Girls and boys then join Tom Nook for tea at Rosie the cat's house, which is also full of familiar elements.

Little builders rearrange the modular baseplates and move around the accessories to make the buildings look however they choose. With so many role-play and rebuild options, this customizable building toy lets kids spend time relaxing and being creative on their own or with parents and friends.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/77050>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 7 bags labeled 1 to 7, 2 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Rosie

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 short light blue pair of legs, 1 light blue tail, 1 light blue torso printed with a pink shirt with purple, magenta, light blue, pink, and yellow squares, 1 light blue head with 2 pointy ears printed with black eyes, pink cheeks, blue hair, and a magenta mouth, and 1 light orange bowtie. Assemble your minifigure, make sure the tail is in the back and sticks up, then attach the bowtie to the top of her head. Now put her away while we make an orange tree!

Group 2 - Orange Tree

1. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.
2. Place a light green 6x6 rounded plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.
3. Place a green 1x1 round plate on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the left of the 6x6 rounded plate. Then place a brown 2x2 round brick with roots on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right and 2nd and 3rd rows from the back.
4. Stack 2 brown 2x2 round bricks on top of the ppp so there is no overhang.
5. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a green 2x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.
6. Place a green 1x2 plate with a 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
7. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

8. Horizontally place 2 green 1x2x1 panels, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally and the walls face the back.

9. Vertically place a green 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

10. Horizontally place a green 1x2x1 panel on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the front. Then place a green 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

11. Place a brown stem on top of the panels. It should not attach to any studs! This is a stick!

12.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a green 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 brick with a side stud in front of the ppp so the side stud faces the front.

12.2. Horizontally place your part on top of your previous part so it is centered horizontally and vertically and the side stud faces the front.

13. Place an orange ball upright on each of the 3 front-facing side studs. These are the oranges!

14. Horizontally place your part on top of the 2x2 round bricks of your previous part so it is centered horizontally and the balls face the front.

15. Place a white 1x1 cone brick on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the right of the 6x6 rounded plate. Now place a red 1x1 dome brick on top. This is a mushroom!

16. Place a green plant with 3 stems on top of the 1x1 round plate that is on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the left of the 6x6 rounded plate. Now stack 2 pink 1x1 round flower plates on top of each of the stems! Now put your orange tree away while we make the outdoor dining set!

Group 3 - Outdoor Dining Set

There are no instructions in this group. You will have 3 extra pink 2x2 round plates and 1 tan 1x1 round tile printed with a pie. Save them for later!

Group 4 - Outdoor Dining Set

1.1. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.

1.2. Place a light green 6x6 rounded plate on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a stud and a hinge on the back row so it is centered horizontally to the 6x6 rounded plate and the hinge is on the left.

1.3. Place a white 2x2 round plate on the front 2 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right of the 6x6 rounded plate. Then place another 1 on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right of the 6x6 rounded plate.

1.4. Place a pink 2x2 round plate from group 3 on top of each of the 2 ppp.

2. Attach an axle connector with a hinge connector to the hinge on the back row so the axle connector faces up. Now insert the stop side of a white 5L bar with a stop into the axle connector. Then place a transparent pink umbrella on top.

3. Place a pink 2x2 round plate from group 3 on the 2 leftmost columns and 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Then place a white 2x2 round brick on top.

4.1. Let's make a part! Place a dark purple 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a tan 1x1 round tile printed with a pie from group 3 on the front row of the rightmost column.

4.2. Place a tan 1x1 round tile printed with white frosting and sprinkles on the 2nd row from the back and 2nd column from the right. Now place a white 1x1 tea cup on the left column of the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Then place a white tea pot on the front row of the leftmost column so the spout faces the front.

4.3. Place your part on the 2x2 round brick that is on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered on it. Now put your dining set away while we make a bicycle!

Group 5 - Bicycle and Grass

Sub-build 2. Horizontally place a blue bicycle base in front of you so the side stud faces the right. Now attach a black and light grey wheel to the bottom left and bottom right clips. Insert the wheels into the gaps and make sure they click into place! Now place a transparent yellow 1x1 round plate upright on the right-facing side stud. Now put your bicycle away while we make some grass!

Sub-build 3. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a light green 6x6 rounded plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically. Now put it away while we make Rosie's house!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 6 - Rosie's House

1. Horizontally place a light purple 8x16 plate with 1x4 gaps on the sides in front of you.

2.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light green 4x8 plate with a round side and a gap in front of you so the round side faces the back. Now horizontally place a green 1x8 plate on the 2nd row from the front.

2.2. Horizontally place a light purple 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a light purple 2x4 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

2.3. Horizontally place the front overhang of your part in the back left 1x4 gap of the 8x16 plate so the round side faces the back.

3.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light green 4x8 plate with a round side and a gap in front of you so the round side faces the back. Now horizontally place a green 1x8 plate on the 2nd row from the front.

3.2. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

3.3. Horizontally place the front overhang of your part in the back right 1x4 gap of the 8x16 plate so the round side faces the back.

4. Place a light green 4x4 plate on the rightmost column in the 1x4 gap so it overhangs 3 columns to the right. Now vertically place a green 3x4 plate with a higher rounded side underneath the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp so the rounded side is exposed to the right. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the left.

5. Horizontally place a light purple 1x4 tile on the front row in each of the 1x4 gaps.

6. Vertically place a white 1x6 brick on the front 6 rows, on the 5th column from the left. Then place a white 1x1 brick behind the ppp.

7. Place a white 1x1x5 brick behind the ppp. Then place the left column of a white 1x2 curved brick behind the ppp so the curve faces the back left.

8. Place a white 1x1 brick on the 3rd row from the back, to the right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a white 1x4x6 door frame to the right of the ppp so the ridges face the back. Now place another white 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp.

9. Place the back row of a white 1x2 curved brick to the right of the ppp so the curve faces the back right. Now place a white 1x1 brick in front of the right column of the ppp. Then horizontally place the leftmost column of a white 1x6 brick in front of the ppp.

10. Vertically place a white 1x4 brick on the front 4 rows on the 5th column from the right. Then place a white 1x1 brick behind the ppp. Now vertically place a white 1x2 brick behind the ppp.

11. Place a white 1x1x5 brick to the left of the 1x4x6 door frame. Then place a white 1x2x5 curved panel to the left so the curve faces the back left and there is no overhang. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right of the door frame.

12. Vertically place a white 1x2x5 brick in front of the right column of the right 1x2x5 curved panel.

Group 8 - Rosie's House

13.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the back. Now place a light grey 1x1 plate to the left and right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the front row.

13.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 on the 5th column from the left, in front of the 1x1x5 brick so the 2x4 plate overhangs 1 column to the left. Then horizontally place the other 1 on the 7th row from the front, and 5th - 10th columns from the right so it sits to the right of the 1x2x5 brick and the 2x4 plate overhangs to the back.

14. Place a white 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column of the front row so it slopes to the front. Then place a white 1x1 brick behind the ppp. Now place another 1 behind the ppp so there are 4 free rows in between them.

15. Vertically place a white 1x6x2 arch brick on top of the 2 ppp.

16. Vertically place a white 1x4 brick on the front 4 rows of the ppp. Then vertically place a white 2x3 brick behind the ppp so 1 column overhangs to the right.

17. Place a white 1x1 slope tile on the rightmost column of the front row so it slopes to the front. Then place a white 1x1 brick behind the ppp. Now vertically place a white 1x4 brick behind the ppp.

18. Vertically place a white 1x4 brick on the 5th column from the right, behind the 1x1 slope tile from the previous step. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick behind the ppp. Now place a white 1x1 brick to the right of the front row of the 1x2x5 brick that is from step 12.

19. Place a white 1x1 brick on the rightmost column of the 2nd row from the front so it sits behind the 1x1 slope tile. Then vertically place a white 1x4 brick behind the ppp. Now horizontally place the rightmost column of a white 1x6x2 arch brick behind the ppp.

20. Place a white 1x1 brick in front of the rightmost column of the ppp. Now vertically place a white 1x4 brick in front of the ppp.

21. Vertically place a white 1x6 brick on the 5th column from the right, on top of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 brick to the left of the back row of the ppp. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with 2 side studs on the sides to the left of the ppp so the side stud faces the front and back.

22.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light brown 1x6x6 curved door frame in front of you so the clips face the front. Now attach a magenta rounded door with a window and bars to the front-facing clips so the door is on the left and the side stud faces the front. Now place a silver 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud.

22.2. Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place your part on the 3rd to 8th columns from the right of the 2nd row from the front so the door opens to the front. Make sure it is centered horizontally in front of the 1x4x6 door frame.

23. Place a light brown 2x2 plate on top of the ppp so there is no overhang.

24. Place a white 1x1 plate to the right of the back row of the ppp. Then place the front row of a white 3x3 quarter circle plate to the right so the curve faces the front right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left of the previous 2x2 plate.

25. Place a white 1x1 plate on the 6th row from the front and 7th column from the left of the build. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 plate to the right of the ppp.

Group 9 - Rosie's House

26. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile on the 6th row from the front and 7th to 10th columns from the left, so it sits on top of the 2 ppp. Now vertically place the back row of a white 1x2 tile to the right of the ppp. Then place the left column of a white 1x2 curved tile in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Now horizontally place a white 1x6 tile to the right of the front row of the ppp. Then place another white 1x2 curved tile to the right so the curve faces the front right. Then place a white 1x1 tile behind the right column of the ppp.

27. Place a white 2x2 round plate to the back left of the 1x2 curved tile that is in the front right corner from the previous step so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

28. Insert the bar of a black 1x1 round plate with a bar into the front-facing side stud that is to the left of the door so the anti-stud faces down. Now attach a transparent yellow 1x1 brick to the anti-stud of the ppp. Then attach a black 1x1 round plate to the anti-stud of the ppp. This is a light!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 10 - Rosie's House

29.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a lamp! Place a white 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a transparent yellow 2x2 round brick on top.

29.2. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tri slope tile on the back row so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now place a white lamp post underneath the part.

29.3. Now place your part on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of the build so it is centered vertically on it.

Group 11 - Rosie's House

30.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a mailbox! Place a light grey 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then place a light grey 2x2x2 cabinet on top so the opening faces the front. Now attach a light grey cabinet door to the front, then close it!

30.2. Vertically insert a white 1x2 tile printed with an envelope with a red seal into the front-facing slot of the ppp.

30.3. Place your part on the 2 leftmost columns of the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so the mailbox opens to the front.

31.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate in front of you. Then place a tan 2x2 brick on top so it is centered horizontally.

31.2. Place a tan 2x2 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place 2 tan 2x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they slope outwards to the left and right. Now horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 double slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top.

31.3. Vertically place your part on the 5th and 6th columns from the left, in front of the back row so it overhangs 1 column to the right. The front row should sit to the left of a 1x4 tile. This is part of the roof!

You will have an extra tan 2x2 brick. Save it for later!

Group 12 - Rosie's House

32.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate in front of you. Then place a tan 2x2 brick from group 11 on top so it is centered horizontally.

32.2. Place a tan 2x2 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the left. Then place a light grey 2x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns.

32.3. Place a light grey 2x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick to the left of the ppp. Now place a tan 2x2 slope brick to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left.

32.4. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns so the brick grooves face the front and back. Now place 2 tan 1x2 double slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the 2 ppp.

32.5. Vertically place 2 light grey 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns so the brick grooves face outwards to the left and right. Now place a dark grey 2x2 round tile with a stud on top of the 2 ppp.

33.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x2 inverted sloped curved tile in front of you so the higher side is on the right. Now place a light grey 1x1 round tile with a bar on the leftmost stud so the bar faces the left. Now horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of a 3x5 cloud plate on top so it is centered vertically.

33.2. Place the bar of your part on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud so the studs of the cloud plate face the left.

34. Vertically place your part on the 5th and 6th columns from the right, on the 2nd to 7th rows from the back so it overhangs 1 column to the left and the studs of the cloud plate face the front. This is part of the roof and it has a chimney!

35. Let's make a part! Let's make a roof! Horizontally place a tan 2x16 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 2x4 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so 2 rows overhang to the front.

36. Horizontally place a tan 2x16 plate underneath the overhang so it is aligned with the previous 2x16 plate.

37. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile on the back row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Then place a tan 2x2 plate on the back 2 rows to the left of the ppp. Now vertically place 2 white 1x2 plates with a stud and a clip, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 2 rows, on the 5th and 6th columns from the right so the clips are in the front.

38. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile on the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 2x4 plate to the right. Now horizontally place another tan 1x2 tile on the back row to the right of the ppp. Then vertically place a tan 2x4 plate to the right. Now horizontally place 1 more tan 1x2 tile on the back row to the right of the ppp.

Group 13 - Rosie's House

39. Horizontally place 4 light nougat 1x2 tiles with a round side on top, 1 in front of each of the 1x2 tiles so the round side faces the front.

40. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 sloped curved tile on the 2nd row from the front, on the 4th to 7th columns from the right. Now place a tan 1x1 tile to the left and right of the ppp.

41.1. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile with a round side on the front left corner so the round side faces the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile behind the ppp. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile with a round side on the front row, on the 5th and 6th columns from the left, so the round side faces the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile behind the ppp.

41.2. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile with a round side on the front row to the left and right of the 2 clips so the round sides face the front.

You will have 4 extra tan 1x2 tiles with a round side. Save them for later!

Group 14 - Rosie's House

42.1. Horizontally place 4 tan 1x2 tiles on the back row, to the right of each of the 1x2 tiles. There should be 2 columns in between each of them. Now horizontally place 4 tan 1x2 tiles with a round side from group 13 on top, 1 in front of each of the 4 ppp so the round sides face the front.

42.2. Horizontally place a light nougat 1x2 tile with a round side on the front right corner so the round side faces the front. Then horizontally place another 1 on the front row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so the round side faces the front. Now horizontally place 1 more on the front row on the 5th and 6th columns from the left so the round side faces the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile behind each of the 3 ppp. There should be no more exposed studs on top!

43. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a tan 1x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x1 plate with a 1x1 slope tile on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

44. Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and 1 row overhangs to the front.

Group 15 - Rosie's House

45. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a white 1x1 plate with a 1x1 slope tile underneath the front left corner so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

46. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the bar faces the back. Now horizontally place a tan 1x3 plate to the left and right of the ppp.

Group 16 - Rosie's House

47. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

48. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x4 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right.

49. Horizontally place 2 white 1x3 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right.

50. Now horizontally attach the back-facing bar of your part to the 2 clips on the front row of your previous part.

51. Bring back your main build and make sure it is horizontal and the door faces the front. Now horizontally place the front row of your part on the 1x6 tile that is on the 3rd row from the back, behind the 1x6x6 curved door frame so it is centered horizontally to it. Make sure the roof is slanted and sits on the slope bricks. There should be no overhang on the leftmost and rightmost columns!

52. Vertically place a light brown 1x4x3 rounded window frame on the 5th column from the right, on the 1x4 overhang part so the window faces the left. Then horizontally place another 1 on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th columns from the left of the 5th row from the front. Make sure it sits on the 1x4 overhang part and the window faces the back. Now locate 2 pink 1x4x3 square window frames. You can switch these out with the 2 ppp if you like!

53. Place a green 1x1 round plate on the 2nd column from the right of the build on the 2nd row from the front.

54. Place a green plant with 3 stems on top of the ppp. Now place a pink flower on top of each of the stems.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 17 - Interior

55. Rotate your main build 180 degrees. Now place a white 2x2 tile printed with a pink bunny and a blue bunny upright on the front-facing side stud so it hangs 1 row down and 1 column to the left.

1. Let's make a part! Let's make a couch! Horizontally place a tan 1x4 arch brick in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 2x3 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so 2 rows overhang to the front.

2. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 arch brick underneath the front row so 2 columns are exposed to the right.
3. Vertically place a pink 2x3 plate on the 2 rightmost column so it is centered vertically.
4. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate on the back row. Now place a pink 2x2 plate on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
5. Vertically place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick on the front left corner so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 2 pink 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally and slope to the front. Now put your couch away while we make another part!

Group 18 - Interior

1. Let's make a table with a plant! Place a pink 2x2 brick in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud on top.
2. Place a white 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top. Then place a white 1x1 cone brick on top so the anti-stud faces up.
3. Place a green stem with 3 leaves on top. Then place a pink flower with a bar on top. Now put your part away while we make a bed!

Group 19 - Interior

1. Horizontally place a tan 4x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the rightmost column.
2. Vertically place a white 2x4 plate on the 2 leftmost columns. Then vertically place a white 1x4 plate to the right. Now vertically place a white 2x4 plate to the right.
3. Horizontally place a tan 1x6 arch brick underneath the front row. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
4. Place a tan 1x1 brick on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the 2 ppp.
5. Vertically place a white 1x4 half cylinder brick on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically.
- 6.1. Place a pink 1x1 tile on the back left corner. Then place another 1 on the back row on the 3rd column from the left. Place 1 more on the leftmost column on the 2nd row from the front. Then place another 1 on the 2nd row from the front and 3rd column from the left.

Group 20 - Interior

- 6.2. Place a light yellow 1x1 tile on the front row on the 4th column from the left. Then place another 1 on the front row on the 2nd column from the left. Now place 1 more on the 2nd row from the back and 2nd column from the left. Then place 1 more on the 2nd row from the back on the 4th column from the left.

Group 21 - Interior

6.3. Place a magenta 1x1 tile on the front left corner. Then place 1 on the leftmost column on the 2nd row from the back. Now place 1 more on the front row on the 3rd column from the left. Then place 1 more on the 2nd row from the back and 3rd column from the left.

Group 22 - Interior.

6.4. Place 4 bright pink 1x1 tiles on the 4 leftmost columns so they fill in the rest of the studs! Now put away your bed while we make an oven and stove!

Group 23 - Interior

1. Place a black 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2x2 cabinet on top so the opening faces the front.

2. Place a white 2x2 plate on top.

3. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 grill tile on the rightmost column. Then vertically place a black 1x2 rounded plate on the leftmost column.

4. Place a silver pan on the front left corner so the bar faces the left. Now attach a transparent cabinet door to the front and leave it open.

5. Let's make a part! Place a white 1x1 swirl on top of a dark grey 1x2 jumper plate. Now vertically insert your part inside the cabinet, then close it! This is a pastry in the oven!

6. Let's make a part! Let's make a mug on a table! Place a white 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Now place a pink mug on top so the handle faces the front.

7. Let's make another part! Place a white 5L antenna in front of you so the bar faces up. Then place a transparent pink 2x2 dome brick on top so the stud faces up. This is a lamp! Now you can use all the parts you made and arrange the house however you want! You can put the parts anywhere you like! Now put everything away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 2):

Group 24 - Tom Nook

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 short tan pair of legs, 1 light brown tail with black wavy stripes, 1 light brown torso printed with a white shirt printed with light blue leaves, 1 light brown and brown head printed with pin ears and light blue eyes, and 1 gold party hat. Assemble your minifigure, make sure the tail is in the back and sticks upward, then place your hat on top of his head! Now put him away while we make Nook's Cranny!

Group 25 - Nook's Cranny

1. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you.

2. Vertically place the 2 rightmost columns of a light green 4x8 plate with a round side and a gap on top of the middle 2 columns of the ppp so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the right.

3. Vertically place a nougat 1x8 plate on the 2nd column from the left so it is centered vertically.

Group 26 - Nook's Cranny

4. Vertically place a nougat 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a nougat 2x4 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and 1 column overhangs to the left.

5. Horizontally place a nougat 8x16 plate with 1x4 gaps on the sides, underneath the overhang so it is centered vertically.

6. Horizontally place a nougat 1x4 tile on the back row in each of the 1x4 gaps.

7.1. Let's make 3 identical parts! Horizontally place a light green 4x8 plate with a round side and a gap in front of you so the round side faces the back. Now horizontally place a nougat 1x8 plate on the 2nd row from the front.

7.2. Horizontally place a nougat 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a nougat 2x4 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

7.3. Now you should have 3 identical parts! Rotate 1 part 180 degrees so the overhang faces the back. Now horizontally place the overhang on the front row in the left 1x4 gap so the round side faces the front. Now repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place the overhang of 1 part on the leftmost column in the 1x4 gap so the round side faces the left.

8. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick on the back 2 rows on the 3rd column from the right of the 4x8 plate with a rounded side. Then vertically place a tan 1x6 brick in front of the ppp. Now horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick to the left of the front row of the ppp.

9. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick on the 5th and 6th rows from the front, to the left of the ppp.

10. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x6 door frame to the left of the back row of the ppp so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach a dark red door to the front of the ppp so it opens to the right. Now place a dark grey 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud of the ppp.

11. Horizontally place the 4 rightmost columns of 2 brown 1x8 tiles, 1 in front of the other, in front of the previous 1x4x6 door frame.

12. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x6 door frame to the left of the 1x4x6 door frame so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach a dark red door to the front of the ppp so it opens to the left. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud of the ppp.

13. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick on the back 2 rows and 3rd column from the left. Then vertically place a tan 1x6 brick in front of the ppp. Now horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick to the right of the front row of the ppp. Then vertically place the front row of a tan 1x2 brick to the right of the ppp.

14. Place a tan 1x1 slope tile on the back row on the 3rd column from the left so it slopes to the back. Now place a tan 1x1x5 brick in front of the ppp. Place a tan 1x1 slope tile on the 3rd row from the right of the back row so it slopes to the back. Then place a tan 1x1x5 brick in front of the ppp.

15. Vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the 3rd column from the left, in front of the 1x1x5 brick. Then vertically place a transparent 1x4x3 panel on top of the ppp so the wall faces the left. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on top. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

16. Vertically place a tan 1x2x5 brick on the front 2 rows of the 3rd column from the left so it sits in front of the 1x4x3 panel. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place 2 tan 1x2x5 bricks to the left and right of the 2 1x4x6 door frames so there is no overhang.

17.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a transparent 1x4x3 panel on top so the wall faces the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick on top.

17.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 part on the 5th row from the front, on the 4th to 7th columns from the left so it sits in between the 1x2x5 bricks and the wall faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

18. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top of the 2 1x4x6 door frames so it is centered horizontally on them and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick to the left and right of the ppp.

19. Vertically place a tan 1x6 brick on the 3rd column from the left, in front of the 1x1 slope tile that is on the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the right so it also sits in front of the 1x1 slope tile.

20. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the 5th row from the front and 5th and 6th columns from the left so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick to the left and right of the ppp. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right so there is no overhang.

Group 27 - Nook's Cranny

21.1. Vertically place a tan 1x6 plate on the 3rd column from the left, in front of the 1x1 slope tile that is on the back row. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 plate in front of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate behind the rightmost column of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a tan 1x6 plate to the right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate to the right of the ppp.

21.2. Vertically place a tan 1x6 plate on the 4th column from the right, in front of the 1x1 slope tile that is on the back row. Then horizontally place a tan 1x6 plate in front of the ppp so there is no overhang.

22. Vertically place a white 1x4 plate on the 3rd column from the left, in front of the 1x1 slope tile that is on the back row. Then vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a stud and a clip in front of the ppp so the clip is in the front. Now repeat symmetrically to the right so they also sit in front of the 1x1 slope tile.

23. Vertically place a blue 1x2 slope brick on the 3rd column from the left, in front of the 1x1 slope tile that is on the back row so it slopes to the back. Then place a blue 1x1 brick in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a blue 1x2 slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right so they also sit in front of the 1x1 slope tile.

24. Vertically place a blue 1x3 plate on top of the 3 ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

25. Horizontally place a blue 1x6 tile on the 5th row from the front, and 3rd to 8th columns from the left. Then horizontally place the leftmost column of a blue 1x4 tile behind the rightmost column of the ppp. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right. Then place 2 light grey 1x1 tiles with a clip, 1 to the right of the other, in between the 2 previous 1x4 tiles so the clip hands face the front and back.

Building Instructions (Bag 6, Book 2):

Group 28 - Nook's Cranny

26.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x8 plate in front of you. Then place a lime green 1x1 quarter circle tile on the rightmost column so the curve faces the front right. Then place another 1 on the 4th column from the left so the curve faces the front right.

Group 29 - Nook's Cranny

26.2. Place a pink 1x1 quarter circle tile to the left of each of the 2 ppp so the curves face the front right.

Group 30 - Nook's Cranny

26.3. Place a light blue 1x1 quarter circle tile to the left of each of the 2 ppp so the curves face the front right.

Group 31 - Nook's Cranny

26.4. Place a yellow 1x1 quarter circle tile to the left of each of the 2 ppp so the curves face the front right.

You will have 6 extra orange 1x1 plates with a 1x1 slope tile and 6 orange 1x1 tiles with a round side, Save them for later!

Group 32 - Nook's Cranny

27.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Vertically place a light orange 1x1 plate with a 1x1 slope tile on the rightmost column so it slopes to the back. Now vertically place 2 more to the left so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them and they slope to the back.

27.2. Vertically place 3 orange 1x1 plates with a 1x1 slope tile, on top of the 2x6 plate, to the left of each of the 3 ppp so they slope to the back. Then horizontally place an orange 1x6 plate on the front row.

27.3. Place a light orange 1x1 tile with a round side on the rightmost column so the round side faces the front. Now place 2 more to the left so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them and the round sides face the front. Now place 3 orange 1x1 tiles with a round side from group 31 on top so the round sides face the front.

27.4. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 upright on the left 2 front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally, hangs 1 row down and it slopes up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 33 - Nook's Cranny

28. Let's make a part! Let's make the roof! Horizontally place a blue 4x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a blue 1x6 tile on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

29. Vertically place a blue 1x2 tile on the rightmost column.

30. Vertically place a blue 1x2 tile on the 3rd column from the right so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place another 1 on the 5th column from the right so it is centered vertically.

31. Vertically place a blue 1x4 tile on the 4th column from the left so it is centered vertically.

32. Horizontally place a blue 1x6 tile on the back left corner so 3 columns overhang to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

33. Horizontally place a blue 4x10 plate underneath the overhang so it is centered vertically.

34. Horizontally place a blue 1x6 tile on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

35. Vertically place a blue 1x4 tile on the 7th column from the left so it is centered vertically.

36. Vertically place a blue 1x2 tile on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place another 1 on the 3rd column from the left. Now vertically place 1 more on the 5th column from the left.

37. Flip your part upside down so it is horizontal. Now vertically place a white 2x3 plate with a bar underneath on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place another 1 on the front 3 rows so it is centered horizontally.

38. Flip your part over so it is right side up and horizontal. Now horizontally place a white 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

39. Place a red 1x2 curved tile on the back left corner of the ppp so it overhangs 1 row to the back and the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a round side on the back row of the 2x4 plate so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the back.

40. Horizontally place a white 2x6 tile printed with a red stripe and acorn on the front row of the previous 2x4 plate so it is centered horizontally.

41. Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the doors face the front. Now horizontally attach the bars of your part to the 4 top-facing clips so the roof slopes to the front.

Building Instructions (Bag 7, Book 2):

Group 34 - Nook's Cranny

42. Locate a yellow bag printed with a dark red star. This is a bag of money in Animal Crossing! Put it away now while we make a bulletin board!

43.1. Horizontally place a brown 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a brown 1x3 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the back.

43.2. Vertically place a brown 1x2 plate with a bar on the short side on the leftmost column so the bar faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

43.3. Horizontally place a dark tan 2x3 tile printed with a bulletin board with 3 papers hung up on top of the front 2 rows. Now attach a brown 1x1 tile with a clip to each of the front-facing bars so the anti-studs face the front.

43.4. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd to 4th columns from the right of the 3rd row from the front so the tile faces the front.

44. Let's make a part! Let's make a sale bin! Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick in front of you.

45. Vertically place a brown 2x3 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns so 2 rows are exposed to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

46. Horizontally place a tan 2x4 plate on the front 2 rows. Now horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row.

47. Place a tan 2x2 corner panel on the front left corner so it looks like the braille letter h with no studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place an orange carrot inside, so it sits on top of the ppp.

48.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a light brown 1x4 plate in front of you.

48.2. Vertically place a brown 2x3 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns so 2 rows are exposed to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

48.3. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 tile on the back row. Now horizontally place a light brown 2x4 sloped curved tile printed with a white and blue sign on the front 2 rows so it slopes to the front.

48.4. Horizontally place your part on top of your previous part so it is centered and slopes to the front.

49. Horizontally place your part on the 4 leftmost columns of the 2nd, to 4th rows from the front so it slopes to the front.

50. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now place a green 1x1 round plate on the 4th row from the front of the rightmost column.

51. Place a green plant with 3 stems on top of the ppp. Now place a red flower on each of the stems.

Group 35 - Nook's Cranny

52. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 brick on the 6th and 7th rows from the front, to the right of the leftmost wall of the building. Then horizontally place a light brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the ppp.

53. Place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, to the right of the leftmost wall of the building. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile behind the ppp. Now place a white 2x2 tile with a stud to the right of the ppp. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile in front of the ppp.

54.1. Let's make a part! Place a pink 1x1 cone brick in front of you. Then place a light grey claw on top so the claw hands face the left and right. Now attach the bar of a pink guitar on top so the short end faces up. Now place your part on top of the left stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs that is to the right of the leftmost wall of the building so the guitar faces the back.

54.2. Place a red bucket on the right stud of the previous 2x4 tile with 2 studs. Then attach a dark grey handle to the bucket so it is horizontal.

55.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a radio! Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.

55.2. Horizontally place a silver 1x2 grill tile upright on the front-facing side studs. Then place a red 1x1 round tile on the left column. Then place a light grey 1x1 round part with a black antenna on the right column so the antenna faces up.

55.3. Horizontally place the right column of your part on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud that is to the right of the leftmost wall of the building and on the 4th and 5th rows from the front.

Group 36 - Nook's Cranny

56.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a register! Horizontally place a brown 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Now horizontally attach a white drawer to the top front-facing row.

56.2. Vertically place a brown 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column. Then place a gold 1x1 round tile printed with a star on top of the ppp. Now place a white 2x2 slope brick printed with a keypad and card reader on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the front.

56.3. Vertically place your part on the front 3 rows on the 13th and 14th columns from the right so it slopes to the right.

57.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a plant! Place a brown 2x2 inverted dome brick in front of you. Then place a green 1x1 leaf plant with a swirl on top so it curves to the left. Now place a yellow flower upright on the front-facing hole.

57.2. Place your part on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, to the right of the leftmost wall of the building so the flower faces the front.

58. Place a brown 2x2x2 barrel on the 5th and 6th columns from the right, and 6th and 7th rows from the front. Now place a brown broom and silver shovel inside the barrel.

You will have an extra white 1x1 brick printed with a blue fish. Save it for later!

Group 37 - Nook's Cranny

59.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a refrigerator! Horizontally place a light blue 2x3x6 refrigerator with shelves in front of you so the opening faces the front. Now attach a transparent door to the front so it opens to the left and the side stud faces the front. Now place a light grey 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud.

59.2. Let's make a part! Place a white 1x1 tile on top of a white 1x1 brick printed with a blue fish from group 36. Now place it on the middle shelf.

59.3. Let's make a part! Place a white 1x1 tile on top of a white 1x1 brick printed with yellow flowers on a green background. Then place your part on the middle shelf.

59.4. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile printed with a light nougat background and a brown acorn on the top shelf. Now close the refrigerator!

59.5. Vertically place your part on the 2nd to 4th rows from the front, to the left of the rightmost wall of the building so the refrigerator opens to the left.

Group 38 - Nook's Cranny

60.1. Let's make a part! Place a lime green watering can in front of you. Now place a brown 1x1 round plate on top. Then place a red flower on top. Now place your part on the back row of the 2nd column from the left so the spout faces the left.

60.2. Now you can attach the orange tree, tea party set, and grass to the left side, front, or right side of any of the 2 main builds! When attaching them, make sure they are centered to the 4x8 plate with a rounded sides of the main builds!

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
