Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic[™] part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic[™].

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ells and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43267) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 10 bags labeled 1 to 10, 5 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Moana and Pua

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 light brown pair of legs printed with a tan dress printed with dark tan drapes, 1 light brown torso printed with a pink top, 1 light brown head printed with brown eyes and dark red lips, 1 dark brown hair, and 1 transparent green 1x1 round tile printed with a swirl. Assemble your minifigure then attach the swirl to her hand! Now place a white pig printed with a pink nose and black eyes next to her! Now put them away while we make the castle!

Group 2 - Beach

- 1. Horizontally place a tan 4x8 plate in front of you. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the back right corner so the clip faces the right.
- 2. Vertically place a dark grey 1x6 brick on the front right corner so 3 rows overhang to the front.
- 3. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with a stud and an upright clip on the front row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so the clip is on the left.
- 4. Horizontally place a tan 4x8 plate underneath the front 3 rows so it is aligned with the previous 4x8 plate.
- 5. Vertically place a light orange 1x2 sloped curved tile on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically and slopes to the front.
- 6. Vertically place a light grey 1x6x5 panel on the back right corner so the wall faces the right.
- 7. Place a brown 1x1x5 brick to the left of the front row of the ppp. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round brick in front of the ppp.
- 8. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick to the left of the ppp. Now place the front row of a brown 2x2 corner brick to the left of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter h.
- 9.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown 1x1 brick with a pinhole in front of you so the hole faces left and right. Now attach a lime green 1L pin with a pin connector to the right-facing hole so the pinhole faces up. Now insert a black 2L pin in the top-facing pinhole.
- 9.2. Place your part on the 2nd column from the left, on the 3rd row from the front so the pin is in the front and faces up.
- 10. Place a dark tan 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, on the 4th and 5th rows from the back.
- 11. Place a nougat 2x2 crate on top of the ppp.

- 12. Place a lime green ball inside the ppp. Now vertically attach a lime green surfboard to the top-facing clip that is on the 3rd column from the right so the tip faces the back and it is on the back 5 rows.
- Place a brown 1x1x5 brick on the 3rd row from the front, on the 4th column from the left.

Group 3 - Beach

- 14. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 brick on the leftmost column on the 3rd row from the front so 1 column overhangs to the left.
- 15. Place a light blue 6x6 quarter circle plate underneath the leftmost overhang so 2 rows are exposed to the front and the curve faces the front left.
- 16. Vertically place the left column of a tan 2x3 plate on the back 3 rows of the 6th column from the left.

Group 4 - Beach

- 17. Place a dark grey 2x2x2 slope brick on the front right corner so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then horizontally place a nougat 1x2 brick behind the ppp.
- 18. Horizontally place the back right corner of a light blue 4x8 plate with a round side underneath the overhang in the front right corner so the round side faces the front.
- 19. Place a white 1x1 slope tile on the 3rd column from the right of the 2nd row from the front so it slopes to the front. Then place another 1 to the back right of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now place the right column of a light blue 2x2 slope brick behind the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 20.1. Let's make a part! Place a light blue 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the long side on the front row so the clips face the front. Now place a light blue 2x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes to the back.
- 20.2. Place your part on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right, and 5th and 6th rows from the front so it sits on the 2x2 slope brick and the clips face the front.

Group 5 - Beach

- 21. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 brick to the left of the back row of the previous part. Now horizontally place the rightmost column of a brown 1x3 brick behind the left column of the ppp.
- 22. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 slope brick in front of the 1x6x5 panel that is on the back right corner so it slopes to the front. Now place a lime green 1x1 slope tile on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 23. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 slope brick to the right of the top-facing pin that is on the 8th column from the left of the 5th row from the front so it slopes to the left.
- 24. Vertically place a light grey 1x2x3 slope brick in front of the right column of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2x2 slope brick to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

- 25. Vertically place a light grey 1x2x3 slope brick on the 2nd column from the right, in front of the 1x1x5 brick so it slopes to the front. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2x2 slope brick to the left of the ppp so there is a 2 column gap in between them and it slopes to the front. Now place a lime green 1x1 slope tile to the left of the front row of the ppp so it slopes to the left.
- 26. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 slope brick on the 2nd column from the right on the 6th and 7th rows from the back so it slopes to the front. Now vertically place a light grey 1x2 slope brick to the left of the ppp so there are 2 free columns in between and it slopes to the front.
- 27.1. Let's make a part! Stack 2 white 1x2x2 window frames in front of you so the ridged sides face the front. Now attach 2 gold lattice window panes to the front of the 2 ppp.
- 27.2. Horizontally place your part in front of the 2x2 crate that is on the 4th and 5th rows from the back, and 6th and 7th columns from the right so the window panes face the front.

Group 6 - Beach

- 28.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a tan 1x1 round plate on the back right corner. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the short side on the left column so the connector faces the back. Now horizontally place a lime green 1x2 plate on the back row. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x2 sloped curved tile on the front row so it slopes to the right.
- 28.2. Place your part on the leftmost column of the back 2 rows so the hinge connector faces the back and it overhangs 1 column to the left.
- 29. Horizontally place a blue 2x6 plate underneath the overhang of the ppp so 5 columns are exposed to the left.
- 30. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 jumper plate on the back row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile to the right of the ppp.
- 31. Place a tan 4x4 quarter circle plate in front of the 2 ppp so the curve faces the front left.
- 32. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile to the left of the top-facing pin that is in front of the 1x2x2 window frames with lattice panes which is on the 6th row from the back of the 6th and 7th columns from the right. Now vertically place a tan 1x2 tile in front of the top-facing pin.
- 33. Place a tan 1x1 quarter circle tile to the left of the back row of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Now place a tan 1x2 curved tile in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front left.
- 34. Place a nougat 1x1 brick on the back row on the 7th column from the left.
- 35.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a brown 1x1 brick with a pinhole in front of you so the pinhole faces left and right. Now attach a lime green 1L pin with a pin connector to the left-facing pinhole so the pinhole faces up and down. Then insert a black 2L pin into the top-facing pinhole.

35.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 on the back row on the 6th column from the left so the pin is on the left and faces up. Now place another part in front of the ppp so there are 4 free rows in between them and the pin is on the left and faces up.

Group 7 - Beach

- 36. Horizontally place the left column of a tan 1x2x2 slope brick on top of each of the 2 ppp so they slope to the left.
- 37. Vertically place a nougat 1x6x2 arch brick on top of the 2 ppp.
- 38. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the back right corner so the clip faces the right. Now place a light brown 1x1 brick in front of the ppp.
- 39. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a nougat 1x8 brick in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a nougat 1x2 brick on the rightmost column, in front of the ppp.
- 40. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a nougat 1x8 brick in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a nougat 1x2 brick behind the leftmost column of the ppp.
- 41. Vertically attach a transparent aqua 2x6 sloped curved windshield with a bar to the 2 front-facing clips that are on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it slopes up and the smooth side faces the front.
- 42. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back right corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 tile in front of the ppp.
- 43. Vertically place a light orange 1x2 plate with spikes on the back 2 rows of the 8th column from the right so the spikes overhang to the left. Now vertically place a tan 1x2 tile in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a light orange 1x2 plate with spikes in front of the ppp so the spikes overhang to the left. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x6 tile to the right of the front row of the ppp. Then horizontally place another 1 behind the ppp so there are 2 free rows in between them.
- 44. Attach a brown curved trunk with a pinhole to the back leftmost top-facing pin so it overhangs to the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.
- 45.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 arch brick on top. Now place a tan 1x1 round plate on top so it is centered horizontally. Now place 3 tan 1x1 cone bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top.
- 45.2. This is a sand castle! Horizontally place it on the back row on the 2nd to 4th columns from the left.
- 46.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown curved trunk with a pinhole in front of you so the bar hole is on top and faces the front. Now insert a lime green 3L bar into the bar hole. Then horizontally attach a clip of a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side to the bar so the studs are on the left and face the front. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 rounded plate with a clip and leaves on top of the ppp so the clip attaches to the bar.
- 46.2. Place the pinhole of your part on the top-facing pin that is on the 5th row from the front of the 8th column from the right so the leaves face the left.

Group 8 - Beach

- 47. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 6x8 plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 cone brick on the back right corner.
- 48. Place a white 1x1 cone brick on the back row to the left of the previous cone brick so there is a 1 column gap in between them. Now repeat 2 more times to the left.
- 49.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light orange 1x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with a stud and an upright clip on the 2 leftmost columns so the clip is on the left. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x2 sloped curved tile on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the right.
- 49.2. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the back, on the 2nd to 4th columns from the left so it slopes to the right.
- 50. Horizontally place a teal 1x4 tile on the back right corner. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left. Together they should be centered horizontally on the back row.
- 51. Horizontally place a light orange 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally. Now vertically place a 1x2 plate with spikes on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the spikes overhang to the right.
- 52. Vertically place 2 light orange 1x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so together they are centered vertically and slope outwards to the front and back.
- 53.1. Let's make a part! Place a red 1x1 round plate in front of you. Then place a gold 4x4 dish on top. Now attach the 5L bar of a brown 5L L-shaped bar to the anti-stud so the short bar faces the back.
- 53.2. Attach the short bar of your part to the top-facing clip so the dish is on top. This is an umbrella!
- 54.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a red 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the right. Now horizontally place 2 pink 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the ppp. Then vertically place a light orange 1x2 panel with a middle wall on the rightmost column so the middle wall faces the left.
- 54.2. This is a beach chair! Horizontally place it on the 3rd and 4th columns from the front so it is centered horizontally on the 6x8 plate and the 1x2 sloped curved brick is on the left.
- 55. Rotate your build 180 degrees, then horizontally place it on the back right corner of your main build. Now put everything away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 9 - Jasmine

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 light blue pair of legs printed with a gold shoe and a dark tan shoe, 1 light brown torso printed with a light blue crop top, 1 light brown head printed with eyes, eyelashes, and lips, 1 black

hair printed with a light blue headband. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we make the part of the castle!

Group 10 - Princess Castle

- 1. Let's make sub-build 2! Horizontally place a lime green 6x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the back right corner.
- 2. Horizontally stack 2 dark grey 1x6 plates to the left of the ppp.
- 3. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the back left corner.
- 4. Vertically place a dark grey 1x3 brick on the rightmost column in front of the 1x2 rounded brick. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side in front of the ppp so the bar faces the front.
- 5. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the leftmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back.
- 6. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate on the leftmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Now vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on top of the ppp so the clip hands face up and down. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate on top of the ppp.
- 7. Vertically place a tan 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the 2nd column from the right, on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back so the long wall faces the left. Then place a light orange 2x2 tile with a stud to the left of the ppp.
- 8. Horizontally place a light orange 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, on the 3rd to 6th columns from the left.
- 9.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x3x2 inverted arch brick on the 3 leftmost columns so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x6x2 arch brick on top.
- 9.2. Vertically place your part on the rightmost column.
- 10. Place a white 1x1x5 brick on the back row on the 2nd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 11.1. Vertically place a white 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the leftmost column so the wall faces the left.
- 11.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the white 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a tan poster of the castle on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 10 - Princess Castle

- 12. Place a white 2x2 corner brick on the back left corner so it looks like the braille letter f. Now place a white 1x1 round brick on the leftmost column, in front of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 13. Vertically place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the front left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on the front right corner so the bar faces the front. Now horizontally place a white 1x10 brick behind the 2 ppp.
- 14. Vertically place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 tile behind the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 15. Horizontally place a white 1x8 tile on the 3rd row from the front so it sits on the 1x10 brick.
- 16. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 2x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 brick on the leftmost column. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 17. Horizontally stack 2 white 1x2x2 window frames on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so the ridged sides face the front. Now attach 2 gold lattice window panes to the front of the 2 ppp.
- 18. Horizontally stack 2 white 1x2x2 window frames on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the ridged sides face the front. Now attach 1 gold lattice window pane to the bottom front-facing window frame.
- 19. Vertically stack 3 pink 1x2 bricks on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 20. Horizontally place a teal 2x6 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 21. Horizontally stack 2 white 1x6 plates on the back row.
- 22. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place 3 teal 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they slope to the front.
- 23. Place 3 teal 2x2 inverted slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, underneath your part so they slope to the front.
- 24. Rotate your sub-build 1 180 degrees so the large open circle faces the left. Horizontally place the back row of your part on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front.
- 25. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 tile on the front row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 26. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now place a gold lattice window pane in the 1x2 panel with 3 walls that is on the 2nd column from the right, on the 4th and 5th rows from the front. It should not attach to any studs!
- 27. Let's make a part! Let's make a telescope! Place a dark tan 2x2 round tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a gold 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top.

28. Place a white candle stick on top. Then place a white bar holder with a clip on top so the clip is on top and the clip hands face left and right.

Group 12 - Princess Castle

- 29.1. Let's make another part! Place a transparent 1x1 round plate in front of you. Place a gold 1x1 half cone brick on top. Then place a gold candle stick on top so the bar hole faces up. Now place a gold 1x1 round tile with an upright stud on top so the anti-stud faces up. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate with a bar on top so the bar faces the front. Now place the thicker side of a gold lightsaber hilt on top of the ppp.
- 29.2. Now attach the bar of the 1x1 round plate with a bar to the top-facing clip so the anti-stud faces the left.
- 30. This is a telescope! Place your part on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud that is to the left of the 1x2 panel with 3 walls that is on the 2nd column from the right so the anti-stud faces out the back-facing window frame that does not have a pane.
- 31. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a magenta 1x1 cone brick on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 32. Place a tan 2x2 tile with a stud on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 33. Place a pink 1x1 brick with a side stud on the front left corner so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 34. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2 tile on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud.
- 35. Horizontally place a pink 2x4 plate on top.
- 36. Place a light orange 1x1 skate upright on the left front-facing side stud so the rounded lip faces down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 37. Place a dark grey 1x1 tile with an upright clip on the front right corner so the clip hands face the back left and front right.
- 38. Attach a black magnifying glass to the clip so the round part faces the front left. Then place a tan head printed with a map on the back left corner.
- 39. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front on the 3rd to 6th columns from the left so the magnifying glass is on the right.

Group 13 - Princess Castle

- 40. Let's make a part! Place a lime green 4x4 quarter circle plate in front of you so the curve faces the front left. Now place 2 light grey 1x1 bricks with a clip, 1 in front of the other, on the back right corner so the clips face the right.
- 41. Place a dark grey 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on the front right corner so the cutoff corner faces the front left.

Group 14 - Princess Castle

- 42. Place a dark grey 2x2 slope brick on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the left. Now place a lime green 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on the back right corner so the cutoff corner faces the front left. Then place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front row of the 2nd column from the right so the leaves face the front left.
- 43. Place a light pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Now place a light yellow 1x1 bird on the back row on the 2nd column from the right so the beak faces the front.
- 44. Rotate your sub-build 1 180 degrees so the window panes face the front. Now attach the clips of your part to the 1x2 rounded brick with a gap that is on the front left corner so the curve of the 4x4 quarter circle plate faces the front right.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 2):

Group 15 - Rajah the Tiger

Sub-build 3. Locate an orange tiger printed with a pink nose, eyes, and black stripes. Place it in front of you! Now put it away while we continue the castle build!

Group 16 - Princess Castle

- 45. Let's make a sub-build! Horizontally place a tan 6x10 plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 46. Horizontally place a white 1x2 inverted arch brick on the back row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it slopes to the right. Now horizontally place another 1 to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 47. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place another 1 on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 48. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 grill tile on the 2 leftmost columns, in front of the tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 49. Vertically place a white 1x4 brick to the left of the ppp. Now repeat symmetrically to the left. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 brick in between the back row of the 2 ppp.
- 50. Place a white 1x1 brick on the front row on the 3rd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 51. Horizontally place 3 white 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row of studs so together they are centered horizontally and the brick grooves face the back.
- 52. Vertically place a light orange 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the front 4 rows on the 4th and 5th columns from the right.

- 53. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile on the front row of studs so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with a side stud to the right of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 54. Vertically place a white 1x4x5 panel with a window on the back 4 rows on the 3rd column from the left so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 55. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing side stud so the leaves face the top right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 17 - Princess Castle

- 56. Stack 2 pink 1x1 bricks on the front row of studs on the 3rd column from the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 57. Horizontally place a white 1x3x2 half arch brick on top of the ppp so it arches to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 58. Horizontally place a white 1x6 arch brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a pink 1x4 brick in front of the leftmost column of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 59. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 brick in front of you. Then vertically place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 60. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.
- 61. Horizontally place a white 1x2x3 panel on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the front. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on top of the ppp. Then place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.
- 62. Place a teal hair brush on the rightmost column so the bristles face the front. Then place a magenta 1x1 cone brick on the leftmost column. Now place a teal 1x1 round tile on top of the ppp.
- 63. Rotate your sub-build 2 180 degrees, then vertically place your part on the front 4 rows of your sub-build on the 2x4 tile with 2 studs so the 1x2x3 panel is on the right.
- 64. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 4x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 65. Horizontally place a white 1x4 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 66. Place a teal 1x2 plate with a 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick on the back left corner so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 67. Vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on the back 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 68. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile on the 2 leftmost columns on the 2nd row from the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

- 69. Horizontally place a white 1x2x2 panel with a window on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the back. Now horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate on top of the ppp. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 masonry brick on top of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate on top of the ppp.
- 70. Horizontally place 2 gold 1x2 jumper plates, 1 in front of the other, on the front 2 rows so they are centered horizontally.
- 71. Rotate your sub-build 2 180 degrees so the upright round plates with 3 leaves face the front. Now horizontally place your part on the back 4 rows so it is centered horizontally and the 1x2 jumper plates face the back.
- 72. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the back. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 73. Place a teal 1x2 plate with a 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the back.
- 74. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally.
- 75. Place a teal 1x2 curved brick on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 76. Rotate your part 180 degrees. Now horizontally place it on the front row of studs so it is centered horizontally and the round side overhangs 1 row to the front.
- 77. Place 2 teal 4x4x3 quarter circle dome bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front 4 rows so together they are centered horizontally and curve to the front left and front right.
- 78. Place a gold 3x3 dome brick on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered on the 2x2 studs. Now place a gold 1x1 half cone brick on top.
- 79. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now vertically place your tiger on the 2 1x2 jumper plates so the head faces the front!
- 80-81. Bring back your sub-build 1 and horizontally place it in front of you so the clips are on the back row and face the right. Now attach the leftmost back-facing bars of your current build to the clips. Now rotate your current build to the front so it is horizontal and the windows face the front. Now put it away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 3):

Group 18 - Rapunzel

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 light tan pair of legs printed with a purple dress, 1 light tan torso printed with a magenta top with a bowtie, 1 light tan head printed with light blue eyes, eyelashes, and pink lips, 1 blonde hair, and 2 pink flowers. Assemble your minifigure then attach the flowers to the little holes that are on the back of her hair! Now put her away while we make part of the castle!

Group 19 - Princess Castle

- 1. Let's make sub-build 3! Vertically place a lime green 2x4 plate in front of you.
- 2. Horizontally place a tan 2x4 rounded tile on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 3. Place a lime green 4x4 quarter circle plate underneath the leftmost column so 2 rows are exposed to the front and the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 4. Horizontally place a pink 2x6x6 curved door frame on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it is centered horizontally and the shorter side faces the back.
- 5. Place a dark grey 1x2 curved brick on the front left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 6. Horizontally place a tan 2x6 tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.
- 7. Horizontally place a lime green 6x10 plate underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally.
- 8. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the leftmost column on the 6th row from the front so the clip faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 9. Place a dark grey 1x1 round brick in front of each of the 2 ppp.
- 10. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip in front of each of the 2 ppp so the clips face outward to the left and right.
- 11. Vertically place a dark grey 1x3 brick in front of each of the 2 ppp.
- 12.1. Place a white 1x2x5 curved panel with a sticker on the 1x2 curved brick that is on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 12.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the white 1x2x5 panel. This sticker has a lot of green vines with pink flowers. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 13.1. Vertically place a white 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the front left corner so the wall faces the left.
- 13.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the white 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a picture of Flounder, Pascal, Rajah, Pua and Mushu! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 14.1. Vertically place a white 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the front right corner so the wall faces the right.

- 14.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the white 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a picture of Maleficent in green and purple fire. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 15. Horizontally place a white 1x4 brick on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally.
- 16. Stack 3 white 1x4 curved plates, then place them to the left of the ppp so the curves face the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 17. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the rightmost column in front of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 18. Horizontally place a white 1x10 brick on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.
- 19. Place a white 1x1 round brick on the front left corner. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip behind the ppp so the clip faces the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 20. Vertically place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x8 tile on the 3rd row from the front so it sits on the 1x10 brick.
- 21. Place a pink 1x2 curved tile on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 tile on the leftmost column in front of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 22. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now place the back row of a teal 2x2 sloped corner brick to the left of the ppp so 1 row overhangs to the front and it slopes to the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 23. Place 2 teal 2x2 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 3 ppp so together they are centered horizontally, there is no overhang, and the studs are in the back.
- 24. Place a pink 1x1 tile with a round side to the right of the back row of the 2 ppp so the round side faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 25. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front left corner so the leaves face the front left. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 26.1. Vertically place a gold 2x3 pentagonal tile with a sticker upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so the angled side overhangs 1 row to the bottom.
- 26.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the gold 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker has gold flowers surrounding a crown on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 27.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a tan 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then place a light orange 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Now place a pink 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top. Now place a magenta 1x1 cone brick on top so the anti-stud faces up.

- 27.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Rotate your sub-build 180 degrees. Then place 1 part on the front 2 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 28.1. Place a white plant with 3 leaves on top of the previous part you placed on the right.

Group 21 - Princess Castle

28.2. Place a light purple plant with 3 leaves on the previous part you placed on the left. Now put your sub-build away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 3):

Group 22 - Pascal the Chameleon

Sub-build 5. Locate a green chameleon printed with white and black eyes and place it in front of you. Now put him away while we make a sub-build!

Group 23 - Princess Castle

- 29. Horizontally place a tan 6x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x6 curved door frame on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the rounded pillars face the back.
- 30. Place a light orange 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile in front of the ppp. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x2 jumper plate in front of the ppp.
- 31. Place a lime green 2x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front. Now stack 2 white 1x2 plates on the back row of the ppp.
- 32. Stack 2 white 1x2 curved bricks to the right of the 2 ppp so the curves face the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 33. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the front.
- 34. Place a pink 1x1x6 pillar on the 3rd column from the right on the 4th row from the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 35.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick in front of you. Now horizontally place a white 1x2x2 window frame on top so the ridged side faces the front. Then attach a gold lattice window pane to the front of the ppp. Now horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on top. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front.
- 35.2. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the front. Make sure to remember to count the 1x2 studs on the front row!
- 36. Place the front row of a white 1x2x5 curved panel to the right of the ppp so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

- 37. Vertically place a white 1x4 arch brick on the back 4 rows on the 3rd column from the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 38. Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a white 1x2 grill tile in front of the leftmost column of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 39. Place the rightmost column of a white 1x4 curved plate in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 40.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a sunflower! Place a brown 1x1 round brick in front of you. Now place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on top so the leaves face the front. Then place a light green 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top. Now place a brown T-shaped bar with studs on top so the side with 2 studs is on top and faces the front and back. Now place a yellow flower upright on the front-facing side stud. Then place a brown 1x1 round tile upright on the front-facing side stud.
- 40.2. Now rotate sub-build 3 180 degrees. Then horizontally place your part on the 5th row from the front so it sits on the 1x2 jumper plate, is centered horizontally, and the upright 1x1 round tile faces the front.

Group 24 - Princess Castle

- 41.1. Let's make a part! Place an orange 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a yellow 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the back right corner so the leaves face the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front. Then place a light orange 2x2 round tile with a stud on top so it is centered.
- 41.2. Place your part on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is centered horizontally on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it is centered on it.
- 42. Place your chameleon on top of the ppp so he faces the front!
- 43. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally.
- 44. Place a lime green 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, and 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the cutoff corner faces the back right and it overhangs in the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 45. Place a tan 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner underneath the front left corner so the cutoff corner faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 46. Vertically place a white 1x2 masonry brick on the front 2 rows of the leftmost column so the brick grooves face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 47. Horizontally place a white 1x2 masonry brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the brick grooves face the front. Now horizontally place another 1 to the right of the ppp so there is a 1 column gap in between them and the brick grooves face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

- 48. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile on top of each of the 3 ppp. Now vertically place 1 on the front 2 rows of the rightmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 49.1. Let's make a part! Place a lime green 1x4 leaf plate in front of you so the stud with the branch faces the back right. Now horizontally place the leftmost stud of another 1 on the back right stud so it overhangs to the right and the stud with the branch faces the right. Then place a yellow flower on the leftmost and rightmost studs of the ppp. Now place the leftmost stud of another 1 underneath the rightmost stud so the stud with the branch faces the front right.
- 49.2. Vertically place your part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so the leaves curve to the left and the flowers are on the left.
- 50. Place a green plant with 3 leaves upright on the topmost front-facing side stud.
- 51. Bring back your previous sub-build and place it in front of you so the doorway faces the front. Now horizontally place your current build on top so it is centered horizontally.

Building Instructions (Bag 6, Book 3):

Group 26 - Princess Castle

- 52. Let's make another sub-build! Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the back. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the back.
- 53. Place a white 1x2 curved brick on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 54. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 55. Place a white 1x2 curved brick on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 56.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x2x2 window frame on top so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach a gold lattice window pane to the front of the ppp. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on top. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front.
- 56.2. Horizontally place your part on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the back.
- 57. Place a white 1x2x5 curved panel on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 58. Place a green 2x2 tile with a stud on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.
- 59. Horizontally place a tan 4x6 plate underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally.

Group 27 - Princess Castle

- 60. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on top so the clip faces the left and the clip hands face the front and back.
- 61. Attach a brown paint brush with a blue tip to the clip so the tip faces up. Now horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 plate with a rail on the long side on top so the rail faces the front.
- 62. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 hinge base on top so the wall faces the back.
- 63. Attach the bar of a black 2x2 plate with a bar underneath to the ppp so 1 row overhangs to the back.
- 64.1. Place a white 2x2 tile with a sticker on top.
- 64.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the white 2x2 tile. This sticker has a yellow sun with purple flowers surrounding it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 65. Horizontally place your part on the 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered horizontally and the tile faces up and to the front.
- 66. Place a pink 1x1x6 pillar on the leftmost column on the 4th row from the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 67. Horizontally place a pink 1x6x6 curved door frame on the front row so the round side of the pillars faces the front.
- 68. Vertically place a white 1x4 arch brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 69. Place a white 1x4 curved plate on the back left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 70. Horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on the front row. Then vertically place a white 1x2 grill tile behind the leftmost column of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 71. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 4x6 plate in front of you. Then place a gold 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
- 72. Horizontally place a white 1x4 brick on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 73. Place a white 1x2 curved brick on the 2nd column from the left of the front row so 1 row overhangs to the front and the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 74. Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate with a round side underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front.

- 75. Place a teal 2x6 curved sloped brick on the front left corner so it slopes and overhangs to the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 76. Horizontally place 2 teal 1x2x3 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the 3rd row from the back so together they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right.
- 77. Horizontally place a teal 2x4x3 half cone panel in front of the 2 ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 78. Place a teal 1x1 slope tile on the rightmost column on the 3rd row from the back so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 79. Place a teal 2x2x2 cone brick on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back so it is centered horizontally. Now place a gold 1x1 cone brick on top of the ppp.
- 80. Place a gold 4L bar on top of the ppp. Now horizontally place a pink flag on top so the thick rounded part is on the bottom and the flag overhangs to the right.
- 81. Bring back your previous sub-build and place it in front of you so the round side faces the back. Now rotate your current part 180 degrees, then place it on top so it is centered horizontally and the round side overhangs 1 row to the back.
- 82. Place a white 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the front 2 rows. Now horizontally place a gold crown on top of the ppp.
- 83.1. Let's make a part! Place a lime green 1x4 leaf plate in front of you so the stud with the branch faces the front left. Now horizontally place the leftmost stud of another 1 on the back right stud so it overhangs to the right and the stud with the shorter branch faces the right. Then place a yellow flower on the leftmost and rightmost studs of the ppp. Now place the leftmost stud of another 1 underneath the rightmost stud so the stud with the short branch faces the front right.
- 83.2. Rotate your current build 180 degrees so the round side faces the front. Now vertically place your part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so the bottommost and topmost studs attach to the side studs.
- 84. Place a green plant with 3 leaves upright on the topmost front-facing side stud.
- 85. Bring back your sub-build from bags 4 and 5 and orient it so the doorway faces the front. Now place your current build on top so there is no overhang and the round side faces the front.
- 86. Bring back your main build and orient it so it is horizontal and the window panes face the front. Now attach the 3 left-facing clips of your part to the 3 right-facing rounded bricks with a gap of the main build. Now put away your build while we make the next part!

- 1. Let's make a sub-build! Horizontally place a lime green 6x10 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 2. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x6 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 3. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on the front left corner so the bar faces the front. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x3 brick behind the ppp.
- 4. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the rightmost column on the 4th and 5th rows from the front.
- 5. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate on the rightmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Then vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side on top of the ppp so the clip faces the front and the clip hands face up and down. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate on top of the ppp.
- 6. Horizontally place a light orange 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back so it is centered horizontally.
- 7.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x3x2 inverted arch brick on the 3 leftmost columns so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x6x2 arch brick on top.
- 7.2. Vertically place your part on the leftmost column.
- 8. Horizontally place 4 pink 1x2x5 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so together they are centered horizontally.
- 9. Vertically place a white 1x6x5 panel on the rightmost column so the wall faces the right.
- 10. Horizontally place a white 1x4 brick on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a white 1x6 brick to the right of the ppp.
- 11. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on the leftmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 12. Horizontally place a white 1x10 brick on the 3rd row from the front.

Group 30 - Princess Castle

13. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a bar on the short side on the front left corner so the bar faces the front. Then vertically place a gold 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the front right corner.

- 14. Vertically place a pink 1x2 tile on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 15. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 tile to the left and right of the ppp.
- 16. Vertically place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x8 tile on the 3rd row from the front so it sits on the 1x10 brick.

- 22.1. Horizontally place a tan 1x2x2 panel with a sticker on the back right corner so the wall faces the front. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.
- 22.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the tan 1x2x2 panel. This sticker has a white and purple rag and a green mitten on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 23. Place a black pan in the center of the 2x2 studs that are on the 2 leftmost columns so the handle faces the right.
- 24. Horizontally place your part on the 4th and 5th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally.

- 26. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the back row on the 2nd column from the right so the clip faces the back.
- 27. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x6 brick on the back row so it overhangs 2 columns to the left.
- 28. Place the back row of a lime green 4x4 quarter circle plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns so 3 rows are exposed to the front and the curve faces the front left.
- 29. Place a dark grey 1x1 round brick on the back left corner. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip to the right of the ppp so the clip faces the back.
- 30. Vertically place a green 1x2 tile on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 tile to the left of the back row of the ppp. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a green 1x2 tile to the left of the 2 ppp.
- 31. Place a light grey 2x2 brick to the left of the ppp.
- 32. Place a light grey 1x1 slope tile in front of the right column of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Then horizontally place a green 1x4 tile with 2 studs to the right of the ppp.
- 33. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick on the back right corner. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud to the left of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x3 brick to the left of the ppp.
- 34. Place a dark grey 1x1 round brick on the back row on the 3rd column from the left. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x2 brick on the 6th column from the right so it is centered vertically.
- 35. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then place the left column of a light grey 2x2x2 slope brick in front of the right column of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 36. Place a dark grey 1x1 round brick on the back right corner. Now horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2 bricks with a side stud, 1 to the left of the other, to the left of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Now place a dark grey 1x1 round brick to the left of the ppp. Then place the back row of a dark grey 2x2 corner brick to the left of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter f. Now vertically place a lime green 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp.
- 37. Place a transparent aqua diamond upright on the bottom front-facing side stud.
- 38. Vertically place a light grey 1x2x2 slope brick on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and slopes to the front. Now vertically place another 1 on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front of the 3rd column of studs from the right so it slopes to the front.
- 39. Place a dark grey 2x2 corner brick on the back right corner so it looks like the braille letter d. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a side stud on the back row to the left of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick to the left of the ppp. Now place a lime green 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner to the left of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front left.

40.1. Place a transparent diamond upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud.

Group 35 - Princess Castle

- 40.2. Place a transparent green diamond upright on the rightmost front-facing side stud.
- 41. Vertically place a light grey 1x2x2 slope brick on the 6th column from the right so it is centered vertically and slopes to the front.
- 42. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 brick on the back right corner. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick on the back row to the left of the ppp. Now place the back row of a dark grey 2x2 corner brick to the left of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter f and overhangs 1 column to the left. Then vertically place a lime green 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp.
- 43. Horizontally place a dark grey 2x4 brick on the back right corner. Then vertically place a lime green 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp.
- 44.1. Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate on the back right corner.

Group 36 - Princess Castle

- 44.2. Horizontally place a lime green 2x4 plate on the back right corner.
- 45.1. Place a transparent pink diamond on the 1x2 jumper plate on the 2nd row from the front and 3rd and 4th columns from the right.

Group 37 - Princess Castle

- 45.2. Place a transparent yellow diamond upright on the top front-facing side stud.
- 46.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 2x4x6 rock formation in front of you so the ridged side faces the front. Now horizontally place a lime green 1x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light grey 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left.
- 46.2. Horizontally place the front row of your part on the 1x4 tile with 2 studs that is on the 2nd to 5th columns from the right.
- 47. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the back row on the 2nd column from the right so the leaves face the front right. - 64. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 6x10 plate in front of you. Then place a teal 2x2 corner slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 65. Horizontally place 3 teal 2x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so together they are centered horizontally and slope to the back.
- 66. Place a teal 2x2 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 67. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the 4th row from the front, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 68. Place a teal 1x1 brick on the 3rd column from the left, on the 3rd row from the front. Then place a white 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 69. Place a teal 2x2 corner slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 2 teal 2x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in between the 2 ppp so they slope to the back.
- 70. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 slope brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of the 3rd row from the front so it slopes to the left. Then place a tan 1x1x2/3 brick with 2 side studs to the right of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Group 41 - Princess Castle

- 71. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 brick on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then place 2 gold 1x1 cone bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp.
- 72. Place a teal 2x2 slope brick on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back. Now place a teal 2x2 corner slope brick to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 73. Horizontally place 2 gold 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 3 ppp.
- 74. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 grill tile behind the ppp.
- 75.1. Vertically place a gold 2x3 pentagonal tile with a sticker upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs so 1 column overhangs to the left and the angled side faces up.

- 75.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the gold 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker has a monkey on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 76.1. Vertically place a gold 2x3 pentagonal tile with a sticker upright on the 2 rightmost front-facing side studs so 1 column overhangs to the right and the angled side faces up.
- 76.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the gold 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker has a bunny on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 77. Bring back your previous sub-build and orient it so it is horizontal and the 9 window panes face the back. Now horizontally place your part on top so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.
- 78. Place your previous dragon on top of the 1x2 jumper plate that is on the front row so the nose faces the front.
- 79.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a target to shoot the bow at! Place a gold 2x2 tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a black 1x1 round plate on top. Now place a brown 4L bar on top. Then place the side stud of a black 1x1 rounded brick with a side stud on top so the stud faces the front. Now place a white 2x2 round tile printed with a white, blue, red, and yellow target upright on the front-facing side stud so it is centered.
- 79.2. Place your part on the bottom floor, on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so the 2x2 round tile faces the front.
- 80. Place a 4L bar in the barrel that is in the back right corner.
- 81.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a firework! Place a black 1x1 round plate in front of you. Then place a red 1x1 round brick on top. Now place a tan 1x1 pyramid tile on top. Then insert a black 2L bar with a stop into the anti-stud of the part.
- 81.2. Place your part inside the barrel that is in the back right corner.
- 82. Place a gold 1x1 tile with an upright clip on the first floor, on the front row on the 5th column from the right so the clip hands face the front and back.
- 83. Let's make a part! Locate 1 nougat bow and 1 yellow arrow! Vertically place the bow in front of you so the straight thin bars are on the front left and back left. Now insert the arrow into the right-facing hole.
- 84. Now horizontally attach the left bar of your part to the top-facing clip that is on the front row so the arrow faces the front.
- 85. Bring back your previous sub-build and orient it in front of you so it is horizontal and the rock formation faces the front. Now horizontally place your part on the back 6 rows so it is centered horizontally and the lattice window panes face the front.

86. Bring back your main build and orient it so it is horizontal and the doorway on the right front-facing side faces the front. Now attach the left-facing bars of the 1x2 rounded bricks of your sub-build to the right-facing clips of the main build.

- 8. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2x3 slope brick on the 2nd column from the left, on the 5th and 6th rows from the back so it slopes to the back. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x3 slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

- 10. Vertically place a blue 2x4 plate on the back right corner so 1 column overhangs to the right.
- 11. Horizontally place a light blue 2x6 plate underneath the back right corner so 5 columns are exposed to the right.
- 12. Place a light blue 6x6 quarter circle plate underneath the 2x4 plate, in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front right.
- 13. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the short side on the back 2 rows on the 6th column from the right so the connector faces the back. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the back row to the left of the ppp.

- 14. Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 plate on the back row on the 6th and 7th columns from the right. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x2 sloped curved tile in front of the ppp so it slopes to the left.
- 15. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x3 slope brick on the 5th row from the back, on the 5th to 7th columns from the right so it slopes to the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope brick in front of the 2 leftmost columns of the ppp so it slopes to the right.
- 16. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 brick to the left of the 2 ppp. Now vertically place a dark tan 1x3 slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 17. Place a lime green 1x1 round brick with 3 leaves to the right of the back row of the ppp so the leaves face the front right.
- 18. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 chest bottom on the 2x4 tile with 2 studs that is in the back left so the lower ridge faces the front. Now attach a brown 2x4 chest top to the ppp so it attaches to the lower ridge and opens to the front.
- 19. Vertically place a light grey 1x6x5 panel on the back left corner so the wall faces the left. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x2x5 brick in front of the ppp.
- 20. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 slope brick to the right of the back row of the ppp so it slopes to the right.
- 21. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2x3 slope brick on the back row on the 6th and 7th columns from the right so it slopes to the right.
- 22. Horizontally place a tan 1x2x2 slope brick on the 5th row from the back, on the 7th and 8th columns from the right so it slopes to the left.
- 23. Place a light grey 2x2x2 slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip behind the right column of the ppp so the clip faces the right.
- 24. Place a teal 1x1 round brick on the 2nd column from the left, on the 6th row from the back. Now place a lime green 1x1 round brick with 3 leaves to the right of the ppp so it sits on the 2x2x2 slope brick so the leaves face the front left. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the back.
- 25. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x6x2 arch brick on the 6th row from the back, on the 2nd to 7th columns from the left. Now vertically place the front row of another 1 to the right of the ppp.
- 26. Vertically place a light grey 1x2x3 inverted slope brick on the 2nd column from the left, on the 7th row from the back so it slopes and overhangs to the front.
- 27. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Now place a teal 1x1 round brick on the back row on the 8th column from the left.
- 28. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x8 brick in front of the 2 ppp.

29. Vertically place a light grey 1x3 brick on the leftmost column on the 3rd to 5th rows from the back. Now place a dark grey 2x2 plate in front of the ppp.

Group 44 - Princess Castle

- 30. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side in front of the ppp so the clip faces the right and the clip hands face the front and back.
- 31. Vertically place a light grey 2x3 plate on the 2 leftmost columns on the 6th to 8th rows from the back. Now place a tan 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on the back 2 rows of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front right.
- 32. Horizontally place a light grey 1x6 brick to the right of the back row of the ppp. Now vertically place a light grey 1x3 brick behind the rightmost column of the ppp.
- 33. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 tile in front of the ppp.
- 34. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back 4 rows on the 8th column from the left. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 tile in front of the ppp. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x6 tile on the 2nd row from the back on the 2nd to 7th columns from the left. Then horizontally place another 1 on the 6th row from the back, on the 2nd to 7th columns from the left.
- 35. Place a mint blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Now place another 1 on the 4th and 5th rows from the front of the 4th and 5th columns from the left.
- 36. Place a teal 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 2nd stud from the right of the 2nd row from the front so the leaves face the front right. Now place another 1 on the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back and 3rd and 4th columns from the right so the leaves face the right. Then place 1 more on the 5th row from the back of the 2nd column from the right so the leaves face the front right. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the 3 ppp.
- 37. Place a teal 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the 4th and 5th rows from the front of the 4th and 5th columns from the left so the leaves face the front. Now place a pink frog on top so it faces the front.
- 38. Vertically attach the small bar of a green seaweed to the right-facing clip that is on the 6th column from the right so the 4 wavy bars face up and the shorter bar is in the front. Now attach another 1 to the right-facing clip that is on the 4th row from the front of the 3rd column from the left so the 4 bars face down and the shorter bar faces the back right.
- 39. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 6x8 plate in front of you.
- 40. Place a white 1x1 cone brick on the back left corner. Then place 2 more, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp so there is a 1 column gap in between each of them.
- 41. Place a black 2x2 turntable base on top of the 6x8 plate so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Then place a light grey 2x2 turntable plate on top of the ppp.

- 42. Horizontally place a teal 1x6 tile on the back left corner on top of the cone bricks so 1 column overhangs to the right.
- 43.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown 1x1 brick with a pinhole in front of you so the hole faces left and right. Now attach a lime green 1L pin with a pin connector to the left-facing hole so the pinhole faces up. Now insert a black 2L pin into the top-facing pinhole.
- 43.2. Place your part on the front right corner so the pin is on the left and faces up.
- 44. Vertically stack 2 lime green 1x2 plates on the rightmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Now vertically place a brown 1x3 sloped curved brick on the front right corner so it slopes to the back.
- 45.1. Let's make a part! Stack 2 dark grey 2x2 round tiles with a stud in front of you. Now horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 doubled half arch brick with 1 stud on top. Then place a dark grey head on top. Now place a black hair on top. This is a statue!
- 45.2. Place your part on the 2x2 turntable plate that is centered on the previous part.
- 46.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown curved trunk with a pinhole in front of you so the bar hole is on top and faces the front. Now insert a lime green 3L bar into the bar hole. Then horizontally attach a clip of a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side to the bar so the studs are on the left and face the front. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 rounded plate with a clip and leaves on top of the ppp so the clip attaches to the bar.
- 46.2. Place the pinhole of your part on the top-facing pin that is on the front right corner so the leaves face the left.
- 47-49. Bring back your previous sub-build and horizontally place it in front of you so the 4x8 plate with a round side faces the front. Now rotate your part 180 degrees then horizontally place it on the back left corner so the leaves face the right.
- 50-51. Bring back your main build and orient it so it is horizontal and the doorway faces the front. Now attach the left-facing clips of your sub-build to the bars of the 1x2 rounded bricks that are in the back right corner.

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
