

43289 Belle & the Beast's Enchanted Castle

Adventures and stories old and new await fans of Disney's Beauty and The Beast with this LEGO® I Disney Princess Belle & the Beast's Enchanted Castle (43289) building set. The castle playset includes familiar features to thrill kids who love the classic movie. Inside, children will find 6 rooms and a spinning ballroom floor, authentic details and movable pieces that bring it to life. There are also 4 LEGO I Disney characters: Belle, The Beast, Lumière and Cogsworth, and plenty of story starters.

DISNEY PRINCESS BUILDING TOY FOR KIDS – Treat girls and boys ages 5 years old and up to this Enchanted Castle (43289), a pretend play set based on Disney's Beauty and The Beast.

DETAILED CASTLE PLAYSET – The castle is decorated with a colorful façade and can be turned to reveal 6 rooms.

FEATURES AND FUNCTIONS – Kids can build the castle, then explore familiar details, including a small ballroom with a turntable, the forbidden room with the rose, the dining room and more.

PLAY POSSIBILITIES – Recreate classic movie scenes or imagine new ones with Disney Princess Belle, The Beast, Lumière, Cogsworth, a book, the enchanted rose, a magic mirror and more.

DIMENSIONS – This 254-piece castle playset, inspired by Disney's Beauty and The Beast, measures over 8.5 in. (22 cm) high, 6 in. (16 cm) wide and 2.5 in. (7 cm) deep.

The build is 254 pieces in total and is for ages 5+.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Before you start building, here are some terms we'll be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)

- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, els and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43289>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 4 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Belle

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 light yellow dress printed with drapes, 1 light tan torso printed with a light yellow top, 1 light tan head printed with pink lips and light brown eyes, and 1 brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you.

Sub-build 2. Let's make a part! Let's make a book! Vertically place a brown 1x2 bottom book cover with 2 studs in front of you so the small hinges are on the left. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile printed with the words "Once upon a time" on it, on top. Now vertically attach a brown top book cover to the small hinges, then close the book! Now attach it to her hand then put them both away while we make the castle!

Group 2 - Enchanted Castle

1. Horizontally place a light brown 6x8 plate in front of you.
2. Vertically place a tan 1x2x3 brick on the front right corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x4x5 panel with a window behind the ppp so the wall faces the right.
3. Place a white 2x2 corner tile on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front of the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it looks like the braille letter j. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
4. Place a black 2x2 tile with a round part on the 4th and 5th columns from the left so it is centered vertically.
5. Place a white 2x2 corner tile on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front of the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it looks like the braille letter h. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.
6. Place a gold 4x4 round plate on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered on it.
7. Vertically place a tan 1x2x3 brick on the front left corner. Then vertically place a tan 1x4x5 panel with a window behind the ppp so the wall faces the left.
8. Place a tan 1x1 round brick on the 2nd row from the front of the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
9. Place a tan 1x1 brick with a side stud and bottom lip on the front left corner so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
10. Vertically place a tan 1x2 log brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

11. Horizontally place a tan 1x8x2 arch brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.
12. Vertically place a tan 1x2 log brick on the leftmost column, in front of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
13. Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 rounded brick with a gap on the rightmost column, in front of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
14. Vertically place a tan 1x4 brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 3 - Enchanted Castle

15. Place a white 2x2 corner tile on the back left corner so it looks like the braille letter f. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a light magenta 1x4 tile on the back row, in between the 2 ppp.
16. Horizontally place a tan 1x8x2 arch brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally.
17. Vertically place a white 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
18. Horizontally place a white 1x6 tile on the front row in between the 2 ppp.
19. Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a light grey 1x1 round plate with a bar in front of you so the bar faces the back.
20. Place a brown 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp.
21. Place a transparent orange candle flame on top of the ppp so it is horizontal.
22. Now you should have 2 identical parts! Insert the bar of 1 part into the leftmost front-facing side stud so the candle flame faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
23. Put your build away now while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 4 - The Beast

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 black pair of legs printed with brown shoes, 1 torso printed with a blue and gold jacket, and white gloves, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes, nose, and mouth, and 1 light brown, brown and tan beast mask. Assemble your minifigure then place him in front of you.

Sub-build 4. Let's make a part! Let's make a mirror! Place a light grey 1x1 round plate with a handle in front of you so the handle faces the front. Then place a light grey 2x2 round tile printed with a light blue and white mirror on top of the stud so it is centered on it. Now attach it to your beast's hand! Now put him away while we continue building the castle!

Group 5 - Enchanted Castle

1. Horizontally place a tan 6x8 plate in front of you.
2. Place a dark red 2x2 slope brick on the front right corner so it slopes to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
3. Horizontally place a dark tan 1x4 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.
4. Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2 grill tiles, 1 to the right of the other, behind the ppp.
5. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then place a tan 1x1 brick to the left and right of the ppp.
6. Horizontally place a light magenta 1x8 brick on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.
7. Horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 inverted arch bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so together they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right.
8. Place 2 tan 1x1 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 2 ppp so together they slope outwards to the left and right.
9. Vertically place a tan 2x3 pentagonal tile printed with a dark orange rose upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so it is centered vertically on it and the angled side faces up.
10. Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 log brick on the 2 rightmost columns of the 4th row from the front.
11. Horizontally place a light magenta 1x2 brick on top of the ppp.
12. Place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick on the back left corner so it slopes and overhangs to the back.
13. Horizontally place a light magenta 1x4 brick to the right of the front row of the ppp. Then place the back row of a light magenta 2x2 brick to the right of the ppp.
14. Horizontally place a light magenta 1x8 brick on the 5th row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a clip in front of the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp so the clip faces the front.
15. Horizontally place a light magenta 1x2 brick on the back left corner.
16. Place a light magenta 2x2 brick on the back left corner.
17. Horizontally place 2 light magenta 1x2x2 panels with a window, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the front row of the ppp so the walls face the back. Now place the back row of a light magenta 2x2 brick to the right of the ppp.
18. Place a dark red 2x2x2 pyramid brick on the back left corner.

19. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

20. Horizontally place a white 1x2 log brick on the 2 rightmost columns of the 5th row from the front. Then place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick in front of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the front.

Group 6 - Enchanted Castle

21. Let's make a part! Let's make a book shelf! Horizontally place a dark grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2x2 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

22. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 jumper plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

23. Place a transparent orange 1x1 pyramid tile on top of the ppp.

24. Horizontally place a light grey 1x4x2 arch brick on the front row.

25. Horizontally place 2 dark grey 1x2 plates with a rail, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the rails face the front.

26. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

27. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

28. Place a light grey 1x1x5 brick on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

29. Place a brown 1x1x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with 2 side studs on the front left corner so the side studs face the right. Then vertically place a light blue 1x2 tile upright on the right-facing side studs of the ppp.

Group 7 - Enchanted Castle

30.1. Let's make a part! Place a brown 1x1x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the left. Then vertically place a green 1x2 plate upright on the left-facing side studs. Now vertically place a red 1x2 tile upright on the left-facing side studs.

30.2. Place your part on the front right corner of your previous part so the upright 1x2 tile faces the left.

31. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

32. Horizontally place a brown 2x4 plate on top so it is centered.

33. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

34. Horizontally place a brown 1x4 double sloped curved tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

35. Horizontally place your part on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front of your previous build so it is centered horizontally.

36. Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate on the back right corner so there is no overhang.

Group 8 - Enchanted Castle

37. Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate in front of the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp.

38. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 grill tile on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right of the 2nd row of studs from the back. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left of the ppp.

39. Horizontally place 2 dark tan 1x2x3 slope bricks, 1 to the right of the other, behind the 2 ppp so together they slope outwards to the left and right.

40. Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 jumper plate on top of the 2 ppp.

41. Place a gold 1x1 cone brick on top of the ppp.

42. Place a light magenta 2x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns on the 2nd and 3rd rows of studs from the back.

43-44. Stack 2 light magenta 2x2 bricks on top of the ppp.

45. Vertically place a tan 1x2 log brick on the right column of the 2 ppp. Then place a tan 2x2 inverted slope brick to the left of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the left.

46. Horizontally place a white 2x3 plate on top of the 2 ppp.

47. Vertically place a tan 1x2 grill tile on the rightmost column of the ppp.

48. Let's make a part! Stack 2 tan 2x2 round bricks in front of you. Then place a dark red 2x2x2 pyramid brick on top of the ppp. Now place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Now place your part to the left of the previous 1x2 grill tile that is on the rightmost column.

49. Bring back your previous build and horizontally place it in front of you so the candles face the back.

50. Now horizontally place your current build on top so it is centered.

51. Now put it away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 9 - Cogsworth

1. Horizontally place a brown 1x2 log brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

2. Place a gold 1x1 plate with a vertical tooth on the left column so the tooth faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

3. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on top.

4. Place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top.

5. Place a brown 2x2 round tile printed with a tan clock face with eyes and a mouth upright on the front-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the top. Now put Cogsworth away while we make the next part!

Group 10 - Foot Stool

1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a red 1x3 plate in front of you.

2. Place a gold 1x1 round plate underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

2. Place a red 1x1 round tile on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

4. Place an orange 1x1 plate in between the 2 ppp. This is a foot stool! Now put it away while we continue making the castle!

Group 11 - Enchanted Castle

1. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the front.

2. Horizontally place a light magenta 2x4x5 curved panel with a window frame on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front.

3. Attach a gold lattice curved window pane to the front of the window.

4. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing side stud so the leaves face the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

5. Place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate upright on each of the 2 front-facing side studs.

6. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the side studs face the back.

7. Let's make a part! Let's make a bed! Vertically place a white 2x6 brick in front of you.

8. Horizontally place a white 1x2 slope tile on the back row so it slopes to the front. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 tile in front of the ppp.

9. Vertically place a yellow 2x4 tile in front of the ppp.

10. Vertically place the back row of your part on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 5 rows to the front.

11. Place a light brown 6x6 plate underneath the front 5 rows so it is centered horizontally and 1 row is exposed to the front.

12. Vertically place a light magenta 1x6x5 panel on the front right corner so the wall faces the right.

13. Vertically place a light magenta 1x2x5 brick on the 5th and 6th rows from the front of the leftmost column.

14. Place a short white 1x1 brick in front of the ppp. Then place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Now place a yellow hair brush on top of the ppp so the bristles face the front.

Group 12 - Enchanted Castle

15. Place a tan 1x3 angled brick on the back right corner so it sits on top of the 1x6x5 panel and 2x4x5 curved panel with a window so the smooth side faces the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. There should be no overhang.

16. Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate with a round side on the back 2 rows of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the back.

17. Place a tan 1x1 brick on the 5th row from the front of the rightmost column.

18. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick with a clip in front of the ppp so the clip faces the right. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 log brick in front of the ppp.

19. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 inverted slope brick on the front right corner so it slopes and overhangs to the left. Now vertically place another 1 on the 5th row from the front of the leftmost column so it slopes and overhangs to the front.

20. Place a tan 6x6 quarter circle plate in front of the 2x6 plate with a round side that is in the back so the curve faces the front left.

21. Horizontally place a gold 1x2 grill tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

22. Rotate your build 180 degrees.

23. Now horizontally place a light magenta 2x4x5 curved panel with a window frame behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front.

24. Attach a gold lattice curved window pane to the front of the window.

25. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing side stud underneath the ppp so the leaves face the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

26-27. Place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate upright on each of the 2 front-facing side studs of the 2 ppp.

28. Place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate to the right of the back row of the previous 2x4x5 curved panel with a window frame. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now rotate your build 180 degrees.

Group 13 - Enchanted Castle

29. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a magenta 1x2x3 brick in front of you.

30. Place a magenta 1x1 slope tile on the left column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
31. Horizontally place your part on the 6th row from the front so it is centered horizontally between the front row of the 2x4x5 curved panel with a window frame.
32. Horizontally place 2 blue 1x2 jumper plates, 1 in front of the other, in front of the previous part.
33. Vertically place a dark blue 1x2 tile to the left of the 2 ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
34. Horizontally place a blue 1x2 jumper plate on the 3rd row from the front of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left of the ppp.
35. Place a light magenta 1x1x5 brick on the 5th row from the front of the rightmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
36. Place the front left corner of a white 3x3 quarter circle plate on top of the ppp so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
- 37.1. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light brown 2x3 plate in front of you.

Group 14 - Enchanted Castle

- 37.2. Horizontally place a magenta 2x3 plate on top of the ppp.
38. Vertically place a magenta 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place a magenta 1x2 tile to the left of the ppp.
39. Vertically place a magenta 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the right.
40. Horizontally place your part on the 4th and 5th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally behind the 1x2 jumper plates.
41. Place a dark red 1x3 sloped curved brick on the back right corner on top of the 3x3 quarter circle plate so the curve faces the back right and it aligns with the curve of the plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.
42. Horizontally place a dark red 2x4x4 sloped curved panel in front of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.
43. Let's make a part! Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plantain front of you. Then place a short white 1x1 brick on top of the ppp.
44. Place a white head on top of the ppp.
45. Place light brown hair on top of the ppp so the long side faces the back.
46. Horizontally place your part in between the front row of the previous 2x4x4 sloped curved panel.

47. Place a gold 1x1 cone brick on top of the previous 2x4x4 sloped curved panel.
48. Bring back your main build and horizontally place it in front of you so the taller side is in the back.
49. Now attach the right-facing clip of your part to the front bar of the gap of the 1x2 rounded brick that is on the leftmost column of the main build.
50. Now put away your build while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 4):

Group 15 - Lumiere

1. Horizontally place a gold 1x3 candle holder in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round brick printed with eyes and a mouth on top so it is centered horizontally and the print faces the front.
2. Horizontally place 3 transparent orange candle flames on top of the 3 studs. Now put away Lumiere while we make a rose!

Group 16 - Rose

1. Place a white 2x2 round table in front of you.
2. Place a tan 2x2 round plate on top.
3. Place a green stem with 3 tips on top of the ppp so it is centered.
4. Place a red 1x1 round flower plate on the tip of the ppp so it faces the front.
5. Place a transparent 2x2x2 dome brick on top so it is centered. Now put it away while we continue making the castle!

Group 17 - Castle

1. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the front.
2. Horizontally place a light magenta 2x4x5 curved panel with a window frame on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front.
3. Attach a gold lattice curved window pane to the front of the window.
4. Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing side stud so the leaves face the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.
5. Place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate upright on each of the 2 front-facing side studs.
6. Rotate your build 180 degrees so the side studs face the back.
7. Place a brown 2x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

8. Place a light brown 6x6 plate underneath the front row of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and 5 rows are exposed to the front.

9. Place a brown 2x2 plate on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place 2 light grey 1x3 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, behind the ppp.

10. Place a red 2x2 round tile on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light brown 2x2 tile with a stud behind the ppp. Now place a red 2x2 round tile behind the ppp.

Group 18 - Enchanted Castle

11. Let's make a part! Let's make a table! Horizontally place a purple 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a light grey 1x1 swirl on the front right corner.

12. Place a transparent green 1x1 round plate on the back left corner. Then place a white 1x1 tea cup in front of the ppp so the handle faces the front. Then place another 1 on the back right corner so the handle faces the back.

13. Place a pink 2x2 round ridged brick on top so it is centered horizontally.

14. Place a dark pink 2x2 round tile with a stud on top of the ppp.

15. Place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

16. Place a brown 2x2 brick underneath your part so it is centered horizontally.

17. Vertically place your part on the 2x2 tile with a stud so it is centered horizontally and the 1x1 round plate is in the front left corner.

Group 19 - Enchanted Castle

18. Vertically place a light magenta 1x6x5 panel on the front left corner so the wall faces the left.

19. Vertically place a light magenta 1x2x5 brick on the 5th and 6th rows from the front of the rightmost column.

20. Place a tan 1x3 angled brick on the back left corner so it sits on top of the 1x6x5 panel and 2x4x5 curved panel with a window so the smooth side faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

21. Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate with a round side on the back 2 rows of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the back.

22. Place a tan 1x1 brick on the 5th row from the front of the leftmost column.

23. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick with a clip in front of the ppp so the clip faces the left. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 log brick in front of the ppp.

24. Horizontally place a tan 1x2 inverted slope brick on the front left corner so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Now vertically place another 1 on the 5th row from the front of the rightmost column so it slopes and overhangs to the front.

25. Place a tan 6x6 quarter circle plate in front of the 2x6 plate with a round side that is in the back so the curve faces the front right.

26. Place a gold 1x3 curved fence with swirls on the back right corner so the curve faces the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

27. Horizontally place a light magenta 2x6x6 door frame with curved sides in front of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and the row of 4 studs are in the back.

28. Place a white 3x3 quarter circle plate on the 3 leftmost columns of the ppp so 1 row overhangs to the back and the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

29. Place a dark red 1x3 sloped curved brick on the back right corner of the previous 3x3 quarter circle plate so the curve faces the back right and it aligns with the curve of the plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

30. Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs in between the front row of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

31. Place a tan 2x2 tile printed with a ripped picture of Belle upright on the front-facing side studs of the ppp.

32. Horizontally place a dark red 2x4x4 sloped curved panel behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.

33. Place a gold 1x1 cone brick on top of the ppp.

34. Bring back your main build and horizontally place it in front of you so the taller side is in the back.

35-36. Now attach the left-facing clip of your part to the front bar of the gap of the 1x2 rounded brick that is on the rightmost column of the main build.
