The build is 601 pieces in total and is for ages 10+.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two

studs on top.

- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ell's and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/40925>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 4 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Bag 1 - Alice

Group 1 - Steps 1-10.

Group 2 - Steps 11-12.

Group 3 - Steps 13-14, rest of Step 15, Step 16, and 2 black 2x2 bricks from Step 17.

Group 4 - Rest of Step 17, Steps 18-28, and 1 yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile from Step 29.

Group 5 - Rest of Step 29, Steps 30-31, and 1 black 1x2 sloped curved tile from Step 32.

Group 6 - Rest of Step 32, Steps 33-35, and 4 white 1x2 plates from Step 36.

Group 7 - Rest of Step 36 and Steps 37-38.

Bag 2 - The White Rabbit

Group 8 - Steps 1-7 and 2 red 1x2 plates from Step 8.

Group 9 - Rest of Step 8 and 1 light yellow 1x2 tile from Step 9.

Group 10 - Rest of Step 9 and Steps 10-13.

Group 11 - 1 white 2x2 plate from Step 14.

Group 12 - Rest of Step 14, Step 15, and 2 black 2x2 bricks from Step 16.

Group 13 - Rest of Step 16, Steps 17-23, and 1 white 4x4 plate, 1 white 2x2 tile with a stud, and red 1x1 round tile from Step 24.

Group 14 - 2 white 1x2 plates and 2 transparent 1x1 round tiles from Step 24.

Group 15 - Rest of Step 24 and Steps 25-30.

Group 16 - Steps 31-39.

Bag 3 - The Mad Hatter

Group 17 - Steps 1-9 and 1 teal 1x2 tile from Step 10.
Group 18 - Rest of Step 10 and 1 white 2x2 plate from Step 11.
Group 19 - Rest of Step 11.
Group 20 - Steps 12-13, and 2 black 2x2 bricks from Step 14.
Group 21 - Rest of Step 14, Steps 15-18 and 2 tan 1x2 slope tile from Steps 19-20.
Group 22 - Rest of Steps 19-20 and Steps 21-22.

Bag 4 - The Mad Hatter

Group 23 - Steps 23-25.
Group 24 - Steps 26-39.
Group 25 - Steps 40-42 and 4 green 1x2 plates from Step 43.
Group 26 - Rest of Step 43 and Step 44.

Bag 5 - Cheshire Cat

Group 27 - Steps 1-5.
Group 28 - Step 6 and 1 magenta 1x4 plate and 1 magenta 1x4 tile from Step 7.
Group 29 - Rest of Step 7 and Step 8.
Group 30 - 1 magenta 1x4 plate and 1 magenta 1x4 tile from Steps 9-10.
Group 31 - Rest of Steps 9-10, Steps 11-13, and 2 black 2x2 bricks from Step 14.
Group 32 - Rest of Step 14, Steps 15-22, and 4 pink 1x2 plates from Step 23.
Group 33 - Rest of Step 23, Steps 24-25, and 1 magenta 1x2 sloped curved brick from Step 26.
Group 34 - Rest of Step 26, Steps 27-28, and 1 pink 1x2 sloped curved brick from Step 29.
Group 35 - Rest of Step 29, Steps 30-32 and 2 pink 1x1 quarter circle tiles from Step 33.
Group 36 - Rest of Step 33 and Step 34.
Group 37 - Steps 35-37 and 2 magenta 1x2 plates from Step 38.
Group 38 - Rest of Step 38 and Steps 39-41.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Alice

1. Horizontally stack 2 blue 2x4 plates in front of you.
2. Horizontally place 2 blue 1x2 plates with 2 side studs hanging down on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
3. Horizontally place 2 blue 1x2 plates with 2x2 upright side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so the side studs face the back. Then place a blue 1x1 plate with 2 upright side studs on the front left corner so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
4. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
5. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then vertically place a black 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top of the ppp so the side studs face the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

6.1. Let's make a part! Place a white 2x2 tile with 2 studs in front of you so the studs are in the back. Now place 2 light grey 1x1 round tiles with an upright bar, 1 to the right of the other, on top. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs upside down on the top-facing bars.

6.2. Horizontally place the back row of your part upside down on the front row so it is centered horizontally, overhangs 1 row to the front and the 2x2 anti-studs face up.

7. Place a blue 1x1 plate upright on the top left front-facing side stud. Then place a blue 2x2 left wedge plate upright below the ppp so 1 column overhangs to the left and the cutoff corner faces the top left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Now place a blue 2x2 plate upright on the front-facing side studs, in between the 2 2x2 plates with a cutoff corner.

8. Place a blue 2x2 plate upright on the bottom 2 rows of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

9. Place a blue 1x1 plate upright on the top left front-facing side stud. Then vertically place a blue 1x2 tile upright below the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

10. Place a white 1x1 quarter circle tile upright on the top left front-facing side stud so the curve faces the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 2x4 trapezoid plate upright on the bottom 2 rows of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and the short side faces up.

Group 2 - Alice

11.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then place a blue 1x1 quarter circle tile on the leftmost column so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

11.2. Horizontally place the front-facing side studs of your part upright on the front row of anti-studs so it is centered horizontally and the tiles face the front.

12. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then horizontally place a blue 1x4 plate upright on the top row of front-facing side studs. Now place a blue 2x2 plate upright below the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then place a blue 2x2 left wedge plate upright to the left of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the top left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right using a 2x2 right wedge plate.

You will have 2 extra blue 2x2 plates. Save them for later!

Group 3 - Alice

13. Horizontally place a blue 1x4 tile upright on the top row of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the bottom. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 plate upright in between the 2 ppp. Then place a white 1x1 quarter circle tile on the 2nd column of front-facing side studs from the left so the curve faces the bottom right. Then place another 1 upright to the right of the ppp so the curve faces the top right.

14. Place a white 2x2 plate on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally and sits on 2 studs and the upright parts. Then vertically place the front 2 rows of a white 1x4 plate to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

15.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a blue 2x2 plate from group 2 in front of you. Then vertically place a blue 1x2 short half cylinder brick on the right column. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side to the left of the ppp so the clip faces the left.

15.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place the top row of 1 part upright on the 2 left-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the bottom and the clip faces down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

16. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2x1 2/3 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so the side studs face the back.

17.1. Stack 2 black 2x2 bricks in front of the 2 ppp so they are centered horizontally.

Group 4 - Alice

17.2. Place a pink 2x2 round plate on top of the 2 ppp. Then place a light pink 2x2 brick on top of the ppp.

18. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2x1 2/3 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then vertically place 1 on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

19. Vertically place 2 light grey 1x2x1 2/3 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 1 on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

20. Vertically place a yellow 2x3 plate upright on the top 3 rows of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a yellow 2x3 left wedge plate upright to the left of the ppp so the short end faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right using a 2x3 right wedge plate. Now horizontally place a yellow 2x6 plate with a round side upright below the 3 ppp so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces down.

21. Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 tile upright on the top row of front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a yellow 2x4 tile upright below the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Now place a yellow 1x2 curved corner tile upright below the 2 leftmost columns of the ppp so the curve faces the bottom left. Then place a yellow 1x1 quarter circle tile upright, above the right column of the ppp so the curve faces the bottom left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

22.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally stack 2 yellow 1x2 plates in front of you. Then place a yellow 1x1 plate on the left column. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x1 plate with a short 1x1 sloped curved brick on top so it slopes to the right.

22.2. Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x3 slope brick underneath the leftmost column so it slopes to the left.

22.3. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 upright on the front column of left-facing side studs so the 1x3 slope brick is on top. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

23. Let's make a part! Let's make the face! Place a tan 4x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile in front of the ppp.

24. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile on the front row. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs behind the ppp.

25. Place a yellow 2x2 triangle tile on the back left corner so the right angle faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a black 1x1 round tile printed with a white eye on the left stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

26. Rotate the main build 180 degrees. Then place your part up-right on the front-facing side studs so it is centered on it and the triangle tiles are on top.

27. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the previous part faces the left. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate upright on the 2nd row of front-facing side studs from the top. Then place a tan 2x2 corner plate upright below the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter d. Now place a tan 2x2 corner tile upright to the left of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter h.

28. Vertically place a tan 1x2 slope tile upright on the right column of the previous 2x2 corner plate so it slopes to the right. Then place a yellow 1x1 quarter circle tile upright to the left of the top row of the ppp so the curve faces the bottom left.

You will have an extra yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile. Save it for later!

Group 5 - Alice

29. Horizontally place the right column of a yellow 1x2 slope tile on the leftmost stud of the top front-facing row of studs so it slopes up. Then place a yellow 1x1 quarter circle tile upright below the left column of the ppp so the curve faces the bottom left. Then place a yellow 1x1 plate upright to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place a yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile from group 3 on the top 2 rows of front-facing side studs, to the right of the ppp so it slopes up. Now vertically place a black 1x2 sloped curved tile upright to the right of the ppp so it slopes up.

30. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate upright on the 2nd row of front-facing side studs from the top. Then place a tan 2x2 corner plate upright below the 2 leftmost columns of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter f. Now place a tan 2x2 corner tile upright to the right of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter j.

31. Vertically place a tan 1x2 slope tile upright on the left column of the previous 2x2 corner plate so it slopes to the left. Then place a yellow 1x1 quarter circle tile upright to the right of the top row of the ppp so the curve faces the bottom right.

You will have an extra black 1x2 sloped curved tile. Save it for later!

Group 6 - Alice

32. Horizontally place the left column of a yellow 1x2 slope tile on the rightmost stud of the top front-facing row of studs so it slopes up. Then place a yellow 1x1 quarter circle tile upright below the right column of the ppp so the curve faces the bottom right. Then place a yellow 1x1 plate upright to the left of the ppp. Now vertically place a yellow 1x2 sloped curved tile on the top 2 rows of front-facing side studs, to the left of the ppp so it slopes up. Now vertically place a black 1x2 sloped curved tile from group 5 upright to the left of the ppp so it slopes up.

33.1. Let's make a part! Place a yellow 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the front row. Now place a black 1x1 slope tile on the front left corner so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

33.2. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the 2 upright 1x1 round tiles face the front. Now place your part on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally and the 1x1 slope tiles are in the front.

34. Horizontally place 2 yellow 1x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so together they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right. Now place a black 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column, in front of the 2 ppp so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

35. Place a yellow 1x1 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column, in front of the ppp so it slopes to the right. Then place another 1 to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left. Now vertically place a yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick on the front left corner so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place another 1 to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

36.1. Flip your build upside down so the upright 1x1 round tiles face the front. Then vertically stack 2 white 1x2 plates on the leftmost column so they are centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 7 - Alice

36.2. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the rightmost column on top of the 2 ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now flip your build back over so it is right side up and the upright 1x1 round tiles face the front.

37. Attach a pink 1x1 heart tile to the leftmost front-facing clip so the tile side faces the left.

38.1. Let's make a part! Let's make the platform! Place a black 6x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs behind the ppp. Now horizontally place a black 2x4 tile behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

38.2. Place your figure on top of the platform so it is centered on it. Now put it away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 8 - White Rabbit

1. Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a red 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
2. Horizontally place a red 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
3. Place a red 1x1 plate with a side stud hanging down on the front left corner so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the back.
4. Place a light blue 2x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 tile on the front row of the ppp. Now horizontally place a red 1x2 plate behind the ppp.
5. Place a yellow 2x2 round plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally.
6. Place a black 2x2 brick on top of the ppp. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2x1 2/3 brick with 2x2 side studs to the left of the ppp so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
7. Horizontally place a red 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs hanging down on the front row of studs so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
- 8.1. Vertically place a red 1x2 plate upright on the bottom left corner of front-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 9 - White Rabbit

- 8.2. Horizontally place a red 1x4 plate upright on the top row of front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate upright below the ppp so it is centered horizontally.
- 9.1. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 tile upright on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Group 10 - White Rabbit

- 9.2. Place a red 1x1 tile upright on the top left front-facing side stud. Then vertically place a red 1x2 tile upright below the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs upright on the top row of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.
- 10.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a red 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a red 1x2 tile on the back row. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the front row so the clip faces the front.
- 10.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 part upright on the 2x2 left-facing side studs so the clip faces down. Then place the other 1 upright on the 2x2 right-facing side studs so the clip faces the front.
11. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then vertically place 2 red 2x3 plates, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the front-facing side studs so together they are centered horizontally.

12. Horizontally place a red 1x4 tile upright on the top row of front-facing side studs. Then vertically place a red 1x2 tile upright, below the leftmost column of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

13. Horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick upright on the bottom row of front-facing side studs so it slopes down. Then place a white 1x1 sloped curved brick upright above the right column of the ppp so it slopes down. Then place another 1 upright to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left.

Group 11 - White Rabbit

14.1. Place a white 2x2 plate on the back row of studs so it is centered horizontally and its back row sits on the upright parts.

Group 12 - White Rabbit

14.2. Place a light yellow 2x2 plate in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x4 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

15. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x1 2/3 brick with 2x2 side studs on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the back.

16.1. Stack 2 black 2x2 bricks in front of the ppp.

Group 13 - White Rabbit

16.2. Place a yellow 2x2 round plate on top of the 2 ppp. Then place a pink 2x2 brick on top of the ppp.

17. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x1 2/3 brick with 2x2 side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now vertically place 2 more, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so the side studs face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

18. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2x1 2/3 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place 1 on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

19. Horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate upright on the bottom row of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place 2 white 2x3 plates, 1 to the right of the other, upright above the ppp.

20. Horizontally place a white 2x4 tile upright on the top 2 rows of front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 tile upright below the ppp. Now horizontally place 2 light yellow 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright below the ppp so they slope down.

21. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the upright tiles face the right. Now horizontally place 2 light yellow 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the 4th row of front-facing side studs from the top so together they are centered horizontally and they slope down. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate upright above the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally.

22. Horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick upright on the ppp so it slopes down. Then place a white 1x1 sloped curved brick upright to the left and right of the ppp so they slope up.

23. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tri-slope tile upright on the 2nd row of front-facing side studs from the top so it is centered horizontally and slopes up. Now place a white 2x2 corner tile upright on the top left corner of front-facing side studs so it looks like the braille letter f. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Rotate your main build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the ppp faces the right.

24.1. Let's make a part! Let's make the face! Place a white 4x4 plate in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Now place a red 1x1 round tile on top of the ppp.

Group 14 - White Rabbit

24.2. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile on the front left corner. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Group 15 - White Rabbit

24.3. Place a pink 1x1 round tile printed with an eye on the 3rd row from the back of the rightmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a white 2x4 tile on the back 2 rows.

24.4. Place your part upright on the top 4 rows of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally on them and the 2x4 tile is on top.

25.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a bowtie! Horizontally place a dark red 1x3 plate in front of you. Then place a dark red 1x1 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

25.2. Vertically place a dark red 1x2 tile with a round side on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the right. Then turn it to the left so it points to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

25.3. Horizontally place your part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.

26. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the previous part faces the right. Now horizontally place 2 light yellow 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the 4th row of front-facing side studs from the top so together they are centered horizontally and they slope down. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate upright above the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally.

27. Horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick upright on the ppp so it slopes down. Then place a white 1x1 sloped curved brick upright to the left and right of the ppp so they slope up.

28. Horizontally place a white 1x2 tri-slope tile upright on the 2nd row of front-facing side studs from the top so it is centered horizontally and slopes up. Now place a white 2x2 corner tile upright on the top left corner of front-facing side studs so it looks like the braille letter f. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

29. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the upright 1x1 round tiles face the front. Then flip it upside down. Now vertically stack 2 light blue 1x2 plates on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then

vertically place a white 1x3 plate on top of the 2 ppp so 1 row overhangs to the front. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

30. Flip your build over so it is right side up and the upright 1x1 round tiles face the front. Now place a white 2x2 plate on the front right corner of studs. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally. Then place a white 2x2 sloped curved tile on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.

Group 16 - White Rabbit

31. Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's make the ears! Horizontally place a white 1x2 inverted sloped curved tile in front of you so it slopes to the left. Then horizontally place a white 1x1 plate with a 1x1 inverted sloped curved brick on the right column so it slopes and overhangs to the right.

32. Place a white 1x1 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

33. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with an upright 1x2 tile on the 2 rightmost columns so the anti-studs of the 1x2 tile face the right.

34. Place a white 1x1 tile on the rightmost column. Then horizontally place a white 1x1 tile with a 1x1 slope tile to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the left.

35. Bring back the main build so the 1x1 round tiles face the front. Vertically place 1 part on the back left corner so the sloped curved side faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

36. Vertically place a white 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then place 2 white 1x1 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the back row of the ppp so they slope to the back. The right 1 should be 1 plate higher than the other.

37. Place 2 white 1x1 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so together they are centered horizontally. Then vertically place a white 1x2 curved sloped right wedge tile on the front row of the 2nd column from the left so it slopes and overhangs to the front, and the angled part faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right using a curved sloped left wedge tile. The right 1 should be 1 plate higher than the other.

38.1. Attach a black umbrella to the leftmost bottom-facing clip so the curved handle faces the front.

38.2. Let's make a part! Let's make a clock! Place a gold 1x1 round plate with a handle underneath in front of you so the stud faces up. Then place a yellow 2x2 round plate on top so it is centered. Now place a white 2x2 round tile printed with a clock on top of the ppp.

38.3. Attach the handle of your part to the rightmost front-facing clip so the 2x2 round tile faces the front.

39.1. Let's make a part! Let's make the platform! Place a black 6x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs behind the ppp. Now horizontally place a black 2x4 tile behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

39.2. Place your figure on top of the platform so it is centered on it. Now put it away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 17 - Mad Hatter

1. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a lime green 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
2. Vertically place 2 green 1x3 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top so together they are centered horizontally and overhang 1 row to the back.
3. Horizontally place 2 lime green 1x2 plates with 2 side studs hanging down, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then place a lime green 1x1 plate with a side stud hanging down on the back left corner so the side stud faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
4. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile on the back row. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs in front of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.
5. Horizontally place 2 lime green 1x2 plates with 2x2 upright side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
6. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on top. Then place a black 2x2 brick on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Now vertically place a black 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the left of the ppp so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
7. Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 plate upright on the top row of front-facing side studs. Then place a lime green 2x2 plate upright below the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Now place a lime green 2x2 left wedge plate to the left of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the top left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right using a right left wedge plate
8. Horizontally place a lime green 2x4 tile upright on the top 2 rows of front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x4 tile upright below the ppp.
9. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 plate upright on the top row of front-facing side studs. Then place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate upright below the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Now place a lime green 2x2 left wedge plate upright to the left of the ppp so the cutoff corner faces the top left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right using a 2x2 right wedge plate
- 10.1. Horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile upright on the 2nd row of front-facing side studs from the top so it is centered horizontally.

Group 18 - Mad Hatter

- 10.2. Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs upright on the top row of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then place a lime green 1x1 tile upright to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place a lime green 1x2 tile upright below the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

11.1. Place a white 2x2 plate on the back row of studs so it is centered horizontally and its back row sits on the upright parts.

Group 19 - Mad Hatter

11.2. Place a tan 2x2 plate in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a white 1x4 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 20 - Mad Hatter

12.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a lime green 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x2 tile on the back row. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side in front of the ppp so the clip faces the front.

12.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place the top row of 1 part upright on the 2 left-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the bottom and the clip faces front. Then place another 1 upright on the 2 right-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the bottom and the clip faces down.

13. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x1 2/3 brick with 2x2 side studs on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the back.

14.1. Stack 2 black 2x2 bricks in front of the ppp.

Group 21 - Mad Hatter

14.2. Place a pink 2x2 round plate on top of the ppp. Then place a light pink 2x2 brick on top of the ppp.

15. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x1 2/3 brick with 2x2 side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now vertically place 2 more, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so the side studs face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

16. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2x1 2/3 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place 1 on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

17.1. Let's make a part! Let's make the face! Place a tan 4x4 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile on the front row. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs behind the ppp. Now horizontally place a tan 2x4 tile on the back 2 rows. Now place a black 1x1 round tile printed with an eye on the left stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

17.2. Place your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered on them and the 2x4 tile is on top.

18.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a bowtie! Horizontally place a light blue 1x3 plate in front of you. Then place a light blue 1x1 plate on top so it is centered horizontally.

18.2. Vertically place a light blue 1x2 tile with a round side on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the right. Then turn it to the left so it points to the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

18.3. Horizontally place your part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then attach a yellow 1x1 teacup. Now rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the upright 1x1 round tiles face the left.

You will have 2 extra tan 1x2 slope tiles. Save them for later!

Group 22 - Mad Hatter

19. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate upright on the front-facing side studs, on the 2nd column from the right of the 3rd and 4th rows from the top. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 slope tile from group 21 upright on the ppp so it slopes to the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile upright to the left of the top row of the ppp. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 slope tile upright below the ppp so it slopes down.

20. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate upright on the front-facing side studs, on the 2nd column from the left of the 3rd and 4th rows from the top. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 slope tile from group 21 upright on the ppp so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile upright to the right of the top row of the ppp. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 slope tile upright below the ppp so it slopes down.

21. Vertically place a white 1x2 inverted half arch brick on the bottom 2 rows of front-facing side studs on the leftmost column so it slopes down. Then place a white 1x1 slope tile upright on top of the ppp so it slopes up. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

22. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the upright 1x1 round tiles face the back. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 plate upright on the bottom row of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place 2 white 1x2 slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the ppp so they slope down.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 3):

Group 23 - Mad Hatter

23. Vertically place a white 2x3 plate upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a white 2x3 right wedge plate upright to the left of the ppp so the angled side faces the left and the short end faces down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right using a 2x3 left wedge plate.

24. Horizontally place a white 2x4 tile upright on the top 2 rows of front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 tile upright below the ppp.

25.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a white 2x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 plate on the back row. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

25.2. Horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back. Then place a white 1x1 sloped curved brick on the back left corner so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

25.3. Horizontally place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back. Then place a white 1x1 sloped curved brick on the front left corner so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

25.4. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place 1 part upright on the top 2 rows of left-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally and slopes up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 24 - Mad Hatter

26. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 plate in front of the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

27. Horizontally place a green 3x6 plate with a round side and a 1x2 gap on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the round side overhangs 2 rows to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

28.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a green 1x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a green 1x2 tile on top so it is centered vertically. Now vertically place a green 1x2 curved sloped right wedge tile in front of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the front and the cutoff corner faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back using a 1x2 curved sloped left wedge tile.

28.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 part on the leftmost column of studs so it is centered vertically and the cutoff corners face the front left and back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

29. Place a teal 1x2 curved corner brick on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front of the 2 leftmost columns of studs so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Together they should form a circle!

30. Place a teal 1x2 curved corner brick on the previous 1x2 curved corner brick that is in the back left so it aligns with it. Then place another 1 to the right of the ppp so the curve faces the back right. Now place 1 more in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front right. Then place a teal 1x1 brick to the left of the front row of the ppp. Now place a teal 1x1 brick with a side stud to the back left of the ppp so it sits in front of a 1x2 curved brick and the side stud faces the front. Then insert a green 1x1 round plate with an angled bar into the front-facing side stud of the ppp so the stud faces the front left.

31. Let's make a part! Let's make part of the hat! Horizontally place a light green 2x4 plate in front of you.

32. Stack 2 lime green 2x2 plates on top of the ppp so they are centered horizontally.

33. Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

34. Place a light green 2x2 tile on top of the 2 ppp.

35. Vertically place a green 1x2x1 2/3 brick with side studs on 3 sides on the leftmost column so the 2x2 side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

36. Vertically place a light green 1x2 grill slope tile upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs so it slopes down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

37. Horizontally place a light green 1x2 plate upright on the top row of left-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

38. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise. Now place a light green 2x2 corner sloped curved tile upright on the 2 rightmost front-facing side studs so 1 column overhangs to the right and the curve faces the bottom right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

39. Vertically place your part on top of the main build so it is centered vertically and horizontally.

Group 25 - Mad Hatter

40.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a light grey 1x2 hinge base in front of you so the wall faces the left. Then place a light grey 2x2 plate with a hinge bar underneath on top so it overhangs to the right. Now place a light green 2x2 sloped curved tile on the front row so it slopes and overhangs to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

40.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place 1 part upright on the 2 right-facing side studs of the previous part so it overhangs to the bottom. Then push the 2x2 sloped curved tiles to the left so they angle inward. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

41. Vertically place a light green 3x6 plate with a round side and 1x2 gap on top of the previous part so it is centered vertically, the round side faces the left, and the 2x2 tile sits in the 1x2 gap. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

42. Place a white 2x2 tile printed with 10/6 upright on the front left facing side stud so it is centered on it.

43.1. Flip your build upside down so the upright 1x1 round tiles face the front. Now vertically stack 2 green 1x2 plates on the leftmost column of anti-studs so they are centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 26 - Mad Hatter

43.2. Vertically place a teal 1x2 plate on the leftmost column of anti-studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now flip your build over so it is upright and the upright 1x1 round tiles face the front.

44.1. Let's make a part! Let's make the platform! Place a black 6x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs behind the ppp. Now horizontally place a black 2x4 tile behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

44.2. Place your figure on top of the platform so it is centered on it. Now put it away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 4):

Group 27 - Cheshire Cat

1. Vertically place a pink 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a pink 1x1 tile on the back right corner. Now vertically place a pink 1x2 plate in front of the ppp.
2. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile on the front row so it overhangs 2 columns to the left. Then vertically place a magenta 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the 2nd column from the right so it overhangs 1 row to the back.
3. Vertically place a pink 2x4 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns so 3 rows are exposed to the back.
4. Place a pink 1x1 tile on the back left corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a magenta 1x4 tile with 2 studs to the right of the ppp so it overhangs 1 row to the back.
5. Place a black 2x2 brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then place a magenta 1x1 plate to the left of the back row of the ppp. Then place a magenta 1x1 plate with 2 upright side studs in front of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Group 28 - Cheshire Cat

6. Place a yellow 2x2 round plate on top of the previous 2x2 brick. Then vertically place a yellow 1x2 plate to the left and right of the ppp.

You will have an extra magenta 1x4 plate and 1 magenta 1x4 tile. Save them for later!

Group 29 - Cheshire Cat

- 7.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs hanging down in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate upright on the top row of front-facing side studs. Now horizontally place a magenta 1x4 plate from group 28 upright below the ppp.
- 7.2. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile upright on the top row of front-facing side studs. Now horizontally place a magenta 1x4 tile from group 28 upright below the ppp. Now horizontally place your part on the 3rd row from the back so it is centered horizontally and the tiles face the back.
8. Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs hanging down on the front row of studs so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then vertically place a black 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the leftmost column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

9. Horizontally place a magenta 1x4 plate upright on the bottom row of front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x4 tile upright on the ppp.

Group 31 - Cheshire Cat

10. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate upright on the front-facing side studs. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile upright on the ppp.

11. Vertically place 4 transparent 1x2 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row of studs so the front row of each of them sits on the upright parts. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

12.1. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a magenta 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 tile on the back row. Now horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side in front of the ppp so the clip faces the front.

12.2. Now you should have 2 identical parts! place the top row of 1 part upright on the 2 left-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the bottom and the clip faces down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

13. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2x1 2/3 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so the side studs face the back.

14.1. Stack 2 black 2x2 bricks in front of the ppp so they are centered horizontally.

Group 32 - Cheshire Cat

14.2. Place a pink 2x2 round plate on top of the 2 ppp. Now place a pink 2x2 brick on top of the ppp.

15. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2x1 2/3 bricks with 2x2 side studs, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the side studs face the front. Then vertically place 1 on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

16. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2x1 2/3 brick with 2x2 side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place 2 more, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column so the side studs face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

17. Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

18.1. Let's make a part! Place a magenta 1x1 plate with 2 upright side studs in front of you so the side studs face the right. Then stack 2 magenta 1x1 plates on top of the ppp. Now horizontally place a magenta 1x2x2 sloped curved brick on top so it slopes and overhangs to the left.

18.2. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place your part on the front row so it slopes to the left.

19. Let's make a part! Place a magenta 1x1 plate with 2 upright side studs in front of you so the side studs face the left. Then stack 2 magenta 1x1 plates on top of the ppp.

20. Horizontally place a magenta 1x2x2 sloped curved brick on top so it slopes and overhangs to the right.

21. Vertically stack 2 pink 1x2 plates upright on the 2 left-facing side studs.

22. Place a pink 1x1 brick upright on the top left-facing side stud. Then place a pink 1x1 sloped curved brick upright below the ppp so it slopes down.

23.1. Horizontally stack 2 pink 1x2 plates underneath your part.

You will have 2 extra pink 1x2 plates. Save them for later!

Group 33 - Cheshire Cat

23.2. Horizontally stack 2 magenta 1x2 plates underneath your part. Then horizontally stack 2 more pink 1x2 plates from group 32 underneath the 2 ppp.

24. Place your part upright on the front row of right-facing side studs so it points up and to the right. This is the tail!

25.1. Let's make a part! Vertically place 2 magenta 2x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, in front of you. Now horizontally place a magenta 2x4 tile on the back 2 rows. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

25.2. Place your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered on them.

26.1. Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 sloped curved brick upright on the right stud of the 4th row of front-facing side studs from the top so 1 column overhangs to the right and it slopes down.

Group 34 - Cheshire Cat

26.2. Horizontally place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick upright to the left of the ppp so it slopes down.

27.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally stack 2 magenta 1x4 plates in front of you. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 tri-slope tile on top so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front. Now place a magenta 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

27.2. Horizontally place your part upright on the 3rd row of front-facing side studs from the top so it is centered horizontally and the 1x1 slope tiles slope up.

28. Place a magenta 1x1 slope tile on the top left front-facing side stud so it slopes up. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 plate upright to the right of the ppp. Then place a magenta 1x1 plate upright to the right of the ppp. Now place a magenta 1x1 slope tile upright below the ppp so it slopes up. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 tri-slope tile upright to the left of the ppp so it slopes up. Now place a magenta 1x1 slope tile upright to the left of the ppp so it slopes up.

29.1. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 sloped curved brick upright on the right stud of the 4th row of front-facing side studs from the top so 1 column overhangs to the right and it slopes down.

Group 35 - Cheshire Cat

29.2. Horizontally place a magenta 1x2 sloped curved brick upright to the left of the ppp so it slopes down.

30.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally stack 2 magenta 1x4 plates in front of you. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 tri-slope tile on top so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the front. Now place a magenta 1x1 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

30.2. Horizontally place your part upright on the 3rd row of front-facing side studs from the top so it is centered horizontally and the 1x1 slope tiles slope up.

31. Place a magenta 1x1 slope tile on the top right front-facing side stud so it slopes up. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 plate upright to the left of the ppp. Then place a magenta 1x1 plate upright to the left of the ppp. Now place a magenta 1x1 slope tile upright below the ppp so it slopes up. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 tri-slope tile upright to the right of the ppp so it slopes up. Now place a magenta 1x1 slope tile upright to the right of the ppp so it slopes up.

32. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the tail is in the back and faces the left. Vertically place a magenta 2x4 plate upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered vertically on them. Then place a pink 2x2 round plate upright to the left of the bottom 2 rows of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

33.1. Place a pink 1x1 quarter circle tile upright on the bottom left front-facing side stud so the curve faces the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 36 - Cheshire Cat

33.2. Horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile printed with a smile upright in between the 2 ppp. Horizontally place a magenta 1x2 jumper plate upright above the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Now place a magenta 1x1 plate upright to the left of the ppp. Then place a magenta 1x1 quarter circle tile upright to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the top left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

34.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 tile in front of you. Then vertically place a magenta 1x2 plate underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

34.2. Horizontally place your part upright on the top 2 rows of front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.

Group 37 - Cheshire Cat

35. Place a pink 1x1 quarter circle tile upright on the middle front-facing side stud so the curve faces up. Then place a yellow 1x1 round tile printed with an eye upright to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

36. Horizontally place a magenta 1x4 plate on the front row.

37. Flip your build upside down so the upright 1x1 round tiles face the front. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate on top so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

38.1. Vertically place a magenta 1x2 plate on the leftmost column of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 38 - Cheshire Cat

38.2. Vertically stack 2 pink 1x2 plates on top of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

39. Flip your build over so it is right side up and the upright 1x1 round tiles face the front. Now horizontally place a magenta 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the front. Then place 2 magenta 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, behind the ppp so they slope to the back.

40. Horizontally place 2 magenta 1x2 tri-slope tiles, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the 2 ppp so they slope to the back.

41.1. Let's make a part! Let's make a platform! Place a black 6x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs behind the ppp. Now horizontally place a black 2x4 tile behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

41.2. Place your figure on top of the platform so it is centered on it.
