This LEGO® Friends Adventure Camp Archery Range (42622) building toy for kids aged 6 and up comes with Autumn and Nova mini dolls, a raccoon and lots of sports playset accessories. Girls and boys can act out target practice for real with this exciting set as the bow actually shoots the arrows. See the target flip down when the arrow hits it! There's a color-coded difficulty scale so kids can move the target back for a bigger challenge.

Archery role play for girls and boys aged 6+ – This buildable Adventure Camp Archery Range building toy for kids comes with 2 mini-dolls and a raccoon figure for children who love imaginative playsets.

Go for gold with the functioning bow and arrows set – Kids can use the toy bow to help Autumn and Nova shoot the arrows at the target to earn the archery badge for their camp book!

Includes 2 mini-dolls and a raccoon figure – Inspire creativity with the characters and have fun with the Autumn mini-doll, which comes with 2 faces to show how her expression changes as she takes aim.

A learning toy packed with stories – Kids can create their own archery adventures with this set as they shoot arrows and use the color-coded difficulty scale to act out challenges for the characters!

A gift idea for kids who love LEGO® sets and creative play – This building set makes a fun best-friend gift for girls and boys who love building toys, friendship stories and role play!

Measurements – 157-piece LEGO® toy set with an archery range measuring over 3 in. (8 cm) high, 5.5 in. (14 cm) wide and 5 in. (12 cm) deep

The build includes 157 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces to make the small clearing, the Autumn mini-doll, and some pieces to make the archery range. Bag 2 includes the remaining pieces to make the archery range. Bag 3 includes the pieces to make the picnic zone, the Nova mini-doll, and the raccoon figure. Bag 4 includes the pieces to make the pine tree and the ranch archway.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner who may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each set, PDF versions are always online at <https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/42622>. As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags or small containers. Have a sighted friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted into groups according to the building steps in the set. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers or meaningful names. The parts will be collected

into a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1-4, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's start building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 – Autumn

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 pair of legs dressed in sand green folded shorts and printed with brown boots, 1 torso printed with a white and orange sleeveless top showing an image of the camp's logo, 2 beige heads with different expressions printed with green eyes, brown eyebrows, mouth, and freckles, terracotta wavy hair in a braid, and 1 blue prosthetic hand. Choose the face expression you like, assemble your minifigure, and place the prosthetic hand on her left arm!

Group 2 – Shooting Bow

1. Locate 1 teal bow and 2 yellow arrows.
2. Put one of the arrows inside the hole in the bow and apply a little bit of pressure on the arrow until you hear a clicking sound. Your bow is done! Now, press on the opposite side of the arrow to shoot!

Group 3 – Small Clearing

1. Locate 1 green 6x6 round plate and 1 light brown 2x2 brick. Place the green 6x6 round plate in front of you. Place the 2x2 brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right of the 6x6 round plate centered-vertically so there is 1 column left on the right of the 6x6 round plate.
2. Locate 1 light brown log brick and place it horizontally on the back row of the previously placed 2x2 brick.
3. Locate 2 terracotta 1x1 plates with side clips. Place one on the left stud of the previously placed log brick so that the clip is facing left. Place the other to the right of the ppp so that the clip is facing behind.
4. Locate 1 terracotta 1x2x2 brick with 4 side studs and place it in front of the ppps so that the 4 side studs are facing front.
5. Locate 1 terracotta 2x2 curved slope tile. Place its front row on the ppp, so it slopes to the back.
6. Locate 1 white 6l bar with stop and 1 beige triangle shaped flag with 2 side clips. Then, locate the sticker sheet included in the set. Choose the number 2 beige triangle shaped sticker printed with 2 teal stripes, 1 bright orange stripe in between, and a teal bow in a bright orange circle under the stripes and place it in the middle of the triangle shaped flag so that their sides align with each other. Hold the 6l bar upright vertically, so the stop is at the bottom, and clip the flag onto the top part of the bar. Your flag is done! Put your flag on the terracotta side clip that faces back. Now, you can also place your shooting bow in the terracotta side clip that faces left!
7. Locate 1 dark brown 2x2 box with no studs and place it to the right of the previously built build so that they touch with no overhangs. Now, you have a box to put your arrows in!
8. Locate 2 bright green 1x1 plates with 3 leaves and 2 1x1 purple flowers. Place the 1x1 flowers on top of the leaves so that you have 2 flower assemblies. Place one of the flowers on the stud located on the second row from the front and the second column from the left of the 6x6 green plate so that the leaves

are facing front. Place the other flower on the stud located on the back row on the right of the 6x6 plate, so that the 2x2 box and the flower touch.

9. Let's make the scoreboard! Locate 1 light brown 2x4 tile and the sticker pack included in the set. On the sticker sheet, locate the number 5 vertically placed, rectangle shaped, yellow sticker titled "score" with a brown outline, printed with 4 names and scores in order: Nova 21 in lime; Autumn 16 in orange; Liann 15 in lime; and Olly 12 in teal. Place the sticker in the middle of the 2x4 tile. Now, put your newly made scoreboard vertically upright on the terracotta 1x2x2 brick's 4 side studs so that the top of the score board overhangs to the top by one row. Your build is done!

Group 4 – Archery Range

1. Locate 1 green 8x16 plate and place it horizontally in front of you.
2. Locate 1 light brown 1x2 log brick and 1 light brown 1x2 slope brick. Place the slope brick vertically at the back right corner of the green 8x16 plate so that it slopes to the back and there is no overhang. Place the log brick vertically in front of the ppp.
3. Locate 1 lime 1x2 corner plate and 1 light brown 1x2 log brick. Place the 1x2 log brick vertically in front of the previously placed 1x2 log brick. Place the 1x2 corner plate in front of the ppp so that it's placed like the Braille letter J and its corner aligns with the 8x16 plate's corner.
4. Locate 1 light brown 1x2 log brick and 1 light brown 1x1 round brick. Place the 1x1 round brick in the gap between the previously placed corner brick. Place the 1x2 log brick horizontally to the left of the front row of the corner brick so that the log brick is at the front of the 8x16 plate.
5. Locate 1 dark brown 2x3 brick and 1 tan 1x2 brick with a vertical side handle. Place the 2x3 brick vertically to the left of the previously placed 1x2 log brick so that it overhangs at the front by 2 rows. Place the 1x2 tan brick horizontally to the left of the ppp so that the vertical side handle is facing left.
6. Locate 1 green 2x6 plate that is rounded on one side and place it horizontally under the previously placed 2x3 brick so that the curved side is facing front and the brick is centered-horizontally.
7. Locate 1 yellow 1x2 plate and 1 yellow 1x9 curved plate with 5 studs. Place the 1x9 plate diagonally on top of the previously build construction with no overhangs so that the curved part of the plate is facing the front right corner and 2 studs are left free at the top right corner of the construction. Place the 1x2 plate vertically on the 2 free studs at the back right corner of the construction.
8. Locate 1 yellow 1x4 plate and place it horizontally to the left of the previously placed 1x9 curved plate.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 5 – Archery Range

9. Time to turn your build around! Rotate your construction 180°. Locate 1 burgundy 1x2 tile and 1 red 2x2 tile with one stud. Place the 1x2 tile vertically to the left of the 8x16 plate so that 4 studs are left free at the front of the plate. Now, place the 2x2 tile to the right of the ppp.

Group 6 – Archery Range

10. Locate 1 bright orange 2x2 tile with one stud and place it to the right of the previously placed red 2x2 tile.

Group 7 – Archery Range

10. Locate 1 orange 2x2 tile with one stud and place it to the right of the ppp.

Group 8 – Archery Range

10. Locate 1 yellow 2x2 tile with one stud and place it to the right of the ppp.

Group 9 – Archery Range

10. Locate 1 purple 1x1 flower and place it on the left column stud behind the orange 2x2 tile.

Group 10 – Archery Range

11. Locate 1 lime 2x2 plate with 1 stud and 1 beige 1x2 grill tile. Place the lime 2x2 plate to the right of the previously placed yellow 2x2 plate. Then, place the grill tile vertically to the right of the ppp.

12. Locate 12 bright green 1x2 slope tiles with no studs. Place one of them vertically in front of the previously placed burgundy 1x2 tile so that it slopes to the left. Place another symmetrically to the right of the ppp. Do the same thing with the rest of the 1x2 bright green tiles, continuing placing them symmetrically to the right of one another so a left-right sloping pattern occurs.

13. Locate 1 beige 4x4 round plate and place it to the right of the ppp so that it overhangs to the right by 1 row and 1 row is left free in front of it. That's going to be the place from which the archer will shoot!

14. Locate 1 green 2x6 plate with one rounded side. Place it under the right column of the ppp so that it is centered vertically and the curved part is facing right.

15. Locate 1 beige 1x1 rounded plate and 1 terracotta 1x1 rounded tile. Place the 1x1 tile on top of the 1x1 plate and put the resulting construction at the front of the second from the left bright green slope tile located at the left of the left-right sloping pattern.

16. Locate 1 beige 1x1 cone and 1 bright orange round dome hat. Place the round dome hat on top of the cone. Place the assembly at the front stud located on the right column of the ppp.

17. Locate 1 beige 2x2 brick with a pin and 2 beige 1x2 grill tiles. Place the 2x2 brick in front of you so that the pin is facing left. Now, put one of the grill tiles vertically on the left studs of the 2x2 brick. Place the other vertically to the right of the ppp. Afterwards, place the resulting assembly on the orange 2x2 tile with one stud located at the back of the left-right sloping pattern assembly and is the third from the left 2x2 tile so that the pin faces front. This is going to be the holder for the shooting target!

18. Let's make the target! Locate 1 white 2x3 plate with a rounded end and a pin hole. Locate 2 white 1x2 plates with underside pin holes and 1 white 2x2 round tile printed with a shooting target. Now, place the white 2x3 plate vertically in front of you so that the pin hole is in the back. Put the 2x2 round tile on top of

the ppp so that a row is left free at the front. Next, flip the assembly over so that the 2x2 round tile is facing down and is still in the back. Now, place one of the 1x2 plates vertically on the left front corner of the assembly so that the underside pin hole is facing up and is at the front. Place the other to the right of the ppp in the same position. Your target is done! Now, let's rotate your previously built archery range 90° clockwise. Place your target on the previously made target holder's pin so that the pin is inside the target's underside pin hole, and the 2x2 round plate on the target is facing front. You can move your target holder front and back on the different colored 2x2 plates with 1 stud on each to increase or decrease the distance between the archer and the target!

Building instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 11 – Nova

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 pair of legs dressed in teal shorts and printed with black and white shoes, 1 torso printed with white T-shirt showing the camp's logo and a purple zip-up hoodie partly covering the T-shirt, 1 tan head printed with lime eyes, brown eyebrows, and a smiling mouth, and short, blonde, wavy hair. Assemble your minifigure! Now, put her away while we make the badge book and the picnic zone!

Group 12 – Badge Book

19. Locate 1 lime 1x2 book half with two studs; 1 lime 1x2 book cover; 1 raccoon mini figure; and 2 bright orange 1x1 round tiles printed with a purple circle with a bow and arrow in the middle. Place the 1x2 book half vertically in front of you so that the attachments are facing left and the studs are facing up. Put one of the 1x1 round tiles on the back stud of the ppp. Now, locate the sticker sheet included in the set and find the number 4 rectangle shaped, horizontally placed, lime sticker printed with a white piece of paper with a math diagram in the middle. Place the 1x2 book cover vertically in front of you so that the rounded side with two holes in it faces right and put the sticker horizontally in the middle of the tile. Afterwards, connect the book cover and the book half so that the sticker on the book cover is facing the book half. You just made a book! Now, place your newly made book vertically in front of you so that the connected side is facing left. Locate the number 3 rectangle shaped, horizontally placed, lime sticker printed with a bright green triangle with no corners and an orange "N" surrounded by an orange circle in the middle and place it on the cover of your book so that the base of the triangle on the sticker faces left. Your badge book is done! You can now put the other badge and the book in Nova's or Autumn's hand and reward the archers!

Group 13 – Picnic Zone

20. Locate 1 green 8x8 plate rounded on one side and place it in front of you so that the rounded side is facing right.

21. Locate 1 light brown 1x4 log brick and 1 light brown 1x1 brick with a side clip. Place the 1x1 brick on the back row, left stud of the 8x8 plate so that the side clip faces left and overhangs. Place the 1x4 brick horizontally to the right of the ppp.

22. Locate 1 light brown 1x2 log brick and 1 light brown 1x1 round brick. Place the 1x1 brick on the back stud located on the second to right column of the 8x8 plate. Now, place the 1x2 log brick vertically on the rightmost column of the 8x8 plate.

23. Locate 1 yellow 1x3 plate and 1 yellow 1x5 curved plate. Place the 1x5 plate diagonally on top of the previously built construction with no overhangs so that the curved part is facing the back right corner and there are 3 free horizontal studs left on the left of the construction. Now, place the 1x3 plate horizontally on top of the free studs.

24. Take your previously built archery range and rotate it so that it's placed vertically in front of you and the target is at the back. Now, combine your archery range and the picnic zone by connecting the clip on the left of the picnic zone and the handle on the right of the archery range under the yellow 1x4 plate.

Group 14 – Picnic Zone

25. Locate 1 bright green 2x4 tile and 2 terracotta 1x2 round plates. Place the 2x4 tile vertically on the left of the picnic zone so that it overhangs the picnic zone to the left by 1 column and there is 1 row left free at the back. Place one of the 1x2 plates horizontally to the back of the ppp. Place the other 1x2 plate in front of the 2x4 tile.

Group 15 – Picnic Zone

26. Locate 2 red 1x1 tiles and place one to the right of the previously placed 2x4 tile so that there is 1 row left free at the back. Then, place another red tile in front of the ppp, so that one row remains free in between.

Group 16 – Picnic Zone

26. Locate 2 white 1x1 tiles and place one in between the previously placed 1x1 red tiles. Then, place the remaining white 1x1 tile in front of the front red 1x1 tile.

Group 17 – Picnic Zone

27. Locate 1 red 1x2 plate and 3 red 1x1 tiles. Place a red 1x1 tile to the right of the second from the back white 1x1 tile located in the red-white tile assembly. Then, place another red 1x1 tile to the back and right of the ppp. Place another red 1x1 tile in front and right of the ppp. Now, place the red 1x2 plate vertically to the right of the ppp so that the back stud is located to the right of the white 1x1 tile located on the back and right of the red-white assembly.

Group 18 – Picnic Zone

27. Locate 3 white 1x1 tiles. Place them in the gaps between the previously placed red 1x1 tiles.

Group 19 – Picnic Zone

28. Locate 1 white 1x2 plate and 3 white 1x1 tiles. Place the 1x1 tiles symmetrically to the previously placed 3 red 1x1 tiles. Then, place the white 1x2 plate vertically in front of the red 1x2 plate located to the right of the red-white assembly.

Group 20 – Picnic Zone

28. Locate 3 red 1x1 tiles and place them in the gaps in between the previously placed white 1x1 tiles.

Group 21 – Picnic Zone

29. Locate 1 transparent yellow 1x1 round brick, 1 black 1x1 round plate with a free stud, and 1 black 1x1 round plate with a top holder. Place the yellow brick on the plate with a free stud so that the free stud is inside the brick. Place the plate with a top holder on the yellow brick so that the top holder is on the outside. You made a lamp! Now, place your lamp on the front right stud of the yellow 1x5 plate located on the picnic zone.

30. Locate 2 white 2x2 rounded plates with one stud. Place one of them on the back right part of the picnic blanket. Place the other at the front of the ppp.

31. Locate 2 beige 1x2 plates, 2 beige 1x2 tiles, 2 terracotta 1x2 rounded plates, and 4 transparent red 1x1 rounded plates. Place a 1x2 plate on top of a 1x2 rounded plate. Then, place two 1x1 rounded plates on each stud of the ppp. Place a 1x2 tile on top of the ppps. You made a sandwich! Now, do the same thing with the remaining pieces to make another sandwich! Afterwards, place your sandwiches on the previously placed white 2x2 plates located on the picnic blanket and rotate the sandwiches 45° to the right.

32. Locate 1 blue 1x1 round tile with a hollow bar, 1 transparent blue 1x1 round brick, and 1 transparent blue 1x1 plate. Place the 1x1 plate on the 1x1 brick. Place the 1x1 tile on the ppp so that the hollow bar is facing up. You've made a water bottle! Now, place your water bottle at the front right of the terracotta 1x2 rounded plate located at the front of the picnic zone-archery range intersection.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 4):

Group 22 – Pine Tree

33. Locate 1 dark brown 2x2 round brick and place it in front of you.

34. Locate 1 dark brown plant tree palm top and place it in the middle of the ppp so that the 4 bars on the palm top face up.

35. Locate 4 dark green 2x3x2 leaves curved upright with 1x1 plates. Place them symmetrically on each of the 4 bars of the ppp so that the leaves are facing down.

36. Locate 1 dark brown plant tree palm top. Place it the middle of the ppps offset 45° from the previous same alignment so that the 4 bars are facing up.

37. Locate 4 dark green 2x3x2 leaves curved upright with 1x1 plates. Place them symmetrically on each of the 4 bars of the ppp so that the leaves are facing down.

38. Locate 1 beige 3l bar and place it in the middle of the ppps. You've built the bottom half of the pine tree!

39. Place your bottom half of the tree on the dark brown 2x2 brick located on the right of the archery range and behind the picnic zone.

Group 23 – Pine Tree

40. Locate 1 dark brown 1x1 brick and 3 dark green 2x3x2 leaves curved upright with 1x1 plates. Place the leaves on top of each other so that each leaf is facing a different direction—right, left, back, or front. Now, place the brown 1x1 brick in the middle of the 3 leaves. Place the assembly on top of the previously built bottom half of the pine tree so that the leaves are facing down.

41. Locate 1 grey 2l bar with a stop ring in the middle and place it on top of the pine tree.

42. Locate 1 dark brown 1x1 round plate and 1 dark green 1x1 cone. Place the 1x1 plate on top of the ppp and slide it down. Now, place the 1x1 cone on top of the ppp. Your pine tree is done!

Group 24 – Ranch Archway

43. Locate 1 dark brown 2x4 plate and 1 light brown 2x2 plate. Place the 2x4 plate horizontally in front of you. Then, place the 2x2 plate in the middle of the ppp centered-horizontally.

44. Locate 2 light brown 1x2 plates with 2 horizontal side clips attached to each. Place one of them vertically to the left of the ppp so that the side clips face left. Place the other to the right of the light brown 2x2 plate so that the side clips are facing right.

45. Locate 1 terracotta 2x4 plate with 2 studs. Place it horizontally on top of the ppps.

46. Locate 1 light brown 3x3 round tile and place it on both studs of the ppp.

47. Locate the sticker sheet included in the set. Find the number 1 round, light brown sticker printed with the camp's logo—an orange tent on a teal clearing surrounded by trees. Place the sticker on top of the ppp.

48. Locate 2 dark brown carrot leaves pieces, 2 dark brown 6l bars with thick stops, and 2 tan handles. Put a carrot leaves piece on one end of a handle. Then, place a bar on the other side of the handle so that the thick stop is located closer to it. Repeat the steps to make an identical assembly. Now, place one of them vertically on one side of the previously built construction with a sticker so that the back part of the handle is between the side clips. Place the other one symmetrically on the other side.

49. Place your new construction on the right studs of the 1x2 terracotta, round plates located on the picnic zone-archery range intersection.
