

71855 Ninja Dragon Riyu's Battle

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Boys and girls ages 7 and up will love building this LEGO® NINJAGO® Ninja Dragon Riyu's Battle (71855) ninja toy and recreating scenes from season 4 of the NINJAGO Dragons Rising TV show. This impressive playset features a dragon toy with posable wings, legs, feet, arms, wrists, claws, head, tail and shoulders, and it's armed with a large sword and shuriken weapon accessories. Kids can also make an exciting swap and use the weapons from the Cole's Mission Mech & Dragon Zane (71854) set (sold separately). This LEGO dragon set comes with 4 minifigures: ninja warriors Arin and dragon form Nya and villains Mutation Monster and Loyalist. The LEGO NINJAGO range of make-believe toys for kids includes mechs, dragons and temples for fans to role-play ninja action.

The packaging displays Ninja Dragon Riyu in full action. The build consists of 347 pieces in total and is recommended for ages 7+. Once finished, you will have a brick-build Riyu and 4 minifigures. The set consists of 4 numbered bags.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind! Before you start building, here are some terms we may be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.

- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- Open/hollow stud: a bump on a LEGO brick with a hole, which allows attaching bars. In the case of open studs, the hole goes all the way through. In the case of hollow studs, it does not.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Left/right wedge parts: these are parts that when placed in front of you and are pointing to the back, their wedge is on the left/right side of the part.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ell and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off

Additionally, it is worth mentioning that besides the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, a PDF version for the set's instructions is always available online at [\[https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/71855\]](https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/71855). This might help a sighted building partner that may want to follow along or low vision users that may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2, and 3 and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 numbered bags, 1 instruction booklet, and 4 minifigures. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder!

LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Building Instructions

Book 1, bag1

Group 1 – Arin

Page 4. Locate 1 bright light orange pair of legs with dark blue sash and knee straps and 1 bright light orange torso with dark blue and reddish orange dragons, reddish orange left arm, dark blue right arm, and black hands. Assemble the body of the minifigure. Then, attach 1 dark blue shoulder wrap with scabbard for 2 katanas to the minifigure neck, so that its scabbard faces to the back. Continue by attaching 1 yellow minifigure head with thick black eyebrows, stubble sideburns, and medium nougat scar to the minifigure's neck. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is facing the right way. Next, attach 1 bright light orange hood with pearl gold horns to the top of the minifigure's head, so that its horns face to the front. Lastly, insert 2 pearl gold katanas into the minifigure's scabbard.

Group 2 – Riyu

1. Let's start building the body of Riyu. Place 1 dark blue 2x12 plate vertically in front of you.
2. Place 1 dark blue 4x4 plate on the 4 front rows of the ppp, so that it overhangs to the left and to the right by 1 column.
3. Place 2 red 1x1 round tiles with upright thin bar, one to the right of the other, behind the ppp.
- 4.1 We need to make a small sub-build. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 plate vertically in front of you.

4.2 Locate 2 black 2x2 plates with 1x2 upright side studs. Rotate the first one so that its side studs face to the left. Place its rightmost column under the 2 front rows of the leftmost column of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

4.3 Place 1 bright light orange 2x2 brick on the 2 front rows, so that it is centered horizontally.

4.4 Find 2 white 1x2 bricks with side studs. Place the first one vertically to the left of the ppp, so that its side studs face to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

4.5 The sub-build is complete. Place its 2 front rows on top of the 2 back rows of the 4x4 plate. Note that the overhanging back row of the sub-build will attach to the 2 red 1x1 round tiles with upright thin bar.

5.1 We need to make a small sub-build. Hold 1 dark blue 1x2 brick with axle hole horizontally. Then, insert 1 red 2L axle into the front-facing hole of the ppp, so that it protrudes to the front by 1L.

5.2 Rotate 1 black 1x2 liftarm with ball horizontally upright, so that its ball faces to the left and its pin hole and axle holes face to the front. Slide its axle hole onto the ppp.

5.3 The sub-build is complete. Place its 1x2 brick horizontally on the 2 leftmost columns on the 2nd row from the front, so that its ball faces to the left.

6.1 We need to make a small sub-build. Hold 1 dark blue 1x2 brick with axle hole horizontally. Then, insert 1 red 2L axle into the front-facing hole of the ppp, so that it protrudes to the front by 1L.

6.2 Rotate 1 black 1x2 technic liftarm with ball horizontally upright, so that its ball faces to the right and its pin hole and axle holes face to the front. Slide its axle hole onto the ppp.

6.3 The sub-build is complete. Place its 1x2 brick horizontally on the 2 rightmost columns on the 2nd row from the front, to the right of the previous sub-build, so that its ball faces to the right.

7. Place 1 dark blue 2x4 plate horizontally on top of the 2 front rows. Then, place 1 dark red 1x4 plate horizontally on top of the back row of the ppp.

8. Place 2 dark blue 1x2 plates with 2x2 side studs hanging down horizontally, one to the right of the other, in front of the ppp, so that its side studs face to the front.

9. Place 1 sand blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top of the 2 front rows, so that it is centered horizontally and its 2 studs face to the back.

Group 3 - Riyu (continued)

10. Rotate the build 180 degrees on the horizontal plane, so that its balls are on the back and face to the left and right.

Place 1 dark blue 2x4 brick horizontally on the 6th and 7th row from the front, so that it is centered horizontally and it overhangs to the left and right by 1 column. Then, place 1 sand blue 1x4 plate horizontally on the front row of the ppp. Lastly, find 2 bright light orange 1x1 round plates with open stud and petals. Place the first one on the leftmost column of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

11. Grab 2 dark bluish gray 2x2 bricks with ball socket. Rotate the first one so that its socket faces to the right. Place its rightmost column behind the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically to the left.

12. Locate 2 black 1x4 tiles with 2 studs. Rotate the first one vertically. Place its 2 front rows on top of the rightmost column of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

13. Find 2 white 1x1 bricks with axle hole. Place the first one on the leftmost column on the 5th row from the front, so that its axle hole faces to the left and right. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Grab 2 dark bluish gray 1L axle with 2L pin. Insert the axle of the first one into the right-facing axle hole of the ppp, so that its pin protrudes to the right. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left. Lastly, locate 2 reddish brown 1x1 bricks with pin hole. Slide the first one onto the ppp, so that the pin protrudes to the left by 1L. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

14. Place 1 dark red 1x4 plate horizontally on the 5th row from the front, on top of the 4 1x1 bricks from the previous step.

15. Find 4 black 1x1 bricks with axle hole. Place the first 2 on the leftmost column on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, so that their axle holes face to the front and back. Then, place the remaining 2 symmetrically on the right. Grab 2 yellow 3L axles. Insert the first one vertically into the 2 ppps, so that it protrudes to the front by 1L. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

16. Locate 2 dark bluish gray 1x2 technic liftarms with angled ball. Rotate the first one horizontally upright, so that its ball faces to the bottom left and its axle holes face to the front and back. Slide its right axle hole onto the left front-facing axle. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

17.1 We need to make a small sub-build. Place 1 black 2x2 round plate with axle hole in front of you.

17.2 Find 2 dark blue 2x2 inverted curved slope tiles. Rotate the first one so that it slopes to the back. Place its front row under the back row of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

17.3 The sub-build is complete. Attach it vertically under the 4 front rows.

Group 4 - Riyu (continued)

18. Rotate 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 plate vertically. Place its 2 back rows on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front. Note that its front row will overhang on top of the 1x2 technic liftarms with angled ball.

19. Place 1 dark blue 2x2 inverted slope brick in front of the ppp, so that it slopes to the front. Then, place 2 black 1x2 plates with locking finger on short edge vertically, one to the right of the other, on top of the ppp, so that their locking fingers face to the front. Lastly, place 1 sand blue 1x2 ingot tile horizontally on the front row of the 2 ppps.

20. Place 1 black 2x6 plate behind the ppp. Then, place 1 sand blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the 2 front rows of the ppp, so that its studs face to the back. Continue by placing 1 sand blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs behind the ppp, so that its studs face to the front. Lastly, place 1 black 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of the studs of the 2 ppps.

21. Grab 2 sand blue 1x1 slope tiles. Place the first one on the leftmost column on the 6th row from the back, so that it slopes to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Locate 2 sand blue 1x2 plates with stud and slope tile. Rotate the first one horizontally, so that it slopes to the right. Place its rightmost column in front of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

22. Place 1 black 1x2 plate with clips on long edge horizontally on top of the 2 ppps, so that its clips face to the front. Then, attach the handle of 1 sand blue 4x5x2 cockpit with handle and studs on side to the ppp. Make sure that the ppp is angled as close as possible to the 1x2 ingot tile on the back of the build.

23. Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs so that its 2 studs face to the front. Place its front row on top of the 1x2 plate with clips on long edge from the previous step.

24. Locate 2 dark red 1x1 bricks. Place the first one on the leftmost column of the row in front of the ppp, to the left of the handle of the 4x5x2 cockpit. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Then, place 1 dark red 1x4 double curved slope tile horizontally on top of the 2 ppps.

Group 5 - Riyu (continued)

25. Rotate the build 180 degrees on the horizontal plane, so that its locking fingers face to the back. Place 1 black 2x2 round plate with axle hole on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so that it is centered horizontally. Then, place 1 bright light orange 2x2 plate on top of the ppp.

26. Place 1 sand blue 4x5x2 cockpit on top of the ppp, so that its handle overhangs to the front. On the right side, its back right-facing side stud should be above the front column of right-facing side studs. Similarly, on the left side, its back left-facing side stud should be above the front column of left-facing side studs.

27. Rotate 1 dark blue 2x2 round corner plate so that its antistuds face to the left and its curved edge faces to the bottom and to the back. Attach its back column to the back column of right-facing side studs. Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 plate with cut corner so that its side studs face to the left and its right angle faces to the bottom and to the front. Place its bottom row in front of the top row of the ppp.

28. Attach 1 sand blue 1x1 slope tile upright behind the bottom row of the ppp, so that it slopes to the front.

29. Attach 1 black 2x2 plate with 1x2 upright side studs upright to the front-facing side studs, so that it is centered horizontally and its side studs face up. Locate 2 bright light orange 1x1 round plates with open stud and petals. Attach the first one upright to the left of the top row of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

30. Attach 1 dark blue 1x4 double curved slope tile horizontally upright to the bottom row of front-facing side studs.

31. Attach 1 dark blue 1x4 double curved slope tile horizontally upright to the top row of front-facing side studs.

32. Rotate 1 dark blue 2x2 round corner plate so that its antistuds face to the right and its curved edge faces to the bottom and to the back. Attach its back column to the back column of left-facing side studs. Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 plate with cut corner so that its side studs face to the right and its right angle faces to the bottom and to the front. Place its bottom row in front of the top row of the ppp.

33. Attach 1 sand blue 1x1 slope tile upright behind the bottom row of the ppp, so that it slopes to the front.

34. Flip the build upside down from left to right, so that its antistuds face up and its locking fingers face to the back. Find 2 dark red 1x1 plates. Attach the first one upside down to the leftmost column of the row with the protruding pins. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Then, attach 1 reddish brown 1x2 plate upside down horizontally between the 2 ppps. Lastly, grab 2 dark red 1x2 inverted curved slope tiles. Rotate the first one so that its studs face down and it slopes to the left. Attach its rightmost column to the leftmost column of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

35. Locate 2 black 1x1 bricks with clip. Attach the clip of the first one to the upright thin bar located on the left side of the 5th row from the front. Note that the 1x1 brick should be right-side up (that is, its stud should face up). Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

36.1 We need to make a small sub-build. Place 1 bright light orange 2x2 plate in front of you.

36.2 Find 2 dark blue 3x4 stepped wedge tiles. Rotate the first one so that it slopes to the back. Place its front row on top of the back row of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the front.

36.3 The sub-build is complete. Place it vertically in front of the 2 dark red 1x2 inverted curved slope tiles, so that the leftmost and rightmost columns of its 3rd row from the back attach to the 1x1 bricks with clips.

Book 1, bag 2

Group 6 - Loyalist

Page 35. Locate 1 black pair of legs with gold buckle and coattails with dark red ornate pattern, 1 black torso with robe, gold pendant, brooches, dragon on back, black arms, and dark red hands, and 1 white minifigure head with gold headpiece, yellow eyes, and grin with fangs. Assemble the minifigure. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is facing the right way. Then, attach 1 dark red hood to the top of the minifigure head, so that its opening faces to the front.

Let's assemble the Loyalist weapon. Hold 1 black 6L bar with ring vertically, so that its ring is on the bottom. Then, attach 1 pearl gold lightsaber hilt vertically upright to the top of the ppp. Lastly, insert 1 black sword blade into the top-facing hole of the ppp. The weapon is ready. Put it in the Loyalist's right hand.

Group 7 - Riyu's tail

37. Let's build Riyu's tail. Place 1 dark blue 2x2 inverted curved slope tile in front of you, so that it slopes to the back. Place 1 white 1x2 plate with clip on long edge horizontally on the front row of the ppp, so that its clip faces to the front.

38. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball socket on long edge horizontally behind the ppp, so that its ball socket faces to the back.

39. Find 2 light bright orange 1x1 plates with 1x1 side studs hanging down. Place the first one in front of the left column of the ppp, so that its side stud faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

40. Grab 2 white 1x1 slope tiles. Attach the first one upright to the ppp, so that it slopes to the front. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

41. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 tile with upright pin on top of the build.

42.1 We need to assemble two identical sub-builds. You can choose to build them simultaneously or one at a time. Let's begin with the first one. Place 1 dark blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs vertically in front of you. Then, place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball and ball socket on opposite short edges on top of the ppp, so that its ball faces to the front.

42.2 Place 2 sand blue 1x1 slope tiles, one in front of the other, on top of the ppp, so that they slope to the back.

42.3 The first sub-build is complete. Bring back the tail build, so that its clip faces to the front and its ball socket faces to the back. Attach the sub-build's front-facing ball to the back-facing ball socket of the tail.

42.4 If you chose to assemble the sub-builds one at a time, build a second one by repeating steps 42.1 and 42.2. Attach its front-facing ball onto the back-facing ball socket of the tail.

Group 8 - Riyu's tail (continued)

43. We need to assemble a small sub-build. Place 1 dark blue 2x2 inverted curved slope tile in front of you, so that it slopes to the back.

44. Locate 2 light bluish gray 1x2 plates with 1x2 upright side studs. Rotate the first one vertically, so that its side studs face to the left. Place its back row on top of the front left corner of the ppp, so that it overhangs to the front by 1 row. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

45. Place 1 dark blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs horizontally under the front overhang of the 2 ppps.
46. Place 1 dark blue 2x4 plate vertically on top of the sub-build, so that it overhangs to the back by 1 row.
47. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball on long edge horizontally on the back row of the ppp, so that its ball faces to the back. Find 2 light bright orange 1x1 plates with 1x1 side stud hanging down. Place the first one in front of the left column of the ppp, so that its side stud faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.
48. Place 2 black 1x2 plates with 2 locking fingers vertically, one to the right of the other, on the 2 front rows, so that their locking fingers face to the front.
49. Place 1 sand blue 2x4 plate vertically on top of the sub-build.
50. Locate 2 light bright orange 1x1 plates with 1x1 side stud hanging down. Place the first one on the front left corner of the ppp, so that its side stud faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.
51. Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 curved slope tile so that it slopes to the back. Place its front row on top of the 2 ppps.
52. Find 2 sand blue 2x2 plates with cut corner. Rotate the first one so that its antistuds face to the left and its right angle faces down and to the front. Attach it to the 2 front columns of right-facing side studs. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.
53. Grab 2 sand blue 1x1 quarter round tiles. Attach the first one to the back left-facing side stud, behind the ppp, so that its round edge faces down and to the back. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.
54. The sub-build is complete. Bring back the tail build, so that its clip faces to the front. Attach the front-facing ball of the sub-build to the back-facing ball socket of the tail.
55. The tail is complete. Bring back Riyu's main build, so that it is vertically in front of you, its balls face to the left and right, and its locking fingers face to the front. Attach the back-facing locking fingers of the tail to the front-facing locking fingers of the body.

Group 9 - Riyu's back right leg

56. Let's build Riyu's back right leg. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 brick with ball socket in front of you, so that its ball socket faces to the back. Then, place 1 dark blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs horizontally under the back row of the ppp.
57. Place 1 dark blue 1x1 plate with 1x1 upright side stud in front of the right column of the ppp, so that its side stud faces to the front.

58. Rotate 1 dark blue 1x2 plate with 1x2 upright side studs horizontally, so that its side studs face to the front. Place it to the left of the ppp, so that its left column is exposed.

59.1 Rotate 1 dark blue 3x3 corner plate so that its right angle faces to the back and to the left. Place its rightmost column on top of the leftmost column of the ppp.

59.2 Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball on short edge vertically on the 2 front rows of the leftmost column of the ppp, so that its ball faces to the front.

59.3 Place 1 black 1x1 plate with horizontal tooth behind the ppp, so that its tooth faces to the left.

59.4 Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 plate with cut corner so that its right angle faces to the front and to the right. Place its front row to the right of the ppp.

59.5 Rotate 1 dark blue 3x3 corner plate so that its right angle faces to the back and to the left. Place its 2 rightmost columns on top of the front row of the ppp.

59.6 Place 1 sand blue 1x1 slope tile behind the rightmost column of the ppp, so that it slopes to the back.

59.7 Place 1 sand blue 1x1 quarter round tile on the back left corner of the 3x3 corner plate, so that its curved edge faces to the front and to the left. Then, place 1 sand blue 1x1 slope tile to the right of the ppp, so that its slope faces to the left.

60. Place 1 bright light orange 1x1 plate with 1x1 side stud hanging down on the front right corner of the leg build, so that its side stud faces to the front.

61. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with 1x2 side studs hanging down horizontally to the left of the ppp, so that its side studs face to the front.

62. Attach 1 pearl gold 2x3 curved slope brick with wing edge horizontally upright to the front-facing side studs, so that its wing edge is to the right.

63. Place 1 sand blue 1x1 quarter round tile behind the left column of the ppp, so that its curved edge faces to the back and to the right. Then, rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 curved slope tile so that it slopes to the back. Place its front row to the right of the ppp.

64. Riyu's back right leg is complete. Bring back Riyu, so that it is vertically in front of you and its tail faces to the front. Rotate the leg 90 degrees counterclockwise, so that its ball socket faces to the left. Attach its left-facing ball socket to Riyu's front right-facing ball.

Group 10 - Riyu's back left leg

65. Let's build Riyu's back left leg. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 brick with ball socket in front of you, so that its ball socket faces to the back. Then, place 1 dark blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs horizontally under the back row of the ppp.

66. Place 1 dark blue 1x1 plate with 1x1 upright side stud in front of the left column of the ppp, so that its side stud faces to the front.

67. Rotate 1 dark blue 1x2 plate with 1x2 upright side studs horizontally, so that its side studs face to the front. Place it to the right of the ppp, so that its right column is exposed.

68.1 Rotate 1 dark blue 3x3 corner plate so that its right angle faces to the back and to the right. Place its leftmost column on top of the rightmost column of the ppp.

68.2 Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball on short edge vertically on the 2 front rows of the rightmost column of the ppp, so that its ball faces to the front.

68.3 Place 1 black 1x1 plate with horizontal tooth behind the ppp, so that its tooth faces to the right.

68.4 Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 plate with cut corner so that its right angle faces to the front and to the left. Place its front row to the left of the ppp.

68.5 Rotate 1 dark blue 3x3 corner plate so that its right angle faces to the back and to the right. Place its 2 leftmost columns on top of the front row of the ppp.

68.6 Place 1 sand blue 1x1 slope tile behind the leftmost column of the ppp, so that it slopes to the back.

68.7 Place 1 sand blue 1x1 quarter round tile on the back right corner of the 3x3 corner plate, so that its curved edge faces to the front and to the right. Then, place 1 sand blue 1x1 slope tile to the left of the ppp, so that its slope faces to the right.

69. Place 1 bright light orange 1x1 plate with 1x1 side stud hanging down on the front left corner of the leg build, so that its side stud faces to the front.

70. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with 1x2 side studs hanging down horizontally to the right of the ppp, so that its side studs face to the front.

71. Attach 1 pearl gold 2x3 curved slope brick with wing edge horizontally upright to the front-facing side studs, so that its wing edge is to the left.

72. Place 1 sand blue 1x1 quarter round tile behind the right column of the ppp, so that its curved edge faces to the back and to the left. Then, rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 curved slope tile so that it slopes to the back. Place its front row to the left of the ppp.

73. Riyu's back left leg is complete. Bring back Riyu, so that it is vertically in front of you and its tail faces to the front. Rotate the leg 90 degrees clockwise, so that its ball socket faces to the right. Attach its right-facing ball socket to Riyu's front left-facing ball.

Group 11 - Riyu's back feet

74.1 We need to assemble two identical sub-builds for Riyu's back feet. You can choose to assemble them simultaneously or one by one. Let's begin with the first one. Place 1 dark blue 2x2 plate in front of you. Then, place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball socket on long edge vertically on the leftmost column of the ppp, so that its ball socket faces to the left.

74.2 Place 1 black 1x2 plate with angled bars on long edge vertically to the right of the ppp, so that its angled bars face to the right.

74.3 Place 1 dark blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs vertically on the leftmost column.

74.4 Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 curved slope tile so that it slopes to the right. Place its leftmost column on top of the ppp.

74.5 Attach 1 black curved claw to each of the 3 right-facing angled bars, so that they curve down.

74.6 The foot is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is vertically in front of you and its tail faces to the front. Attach the foot's left-facing ball socket to Riyu's front right-facing ball.

74.7 If you chose to assemble the sub-builds one at a time, assemble a second foot by repeating steps 74.1 to 74.5. Rotate the second foot 180 degrees on the horizontal plane, so that its ball socket faces to the right. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is vertically in front of you and its tail faces to the front. Attach the foot's right-facing ball socket to Riyu's front left-facing ball.

Group 12 - Mutation Monster

Pages 59-61. Locate 1 bright green pair of legs with dark tan cloth, yellowish green claws, black hips and 1 bright green torso with dark tan tattered belt, gold heart, transparent green left arm, bright green right arm, and dark green hands. Assemble the body of the minifigure. Then, attach 1 black neck bracket with 4 angled bar handles to the minifigure's head, so that the angled bars are to the back.

Attach the clip of 1 bright green bar holder with clip to each of the 4 bar handles of the ppp. Find 2 lime elephant tails with bar. Insert the bar of the first one into the hole of the top left bar holder, so that it curves to the back. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Lastly, insert 1 yellowish green claw into each of the 2 ppps and the 2 remaining free bottom bar handles, so that they curve towards the minifigure's chest.

Continue by attaching 1 bright green giant minifigure head with giant orange eye, yellowish green fangs, and dark green wrinkles to the minifigure's neck. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is oriented properly. Next, put 1 reddish brown Asian straw hat on top of the ppp. Lastly, place 1 green claw into each of the 2 minifigure's hands.

Group 13 - Riyu's front right leg

75. Let's build Riyu's front right leg. Place 1 black 2x5 stepped plate vertically in front of you, so that its high 2x3 plate faces to the front. Then, place 1 dark blue 1x2 brick vertically on the 2 back rows of the leftmost column of the ppp.

76. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 brick with ball socket to the right of the ppp, so that its socket faces to the right.

77. Place 1 black 1x1 half cylinder short brick with side stud on the back left corner, so that its side stud faces to the back and to the left. Then, insert 1 dark bluish gray mechanical claw into the side stud of the ppp, so that its hands face up and down.

78. Rotate 1 dark blue 2x2 corner plate so that it resembles a J in Braille. Place its left column in front of the 1x1 half cylinder short brick with side stud from the previous step. Then, place 1 bright light orange 1x1 round plate with open stud and petals on the leftmost column of the ppp. Rotate 1 black 1x2 plate with clips on long edge vertically. Place its front row to the right of the ppp.

79. Place 1 dark blue 2x4 plate vertically on the 3 front rows, so that it overhangs to the front by 1 row. Then, place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball horizontally on the front row of the ppp. Continue by placing 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 plate vertically behind the ppp. Place 1 sand blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top of the 2 front rows, so that its studs face to the front.

80. Place 2 black 1x4 rounded plates vertically, one to the right of the other, behind the ppp.

81. Attach 1 dark blue 2x2 inverted curved slope tile under the 2 front rows, so that it slopes to the front.

82. Place 1 pearl gold 2x4 curved slope with 2x2 studs, 1x2 side studs hanging down, and wing end vertically on the 4 front rows, so that its wing end faces to the front and its side studs face to the left and right.

83. Place 1 pearl gold 1x2 curved slope tile with wing end horizontally behind the ppp, so that its wing end faces to the back.

84. Place 1 dark blue 1x1 plate with 1x1 upright side stud under the leftmost column on the 3rd row from the front, so that its side stud faces to the left.

85. Locate 1 dark blue 1x1 plate with 1x1 upright side stud and repeat the previous step symmetrically on the right.

86. Rotate 1 pearl gold 1x2 ingot tile vertically upright, so that its antistuds face to the left. Attach its bottom row to the right-facing side stud of the ppp.

87. Locate 1 pearl gold 1x2 ingot tile vertically upright, so that its antistuds face to the right and repeat the previous step symmetrically on the left.

88. Riyu's front right leg is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is vertically in front of you and its tail faces to the back. Attach the leg's right-facing ball socket to Riyu's front left-facing ball.

Group 14 - Riyu's front right foot

89. Let's build Riyu's front right foot. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with pin hole underneath horizontally in front of you, so that its pin hole faces to the front and back and is on the right. Then, insert 1 blue 3L pin into the front-facing hole, so that it protrudes to the front by 2L.

90. Rotate 1 black 1x2 plate with pin hole underneath horizontally, so that its pin hole faces to the front and back and is on the right. Slide its pin hole onto the front-facing pin, so that it protrudes to the front by 1L.

91. Place 1 dark blue 2x2 plate on top of the build.

92. Attach 1 dark blue 1x1 plate with 1x1 upright side stud under the back left corner, so that its side stud faces to the left.

93. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball socket on long edge horizontally on the back row, so that its ball socket faces to the back.

94. Place 1 black 1x2 plate with angled bar handles horizontally in front of the ppp, so that its bar handles face to the front.

95. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with 1x2 side studs hanging down on the leftmost column, so that its side studs face to the left.

96. Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 plate with cut corner so that its side studs face to the right and its right angle faces to the back and to the top. Attach it to the left-facing side studs.

97. Place 1 sand blue 2x2 curved slope tile on top of the build, so that it slopes to the right.

98. Attach 1 black curved claw to each of the 3 front-facing bar handles, so that they curve down.

99. The foot is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is vertically in front of you and its tail faces to the back. Attach the foot's back-facing ball socket to Riyu's front right leg's front-facing ball.

Group 15 - Riyu's front left leg

100. Let's build Riyu's front left leg. Place 1 black 2x5 stepped plate vertically in front of you, so that its high 2x3 plate faces to the front. Then, place 1 dark blue 1x2 brick vertically on the 2 back rows of the rightmost column of the ppp.

101. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 brick with ball socket to the left of the ppp, so that its socket faces to the left.

102. Place 1 black 1x1 half cylinder short brick with side stud on the back right corner, so that its side stud faces to the back and to the right. Then, insert 1 dark bluish gray mechanical claw into the side stud of the ppp, so that its hands face up and down.

103. Rotate 1 dark blue 2x2 corner plate so that it resembles an H in Braille. Place its right column in front of the 1x1 half cylinder short brick with side stud from the previous step. Then, place 1 bright light orange 1x1 round plate with open stud and petals on the rightmost column of the ppp. Rotate 1 black 1x2 plate with clips on long edge vertically. Place its front row to the left of the ppp.

104. Place 1 dark blue 2x4 plate vertically on the 3 front rows, so that it overhangs to the front by 1 row. Then, place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball horizontally on the front row of the ppp. Continue by placing 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 plate vertically behind the ppp. Place 1 sand blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top of the 2 front rows, so that its studs face to the front.

105. Place 2 black 1x4 rounded plates vertically, one to the right of the other, behind the ppp.

106. Attach 1 dark blue 2x2 inverted curved slope tile under the 2 front rows, so that it slopes to the front.

107. Place 1 pearl gold 2x4 curved slope with 2x2 studs, 1x2 side studs hanging down, and wing end vertically on the 4 front rows, so that its wing end faces to the front and its side studs face to the left and right.

108. Place 1 pearl gold 1x2 curved slope tile with wing end horizontally behind the ppp, so that its wing end faces to the back.

109. Place 1 dark blue 1x1 plate with 1x1 upright side stud under the rightmost column on the 3rd row from the front, so that its side stud faces to the right.

110. Locate 1 dark blue 1x1 plate with 1x1 upright side stud and repeat the previous step symmetrically on the left.

111. Rotate 1 pearl gold 1x2 ingot tile vertically upright, so that its antistuds face to the right. Attach its bottom row to the left-facing side stud of the ppp.

112. Rotate 1 pearl gold 1x2 ingot tile vertically upright, so that its antistuds face to the left and repeat the previous step symmetrically on the right.

113. Riyu's front left leg is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is vertically in front of you and its tail faces to the back. Attach the leg's left-facing ball socket to Riyu's front right-facing ball.

Group 16 - Riyu's front left foot

114. Let's build Riyu's front left foot. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with pin hole underneath horizontally in front of you, so that its pin hole faces to the front and back and is on the left. Then, insert 1 blue 3L pin into the front-facing hole, so that it protrudes to the front by 2L.

115. Rotate 1 black 1x2 plate with pin hole underneath horizontally, so that its pin hole faces to the front and back and is on the left. Slide its pin hole onto the front-facing pin, so that it protrudes to the front by 1L.

116. Place 1 dark blue 2x2 plate on top of the build.

117. Attach 1 dark blue 1x1 plate with 1x1 upright side stud under the back right corner, so that its side stud faces to the right.

118. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball socket on long edge horizontally on the back row, so that its ball socket faces to the back.

119. Place 1 black 1x2 plate with angled bar handles horizontally in front of the ppp, so that its bar handles face to the front.

120. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with 1x2 side studs hanging down on the rightmost column, so that its side studs face to the right.

121. Rotate 1 sand blue 2x2 plate with cut corner so that its side studs face to the left and its right angle faces to the back and to the top. Attach it to the right-facing side studs.

122. Place 1 sand blue 2x2 curved slope tile on top of the build, so that it slopes to the left.

123. Attach 1 black curved claw to each of the 3 front-facing bar handles, so that they curve down.

124. The foot is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is vertically in front of you and its tail faces to the back. Attach the foot's back-facing ball socket to Riyu's front left leg's front-facing ball.

Group 17 - Riyu's posing and armor details

125. In the following steps, we will pose Riyu's extremities. Begin by flipping Riyu's back feet 90 degrees from back to front, so that their antistuds face to the back and their claws curve to the back. Then, rotate Riyu's front right foot 90 degrees from left to right, so that its antistuds face to the left and its claws curve to the left. Repeat symmetrically with Riyu's front left foot.

126. Bend Riyu's back right foot 90 degrees counterclockwise, so that its antistuds face to the left and its claws curve to the left. Repeat symmetrically with Riyu's back left foot.

127. Rotate Riyu's right legs (both front and back) 90 degrees from right to left, so that their claws curve down. Repeat symmetrically with both of Riyu's left legs. Continue by rotating Riyu's front legs (both left and right) approximately 45 degrees from front to back. Lastly, rotate Riyu's front feet (both left and right) approximately 45 degrees from back to front, so that their claws curve down. This should leave Riyu in a standing position.

128. Grab 2 pearl gold 4x5x2 cockpits with bar handle. Rotate the first one so that its antistuds face to the left and its handle faces to the back and down. Attach its handle to the top- and front-facing clips located on Riyu's front left leg. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

129. Locate 2 pearl gold 2x2 round tiles with dragon head with horns printed pattern. Attach the first one to the left-facing studs of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the 2 ppps are oriented correctly.

Group 18 - Dragon Nya

Pages 93-95. Place 1 dark azure pair of legs with gold knee scales and claw pattern in front of you. Then, attach 1 dark azure dragon tail to the minifigure legs, so that its tail faces down and is to the left. Continue by attaching 1 dark azure torso with gold dragon head armor, pearl dark gray arms, and black hands to the minifigure. Attach 1 pearl gold shoulder armor with studs to the minifigure's neck, so that its studs face to the back. Then, attach 1 yellow minifigure head with medium azure eye mask with light aqua eyes. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the head is oriented correctly. Put on 1 dark azure helmet with molded pearl dark gray crests, so that its opening faces to the front.

Rotate the minifigure, so that its studs face to the front. Attach 2 pearl gold 1x1 tiles with upright clips, one to the right of the other, to the front-facing studs, so that their clip hands face to the left and right. Then, attach 1 dark azure webbed wing to each of the 2 ppps. Lastly, put 1 pearl gold katana into Dragon Nya's left hand.

Group 19 - Riyu's neck

130. Let's build Riyu's neck. Place 1 dark blue 2x2 plate in front of you.

131. Locate 2 dark blue 1x2 plates with 1x2 upright side studs. Place the first one vertically under the leftmost column of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

132. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball on long edge horizontally on the back row, so that its ball faces to the back. Then, place 1 black 1x2 plate with clips horizontally in front of the ppp, so that its clips face to the front.

133. Place 1 dark blue 2x2 plate on top of the build.

134. Find 2 light bright orange 1x1 plates with 1x1 side stud hanging down. Place the first one on the front left corner, so that its side stud faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

135. Place 1 sand blue 2x2 curved slope tile on top, so that it slopes to the back.

136. Grab 2 sand blue 2x2 plates with cut corner. Rotate the first one so that its side studs face to the left and its right angle faces to the front and to the bottom. Attach it to the right-facing side studs. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

137. The neck build is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is standing in front of you, with its tail to the back. Attach the neck's back-facing clips to the front-facing handle located between the articulations of Riyu's front legs.

Group 20 - Riyu's head

138. Let's build Riyu's head. Place 1 black 2x2 plate with bar underneath in front of you, so that its bar is to the front.

139. Locate 2 dark blue 1x1 plates with 1x1 upright side studs. Attach the first one under the back left corner of the ppp, so that its side stud faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

140. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with ball socket on long edge horizontally on the back row, so that its ball socket faces to the back.

141. Place the 1x2 plate of 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with 1x2 brick with pin hole on top of the ppp, so that its pin hole faces to the front.

142. Find 2 light bright orange 1x1 plates with 1x1 side studs hanging down. Place the first one on the back left corner, so that its side stud faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

143. Grab 2 light bright orange 1x1 plates with 1x1 side studs hanging down. Place the first one on the front left corner, so that its side stud faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

144. Place 1 sand blue 2x2 curved slope tile on top of the build, so that it slopes to the back.

145. Locate 2 sand blue 2x2 plates with cut corner. Rotate the first one so that its antistuds face to the left and its right angle faces to the back and to the bottom. Attach its back column to the back column of right-facing side studs. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

146. Find 2 sand blue 1x1 quarter round tiles. Attach the first one to the top front left-facing side stud, so that its curved edge faces to the back and to the bottom. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

147. Insert 1 black 2L pin into the front-facing pin hole, so that it protrudes to the front by 1L. Then, rotate 1 sand blue dragon head so that its pin hole faces to the back. Slide it onto the ppp.

Group 21 - Riyu's jaw

148. We need to assemble a sub-build for Riyu's jaw. Place 1 dark blue 1x2 rounded plate with open studs vertically and upside down in front of you. Then, attach 1 black 1x2 short brick with side studs on all sides and handle vertically to the ppp, so that its handle faces to the top and to the back.

149. Insert 1 reddish brown 2L bar with ring vertically upright to the front row, so that it protrudes by 1L up.

150. Flip 1 dark bluish gray short pin upside down. Then, slide it onto the ppp.

151. Attach 1 dark blue 1x1 brick with side stud to the front-facing side stud, so that its stud faces to the front and its side stud faces down. Then, attach 1 dark blue 1x1 slope tile to the bottom-facing stud of the ppp, so that it slopes to the back.

152. Grab 2 black 1x2 plates with clip on short edge. Attach the first one horizontally upright to the right-facing side studs, so that its clip faces to the back. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left. Locate 2 dark blue 1x2 curved slope tiles. Rotate the first one horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the right and it slopes to the front. Attach its back row to the front row of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

153. Locate 2 dark blue 1x1 quarter round tiles. Attach the first one behind the ppp, so that its curved edge faces to the back and to the bottom. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

154. Riyu's jaw is complete. Bring back Riyu's head, so that its pin hole faces to the back. Attach the jaw's back-facing clips to the head's bottom-facing handle.

155. Riyu's head is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is standing in front of you, with its tail to the back. Attach the head's back-facing ball socket to the neck's front-facing ball.

Group 22 - Riyu's wings and tail blade

156. Let's assemble Riyu's left wing. Place 1 sand blue dragon wing horizontally in front of you, so that its pin holes face to the left and its webbed fingers face to the back and to the right. Attach 1 pearl gold curved claw to the handle located on the front of the wing, so that it curves down.

157. Hold 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 technic liftarm with angle ball vertically, so that its ball faces to the back and to the bottom. Then, insert the axle of 1 blue pin with axle into each of the right-facing axle holes of the ppp, so that the pins protrude to the right. Lastly, slide the protruding pins into the 2 back holes of the wing.

158. The left wing is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is standing in front of you, with its tail to the back. Attach the wing's ball to the right-facing ball socket located in the middle of Riyu's torso, so that the wing's claw faces to the front.

159. Let's assemble Riyu's right wing. Place 1 sand blue dragon wing horizontally in front of you, so that its pin holes face to the right and its webbed fingers face to the back and to the left. Attach 1 pearl gold curved claw to the handle located on the front of the wing, so that it curves down.

160. Hold 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 technic liftarm with angle ball vertically, so that its ball faces to the back and to the bottom. Then, insert the axle of 1 blue pin with axle into each of the left-facing axle holes of the ppp, so that the pins protrude to the left. Lastly, slide the protruding pins into the 2 back holes of the wing.

161. The right wing is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is standing in front of you, with its tail to the back. Attach the wing's ball to the left-facing ball socket located in the middle of Riyu's torso, so that the wing's claw faces to the front.

162. Rotate Riyu's build 180 degrees on the horizontal plane, so that its tail is to the front. Attach 1 pearl gold saw blade with 6 teeth to the upright pin located on the front of the tail.

Group 23 - Riyu's weapon and final details

163. Let's build Riyu's weapon. Place 1 pearl gold 16L blade with axle vertically in front of you, so that its curved edge faces to the right. Then, slide 1 reddish brown axle connector with pin hole vertically onto the front-facing axle of the ppp, so that its pin hole faces to the left and right.

164. Insert 1 red 2L axle into the front-facing axle hole of the ppp, so that it protrudes to the front by 1L.

165. Attach 1 reddish brown 1x1 cone brick to the ppp.

166. Insert 1 of the bars of 1 pearl gold chain with bar ends into the front-facing hole of the ppp.

167. Attach 1 tan broom to the free bar of the ppp.

168. Riyu's weapon is complete. Bring back Riyu's build, so that it is standing in front of you, with its tail to the front. Attach the pin hole of the weapon's handle to the left-facing protruding pin located in the middle of Riyu's torso, so that its blade faces to the front. During play, you can also attach its weapon on the opposite side or to the pin in Riyu's mouth.

169. Locate 3 satin transparent clear 1x2 plates with handle on short edge and angular leaves with 7 spikes. Rotate the first one vertically, so that its handle faces to the back. Attach its handle to the front-facing clips located on the front of Riyu's tail. Rotate the second one horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the front and its handle faces to the right. Attach its handle to the mechanical claw located on the back of Riyu's left leg. Take the remaining one and repeat symmetrically on the right side.

The build is complete! Have fun battling Riyu, Arin, and Dragon Nya against the Loyalist and Mutation Monster.
