

42692 Ice Cream & Balloon Stand

Girls and boys ages 6 and up can enjoy sweet adventures and creative playtimes with the LEGO® Friends Ice Cream & Balloon Stand (42692). The pretend play toy features fun details and cute accessories to fuel kids' imaginations. Liann and Paisley minidolls help kids jump into the story as they set up the stand ready to sell balloons and ice pop treats. Liann comes with a helmet, ready to ride the bike that tows the food stand. Play continues with an adorable ice pop mascot, plus a menu, cash register and phone. There's also a table where the friends hang out together. This kids' role-play set makes a fun birthday gift for girls and boys who love pretend play. Enjoy intuitive building with the LEGO Builder app, zooming and rotating with 3D instructions, while saving and tracking progress – all from the app. Set contains 107 pieces.

The build is 107 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back.
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified).
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece.
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece. - Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner who may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each set, PDF versions are always online at: <https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/42692>. As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags or small containers. Have a sighted friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted into groups according to the building steps in the set. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers or meaningful names. The parts will be collected into a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 bags, 1 instruction book, and 1 sticker sheet. The bags are labeled 1, and 2. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Bag 1 - Paisley, table, sign and mascot

Group 1 - Paisley minidoll sub build

Group 2 - Table sub build

Group 3 - Sign sub build

Group 4 - Mascot sub build

Bag 2 - Liann and stand

Group 5 - Liann minidoll sub build

Group 6 - Balloon and ice cream stand

Group 7 - 2 medium azure 1x1 plates

Group 8 - 3 medium azure curved 1x4 slope bricks

Group 9 - 3 pink curved 1x4 slope bricks

Group 10 - Magenta balloon

Group 11 - Pink balloon

Group 12 - Green balloon

Group 13 - Cycle parts

Group 14 - Yellow ice pop

Group 15 - Blue ice pop

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1)

Group 1 contains the pieces for the Paisley minidoll.

1. Locate a minidoll torso with pink tank top, minidoll trousers, light nougat minidoll head, long minidoll hair parted on the side, and a medium azure 1x2 tile with cell phone decoration. Put the torso on the trousers, head on the torso, and hair on the head, Place the cell phone in minidoll's hand.

Group 2 contains the pieces for the table.

2. Locate a medium azure 2x2 round tile with open stud, and a white 2 x 2 x 2 stand with hole. Place the tile on top of the stand.

Group 3 contains the pieces for the sign.

3. Locate a yellow 2x3 tile, and a medium nougat 2x2 tile with upright 1x2 plate. Vertically place the 2x3 tile in front of you. Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the tile. The sticker shows that balloons cost "2" and the ice pops cost "4". Place the 2x2 tile with the studs facing front. Rotate the 2x3 tile to stand vertically upright and place the bottom row of the tile on the studs of the 1x2 plate.

Group 4 contains the pieces for steps 4 - 16. You will be building the mascot.

4. Place a yellow 1x2 bracket with 2x2 inverted plate in front of you with the 1x2 bracket facing front.
5. Locate 2 yellow 1x2 bricks with hole. Vertically place the back stud of one brick on the left stud of the bracket. The front stud of the brick will overhang the front of the bracket. Vertically place the second brick to the right of the ppp in the same manner.
6. Locate a yellow 2x3 plate with hole. Place it vertically with the hole toward the front with the back row of studs under the ppps.
7. Locate a gray 1/2 pin and a yellow round 2x2 brick with pin holes. Insert the long part of the pin into the side hole in the brick and place the brick on the 2x3 plate with the pin facing forward.
8. Rotate the build 90 degrees counter clock wise. Place a yellow 1x2 half round tile with the flat edge facing left on the rightmost column.
9. Locate a yellow 2x3 tile. Horizontally place the 2x3 tile in front of you. Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the tile. The sticker shows the smiling face of the mascot. Place the tile on the 3 leftmost columns.
10. Locate a yellow 2x2 round tile with hole and orient it to stand upright with the smooth side pointing to the left. Connect it to the studs on the left-facing side of the build.
11. Locate a medium azure 2x2 round brick with dome top. Place it on the ppp with the flat side facing left.
12. Locate 2 yellow arms with pin. Rotate the build so that the ppp is on the ground and the sticker faces front. Insert the pin of the first arm into the hole on the left. Insert the pin of the second into the hole on the right.
13. Place a tan 1x1 round plate with open stud on the top of the build.
14. Place a pink cap on the ppp.
15. Locate a white 4L bar, 2 medium azure 2x2 round bricks with dome top, and 1 tan bar with stop ring.

Let's make a part.

Place one azure round brick with the flat side facing up. Place the tan bar with stop ring upright into the anti-stud in the center of the round brick. Place the second brick with the flat side facing down on top of the other. Place the entire sub build on the upright white 4L bar.

Take this balloon part and place it in the left hand of the mascot.

16. Locate 1 tan bar with stop ring, 1 tan 1x1 round plate with open stud, 1 magenta half cylinder brick, 1 transparent pink 1x1 brick.

Let's make a part.

Place the 1x1 brick on top of the plate. Place the half cylinder brick on top of the 1x1 brick. Place the entire sub build on the upright tan bar.

Take this ice pop part and place it in the right hand of the mascot.

Building Instructions (Bag 2)

Group 5 contains the pieces for the Liann minidoll.

17. Locate a minidoll torso with green tank top, minidoll hips with short skirt, light tan minidoll head, and minidoll hair with helmet. Put the torso, on the hips with skirt, head on the torso, and hair with helmet on the head.

Group 6 - Balloon and ice cream stand.

18. Place a yellow 2x4 plate horizontally in front of you. Place a yellow 2x2x1 inverted curved brick with 2 recessed studs with the 1x2 plate on the back row of the 2 rightmost columns, with the curve overhanging the back.

19. Place a yellow 2x2x1 inverted curved brick with 2 recessed studs with the 1x2 plate on the front row of the 2 rightmost columns, with the curve hanging off the front.

20. Vertically place a black 1x4 plate with wheels holder on the 2nd column from the left so that it is centered vertically.

21. Locate 2 yellow 2x2x1 inverted curved bricks with 2 recessed studs. Place one with the 1x2 plate on the back row of the 1st column from the left, overhanging to the left with the curve hanging off the back. Place the other on the front row of the 1st column from the left, overhanging to the left with the curve hanging off the front.

22. Place a yellow 2x4 tile horizontally on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front on the 4 rightmost columns.

23. Place a grey 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the 2nd and 3rd rows on the 1st column from the left, with the clips facing left.

24. Locate 2 yellow 1x1 plates. Place one on the front row in the 3rd column from the left. Place the other on the back row in the 3rd column from the left.

25. Locate 2 medium azure 1x4 plates. Place one horizontally on the front row on the 4 rightmost columns. Place the second symmetrically on the back row.

Group 7 - Balloon and ice cream stand

26. Locate 2 medium azure 1x1 plates. Place one on the front row on the 1st column from the left. Place another on the back row on the 1st column from the left.

Group 6 - Balloon and ice cream stand

27. Place a medium azure 1x2 bracket with 2x2 inverted plate on the 2nd and 3rd row on the 1st column from the left with the 2x2 plate facing right.

28. Place a grey 1x2 brick with clip vertically on the 2nd and 3rd row on the 1st column from the left with the clip facing left.

29. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 brick on the back row on the 4 leftmost columns.

30. Locate a grey 1x4 brick with side studs. Horizontally place the brick with the studs facing front on the front row on the 4 leftmost columns.

31. Locate 2 pink 1x1 bricks. Place one on the back row on the 1st column from the right. Place the second symmetrically on the front row.

32. Locate 1 medium azure 1x2 plate and 2 grey 1x1 plates with clip. Horizontally place the 1x2 plate on the back row on the 2 rightmost columns. Place the 1x1 plates with the clips facing the back on the back row in the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left.

33. Locate 2 medium azure 1x4 plates. Horizontally place one on the front row on the 4 rightmost columns. Vertically place the front stud of the other on the 1st column from the left.

34. Locate 3 tan bars with stop ring. Insert them into the holes in front of the 1x4 brick with side studs in the 3 leftmost columns.

35. Locate 1 transparent yellow round 1x1 tile, 1 medium azure 2x2 tile with stud, 1 medium azure 2x2 brick, 1 white 2x2x2 box.

Let's make a part.

Place the box with the opening facing left. Place the brick on top of the ppp. Place the 2x2 tile on top of the ppp. Place the 1x1 tile on top of the ppp.

36. Rotate the build 90 degrees clockwise. Rotate the part from the previous step so that the box opening faces up and the 1x1 tile faces front. Place the previously built part into the main build on the 2x2 plate on the inside.

37. Place a white 1x4x3 window frame on the back row facing the back.

38. Place a white 1x4x3 window frame on the front row facing the front.

39. Vertically place a medium azure 2x6 plate centered horizontally over the window frames. The plate will overhang 1 row to the back.

Group 8 - Balloon and ice cream stand

40. Horizontally place a medium azure curved 1x4 slope brick on the front row of the build.

Group 9 - Balloon and ice cream stand

41. Horizontally place a pink curved 1x4 slope brick behind the ppp.

Group 8 - Balloon and ice cream stand

42. Horizontally place a medium azure curved 1x4 slope brick behind the ppp.

Group 9 - Balloon and ice cream stand

43. Horizontally place a pink curved 1x4 slope brick behind the ppp.

Group 8 - Balloon and ice cream stand

44. Horizontally place a medium azure curved 1x4 slope brick behind the ppp.

Group 9 - Balloon and ice cream stand

45. Horizontally place a pink curved 1x4 slope brick behind the ppp.

Group 10 contains the pieces for the Magenta balloon

46. Locate a white 4L bar, 1 white bar holder with clip, 1 tan bar with stop ring, and 2 magenta 2x2 round bricks with dome top.

Let's make a part.

Place one magenta round brick with the flat side facing up. Place the tan bar with stop ring upright into the anti-stud in the center of the round brick. Place the second brick with the flat side facing down on top of the other. Place the entire sub build on the upright white 4L bar. Place the white bar into the bar holder with the clip pointing down.

Rotate the build so that the tan bars point toward the front. Take this balloon part and clip it to the rightmost tan bar.

Group 11 contains the pieces for the Pink balloon

47. Repeat the previous step except with pink round bricks instead of magenta.

Take this balloon part and clip it to the middle tan bar in the front of the build.

Group 12 contains the pieces for the Green balloon

48. Repeat the previous step except with transparent green round bricks instead of pink.

Take this balloon part and clip it to the leftmost tan bar in the front of the build.

Group 13 contains the pieces for the cycle parts of the stand

49. Locate 2 wheelchair wheels. Attach one to each wheel holder at the bottom of the build.

50. Locate 1 grey handlebars, 1 bicycle wheel, and 1 medium azure tricycle frame.

Let's make a part.

Attach the handlebars to the clip at the top of the frame. Attach the wheel to the back of the frame. Attach the frame to the 3 clips on the left of the main build.

Group 14 contains the pieces for the Yellow ice pop

51. Locate 1 tan bar with stop ring, 1 tan 1x1 round plate with open stud, 1 yellow half cylinder brick, 1 transparent yellow 1x1 brick.

Let's make a part.

Place the 1x1 brick on top of the plate. Place the half cylinder brick on top of the 1x1 brick. Place the entire sub build on the upright tan bar.

Rotate the build so that the bicycle is toward the front. Take this ice pop part and place it in the left clip on the left side of the build.

Group 15 contains the pieces for the Blue ice pop

52. Repeat the previous step except with light blue bricks instead of yellow.

Take this ice pop and place it in the right clip on the left side of the build.

53. Place the Liann minidoll on the bicycle
