Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.

- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner who may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/76431) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a sighted friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted into groups according to the building steps in the set. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, Numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be collected into a small Number from steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collecting all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and putting them in one container.

This set comes with 4 paper bags labelled 1-4, 1 instruction booklet, 1 sticker sheet, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split across two groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder!

LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 27: contains the pieces for steps 95-98.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Hermione Granger.

Sub build 1. Locate a short black pair of legs, a black skirt piece designed to clip over the hip section, a torso with a printed Gryffindor uniform, a red necktie and a house crest, a light brown head with a smile (note: the head has two faces — rotate to use the alternate expression, which shows a concerned look), a long brown hairpiece, and a dark brown set of wands. Assemble the minifigure, choose which face you want to display. Ask a sighted helper to help you identify the face. then break off a wand and attach it to Hermione's right hand.

Group 2 – Seamus Finnigan

Sub build 2. Locate a short dark gray pair of legs, a torso with a printed Gryffindor uniform featuring a red necktie and crest, a tan head printed with a wide smile and soot marks (hinting at a magical mishap; note: the head has two faces — rotate to use the alternate expression, which shows a startled look), a tousled reddish-brown hairpiece, and a dark brown set of wands. Assemble the Seamus Finnigan minifigure. Choose which face you want to display. Ask

a sighted helper to help you identify the face. Break off a wand and place it in his right hand. Set both Hermione Granger and Seamus Finnigan minifigures aside while we start building the potions class.

Potions Class

Group 3:

- 1. Vertically place a grey 6x14 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate on the back row on the 2 left columns, on the back left corner.
- 2. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a grey 1x2 plate horizontally to the right of the ppp. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with rail on top of the ppp, so the rail faces the back. Place a grey 1x2 plate horizontally on top of the ppp.
- 3.1 Vertically place a grey 2x4 plate on the 2nd through 5th rows from the back on the 2 right columns.
- 3.2 Let's make a square to the left of the 4 back rows of the ppp! Orient a brown 2x2 corner tile so it looks like a braille letter F In this position place it on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 2 left columns. Place another symmetrically to the right of the ppp.
- 3.3 Orient a brown 2x2 corner tile so it looks like a braille letter J. Place it in front of the ppp on the 4th and 5th rows from the back on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Place another symmetrically to the left. The 4 2x2 corner tiles should make a square, there should be 2 columns and 2 rows of studs on the center of the square. Place a brown 2x2 tile with stud on the center of the square.
- 4. Horizontally place a grey 1x4 hinge plate on the back left corner, so 2 columns overhang to the left and the round hinge part faces the front. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate on the 2 right columns of the ppp, on the 3rd and 4th columns of the back row.
- 5.1 Vertically place a 1x3 jumper plate on the 6th through 8th rows from the back on the leftmost column. place a dark grey 1x1 tile in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a 1x3 jumper plate in front of the ppp. The 2 front rows should remain empty.
- 5.2 Vertically place a grey 1x3 tile on the 3rd through 5th rows from the front on the rightmost column. Place a dark grey 1x1 tile behind the ppp. Then place a grey 1x3 tile behind the ppp.
- 6. Horizontally place a grey 1x4 hinge plate on the 2nd row from the back on the 2 right columns so 2 columns overhang to the right, and the round hinge part faces the front. Place a grey 2x2 plate on the 2 right columns of the 4th and 5th rows from the back, on the 2 front rows of the 2x4 plate.
- 7.1 Vertically place a grey 2x4 plate on the 2nd through 5th rows from the back on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right, so it covers and joins the ppps. This is the first time a piece goes across more than one row, and the rows aren't all the same length.

When that happens, we always use the longest row—the one with the most columns—to figure out where to place the piece.

Here, the 2x4 plate goes vertically across rows 2 to 5 (counting from the back), and we're placing it on columns 3 and 4 from the right of row 2, since it's the longest.

If we used one of the shorter rows to count, the placement would be off.

We'll follow this same rule for the rest of the build whenever a piece spans multiple rows.

- 7.2 Place a brown 2x2 tile with stud on the 2 front rows of the ppp.
- 8. Vertically place a grey 1x2 brick on the back right corner. Horizontally place a grey 1x4 brick on the back row to the left of the back row of the ppp. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick to the left of the ppp.
- 9. Orient a grey 2x2 corner brick so it looks like a braille letter D. In this position place it on the back right corner. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 masonry brick to the left of the back row of the ppp, so the masonry pattern faces the front. A masonry brick has two different patterns on the long sides: one is smooth with a shallow horizontal groove, and the other has a raised brick-like texture you can feel with your fingers. That textured side is the masonry pattern.
- 10.1 Horizontally place a grey 1x4x3 panel with side support and 2 stickers on the back row so it is centered horizontally, and the flat side of the panel faces front.
- 10.2 Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the back side of the grey 1x4x3 panel with side support. This sticker is grey and has a stone pattern simulating the wall of the castle. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 10.3 Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the front side of the grey 1x4x3 panel with side support. this sticker has a black background with white symbols at the top and gold letters at the bottom recreating a blackboard with potion making instructions. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 11. Place a grey 1x1x3 brick to the left of the blackboard. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then place a grey 1x1 brick with clip in front of the ppp, so the clip faces the front. The hands of the clip should face left to right.
- 12. Vertically place a grey 1x2 brick on the ppps, on the back right corner. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on the ppp so the masonry pattern faces the left. Horizontally place a grey 1x5 plate to the left of the back row of the ppp.
- 13. Vertically attach a dark grey 4L bar to the front facing clip at the right of the build, it attaches by the center of the bar.

Group 4:

- 14.1 Let's make a part! Let's build the big cauldron! Place a black 4x4 round plate in front of you. Place a black 4x4 round plate with hole on the ppp, so the edged studs are aligned.
- 14.2 Place a grey 2x2 round tile on the center of the sub build.
- 14.3 Stack 2 black 4x4 round plates with hole. Then place the stack on top of the sub build.
- 14.4 Place 4 white 1x3 curved tiles on the ppp following the shape of the circle. Place the cauldron on the 2 left columns of the 2nd through 5th rows from the back, in front of the back wall. It attaches to the brown 2x2 tile with stud from step 3.
- 15. Place a transparent orange bottle Florence Flask to the right of the ppp on the brown 2x2 tile with stud from step 7.
- 16. Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's build 2 student's desks! Horizontally place a brown 2x6 plate in front of you. Then place a red 2x2 tile with stud on the 2 left columns of the ppp. You should have now 2 identical parts.

- 17. Let's continue placing pieces onto the 2 identical parts! Stack 2 brown 1x2 plates and vertically place the stack to the right of the ppp. Place a brown 2x2 tile with 2 studs on edge on the 2 right columns so the studs are facing the left. You should now have 2 identical parts
- 18.! Let's continue placing pieces on the 2 identical parts! Place 2 brown 1x1 plates with clip on the left facing studs of the ppp, so the clips face the right. you should now have 2 identical parts.
- 19. Let's continue placing pieces! Horizontally place the right column of a brown 2x3 plate on the ppp. It goes on the 3 right columns of studs; it sits on the ppp and on the stacked 1x2 plates. You should now have 2 identical parts!

Group 5:

- 20. Let's continue placing pieces. Place a small grey pot with handle holders on the leftmost column of the sub build on top of the red 2x2 tile with stud, so the handle holders face left and right. Vertically place a tan 1x2 tile printed with the instructions of a magic textbook for brewing the potion on the 2nd column of studs from the left, so it is horizontal and centered vertically on the 2x3 plate. The printing shows a dark orange cauldron on the left, a dark brown magical text not readable beside it, and a series of dark tan icons representing potion ingredients. Place a black 1x1 round tile with pin to the right of the back row of the ppp, this is the inkwell. Attach a white quill to the ppp so the feather curves forward. Attach the handle of a spoon to the right back facing clip next to the right back corner, so it is pointing up. Attach the handle of a fork to the right facing clip on the right front corner, so it is facing up. You should now have 2 identical student's desks.
- 21. Place the first desk horizontally in front of the big cauldron and the orange bottle Florence Flask. It attaches only on the back jumper plate. Place the 2nd desk horizontally 2 rows in front of it, so it only attaches to the front 1x3 jumper plate. You have completed the first stage of construction. The stone floor of the Potions classroom now lies beneath your hands—cold, unforgiving, and ready for the trials ahead. Student desks are arranged with rigid order, awaiting those foolish enough to attempt brewing without preparation. At the back, the central wall rises, crowned by the blackboard. Upon it, an instruction is scrawled—cryptic, precise, and essential for the potion to succeed. Ignore it at your peril. This is no ordinary classroom. This is the domain of discipline, of silence, of mastery. Proceed.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 6 - Pansy Parkinson

Sub build 3. Locate a short pair of black legs with gray stripes, a black skirt piece that clips over the hips, a torso printed with a Slytherin robe and green details, a light brown head with a smirking expression (note: the head has two faces — rotate to use the alternate expression, which shows a neutral face), a black bob-style hairpiece, and a dark brown set of wands. Assemble the minifigure. Choose which face to display—smirking or neutral—. Ask a sighted helper to help you identify the face. Then break off a wand and attach it to her right hand. Set Pansy Parkinson aside while we continue building the potions class.

Potions class

Group 7:

- 22. You'll start building the right wall. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a grey 2x14 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a grey 1x4 plate on the back right corner.
- 23. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate on the 2 left columns of the ppp. Then place a dark grey 1x1 brick on the front right corner of the sub build.

- 24. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on the back row on the 5th and 6th columns from the right, so the masonry pattern faces the back. Place a grey 2x2 corner brick so it looks like a braille letter D to the left of the ppp. It must not overhang. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on the back left corner, so the masonry pattern faces the back. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick on the front left corner, in front of the left column of the ppp.
- 25. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick with side stud on the long side on the back row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right, so the side stud faces the front. Then place a grey 1x2 plate horizontally on top of the ppp.
- 26. Horizontally place a grey 1x4 brick to the left of the ppps, on the back row on the 5th through 8th columns from the right, so it sits on the right 1x2 masonry brick and on the 2x2 corner that looks like a braille letter D. Then place a grey 1x1 brick with clip on the front row on the 7th column from the right, on top of the front row of the 2x2 corner brick that looks like a braille letter D, so the clip faces the left. Attach a sand spider to the front facing side stud, so it faces the left.
- 27. Place a grey 2x2 corner brick so it looks like a braille letter F on the 6th and 7th columns from the right, the front row sits on the grey 1x1 brick with left facing clip and the 2 columns of the back row sit on the grey 1x4 brick. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick to the left of the back left corner of the ppp.
- 28. Place a grey 1x1 brick with clip on the front row on the 7th column from the right, on top of the front row of the 2x2 brick from the previous step, so the clip faces the left. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x3 brick on the back row, behind the PPP, on the 6th through 8th columns from the right.
- 29. Place a grey 2x2 corner brick on the back left corner so it looks like a braille letter F. then vertically place a grey 1x2 brick on the leftmost column. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick to the right of the back row of the ppp. Then place another grey 2x2 corner brick so it looks like a braille letter F on top of the ppps.
- 30. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on the leftmost column, so the masonry pattern faces the left. Place another vertically on the 7th column from the right, so the masonry pattern faces the right. it sits on the grey 1x1 brick with left facing clip and the dark grey 1x3 brick. Then place a grey 1x1 brick with side stud on the back row of the ppp, so the side stud faces the back. Then place a grey 1x1 slope tile in front of the ppp, so it slopes to the front.

Group 8:

- 31. Horizontally place a grey 1x6x2 arch brick on the back row on the 2nd through 7th columns from the left, so it sits on the 2nd and 7th columns from the left. Vertically place a grey 1x2 brick on the leftmost column of the sub build.
- 32. Locate a brown 1x4x6 door with round top, window and key hole and reinforced edge. Place it vertically in front of you so the ridges face down. Attach a black 1x2x2 window panel to the door window's ridges so it snaps in place. Attach the hinges of the door to the left facing clips.
- 33. Rotate the sub build 180 degrees. Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the round hinge parts face the front. Place the sub build to the right of the main build. Attach the right 1x2 overhanging plate of the main build to the 2 left columns of the front row of the sub build. Let's call the attached sub build R. wall.
- 34. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate in front of you. Then place the front row of a grey 2x2 corner brick so it looks like a braille letter H on top of the ppp. Place the sub build on the 2 back rows on the 9th and 10th columns from the left, on the front left corner of the

attached R. wall from the previous step. Remember to use the longest row when counting columns as we are using it as our column counting reference.

35. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on the left column of the ppp, so the masonry pattern faces the right. Vertically place a grey 1x2 brick on top of the ppp. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 tile on the 2nd row from the back on the 10th through 13th columns from the right to the right of the front row of the ppps.

Group 9:

- 36. Stack 2 dark grey 1x1 bricks, then place the stack on the back row on the 9th column from the left. Horizontally place the left column of a grey 1x6x2 arch brick in front of the stack. it sits on the 2nd row from the back on the 3rd and 5th columns of studs from the left. the 4 left columns of the 2nd row from the back are covered by the big cauldron so we are not counting them.
- 37. Fold a grey 1x4 hinge plate so the round hinge part faces the front. Vertically place the front row of the right column on top of the left column of the ppp so it is placed on the 2 back rows on the 8th and 9th columns from the left. The right hinge plate should be attached to the far end of the right wall, and the left hinge plate should be attached to the right end of the center back wall. Place a grey 1x1 plate to the right of the front row of the ppp, on the 2nd row from the back on the 4th column from the left.
- 38. Horizontally place a grey 1x4 plate on the back row on the 5th through 8th columns from the left. Then place a grey 1x1 slope tile in front of the right column of the ppp on the 8th column, so it slopes to the left.
- 39. Stack 2 grey 2x2 corner plates, then place the stack to the right of the ppps, so it looks like a braille letter H. there is no overhang. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the front row of the stack, so the masonry pattern faces the front. Horizontally place a grey 1x6 brick to the right of the ppp. Horizontally place another dark grey 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the ppp, so the masonry pattern faces the front. Then place the front row of a grey 2x2 corner brick to the right of the ppp on the back right corner, so it looks like a braille letter J.

Group 10:

- 40. Place a tan 2x2 corner plate so it looks like a braille letter J on top of the ppp. Place a grey 1x1 plate to the left of the front row of the ppp. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate with rail to the left of the ppp, so the rail faces the front. Place a grey 1x1 plate to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 plate to the left of the ppp. Place a grey 1x1 plate to the left of the ppp. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate with rail to the left of the ppp, so the rail faces the front. Place a grey 1x1 plate to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place the front row of a tan 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp.
- 41.1 Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick with stud on the long side in front of you, so the side stud faces the front. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 double curved slope tile on top of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally.
- 41.2 Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with stud and slope tile in front of you, so it slopes to the right. Place a dark grey 1x1 round plate on the left column of the ppp. You should now have 2 identical parts! Place the left column of the first part underneath the rightmost column of the 1x4 double curved slope tile from the previous step, so it faces and slopes to the right. Place the 2nd part symmetrically to the left. You should now have 2 identical sub builds!
- 41.3 Horizontally place the first part or sub build on the 2nd row from the back on the 2nd through 7th columns from the right, on top of the door of the classroom, so the side stud faces

the front. Skip one stud to the left, and" Place the other in the same orientation. This will be on top of the arch.

- 42. Vertically place a dark grey tile on the 2 back rows on the rightmost column. Place a dark grey 1x1 tile on the 8th column from the right on the 2nd row from the back, between the 2 attached parts from the previous step. Place a dark grey 1x1 tile on the back row on the 9th column from the left.
- 43.1 Orient a collective portrait 2x3 pentagonal tile with portrait of Edessa Sakndenberg pattern, so the triangle side faces the back. Attach the back stud to the front facing stud between the door and the arch so the triangle side faces upward. Attach a dark grey 1x6 curved tile with sticker on the front facing side stud on top of the door so it is centered horizontally on the front facing rail and the curving edge faces up and the ends face down. Place another symmetrically to the left over the arch.
- 43.2 Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place stickers 5 on the dark grey 1x6 curved tiles. There are 6 stickers labelled number 5, and in this step, we are placing 2. Both stickers are gold with brown spots. Make sure the stickers are placed on correctly and are oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

So far, you have assembled the cold stone floor where cauldrons simmer and secrets fester. The central back wall rises like the spine of the dungeon, and the right wall—crafted with precision—folds forward on its hinge, revealing hidden corners where ingredients may be stored... or concealed. Do not mistake progress for completion. The true complexity lies ahead. Proceed with care.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 11 – Severus Snape.

Sub build 4. Locate a long black pair of legs, a torso with a printed black coat and a bit of purple shirt showing, a tan head printed with a serious look with raised eyebrows (note: the head has two faces — rotate to use the alternate expression, which shows a small smile and one eyebrow slightly lifted), a smooth black hairpiece that reaches the shoulders, and a black set of wands. Assemble the Severus Snape minifigure. Choose which face you want to display. Ask a sighted helper to help you identify the face. Break off a wand and place it in his right hand. Set the Severus Snape minifigure aside while we continue building the potions classroom.

Potions class.

Group 12:

- 44. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a grey 2x14 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 brick with hole on the back right corner, so the hole faces front to back. Place another symmetrically to the left.
- 45.1 Let's make another part! Horizontally place a grey 2x3 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate on the back left corner.
- 45.2 Then place a grey 1x1 plate on the left column of the ppp.
- 45.3 Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate underneath the 2 right columns of the back row.
- 45.4 Vertically place a grey 2x4 plate in front of the ppp, so the back row attaches underneath the 2 right columns of the front row of the sub build and 3 rows extend to the front.

- 45.5. Rotate the sub build 90 degrees clockwise, so the 3 rows extend to the left. Attach the sub build to the previous part you built in the previous step by placing the back row on the 2 right columns of the front row.
- 46.1 Let's make another part! Horizontally place a grey 1x4 plate in front of you. Place the back row of a grey 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the 2 right columns of the ppp, so the studs face the left and 1 row overhangs to the front.
- 46.2 Place the back right corner of a grey 2x4 plate underneath the overhang.
- 46.3 Place a brown 2x2 tile with stud on the 2 back rows on the 2 left columns, to the left of the 2x2 tile with 2 studs.
- 46.4 Rotate the part 90 degrees counterclockwise. Place the part vertically on the 3rd through 5th columns from the right on the sub build, to the left of the right 1x2 brick with hole. There is no overhang.
- 47. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 brick on the back right corner on top of the 1x2 brick with hole. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick on top of the ppp, so the masonry pattern faces the front. Then place a grey 1x2 brick horizontally on the ppp.
- 48. Horizontally place a grey 2x6 brick on the 3rd through 8th columns from the left, the back row goes to the right of the left 1x2 brick with hole. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 slope brick to the left of the front row of the ppp, so it slopes to the left.
- 49. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate on the back left corner on top of the left 1x2 brick with hole then horizontally place the 2 right columns of a 1x4 hinge plate on the ppp, so 2 columns overhang to the left and the round hinge part faces the front. Horizontally place another grey 1x2 plate on the 2 right columns of the ppp. Horizontally place a grey 1x6 brick to the right of the ppp.

Group 13:

- 50. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate on the front row of the 2nd through 5th columns from the left. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 jumper plate to the right of the ppp. Place another horizontally on the front row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, on the 2 left columns of the brown 1x4 plate.
- 51. Horizontally Place a 1x2 masonry brick on the 7th and 8th columns from the right of the back row, so the masonry pattern faces the front. Vertically place a grey 1x2 slope brick to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 tile to the left of the back row of the ppp. Then place a dark grey 1x1 brick to the left of the ppp.
- 52. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick on top of the ppp. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x3 brick on the back row on the 7th through 9th columns from the right.
- 53. Horizontally place a grey 1x6x2 arch brick on the back row on the 2nd through 7th columns from the right, so it sits on the rightmost column of the ppp and on the left column of the grey 1x2 brick.
- 54. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick to the left of the ppp. Place a grey 1x1 brick with clip on the ppp, so the clip faces the front. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick on the rightmost column of the back row, to the right of the arch.
- 55. Horizontally place a grey 1x6x2 arch brick on the back row on the 3rd through 8th columns from the left.

- 56. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate on the 2 left columns of the ppp. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the ppp, so the masonry pattern faces the front. Horizontally place a grey 1x6 brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a dark grey 1x2 masonry brick horizontally to the right of the ppp, so the masonry pattern faces the front. The rightmost column of the back row should remain empty.
- 57. Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the round hinge parts face the front. Horizontally place the front right corner underneath the left overhanging plate of the main build. You have built the left wall of the classroom! Let's call it L. wall to make things easier. Keep it horizontally, don't fold it for the moment.
- 58. Place a grey 2x2 corner plate so it looks like a Braille letter J on the front right corner of the previous attached L. wall.

Group 14:

- 59.1 Let's make a part! Let's build a shelf! Vertically place a brown 1x2 plate in front of you. Then place a transparent 1x1 round brick on the back row of the ppp.
- 59.2 Place a transparent green 1x1 round brick in front of the ppp.
- 59.3 Place a light brown 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 59.4 Place a brown 1x2 plate on top of the ppps.

Group 15:

59.5 Place a transparent red 1x1 round brick on the back row.

Group 16:

- 59.6 Place a transparent blue 1x1 round brick in front of the ppp. Place a light brown 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 59.7 Vertically place a brown 1x2 plate on top of the ppps.

Group 17:

59.8 Then vertically place a grey 1x2 plate on top of the ppp. Place the shelf with its bottles on the rightmost column of the left wall, so the front row sits on the back row of the 2x2 corner plate from the previous step.

Group 18:

- 60. Horizontally place the right column of a grey 1x2 slope brick in front of the shelf with bottles so it slopes to the left. Then place a grey 1x1x3 brick on the ppp.
- 61. Place a dark grey 1x2 inverted slope brick on top of the ppp, so it curves upward to the left. Vertically place a dark grey 1x3 brick behind the right column of the ppp, so it sits on the shelf and on the back right corner of the L. wall.
- 62. Place a grey 2x2 corner brick so it looks like a braille letter D on the back right corner of the L. wall. Place a grey 2x2 corner plate so it looks like a braille letter J in front of the right column of the ppp.
- 63. place the 2 left columns of a grey 1x4 hinge plate on the front row of the ppp, so the round hinge part faces the front, and the 2 right columns sit on the central wall. Place a dark grey 1x1 round plate behind the 2nd column from the left of the ppp, on the back row of the 2x2 corner plate from the previous step.

Group 19:

- 64.1 Let's make a part! Horizontally place a grey 1x6 plate in front of you. Place a grey 1x2 plate with rail on the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and the rail faces the front.
- 64.2 Place a grey 1x1 plate to the right of the ppp. Place another symmetrically to the left.
- 64.3 Place a tan 1x1 plate to the left of the ppp. Place another symmetrically to the right.
- 64.4 Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with stud and slope tile on the 2 right columns, so it slopes to the right. Place another symmetrically to the left. Place a dark grey 1x1 round plate on the stud of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick with side stud on the long side to the left of the ppp, so the side stud faces the front, and it sits on the 1x2 plate with rail.
- 64.5 Horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 double curved slope tile on the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. You've built a Half-circle topper.
- 64.6 Horizontally place the sub build on top of the central wall, so the rail faces the front. There is no overhang.
- 65.1 Attach a dark grey 1x6 curved tile with sticker on the front facing side stud on top of the blackboard so it is centered horizontally on the front facing rail, and the curving edge faces up and the ends face down.
- 65.2 Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the dark grey 1x6 curved tile. This sticker is gold with brown spots. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 20:

- 66.1 Stack a tan 2x2 corner plate onto a grey 2x2 corner plate so the stack looks like a braille letter J. Place the stack on the front right corner of the L. wall, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left of the 3rd and 4th rows from the back.
- 66.2 Place a tan 2x2 corner plate symmetrically to the back, on the back right corner of the L. wall.
- 66.3 Place a grey 1x1 plate to the left of the back row of the ppp. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate with rail to the left of the ppp, so the rail faces the front. Place a grey 1x1 plate to the left of the ppp. Horizontally place a tan 1x3 plate to the left of the ppp. Place a grey 1x1 plate to the left of the ppp. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate with rail to the left of the ppp, so the rail faces the front.
- 67.1 Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 round tile with upright bar in front of you. Place a grey lightsaber hilt with bottom ring on the ppp.
- 67.2 Place a grey 1x1 plate with clip on top of the part, so the clip faces the right.
- 67.3 Hold a white 2L bar with stop ring upright. Push a white 1x1 round plate with open stud down through the bar until it reaches the stop ring, the hollow stud should face up. Then attach a transparent yellow 1x1 cone brick on the ppp. Turn the part upside down and attach it by the free bar's end to the right facing side clip of the previous part.
- 67.4 Horizontally place the part on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of the 2nd row from the back to the left of the front facing slope.

- 68.1 Let's make a part! Locate a black 1x1 round tile with upright bar and turn it upside down. Attach the bottom pin of a Transparent Orange flame candle to the ppp. Attach the candle by the upright bar to the front facing clip of the L. wall.
- 68.2 Place a white 1x1 round plate with open stud in front of you. Then attach the bottom bar of a transparent pink 1x1 shaped jewel heart to the open stud of the ppp. Place the part to the left of the previous part so it sits on the brown 1x2 jumper plate.
- 68.3 Place a golden goblet on the leftmost column of studs of the 2nd row from the back, below the previous attached candle.
- 69.1 Let's make a part! Let's build Professor Snape's desk! Place a brown 2x2 plate in front of you. Vertically place a brown 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column.
- 69.2 Place another symmetrically to the right.
- 69.3 Attach a brown 2x2 hinge brick top plate to a brown 1x2 base hinge brick. Horizontally place the base hinge brick on the 2 studs of the jumper plates, so the top plate faces the back, so it is at a 45-degree angle.
- 69.4 Place a brown 2x2 plate on the hinge brick top plate.
- 69.5 Vertically place a tan 1x2 tile printed with the instructions for brewing the potion on the left column of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile with pin to the right of the back row of the ppp, this is the inkwell. Attach a white quill to the ppp so the feather curves forward.
- 69.6 Rotate the sub build 180 degrees and place it on the leftmost column of studs of the 4th row from the back, so it sits on the brown 2x2 tile with stud. You have now constructed the left wall—hinged at the far corner of the central back wall. It folds forward with quiet precision, revealing shelves lined with bottles of rare ingredients and volatile potions. Do not touch them. Some react poorly to clumsy hands. Continue building, and remember in this classroom, mistakes are not tolerated.

- 70. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a grey 2x8 plate in front of you. Place a grey 1x4 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 71.1 Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp. Horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate with rail on top of the ppp, so the rail faces the back. Then horizontally place a grey 1x2 plate on top of the ppp.
- 71.2 Vertically place a grey 1x2 brick with handle on the 2nd column from the right, so the handle faces the front. Then place a grey 2x2 corner brick so it looks like a braille letter F to the right of the ppp. The right column of the back row overhangs to the right.

- 84.2 Let's make 6 identical parts! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with stud and slope tile in front of you, so it slopes to the right. Place a dark grey 1x1 round plate on the left column of the ppp. You should now have 6 identical parts! Place the left column of the first part underneath the rightmost column of the main sub build, so it faces and slopes to the right. Place the 2nd part symmetrically to the left. Repeat the process twice more for the other 2 half-circle toppers. You should have now 3 identical half-circle toppers!
- 84.3 Horizontally place the first sub build on the 2nd through 7th columns from the left of the back row, so the side stud faces the front. Horizontally place the 2nd sub build on the 9th through 14th columns from the right of the back row, so the side stud faces the front. Place the third sub build horizontally on the 2nd through 7th columns from the right of the back row, so the side stud faces the front.

- 91. Let's make a part! Place a brown 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on the back row of the ppp. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with clip on the short side in front of the ppp so the clip faces the left. Place a brown 2x2 plate on top of the ppps. Place the part keeping the same position on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left to the left of the 1x1 round bricks.
- 92. Horizontally place a brown 1x8 plate on the front row of the sub build so it sits on the 1x1 round bricks and on the previous attached part. Then horizontally place a brown 1x8 tile behind the ppp.
- 93. Place 4 tan 2x2 round tiles with open stud on the sub build. The front row of the 2x2 round tiles with open stud sit on the brown 1x8 plate from the previous step.
- 94. insert the bar of a black 1x1 round tile with upright bar into the open stud of each of the ppps.

Group 27:

- 95.1 Place a transparent 2x2x1 round brick with dome top and sticker upside down on the 2nd hole from the right. This is a receptacle to store magic ingredients.
- 95.2 Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the front side of the transparent 2x2x1 round brick with dome top. This sticker has a tan background and a green leaf. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 95.3 Place 3 lime 1x1 quarter round tiles loosely inside the receptacle, they represent the magic ingredients.
- 95.4 Place a transparent 2x2x1 round brick with dome top and sticker upside down on the 2nd hole from the left. This is a receptacle to store magic ingredients.
- 95.5 Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the front side of the transparent 2x2x1 round brick with dome top. - 98.2 Stack 2 transparent 1x1 round plates and place the stack at the bottom of a transparent lime column of bubbles energy effect. Place a transparent lime column of bubbles energy effect inside the cauldron of the second student's desk located behind the previous one.
- 98.3 Let's close the potions Classroom! start with the front wall: Use the hinge on the corner to fold the front wall forward, toward you. It should now be standing vertically, forming the front side of the classroom. Next, the left wall: Fold the left wall forward so it becomes vertical. This wall now covers the left side and connects with the front wall. Finally, the right wall: Push or fold the right wall forward until it's vertical. This completes the structure, forming the right side of the classroom. At last, you have assembled the classroom. The walls stand. The potions await. No foolish wand-waving, no silly incantations—just discipline, precision, and silence. You may consider this task complete. For now.
