A magical holiday gift toy or birthday present for boys, girls and any fans aged 8 and up, this fantasy adventure set includes 5 LEGO Harry Potter minifigures and a Ripper the dog figure. It also features an inflated Aunt Marge figure to recreate the hilarious scene where Harry casts a spell to blow her up like a balloon, plus a side-build with the 'Privet Drive' sign and lamppost.

The back of the box shows the interior of the house! They have beds, a toilet, living rooms, and stairs!

The top of the box shows a real size image of inflatable Aunt Marge!

The build is 639 pieces in total and is for ages 8+.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.

- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic[™] part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic[™].

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ells and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/76451) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 6 bags labeled 1 to 6, 2 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Harry Potter

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 short dark tan pair of legs, 1 dark blue torso printed with a jacket, 1 light tan head printed with eyes, lips, and glasses, 1 black hair, and 1 brown set of wands. Assemble your minifigure, break off 1 wand from the set and attach it to your minifigure. Now put them away while we make the next part!

Group 2 - Lamp

- 1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 2x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark green 1x2 slope brick on the back right corner so it slopes to the right.
- 2. Horizontally place a black 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row to the right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x4 tile in front of the ppp.
- 3. Place a dark green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front right corner so the leaves face the front left. Then place another 1 on the back row on the 1x2 slope brick so the leaves face the right.
- 4. Place a black 1x1 brick on the back row on the 3rd column from the left. Then place a black 1x1 brick with a side stud and bottom lip on top of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Group 3 - Lamp

- 5.1. Horizontally place an aqua 1x4 tile with a sticker upright on the 2 front-facing side studs.
- 5.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the aqua 1x4 tile. This sticker has a white background and says Privet Drive. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 6. Stack 2 black candle sticks on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the 2 leftmost columns.
- 7. Place a white owl on the back row on the 3rd column from the right so it faces the front.
- 8.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a black axle connector with 2 bar holes in front of you so the bar holes face the front, and back and the axle connector faces left and right. Now insert a black 3L bar into the left-facing axle hole so it is centered horizontally.
- 8.2. Insert a dark grey 2L bar with a stop into the back-facing bar hole. Now insert the side with a stop of a black 5L bar with a stop into the front-facing bar hole.
- 8.3. Place the 5L bar with a stop of your part on top of the candle sticks that are on the 2 leftmost columns so the 3L bar faces left and right.
- 8.4. Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 round plate with a hollow stud in front of you. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 brick on top. Then place a black 2x2 tile with a stud on top so it is centered. Now place a black 1x1 pyramid tile on top.
- 8.5. Place your part on top of the 2L bar with a stop on your previous part so it is centered on it! This is a lamp!

Group 4 - House

- 1. Let's make the house now! Horizontally place a green 4x8 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the front. Now horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally.
- 2. Horizontally place a brown 2x8 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally and 1 row overhangs to the back.
- 3. Horizontally place the front left corner of a dark tan 6x16 plate underneath the back row so 5 rows are exposed to the back and 8 columns are exposed to the right.
- 4. Horizontally place a brown 2x8 plate on the front row of the 8 rightmost columns so 1 row overhangs to the front. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x8 plate underneath the overhang of the ppp.
- 5. Vertically place a brown 1x4 plate on the back left corner. Then place a brown 1x1 plate in front of the ppp. Now place a brown 1x1 plate on the rightmost column on the 5th row from the back.
- 6. Place 2 white 2x2 tiles with 2 studs, 1 in front of the other, on the back 4 rows of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the studs are on the left. Now place a green 1x1 round flower plate in front of the left column of the ppp.
- 7. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a clip on the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick in front of the ppp.
- 8. Horizontally place the leftmost column of a tan 1x8 brick in front of the ppp. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp.
- 9. Horizontally place a dark green 1x2 plate with a stud and an upright clip on the 2 leftmost columns of the 7th row from the back so the clip is on the left. Now place the back row of 2 dark green 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp. Now place a green 1x1 round flower plate to the right of the back row of the ppp.
- 10. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 masonry brick on the front row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so the brick grooves face the front. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x4 tile to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 masonry brick to the left of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front.
- 11. Horizontally place a tan 1x8 brick on the 6th row from the back on the 2nd to 9th columns from the left. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 rounded plate in front of the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp.
- 12. Place 2 green stems with 3 tips, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp.
- 13. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left of the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so the leaves face the front. Then place another 1 on top of the ppp so the leaves face the left.
- 14. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves to the right of the ppp so it sits on the 2x2 tile with a stud and the leaves face the front right. Then place another 1 on top so the leaves face the front. Now place 1 more on top so the leaves face the right.

Group 5 - House

- 15. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the left stack of round plates with 3 leaves so the leaves face the front right. Then place a light purple 1x1 round flower plate on the ppp.
- 16. Place a green 1x1 round plate with leaves on the right stack of round plates with leaves so the leaves face the front. Then place another 1 on top so the leaves face the front right. Now place a light purple 1x1 round flower plate on the ppp.
- 17. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now place a white 1x1x2/3 brick with 2 side studs on the front row of the 2nd column from the right so the side studs face the left. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile printed with an envelope on the 3rd row from the front of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right. Now place a white 1x1x2/3 brick with 2 side studs behind the right column of the ppp so the side studs face the left.
- 18.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a gold 1x2x2 window frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the back. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 rounded plate on top.
- 18.2. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a sticker on top so the sticker faces the front. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 ingot tile on top.
- 18.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 14 on the light grey 1x2 brick. This sticker has a red and orange fiery background with a teal person and orange person! The sticker has the news on it and it is about an escaped convict, Sirius Black, who is described as armed and highly dangerous. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 18.4. This is a TV! Horizontally place your part on the 5th row from the front of the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so the sticker faces the front.
- 19. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the side studs face the front. Now place the right column of a brown 2x2 corner tile upright on the 2 rightmost front-facing side studs so 1 column overhangs to the left and it looks like the braille letter d. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 20. Horizontally place 2 brown 1x2 plates with a rail on the long side, 1 to the right of the other, on the 4 rightmost columns of the 2nd row from the back so the rails face the front. They should each sit on 1 stud.

You will have an extra brown 1x1 round tile. Save it for later!

Group 6 - House

- 21.1. Rotate your main build 90 degrees clockwise so the plates with leaves are in the back. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 jumper plate in front of you. Then place a brown 1x1 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the left. Now place a brown 1x1 round tile on top. Then place a gold 1x1 round tile printed with a clock upright on the left-facing side stud.
- 21.2. Vertically place your part on the 2nd column from the right, on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so the upright round tile faces the left. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 brick on top of the ppp. Now place a gold 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp.

- 21.3. Place a white minifigure statue on the front row on the 2nd column from the right.
- 22. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark red 2x4 plate in front of you.
- 23. Vertically place a black 1x3 rounded plate underneath the leftmost column so 1 row is exposed to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 24. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x4 plate on the back row.
- 25. Horizontally place a dark red 1x4 brick on the back row. Then place a dark red 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally and the studs are in the front.
- 26. Vertically stack 2 dark red 1x2 plates on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 27. Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a dark red 1x4 double sloped curved tile on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.
- 28. Place 2 dark red 1x1 half cylinder bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the front left corner so they slope to the left and right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 29. This is a couch! Horizontally place your part on the 3rd to 5th rows from the front, of the 5th to 8th columns from the right so the double sloped curved tile is in the back.

You will have an extra green 1x1 round flower plate. Save it for later!

Group 7 - House

- 30.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate on the right column. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate from group 6 on the left column. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate on the left column.
- 30.2. Horizontally place your part on the back row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left.
- 31.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x2x2 brick in front of you. Then place a tan 1x1 brick with a clip on the right column so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 31.2. Attach a black umbrella to the right front-facing clip so it faces down. Now vertically attach a white telephone to the left front-facing clip.
- 31.3. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the back, on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the clips face the front.
- 32. Vertically place a tan 1x2x2 brick on the leftmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick with a clip on the back row of the ppp so the clip faces the back. Now place a dark tan 1x1 brick in front of the ppp.
- 33. Vertically place a tan 1x4x3 panel on the front left corner so the wall faces the left. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x4 plate on top of the ppp.

34. Horizontally place 3 brown 1x2 ingot tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row, to the right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a brown 2x6 tile behind the 3 ppp.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 8 - Petunia Dursley

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 dark red pair of legs, 1 white torso printed with a white shirt with leaves, 1 light tan head printed with eyes, eye lashes, and light nougat lips, and 1 brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her away while we continue the house.

Group 9 - House

- 35. Bring back your main build and make sure it is horizontal and the leaves are in the back. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 masonry brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right of the 6th row from the front so the brick grooves face the back. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick to the left of the ppp.
- 36. Vertically stack 2 tan 1x6 bricks on the front left corner.
- 37. Horizontally stack 2 tan 1x2 bricks with a side stud to the right of the back row of the 2 ppp so the side studs face the back.
- 38. Place a tan 2x2 corner brick on the 2 leftmost columns on the 5th and 6th rows from the front so it looks like the braille letter f.
- 39. Place a light grey 1x1 brick with a clip on the front left corner so the clip faces the front. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs behind the ppp so the side studs face the right. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick behind the ppp. Now place another 1 to the right of the back row of the 2x2 corner brick that is behind the ppp.
- 40. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side behind the ppp so the bar faces the left. Now vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate behind the ppp.
- 41.1. Vertically place a brown 2x3 tile with a sticker upright on the 2 right-facing side studs that are on the leftmost column so it hangs 2 rows to the bottom.
- 41.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the brown 2x3 tile. This sticker has a black background with a gold clock tower on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 42.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x4x6 door frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach a brown door with 2 stickers to the front so it opens to the right. Then place a black 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud.
- 42.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the front-facing side of the door. This sticker has light brown squares and rectangles etched into the wood. It also

has a mail slot filled with tons of envelopes! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

- 42.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the backfacing side of the door. This sticker has light brown squares and rectangles etched into the wood. It also has a lock on it and a nailed plank over the mail slot. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 42.4. Horizontally place your part on the back row on the 4th to 7th columns from the left so the door opens to the back.

Group 10 - House

- 43. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with a side stud to the right of the ppp so the side stud faces the back. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 masonry brick on top so the brick grooves face the back. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the right column of the ppp. Now place a short tan 1x1 brick to the left of the ppp.
- 44. Stack 2 tan 1x1x3 bricks in front of the ppp.
- 45. Vertically place a tan 1x4x6 door frame in front of the 2 ppp so the ridged side faces the right.
- 46. Vertically place a dark tan 1x6 plate on top of the ppp so there is no overhang.
- 47.1. Let's make 3 identical parts! Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2x3 window frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the back. Now attach a transparent window pane with a sticker to the back-facing side so the sticker faces the back.
- 47.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 11 on each of the 3 glass panes. These stickers have a diamond grid design on them. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 47.3. Now you should have 3 identical parts! Horizontally place them, 1 to the right of the other, on the 6th row from the front, on the 2nd to 7th columns from the right so the panes face the back.
- 48.1. Vertically place a tan 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the front right corner so the wall faces the right.
- 48.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the tan 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a picture of the family! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 49.1. Vertically place a tan 1x5 plate on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x4 plate behind the ppp so there is no overhang. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x3 tile to the left of the ppp.
- 49.2. Vertically place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front 4 rows of the 8th column from the left. Then place a black 1x1 tile behind the ppp.
- 50.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 2x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place 4 dark brown 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they slope to the back.

- 50.2. Horizontally place your part on the back row of the 2nd to 9th columns from the left so the slopes overhang to the back.
- 51.1. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now vertically place a black 1x2 rounded tile with a sticker upright on the rightmost bottom front-facing side stud so 1 row overhangs to the bottom.
- 51.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 12 on the black 1x2 rounded tile. This sticker has the number 4 on it with flowers above it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 52. Place a black 1x1 plate with an upright side stud upright above the ppp so the side stud faces up. Now place a black 1x1 pyramid tile on the top-facing stud of the ppp. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 plate upright on the front-facing side stud above the 1x2 rounded tile.
- 53.1. Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 round plate with a horizontal bar upside down in front of you so the bar faces the back. Then place a black 2x2 dome brick upside down on top of the ppp. Now place a green stem with 3 tips on top so it is centered. Then attach 3 white flowers to the 3 tips of the ppp!
- 53.2. Attach the back-facing bar of your part to the front-facing side stud that is to the left of the door.

Group 11 - House

- 54.1. Let's make a part! Place a dark green 1x1 round plate with a leaf in front of you so the leaf faces the right. Then place another 1 on top so the leaf faces the back. Now place a brown 2L bar with a stop on top. Then place a brown bar holder with a handle on top.
- 54.2. Attach the handle of your part to the top-facing clip that is on the front row of the leftmost column so it leans to the left and the leaves face the front and right.
- 55. Let's make a part! Place a dark green 1x1 cone brick upside down in front of you. Then place a dark green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on top of the ppp so the leaves face the back.
- 56. Place a brown 2L bar with a stop on top.
- 57. Place a dark green 1x1 round plate with a leaf on top of the ppp so the leaf faces the right. Then place another 1 on top so the leaf faces the back.
- 58. Place a brown 1x1 round brick on top.
- 59. Flip your part over so the cone brick faces up, then place it on top of your previous part so the leaves face the front right and front left. This is a tree!

Group 12 - House

60. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark tan 6x16 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the back right corner.

- 61. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a clip on the front right corner so the clip faces the right. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick behind the ppp.
- 62. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x6 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the 2 ppp so the brick grooves face the back.
- 63. Vertically place a mint blue 1x3 brick on the 2nd column from the right, on the 2nd to 4th rows from the back. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left of the front row of the ppp. Now vertically place the front row of another 1 to the left of the ppp.
- 64.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a table with a computer on it! Horizontally place a brown 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a dark brown 1x2 log brick underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 64.2. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 jumper plate on the back row. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile printed with a keyboard on the front left corner. Now place a white 1x1 tile with a round side to the right of the ppp so the round side faces the front. This is a mouse!
- 64.3. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back of the 7th to 9th columns from the right.

You will have an extra red 1x3 tile and red 1x3 jumper plate. Save them for later!

Group 13 - House

- 65.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x5 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x3 jumper plate on the rightmost column so 2 rows overhang to the front. Now horizontally place 2 white 1x5 plates, 1 in front of the other, underneath the front 2 rows so they are aligned with the previous 1x5 plate.
- 65.2. Vertically place a red 1x3 jumper plate from group 12 on the leftmost column. Now vertically place a dark red 1x3 tile to the right of the ppp. Then vertically place a red 1x3 tile from group 12 to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place a dark red 1x3 tile to the right of the ppp.
- 65.3. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope tile on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left.
- 65.4. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd to 4th rows from the back of the 2nd to 6th columns from the right so the 1x2 slope tile is on the right. This is a bed!
- 66. Place a black 2x2 round plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, on the 8th and 9th columns from the left. Then place a dark red 2x2 chair on top of the ppp so the back of the chair faces the front.
- 67. Place a tan 1x1 round plate on the 2nd column from the left on the 2nd row from the back. Now place a white 1x1 swirl on top of the ppp.

Group 14 - House

- 68. Place a transparent wine glass to the right of the ppp. Then place a pink 1x1 swirl on top of the ppp.
- 69.1. Place a light brown 1x1 round tile printed with a pie in front of the ppp.

Group 15 - House

- 69.2. Place a light brown 1x1 round tile printed with a pink donut to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place a black 1x2 gaming controller in front of the ppp so the 2 rounded tips face the right.
- 70.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x2 jumper plate in front of you. Then horizontally place the left column of another 1 on top of the stud so it overhangs a little to the right. Then horizontally place the right column of a brown 1x2 tile printed with a chocolate bar on top so it overhangs a little to the left.
- 70.2. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the back, on the 4th and 5th columns from the left.

Group 16 - House

- 71.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place a brown 1x4 rounded plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 jumper plate with a round side on top so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the right. Then place a yellow 1x1 round tile on top of the ppp.
- 71.2. Place a short brown 1x1 brick on the front row. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a brown 1x4 tile on top so it is centered vertically.
- 71.3. Vertically place your part on the front 4 rows of the 2nd column from the left so the round side of the 1x2 jumper plate with a round side faces the right.
- 72. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then vertically place a yellow 1x4 brick behind the ppp. Now place a tan 1x1 brick with a clip behind the ppp so the clip faces the back.
- 73. Horizontally place your part on top of your main build so it is centered and the clip of the ppp is in the back left corner.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 17 - Dudley Dursley

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 short black pair of legs, 1 dark blue and light blue torso printed with a white bib, 1 light tan head printed with eyes and lips, and 1 brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put him away while we continue the main build.

Group 18 - House

74. Make sure the house is horizontal in front of you and the door opens to the back. Now place a tan 2x2 corner brick on the back right corner so it looks like the braille letter d. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the front right corner.

- 75. Vertically place a tan 1x6 brick on the rightmost column. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the back right corner. Then place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the left.
- 76. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick on the back row on the 3rd to 6th columns from the left. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the ppp so the brick grooves face the back. Then horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick to the right of the ppp.
- 77. Place a tan 2x2 corner brick on the back left corner so it looks like the braille letter f. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the front left corner.
- 78.1. Let's make 3 identical parts! Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2x2 window frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the back. Now attach a transparent window pane with a sticker to the back-facing side so the sticker faces the back.
- 78.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 17 on each of the 3 glass panes. These stickers have a diamond grid design on them. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 78.3. Now you should have 3 identical parts! Horizontally place them, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row on the 2nd to 7th columns from the right so the panes face the back.
- 79.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the front. Now horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the ppp so the brick grooves face the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 79.2. Horizontally place your part on the back row on the 4th to 9th columns from the left so the side stud faces the front.
- 80.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2x2 window frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the back. Now attach a transparent window pane with a sticker to the back-facing side so the sticker faces the back.
- 80.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 17 on the glass pane. This sticker has a diamond grid design on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 80.3. Horizontally place your part on the back row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so the pane faces the back.
- 81.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a sticker on top so the sticker faces the front. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 ingot tile on top.
- 81.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 13 on the white 1x2 brick. This sticker has a teal screen with a pool table on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

- 81.3. Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the back, on the 1x3 rounded plate that is on the 7th to 9th columns from the right so the sticker faces the front.
- 82.1. Horizontally place a brown 2x3 tile with a sticker upright on the front-facing side stud that is to the left of the previous part so it is centered horizontally on it and 1 row overhangs to the bottom.
- 82.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the brown 2x3 tile. This sticker has a picture of a referee holding up the winner's hand in a boxing ring! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 83. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the back left corner. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x2 brick with an axle hole in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a side stud in front of the ppp so the side stud faces the right. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the front left corner.
- 84. Vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the back left corner. Then place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the right.

Group 19 - House

- 85.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light grey 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 2x3 tile with a sticker on top of the ppp.
- 85.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 16 on the light grey 2x3 tile. This sticker has a screen with fire that says MM3 which means WWE! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 85.3. Horizontally place your part upright on the right-facing side stud that is on the leftmost column so 1 row overhangs to the bottom and it is centered horizontally on it.
- 86. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x5 plate on the back left corner.
- 87. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the front left corner.
- 88. Place a tan 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns.
- 89. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the back left corner. Then place a short tan 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp. Now place another 1 on the front row on the 3rd column from the left.
- 90. Place a dark tan 1x1 slope tile on the back right corner so it slopes to the right. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 slope brick to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the right.
- 91. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 jumper plate on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 sloped curved brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the right.
- 92. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a stud and an upright clip on the 1x3 jumper plate that is on the front left corner so the clip is on the left.
- 93. Vertically place your part on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the back.

- 94. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x6 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row to the right of the previous part.
- 95. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x5 plate on the back right corner.
- 96. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the front right corner.
- 97. Place a tan 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns.
- 98. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then place a short tan 1x1 brick to the left of the ppp. Now place another 1 on the front row on the 3rd column from the right.
- 99. Place a dark tan 1x1 slope tile on the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the left.
- 100. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 jumper plate on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 sloped curved brick on the back right corner so it slopes to the left.
- 101. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a stud and an upright clip on the 1x3 jumper plate that is on the front right corner so the clip is on the right.
- 102. Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the back.

Group 20 - House

- 103.1. Let's make a part! Place a black 6L antenna in front of you. Then place a black 2L bar with a stud on each end on top. Now place a black 6L bar with 2 stops and a bend on top so it bends to the left. Now place a short black 1x1 brick upside down on top so the anti-stud faces up.
- 103.2. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so the door opens to the front. Now place your part on the front right corner so it attaches to the 2 clips. This is the drain for the gutter!
- 104. Let's make a part! horizontally place a dark brown 8x16 plate upside down in front of you.
- 105. Vertically place a brown 2x3 plate with a bar underneath on the back 3 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 106. Flip your part over so it is right side up and the 2 ppps are in the front. Now horizontally place 2 black 1x8 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally.
- 107.1. Place a brown 1x1 tile with a round side on the 2nd column from the left, on the 3rd row from the back so the round side faces the back. Then place another 1 on the 3rd column from the right, on the 2nd row from the back so the round side faces the back. Now place another 1 on the 7th column from the left, on the 2nd row from the back so the round side faces the back. Then place 1 more on the 7th column from the right, on the 5th row from the back so the round side faces the back.

- 107.2. Place a dark green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 3rd column from the left, on the 6th row from the back so the leaves face the back. Now place another 1 on the 5th column from the right, on the 4th row from the back so the leaves face the back. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope tile on the front row of studs, on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so it slopes to the front.
- 108.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown 1x1 tile with an upright clip in front of you so the clip hands face the front and back. Now place a light grey bar holder with a handle on top so the bar hole faces up. Then insert the bar of a light grey 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top of the ppp.
- 108.2. Place your part on the 3rd row from the back, on the 5th column from the left so it angles to the front.
- 109. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 hinge base behind the 1x2 slope tile that is on the front right corner so the wall faces the back. Then place a tan 2x2 plate with a bar underneath on top so it overhangs 1 row to the front.
- 110. This is the roof! Rotate your roof 180 degrees. Now attach the bottom-facing bars of your part to the 2 top-facing clips that are on the back left and back right corners of the main build so the roof slopes to the front!
- 111.1. Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a tan 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Now place a light grey 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top. Then place a bar with an end stud and a double sided stud on top so the double sided stud is on top and faces left and right. Now attach a silver fork to the right-facing side stud.
- 111.2. This is a radio antenna! Place your part on the 2x2 studs that are on the back 2 rows of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. These studs should be flat and not sloped! Now put your house away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 2):

Group 21 - Vernon Dursley

Sub-build 4. Locate 1 brown pair of legs, 1 tan torso printed with a green vest, 1 light tan head printed with eyes, lips, and a grey mustache, and 1 light grey hair. Assemble your minifigure then put him away while we make the house!

Group 22 - House

- 1. Let's make a house! Place a green 6x6 quarter circle plate in front of you so the curve faces the front right. Now place a light grey 2x2 round tile on the front left corner so 1 column overhangs to the left.
- 2. Place a green 6x6 quarter circle plate underneath the overhang of the ppp so it is aligned with the previous quarter circle plate and the curve faces the front left.
- 3. Horizontally place a brown 1x6 plate on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.
- 4. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 slope tile behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front. Now place a light grey 1x1 round tile on the 2nd row from the front, to the left of the 2x2 round tile.

Then place a dark green 2x2 round tile with a stud on the front left corner so the back row sits to the left of the 1x6 plate.

- 5. Place a brown 4x4 plate on the back 3 rows on the 2nd to 5th columns from the left so 1 row overhangs to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 6. Horizontally place a dark tan 6x16 plate underneath the back row so the rightmost column is aligned with the rightmost column of the build.
- 7. Place a brown 3x3 plate on the back right corner. Then horizontally place a brown 2x3 plate in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 rounded plate on the rightmost column in front of the ppp.
- 8. Place a dark tan 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows on the 6th and 7th columns from the right. Now vertically place a dark tan 2x4 tile in front of the ppp. Then place a dark tan 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the ppp. Now place another 1 on the 4th and 5th rows from the back, to the left of the previous 2x4 tile that is behind the ppp.
- 9. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a clip on the back right corner so the clip faces the right. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick in front of the ppp. Now place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the rightmost column on the 7th row from the back. Then place another 1 on the 2nd row from the front of the 2nd column from the right.
- 10. Place a dark tan 2x2 corner brick on the 2 rightmost columns on the 6th and 7th rows from the back so it looks like the braille letter f. Then place the right column of a tan 2x2 corner brick with a cutoff corner in front of the left column of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front right.
- 11. Place a light brown 1x1 round brick in front of the left column of the ppp. Now place a green stem with 3 tips on top of the ppp.
- 12. Vertically place 3 tan 1x2x3 bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the back right corner.
- 13. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then vertically place 2 tan 1x2 bricks with a side stud, 1 in front of the other, in front of the ppp so the side studs face the left. Now place a dark tan 1x1 brick in front of the 2 ppp.
- 14. Insert a gold T-shaped bar into each of the 2 left-facing side studs that are on the rightmost column so the bars face up and down. Then place a red 1x1 cupcake wrapper upside down on top of each of the 2 ppp. These are lamps!
- 15. Vertically place a tan 1x6 brick on the back right corner.
- 16. Vertically place a white 1x2x5 brick on the 2nd column from the right, on the 6th and 7th rows from the back. Then place the right column of a transparent 2x2x5 corner panel with a cutoff corner in front of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front right.
- 17. Vertically place a dark tan 1x4 plate on the back right corner. Then place the right column of a dark tan 2x2 corner plate in front of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter j.

18. Horizontally place a dark brown 1x2 log brick on the back row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right. Then place a transparent 1x1 round brick in front of the left column of the ppp. Now horizontally place the left column of a dark brown 1x2 log brick in front of the ppp.

You will have an extra red 1x1 round tile. Save it for later!

Group 24 - House

- 19.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a sandwich! Place a white 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a light purple 1x1 round flower plate on the front left corner. Then place another 1 on the back right corner.
- 19.2. Place a sand green 1x1 round plate on the front right corner. Then place another 1 on the back left corner.
- 19.3. Place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Then place a red 1x1 round tile on top.
- 19.4. Horizontally place a brown 2x3 plate underneath your part so 1 column is exposed to the right. Then place a white 1x1 round tile printed with a yellow egg on the front right corner.
- 19.5. Vertically place your part on the back 3 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so it sits on the log bricks! Make sure the 2x2 round tile with a stud is in the back!
- 20.1. Let's make a part! Place a white 2x2x2 cabinet in front of you so the opening faces the front. Then attach a transparent cabinet door to the front. Now place a black 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then place a silver pan on top so the handle faces the front.
- 20.2. Now place your part in front of your previous part so the cabinet door opens to the left. This is a stove!
- 21.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a gold 1x2x2 window frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the back. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 rounded plate on top. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a sticker on top so the sticker faces the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 ingot tile on top.
- 21.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 14 on the light grey 1x2 brick. This sticker has a red and orange fiery background with a teal person and orange person! This sticker is about the news! It is about an escaped convict, Sirius Black, who is described as armed and highly dangerous. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 21.3. Vertically place your part on the 3rd column from the right, on the 6th and 7th rows from the back so it sits in front of the left column of the stove and the sticker faces the left.

Group 25 - House

- 22.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x6x6 door frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach 2 transparent doors to the front so they open to the left and right. Then place 2 white 1x1 round plates with a hollow stud upright on the 2 front-facing side studs.
- 22.2. Horizontally place your part on the 3rd row from the front, on the 4th to 9th columns from the right of the build so the doors open to the front.
- 23. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a side stud and bottom lip on the 6th row from the back of the 6th column from the left so the side stud faces the back. Then place a white 1x1 tile printed with 3 dots upright on the back-facing side stud of it. This is a thermostat! Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick in front of the previous 1x1 brick with a side stud and bottom lip. Now place the left column of a tan 2x2 corner brick with a cutoff corner in front of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front left.
- 24. Place a transparent 2x2x5 corner panel with a cutoff corner on top of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front left. Then vertically place a white 1x2x5 brick behind the left column.

Group 26 - House

- 25.1. Let's make a part! Stack 2 black 1x1 round plates. Then place a light brown 2x2 tile with corner walls underneath your part. Now place a dark grey 2x2 double slope tile on top so it is centered and slopes to the left and right. Now place a light brown 1x1 ice cream cone underneath so it is centered. Then place a short light brown 1x1 brick underneath your ppp.
- 25.2. This is a bird house! Place it on the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the front left corner of the front 2 rows.
- 26. Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate on the 1x6x6 door frame that is on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally on it. Now place the front row of a white 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner to the right of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the front right and it overhangs to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 27.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x10 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 2x4 slope brick on top so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs 2 rows to the front. Now place a white 4x4 corner slope brick to the left of the ppp so 2 rows overhang to the front and it slopes to the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 27.2. Horizontally place your part on the 3rd to 6th rows from the front, on the 2nd to 9th columns from the right so it slopes to the front.
- 28. Horizontally place a white 1x2 jumper plate on the back row of your previous part so it is centered horizontally on it. Then place a white 1x1 cone brick on top of the ppp.
- 29. Place a brown 3x3 plate on the front 2 rows of the 3 leftmost columns so 1 row overhangs to the front. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x4 plate underneath the overhang so 1 column is exposed to the right.

Group 27 - House

30. Vertically place a brown 1x4 plate on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a brown 1x4 plate on the back row to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place 2 brown 2x3 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a brown 2x3 plate in front of the right ppp.

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 2):

Group 28 - Aunt Marge and Ripper the Dog

Sub-build 5. Locate 1 brown pair of legs, 1 torso printed with a dark tan shirt with a light brown jacket, 1 light tan head printed with eyes and a smirk, 1 dark tan hair, and 1 light brown and white dog. Assemble your minifigure then put the dog next to her!

Group 29 - House

- 31. Place a green 1x1 tile with a round side on the front row of the leftmost column so the round side faces the front. Then place a dark green 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Now place a green 1x1 tile with a round side to the right of the ppp so the round side faces the front. Then place 1 more dark green 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Now place a light brown 1x1 round brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a green stem with 3 tips on top.
- 32. Place a $\tan 1x1x3$ brick behind the ppp. Now place a $\tan 1x1x2/3$ brick with 2 side studs on top of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Then place a dark $\tan 1x1$ plate on top of the ppp.

Group 30 - House

- 33.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x4x6 door frame in front of you so the ridged side faces the front. Now attach a tan door with a sticker to the front so it opens to the left.
- 33.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the tan door. This sticker has bricks on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 33.3. Place a black 1x1 plate with an upright side stud upright on the front-facing side stud so the side stud faces up. Now place a transparent 1x1 plate upright on the front-facing stud. Then place a black 1x1 pyramid tile on the top-facing stud of the 1x1 plate with an upright side stud.
- 33.4. Horizontally place your part on the front row of studs of the 4 leftmost columns so the door opens to the front.
- 34. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick in front of you. Then place a tan 1x1x3 brick on the rightmost column.
- 35. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x3 panel on the 3 leftmost columns so the wall faces the back and 1 column overhangs to the left. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick underneath the leftmost column.
- 36. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the leftmost column. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick to the right of the ppp.

- 37. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 masonry brick on the 2 leftmost columns so the brick grooves face the back. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with a hinge connector on the short side to the right of the ppp so the hinge connector faces the right.
- 38. Vertically place your part on the back left corner so the hinge connector faces the back.

Group 31 - House

- 39. Horizontally place a dark tan 4x8 plate in front of you. Then stack 2 white 1x8 plates on the back row.
- 40. Horizontally place 2 white 1x5 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the front right corner.
- 41. Vertically place a teal 1x3 tile on the front left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x2 slope tile on the front right corner so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place a sand blue 2x4 tile to the left of the ppp.
- 42.1. Horizontally place a white 1x3x4 curved door with a sticker on the back right corner so it opens to the back. Make sure the stud is on the right!
- 42.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the white 1x3x4 curved door. This sticker has a dark orange plaque with a bunch of lines. Make sure the stickers are placed on correctly and are oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 43.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round brick on the right column. Now place a white 1x1 corner panel on the right column so the corner wall faces the back left. Then place another 1 on the left column so the corner wall faces the back left.
- 43.2. Horizontally place your part on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
- 44. Place a white 1x1 round plate on the back left corner. Now place a white 1x1 corner panel on the back row on the 3rd column from the left so the corner wall faces the back left. Then place a dark red 1x1 minifigure statue on the 2nd row from the back, on the 4th column from the left.
- 45. Rotate your main build 180 degrees so the double doors open to the back. Now vertically place your part on the front 5 rows of the 2nd to 5th columns from the right so 3 rows overhang to the front and the 1x3x4 curved door is in the back left corner.
- 46. Vertically place a white 1x3 brick on the back 2 rows of the 5th column from the right so 1 row overhangs to the front over the 1x3x4 door.
- 47. Place the right column of a dark tan 2x2 corner plate on the back 2 rows of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter d.
- 48.1. Let's make a part! Place a white staircase in front of you so the taller side faces the back. Now horizontally place a teal 1x3 tile on the front right corner. Then place a teal 1x1 quarter circle tile on the rightmost column behind the ppp so the curve faces the front right. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 ingot tile to the left of the ppp.

- 48.2. Horizontally place a teal 1x3 tile on the 3 rightmost columns behind the 2 ppp. Then horizontally place 2 more, 1 behind the other, behind the ppp.
- 48.3. Horizontally place the back left corner of your part on the 3rd row from the back of the 5th row from the right so it angles down to the front.
- 49. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows of the rightmost column so the front row sits above the hinge connector. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side behind the ppp so the bar faces the right. Then horizontally place the rightmost column of a dark tan 2x4 plate behind the ppp.
- 50. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope brick on the front 2 rows of the 5th column from the right so it slopes to the front.
- 51. Vertically place a white 1x2 slope brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place another 1 on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front. There should be no overhang and the slopes should align!
- 52. Vertically place a white 1x2 brick on top of the ppp so there is no overhang. Then vertically place a white 1x3 brick on top of the ppp so there is no overhang.
- 53. Vertically place a tan 1x5 plate on the front 5 rows of the rightmost column. Then horizontally place the right column of a tan 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side behind the ppp so the bar faces the back. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp.
- 54. Horizontally place a dark grey 2x3 tile on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back of the 2nd to 4th columns from the right.
- 55. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the double doors open to the front. Now let's make a part! Attach a dark grey 3L bar to the 2 clips of a dark grey ladder with clips on the short ends. Now attach the clips of your part to the front-facing bar that is on the front left corner so it hangs down.

Group 32 - House

- 56. Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile upright on the 2 front-facing side studs that are on the 5th column from the left so 2 rows overhang to the top.
- 57. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 ingot tile on the rightmost column.
- 58. Horizontally place a teal 2x6 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so 4 columns overhang to the left.
- 59. Vertically place a black 2x4 plate underneath the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so 2 rows are exposed to the front. Now place a teal 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the front 2 rows so the studs are in the back.
- 60. Horizontally place a black 2x3 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns so 1 column is exposed to the left. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 ingot tile on the leftmost column.

- 61. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 brick on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a white 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the ppp.
- 62. Place 2 transparent 1x1 wine glasses on top of the ppp.
- 63. Rotate the house 180 degrees so the doors open to the back. Vertically place your part on the front 8 rows of the 6th and 7th columns from the left so the 2x2 part faces the right.
- 64. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 6x12 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the back left corner.
- 65. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a clip on the front left corner so the clip faces the left. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick behind the ppp.
- 66. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 brick on the back row on the 2nd to 5th columns from the left. Then vertically place a brown 1x3 brick in front of the leftmost column of the ppp.
- 67. Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the front 2 rows on the 2nd to 5th columns from the left. Then vertically place a light brown 1x2 tile behind the rightmost column of the ppp. Then vertically place a light brown 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the ppp. Now vertically place a light brown 1x2 tile to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a light brown 1x3 jumper plate behind the 3 ppp.
- 68. Horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick on the back row on the 2nd to 7th columns from the right. Now vertically place a mint blue 1x4 brick in front of the leftmost column of the ppp.

You will have an extra light brown 1x3 jumper plate. Save it for later!

Group 34 - House

- 69.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x5 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x3 rounded plate underneath the leftmost column so 2 rows are exposed to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 69.2. Horizontally place a white 1x5 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place another 1 behind the ppp.
- 69.3. Vertically place a white 1x3 jumper plate on the leftmost column. Then vertically place 3 white 1x3 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place a light brown 1x3 jumper plate on the rightmost column. Then vertically place a white 1x2 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the right.
- 69.4. This is a bed! Horizontally place it on the 2nd to 4th rows from the back, on the 2nd to 6th columns from the right so the 1x2 slope tile is on the left.
- 70. Place a white 1x1 brick printed with jelly beans on the 2nd row from the front of the 6th column from the right. Then place a red 1x1 pyramid tile on top of the ppp.
- 71. Horizontally place your part on the front left corner of the main build so the clip that is on the front left corner faces the left.

- 72. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 jumper plate on the back row of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left of the ppp.
- 73. Vertically place a tan 1x6 brick on the rightmost column.

Building Instructions (Bag 6, Book 2):

Group 35 - House

- 74. Place a tan 2x2 corner brick on the 5th and 6th rows from the front of the 2 leftmost columns so it looks like the braille letter f. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the back row of the ppp so the brick grooves face the back. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp.
- 75. Vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the front left corner. Now horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick on the 6th row from the front of the 6th to 11th columns from the left.
- 76. Vertically place a tan 1x6 brick on the front left corner. Then place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick on the front left corner so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Now vertically place a tan 1x4 brick behind the left column of the ppp.
- 77.1. Horizontally place 2 dark brown 1x2x2 window frames, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the back row of the ppp so the ridged sides face the back.
- 77.2. Attach a transparent window pane with a sticker to each of the 2 back-facing sides of the 2 ppp so the stickers face the back.
- 77.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place sticker 17 on each of the 2 glass panes. These stickers have a diamond grid design on them. Make sure the stickers are placed on correctly and are oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 78. Vertically place a white 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the 2nd column from the left, on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so the long wall faces the right. Then place a short white 1x1 brick behind the ppp. Now place a gold 1x1 faucet on top of the ppp so the bar faces the front. Then place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.
- 79.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x2 rounded brick with a gap in front of you. Then horizontally place a sand green 1x2 brick on top. Now horizontally place a sand green 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.
- 79.2. Horizontally place your part on the 1x3 jumper plate that is on the 5th row from the front of the 3rd to 5th columns from the left.

Group 36 - House

80. Place a sand green 2x2 inverted dome brick on the 1x2 jumper plate that is in front of the ppp. Then place a light blue 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp. Now place a transparent blue 1x1 round tile on top of the ppp. This is a toilet!

- 81. Vertically stack 2 mint blue 1x4 bricks on the 2nd to 5th rows from the front of the 6th column from the left.
- 82. Vertically place a sand green 1x3 brick on the front 3 rows of the ppp. Now place the left column of a tan 2x2 corner brick behind the ppp so it looks like the braille letter f.
- 83. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the right of the back row of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp. Now place a short tan 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place a mint blue 1x4 tile on the 2nd to 5th rows from the front of the 6th column from the left.
- 84. Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front right corner so the side studs face the left. Then vertically place a dark tan 1x2 masonry brick behind the ppp so the brick grooves face the right. Now vertically place a dark tan 1x2 brick with an axle hole behind the ppp.
- 85. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark brown 1x4 plate in front of you.
- 86. Horizontally place 2 black 1x2 plates with a clip on the long side, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the clips face the front.
- 87.1. Horizontally place 2 dark brown 1x2x2 window frames, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the ridged sides face the front.
- 87.2. Attach a transparent window pane with a sticker to the front-facing side of each of the 2 ppp.
- 87.3. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 17 on each of the 2 glass panes. These stickers have a diamond grid design on them. Make sure the stickers are placed on correctly and are oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 88. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 slope tile on top so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back. Now place a brown 1x1 slope tile to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 89. Horizontally attach the bottom bar of a black ladder with 4 rungs to the 2 front-facing clips so it sticks up.
- 90-91. Horizontally place your part on the back row of the 2nd to 5th columns from the right so it slopes to the front.
- 92.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick in front of you. Then place a short tan 1x1 brick on the leftmost column. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.
- 92.2. Place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then place a dark tan 1x1 brick to the left of the ppp.
- 92.3. Vertically place your part on the rightmost column so the inverted slope brick is in the front.

- 93. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x6 plate on the back right corner so it sits on 2 studs and the slope tiles.
- 94.1. Horizontally place a red 2x3 pentagonal tile with a sticker upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the bottom, and the angled side overhangs 1 column to the right.
- 94.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 15 on the red 2x3 pentagonal tile. This sticker is half red and half orange, and it has an orange lion on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 95.1. Place a light brown 2x2 tile with a sticker upright on the front 2 left-facing side studs that are on the rightmost column so 1 row overhangs to the bottom.
- 95.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the light brown 2x2 tile. This sticker has a portrait of a guy with black hair and a teal suit. This is Cornelius Fudge, the Minister for Magic! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 96.1. Place a light brown 2x2 tile with a sticker upright on the back 2 left-facing side studs that are on the rightmost column so 1 row overhangs to the bottom.
- 96.2. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the light brown 2x2 tile. This sticker has a sandy beach with water and a sunset on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 97. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x5 plate on the back right corner.
- 98. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the front right corner.
- 99. Place a tan 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns.
- 100. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then place a short tan 1x1 brick to the left of the ppp. Now place another 1 on the front row on the 3rd column from the right.
- 101. Place a dark tan 1x1 slope tile on the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the left.
- 102. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 jumper plate on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a stud and an upright clip on top of the ppp so the clip is on the right.
- 103. Horizontally place a tan 1x3 sloped curved brick on the back right corner so it slopes to the left.
- 104. Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the back.
- 105. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x6 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row to the left of the previous part.

- 106. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x5 plate on the back left corner.
- 107. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate on the front left corner.
- 108. Place a tan 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns.
- 109. Place a dark tan 1x1 brick on the back left corner. Then place a short tan 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp. Now place a short tan 1x1 brick on the front row on the 3rd column from the left.
- 110. Place a dark tan 1x1 slope tile on the back right corner so it slopes to the right. Then horizontally place a tan 1x3 slope brick to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the right.
- 111. Horizontally place a brown 1x3 jumper plate on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a stud and an upright clip on top of the ppp so the clip is on the left.
- 112. Horizontally place a tan 1x3 sloped curved brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the right.
- 113. Vertically place your part on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the back.

Group 39 - House

- 114. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 8x16 plate upside down in front of you.
- 115. Vertically place a brown 2x3 plate with a bar underneath on the back 3 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 116. Flip your part over so it is right side up and the 2 ppps are in the front. Now horizontally place 2 black 1x8 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally.
- 117.1. Place a brown 1x1 tile with a round side on the 2nd column from the left of the 5th row from the back so the round side faces the back. Then place another 1 on the 7th column from the left and 4th row from the back so the round side faces the back. Now place 1 on the 7th column from the right of the 2nd row from the back so the round side faces the back. Then place 1 on the 4th column from the right of the 5th row from the back so the round side faces the back.
- 117.2. Place a dark green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 2nd column from the right of the 4th row from the back so the leaves face the back. Now place another 1 on the 6th row from the back of the 5th column from the left so the leaves face the back.
- 118. This is the roof! Horizontally attach the bottom-facing bars to the 2 top-facing clips that are on the front left and front right corners so the roof slopes to the back.
- 119.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a black 1x2 rounded brick with a gap in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 rounded tile on top of the ppp.
- 119.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally attach them to the 2 left-facing clips.

- 120. Attach the axle of a transparent curved bar with an axle and stud into the right-facing axle hole so it curves up and the stud faces the front.
- 121. Place a brown 5x5x2 dome upside down in front of you so the pinholes are on the left and right. Now insert a brown 3L axle with a stop into the middle bottom-facing axle hole so the axle faces up.
- 122. Place a red 2L axle connector on top of the top-facing axle. Then insert a light grey 3L axle into the top-facing axle hole.
- 123.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a brown 1L pin with a stud in front of you so the stud faces up. Then place a black 1x1 round plate with a bent bar on top so the stud faces the top right. Now place a black 1x1 tile on top of the ppp.
- 123.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Insert the pin of 1 part into the rightmost bottom-facing pinhole so the tile faces the bottom right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Group 40 - House

- 124. Place a 5x5x2 dome printed with a tan shirt and light nougat jacket on top so it is centered and the pinholes are on the left and right. Now insert a light nougat arm with a pin to the rightmost top-facing pinhole so the hand faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 125. Place a dark tan 2x2 dome printed with a light tan face, dark tan hair, and a blown up face on the top-facing axle so it is centered.
- 126. This is Aunt Marge as a balloon! Attach the right hand of your part to the end of the right-facing bar so she faces the back!
- 127. Bring back your previous build and make sure it is horizontal and the roof slopes down to the back. Now attach the right-facing clips of your build to the front bar of the leftmost 1x2 rounded bricks of the main build.
