leftmost column of your part on the front 6 rows on the 4th column from the left so there is no overhang on the sides.
- 129. Horizontally place 2 nougat 1x2 plates with a stud and a clip, 1 in front of the other, on the back left corner so the clips are on the left.
- 130. Vertically stack 2 white 1x2 plates on top of your 2 ppp so there is no overhang.
- 131.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope brick in front of you so it slopes to the left. Then place a tan 1x1 plate on top. Now place a tan 1x1 slope tile on top so it slopes to the left.
- 131.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Then horizontally place 1 on the front right corner to the left of the clips so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left so it sits to the left of the 1x2x2 panel with a window.
- 132. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the rightmost front-facing side stud so the leaves face the right. Then place a yellow 1x1 round flower plate upright to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

133. Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate upright on each of the 1x1 round plates with 3 leaves from the previous step.

Group 22 - Pet Vet Clinic

- 134. Horizontally place 2 orange 3x3 quarter circle plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th rows from the front so they are centered horizontally on the 1x6 plates and 1x1 round plate with a bar and curve to the front left and front right.
- 135. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 window frame on the back row of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side with ridges faces the front. Then horizontally place a yellow 2x3 plate to the left and right so they overhang 1 column outwards to the left and right.
- 136. Place a yellow 1x1 brick to the left and right of the 1x2x2 window frame from the previous step.
- 137. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 jumper plate on the 2nd row from the front on top of the 2 3x3 quarter circle plates so it is centered horizontally on them. Then place a yellow 1x1 quarter circle tile to the left so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 138. Place a white 1x1 round brick with a side stud behind each of the 1x1 quarter circle tiles from the previous step so the side studs face the front. Now place a light blue 2x2 plate to the right of the right ppp so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

- 139. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 window frame on the 3rd row from the front, behind the 1x2 jumper plate so the side with ridges faces the front. Then place a blue 1x1 round plate to the left and right so they sit on the 1x1 round brick with a side stud.
- 140. Vertically place a blue 1x2 plate on top of each of the 1x1 round plates from the previous step so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place another 1 between the back row of them.
- 141. Place a light blue 2x2 slope brick to the right of the right vertical 1x2 plate from the previous step so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 142. Place a light blue 2x2 slope brick on the right ppp and 1x2 plate so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate in between the back row of the 2 ppp. Then place 2 white 1x1 round bricks with a side stud, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so the side studs face the front.
- 143. Place 2 light blue 2x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of all the ppp from the previous step so they slope outwards to the left and right.
- 144. Place a light purple 1x1 tile upright on the right front-facing side stud that is behind a 1x1 quarter circle tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now place 2 light purple 1x2 curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright above the 2 ppp so the curves face the top left and top right.
- 145. Place a red 1x1 bird on the 1x2 jumper plate that is in front of the ppp.
- 146. Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's make the roofs! Horizontally place a light blue 4x6 tile with 3 sides of studs upside down in front of you so the tile side faces the back. Now place a tan 2x2 plate with a bar on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the bar is on the left.
- 147. Place a tan 2x2 inverted sloped curved tile on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it is centered vertically and slopes to the right.
- 148. Horizontally place an orange 1x10 plate on the front row so 4 columns overhang to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 149. Horizontally place a light blue 4x6 tile with 3 sides of studs upside down underneath the 4 rightmost columns of overhang so the tile side faces the back.
- 150. Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate to the right of the 2x2 inverted sloped curved tile so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place an orange 1x4 plate on the 2nd column from the right.
- 151. Vertically place 2 orange 1x2 plates with a rail, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so the rails face the right.
- 152. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally attach the bar of 1 part to the 2 rightmost clips so the stud side faces up and it slopes to the right. Make sure it is sitting on all the slope bricks! Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 153.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a white 4x4 rounded tile with a sticker on top so it is centered vertically.

- 153.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the white 4x4 rounded tile. This sticker is a heart made up of a purple horse, orange dog, and blue cat! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 153.3. Place your part upright on the 1x4 front-facing side studs that are underneath the roof so it hangs 1 row down.

Group 24 - Sunflower

- 154. Let's make a part! Let's make a sunflower! Place a green 4x4 round plate in front of you.
- 155. Place a dark green 1x1 round plate on the front stud of the rightmost column. Then place a light grey 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar to the left.
- 156. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves to the left of the ppp so the leaves face the front left. Then place another 1 behind the 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar so the leaves face the back right.
- 157. Place a green 4L bar on the right 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves.
- 158. Place a green bar with a stud on each end on top of the 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar.
- 159. Place a green 1x1 round plate with a bent bar on top of the rightmost 1x1 round plate so the stud faces the front right. Now place a purple 1x1 butterfly on top of the ppp.
- 160. Place a green bar with a stud on each end on top of the 4L bar. Now place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on top so the leaves face the back right.
- 161. Place a green 1x1 round plate with a bent bar on top of the bar with a stud on each end that is on the 2nd row from the front so the stud faces the front. Now place a yellow flower on top of the ppp. Then place a brown 1x1 round tile on top of the ppp. This is a sunflower!
- 162.1. Let's make a part! Place a dark green 1x1 round plate with a bar in front of you so the bar faces the front. Now place a yellow flower on top. Then place a brown 1x1 round tile on top.
- 162.2. Attach the bar of your part to the 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves that is on top of a bar with a stud on each end so the 1x1 round tile faces the front.
- 163. Place a brown 5L L-shaped bar on the leftmost 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves so the short bar faces the left.
- 164.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown 2x2 inverted sloped curved plate in front of you so the higher side is in the front. Now horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the back row so the clip faces the back. Then vertically place a white 2x3 tile with a sticker on top so it overhangs 1 row to the front.
- 164.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 11 on the white 2x3 tile. This sticker has a cute white bunny holding a carrot sign that says open! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

164.3. Attach the clip of your part to the short bar of the 5L L-shaped bar so the tile faces the front. Now place this next to the main build!

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
