40811 Altar of the Dead

Adapted by Shannon Holmes and tested by Jolene Nemeth.

Celebrate the Day of the Dead with this LEGO® Altar of the Dead (40811) building set for kids aged 9 and up. Have fun creating the Día De Los Muertos model, which features a skull on one side and an altar on the other, before using it as seasonal decor. The skull is embellished with LEGO flowers, while the altar features a flower arch and various food offerings. A creative way to learn about how the tradition is celebrated in Mexico.

Día De Los Muertos building set – Encourage kids to celebrate the Day of the Dead with this LEGO® Altar of the Dead building set for kids aged 9 and up, which is full of symbolism

2 sides – One side of the model features a skull that's decorated with LEGO® flowers, while the other features an altar with a flower arch and various food accessories

Colorful decor – Once it's complete, the set becomes home decor that can be used as a Día De Los Muertos decoration

Dimensions – The set includes 231 pieces and measures over 3.5 in. (9 cm) high, 3 in. (8 cm) wide and 3.5 in. (10 cm) deep

The build is 231 pieces and is for ages 9+.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.

- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner who may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each set, PDF versions are always online at https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/40811 as low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags or small containers. Have a sighted friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted into groups according to the building steps in the set. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers or meaningful names. The parts will be collected into a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 - 4, 1 set of instructions

Sorting Instructions:

Bag 1: Skull and Altar

Group 1: Steps 1 - 6 (stack 2 tan 1x3 plates on top of 2 light bluish gray 1x3 plates to differentiate), and 1 bright pink 2x2 tile from Step 21.

Group 2: Steps 7 - 11 (stack 2 bright pink 1x1 flower plate on top of 2 dark pink to differentiate), and 1 bright light orange 2x2 tile from Step 21.

Group 3: Steps 12 – 20 (stack 1 tan 2x6 brick on top of 1 black 2x6 brick to differentiate), and 1 magenta 2x2 tile from Step 21.

Bag 2: Skull and Altar

Group 1: Steps 22 – 24, 2 white 2x2 corner brick from Step 25, 1 magenta 1x1 slope from Step 35.

Group 2: 2 black 2x2 corner brick from Step 25 and Steps 26 – 31, 1 orange 1x1 slope from Step 35, and 1 magenta 1x2 slope from Step 38.

Group 3: Steps 32 – 37, 1 lime 1x1 slope from Step 35, 1 bright light orange 1x2 slope from Step 38, and 2 yellow 2x1 slopes from Step 39.

Group 4: Rest of Step 38 and Step 39, Steps 40 – 41, 1 medium azure 1x1 slope from Step 35.

Bag 3: Skull and Altar

Group 1: Steps 42 – 48.

Group 2: 1 magenta 2x3 tile from Step 49, Steps 50 – 56 (stack 2 medium lavender 1x1 flower plate on top of 2 bright green, and 2 light bright blue on the bottom to differentiate).

Group 3: Steps 57 – 61, 1 bright pink 2x3 tile from Step 49, 4 bright light orange 1x1 flower plate from Step 51.

Group 4: Steps 62 – 65, (stack 1 magenta 2x2 plate with 4 petals on top (studs up) of 1 bright green, and 1 bright light orange; stack 1 bright pink 1x1 flower plate on top of 1 lime, 2 bright light yellow, and 1 light aqua to differentiate; stack 1 yellow 2x2 sunflower on top of 1 bright light blue to differentiate).

Bag 4: Skull and Altar

Group 1: Steps 66 – 72. (stack 5 bright light orange 1x1 flower plate on top of 1 lavender to differentiate)

Group 2: 1 orange peony flower with 2 layers from Step 68, Steps 73 –77. (stack 1 dark green 1x1 flower plate on top of 6 bright light orange to differentiate)

Let's start building!

Building Instructions:

Bag 1.

Group 1 -

- 1. Place a white 4x6 plate horizontally in front of you. Place a white 2x2 inverted curved slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the left.
- 2. Place another white 2x2 inverted slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Then place 2 more on the rightmost column so they slope and overhang to the right.
- 3. Place 2 white 1x2 plates with rail horizontally on the front row so the rails face the front and together they are centered horizontally.
- 4. Place a light bluish gray 1x3 plate vertically on the second column from the left on the back 3 rows. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then place a tan 1x3 plate on top of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 5. Place a light gray 1x6 brick horizontally on the second row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Its left and right anti studs will sit on the 1x3 plates from the previous step.
- 6. Place a white 1x2x1 2/3 brick with 2x2 side studs horizontally on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of the front row so the side studs face the front. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 2 -

- 7. Now it's time to make some teeth! Place the black 2x4 plate horizontally in front of you.
- 7.1. Place 4 1x1 tiles with rounded side on the front row so the round side faces the back. Repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 7.2. Take the teeth sub-build and orient so it is horizontally upright with the tiles facing the front. Place it on the front facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.
- 8. Place a bright pink 1x1 round flower plate on the bottom leftmost front facing side stud. Place a white 1x1 tile with rounded side on the side stud above the ppp so the round side faces down. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 9. Place a white 1x3 brick vertically on the front 3 rows of the leftmost column. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 10. Place a dark pink 1x1 round flower plate on the front row of the leftmost column. Then place a 2x2 inverted curved slope brick behind it so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 11. Vertically place a white 2x3 plate on the 2nd row from the front so it overhangs the teeth slightly. Place a white 3x3 quarter circle plate to the left of the ppp so the right angle faces the back right. The curved side should face the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 3 -

Rotate the build 180 degrees. We will now be working on building the altar table off the back.

- 12. Place a white 1x2 inverted slope brick vertically on the leftmost column of the front row so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on top. Repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.
- 13. Place a black 1x3 plate vertically on top of the ppp so there is no overhang. Repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 14. Place a tan 1x4 brick horizontally on the front row so it is centered horizontally.
- 15. Place a tan 6x8 plate vertically on the front 2 row so it is centered horizontally and 6 rows overhang to the front.
- 16. Place a tan 1x6 arch brick horizontally underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a dark brown 1x1 plate under the left and right anti study of the arch brick.
- 17. Place a tan 2x6 brick horizontally on the 7th and 8th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then place a black 2x6 brick in front of the ppp.
- 18. Place 3 black 2x2 jumper plates, one to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so together they are centered horizontally.
- 19. Horizontally place 3 black 1x2 jumper plates, one to the right of the other, in front of the ppp.
- 20. Horizontally place 3 1x2 plates with 2x2 side studs hanging down, one to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so the side studs face the front.
- 21. Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! The stickers are inspired by the Mexican paper banners, called papel picado, meaning perforated paper. The designs are printed in black on a background similar to the tile they are being placed on.
- 21.1.1. Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the magenta 2x2 tile (in Group 3). This sticker is a heart in the middle of a design with lines and flowers around it.
- 21.1.2. Place a 2x2 magenta tile with sticker upright on the left 2 columns of front facing side studs. Make sure the sticker is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 21.2.1. Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the bright light orange 2x2 tile (in Group 2). This sticker is a sugar skull (also called a calavera) wearing a sombrero in the middle of a design with lines, hearts, and flowers around it.
- 21.2.2. Place a 2x2 orange tile with sticker upright on the front facing side studs to the right of the ppp. Make sure the sticker is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 21.3.1. Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the bright pink 2x2 tile (in Group 1). This sticker is a butterfly in the middle of a design with lines and flowers around it.
- 21.3.2. Place a 2x2 bright pink tile with sticker upright on the remaining front facing side studs. Make sure the sticker is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Bag 2.

Group 1 -

- 22. Horizontally place a white 1x2 slope brick on the second column from the left of the back row. Repeat symmetrically to the right. This will create a hole for the skull's nose.
- 23 Place the back row of a white 1x2 curved brick on the leftmost stud of the back row so the curve faces the back left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 24. Horizontally place a black 2x4 brick on the second and third rows from the back so it is centered horizontally. Then place a black 1x4 brick in front of the ppp.

25.1. Place a white 2x2 corner brick on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back, on the 2 leftmost columns so it looks like a braille letter F. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 2 -

- 25.2. Place a black 2x2 corner brick to the left of the ppp so it looks like a braille letter H. Repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 26. Place a light gray 2x4 plate horizontally on the 5th and 6th rows from the back so it is centered horizontally. It should sit in front of the black 1x4 brick.
- 27. Place a black 1x4 plate horizontally in front of the ppp. Then place the front row of a black 3x3 corner plate to the left of the ppp so the right angle faces the back right. The curve should face the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 28. Place a black 2x2 jumper plate on the 5th and 6th rows from the back so it is centered horizontally. It should sit in front of the 1x4 brick. Then place another to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 29. Place 3 black 1x2 jumper plates, one to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so together they are centered horizontally.
- 30. Place a purple 1x2 plate horizontally on the 2 rightmost columns of the 5th row from the back. Then place the right column of a purple 1x2 curved tile in front of the ppp so it curves to the front right. It should follow the curve of the plate below. Repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 31. Place the back row of a magenta 2x2 angled corner plate on the 2 left columns of the 5th column from the back so the angled side faces the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 3 -

- 32. Place a white 2x2 slope brick on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally, and it slopes to the back. Then place a white 1x2 brick horizontally in front of the ppp.
- 33. Place a white 3x3 quarter circle plate on the back 3 rows to the left of the 2 ppp, so the right angle faces the front right. The curve will face the back left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 34.1. Let's make 2 identical parts. Place a 1x1 white plate with side stud hanging down in front of you so the side stud faces the front. Place a medium lavender 1x1 round flower plate upright on the front facing side stud.
- 34.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts. Place the first part on the back row of the leftmost column so the flower plate faces the back. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 35.1. Place a lime green 1x1 slope tile on the back row on the second column from the left so it slopes to the back.
- 35.2. Place a 1x1 medium azure slope tile to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the back.
- 35.3. Place an orange 1x1 slope tile on the second stud from the right of the back row so it slopes to the back.
- 35.4. Place a magenta 1x1 slope tile on the back row to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the back.
- 36.1. Let's make 2 identical parts. Place a blue 1x2 jumper plate horizontally in front of you. Then place a yellowish green 1x1 round plate with open stud on top of the ppp.
- 36.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts. Place the first part horizontally on the 2nd row from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

37. Place the right column of a white 1x2 curved brick on the second row from the back on the leftmost stud so the curve faces the back left. It should sit next to the blue 1x2 jumper plate and the left anti stud should sit on the 1x1 brick with side stud hanging down. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 4 -

- 38.1. Place a black 1x6 plate horizontally in front of you. Place a bright pink 1x2 slope tile horizontally on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the front.
- 38.2. Place a bright orange 1x2 slope tile horizontally to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 38.3. Place a magenta 1x2 slope tile horizontally to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the front.
- 38.4. Place your part horizontally on the 4th row from the back so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front.
- 39.1. Place the back row of a purple 1x2 slope brick vertically to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 39.2. Vertically place a yellow 1x2 slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 40. Place a yellow 1x2 plate horizontally on the 2 leftmost columns of the 4th row from the back. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 41.1. Let's make 2 identical parts. Place a white flower with bar on the black 1x1 round plate with hollow stud and horizontal bar.
- 41.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts. Orient your part upright so the bar of the round plate faces down and the flower faces the back. Place it into the hollow stud between the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. It should sit in front of 2 slope tiles and to the right of the curved brick. Repeat symmetrically to the right. These are the skull's eyes.

Bag 3.

Group 1 -

- 42. Place a white 2x2 plate on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally.
- 43. Place a white 1x4x2 arch brick on the back row of studs on the 4 leftmost columns. Repeat symmetrically to the right. These are the tops of the eyes for the skull.
- 44. Place a light gray 1x2 log brick in front of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then place a medium azure 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top of the ppp so the side studs face the front.
- 45. Horizontally place a black 1x2x3 brick to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 46. Place a white 2x8 plate horizontally on the back 2 rows of studs.
- 47. Place the top row of a black 2x6 plate horizontally upright on the front facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and hangs down 1 row.
- 48. Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the bright light orange 2x3 tile or skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! The stickers are inspired by the Mexican paper banners, called papel picado, meaning perforated paper. The designs are printed in black on a background similar to the tile they are being placed on. This sticker is a LEGO parrot in the middle of a design with lines and heart border.

48.1 Place a bright light orange 2x3 tile with sticker vertically upright on the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Make sure the sticker is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 2 -

- 49. Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the magenta 2x3 tile and sticker 3 on the bright pink 2x3 tile (Group 3) or skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! The stickers are inspired by the Mexican paper banners, called papel picado, meaning perforated paper. The designs are printed in black on a background similar to the tile they are being placed on.
- 49.1. Place a bright pink 2x3 tile with sticker vertically upright to the left of the ppp. This sticker is a LEGO dog in the middle of a design with lines and flowers border. A Xoloitzcuintli dog is believed to guide souls to the afterlife. Make sure the sticker is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 49.2. Place a magenta 2x3 tile vertically upright on the 2 rightmost columns of front facing side studs. This sticker is a LEGO cat in the middle of a design with lines and flowers border Make sure the sticker is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 50. Place a yellow 1x1x1 2/3 brick with side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front.
- 50.1. Place a medium lavender 1x1 round flower plate on top.
- 50.2. Place a bright green 1x1 round flower plate on the top front facing side stud. Then place a bright light blue 1x1 round flower plate below the ppp. Now, turn the part 180 degrees so the flowers face the back.
- 50.3. Now you should have 2 identical parts. Place one part on the back row of the leftmost column so the flowers face the back. Repeat symmetrically to the right. These sit just behind and to the left and right of the arches which form the back row of studs.
- 51.1. Let's make 2 identical parts. Place a yellow 1x1x1 2/3 brick with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Place a bright light orange 1x1 round flower plate upright on each of the front facing studs.
- 51.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts. Place 1 on the second row from the back on the rightmost column so the flowers face the front. Repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 52. Place a yellow short 1x2 curved sloped brick on the ppp and the piece behind it so it slopes to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 53. Place a white 1x4 plate on the back row of studs so it is centered horizontally. Then place a white 1x8 plate in front of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.
- 54. Place the 1x2 plate of a white 2x2 tile with upright 1x2 plate horizontally on the back row of studs on the 2 left columns so the anti-studs face the back. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 55. Place a white 2x2 plate with 1x2 side studs on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally, and the side studs face the front.
- 56. Place the 1x2 plate of a white 2x2 tile with an upright 1x2 plate horizontally on the back row of studs so it is centered horizontally, and the anti-studs face the back. Then place a purple 2x2 round plate on the anti-studs of the ppp.

Group 3 -

- 57. Place a white 2x2 plate on the back row of studs so it is centered horizontally. Then place a white 2x3 curved slope brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.
- 58. Place a white 1x2 plate with stud and upright clip horizontally on the 2 left columns of the back row of studs so the clip is on the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

- 59. Place a yellow 1x4 plate on the second row from the back so it is centered horizontally. Place the right column of a yellow 1x3x3 curved slope brick to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left and attaches to the lower stud on the back row of the leftmost column. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 60. Place a yellow 1x6 plate horizontally on top of the 3 ppp.
- 61. Place a white 2x2 curved slope brick on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally, and it slopes to the back.

Group 4 -

- 62. Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the lavender 2x3 tile or skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! The stickers are inspired by the Mexican paper banners, called papel picado, meaning perforated paper. The designs are printed in black on a background similar to the tile they are being placed on.
- 62.1. Place a lavender 2x3 tile with sticker horizontally upright on the top row of front facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. This sticker is a LEGO dog in the middle of a design with lines and 1 flower at the top of the border. A Xoloitzcuintli dog is believed to guide souls to the afterlife. Make sure the sticker is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.
- 63. Rotate the whole build 180 degrees so that the skull is facing you.
- 63.1. Place a magenta 2x2 plant plate with 4 petals upright on the front facing anti studs of the 2x2 round plate that is in the center of the build.
- 63.2. Place a bright light green 2x2 plant plate with 4 petals upright on the 2x2 anti studs to the left of the ppp. Then place a bright light orange 2x2 plant plate with 4 petals symmetrically to the right.
- 64. Place a bright pink 1x1 round flower plate upright on the center of the 2x2 anti studs in the center of the skull. Then place a 1x1 round lime green flower plate in the center of the anti-studs to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right with a yellow 1x1 round flower plate.
- 65.1. Place the yellow sunflower on top of the transparent clear bar with angled stud and place the bright light yellow 1x1 round flower plate in the middle of the sunflower. Vertically and angled so the flowers face to the front right, put the bar into the right clip on the top of the skull. You may want to rotate the flower a bit once attached to angle it a bit upward.
- 65.2. Place the bright light blue sunflower on top of the transparent clear bar with angled stud and place the light aqua 1x1 round flower plate in the middle of the sunflower. Vertically and angled so the flowers face to the front left, put the bar into the leftmost clip on the top of the skull. You may want to rotate the flower a bit once attached to angle it a bit upward.

Bag 4.

Group 1 -

66. Place a 1x1 round bright orange flower plate on the second row of studs from the front on each of the studs to the left and right of the 2x2 curved slope tile. You will place a total of 4.

You have finished decorating the sugar skull. Now let's finish decorating the altar.

- 67. Rotate the whole build 180 degrees so that the altar is now facing you.
- 67.1. Let's make 2 identical parts. Orient a white candle so it is vertically upright with the bar at the bottom. Place it into the hollow stud of the 1x1 round tan plate. Then place an orange candle flame on top.

- 67.2. Place one candle on the 3rd row of studs from the back on the second column from the left. It should sit in the space between the front facing flower plates and the 2x3 tiles. Repeat symmetrically to the right. You can rotate the candles once in place to position the flames the way you want them.
- 68.1. Place a transparent saucer on the center 1x2 jumper plate that is on the 5th row from the front. Then place a lavender peony flower on the stud of the jumper plate to the right of the ppp.
- 68.2. Place an orange peony flower on the 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the saucer.
- 69. Place a white 1x1 round plate on top of the saucer. Place a 1x1 round bright orange flower plate on top of the peony to the left of the ppp. Then place a lavender 1x1 round flower plate on top of the lavender peony on the right 1x2 jumper plate.
- 70. Place a black cone onto the stud in the silver inverted dome. Then place the dome on the 2x2 jumper plate behind the saucer
- 71. Hold a transparent green bottle upright so the side with the ridge faces down. Place a black 1x1 round plate on top. Then place the bottle to the left of the dome and place a transparent goblet to the right of the dome.
- 72. Let's make 2 identical parts. Place one bright green flower stem in the top of each 1x1 transparent light blue round brick then place 1 bright light orange round flower plate on each of the 3 stems. You will place 6 flower plates in total. Place one on the leftmost stud of the 6th row from the front. It should sit in front of the slope bricks. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 2 -

- 73. Place a 1x1 round plate on each of the 2x2 reddish-brown round plate studs (4 in total). Then place the center anti-stud of the 2x2 plate on the stud of the right 2x2 jumper plate that is on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front.
- 74. Place a transparent saucer to the left of the ppp. Then place a dark green 1x1 flower plate to the left of the ppp. Place a skeleton minifigure head on the stud in front of the saucer.
- 75. Locate 6 bright light orange 1x1 round flower plates. Place one to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then place the remaining flower plates on the 4 middle studs of the front row.
- 76. Place a turkey leg on the saucer that is behind the skeleton head, so the end faces the front right. Then place a yellow 1x1 cone brick to the left of the ppp on top of the dark green 1x1 round flower plate.
- 77. Let's make 2 identical parts. Stack 2 tan 1x1 round plates with open stud. Then place an orange candle flame in the open stud. Now you should have 2 identical parts. Place one on the leftmost column of the front row. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

This completes the Altar of the Dead!
