

71856 Jay's Transforming Car

Boys and girls ages 8 and up can enjoy hours of fast action with the LEGO® NINJAGO® Jay's Transforming Car (71856) toy building set. This 2-in-1 ninja car racing toy can be played with and displayed in 2 versions: regular mode or flip the front to put it into dragon mode, revealing golden claws, a dragon head and rotating shurikens. This great-value kids' adventure toy features a spring-loaded shooter with 2 darts, which can be detached and placed on a plant-covered side build for kids to play out battles. The set also includes 5 NINJAGO minifigures: Jay, Nya and dragon form Kai, plus the villainous Earth Monster and Loyalist Leader to stage good vs. evil battles. The LEGO NINJAGO range of building sets and role-play toys for kids includes detailed mechs, dragons and temples for fans to role-play ninja action.

The packaging displays Jay's Transforming Car in a fast-moving NINJAGO action scene. The front of the box shows the blue and gold car racing forward on large black tires, with Jay driving from the cockpit and the vehicle angled as if it is charging into battle. Around the car, the set's minifigures are arranged in an energetic fight scene: Dragon Kai appears in red dragon form with wings and a sword, Nya is shown as another heroic ninja, while the Earth Monster and the Loyalist Leader stand as the villains ready to confront them. The car itself uses bright blue bodywork, black structural details, pearl gold decoration, white flags, and yellow wheel accents, with a dragon-like front section that hints at the transformation feature. The build consists of 387 pieces in total and is recommended for ages 8+. Once finished, you will have a small piece of terrain, Jay's Car and 5 minifigures. The set consists of 4 numbered bags.

Welcome to text-based instructions from Bricks for the Blind! Before you start building, here are some terms we may be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- Open/hollow stud: a bump on a LEGO brick with a hole, which allows attaching bars. In the case of open studs, the hole goes all the way through. In the case of hollow studs, it does not.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Left/right wedge parts: these are parts that when placed in front of you and are pointing to the back, their wedge is on the left/right side of the part.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ell and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

Additionally, it is worth mentioning that besides the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, a PDF version for the set's instructions is always available online at [<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/building-instructions/71856>]. This might help a sighted building partner that may want to follow along or low vision users that may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2, and 3 and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 unnumbered bags, 1 instruction booklet, and 3 minifigures. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder!

LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Building Instructions

Book 1, bag 1

Group 1 – Jay

Page 4. Locate 1 blue pair of legs with dark blue sash, dragon scales, and claws pattern and 1 blue torso with a gold dragon head armor print and bright light yellow arms with black hands. Assemble the body of the minifigure. Then, attach a dark blue bandana to the minifigure's neck, so that it faces to the front. Continue by attaching 1 yellow minifigure head with reddish eyebrows and freckles to the minifigure's neck. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is facing the right way. Lastly, place 1 dark brown hair piece with molded blue headband on top of the minifigure's head, so that its bandana knot faces to the back. Lastly, place 1 pearl gold katana into Jay's left hand.

Group 2 – Dragon Kai

Pages 5-7. Place 1 red pair of legs with gold knee scales and claw pattern in front of you. Then, attach 1 red dragon tail to the minifigure legs, so that its tail faces down and is to the left. Continue by attaching 1 red torso with gold dragon head armor, dark red arms, and black hands to the minifigure. Attach 1 pearl gold shoulder armor with studs to the minifigure's neck, so that its studs face to the back. Then, attach 1 yellow minifigure head with black and red mask and bright light yellow eyes. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the head is oriented correctly. Put on 1 red helmet with molded dark red crests, so that its opening faces to the front.

Rotate the minifigure, so that its studs face to the front. Attach 2 pearl gold 1x1 tiles with upright clips, one to the right of the other, to the front-facing studs, so that their clip hands face to the left and right. Then, attach 1 dark red webbed wing to each of the 2 ppps. Lastly, put 1 pearl gold katana into Dragon Kai's left hand.

Group 3 – Loyalist Leader

Pages 8-10. Locate 1 black pair of legs with dark bluish gray belt, bold buckle, and cocktails, 1 black torso with dark red lapels, gold pendant, dragon on back, black arms, and dark red hands, and 1 yellow minifigure head with gold dragon mask with bright green eyes pattern. Assemble the minifigure. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the head is oriented correctly. Then, place 1 black hood on top of the minifigure's head, so that its opening faces to the front.

Let's build the Loyalist Leader's weapon. Hold 1 pearl gold 1L hilt with 2 side studs vertically upright, so that its side studs face to the left and right and its hole faces to the top. Then, insert 1 pearl gold 3L bar vertically upright into the top-facing hole. Rotate 1 pearl gold 1x1 round plate with holder ring with 3 bars and 3 bar holes upright, so that its antistud faces to the back and one of its bar holes faces down. Slide its bottom-facing bar hole onto the top of the ppp. Next, locate 2 pearl gold claws. Insert the first one into the top-left facing bar hole of the ppp, so that it curves to the top. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Continue by attaching 1 light bluish gray 1x1 round plate to the front-facing side stud. Lastly, attach 1 dark red 2x2 round tile with lime green background and gold dragon skull printed pattern onto the ppp. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the ppp is oriented correctly.

The weapon is complete. Put it in the Loyalist Leader's left hand.

Group 4 – Terrain

1. Place 1 dark tan 4x8 trapezoidal plate horizontally in front of you, so that its narrow side faces to the front. Then, place 1 reddish brown 1x2 inverted half arch horizontally on the 2 leftmost columns on the back row, so that it slopes to the left.
2. Place 1 reddish brown 1x1 cylinder brick in front of the right column of the ppp.
3. Place 1 reddish brown 1x2 rounded plate with open studs vertically on top of the 2 ppps.
4. Locate 2 reddish brown 1x1 slope tiles. Place the first one in front of the ppp, so that it slopes to the front. Place the second one to the right of the back row of the 1x2 rounded plate with open studs, so that it slopes to the right.

5. Rotate 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 slope brick so that it slopes to the back. Place its back row to the right of the ppp. Then, place 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 tile with 2 studs in front of the ppp, so that its studs face to the back. Lastly, place 1 orange 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves to the right of the front row of the ppp, so that its leaves face to the right.

Group 5 – Terrain (continued)

6. We need to assemble a sub-build. Place 1 black 2x3 step plate vertically in front of you, so that its high part faces to the back.

7. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 brick with pin horizontally on the front row of the ppp, so that its pin faces to the front.

8. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 plate vertically on top of the sub-build.

9. Find 2 black 1x2 plates with up-facing bar on long edge. Place the first one vertically on the 2 back rows of the leftmost column of the ppp, so that its bar is on the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically to the right.

10. Place 1 black 2x2 plate with wings in front of the 2 ppps, so that its wings face to the left and right and slope to the front.

11. Place 4 pearl gold 1x2 jumper plates horizontally, one in front of the other, on top of the sub-build.

12. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x4 projectile launcher vertically on top of the 4 ppps.

13. Place 2 dark bluish gray 1x2 ingot tiles vertically, one in front of the other, on top of the ppp.

14. The sub-build is complete. Bring back the terrain build, so that its narrow edge faces to the front. Place the sub-build's 2x2 base on the 2 front rows of the terrain, so that it is centered horizontally, on top of the 2x2 tile with 2 studs.

Group 6 – Terrain (continued)

15. Insert the bar of 1 reddish brown dinosaur tail into the open stud located on the 2nd column from the left on the back row, so that it faces to the right and to the top. Then, attach 1 reddish brown bar holder with clip to the tip of the ppp, so that its clip hands face up and down. Lastly, attach the bar of 1 bright green 1x2 plate with bar on short edge and 7 spike leaves to the ppp.

16. Insert 1 bright green plant stem with 3 leaves vertically upright into the open stud located on the 2nd column from the left on the 2nd row from the back.

17. You can use any of the 2 transparent red 8L bars with round end as projectiles by inserting them into the hole of the projectile launcher and tapping them on the opposite side. Be careful not to point or shoot them at anyone's face.

18. Let's assemble a small sub-build for a crate. Place 1 black 3x4 trapezoidal plate with 1x2 cutout horizontally in front of you, so that its narrow edge faces to the front and its cutout faces to the back.

19. Rotate 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with 1x2 brick with pin hole so that its pin hole faces to the front. Attach its back row to the front row of the ppp. Then, place 2 dark bluish gray 1x2 plates with clip on short edge vertically, one to the right of the other, behind the ppp.

20. Place 1 medium nougat 3x4 container horizontally on top of the 2 ppps, so that it is centered horizontally. Then, place 2 pearl gold sai weapons into the ppp. Lastly, place one medium nougat 3x4 tile with 4 studs in center horizontally on top of the crate to close it.

Book 1, bag 2

Group 7 – Jay's car

1. Let's build Jay's car. Place 1 dark bluish gray 6x8 plate vertically in front of you. Then, place 1 black 2x6 plate horizontally on the 2 front rows of the ppp.

2. Locate 2 red 1x6 plates with 1x4 cutout and 2x6 upright side studs. Place the first one vertically behind the leftmost column of the ppp, so that its side studs face to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

3. Find 2 tan 2x4 tiles. Rotate the first one vertically. Place its rightmost column on the 1x4 cutout of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

4. Grab 2 white 2x2 corner plates. Rotate the first one so that it resembles a D in Braille. Place its leftmost column behind the rightmost column of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 8 – Jay's car (continued)

5. We need to assemble a sub-build. Place 1 black 1x12 technic brick with holes vertically in front of you. Then, place 1 pearl gold 1x2 grille tile vertically on the 2 back rows of the ppp.

6. Place 1 pearl gold 1x2 plate with 3 vertical teeth on long edge vertically in front of the ppp, so that its teeth face to the right.

7. Place 1 black 2x2 ribbed short brick on the 2 front rows, so that it overhangs to the left by 1 column. Then, place 1 dark azure 1x2 brick with axle hole vertically under the overhang of the ppp, so that its axle hole faces to the left.

8. Insert 2 black pins into the 6th and 8th holes from the back of the 1x12 technic brick, so that they protrude to the left by 1L. Rotate 1 light bluish gray 4x6 technic brick with open center vertically. Slide its 2 back and front right-facing holes onto the 2 ppps. Lastly, insert 2 black pins into the back and front left-facing holes of the ppp, so that they protrude to the left by 1L.

9. Rotate 1 black 1x12 technic brick with holes vertically. Slide its 4th and 6th holes from the front onto the 2 ppps.

10. Place 1 pearl gold 1x2 grille tile vertically on the 2 back rows of the ppp.

11. Place 1 pearl gold 1x2 plate with 3 vertical teeth on long edge vertically in front of the ppp, so that its teeth face to the left.

12. Place 1 black 2x2 ribbed short brick on the 2 front rows of the left 1x2 technic brick, so that it overhangs to the right by 1 column. Then, place 1 dark azure 1x2 brick with axle hole vertically under the overhang of the ppp, so that its axle hole faces to the right.

13. The sub-build is complete. Bring back the main build, so that it is vertical and its black 2x6 plate faces to the front. Place the sub-build's 2 front rows on top of the 2 front rows of the main build, so that the sub-build overhangs to the back by 4 rows.

Group 9 – Jay's car (continued)

14. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 brick with pin hole horizontally on the 6th row from the back, so that it is centered horizontally and its pin hole faces to the front.

15. Insert 1 tan 3L pin into the back-facing hole located on the 5th row from the back, so that it protrudes to the back by 1L.

16. Locate 8 red 1x1 round plates. Stack 2 of them and place them on the 3rd row from the back on the leftmost column. Stack 2 more and place them in front of the 2 ppps. Take the remaining 4 and repeat symmetrically on the right. Lastly, place 1 black 1x1 cone brick on top of each of the 4 round plate stacks.

17. Find 2 black 2x5 step plates. Rotate the first one vertically, so that its elevated 2x3 plate faces to the back. Place its 2 front rows on the 6th and 7th rows from the front on the 2 leftmost columns, so that its 2 back rows of its leftmost columns attach to the 1x1 cone bricks. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Lastly, place 1 medium nougat 2x2 tile to the left of the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front of the ppp.

18. Place 1 black 1x2 rounded plate with open studs horizontally on the 3rd row from the front, so that it is centered horizontally. Grab 2 white 2x3 plates. Rotate the first one vertically. Place its front row to the left of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

19. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x6 brick horizontally on the 7th row from the front, in front of the raised part of the 2x5 step plates.

20. Locate 4 reddish brown 1x2 plates with 1x2 upright side studs. Place the first 2 vertically, one in front of the other, in front of the leftmost column of the ppp, so that their side studs face to the left. Take the remaining 2 and repeat symmetrically on the right.

21. Place 1 reddish brown 4x4 plate between the 2 columns of 1x2 plates with 1x2 upright side studs from the previous step.

22. Grab 2 dark bluish gray 1x2 bricks with pin hole. Place the first one vertically on the 2nd column from the left on the 2 front rows, so that its pin hole faces to the left and right. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

23. Locate 2 dark azure 1x2 bricks with axle hole. Place the first one vertically to the right of the ppp, so that its axle hole faces to the right. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left. Find 2 yellow 3L axles. Insert the first one into the left-facing axle hole of the ppp, so that it protrudes to the left by 2L. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

24.1 We need to assemble a small sub-build. Hold 1 white 3L axle and pin connector with center pin hole vertically upright, so that its pin hole faces to the front and back. Insert 1 black 2L pin into the front-facing pin hole, so that it protrudes to the front by 1L.

24.2 Attach 1 light bluish gray rotation joint pin with axle hole to the ppp, so that its axle hole faces to the left and right.

24.3 Attach 1 light bluish gray 12 tooth gear with axle holes to the ppp, so that its axle holes are to the back and face to the left and right.

24.4 The sub-build is complete. Bring back the car build, so that its elevated plates face to the back. Slide the sub-build between the 1x2 bricks with pin hole located on the 2 front rows, so that the sub-build's top left- and right-facing axle holes are aligned with their pin holes. Then, fix the sub-build in place by pushing the overhanging axles towards the center of the build, so that they do not protrude any more.

Group 10 – Jay's car (continued)

25. Place 1 blue 2x4 plate horizontally on top of the 2 front rows, so that it is centered horizontally. Find 2 blue 1x2 plates with 2x2 side studs hanging down. Place the first one vertically to the left of the ppp, so that its side studs face to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

26. Place 1 black 1x2 rounded plate with open studs horizontally on the 6th row from the front, so that it is centered horizontally. Then, rotate 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 curved slope tile so that it slopes to the front. Place its back row on top of the ppp.

27. Grab 2 reddish brown 1x2 slope tiles. Place the first one horizontally to the left of the back row of the ppp, so that it slopes to the front. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

28. Place 1 reddish brown 1x2 tile with bar handle horizontally behind each of the 2 ppps, so that their flat edge faces to the back. These are the backrests of the car seats.

29. Rotate the build 180 degrees on the horizontal plane, so that its elevated plates face to the front. Place 1 red 1x1 round plate on the 4th row from the back on the 3rd column from the right, in front of the right column of the 2x2 curved slope tile. Then, place 1 dark bluish gray 1x1 round tile with upright thin bar to the left of the ppp. Lastly, attach the stud of 1 light bluish gray 1x1 round plate with open stud with angled bar underneath to the ppp, so that its angled bar faces to the front and up.

30. Place 1 dark bluish gray 1x6 plate horizontally on the 3rd row from the back. Then, place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 tile with steering wheel horizontally on the 2 leftmost columns of the ppp, so that the steering wheel faces to the front. Continue by placing 1 light bluish gray 1x2 jumper plate horizontally to the right of the ppp. Next, place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 slope tile horizontally to the right of the ppp, so that it slopes to the front. Attach 1 blue minifigure skate horizontally to the 1x2 jumper plate, so that its side with upright end faces to the left. Lastly, place 1 pearl gold 1x1 round plate with open stud on top of the ppp.

31. Place 2 dark bluish gray 1x2 plates with stud and upright clip vertically, one to the right of the other, on the 2 back rows, so that together they are centered horizontally and their clips are to the back.

32. Rotate 1 dark bluish gray 2x2 curved slope tile so that it slopes to the front. Place its back row to the front row of the 2 ppps. We need to apply sticker 4 (a dark blue screen with a pearl gold diagram of the car simulating a computer screen) to the ppp. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the sticker is applied and oriented correctly.

33. Locate 2 dark bluish gray 1x2 bricks with pin hole. Place the first one horizontally on the front row of the elevated plate on the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

34. Place 1 blue 1x6 technic brick with holes horizontally behind the 2 ppps. Find 2 dark bluish gray 1L pins with studs. Insert the first one into the 2nd back-facing hole from the left of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Lastly, insert 1 dark bluish gray mechanical claw into the back of each of the 2 ppps, so that their arms face up and down.

35. Grab 2 blue 1x2 plates with 2x4 side studs hanging down. Rotate the first one vertically, so that its side studs face to the left. Place its back row on top of the leftmost column of the 1x6 technic brick with holes. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Locate 2 blue 2x2 corner tiles. Rotate the first one so that its right angle faces to the back and to the right. Place it to the left of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left.

36. Insert 1 black 2L pin into each of the front-facing pin holes, so that they protrude to the front by 1L. Then, attach 1 light bluish gray round technic driving ring to each of the 2 ppps.

Group 11 – Jay's car (continued)

37. Rotate the build 90 degrees counterclockwise, so that the 2 ppps face to the right. Rotate 1 black 3x3 corner plate so that its antistuds face to the back and its right angle faces to the top and to the right. Attach its top row to the 3 leftmost columns on the 2nd row from the top of front-facing side studs.

38. Attach 1 black 1x4 tile horizontally upright to the right of the bottom row of the ppp. Then, attach 1 black 1x2 left wedge tile vertically to the right of the ppp, so that it points up.

39. Attach 1 black 1x2 plate with clip on short edge vertically upright to the right of the 2 top rows of the 3x3 corner plate, so that its clip faces up. Then, attach 1 black 1x2 rounded plate with open studs vertically upright to the right of the ppp. Lastly, attach 1 black 1x2 plate with clip on short edge vertically upright to the right of the ppp, so that its clip faces up.

40. Rotate 1 blue 4x4 plate with cut corner so that its antistuds face to the back and its right angle faces to the left and to the top. Attach its 2 bottom rows to the right of the ppp.

41. Attach 1 pearl gold 1x1 plate with clip above the rightmost column of the ppp, so that its clip faces up. Then, attach 1 blue 1x2 plate with stud and sloped tile horizontally upright to the left of the ppp, so that it slopes to the left. Lastly, rotate 1 blue 1x4 slope tile horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the back and it slopes to the right. Attach its leftmost column to the rightmost column of the ppp, so that it overhangs to the right by 1 column.

42. Rotate the car build 180 degrees on the horizontal plane, so that the ppp slopes to the left. Rotate 1 black 3x3 corner plate so that its antistuds face to the back and its right angle faces to the top and to the left. Attach its top row to the 3 rightmost columns on the 2nd row from the top of front-facing side studs.

43. Attach 1 black 1x4 tile horizontally upright to the left of the bottom row of the ppp. Then, attach 1 black 1x2 right wedge tile vertically to the left of the ppp, so that it points up.

44. Attach 1 black 1x2 plate with clip on short edge vertically upright to the left of the 2 top rows of the 3x3 corner plate, so that its clip faces up. Then, attach 1 black 1x2 rounded plate with open studs vertically upright to the left of the ppp. Lastly, attach 1 black 1x2 plate with clip on short edge vertically upright to the left of the ppp, so that its clip faces up.

45. Rotate 1 blue 4x4 plate with cut corner so that its antistuds face to the back and its right angle faces to the right and to the top. Attach its 2 bottom rows to the left of the ppp.

46. Attach 1 pearl gold 1x1 plate with clip above the leftmost column of the ppp, so that its clip faces up. Then, attach 1 blue 1x2 plate with stud and sloped tile horizontally upright to the right of the ppp, so that it slopes to the right. Lastly, rotate 1 blue 1x4 slope tile horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the back and it slopes to the left. Attach its rightmost column to the leftmost column of the ppp, so that it overhangs to the left by 1 column.

47. Attach 1 black 6L bar with ring vertically to the right-facing mechanical claws located to the left of the car seats.

Group 12 – Earth Monster

Pages 66-67. Locate 1 dark tan pair of legs with black cracks and reddish orange markings and 1 dark tan torso with gold pendant necklace, reddish orange lava pattern, dark tan arms, and dark bluish gray hands. Assemble the body of the minifigure. Then, attach 1 transparent orange shoulder armor with crystal shards and 2 studs to the minifigure's neck, making sure that the studs are on the minifigure's back. Attach the dark tan head with black cracks and reddish orange eyes and mouth to the minifigure's head. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the face print is facing the right way. Place the dark tan stone headgear with pincers on top of the ppp, making sure that the long pincer faces to the front and the short one to the back. Then, put 1 dark bluish gray 1x1 round plate with bar underneath into each of the minifigure's hands. Finally, attach 1 dark tan stone headgear with pincers to each of the 2 ppps, so that the long pincer faces to the top and the short one to the bottom.

Group 13 – Jay's car

48. Locate 2 pearl gold 1x1 round plates. Attach the first one to the leftmost column and top row of front-facing side studs. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

49. Rotate 1 blue 1x2 plate with stud and slope tile horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the back and it slopes to the right. Skip 2 columns to the right of the ppp and attach the 1x2 plate with stud and slope tile, on the 2 right columns on the top row of the 4x4 plate with cut corner. Rotate 1 blue 2x5 left wedge tile horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the back and it points to the left. Attach its top right corner to the left column of the ppp.

Find 1 blue 1x2 plate with stud and slope tile and 1 blue 2x5 right wedge tile and repeat symmetrically on the back.

50. Rotate 1 blue 2x3 plate horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the back. Attach its left and right columns to the front-facing 1x2 plates with clip on short edge. Then, attach 1 blue 1x2 grille tile vertically upright to the ppp, so that it is centered horizontally. Grab 2 blue 2x2 curved slope tiles. Attach the first one upright to the left of the ppp, so that it slopes to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

Locate 1 blue 2x3 plate, 1 blue 1x2 grille tile, and 2 blue 2x2 curved slope tiles and repeat symmetrically on the back.

51. Find 2 black 4L bars. Attach the first one to the top-facing clips located on the front of the build. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

52. Grab 2 blue 2x2 curved slope tiles. Attach the first one to the 2 rightmost columns on the 2 top rows of front-facing side studs, so that it slopes to the top. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back. We need to apply 1 sticker 1 (a blue armor plating with black horizontal exhaust ports) to each of the 2 ppps. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the stickers are applied and oriented correctly.

53.1 We need to assemble a small sub-build. Place 1 black 3x6 rectangular bar with 4 studs vertically in front of you.

53.2 Locate 2 black bar holders with hole and clip. Attach the first one behind the front left stud of the ppp, so that its hole faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

53.3 Insert 1 black 4L bar into the left-facing hole of each of the 2 ppps.

53.4 Rotate 1 black 1x2 rounded plate with open studs horizontally upright, so that its antistuds face to the left. Then, slide it onto the 2 ppps. Push it as far as possible to the right.

53.5 Find 2 black bar holders with hole and clip. Attach the first one to the left of the bar in the front, so that its clip hands face up and down. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the back.

53.6 The sub-build is complete. Bring back the car build, so that rotation pin faces to the right. Attach the 2 ppps to the middle of the vertical bar located behind the car seats.

54. Bring the sub-build down and angle its 3x6 rectangular bar with 4 studs so that its right bar attaches to the upright clips located on the rightmost column of the car.

55. Attach 1 pearl gold bar holder with handle to the back clip located on the left of the car. Angle it so that it points up and to the left. Then, insert 1 black 4L bar into the ppp. Lastly, attach 1 white 2x3 triangular flag to the top part of the ppp, so that it points to the left and down. We need to apply sticker 6 (a dark blue triangle with a golden dragon head) to the back of the ppp. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the sticker is applied and oriented correctly.

56. Attach 1 pearl gold bar holder with handle to the front clip located on the left of the car. Angle it so that it points up and to the left. Then, insert 1 black 4L bar into the ppp. Lastly, attach 1 white 2x3 triangular flag to the top part of the ppp, so that it points to the left and down. We need to apply sticker 5 (a dark blue triangle with a golden dragon head) to the front of the ppp. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the sticker is applied and oriented correctly.

Group 14 – Jay's car (continued)

57. We need to assemble a sub-build for the front part of the car. Place 1 black 4x4 technic brick with open center in front of you, so that its sides with 1 pin hole face to the front and back. Then, insert 1 yellow 2L pin to the back-facing hole, so that it protrudes to the back by 1L.

58. Rotate 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 brick with pin hole and liftarm extensions horizontally, so that its liftarms face to the back. Slide its front-facing hole onto the ppp.

59. Insert 1 blue 3L pin into each of the 2 back left-facing pin holes, so that they protrude to the left by 2L. Rotate 1 light bluish gray 1x8 technic brick vertically. Slide its 2nd and 3rd holes from the front onto the 2 ppps, so that its front edge is flush with the front edge of the 4x4 technic brick with open center and the pins protrude to the left by 1L.

60. Insert 1 blue 3L pin into each of the 2 back right-facing pin holes, so that they protrude to the right by 2L. Rotate 1 light bluish gray 1x8 technic brick vertically. Slide its 2nd and 3rd holes from the front onto the 2 ppps, so that its front edge is flush with the front edge of the 4x4 technic brick with open center and the pins protrude to the right by 1L.

61. Place 1 black 4x6 plate horizontally under the 2nd to 5th rows from the back. Locate 2 dark bluish gray 1x2 bricks with pin hole. Place the first one vertically on the 2nd column from the left on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back, so that its back edge is flush with the back edge of the 4x6 plate. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Then, place 1 tan 1x1 round brick in front of each of the 2 ppps.

62. Attach 1 reddish brown 1x2 plate with 1x2 upright side studs horizontally under the front row, so that it is centered horizontally, so that its side studs face to the front.

63. Attach 1 black 2x6 plate with holes horizontally behind the ppp, under the sub-build. Then, place 1 white 2x2 round brick with axle hole on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so that it is centered horizontally and in the middle of the open center of the 4x4 technic brick.

64. Find 2 black 1x2 ingot tiles. Place the first one vertically on the 2 back rows of the leftmost column. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Then, place 1 black 1x3 plate vertically in front of each of the 2 ppps. Lastly, place 1 pearl gold 1x2 plate with vertical teeth on long edge vertically in front of each of the 2 ppps, so that their teeth face to the outside.

65. Grab 2 black 1x2 plates with 1x4 side studs hanging down. Place the first one horizontally on the 2 leftmost columns of the front row, so that its side studs face to the front. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

66. Rotate 1 black 4x6 plate vertically. Place its rightmost column behind the left column of the ppp.

Group 15 – Jay's car (continued)

67. Place 1 flat silver 2x2 plate with air scoop engine on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back, so that it is centered horizontally and its open side faces to the front.

68. Locate 4 light bluish gray 1x2 plates with stud and upright pin hole. Rotate the first horizontally, so that its pin hole faces to the left. Place its rightmost column in front of the leftmost column of the ppp. Place the second one horizontally in front of the ppp, so that its pin hole faces to the left. Take the remaining 2 and place them symmetrically on the right.

69. Find 2 blue 3x3 corner plates. Rotate the first one, so that its right angle faces to the front and to the right. Place its 2 back rows to the right of the 2 ppps. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left. Then, place 1 blue 1x6 plate horizontally in front of the 2 ppps.

70. Grab 2 reddish brown 1x2 plates with clip on long edge. Place the first one vertically behind the leftmost column of the ppp, so that its clip faces to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Then, locate 2 yellow 2x2 corner plates. Rotate the first one so that it resembles an H in Braille. Place its front row to the left of the front row of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically to the left.

71. Rotate 1 blue 2x2 curved slope tile so that it slopes to the back. Place its front row on top of the back row of the 2 ppps.

72. Rotate 1 blue 1x4 right wedge tile vertically, so that it slopes to the back. Place it on the 2nd to 5th rows from the back on the leftmost column. Take 1 blue 1x4 left wedge tile and repeat symmetrically on the right.

73. Place 1 blue 2x4 curved slope tile vertically in front of the 2x2 curved slope tile, so that it slopes to the front and it overhangs to the front by 1 row. We need to apply sticker 2 (blue plates of armor with pearl gold decorations) to the ppp. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the sticker is applied and oriented correctly.

74. Locate 2 blue 1x4 right wedge tiles. Place them vertically, one to the left of the other, to the left of the ppp, so that they slope to the front. Then, take 2 blue 1x4 left wedge tiles and repeat symmetrically on the right.

Group 16 – Jay's car (continued)

75. Find 2 blue 2L pins with axle. Insert the pin of the first one into the left back-facing pin hole. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Grab 2 flat silver round 90 degree tubes. Attach the first one to the ppp, so that its other hole faces to the right. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left. Then, attach 1 transparent light blue 1x1 round plate to the hole of each of the 2 ppps.

76. Attach 2 dark bluish gray 1x2 plates with stud and upright clip vertically upright, one to the right of the other, to the front facing side studs, so that together they are centered horizontally and their clips are to the bottom. Locate 4 pearl gold 1x1 round plates with bar. Place the first 2 vertically upright to the left of the top row of the 2 ppps, so that their bars face to the bottom. Take the remaining 2 and place them symmetrically on the right.

77. Find 2 transparent yellow 1x1 slope tiles. Place the first one on the leftmost column of front-facing side studs, so that it slopes to the left. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

78. Attach 1 dark bluish gray 1x6 tile horizontally upright to the row of front-facing side studs, between the 2 ppps.

79. Rotate 1 black push bumper horizontally, so that it curves slightly upwards. Attach its back bar to the front-facing clips.

80. Angle the ppp upright so that it is as close as possible to the body of the sub-build.

Group 17 – Jay's car (continued)

81. Flip the build upside down from left to right, so that the ppp faces to the front. Then, attach 1 pearl gold curved claw to each of the 4 top-facing handles located on the front of the sub-build, so that they curve down.

82. Grab 2 black 1x2 inverted curved slope tiles. Place the first one vertically on the 2 back rows of the leftmost column, so that it slopes to the back. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the right. Locate 4 black 2x2 inverted tiles. Place the right column of the first one in front of the ppp. Take the second one and repeat symmetrically on the left. Place the third one in front of the ppp. Take the last one and repeat symmetrically on the right.

83. Find 4 black 1x2 inverted curve slope tiles. Place the first 2 vertically in front of the ppp, one to the right of the other, so that they slope to the front. Take the remaining 2 and repeat symmetrically on the left.

84. The front of the car is complete. Bring back the car, so that its flags face to the back and its rotation joint pin faces to the front. Then, insert the car's rotation joint pin into the back of the front of the car. Note that the front of the car should still be upside down, with its claws at the front curving down. Then, insert 1 black 6L axle horizontally into the 2nd hole from the back of the nose of the car. Make sure to push it through, so that it does not protrude to either side.

Group 18 – Nya

Page 98. Locate 1 dark azure pair of legs with gold knee scales and claws pattern and 1 dark azure torso with gold dragon head armor, pearl dark gray arms, and black hands. Assemble the body of the minifigure. Then, attach 1 dark azure bandana to the minifigure's neck, so that it faces to the front. Next, attach 1 yellow minifigure head with eyelashes and beauty mark to the minifigure's neck. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the head is oriented correctly. Lastly, place 1 black ponytail with molded dark azure bandana on top of the ppp, so that the ponytail faces to the back. Put 1 pearl gold katana into Nya's left hand.

Group 19 – Jay's car

85. Find 4 blue 2L axles with pin. Grab the first 2 and insert their pins into the 1st and 3rd left-facing holes from the back of the nose of the car, so that their axles protrude to the left. Take the remaining 2 and repeat symmetrically on the right. Lastly, attach 1 light bluish gray 2x2 truncated cone to each of the 4 ppps.

86. Insert 1 red 4L axle vertically upright into the hole located on the 2nd row from the front, so that it protrudes to the top by 3L.

Group 20 – Jay's car (continued)

87. We need to assemble a sub-build for the car's dragon head. Place 1 black 2x6 plate with holes vertically in front of you. Then, place 1 white 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of the 2 front rows of the ppp. Continue by placing 1 transparent yellow 1x2 plate horizontally behind the ppp.

88. Grab 4 bright light yellow 1x1 plates with horizontal tooth. Place the first 3 behind the left column of the ppp, one in front of the other, so that their teeth face to the left. Take the remaining 3 and repeat symmetrically on the right.

89. Place 1 dark bluish gray 2x4 plate with holes vertically on the 4 front rows. Then, place 1 white 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of the 2 back rows of the ppp. Lastly, place 1 transparent yellow 1x2 plate horizontally on the front row of the ppp.

90. Place 1 pearl gold 4x4 stepped wedge behind the ppp, so that its studs face to the front and it slopes to the back.

91. Rotate 1 transparent yellow dragon head with pearl gold face vertically, so that its teeth face down and are to the front. Place its two back rows on top of the 2 front rows of the sub-build. Then, attach 1 pearl gold curved claw to each of the 2 back-facing handles of the ppp, so that they curve to the back.

92. Place 1 pearl gold 2x3 pentagonal tile vertically on the 2 front rows of the dragon head, so that its point faces to the back. We need to apply sticker 3 (a pearl gold armor with bright light yellow, white, and blue decorations) to the ppp. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the sticker is applied and oriented correctly.

93. The sub-build is complete. Bring back the car, so that its flags face to the back. Slide the front bottom-facing hole of the dragon head sub-build onto the protruding axle on the front of the car. Make sure to push the head down as much as possible.

Group 21 – Jay's car (continued)

94. We need to assemble a small sub-build. Place 1 light bluish gray 1x2 plate with clip on long edge horizontally in front of you, so that its clip faces to the front. Then, place 1 dark bluish gray 1x2 plate with bar holders on top of the ppp, so that the bar holders are to the back. Lastly, place 4 transparent yellow 1x1 round tiles on top of the ppp (2 on the studded surface and 1 on top of each of the 2 bar holders).

The sub-build is complete. Flip it upright from back to front, so that its clip faces down. Attach its clip to the middle of the bar located behind the car seats.

95.1 We need to assemble a small sub-build. Hold 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 quarter ellipse technic liftarm horizontally upright, so that its curved edge faces to the right and to the bottom. Then, insert the axle of 1 blue 2L axle with pin into the leftmost back-facing axle hole, so that its pin protrudes to the back.

95.2 Insert 1 dark bluish gray 4L axle with stop into the leftmost back-facing pin hole (below the ppp), so that its stop faces to the back and it protrudes to the front by 3L.

95.3 Slide 1 light bluish gray bush onto the front of the ppp, so that it goes as far to the back as possible.

95.4 Insert 1 black 2L pin into the rightmost back-facing hole, so that it protrudes to the back by 1L.

95.5 The sub-build is complete. Bring back the car build, so that its dragon head faces to the right. Insert the back-protruding pins of the sub-build into the 1st and 3rd front-facing holes from the left located on the left of the car. We will attach one wheel to this protruding axle soon.

96.1 We need to assemble a small sub-build. Hold 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 quarter ellipse technic liftarm horizontally upright, so that its curved edge faces to the left and to the top. Then, insert 1 dark bluish gray 4L axle with stop into the rightmost back-facing pin hole, so that its stop faces to the back and it protrudes to the front by 3L.

96.2 Slide 1 light bluish gray bush onto the front of the ppp, so that it goes as far to the back as possible.

96.3 The sub-build is complete. Bring back the car build, so that its dragon head faces to the right. Slide the sub-builds 2 leftmost pinholes onto the protruding pins located on the right of the car. We will attach one wheel to this protruding axle soon.

97.1 We need to assemble a small sub-build. Hold 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 quarter ellipse technic liftarm horizontally upright, so that its curved edge faces to the left and to the bottom. Then, insert the axle of 1 blue 2L axle with pin into the rightmost back-facing axle hole, so that its pin protrudes to the back.

97.2 Insert 1 dark bluish gray 4L axle with stop into the rightmost back-facing pin hole (below the ppp), so that its stop faces to the back and it protrudes to the front by 3L.

97.3 Slide 1 light bluish gray bush onto the front of the ppp, so that it goes as far to the back as possible.

97.4 Insert 1 black 2L pin into the leftmost back-facing hole, so that it protrudes to the back by 1L.

97.5 The sub-build is complete. Bring back the car build, so that its dragon head faces to the left. Insert the back-protruding pins of the sub-build into the 1st and 3rd front-facing holes from the right located on the right of the car. We will attach one wheel to this protruding axle soon.

98.1 We need to assemble a small sub-build. Hold 1 dark bluish gray 2x3 quarter ellipse technic liftarm horizontally upright, so that its curved edge faces to the right and to the top. Then, insert 1 dark bluish gray 4L axle with stop into the leftmost back-facing pin hole, so that its stop faces to the back and it protrudes to the front by 3L.

98.2 Slide 1 light bluish gray bush onto the front of the ppp, so that it goes as far to the back as possible.

98.3 The sub-build is complete. Bring back the car build, so that its dragon head faces to the left. Slide the sub-build's 2 rightmost pinholes onto the protruding pins located on the left of the car. We will attach one wheel to this protruding axle soon.

Group 22 – Jay's car (continued)

99. Insert 1 bright light yellow wheel into each of the 4 black tractor tires.

100. Attach 1 wheel to each of the 4 protruding axles, so that the axles protrude slightly.

101. Attach 1 black 3x3 disk with axle hole the protruding axle of each of the 4 wheels.

Group 23 – Jay's car (continued)

102.1 We need to assemble 2 identical sub-builds for the car's spinners. You can choose to assemble them simultaneously or one at a time. Let's begin with the first one. Hold 1 dark bluish gray technic angled axle and pin connector horizontally upright, so that its pin hole faces to the front, its first axle connector faces to the left and its second axle connector faces to the right and to the bottom. Then, insert 1 red 4L axle into the left-facing axle hole of the ppp.

103. Insert the axle of 1 dark bluish gray technic pin hole with axle into the bottom-right facing axle hole, so that its pin hole faces to the top right and to the bottom left.

104. Insert 1 white bush into 1 black small wheel. Hold the wheel so that it is horizontal. Then, insert 1 reddish brown 3L axle with stop vertically upright into the bottom facing axle hole, so that its stop faces to the bottom and it protrudes to the top. Then, slide 1 tan 12 tooth gear onto the ppp, so that its flat side faces to the bottom. Then, insert the protruding axle into the bottom left-facing pin hole of the sub-build, so that the axle protrudes to the top right. Lastly, slide 1 white 2x2 round plate with axle hole onto the protruding axle.

105. Attach 1 dark bluish gray 4x4 round plate to the ppp. Then, place 1 pearl gold 2x2 round tile onto the ppp, so that it is centered horizontally and vertically. We need to apply sticker 1 (a pearl gold round armor with yellow electrical rays in the center) to the ppp. Ask a sighted friend to make sure that the sticker is applied and oriented correctly. Lastly, slide 1 pearl gold 4x4 spinner crown with 2x2 hole onto the ppp.

106. The sub-build is complete. Bring back the car, so that its dragon head faces to the left. Then, insert the protruding axle of the spinner sub-build into the front-facing hole located in the middle of the car, underneath the 2x2 top-sloping curved slope tile.

If you chose to build one spinner at a time, build a second one by repeating steps 102 to 105. Attach it symmetrically to the opposite side of the car.

We are done with the construction! If you wish, you can change the look of the car by rotating its front 180 degrees. This way, the dragon head can be on the top or on the bottom. Enjoy the adventures of our Ninjago heroes battling evil monsters in Jay's car.
