

71840 Rogue vs. Drix Race Car Duel

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Treat your little ninja with this action-packed LEGO® NINJAGO® playset. This hero toy battle set lets imaginative children aged 4 and up learn how to build as they play out exciting car chase stories from season 3 of the NINJAGO Dragons Rising TV show. This LEGO set comes with 2 ninja car toys – a ninja car with moving wheels and 2 shooters with 4 darts, and the villains' toy car – so kids can place a minifigure character behind the wheel of each one and get racing! There are also 3 NINJAGO minifigures: ninja warriors Rogue and Nya armed with golden katana sword accessories and the evil Drix with a translucent reveal blade accessory.

The packaging captures the excitement of the car duel! The front of the box shows Drix escaping on his black and red car to the left, while being chased by Nya while swinging her katana and by Rogue on his own blue car on the right. The vehicles are racing on a rocky, dusty brown terrain. On the background, we can see a mountain range in tones of blue and purple. The top left corner is decorated with the iconic red LEGO logo. The build consists of 111 pieces in total, 3 minifigures, and is recommended for ages 4+. Once finished, you will have 2 awesome vehicles. The set consists of 2 bags and 2 instruction booklets.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind! Before you start building, here are some terms we may be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.

- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- “Anti-stud” is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Left/right wedge parts: these are parts that when placed in front of you and are pointing to the back, their wedge is on the left/right side of the part.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

Additionally, it is worth mentioning that besides the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, a PDF version for the set’s instructions is always available online at [<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/71840>]. This might help a sighted building partner that may want to follow along or low vision users that may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2, and 3 and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 bags labeled 1 through 2 and 2 instruction booklets (one for each bag). Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder!

LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Book 1, Bag 1 – Drix, Nya, and Drix’s car

Alright, we are done with sorting. Let's get building!

Building Instructions

Book 1, bag 1:

Group 1 – Drix

Pages 6-7. Let's start putting together the villain of the set: Drix.

Locate 1 black pair of legs with robe ends, 1 black torso printed with robe open and red spikes, black arms, and dark red hands, and 1 dark red minifigure alien insect head with gold eyes. Assemble your minifigure. If you wish, ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is facing the right way. Then, put on the black conical Asian hat on it. Lastly, arm Drix by placing the trans-red sword with pearl gold dragon head hilt in his left hand. Drix is ready!

Group 2 – Nya

Pages 8-9. Let's continue by putting together Nya.

Locate 1 pearl dark gray pair of legs with knee pads and sandals pattern, 1 pearl dark gray torso printed with tunic and black shirt, pearl dark gray arms, and black hands, and 1 yellow minifigure head with beauty mark and single eyelashes. Assemble your minifigure. If you wish, ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is facing the right way. You can choose between the face print with a smile or with a smirk. Then, put on the black female hair with ponytail and dark azure bandana. Lastly, arm Nya by placing the pearl gold katana in her right hand. Nya is ready!

Group 3 – Drix's car

Pages 10-11. Locate 1 black 6x10 vehicle base. Place it horizontally in front of you. Locate 1 light bluish gray 2x2 plate with 1x2 upright side studs. Place it on the 2 leftmost columns, so that its side studs are facing to the left and it is centered vertically.

Pages 12-13. Locate 1 bright green 1x2 plate. Place it centered vertically on the 4th column from the left.

Pages 14-15. Locate 1 red 2x4 brick. Place it centered vertically on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left.

Pages 16-17. Locate 1 light bluish gray tile with steering wheel. Place it centered vertically on the 5th column from the left, so that the wheel faces to the right. Locate 1 red 2x2 tile with studs on edge. Rotate it so that its studs are on the left column and place it to the right of the ppp.

Group 4 – Drix's car

Pages 18-19. Locate 4 light aqua 1x2 plates with 3 teeth. Take the first 2 and place them horizontally, side by side, on the 4 columns of the front row, so that the teeth are facing to the front. Take the remaining 2 and place them symmetrically to the back.

Page 20-21. Locate 2 black 1x4 tiles. Take the first one and place it centered horizontally on top of the ppps. Take the second one and place it symmetrically to the front.

Page 22-23. Locate 2 red 1x4 bricks. Take the first one and place it horizontally on the 3rd to the 6th columns from the right of the 2nd row from the front, to the right of the 2x4 brick. Take the second one and place it symmetrically to the back.

Page 24-25. Locate 1 red 1x2 brick. Place it centered vertically on the 3rd column from the right, so that it is between the 2 ppps.

Pages 26-27. Locate 1 bright green 1x2 plate. Place it centered vertically to the right of the ppp.

Pages 28-29. Locate 1 black 1x2 plate with angled handles on long side. Place it centered vertically to the right of the ppp, so that the handles are facing to the right.

Pages 30-31. Locate 1 red 2x2 tile with studs on edge. Place it centered vertically on the 2 rightmost columns, so that its studs are on the left.

Group 5 – Drix's car

Pages 32-33. Locate 2 black ribbed short bricks with axle hole. Place them centered vertically on the 2 rightmost columns.

Pages 34-35. Locate 3 red curved claws with clip. Attach them to the handles on the right side, so that they curve upwards.

Pages 36-37. Locate 1 black 2x2 curved slope with lip. Place it centered vertically on the 2 rightmost columns, so that it slopes to the right.

Pages 38-39. Locate 1 red 1x2 tile with bar handle. Place it vertically to the left of the ppp, so that its flat edge faces to the right.

Group 6 – Drix's car

Pages 40-41. Locate 2 black 1x6 slopes. Take the first one and rotate it horizontally, so that it slopes to the left. Place its rightmost column on top of the rightmost column of the 2nd row from the front. Take the second one and place it symmetrically to the back.

Pages 42-43. Locate 2 flat silver 1x4 plates with angled tubes. Take the first one and place it vertically on the 4th column from the left. Take the second one and place it to the left of the ppp.

Pages 44-45. Locate 1 black 3x4 curved wedge with cutout. Place it to the left of the ppp, so that it slopes to the left.

Pages 46-47. Locate 1 red 2x2 curved slope tile. Place it centered vertically on the 2 leftmost columns, so that it slopes to the left.

Pages 48-49. Locate 1 light aqua 1x2 plate with 3 teeth. Rotate it horizontally upright, so that its antistuds are facing to the right and its teeth are pointing downwards. Place it on top of the side studs on the left face of Drix's car.

Pages 50-51. Locate 4 flat silver wheels and 4 black tires. Place each of the wheels inside the tires.

Pages 52-53. Attach each of the tires to the bars on the front and back of Drix's car.

We are done with Drix's car! You can sit Drix in it and make him cause havoc around, while Nya is chasing him on foot.

Book 2, bag 2:

Group 7 – Rogue (Jay)

Let's put together Rogue (Jay).

Pages 4-5. Locate 1 dark blue pair of legs with knee wrappings, 1 dark blue torso printed with tunic and gold charms, left dark blue arm, right sand blue arm, and black hands, and 1 yellow minifigure head with nougat freckles and angry scowl. Assemble your minifigure. If you wish, ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is facing the right way. Then, put on the dark blue head wrap with gold wraps and knot. Lastly, arm Rogue Jay by placing the pearl gold katana in his right hand. Rogue Jay is ready!

Group 8 – Rogue's (Jay's) car

Pages 6-7. Locate 1 black 4x14 vehicle base. Place it horizontally in front of you.

Pages 8-9. Locate 1 bright green 1x2 plate. Place it centered vertically on the leftmost column.

Pages 10-11. Locate 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with 1x2 side studs hanging down. Place it vertically on top of the ppp, so that its side studs face to the left.

Pages 12-13. Locate 6 light bluish gray 1x2 plates with 1x2 side studs hanging down. Take the first 3 and place them horizontally on the front row, side by side, starting on the 5th column from the left, so that their side studs are facing to the front. Take the remaining 3 and place them symmetrically to the back.

Pages 14-15. Locate 2 bright light yellow 2x4 plates. Take the first one and place it vertically on the 2 leftmost columns, so that it is centered vertically. Take the second one and place it to the right of the ppp.

Pages 16-17. Locate 1 bright light yellow 4x6 wedge plate with cut corners. Place it centered vertically to the right of the ppp, so that its cut corners are pointing to the right, to the front and back.

Pages 18-19. Locate 3 bright light yellow 2x4 plates. Take the first one and place it vertically to the right of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically. Take the remaining ones and place them vertically to the right of the ppp, one next to the other.

Group 9 – Rogue's (Jay's) car

Pages 20-21. Locate 1 blue 1x6 curved slope with 2 studs. Rotate it horizontally upright and attach it to the front-facing side studs, so that it slopes to the right.

Pages 22-23. Rotate the car 180 degrees on the horizontal plane, so that the ppp is to the back. Locate 1 blue 1x6 curved slope with 2 studs. Rotate it horizontally upright and attach it to the front-facing side studs, so that it slopes to the left.

Pages 24-25. Locate 1 blue 2x4 brick. Place it horizontally on the 4 rightmost columns, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 26-27. Locate 1 bright light yellow 2x2 plate. Place it on top of the 2 leftmost columns of the ppp. Locate 1 bright green 1x2 plate. Place it vertically to the right of the ppp.

Pages 28-29. Locate 1 blue 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs hanging down. Place it centered vertically on the leftmost column, so that its side studs face to the left.

Pages 30-31. Locate 2 blue 2x2 ribbed short bricks with axle hole. Place them to the right of the ppp, side by side. Locate 1 blue 2x2 brick. Place it to the right of the ppp.

Pages 32-33. Locate 1 light bluish gray tile with steering wheel. Place it to the right of the ppp, so that the wheel is facing to the right.

Pages 34-35. Locate 2 blue 1x8 bricks. Take the first one and place it horizontally on the 2nd row from the front, so that its 2nd column from the left is to the front of the steering wheel. Take the second one and place it symmetrically to the back.

Group 10 – Rogue's (Jay's) car

Pages 36-37. Locate 2 blue 1x6 curved slopes with 2 studs. Place them horizontally to the left of each of the ppps, so that they slope to the left.

Pages 38-39. Locate 2 blue 3x3 inverted corner arches. Take the first one and rotate it so that its solid stud is to the left and to the back. Place this stud on top of the 2nd column from the right on the 3rd row from the front, so that it overhangs to the front by 1 row and to the right by 1 column. Take the second one and place it symmetrically to the back.

Pages 40-41. Locate 1 pearl gold 1x2 curved slope with wing end. Place it on top of the column of solid studs created by the ppps, so that its wing faces to the right.

Pages 42-43. Locate 1 light bluish gray 2x2 plate with vents (which are on opposite sides of the 2x2 plate, are taller than it, and have small rectangles as texture to mimic the vents). Place it vertically to the left of the ppp, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 44-45. Locate 1 light bluish gray 1x2 tile with bar handle. Place it vertically on top of the right column of the ppp, so that its flat edge faces to the right.

Group 11 – Rogue's (Jay's) car

Pages 46-47. Locate 1 bright light yellow 2x4 plate. Place it vertically to the left of the steering wheel, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 48-49. Locate 4 dark blue 1x2 plates with pin holes. Take the first 2 and place them vertically on top of the 2 front rows of the ppp, side by side, so that their pin holes overhang to the front. Take the remaining 2 and place them symmetrically to the back.

Pages 50-51. Locate 1 blue 2x5 bracket. Rotate it horizontally, so that its 2x3 plate is to the right. Place its 2 rightmost columns on top of the ppps, so that it is centered vertically.

Pages 52-53. Locate 3 dark blue 2x2 curved slope tiles. Take the first one and place it on top of the 2 rightmost columns of the front row of the ppp, so that it slopes to the front. Take the second one and place it symmetrically to the back. Take the last one and place it on top of the 2 leftmost columns of the car, so that it slopes to the left.

Group 12 – Rogue's (Jay's) car

Pages 54-55. Locate 1 bright green 1x2 plate. Place it centered vertically on top of the 2nd stud column from the left.

Pages 56-57. Locate 1 blue 3x4 triple curved wedge with a golden dragon head and armor with lightning bolts printed pattern. Place it horizontally on top of the ppp, so that it slopes to the left. Locate 1 dark blue 1x2 slope tile. Place it vertically to the right of the ppp, so that it slopes to the left.

Pages 58-59. Locate 2 pearl gold 2x2 curved slopes with 2 studs and curved sides. Take the first one and rotate it upright, so that its antistuds face to the right and it slopes to the front. Place it on top of the 2 columns to the front on the left-facing side studs. Take the second one and place it symmetrically to the back.

Pages 60-61. Locate 4 yellow projectiles with round end. Take the first 2 and place them on the pin holes on the front and on the back sides of the car, so that their round ends face to the left. You can fire them by pushing them from right to left. Be careful when shooting them! The remaining 2 are the leftover ammunition.

Pages 62-63. Locate 4 pearl gold wheels with black tires and axle. Take the first 2 and attach their axle to the axle holes to the front of the car, to the left and to the right. Take the last 2 and attach them symmetrically to the back.

We are done with Rogue's (Jay's) car! You can sit Rogue in it and help Nya chase Drix. We are also done with the build! Have fun making up the adventures of our 3 characters.

At the end of the instruction booklet, you will find a page advertising LEGO's "Rebuild the World" initiative, with a brick-built pig with very long legs, and a giraffe. Afterwards, you will find the set inventory and on the last page you will find an invitation to share feedback.
