

## **77076 Durr Burger Restaurant**

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Indulge kids' creativity with the LEGO® Fortnite® Durr Burger Restaurant (77076) building set for boys and girls aged 10 and up. Based on an iconic gaming location, the video game toy lets fans cook up creative stories.

Gamers will have fun assembling the Durr Burger restaurant model, which is modular to encourage customization, before discovering all the deliciously fun details. Inside, kids will find a condiment station, a soda machine and a cash register, and outside they'll find a seating area that includes a cup and a fried egg. There's also a removable attic that includes a spider figure and enough room for other accessories, including a shovel and dynamite. Beach Bomber, Beef Boss, Grimey and skeleton minifigures bring the action to life and encourage imaginative role play.

Durr Burger restaurant model – Feed imaginations with the LEGO® Fortnite® Durr Burger Restaurant building set for kids aged 10 and up.

Video game toy – This modular build includes a cash register, condiment station, soda machine and drive-through sign featuring a menu, as well as a spicy pepper plant and fertilizer.

4 LEGO® minifigures – Beach Bomber, Beef Boss, Grimey and skeleton minifigures bring the action to life and encourage imaginative role play.

Dimensions – The burger model includes 546 pieces and measures over 10.5 in. (27 cm) high, 7 in. (18 cm) wide and 3.5 in. (9 cm) deep.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the

table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

**Axles** - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

**Pins** - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

**Technic brick** - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

**Lift-arms** - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, els and triangles.

**Gears** - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

**Axle and Pin Connectors** - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

**Bushes/Bushings** - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/77076>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

**Sorting the pieces:**

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

#### Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

##### Group 1 - Beef Boss

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 orange pair of legs printed with a light grey patch and purple straps, 1 torso printed with an orange and purple tux with a brown belt and orange bowtie, and 1 light brown and brown burger head printed with white eyes, yellow cheese, and a pink tongue, and 1 silver sword. Assemble your minifigure, attach the sword to his hand, then put him away while we make the skeleton!

##### Group 2 - Skeleton

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 white skeleton body, 2 white arms, 2 white legs, 1 white head printed with skull face, and 1 dark grey pickaxe. Assemble your minifigure, make sure the toes face the front, the clips of

the arms face the front, and attach the pickaxe to their hand! Now put it away while we make the restaurant!

#### Group 3 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

1. Horizontally place a light grey 8x16 plate with 1x4 gaps on the sides in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 plate on the front row on the 3rd to 6th columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
2. Place a blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the front left corner so the studs are in the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Then place 2 blue 2x2 tiles with 2 studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so together they are centered horizontally and the studs are in the front.
3. Vertically place a blue 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the 2nd column from the left so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place another 1 on the 2nd row from the back, on the 3rd to 6th columns from the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
4. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a purple 2x4 plate in front of you.
5. Place 2 orange 2x2 round bricks, 1 to the right of the other, underneath the ppp.
6. Horizontally place an orange 1x4 brick on the back row.
7. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2 grill tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row.
8. Horizontally place an orange 1x4 brick on the back row. Then place 4 orange 1x1 bricks with a side stud and bottom lip, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so the side studs face the front.

#### Group 4 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

9. Horizontally place a purple 1x4 plate on the back row. Then horizontally place a purple 1x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 grill tile on top of the ppp. Then place a purple 1x1 slope tile to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 10.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 rounded plate in front of you. Then place 4 light grey 1x1 bricks with a side stud and bottom lip, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp so the side studs and lips face up, and the anti-studs face the back. Now place a transparent red 1x1 round tile upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud.

#### Group 5 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

- 10.2. Place a transparent green 1x1 round tile upright on the 2nd front-facing side stud from the left.

#### Group 6 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

- 10.3. Place a transparent light blue 1x1 round tile upright on the 2nd front-facing side stud from the right.

#### Group 7 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

10.4. Place a transparent yellow 1x1 round tile upright on the rightmost front-facing side stud. Now place 4 orange 1x1 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they slope to the front.

10.5. Horizontally attach the back-facing anti-studs of your part upright on the front-facing side studs of the previous part so the slope tiles are on top.

11. This is a soda machine! Vertically place it on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically and slopes to the right.

You will have an extra yellow 1x1 round plate. Save it for later!

#### Group 8 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

There are no steps in this group. You will have an extra lime green 1x1 round plate. Save it for later!

#### Group 9 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

12.1. Let's make a part! Place an orange 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a purple 2x3 plate with a round side and a pinhole on top so the round side overhangs 1 column to the left.

12.2. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 hinge base on the rightmost column so the wall faces the right. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 slope tile to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Now place a light grey 2x2 plate with a bar underneath on top of the hinge base so 1 column overhangs and slopes to the left. It should rest on the 1x2 slope tile!

12.3. Place a yellow 1x1 round plate from group 7 on the back left stud. Then place a lime green 1x1 round plate from group 8 on the front right stud. Now place a red 1x1 round plate on the front left stud and back right stud.

12.4. Rotate your part 180 degrees. Then horizontally place it on the front 2 rows on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so the round side faces the right. This is the condiments! There is ketchup, mustard, and relish!

#### Group 10 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

13.1. Let's make a part! Stack 2 orange 2x2 round bricks in front of you. Then horizontally place a purple 2x3 plate with a round side and a pinhole on top so the round side overhangs to the left. Now place a light grey 2x2 tile with a stud on top.

13.2. Place a white 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp. Then place a white unicorn horn on top. Now place a green 1x1 round brick on top of the ppp so it sits on the 1x1 round plate.

13.3. This is a table with a bottle of relish on it! Vertically place your part on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back, and in front of the left 2x2 tile with 2 studs that is in the middle of the back 2 rows so the round side faces the front.

14. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a purple 2x4 plate in front of you.

15. Place 2 orange 2x2 round bricks, 1 to the right of the other, underneath the ppp.

16. Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top.

#### Group 11 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

There are no instructions in this group. You will have an extra brown 2x2 round plate and 1 yellow 1x1 round plate. Save them for later!

#### Group 12 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

17.1. Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a brown 2x2 round plate from group 16 on top.

17.2. Place a yellow 1x1 round plate from group 11 on the front left corner. Then place a red 1x1 round plate on the back right corner. Now place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the front right corner and back left corner. Then place a tan 2x2 round tile on top.

17.3. This is a burger! Place it on the left stud of the previous part so it is centered on the stud.

18.1. Let's make a part! Place a yellow 2x2 tile with 2 studs in front of you so the studs are in the back. Now horizontally place a light orange 1x2 plate with a rail on the long side on top so the rail faces the front.

18.2. Horizontally place a light orange 1x2 slope tile with a sticker on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

18.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the light orange 1x2 slope tile. This sticker has red and blue buttons on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

18.4. This is the cash register! Place your part on the right stud of the counter so it sits to the right of the burger and it is centered on it and it slopes to the front.

19. This is a cash register with a burger! Horizontally place your part on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, on the 3rd to 6th columns from the right so the burger is on the left.

#### Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

#### Group 13 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

20. Let's make 5 identical parts! Let's make the pillars! Place a blue 2x2 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 masonry brick on the front row so the brick grooves face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

#### Group 14 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

21. Place an orange 2x2 brick on top. Now vertically place a white 1x2 masonry brick on the left column so the brick grooves face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Group 15 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

22. Place a white 2x2 brick on top.

23. Horizontally place a white 1x2 masonry brick on the front row so the brick grooves face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

24. Place a white 2x2 brick on top.

25. Place an orange 2x2 plate on top. Then place a blue 2x2 tile with a stud on top.

26. Now you should have 5 identical parts! Rotate your main build 180 degrees so the soda machine is on the right. Place 1 part on the back left corner so the brick grooves of the bottom masonry bricks face the front and back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front. Now place 1 pillar on the front 2 rows on the 7th and 8th columns from the left so the brick grooves of the bottom masonry bricks face the front and back.

27. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a blue 1x4 brick in front of you.

28. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2x2 window frame on the 2 leftmost columns so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach a blue window pane to the front of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

29. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2x3 window frame on the 2 leftmost columns so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach a transparent window pane to the front of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

30. Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 brick with 4 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.

31. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 tile upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 tile with a cutoff corner upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so 1 row overhangs to the bottom and the cutoff corner faces the bottom right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

32. Place an orange 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on the 2 leftmost columns so 1 row overhangs to the back and the cutoff corner faces the back left. It should look like the braille letter j. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

33. Horizontally place a blue 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front row.

#### Group 16 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

34. Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

35. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 part on the 2nd column from the left so it is centered vertically and the window frames face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

36. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a blue 1x6 brick in front of you.



37. Horizontally place 3 dark grey 1x2x2 window frames, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the ridged sides face the front. Now attach a blue window pane to the front of each of the 3 ppp.

38. Horizontally place 3 dark grey 1x2x3 window frames, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the ridged sides face the front. Now attach a transparent window pane to the front of each of the 3 ppp.

39. Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 brick with 4 side studs on top so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then place a light grey 1x1 brick with a side stud on the leftmost column so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Group 17 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

40. Horizontally place 2 orange 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the front-facing side studs so together they are centered horizontally. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 tile with a cutoff corner upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so 1 row overhangs to the bottom and the cutoff corner faces the bottom right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

41. Place an orange 2x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and 1 row overhangs to the back. Now place an orange 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner to the left of the ppp so 1 row overhangs to the back and the cutoff corner faces the back left. It should look like the braille letter j. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

42. Horizontally place a blue 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Now place a blue 1x1 tile to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Group 18 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

43. Horizontally place 2 black 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so together they are centered horizontally.

44. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the front, on the 3rd to 8th columns from the right so the window panes face the front.

45. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a blue 1x4x6 door frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach a transparent door frame to the front so it opens to the left.

46. Now place an orange 1x1 round tile upright on the front-facing side stud.

47. Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 brick with 4 side studs on top so the side studs face the front.

#### Group 19 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

48. Horizontally place 2 orange 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the front-facing side studs.

49. Place an orange 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on the 2 leftmost columns so 1 row overhangs to the back and the cutoff corner faces the back left. It should look like the braille letter j. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a blue 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front row.

## Group 20 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

50. Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

51. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the front, on the 3rd to 6th columns from the left so the door opens to the front.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

## Group 21 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

52. Let's make a part! Let's make the roof! Horizontally place a light grey 8x16 plate with 1x4 gaps on the sides in front of you. Now horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 plate on the front row on the 3rd to 6th columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x4 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

53.1. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place 2 blue 1x2 plates with 1x4 side studs hanging down, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

53.2. Vertically place 2 blue 1x2 plates with 1x4 side studs hanging down, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so together they are centered vertically and the side studs face the left. Make sure there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

54.1. Place a light tan 1x1 round plate on the back left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 rounded plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

54.2. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 rounded plate on the front row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Then place a tan 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp so there is a 2 column gap in between them. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

55. Vertically place a blue 1x6 plate upright on the back 6 left-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 rounded plate upright on the front 2 left-facing side studs. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 3 blue 1x6 plates, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the front-facing side studs so there is no overhang.

56. Horizontally place a blue 1x8 tile upright on the left-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a blue 1x2 tile upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a blue 1x8 tile upright to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

57. Place a red 2x2 corner tile on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it looks like the braille letter h. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

58. Vertically stack 2 black 2x4 plates on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so they are centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

59. Vertically place a light grey 3x4 tile with 4 studs on the back 4 rows on the 5th to 7th columns from the left.

60. Horizontally stack 2 black 1x2 rounded plates on the 3rd row of studs from the front, to the right of the 2x4 plates that are on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Then vertically stack the front row of 2 more to the right of the 2 ppp. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

61. Vertically place a tan 1x2 log brick on the back 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place another 1 on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.

62. Vertically place a black 1x2x2 panel on the back 2 rows on the 3rd column from the left so the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place another 1 on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the front.

63. Vertically place a blue 2x6 plate on the back left corner so the left column sits on upright parts. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate in front of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Then horizontally place 3 blue 2x6 plates 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so together they are centered horizontally and the front row sits on upright parts.

#### Group 23 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

64. Vertically place an orange 1x2 plate on the back 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 1 on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.

65. Place an orange 2x2 slope brick on the back 2 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place another 1 on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front.

66.1. Place 3 light grey 1x1 half cylinder bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the back left corner so they slope to the left and right. Then vertically place a light grey 1x4 half cylinder brick in front of the 3 ppp so it slopes to the left and right. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

66.2. Place a light grey 2x2 corner half cylinder brick on the front left corner so it looks like the braille letter h. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x4 half cylinder brick on the front row to the right of the ppp. Now place a light grey 1x1 half cylinder brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front and back. Then repeat everything symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x4 half cylinder brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

67. Vertically place a tan 1x2 log brick on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back on the 4th column of studs from the left. It should sit 2 rows in front of and 1 column to the right of the 1x2x2 panel that is on the back left corner. Then horizontally place the leftmost column of a black 1x4 arch brick in front of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

68.1. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x3 slope brick on the 3rd row from the back, on the 3 leftmost columns of studs so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a brown 2x3 slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Now place a dark brown 3x3 corner slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front left. Now vertically place a dark brown 1x3 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the

front. Then vertically place a brown 2x3 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now vertically place another dark brown 1x3 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

68.2. Horizontally place a brown 2x3 slope brick on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back, on the 3 rightmost columns of studs so it slopes to the right. Then horizontally place a dark brown 1x3 slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the right. Now place a dark brown 3x3 corner slope brick in front of the ppp so they slope to the front right. Then vertically place 2 brown 2x3 slope bricks, 1 to the left of the other, to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

69. Place a brown 2x2x4 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns of studs of the 3rd and 4th rows from the back so it slopes to the left. Then place a brown 2x2x4 corner slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front left. Now place a brown 2x2x4 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place a brown 1x2x4 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Then repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

#### Group 24 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

70. Place an orange 2x2x4 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns of studs of the back 2 rows so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place another 1 on the front 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front.

71. Horizontally place the front row of a brown 4x10 plate behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

72. Horizontally place an orange 2x12 plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally . Then place an orange 2x2 plate on the front 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally on the 4x10 plate and 2x2x4 slope brick.

73. Horizontally place 3 orange 2x4 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so together they are centered horizontally.

74.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a nougat 3x4 crate in front of you. Place 2 red sticks of dynamite inside. Then place a dark grey shovel inside the crate too. Then attach a red fang to a green 1x1 round flower plate, then place it inside the crate. This is a pepper! None of these things should attach to any studs!

74.2. Rotate your roof build 180 degrees. Then vertically place your part on the front 4 rows, on the 3x4 tile with 4 studs that is on the 6th to 9th columns from the right so there is no overhang.

75. Place a black spider on the 3rd row from the front, to the left of the ppp so there is a 1 column gap in between them.

76. Bring back your main build and horizontally place it in front of you so the door opens to the back. Now horizontally place your roof build on top so it is centered horizontally and vertically and slopes to the back.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

#### Group 25 - Grimey

Sub-build 3.1. Locate 1 black pair of legs, 1 black torso printed with a sweater and 3 white circle outlines with eyes, 1 aqua head printed with a black mask with white eyes and mouth, 1 black hood, and 1 silver sword. Assemble your minifigure, make sure the gap of the hood faces the front, and then attach the sword to his hand.

Sub-build 3.2. Let's make a part! Place a brown 1x1 telescope bar in front of you so the anti-stud faces up. Now place a red 1x1 round plate on top. Then place a transparent orange flame on top. This is a torch! Now attach it to your minifigure, then put it away while we continue the build!

#### Group 26 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

77.1. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so the roof slopes to the front. Now let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a blue 1x4 tile on the back row. Then horizontally place a dark grey 2x6 plate with a round side underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally, 1 row is exposed to the front and the round side faces the front.

77.2. Horizontally place the back row of your part on the front row on the 3rd to 6th columns from the left so the round side overhangs 2 rows to the front.

78. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 4x8 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the front.

#### Group 27 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

79. Vertically place 2 dark brown 2x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 2 rows so together they are centered horizontally and overhang 2 rows to the back.

80.1. Place a brown 1x1 swirl on the back row of the 2nd column from the left. Then place a brown 1x1 quarter circle tile in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front left.

80.2. Place a brown 1x1 quarter circle tile on the back row of the 2nd column from the right so the curve faces the front right. Now place a brown 1x1 swirl in front of the ppp.

80.3. Place a brown 1x1 swirl on the right column of the front row. Then place a brown 1x1 quarter circle tile to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the front left.

81-82. Stack 2 brown 2x2 round tiles with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back so they are centered horizontally. Then place a brown 1x1 quarter circle tile behind the left column of the ppp so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

83. Vertically place a brown 1x2 slope tile on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back, on the 3rd column from the left so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place another 1 on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front.

84. Place a brown 1x1 quarter circle tile on the leftmost column of the back row so the curve faces the back left. Then place another 1 in front of the 1x2 slope tile that is in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

85.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a green 1x4 leaf plate in front of you so the stud with the long branch faces the left. Now place a light green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front left stud so the leaves face the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place another 1 on the leftmost stud so the leaves face the left.

85.2. Place a green claw with a bar on top of each of the 1x1 round plates with 3 leaves so the claw hands face the front and back. Now attach a red fang to each of the 3 ppp so the fangs face the right.

85.3. Attach the shorter bar of a brown L-shaped bar with an anti-stud to the rightmost anti-stud so the longer bar faces the right.

85.4. Place the right-facing bar of your part upright on the 2x2 round tile with a stud so the fangs face the front.

86. This is a plant growing peppers! Rotate your part so the round side faces the left. Now vertically place the rightmost column of your part on the leftmost column of the main build so the round side overhangs 4 columns to the left.

#### Group 28 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

87. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a blue 1x4 tile on the back row.

88. Horizontally place a dark grey 4x8 plate with a round side underneath the front row so the round side is exposed 3 rows to the front.

89. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on the back row of studs so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 sloped curved tile to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

90. Let's make another part! Let's make a dining area with an umbrella with eyes! Place a purple 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place an orange 2x2 round tile with a stud on top.

91. Place a black 2L bar with a stop on top.

92. Place a white 2x2 inverted cone brick on top of the ppp.

93. Stack 2 black 1x1 round plates on top of the top-facing bar.

94. Place a purple 2x2 round plate on top.

95. Place a white 5L bar with a stop on top of the top-facing axle hole of the ppp so the side with the stop faces up.

#### Group 29 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

96. Vertically place a pink 1x2 rounded plate on top of the 5L bar so it goes all the way down to the stop of the bar and overhangs 1 row to the front. Then place a pink 1x1 round plate underneath the front row of the ppp.

97. Place an orange 4x4 dish on top of the top-facing bar.; Then place a green 1x1 tile with a clip on top so the clip hands face front and back.

#### Group 30 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

98. Attach a white telescope to the top-facing clip so the anti-studs face the front. Now attach a transparent 1x1 dish to each of the anti-studs of the ppp. Then place a black 1x1 round plate upright on each of the anti-studs of the 2 ppp.

99. Place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front of the previous part so it is centered horizontally and the anti-studs of the 2 ppp face the front.

100. Place an orange 2x2 round brick on the 2 rightmost columns of the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Then place a purple 2x2 round plate on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

101. Place a yellow 1x1 mug on the 3rd column from the left of the 2nd row from the front so the handle faces the left. Then place a white 1x1 round tile printed with an orange egg yolk to the back right of the ppp.

102. This is the seating area! Bring back your main build and orient it so the door opens to the front. Now horizontally place the back row of your part on the front row on the 3rd to 6th columns from the right so the round side overhangs 4 rows to the front.

103. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a blue 1x4 tile on the back row.

104. Horizontally place a dark grey 2x6 plate with a round side underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally and the round side is exposed 1 row to the front.

105. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

106. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 sloped curved tile on the 2 leftmost columns of the 2nd row from the front so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

107. Place a light grey 2x2 round brick on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

108. Horizontally stack 2 light grey 1x2 half cylinder bricks, on the 2nd row from the front so they are centered horizontally and the round sides face the back.

109. Place 2 black 1x1 plates with 2 side studs sticking up, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so together they are centered horizontally and the side studs face outwards to the left and right.

110. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 rounded plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a pink 1x2 rounded plate on top of the ppp.

#### Group 31 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

111. Place a light grey 2x2 round brick on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 half cylinder brick on the back row of the ppp so the round side faces the back.

112. Place a light grey 1x1 plate with 2 side studs hanging down, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally and the side studs face outwards to the left and right.

113. Stack 2 dark grey 1x4 plates upright on the 4 left-facing side studs. Then vertically place a black 2x4 wedge plate upright on the left-facing side studs so the angled side overhangs 1 row to the front and the short side faces down.

114. Repeat the previous step symmetrically to the right.

115.1. Place a black 4x4 tile with a sticker upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the bottom.

115.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the black 4x4 tile. This sticker has a menu with a picture of a burger, egg, and drink, as well as a pepper! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

116. Place an orange 2x2 plate on top of the front row of studs above the ppp so it is centered horizontally and 1 row overhangs to the front. Now horizontally place 2 black 1x4 double sloped curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top of the ppp so they are centered horizontally.

117. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs sticking up behind the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 slope tile on top of the ppp so it slopes to the back.

118.1. Horizontally place a black 2x4 rounded tile with a sticker upright on the 2x2 front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.

118.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the black 2x4 rounded tile. This sticker has a blue background and says order in red! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

119. This is a drive through ordering system! Bring back your main build and orient it so it is horizontal and the roof slopes to the front. Now rotate your part 90 degrees counter clockwise so the 4x4 tile faces the right. Now vertically place the leftmost column of your part on the rightmost column of the build so 2 columns overhang to the right.

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 1):

Group 32 - Beach Bomber

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 dark grey pair of legs printed with 2 white stripes, and black and white shoes, 1 brown torso printed with a pink shirt with a blue llama on the clouds, 1 brown head printed with eyes, eyelashes, and dark red lips, 1 black hat with pink hair printed with a rainbow, 1 silver sword, and 1 brown shield. Assemble your minifigure then attach the sword and shield to her hands! Now put her away while we make the next part!



### Group 33 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

120. Let's make a part! Let's make the sign! Horizontally place a brown 2x8 plate in front of you. Then place an orange 2x2 tile on top so it is centered horizontally.

121. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a stud and a pinhole on the front left corner so the hole is on the right. Then insert a black 2L pin into the back-facing pinhole of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

122. Vertically place a brown 1x2 sloped curved tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

123.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a black axle connector with a pinhole in front of you so the axle hole faces the right, and the pinhole is on the left and faces up. Now insert a red 2L axle into the right-facing axle hole.

123.2. Attach a black 2L axle connector to the right-facing axle. Now insert a yellow 3L axle into the right-facing axle hole.

123.3. Attach the axle hole of a black 2L lift arm with a pinhole and axle hole to the right-facing axle so it goes all the way in and the pinhole is in the front and faces left and right.

123.4. Attach the axle connector of a pin hole with an axle hole to the right-facing axle so the pinhole is on the right and faces up. Now attach a blue 2L pin axle to the right-facing pinhole so the axle faces the right.

123.5. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach the leftmost pinhole of 1 part to the left back-facing pin of the previous part so the axle is on the left and faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. They should lean onto each other!

124. Attach a black 3L bent axle connector with a pinhole to the left top-facing axle so the other axle hole faces the top left. Now insert a tan 2L bar with a stop into the top-facing axle hole of the ppp.

125.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 6x8 rounded tile with a sticker upside down in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 rounded plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

125.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the black 6x8 rounded tile. This sticker has a blue sign that says Durrr Burger in all capital letters! Durrr is in yellow and Burger is spelled in red! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

126. Place a dark grey 2x2 plate with 2 pins on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back so it is centered horizontally and the pins are on the left and right. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 rounded plate in front of the ppp.

127. Place a light grey 2x2 round brick on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.

128-129. Horizontally attach the pins of your part to the 2 rightmost back-facing pinholes so the 2x2 round brick is on the bottom.

130. Rotate your part 180 degrees. Now horizontally place your part behind the 2x2 tile that is on the roof of your main build so it is centered horizontally and the 6x8 rounded tile faces the front.

#### Group 34 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

131. Let's make a part. Let's make a burger! Horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 black 1x2 bricks with side studs on 2 sides, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the side studs face the front and back.

132. Horizontally stack 2 lime green 1x2 rounded plates, on top so they are centered horizontally.

133. Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with side studs on 2 sides on top so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now place a dark grey 1x1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the leftmost column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

134. Horizontally stack 2 brown 1x4 plates on top.

135. Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with side studs on 2 sides on top so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then place a brown 1x1 plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

136. Place a brown 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

137. Vertically place a brown 1x4 plate upright on the left-facing side studs so it is centered vertically on the side studs. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 plate upright on the left-facing side studs so it is centered vertically. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

138. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate underneath your part so it is centered horizontally.

139. Place a brown 6x6 round plate upright on the front-facing side studs so the top row is centered horizontally on the top row of front-facing side studs.

140. Lay your part on its back so the 6x6 round plate faces up and the anti-studs face the front. Now stack 2 black 2x2 round plates on top so they are centered.

141. Place an orange 1x4 sloped curved brick on the front right corner so it slopes to the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

142.1. Flip your part upside down so the anti-studs face the right. Horizontally place the leftmost column of a black 2x4 plate with a pinhole sticking up on the 3rd column from the left so it is centered vertically and the pinhole is on the back right and faces the front and back. Now insert a black 2L pin into the front-facing pinhole of the ppp.

142.2. Horizontally attach the pinhole of a black 2x4 plate with a pinhole hanging down to the front-facing pin so the plate is upright and the studs face the right.

143. Now place a red 2x2 tile on top so it is centered.

144. Lower the right-facing side studs to the left so the studs face up.

You will have an extra yellow 2x6 plate with a round side. Save it for later!

#### Group 36 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

145.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a yellow 2x6 plate with a round side from group 35 in front of you so the round side faces the left. Now horizontally place a red 2x6 plate with a round side on the back 2 rows so the round side faces the back and 4 columns overhang to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

145.2. Flip your part upside down so the ends of the 2 2x6 plates with a round side face the right. Now place a yellow 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on the front right corner so the cutoff corner faces the front right. It should look like the braille letter h. Then place a yellow 2x2 plate to the left of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

146. Flip your part over so it is right side up and the ends of the 2 2x6 plates with a round side face the right. Now place your part on top of the previous part so the 2x4 plate with a pinhole sits in the gap of it.

147. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 rounded plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place a pink 2x2 sloped curved tile on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and slopes to the right.

148.1. Let's make a part! Place a pink 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 tile with a round side on the leftmost column so the round side faces the left. Then place a pink 2x2 sloped curved tile on the right column so it slopes and overhangs to the right. This is the tongue!

148.2. Vertically place your part upright on the 2 left-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs and slopes to the top.

#### Group 37 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

149. Let's make a part! Place a brown 6x6 round plate in front of you.

150. Stack 2 black 2x2 round plates on top so they are centered.

151. Place an orange 1x4 sloped curved brick on the front right corner so it slopes to the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

#### Group 38 - Durrr Burger Restaurant

152. Place an orange 4x4 round plate on top so it is centered. Now place an orange 2x2 round plate on top so it is centered.

153. Place a brown 1x1 round plate with a bar on the front left corner of the ppp so the bar faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 rounded plate to the right of the 2 ppp. Then place a brown 2x2 round tile with a stud on top of the 3 ppp.

154.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place an orange 1x1 plate with a clip in front of you so the clip faces the right. Now place a white 1x1 ball printed with a black eye on top.

154.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Attach the clip of 1 part to the front left facing bar so the eye faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

You will have an extra red 1x1 round tile. Save it for later!

#### Group 39 - Durr Burger Restaurant

155.1. Let's make a part! Let's make an olive! Place a lime green 1x1 brick with a side stud on each side in front of you. Now place a lime green 1x1 round tile upright on the front-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

155.2. Place a lime green 1x1 half dome brick upright on the right-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now place a lime green 1x1 round tile upright on the left-facing side stud. Then place a red 1x1 round tile from group 38 upright on the right-facing side stud.

155.3. Now insert a tan 4L bar into the bottom-facing anti-stud so a little bit sticks out from the top. Now vertically place the bar of your part on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud of your previous part.

156. Bring back your main burger part and place it in front of you so the upright 2x2 sloped curved tile faces the left. Now place your current part on top so it is centered and the eyes face the left.

157. Attach the bottom-facing 2x2 round tile with a stud of your part to the top right facing bar that is on the sign of the main build so the upright 2x2 sloped curved tile faces the front.

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
