

## 11208 Team Spidey Pirate Ship

Adapted by Arturo Moncada-Torres and tested by Peter Durieux.

Set sail for imaginative play aboard the Team Spidey Pirate Ship (11208) creative building toy with Spidey, Green Goblin, Ghost-Spider and Miles "Spin" Morales. This building set offers a great way for boys, girls and kids ages 4 years old and up to develop skills as they explore fun at sea and on Spider Island. This feature-packed Spidey building toy includes a pirate ship, Spider Island with a slide, Green Goblin's ship and a smaller boat. There's a cannon on the pirate ship, a disc shooter on the island and shooters on Green Goblin's ship. Spidey's web rope can be used to catch a fish, a treasure chest or Goblin's ship. This Spider-Man gift for fans of Spidey And His Amazing Friends comes with colorful pictorial instructions, a Starter Brick and separate bags containing 1 buildable model per bag to make creative construction fast and fun.

The packaging transmits all the aquatic fun contained in the set. The front of the box shows a large illustration of the combat between the set's characters. To the left, Ghost Spider is standing on her island, aiming her water gun at Green Goblin, who is in his small ship, on the water. In the middle, we can see Spidey's ship prominently, with Spidey at the wheel and Spin floating to its side, in a tub, attached to the ship by a web. Behind the Spidey's ship, a shark lurks around the area. The background is composed of a white and blue sky with some clouds. On the top left corner, we have the classic LEGO and Marvel logos. On the right side, we have our heroes (Spidey, Ghost Spider, and Spin) as depicted in the Spidey and this Amazing Friends show. The build consists of 201 pieces in total and is recommended for ages 4+. Once finished, you will have Spidey's ship, an island with a slide, Green Goblin's ship, a smaller boat, and 4 minifigures. The set consists of 4 numbered bags.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind! Before you start building, here are some terms we may be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- Open/hollow stud: a bump on a LEGO brick with a hole, which allows attaching bars. In the case of open studs, the hole goes all the way through. In the case of hollow studs, it does not.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Left/right wedge parts: these are parts that when placed in front of you and are pointing to the back, their wedge is on the left/right side of the part.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

Additionally, it is worth mentioning that besides the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, a PDF version for the set's instructions is always available online at [<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/11208>]. This might help a sighted building partner that may want to follow along or low vision users that may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

#### Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2, and 3 and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 numbered bags, 4 instruction booklets, and 4 minifigures. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder!

LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Building Instructions

Book 1, bag 1:

Group 1 – Green Goblin

Pages 6-7 Let's start putting together the villain of the set: Green Goblin.

Locate 1 dark purple pair of medium legs, 1 dark purple torso with tattered vest, black bandana, lime green arms, and dark purple hands, and 1 dark purple head with balaclava and lime face. Assemble your minifigure. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is facing the right way. Then, put on the dark purple tricorne pirate hat on the minifigure's head. Green Goblin is ready!

Group 2 – Shark and Green Goblin's accessories

Pages 8-9. Attach 1 light bluish gray shark head to 1 light bluish gray shark body. When assembled, there should be a click sound. Feel free to pose the shark with its mouth open or closed.

Pages 10-11 Stand Green Goblin inside a dark orange half barrel. Place 1 reddish brown oar in his left hand and a 2x2 tan tile with a pirate map print (decorated with different pieces of land in yellow surrounded by blue water, with one black pirate ship navigating towards a red X) in his right hand.

#### Group 3 – Green Goblin's ship

Pages 12-13. Place 1 black 4x6 triple inverted slope tile in front of you, so that it slopes to the back. Rotate 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with 1x2 inverted curved slope tile so that it slopes to the front. Place its back row on top of the 2 middle columns of the front row of the ppp.

Pages 14-15. Place 1 white 2x2 brick behind the ppp.

Pages 16-17. Place 1 medium azure 1x2 plate horizontally in front of the ppp.

Pages 18-19. Place 1 lime 1x2 plate horizontally on top of the ppp.

Pages 20-21. Locate 4 light bluish gray 1x2 plates with pin holes underneath. Place the first one horizontally to the left of the ppp, so that the column with the pin hole overhangs to the left. Then, place the second one in the same orientation behind the ppp. Lastly, take the last 2 and repeat symmetrically to the right.

Pages 22-23. Rotate 1 dark purple 2x2 short brick with 1x3 left and right wedges so that its narrow part faces to the back. Place its 2x2 short brick behind the 2x2 white brick.

Pages 24-25. Find 2 lime 2x2 slope bricks. Place the first one on the 2 front rows of the 2 leftmost columns, so that it slopes to the left. Then, place the second one symmetrically on the right.

Pages 26-27. Place 1 lime 1x2 plate horizontally on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row from the back, so that it is centered horizontally.

Pages 28-29. Place 1 lime 2x2 curved slope tile on top of the ppp, so that it slopes to the back.

#### Group 4 – Green Goblin's ship (continued)

Pages 30-31. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 steering wheel horizontally in front of the ppp, so that the steering wheel faces to the front.

Pages 32-33. Place 1 black 1x4 double inverted slope horizontally on the front row, so that it is centered horizontally and it slopes and overhangs by 1 column to the left and right.

Pages 34-35. Place 1 light bluish gray 2x2 brick with 1L pin on the 2 front rows, so that it is centered horizontally and its pin overhangs to the front.

Pages 36-37. Place 2 red round plates with open studs on the leftmost and rightmost columns of the front row.

Pages 38-39. Place 1 black 2x4 double jumper tile horizontally on top of the 2 front rows, so that it is centered horizontally.

Pages 40-41. Find 2 dark purple 1x2 curved slope tiles. Place the first one vertically behind the left column of the ppp, so that it slopes to the back. Then, take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

Pages 42-43. Attach 1 black propeller upright to the front-facing pin.

Pages 44-46. You can use the 3 medium azure projectiles with round end as ammunition for the ship. You can insert them into the pin holes on the sides, from front to back, so that their flat side faces to the front. Then, you can push them from the back to fire. Be careful not to point or shoot them at anyone's face.

Page 47. If you want, you can also sit Green Goblin in his ship.

Book 2, bag 2:

Group 5 – Ghost Spider

Pages 4-5 Let's put together Ghost Spider.

Locate 1 dark purple pair of medium legs, 1 white torso with hoodie, dark purple front, magenta web, and medium azure spider, white arms, and magenta hands, and 1 white head with magenta eyes. Assemble your minifigure. Then, put on the magenta bicorne pirate hat with medium azure spider logo on the minifigure's head. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face and hat prints are facing the right way. Lastly, put a black blaster in Ghost Spider's left hand. Attach 1 trans-light blue water effect to its muzzle (front hole) to complete her water gun. Ghost Spider is ready!

Group 6 – Small island

Pages 6-7. Place 1 blue 6x6 plate in front of you. Then, place 1 medium azure 1x6 plate vertically on the leftmost column of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 8-9. Place 1 white 1x4 plate vertically to the right of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically. Grab 2 medium azure 1x6 plates. Place the first one horizontally on the back row, so that it overhangs to the right by 1 column. Then, place the second one symmetrically on the front.

Pages 10-11. Place 1 light bluish gray 6x8 plate horizontally on the right of the build, so that its left front and back corners are under the overhangs of the ppps.

Pages 12-13. Place 1 reddish brown 2x4 brick vertically on the 2 leftmost columns of the build, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 14-15. Place 1 reddish brown 2x4 brick vertically on top of the ppp.

Pages 16-17. Place 1 white 1x4 plate vertically on the leftmost column of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 18-19. Rotate 1 yellow slide so that its low end faces to the front and its high end faces to the right. Place its high end on top of the ppp.

Page 20-21. Place 1 red 1x6x2 arch vertically on the 7<sup>th</sup> column from the left.

Group 7 – Small island (continued)

Pages 22-23. Locate 2 reddish brown 1x6x1 arches. Place the first one horizontally on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row from the back, so that it attaches to the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> columns from the left. Then, place the second one symmetrically on the front.

Pages 24-25. Find 2 medium nougat 1x4 tiles with 2 studs. Place the first one vertically on top of the rightmost columns of the ppps. Then, take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

Pages 26-27. Grab 2 medium nougat 1x4 tiles with 2 studs. Place them vertically, side by side, between the ppps.

Pages 28-29. Locate 2 red 1x6 bricks. Place the first one horizontally on the back row, so that it leaves one column exposed to the right. Then, take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Pages 30-31. Find 2 red 1x2 slope bricks. Place the first one vertically on the 2 back rows of the rightmost column, so that it slopes to the front. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Pages 32-33. Place 1 blue 1x2 plate with bar handle on long side vertically on the rightmost column, so that it is centered vertically and its bar handle is to the right.

Pages 34-35. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 curved slope tile on top of the ppp, so that it slopes to the left and it has no overhang.

Group 8 – Small island (continued)

Pages 36-37. Grab 2 red 1x1x3 bricks. Place the first one on the 7<sup>th</sup> column from the left of the back front (on top of the front row of the red 1x6 arch). Then, take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

Pages 38-39. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2x3 brick horizontally to the right of the ppp. Then, place 1 dark bluish gray 1x4x3 panel to the right of the ppp, so that its flat face faces to the back.

Pages 40-41. Place 1 red 1x1x3 brick on the 7<sup>th</sup> column from the right of the front row.

Pages 42-45. Place 1 red 1x4x3 window frame horizontally to the right of the ppp, so that its ridge faces to the front. Attach 1 medium nougat 1x4x3 grille horizontally upright to the front of the window frame to add bars to the window.

Group 9 – Small island (continued)

Pages 46-47. Place 2 bright light orange 2x6 plates vertically, side by side, on the 4<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> columns from the right, so that together they are centered vertically.

Pages 48-49. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2x2 slope brick horizontally on the 2 rightmost columns of the front row, so that it slopes to the right.

Pages 50-51. Place 1 green 1x1 round brick with 3 bamboo leaves on top of the ppp, so that its leaves face to the front right.

Pages 52-53. Place 1 bright light orange 2x6 plate vertically on the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> columns from the right, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 54-55. Locate 2 red 1x6 bricks. Place the first one horizontally on the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> columns from the right of the back row. Then, take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Pages 56-57. Place 1 red 1x6 brick horizontally on the 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> columns from the right of the back row.

Group 10 – Small island (continued)

Pages 58-59. Place 1 red 1x2 brick with horizontal clip horizontally on the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> columns from the right of the front row. Then, place 1 white 1x4 brick with disk shooter horizontally to the left of the ppp, so that its clips face to the front.

Pages 60-61. Find 2 medium azure 1x6 plates. Place the first one horizontally on top of the ppps. Then, take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

Pages 62-63. Place 2 red 1x2 slope bricks on the 2 leftmost columns of the ppps, so that they slope to the right.

Pages 64-65. Place 1 red 1x6x2 arch vertically on top of the ppps.

Pages 66-67. Place 1 bright light orange 1x4 fence vertically on top of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically and the fence's lattice is on the right side.

Pages 68-69. Place 1 black 4L antenna behind the ppp. Slide 1 medium azure flag into the ppp, so that the flag waves to the right.

Pages 70-71. Place 1 transparent yellow 1x1 round brick on the 3<sup>rd</sup> column from the right of the back row. Then, place 1 pearl dark gray lantern on top of it.

Pages 72-73. Attach the clips of 1 white 3x7 ladder to the right-facing bar handle of the build. Raise it and bring it as close as possible to the island's second floor.

Pages 74-76. You can use the 2 medium azure 2x2 round tiles as ammunition for the disk shooter. You can insert them from the front and push them from the back to fire them. Be careful not to point or shoot them at anyone's face.

Page 77. If you want, you can also stand Ghost Spider on the island to defend it with her water gun.

Book 3, bag 3:

## Group 11 – Spidey

Pages 4-5 Let's put together Spidey.

Locate 1 blue pair of medium legs, 1 red torso with dark red webbing, black spider on the front, red spider on the back, blue arms, and red hands, and 1 red head with dark red webbing and large white eyes. Assemble your minifigure. Then, put on the blue bicorne pirate hat with black spider logo on the minifigure's head. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face and hat prints are facing the right way. Spidey is ready!

## Group 12 – Spidey's ship

Pages 6-7. Place 1 blue 8x8x2 inverted double curved slope in front of you, so that its technic holes face to the left and right. Insert 2 light bluish gray 2L technic pins without friction ridges into the front and back left-facing pin holes.

Pages 8-9. Rotate 1 blue 8x12 curved fuselage so that it slopes to the left. Attach its front and back right-facing pin holes into the left-facing pins of the ship build.

Pages 10-11. Find 2 medium azure 2x3 plates. Place them vertically, one in front of the other, on studs on top of the pins, on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> columns from the right, so that together they are centered vertically.

Pages 12-13. Place 1 reddish brown 1x6 tile vertically on the rightmost column, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 14-15. Place 2 bright light orange 2x4 bricks horizontally, one in front of the other, on the 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> columns from the left, so that together they are centered vertically. They should be to the left of the 2x3 plates.

## Group 13 – Spidey's ship (continued)

Pages 16-19. Place 1 red 1x2 plate with horizontal clip on short end horizontally on the 2 rightmost columns of the back row, so that its clip faces to the right. Then, place 1 medium azure 1x2 plate horizontally on top of the ppp. Lastly, place 1 red 1x2 plate with horizontal clip on short end horizontally on top of the ppp, so that its clip faces to the right

Pages 20-21. Place 1 reddish brown 1x4 brick horizontally to the left of the ppps.

Pages 22-23. Place 1 bright light orange 1x6 brick horizontally on the right of the front row, so that it has no overhang.

Pages 24-25. Place 2 reddish brown 1x1 round bricks on the front and back rows of the rightmost column.

Pages 26-27. Place 1 blue 1x8 brick vertically on top of the ppps, so that it has no overhang.

Pages 28-29. Grab 2 yellow 1x4x2 panels with round window and white spider webs print. Place the first one horizontally to the left of the front row of the ppp, so that its flat face (with the print) faces to the front. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

Pages 30-31. Place 1 blue 1x8 brick vertically to the left of the ppps.

Pages 32-33. Place 1 bright light orange 1x4 tile with studs vertically on the rightmost column, so that it is centered horizontally. Then, place 2 white 1x1 round tiles in front and behind of the ppp.

Pages 34-35. Locate 2 bright light orange 1x3 tiles. Place the first one horizontally on the right of the back row, so that it has no overhang. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Group 14 – Spidey's ship (continued)

Pages 36-37. Place 1 reddish brown 1x4 brick vertically on the 7<sup>th</sup> column from the left, so that it is centered vertically. Then, place 1 red 2x4 brick with 3 axle holes horizontally to the right of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 38-39. Place 2 blue 2x4 bricks in front and behind the ppp.

Pages 40-41. Place 1 black 2x2 ribbed short brick on top of the 2 rightmost columns of the red 2x4 brick with 3 axle holes, on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> columns from the left, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 42-43. Insert 1 yellow 3L axle into the ppp. Make sure that it goes as deep as possible, so that it protrudes by 1L.

Pages 44-45. Find 2 red 1x4x2 fences. Place the first one horizontally on the 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> columns from the right of the front row. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

Pages 46-47. Place 2 red 1x2 plates with horizontal clip on short end to the left of the ppps, so that their clips face to the left.

Pages 48-49. Grab 2 blue 2x4 bricks. Place the first one vertically on the 4 front rows of the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> columns from the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically to the back.

Pages 50-51. Locate 2 red 1x2 plates with horizontal clip on short edge. Place the first one horizontally on the back row of the ppp, so that its clip faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Pages 52-53. Find 2 bright light orange 2x2 half circle curved tile with studs. Place the first one on top of the ppp, so that it slopes to the back and it has no overhang. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

Pages 54-55. Place 2 blue 1x6 curved bricks horizontally on the 6<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> columns from the right of the front and back rows, so that they slope to the left.

Pages 56-57. Place 2 bright light orange 1x4 tiles with studs horizontally on the 4<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> columns from the right of the front and back rows.

Group 15 – Spidey's ship (continued)

Pages 58-59. Place 1 white 2x2 brick on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> columns from the left, so that it is centered vertically. Then, place 1 bright light orange 2x4 brick vertically to the right of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 60-61. Place 1 medium nougat 2x4 plate vertically on top of the ppp.

Pages 62-65. Place 1 bright light orange 2x4 brick horizontally on the 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> columns from the left, so that it is centered horizontally. Then, place 1 red 2x4 cannon base horizontally on top of the ppp, so that its upright clips are to the left. Lastly, attach 1 pearl dark gray cannon by its handles to the upright clips of the ppp, so that it aims to the left.

Pages 66-69. Let's make a sub-build. Place 1 bright light orange 2x2 plate in front of you. Then, place 1 blue 1x2 plate with bar handle on long edge vertically on the right column of the ppp, so that its bar handle faces to the right. Rotate 1 red 2x8 curved slope tile with printed white left eye and black spider horizontally, so that it slopes to the left. Place its rightmost column on top of the ppp.

The sub-build is complete. Rotate it horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the back and its bar handle is to the right. Attach it to the left-facing clips on the front side of the ship. Bring the sub-build as close to the cannon as possible.

Group 16 – Spidey's ship (continued)

Pages 70-73. Let's make another sub-build. Place 1 bright light orange 2x2 plate in front of you. Then, place 1 blue 1x2 plate with bar handle on long edge vertically on the left column of the ppp, so that its bar handle faces to the left. Rotate 1 red 2x8 curved slope tile with printed white right eye and black spider horizontally, so that it slopes to the right. Place its leftmost column on top of the ppp.

The sub-build is complete. Rotate it horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the front and its bar handle is to the left. Attach it to the left-facing clips on the back side of the ship. Bring the sub-build as close to the cannon as possible.

Pages 74-75. Attach the handle of 1 white spider web to the right-facing clips on the back of the ship, so that largest curved surface of the web faces to the right.

Group 17 – Spidey's ship (continued)

Pages 76-83. Let's make a build for the ship's mast. Place 1 black mast horizontally in front of you, so that its pin holes face to the front and back. Insert 1 red 3L technic pin with friction ridges and stop bush into the 4<sup>th</sup> hole from the top, in the middle of the mast, so that its stop bush faces to the front and it protrudes on the back by 1L.

Rotate 1 medium azure plastic triangular sail printed with Spidey's head with a blue pirate hat and white web pattern so that its narrow side is to the left and its large hole is to the back. Slide the sail's large hole into the top part of the mast. Then, bend the sail down and slide its small hole into the front-facing stop bush of the 3L technic pin.

The ship's mast is complete. Place it on top of the 2x2 short brick with 1L axle protruding on top, located in the middle of the ship.

Pages 84-86. You can use the 2 reddish brown 1x1 round bricks as ammunition for the cannon by inserting them in it and pulling and releasing the cannon's back to fire them. Be careful not to point or shoot them at anyone's face.

Page 87. If you want, you can also stand Spidey on his ship.

Page 88. Put the ship to the side for now. Make sure that it stays in the same orientation.

Book 4, bag 4:

Group 18 – Miles "Spin" Morales

Pages 4-5 Let's put together Miles "Spin" Morales.

Locate 1 black pair of medium legs, 1 black torso with red webbing, red spider on the front, red spider on the front and back, black arms, and red hands, and 1 black head with dark red webbing and large white eyes. Assemble your minifigure. Then, put on the red bicorne pirate hat with black spider logo on the minifigure's head. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face and hat prints are facing the right way. Spin is ready!

Group 19 – Miles "Spin" Morales's accessories

Pages 6-9. Place 1 medium nougat bottom chest container horizontally in front of you, so that its hinge holes face to the back. Attach 1 medium nougat top chest container horizontally to the ppp. Insert 1 trans-purple jewel and 1 trans-light blue 1x1 crystal into the chest. Lastly, put 1 red spider robot next to Spin.

Group 20 – Spidey's ship's upper deck

Pages 10-11. Place 1 medium nougat 8x8 plate with rounded end in front of you, so that its curved edge faces to the right.

Pages 12-13. Rotate 1 red 4x4 quarter round fence so that its longest curved edge faces to the back right. Place its leftmost column on top of the 5<sup>th</sup> column from the left of the back row of the ppp, so that their curvatures are aligned.

Pages 14-15. Place 1 red 4x4 quarter round fence symmetrically on the front.

Pages 16-17. Place 1 tan 2x4 brick horizontally on the 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> columns from the left, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 18-19. Place 2 reddish brown 2x2 round bricks behind and in front of the middle columns of the ppp.

Pages 20-21. Place 1 reddish brown 2x2 jumper on top of the 2x4 brick, so that it is centered horizontally. Then, place 2 reddish brown 1x2 tiles vertically to the left and right of the ppp.

Pages 22-23. Locate 2 red 1x2x2 bricks. Place the first one horizontally on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> columns of the back row. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Pages 24-25. Place 1 red 1x4x2 fence horizontally on the left of the back row, so that it overhangs to the left by 2 columns.

Pages 26-27. Rotate 1 medium nougat 2x8 plate vertically. Place its back row under the overhang of the ppp.

Pages 28-29. Place 1 red 1x4x2 fence horizontally on the left of the front row, so that it has no overhang.

Pages 30-31. Place 1 red 1x6x2 arch vertically on the leftmost column, so that it is centered vertically.

Group 21 – Spidey's ship's upper deck (continued)

Pages 32-33. Place 1 medium azure 1x2 brick with pin hole vertically on top of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 34-35. Grab 2 bright light orange 1x3 sloped bricks. Place the first one vertically behind the ppp, so that it slopes to the back. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Pages 36-37. Locate 3 bright light orange 1x4 tiles with studs. Place the first one vertically on the leftmost column, so that it is centered vertically. Place the second one horizontally on the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> columns of the back row. Take the last one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Pages 38-39. Attach 1 reddish brown ship's wheel with pin to the right of the 1x2 brick with hole, so that the wheel stays inside the deck.

Pages 40-41. Place 1 reddish brown 2x2 round brick to the right of the ship's wheel, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> columns from the left, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 42-43. Attach 1 reddish brown telescope to the 6<sup>th</sup> column of the back row. Find 2 bright light orange 4x4 round corner tiles. Place the first one to the right of the ppp, so that its curvature aligns with the back-right facing fence. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

Page 44-45. Place 1 transparent cup to the left of the telescope, on the 5<sup>th</sup> column from the left of the back row.

Pages 46-47. Let's make a hot dog. Insert 1 red sausage into 1 tan hot dog bun. Attach the complete hot dog vertically to the 2x2 jumper plate in the middle of the deck.

Pages 48-49. Attach one end of 1 white 21L string to the 6<sup>th</sup> column from the left of the front row.

Pages 50-51. Attach one flat silver fish to the other end of the ppp.

Pages 52-53. Stand Spin to the right of the ship's wheel. If you wish, you can also place his accessories (the treasure chest with the gems and the robot spider) on the deck with him.

Pages 54-55. Bring back the ship. Place the upper deck on top of the studs to the right of the mast, so that the upper deck overhangs to the right by 3 columns.

We are done with the construction! Feel free to arrange the elements of the set as you wish: Spider Ghost's island, Green Goblin and his ship and shark, and Spidey's ship. Enjoy the sea adventures of Team Spidey vs Green Goblin!

At the end of the instruction booklet, you will find one page advertising other sets from the theme. On the left, you will find set 11206 (Spidey on his Motorcycle vs. Rhino), on the top right corner set 11208 (Team Spidey Pirate Ship, this set), and on the bottom right corner set 11207 (Spidey Underwater Vehicles).
