This Advent calendar for kids includes Elsa, Anna and Kristoff LEGO® I Disney micro doll characters, Olaf and Sven LEGO I Disney characters and 2 LEGO I Disney kitten characters. Behind every door is a character or other mini build to help deliver a daily dose of magical holiday cheer.

After the fun of building, the box becomes a game board that leads children on an exciting adventure with the characters to collect treasures for the holiday. Kids can experience a little Advent fun every day, and indulge their passion for Disney's Frozen characters, LEGO creativity and the holiday season with a buildable set full of details.

LEGO® I Disney Frozen Advent Calendar 2025 – Surprise kids, girls and boys aged 5 and up with a building kit toy packed with 24 days of characters, activities and constructable treats.

Buildable Disney playset – Each day offers a new festive build or character to inspire play, plus the LEGO® Advent calendar box turns into a game board for up to 5 players to expand the fun.

Disney characters and more – The Advent calendar has Elsa, Anna, Kristoff, Olaf and Sven LEGO® I Disney characters, 2 LEGO I Disney kitten characters, a mini Arendelle Castle and an ice crystal tree Fantasy building toy game board and spinner – The LEGO® I Disney Advent calendar box becomes a game board that has a buildable spinner and 5 characters so 5 people can play together.

LEGO® I Disney Frozen fun – Surprises in the 231-piece construction set include Olaf's sleigh (which Sven can be attached to), a wreath with candles, a micro bell and letter, an ice table and more.

The front of the box shows Olaf, Elsa, Anna, Kristoff, and Sven around a huge Christmas tree! There is a sledge, presents, toys, a cat, table, snacks, and a reindeer too!

The back of the box shows a grid of 24 boxes in 4x6 pattern.

The top of the box shows all of the characters in Frozen!

The build is 231 pieces in total and is for ages 5+.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.

- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43273) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

The box folds down into a mat, the mat features a top down view of a snowflake pathway from a house to a bridge that goes over the river!

The windows that we'll be opening are arranged in 4 rows of six windows. No grouping instructions are provided, since each build is very small.

We don't want to spoil each day's surprise for you, so we'll put lots of ***s between each day.,

The box should be oriented with the fold-out mat on the table. The windows themselves are decorated with a view of the mountains and a reindeer flying! Ho Ho Ho! Happy building!

Day 1: (2nd row from the bottom of the leftmost column.)

Today, we are making Elsa and a penguin!

- 1. Locate a tan body printed with a light blue dress, 1 tan head printed with blue eyes and pink lips, 1 blonde hair, and 1 transparent aqua flame. Assemble your minifigure then attach the flame to her hand! This is a snowflake!
- 2. Let's make the penguin! Place a black 1x1 half cone brick in front of you. Then place a black and white 1x1 ball printed with light blue eyes and an orange nose on top so the print faces the front.

Day 2: (3rd column from the left of the 2nd row from the top.)

Today, we are making a miniature house!

- 1. Horizontally place a tan 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a nougat 2x2 box printed with windows and a door on top so it is centered horizontally and the print faces the front.
- 2. Vertically place a nougat 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then vertically place a light brown 1x2 plate on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 3. Place 2 white 1x1 pyramid tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 4. Place a light brown 2x2 plate on top of the 2x2 box so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a nougat 1x2 plate on the back row of the ppp. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 jumper plate on the ppp.
- 5. Place a nougat 1x1 brick on top of the ppp. Then place a white 1x1 pyramid tile on top of the ppp. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 slope tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front. Then place a nougat 1x1 round tile printed with a pie next to your house!

Day 3: (Top right corner.)

Today, we are making Olaf, hot chocolate, candy, and a peppermint stick!

- 1. Place a white snowman body printed with buttons and twig arms in front of you so the print faces the front. Then place a white Olaf head on top so the bar hole faces the front. Now attach an orange unicorn horn to the front-facing bar hole. This is his carrot nose!
- 2. Place a brown stem with 3 tips on top of his head! Now put Olaf away while we make the rest! Place a transparent mug of hot chocolate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 swirl on top! Now place a white and red striped candy cane next to it!
- 3. Let's make a candy bar! Horizontally place a nougat 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 tile printed with red, green and yellow candy dots on top!

Day 4: (2nd column from the left of the top row.)

Today, we are making a miniature house!

- 1. Horizontally place a white 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark red 1x2 plate on the back left corner. Now vertically place a dark green 1x2 brick on the rightmost column.
- 2. Vertically place a white 1x2 double slope brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the front and back.

- 3. Horizontally place a red 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the back left corner so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 double slope brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the left and right.
- 4. Place a dark orange 1x1 tile with a round side upright on the left front-facing side stud so the round side faces up. Then place a green 1x1 round plate upright to the right of the ppp.

Day 5: (3rd column from the right of the 2nd row from the top.)

Today, we are making a reindeer and saddle!

- 1. Horizontally place a dark tan reindeer in front of you so the head faces the left. Then place a brown 1x1 tile with a clip on top of the ppp so the clip hands face left and right. Now place a dark tan 1x1 half circle brick next to your reindeer. You can switch this out with the clip if you don't want the reindeer to wear a saddle!
- 2. Let's make a part! Let's make the saddle! Vertically place a brown 4L bar in front of you. Now horizontally attach a tan skeleton arm to the front of the bar so the other clip faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically attach a brown 4L bar to the 2 right-facing clips.
- 3. Attach the middle of the left 4L bar to the top-facing clip of the reindeer so the other bar overhangs to the right.

Day 6: (3rd column from the left of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Today, we are making a sleigh!

- 1. Horizontally place a light brown 2x6 plate with inverted sloped curved ends in front of you. Now vertically place a gold 1x2 plate with 2 bars on the 2nd column from the left so the bars face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 2. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 plate with a rail on the long side on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the rail faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top so it is centered horizontally.
- 3. Vertically place a dark tan 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the long side on the leftmost column so the clips face the left. Now vertically place a dark blue 1x2 sloped curved brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the left
- 4. Vertically place a dark pink 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the rightmost column so the long wall faces the right.

Day 7: (Bottom left corner.)

Today, we are making a spinner!

- 1. Place a white 2x2 dome brick upside down in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2x1 % brick with side studs on 3 sides on the right column so the smooth side faces the left. Now vertically place a yellow 1x2x1 % brick with side studs on 3 sides on the left column so the smooth side faces the right.
- 2. Place a white 2x2 plate with a pin underneath on the 2x2 top-facing anti-studs so the pin faces up.
- 3. Place a magenta 2x2 tile upright on the front-facing side studs. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile upright on the right-facing side studs.
- 4. Place a light orange 2x2 tile upright on the back-facing side studs. Now place a purple 2x2 tile upright on the left-facing side studs!

Day 8: (2nd column from the right of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Today, we are making Anna and 2 presents!

- 1. Locate 1 body printed with a dark green outfit and a dark orange belt, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes and pink lips, and 1 light brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her aside while we make the presents!
- 2. Place a pink 2x2 box in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Now place a yellow 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.
- 3. Let's make another present! Place a teal 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a mint blue 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Now place a red bow tie next to the present!

Day 9: (3rd column from the left of the bottom row.)

Today, we are making a fireplace!

- 1. Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a transparent orange 1x1 slope tile on the 2nd column from the left of the back row so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 2. Horizontally place a tan 1x4x2 arch brick on the back row. Then horizontally place 2 dark tan 1x2 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right.
- 3. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 jumper plate on top of the ppp.

Day 10: (Top left corner.)

Today, we are making some stockings!

- 1. Place a green 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a red 1x1 tile with a round side on the front left corner so the round side faces the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 2. Let's make another stocking! Place a white 2x2 corner plate in front of you so it looks like the braille letter d. Then place a mint blue 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Now place a blue 1x1 quarter circle tile on the back right corner so the round side faces the back right. Then place a blue 1x1 tile with a round side in front of the ppp so the round side faces the front.
- 3. Let's make another stocking now! Place a white 2x2 corner plate in front of you so it looks like the braille letter d. Then place a pink 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Now place a light pink 1x1 quarter circle tile on the back right corner so the round side faces the back right. Then place a light pink 1x1 tile with a round side in front of the ppp so the round side faces the front.
- 4. Let's attach the stockings to the fireplace from the previous day! Horizontally place the fireplace in front of you so the side studs face the front. Now place your stocking with the 2x2 round plate upright on the top 2 front-facing side studs so 1 row hangs down and the flat sides of the 1x1 tiles with a round side face the bottom left and bottom right.
- 5. Place the left column of your second stocking upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so it looks like the braille letter f and the 1x1 slope tile is on the left. Now rotate it 45 degrees clockwise so it is diagonal! Now repeat symmetrically to the right with the other stocking.

Day 11: (2nd row from the top of the 2nd column from the left.

Today, we are making 2 musical instruments!

- 1. Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2 upright side studs in front of you so the side studs face the right. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile printed with piano keys on top.
- 2. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 ridged brick upright on the right-facing side studs so the horizontal ridges face up. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 tile upright on the right-facing side studs.
- 3. This is an accordion! Now put a saxophone next to it!

Day 12: (2nd row from the top of the 2nd column from the right.)

Today, we are making a miniature windmill!

1.Place a white 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a red brown 2x2 brick with vertical gaps on top of the ppp.

2. Place a brown 2x2 brick on top of the ppp. Now place a tan 2x2 brick with a pin on top of the ppp so the pin faces the front. Then attach a gold pinhole with rotors to the front-facing pin. Now place a white 2x2 double slope brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the left and right.

Day 13: (3rd column from the right of the bottom row.)

Today, we are making candles!

- 1. Let's make 4 identical parts! Place a green 1x1 round plate in front of you. Then place a white candle stick on top of the ppp. Now place a transparent orange candle flame on top of the ppp.
- 2. Now you should have 4 identical parts! Place a green 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place 1 part to the right of the other, on the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Day 14: (2nd row from the top of the leftmost column.)

Today, we are making a bell and mail!

- 1. Horizontally place a white 1x3 plate in front of you. Then place a brown 1x1 telescope bar on the leftmost column. Then place a tan 1x1 tile with a clip on top of the ppp so the clip hands face the front and back. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 2. Horizontally attach a brown 3L bar to the 2 top-facing clips so it is centered horizontally. Now attach a black claw to the middle of the ppp so the bar faces the front. Then attach a gold 1x1 cone brick to the front-facing bar so the anti-stud faces the front. Now bend it down so the anti-stud faces down.
- 3. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 tile printed with mail next to the build!

Day 15: (2nd row from the bottom of the rightmost column.)

Today, we are making Kristoff and his cooking supplies!

- 1. Let's make Kristoff! Locate a body printed with black legs, sand blue arms, and a dark red shirt, 1 tan head printed with eyes, a nose, and lips, 1 blonde hair with a dark blue hat. Assemble your minifigure then put him in front of you while we make the rest!
- 2. Attach a green stem to an orange carrot and place it in front of you. Now place a black pot and a dark green 1x1 pile of balls next to the carrot! The pile of balls are bubbles from the pot!

Day 16: (3rd column from the right of the bottom row.)

Today, we are making some miniature houses!

- 1. Horizontally place a white 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 brick on the back left corner. Now horizontally place a green 1x2 brick with a side stud on the long side on the front left corner so the side stud faces the front. Then place a gold 1x1 tile with a round side upright on the front-facing side stud so the round side faces up.
- 2. Place a green 2x2 brick on the 2 leftmost columns. Then place a white 2x2 slope brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 3. Horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 brick on the back right corner. Then place a mint blue 1x1 brick on the left column of the ppp. Now place a mint blue 1x1 brick with a side stud and bottom lip to the right of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Then place a transparent orange 1x1 tile upright on the front-facing side stud of the ppp.
- 4. Horizontally place a white 1x2 double slope tile on the back right corner so it slopes to the left and right.

Day 17: (2nd column from the left of the bottom row.)

Today, we are making a Christmas tree and 2 presents!

- 1. Let's make a Christmas tree! Place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a brown 1x1 cone brick on top of the ppp.
- 2. Place a green 2x2 cone brick on top of the ppp so it is centered. Then place the bar of a gold 1x1 round plate with a horizontal bar on top of the ppp so the stud faces the front. Now place a gold 1x1 star upright on the front-facing side stud.
- 3. Let's make a present! Place a white 2x2 brick in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the ppp. Now place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.
- 4. Let's make another present! Place a purple 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then place a purple 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Day 18: (3rd column from the left of the bottom row.)

Today, we are making another miniature house!

1. Horizontally place a white 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light orange 1x2 brick on the back left corner. Now place a dark blue 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then place a white 1x1 double slope tile on the ppp so it slopes to the left and right.

- 2. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 brick with a side stud on the long side on the front left corner so the side stud faces the front. Now place a dark orange 1x1 tile with a round side onto the front-facing side stud so the round side faces up.
- 3. Place an orange 2x2 box on the 2 leftmost columns. Then place a white 2x2 double slope brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the left and right. Now place a transparent 1x1 snowflake tile next to your house!

Day 19: (2nd row from the bottom of the 2nd column from the left.)

Today, we are making a seesaw!

- 1. Vertically place a white 2x4 tile with 2 studs in front of you. Then vertically place a light blue 2x3 plate with a round side and a pinhole underneath the front 2 rows so the round side is exposed to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a light brown kitten printed with eyes and eyelashes on the back stud so it faces the front.
- 2. Now place a light grey 2x2 plate with a pinhole underneath the part so it is centered vertically and the pinhole faces left and right.
- 3. Let's make another part! Horizontally place a mint blue 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x2 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Now vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a pin on the rightmost column so the pin faces the left. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x2 slope tile on the rightmost column so it slopes to the right.
- 4. Vertically attach the pinhole of your first part to the left-facing pin so it is centered vertically and the kitten is in the back.

Day 20: (2nd column from the right of the bottom row.)

Today, we are making a pine tree and a present!

- 1. Place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a brown 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top of the ppp so the bar faces up.
- 2. Then place a green sunflower upside down on top of the top-facing bar so the anti-stud faces up. Now place a green ice cream cone upside down on top of the ppp so the bar faces up. This is a pine tree!
- 3. Let's make a present! Place a light brown 2x2 crate in front of you. Then place a light brown 2x2 tile printed with a wreath made up of white goats on top. Then place a white 1x1 tile printed with Olaf next to it!

Day 21: (2nd column from the right of the top row.)

Today, we are making a pine tree, a cat, and a croissant!

- 1. Place a white 2x2 round tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a brown 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top of the ppp so the bar faces up.
- 2. Then place a green sunflower upside down on top of the top-facing bar so the anti-stud faces up. Now place a green ice cream cone upside down on top of the ppp so the bar faces up. This is a pine tree! Now place a yellow cat and a light brown croissant next to the tree!

Day 22: (3rd column from the right of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Today, we are making a table with hot chocolate and a cupcake on it!

- 1. Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a transparent aqua 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 2. Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a transparent aqua 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 rounded plate on top of the ppp.
- 3. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 part underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 4. Let's make a part! Place a mint blue cupcake wrapper in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 swirl on top of the ppp. Now place your part on the left stud.
- 5. Let's make another part! Place a transparent cup of hot chocolate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 swirl on top of the ppp. Now place your part on the right stud so the handle faces the right.

Day 23: (2nd row from the top of the rightmost column.)

Today, we are making a water fountain!

- 1. Place a mint blue 2x2 tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a transparent aqua snowflake on top of the ppp so the bars face outwards to all sides.
- 2. Place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick on top of the ppp. Now place a transparent 3x3 dish on top of the ppp.
- 3. Place a transparent blue 1x1 cone brick on top of the ppp. Then place a transparent 2x2 dish on top of the ppp. Now place a transparent diamond on top of the ppp.

Day 24: (Bottom right corner.)

Today we are making an archway!

- 1. Horizontally place a light magenta 2x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 slope brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the front. Then place a tan 1x1 brick on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 2. Stack 2 teal 1x1 round bricks on the 2nd column from the left of the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a magenta 2x2 tile in between the 4 ppp so there is no overhang.
- 3. Place a white 1x1 brick with a side stud on the back left corner so the side stud faces the front. Now place a transparent white 1x1 snowflake tile upright on the front-facing side stud. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 inverted slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the right. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.
- 4. Horizontally place a light orange 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 double slope tile on the ppp so it is centered horizontally.
- 5. Place a white 1x1 cone brick on the back left corner. Then place a mint blue 1x1 slope tile to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Congratulations you have finished the build!
