

43303 Mini Jasmine & Rapunzel

Set adapted by Isabelle and Julia Black and tested by Matthew Shifrin.

Treat kids ages 5 years old and up this LEGO® Disney Princess Mini Jasmine & Rapunzel (43303) toy building playset. The Jasmine and Rapunzel movie characters are designed to spark storytelling and pretend play with the included magic lamp and frying pan accessories. Each character has movable arms and can hold an accessory. They are also perfect for a cute display and are part of a larger collectible series that includes other brick-built Disney Princess character toys.

Fulfill a child's love for Disney Princess characters with a playset building toy that makes a cute birthday or anytime gift-giving idea for girls and boys and works with other LEGO Disney building sets (sold separately). Kids also get an easy, intuitive building adventure on the LEGO builder app for zooming and rotating with 3D instructions, saving and tracking progress. Contains 59 pieces.

Building toy and display - Treat kids ages 5 and up to this buildable Disney Princess playset with 2 brick-built characters, designed for story-driven pretend play or as a fun display.

Jasmine and Rapunzel Disney characters - This Mini Jasmine & Rapunzel (43303) princess toy building set has 2 LEGO Disney Princess fantasy movie characters as part of a collectible series.

Play or display accessories –The model building kit includes a magic lamp for Jasmine and a frying pan for Rapunzel for imaginative storytelling or a clever display.

Make-believe building toy features – This Disney Princess toy building set features 2 brick-built characters from beloved Disney movies with movable arms that can hold their accessories.

Gift-giving idea for Disney fans – This Lego Disney building set for kids is a fun Disney princess gift-giving idea for birthdays or any time for girls and boys ages 5 plus who love the characters.

Discover more creative kits – Add this imagination toy building set to the extensive assortment of LEGO toys and LEGO Disney building sets (all sold separately) in the range.

Digital building instructions – The LEGO builder app guides your child on a building adventure that lets them zoom in and rotate sets using 3D instructions, as well as save and track their progress.

Dimensions – This 59 piece LEGO Disney princess toy building set has brick-built Jasmine and Rapunzel characters that each measure over 2 inches (5cm high), 1.5 inches (4 cm wide) and 1 inch (3cm deep).

59 pieces, Jasmine: 22 steps, Rapunzel: 18 steps

On the front of the box on the left Jasmine who is dark skinned, has brown eyes, and black long hair which is gathered by a ponytail in the back stands next to Rapunzel who stands to her left. Jasmine is wearing turquoise fitted pants with matching shoes as well as a sleeveless, cropped turquoise top with her dark-skinned belly slightly exposed. She also wears a turquoise headband to complete her outfit. Her big brown eyes with beautiful dark eyelashes are wide open and she exhibits a serene, closed mouth smile. In her left hand she holds a golden magic lamp. Sparkles emanate from her magic lamp.

Rapunzel has bright green wide-open eyes, freckles on her light-colored skin, and her big smile reveals her beautiful white teeth. She has blonde long hair which is gathered by a braid in the back. Her forehead

is framed by bangs which she wears parted on her right and combed to her left. She wears a ballgown with a lilac bodice and has a fitted waistline as well as a full, floor length skirt in a darker shade of purple. The white horizontal stripe which is the platform on which her skirt is built is an underskirt (which helps her dress to keep its full and puffy shape). She holds a black frying pan in her right hand which she points upward tilted at an angle toward you to show the interior of the frying pan. Both stand on a light wooden floor and in the background is pink wallpaper with a repeating white crown pattern (the white outline of a crown shape).

On the front flap of the box Jasmine stands in front of Rapunzel who is located on Jasmine's right but is slightly to the right and behind her. The full figure of Rapunzel is slightly tilted to her left. Only the upper half of Jasmine's figure is visible. The two Disney princesses are looking and smiling at you in the same way as on the front of the box. Jasmine is not holding her magic lamp in her hands.

On the back of the box both Disney princesses are featured again on a pink background. This time Rapunzel is standing on the left and she no longer grips onto the black frying pan with her right hand but it seems that it slid out of her hand to the ground. To her left stands Jasmine who also placed her golden magic lamp on the ground and steam is emerging out of its spout.

Behind above them is a little framed mirror with rounded corners on the back wall. The backsides of both Disney princesses are reflected in this mirror. One can see Rapunzel's long, blond braid as well as Jasmine's shiny black hair which is gathered by a long ponytail which reaches halfway down her back and is tied together by a thick, turquoise hair elastic which matches her outfit.

On one of the sides of the box Jasmine's golden magic lamp is depicted in its actual size. It says 1:1 on the bottom left corner under her magic lamp.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.

- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- “Anti-stud” is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner who may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each set, PDF versions are always online at [\[https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/43303\]](https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/43303). As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

Bag 1 (3 groups of bricks)

First Figure Parts: Rapunzel – white underskirt platform, purple puffy skirt, lilac torso, white arms, head, blonde hair with braid piece for back of head, oval white face with green eyes and big smile, black frying pan. One Assembly – Steps 1-6 (body with torso), 7-16 (head and hair), 17 (braid), 18.

Bag 2 (3 groups of bricks)

Second Figure Parts: Jasmine – turquoise 2x2 round plate with 2 feet , exposed strip of brown belly, turquoise torso, brown arms, head, black hair with ponytail for back of head, turquoise headband on top of head, oval brown face with brown eyes and smile, golden magic lamp. One Assembly – Steps 1-4 (body with torso), 5-16 (head and hair), 17-21 (ponytail), 22.

Now let’s build some princesses!

The build:

Rapunzel

1. Put a white rounded 4x4 square plate in front of you.

2. Put a 1x4 purple curved smooth brick with no studs vertically on the left column, curve to the left. This brick is curved on its sides.
3. Put a purple 2x2 brick to the right of the middle 2 rows of the ppp. It will be in the middle of the 4x4 rounded square.
4. Put a 1x2 purple curved smooth brick with no studs horizontally behind the 2x2 brick on the back row curved to the back. This brick is flat on its sides. Repeat symmetrically at the front.
5. Put another 1x4 purple curved smooth brick with no studs vertically on the right column, curve to the right. This brick is curved on its sides.
6. Take the 2x2 lilac round brick with pinholes on sides and stick the pins of the light skin colored arms into the pinholes.
7. Take the 2x4 double inverted light skin colored curved brick and put it horizontally with its 2x2 middle studs onto the previous piece.
8. Put a 2x1 tall tan brick with 4 side studs horizontally on the middle studs of the front row of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the back.
9. Put a yellow 2x1 tall brick with 2x2 side studs and 1x2 vertical studs on the sides vertically on the leftmost column of the build, 2x2 side studs to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.
10. Put a yellow 2x2 tile in the middle on top of your build. There will be a free column to its left and its right.
11. Place a yellow 1x4 double sloped curved tile horizontally on the front row of the build. It will only attach on the right and left studs. Repeat with another such piece to the back.
12. Take a 4x2 oval tile printed with Rapunzel's light skin colored face holding it horizontally upright. Place its top row on the bottom row of front facing side studs. Place a yellow 1x4 plate horizontally upright above the ppp.
- 13-1. Put a 2x1 yellow tile with cut corner vertically upright on the leftmost stud of the ppp, cut corner on the bottom right.
- 13-2. Put a yellow 2x1 tile with cut corner horizontally upright on the second stud from the right of the horizontally upright 1x4 plate so the cut corner is at the bottom left. Put another 1x2 tile with cut corner to the left of the ppp in the same way, cut corner to the bottom left.
- 13-3. Put a yellow 1x2 tile with cut corner vertically upright to the right of the ppp so its cut corner is at the bottom left. (This piece should mirror the one on the leftmost stud.)
14. Put a yellow 2x2 quarter circle plate on the 2x2 side studs at the left of the build so the straight edges are at the top and at the back. The curve of the plate will be at the front and there will be half of a free stud in the front at the middle of the curve.
15. Repeat symmetrically at the right with another 2x2 quarter circle plate.

16. Shows the figure with the finished front and sides.

17. Now build the yellow braid piece which will be attached to the back of Rapunzel's head.

17-1. Put a yellow 2x4 plate horizontally in front of you.

17-2. Put a yellow 2x2 curved triangular slope tile horizontally on the rightmost 2 studs of the front row, triangle to the front.

17-3. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

17-4. Put a yellow 1x1 half oval tile on the back stud of the second column from the left rounded side to the front. Put another rounded 1x1 half oval tile to the left oriented the same way. Repeat symmetrically to the front with the remaining pieces.

Take your part and hold it vertically upright with the curved tiles at the bottom. Turn your build 180 degrees so the studs are facing you. Attach the part you just built onto the middle studs which are facing you.

18. Clip the black frying pan into one of Rapunzel's hands.

Jasmine

1. Take a turquoise round 2x2 plate with 2 feet underneath and place it on the table in front of you, feet to the front and back.

2. Take a turquoise round 2x2 plate and put it on top of the ppp.

3. Stack another round brown 2x2 plate on top of the ppp.

4. Take the turquoise 2x2 round brick with pinholes and put it on top, pinholes to the left and the right. Take 2 brown hands with pin and put them into the holes.

5. Take a brown inverted curved 2x4 brick and place it horizontally on top of the build with the curve at the left and the right.

6. Take two 2x1 tall tan bricks with 2x2 side studs and put them on the front and back rows of the build in the middle so that one's side studs are to the front and the others are to the back.

7. Put one black 1x2 tall brick with 2x2 side studs and 1x2 side studs on short ends and place it vertically on the leftmost column of the build, 2x2 studs to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

8. Put a black 2x2 tile on top of the build in the middle.

9. Put a turquoise 1x4 double sloped curved tile horizontally on top of the build on the front row. It will only connect by two studs. Repeat to the back with a black 1x4 double sloped curved tile.

10. Hold a black 1x4 curved oval brick with no studs horizontally upright, curve to the bottom and place it on the top row of front facing side studs.

11. Take the 4x2 oval with the dark skin colored face and place it horizontally upright on the bottom row of the build.
12. Take a black 1x2 semi circular tile and place it horizontally upright on the bottom row of the left side studs, curve to the bottom.
13. Place a 1x2 black smooth half cylinder brick horizontally upright above the ppp.
14. Take another black 1x2 semi circular tile and place it horizontally upright on the bottom row of the right side studs, curve to the bottom.
15. Place another 1x2 black smooth half cylinder brick horizontally upright above the ppp.
16. Shows the finished figure with the finished front and sides.
17. Now build the black ponytail with the turquoise hair band which will be attached to the back of Jasmine's head. Take a 2x4 black plate and place it horizontally on the table in front of you.
18. Take a black 1x4 double sloped curved tile and place it vertically on the rightmost column of the ppp.
19. Put a black 1x2 curved tile with cut corner on the front stud of the third column from the left. Repeat symmetrically to the back with another 1x2 black curved tile with cut corner so its cut corner is at the back left.
20. Put a turquoise 1x2 tile vertically to the left of the two ppp's. Put a black 2x2 triangular sloped curved tile vertically to the left of the ppp, triangle to the left.
21. Rotate your figure 180 degrees. Rotate the sub-build vertically upright so the 1x4 curved tile is on the top and attach it to the top row of studs on the build.
22. Clip the golden magic lamp in one of Jasmine's hands.

If you build 43284, 43303, and 43291 you can place the 6 figures inside the 6 arches. (3 figures under each of the three arches on the main floor and the other 3 figures under each of the three arches on the first floor of Mini Belle’s & Tiana’s Castle.)
