42658 Unicorn & Flamingo Pool Party

Set adapted by Alex Charbonneau and tested by Natalie Charbonneau.

This building set is packed with pretend-play opportunities as kids dive into storytelling at the LEGO® Friends Unicorn & Flamingo Pool Party (42658). This set for girls and boys aged 5 and up comes with 2 buildable floaties, pool accessories, 2 LEGO Friends minidolls and a cat figure.

Kids can get creative telling the story of Leo, Liann and Churro as they enjoy a fun pool party with their unicorn and flamingo floaties. The buildable flamingo floatie has space for 2 characters and includes a holder for the 2 ice pops. The smaller unicorn floatie is perfect for Churro the cat, who loves to join in. The set also includes a lounge chair, a DJ booth with spinning record and microphone, sunscreen and a drink for even more imaginative role play.

Discover more social-emotional toys (sets sold separately) in the LEGO Friends universe. This set comes with the LEGO Builder app for intuitive building. Here kids can zoom in and rotate models, save sets and track progress as they build.

Building set for pretend play:

- This kids' Unicorn & Flamingo Pool Party set makes a fun treat for girls and boys aged 5 and up and comes with 2 minidolls, a cat figure and lots of accessories.

2 buildable floaties:

- Kids develop their building skills as they assemble the flamingo floatie, the unicorn floatie and the poolside scene, which includes a lounge chair and a DJ booth.

Includes 2 minidolls and a cat figure:

- This set comes with Leo and Liann minidolls and a Churro the cat figure so kids can act out lots of friendship stories with the characters.

Accessories for creative play:

- This LEGO® set comes with cute accessories to boost creativity, including sunscreen, 2 ice pops, a drink and a microphone.

A gift for kids:

- This building set makes a fun gift idea or treat for kids who love friendship-based play and storytelling.

Measurements:

- 99-piece set with a flamingo floatie measuring over 2 in. (5 cm) high, 3 in. (8 cm) wide and 2.5 in. (7 cm) deep

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of the piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner who may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/42658) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with three bags labeled 1-3, a few large pieces, and an instruction booklet. Sort the pieces into groups as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split across two groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

This build is 99 pieces, and 59 building steps.

Bag 1 (3 groups of bricks)

Minifigure Group 1 contains Churro the cat and his glasses.

Sub-Build: Unicorn Pool Floaty

Group 1 contains the pieces for steps 1-9.

Sub-Build: Lounger

Group 2 contains the pieces for steps 10-20.

Bag 2 (8 groups of bricks)

Minifigure Group 2 contains the pieces for the Leo minidoll.

Sub-Build: DJ Booth

Group 3 contains the pieces for steps 1-4. Group 4 contains the pieces for steps 5-12.

Bag 3 (5 groups of bricks)

Minifigure Group 2 contains the pieces for the Liann minidoll.

Sub-Build: Flamingo Pool Floaty

Group 5 contains the pieces for steps 1-7.

Group 6 contains the pieces for steps 8-11.

Group 7 contains the pieces for steps 12-26.

Group 8 contains the pieces for steps 27-28.

Building Instructions:

Bag 1.

Minifigure Group: Churro the Cat

This group consists of a cat figure, named Churro! This kitty is white with orange paws and some orange patches on his face. You can push the bar of a pair of goggles into a small hole between Churro's ears to give him some goggles in case he wants to go looking for fish in the pool!

Sub-Build: Unicorn Pool Floaty

Group 1.

- 1. Let's start by making a unicorn pool floaty! We'll start with the body. Place a white 2x4 double inverted curved slope brick, horizontally, in front of you.
- 2. Place a pale blue 2x2 jumper plate, centered horizontally, on the previous piece.
- 3. Place a pale blue 1x2 jumper plate, vertically, to the left of the previous piece. Repeat symmetrically on the right side.
- 4. Now we'll make the head. Place a white 1x2 plate with rounded ends, horizontally, in front of you.
- 5.1. Place a white 1x1 brick with studs on two opposite sides, with the side studs at the front and back, on the right stud of the previous piece.
- 5.2. Place a white 1x1 half cylinder, with the flat sides at the front and back, to the left of the previous piece.

- 6. Place a white 1x1 round tile with an eye print on the side stud on the front side of the head. Repeat symmetrically on the back side.
- 7.1. Place a bright pink 1x1 round plate with a hollow stud on the only stud on the head. This should be right above the eyes.
- 7.2. Push the short bar of a gold unicorn horn, with the point on top, into the hollow stud of the previous piece.
- 8. Place the right stud of the head on the left jumper plate on the rest of the pool floaty.
- 9. Now we'll add the tail to the unicorn! Find a bright pink cat tail. This piece doesn't look a lot like a cat tail, it looks more like a thick question mark without the dot underneath! There are two flat sides, a long one and a short one. The short side has an anti-stud. Rotate the cat tail so the anti-stud faces the bottom and so the curved sides are at the right and on top. Place this piece on the right stud on the pool floaty so the right side of the tail overhangs. This completes the unicorn pool floaty!

Sub-Build: Lounger

Group 2.

- 10. Now we'll make a lounger where you can relax and sunbathe! Set the floaty aside. Place a light green 4x6 plate, horizontally, in front of you.
- 11. Place a brown 1x4 arch brick, vertically, under the leftmost column of the previous piece. Repeat symmetrically on the right side.
- 12.1. Place a tan 2x4 tile with two studs, horizontally, on the back two rows of the lounger so the right sides are even.
- 12.2. Place a tan 1x2 plate with a vertical clip on one long side, vertically with the clip on the right, on the rightmost column in front of the previous piece. We'll add an umbrella here in a minute!
- 13. Let's add a pillow. Place the right column of a pale blue 2x2 curved slope tile, with the tall side on the right, on the previous piece.
- 14. Now we'll add a towel to lay down on! Place a teal 2x4 tile, horizontally, to the left of the previous piece.
- 15.1. Let's add a nice cool drink! Place a purple 1x1 round brick on the right stud of the 2x4 tile with two studs.
- 15.2. Place a green 1x1 round plate with a flower petal pattern on the previous piece.
- 15.3. Place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a short bar sticking up on the previous piece. This piece is the lid of the cup with a straw!
- 16.1. It's important to wear sunscreen if you'll be in the sun! Place a white 1x1 brick with a sunscreen logo printed on it on the other stud on the 2x4 tile with two studs.
- 16.2. Place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a short bar sticking up on the previous piece. This is the lid of the sunscreen container.
- 17. Next, we'll add the umbrella! Push a brown 6L bar with a stop on one side, with the stop on the left, from the left into the hollow anti-stud of a yellow umbrella top.

- 18. Find a brown bar holder with a short bar on one side. This piece has a cylinder with a hole in it on one side, and a short bar on the other side. Push the hole onto the left end of the bar on the umbrella.
- 19. Clip the short bar on the left side of the umbrella onto the clip on the right side of the lounger.
- 20. Rotate the umbrella so the bar points up and down with the umbrella on top. This completes the lounger!

Bag 2.

Minifigure Group: Leo

Next, we'll build the Leo minidoll! Place the torso on the head on the torso, and the hair on the head. Leo wears lime green board shorts, a white shirt with an orange and blue pattern, and a vest with pink and purple checkers. He has brown eyes and brown messy hair. There is a picture on the instructions next to Leo showing activities he enjoys. These are soccer, cooking, and surfing!

Sub-Build: DJ booth

Group 3.

- 1. Next up we'll build a DJ booth that's shaped like a pineapple! Set the lounger aside. Place a tan 3x6 half-circle plate, horizontally with the round side at the front, in front of you.
- 2. Place a green 1x2 plate, horizontally on the left two studs on the back row of the previous piece. Repeat symmetrically on the right side. There will be a gap between these two pieces.
- 3.1. Now let's add the speakers! Place a yellow 1x2x2 tall brick with four studs on one side, horizontally with the side studs at the front, on each of the previous two pieces.
- 3.2. Place a black 2x2 round tile with a hole in the middle on the side studs of each of the previous two pieces.
- 4. Place a yellow 1x2x2 wall panel, horizontally with the smooth side at the back, centered horizontally, on the second row from the front.

Group 4.

- 5. Place the front of a light green 2x6 plate with two rounded corners, horizontally with the row of six studs at the back, centered horizontally on the previous piece. The left and right sides should attach to the speakers.
- 6. Every good DJ needs a turntable to play records! Assemble a 2x2 turntable by pushing a light gray 2x2 round turntable plate into a black 2x2 turntable base. The plate looks like a very thin 2x2 round plate and the base looks like a 2x2 tile that's hollow in the middle. Place the turntable, centered horizontally, on the 2x6 plate with rounded corners from the previous step.
- 7. Place a white 1x2 plate with rounded ends, vertically, to the left of the turntable. Repeat symmetrically on the right side.
- 8.1. Let's add a microphone so people can sing along! Push the bottom of a microphone into the hollow front stud of the right piece from the previous step.
- 8.2. Now we'll add a record to the turntable! Place a black 2x2 round tile with a record label print on the turntable.

- 9. Next we'll build an arch over the turntable. Place the left stud of a yellow 1x3x3 half arch, with the arch on the right, on the leftmost stud on the back row of the karaoke machine. This is on the back left stud of the 2x6 plate with rounded corners. Repeat symmetrically on the right side. These two pieces should meet in the middle.
- 10. Place a green 1x2 plate, horizontally and centered horizontally, on the previous two pieces where they meet in the middle.
- 11. Place a yellow 1x2 curved slope, horizontally with the tall side on the right, to the left of the previous piece. Repeat symmetrically on the right side.
- 12.1. Now we'll make the top of the pineapple! Place a green 1x2 plate, horizontally, between the previous two pieces.
- 12.2. Place a green 1x1 round plate with a large leaf on one side, with the leaf on the left, on the left stud of the previous piece. Repeat symmetrically on the right side.
- 12.3. Place a green 1x2 plate, horizontally, on the previous two pieces. This completes the DJ booth.

Bag 3.

Minifigure Group: Liann

Let's build the Liann minidoll! Place the torso on the head on the torso, and the hair on the head. Lian is wearing a short yellow skirt and a tank top that's blue with white polka dots. She's wearing purple eye shadow and has long black hair. There is a picture on the instructions next to things she enjoys. They are skateboarding, painting, cookies, and candy!

Sub-Build: Flamingo Pool Floaty

Group 5.

- 1. Now we'll build a flamingo shaped pool floaty! Set all the other builds aside for now. Place a pink 8x8 round plate in front of you.
- 2. Place the left two columns of a yellow 2x3 plate with one rounded end, horizontally with the rounded end on the right, centered vertically on the rightmost two columns so it overhangs one stud to the right. Place another on top of the first.
- 3. Place the right stud of a pink 1x1 plate with a 1x1 curved slope on one side, horizontally with the slope on the left, on the front left stud of the top previous piece. Place another behind the first.
- 4. Place the left stud of a pink 1x2 curved slope tile, horizontally with the tall side on the left, on the right stud of each of the previous two pieces.
- 5.1. Place a white 1x2 panel with a T-shaped wall, vertically with the longest wall on the right, centered vertically, to the left of the two 1x1 plates with 1x1 curved slopes. There should be four free columns to the left of this piece.
- 5.2. Place a yellow 1x2 tile, vertically, to the left of the previous piece.
- 6. Place a white 2x2 tile with one rounded end, with the rounded end at the front, in front of the previous two pieces. Repeat symmetrically on the back side.

7. Place a yellow 1x2 tile, vertically and centered vertically, on the third column from the left. This is to the left of the first 1x2 tile.

Group 6.

- 8.1. Place a pink 1x2 brick, vertically, to the left of the previous piece.
- 8.2. Place a pink 1x2 quarter cylinder, vertically with the tall side on the right, to the left of the previous piece.
- 9. Place a white 1x2 plate with rounded ends, vertically, on the 1x2 brick to the right of the previous piece.
- 10. Now we'll make the round sides of the floaty so it looks like an innertube! Place a pink 4x4 rounded corner brick, with the flat sides on the right and back, on the front left corner of the floaty so it's even with the left side and so it overhangs one row to the front. Work your way around the floaty, placing the 4x4 rounded corner bricks until they wrap around the front and back sides and make it look like an oval.
- 11. Ice cream is great to cool off with. Push the bar of a yellow ice cream bar into each of the hollow studs of the 1x2 plate with rounded ends which is on the second column from the left.

Group 7.

- 12.1. Now we'll make the flamingo's long, wavy neck! Find a pink 90 degree tube. This looks exactly like a macaroni noodle, except that it's pink and it's not edible! Place this in front of you, with the openings at the front and right.
- 12.2. Push a dark gray 2L bar with a stop in the middle into the front hole of the previous piece.
- 13. Push a red 2L axle into the right hole of the 90 degree tube.
- 14. Push the left side of another pink 90 degree tube, with the openings at the left and back, onto the right side of the previous piece.
- 15. Push the axle side of a blue 2L axle/pin connector into the back side of the previous piece.
- 16. Rotate the neck so the pin side of the previous piece is at the bottom. Find the rounded plate that overhangs on the right side of the floaty. Push the pin of the neck into the hole on the round plate. The neck should be free to spin around!
- 17. Next we'll make the head! Set the rest of the floaty aside for now. Place a dark gray 1x3 plate with round ends, horizontally, in front of you.
- 18. Place a bright pink 1x1 round plate on the right stud of the previous piece.
- 19.1. Place a white 1x1 brick with studs on two opposite sides, with the side studs at the front and back, to the left of the previous piece.
- 19.2. Place a pink 1x1 brick with a stud on one side, with the side stud on the left, to the left of the previous piece.
- 20. Place a pink 1x1 plate with a 1x1 curved slope on one side, horizontally with the curved slope on the right, on the right two studs on the head. The right side should attach to a 1x1 round plate.
- 21. Place the right stud of a pink 1x2 curved slope tile, horizontally with the tall side on the right, on the left stud of the previous piece.

- 22. Place the center anti-stud of a bright pink 2x2 round tile with a single stud onto the side stud on the front of the head.
- 23. Place a white 1x1 round tile with an eye pattern on the previous piece.
- 24. Rotate the head 180 degrees so the first eye is at the back. Place the center anti-stud of a bright pink 2x2 round tile with a single stud onto the side stud on the front of the head.
- 25. Place a white 1x1 round tile with an eye pattern on the previous piece.
- 26. Now we'll place the head on the neck! Place the flamingo floaty back in front of you, with the neck on the right, Rotate the neck so the left side is over the floaty. It should look like the middle part of a letter S. Push the bar on the top of the neck into the bottom of the leftmost stud of the head. The hollow stud should hold onto the bar.

Group 8.

- 27.1. Now we'll add the beak to the flamingo! Place a white 1x1 plate on the side stud on the right side of the head.
- 27.2. Place the top stud of a black 1x2 curved slope tile, upright with the tall side on top, on the previous piece so the beak extends down below the head. You can now sit the Liann mini doll on the floaty! She leans back against the 1x2 plate with rounded ends where the ice cream is. Her feet go around the T-shaped wall panel.

This completes the Unicorn & Flamingo Pool Party.
